**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 7 is a front view of a third embodiment of a window shade according to the present invention in an open position.

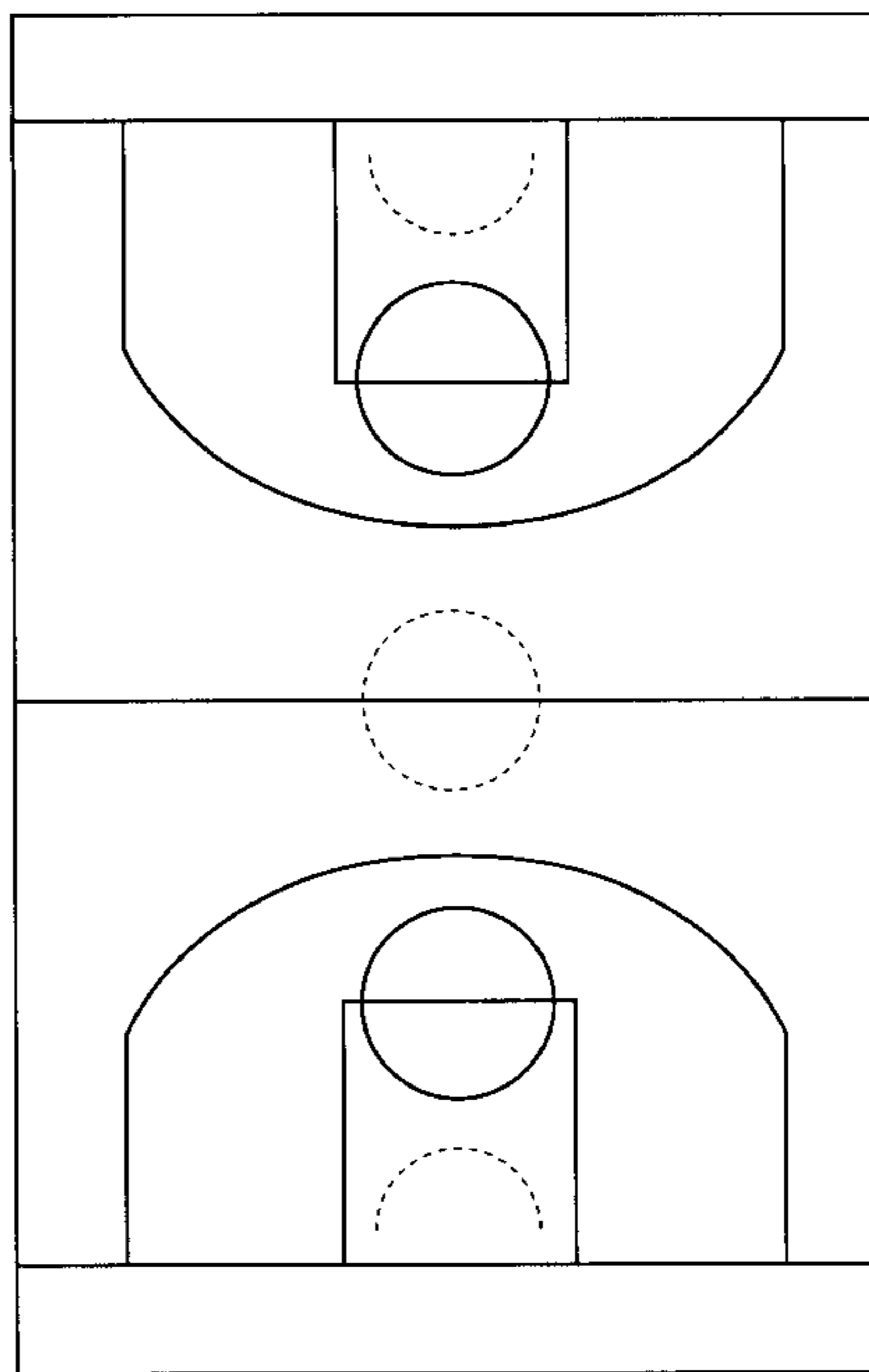
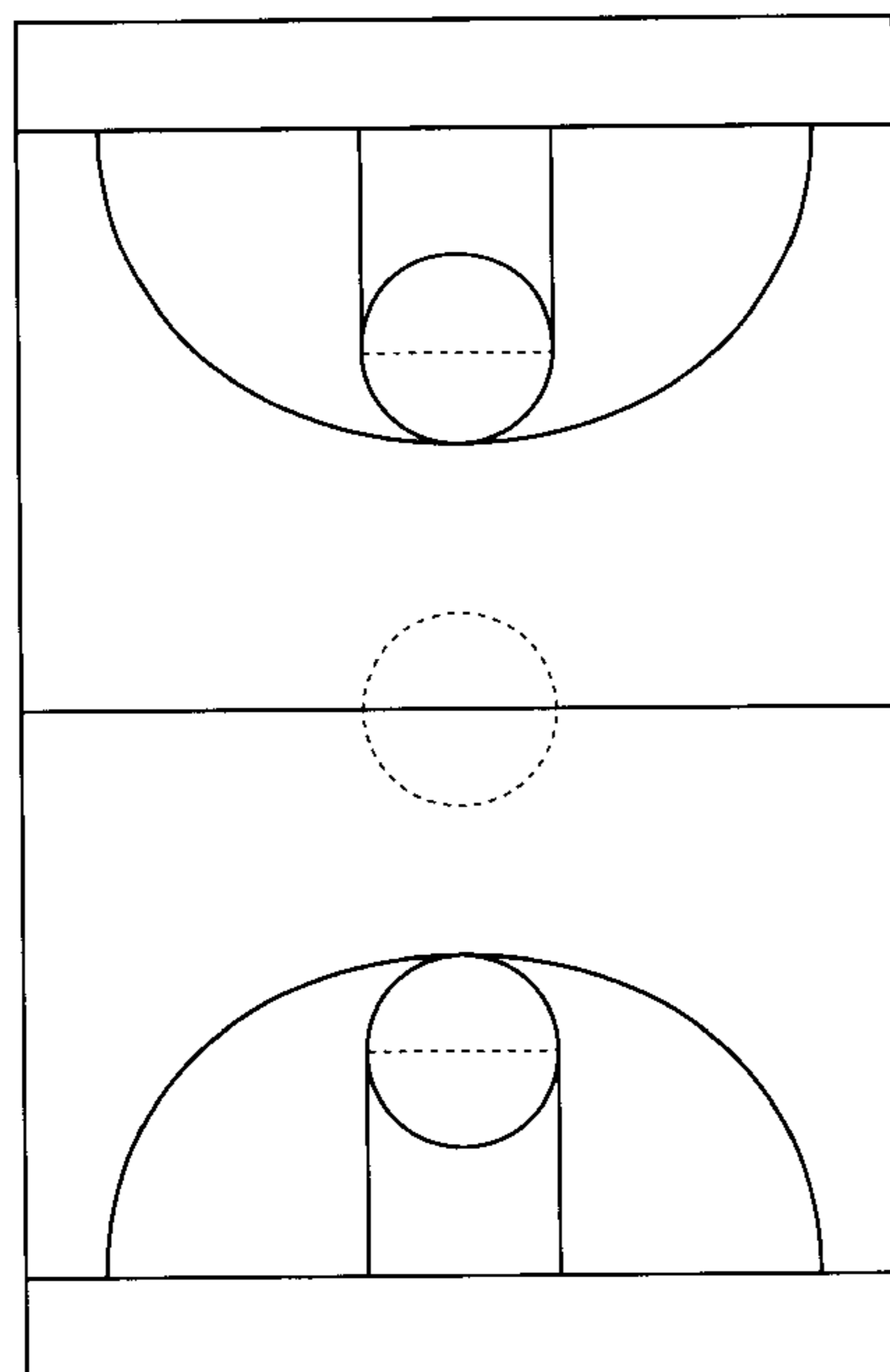
FIG. 8 is a front view of a fourth embodiment of a window shade according to the present invention in an open position;

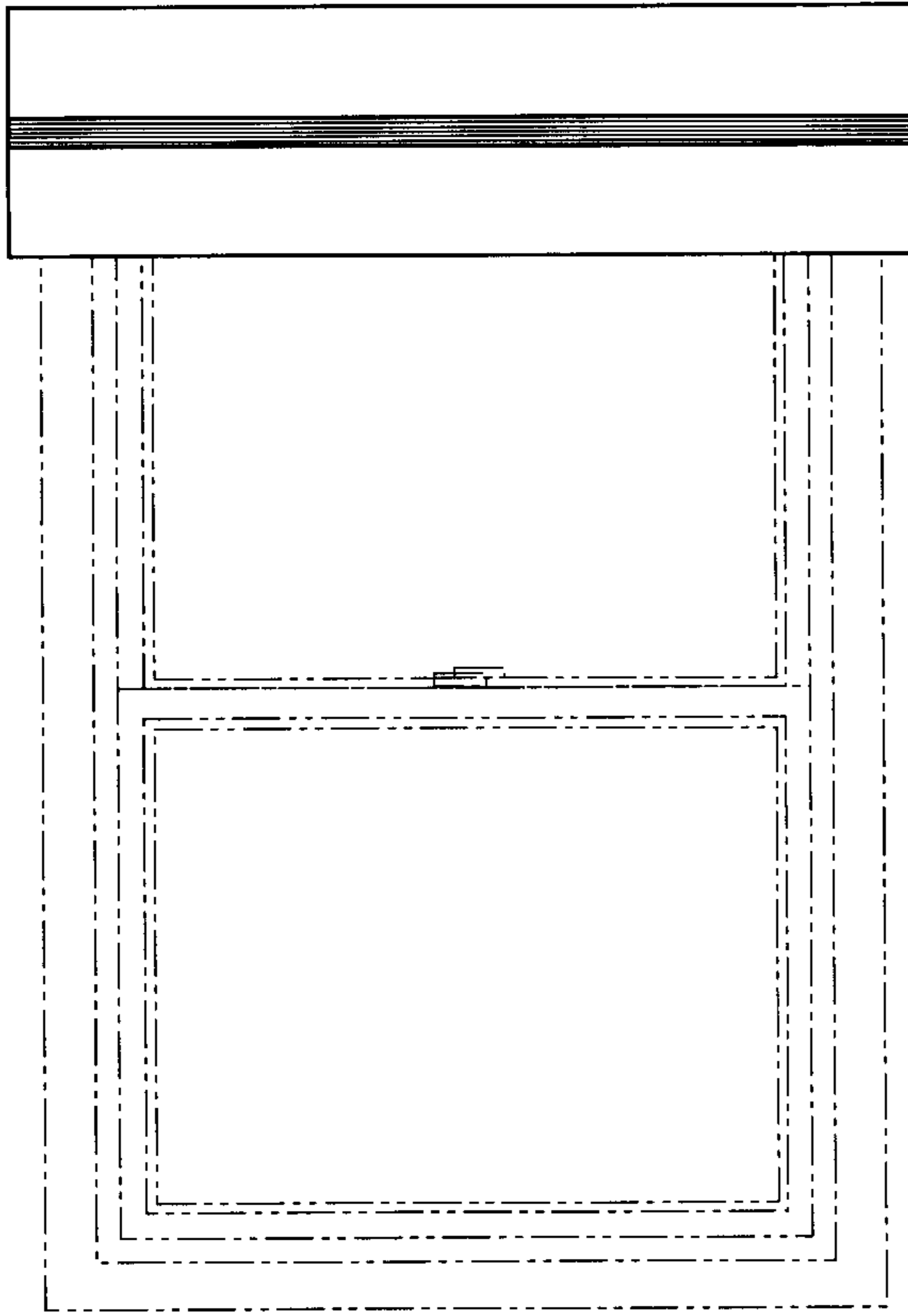

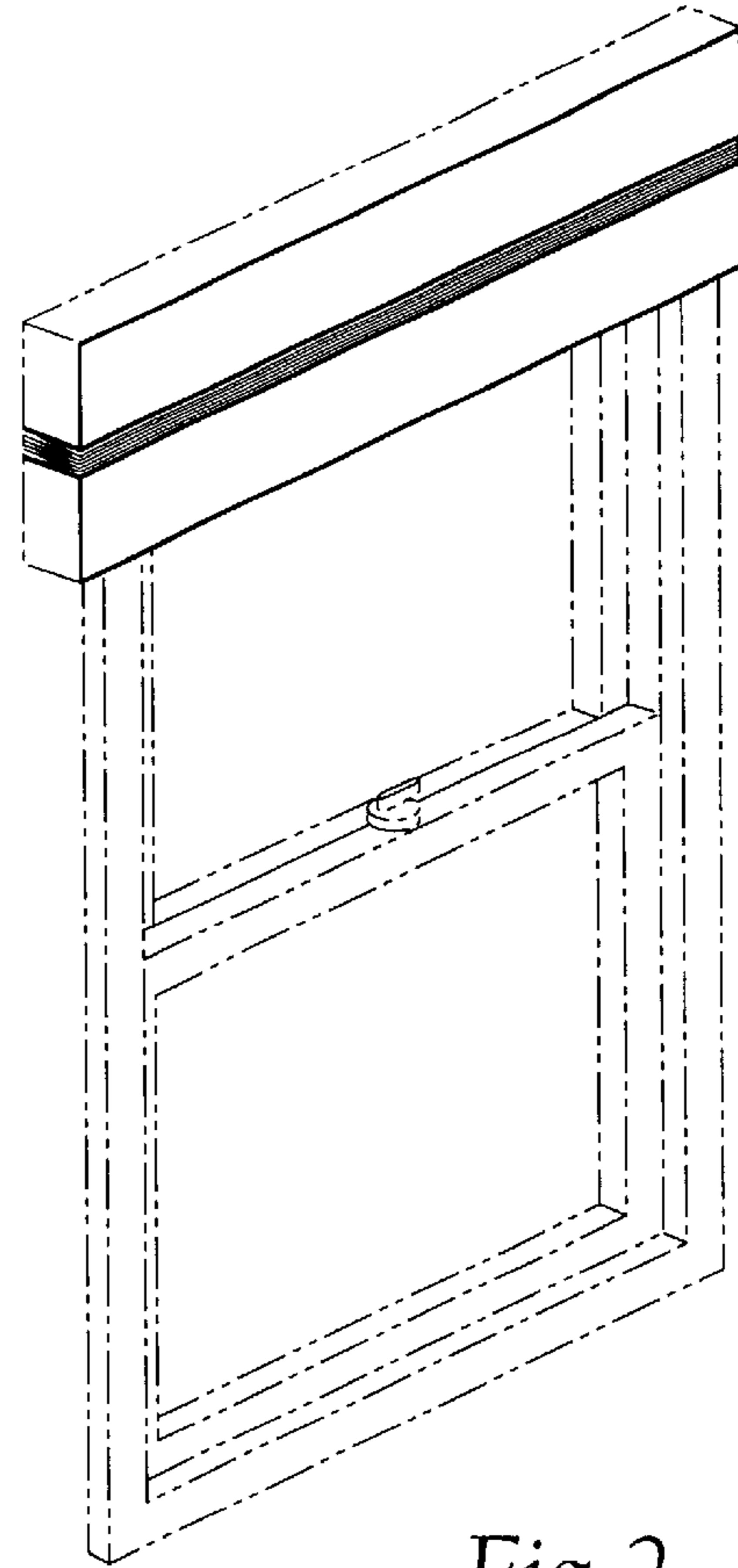

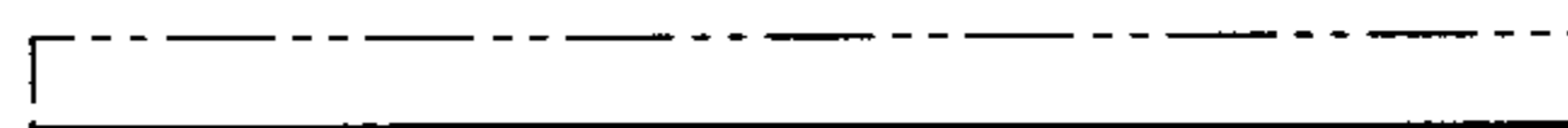

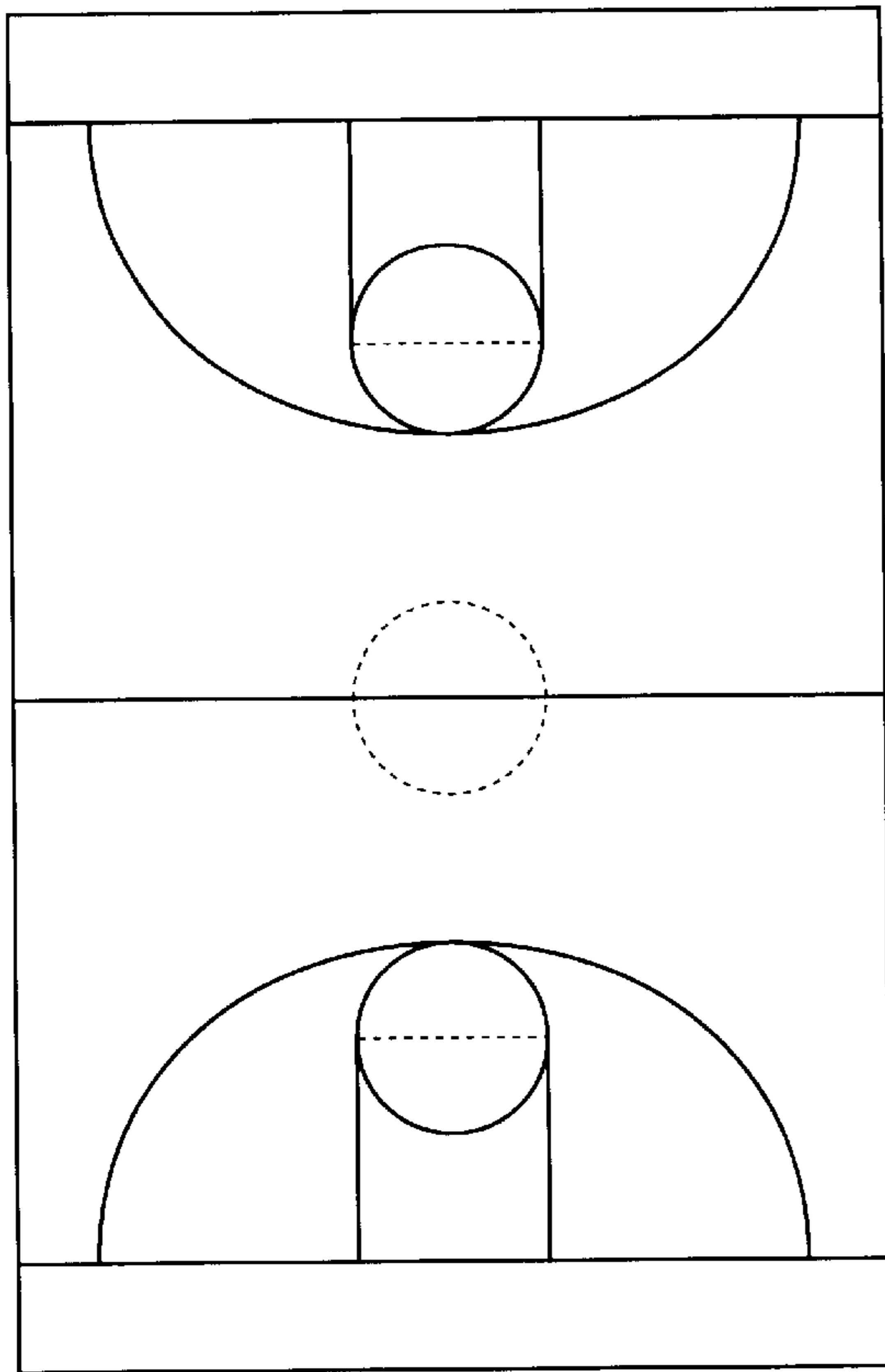
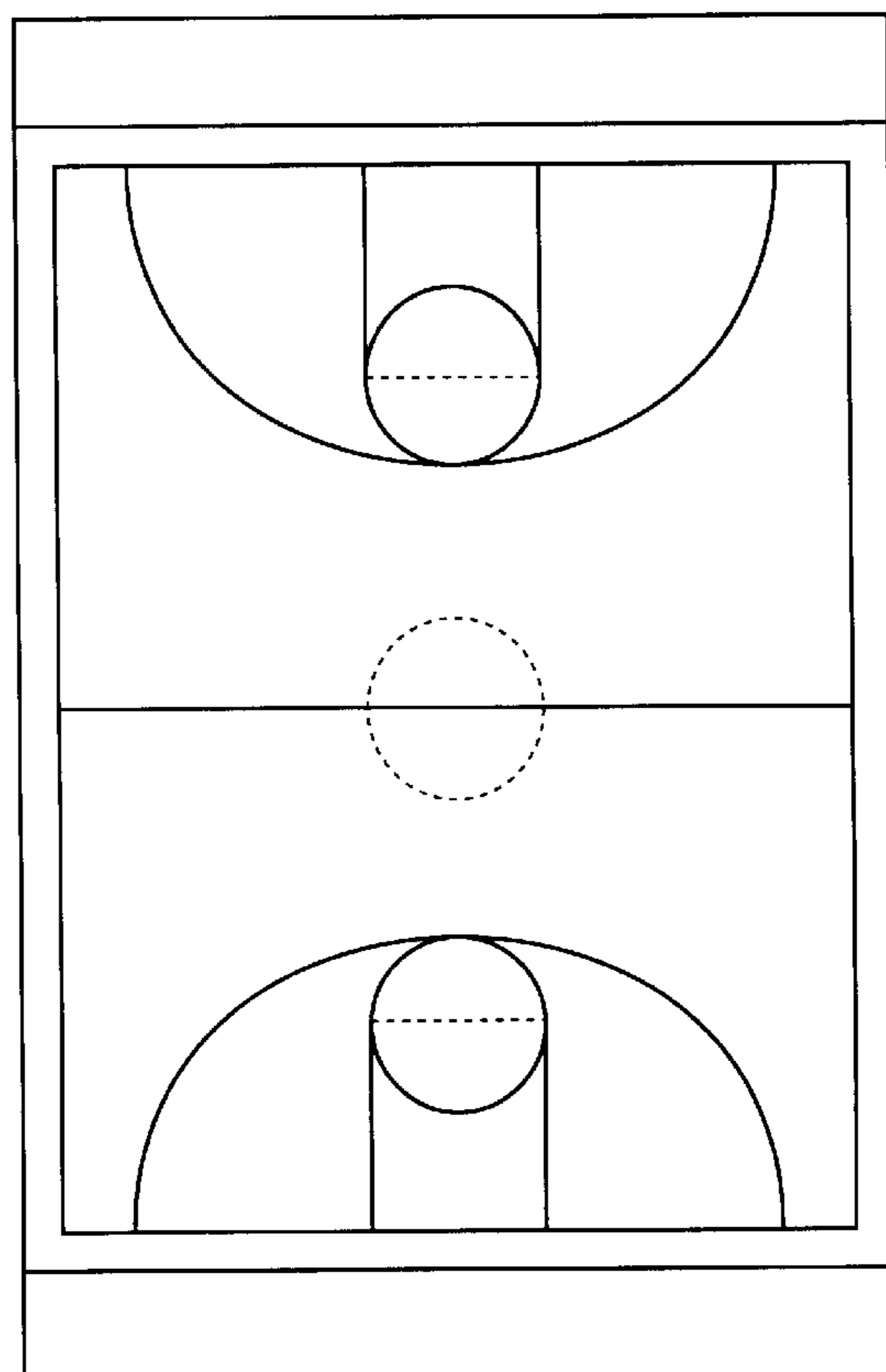

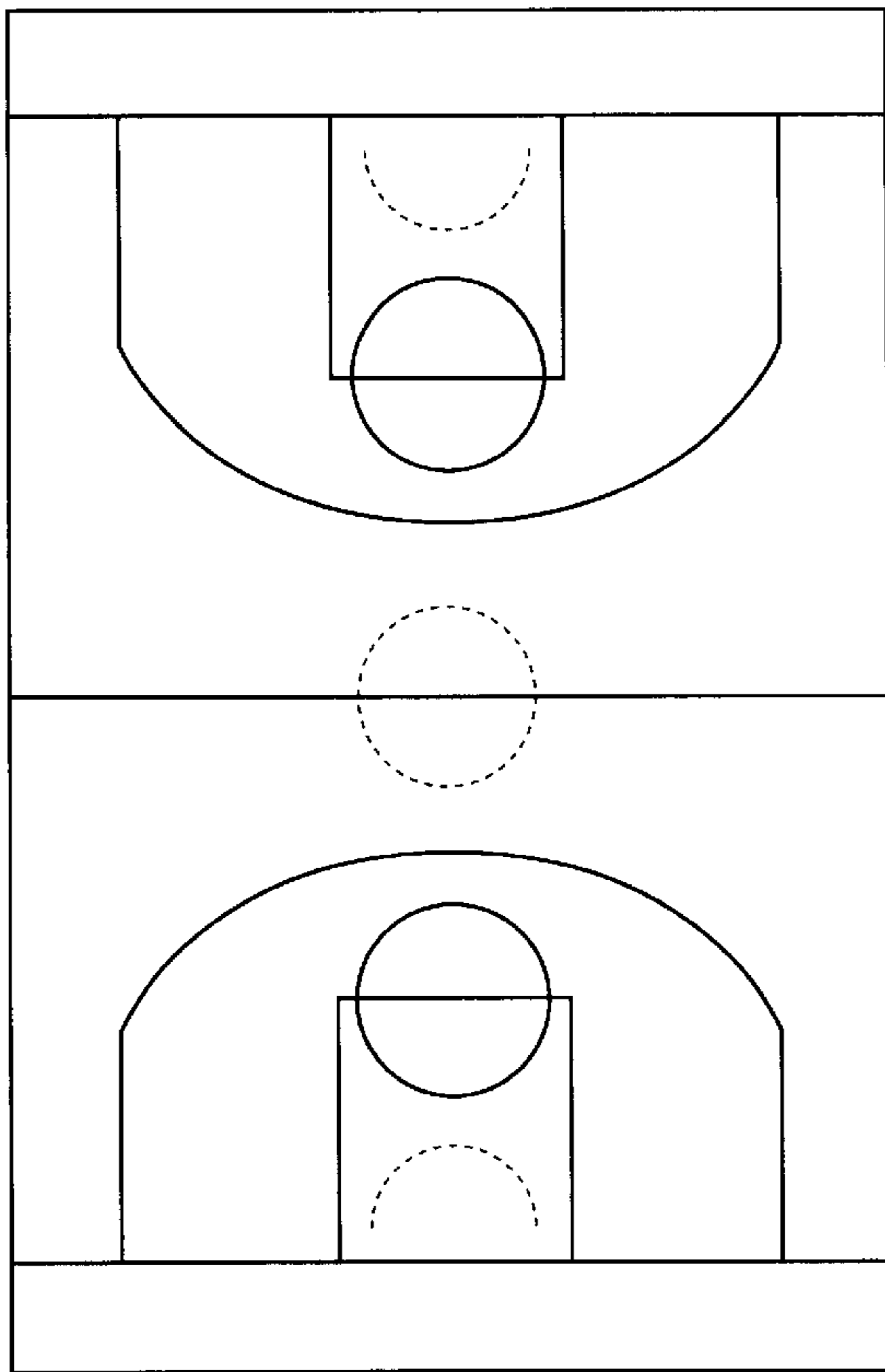
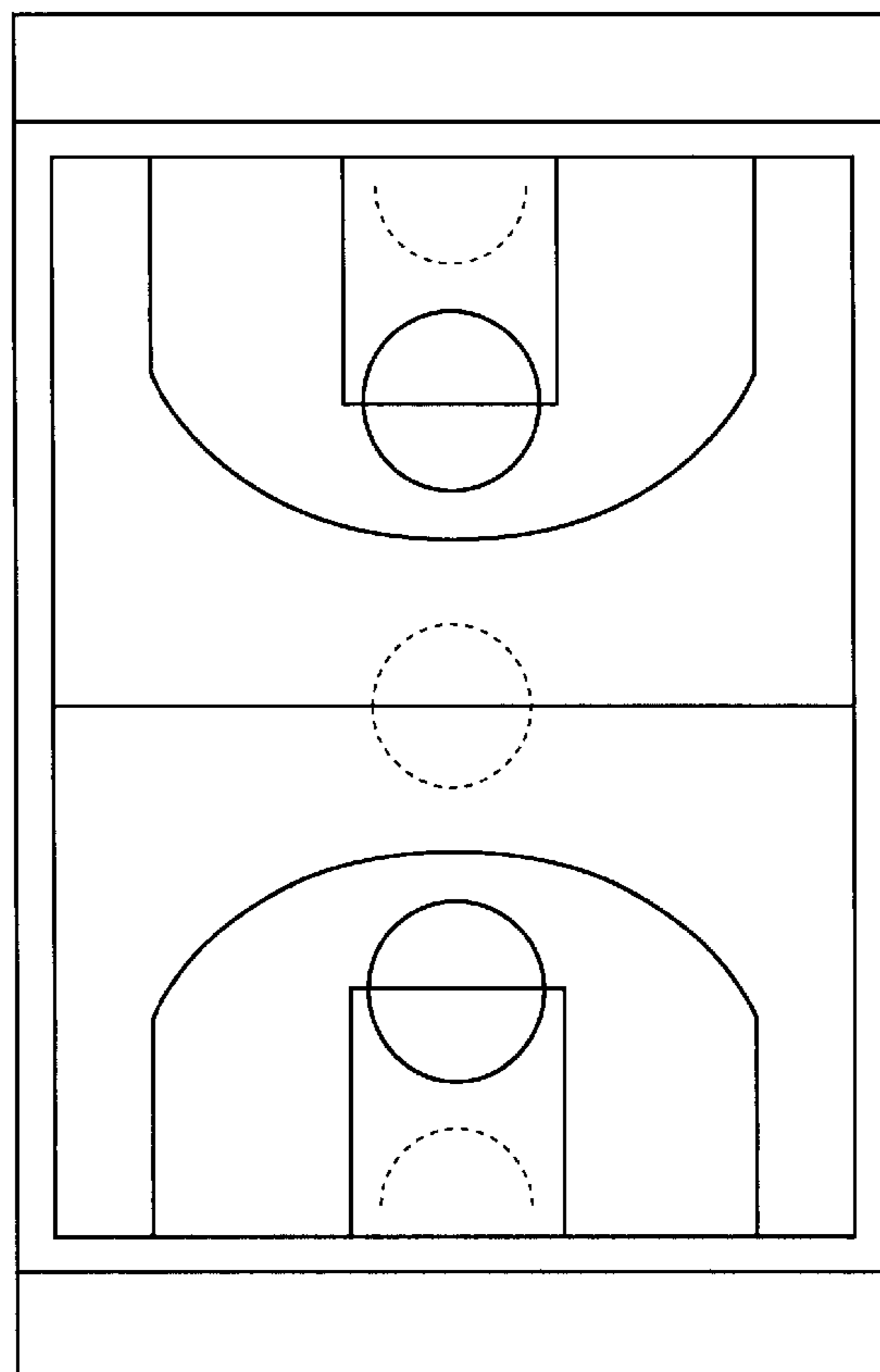

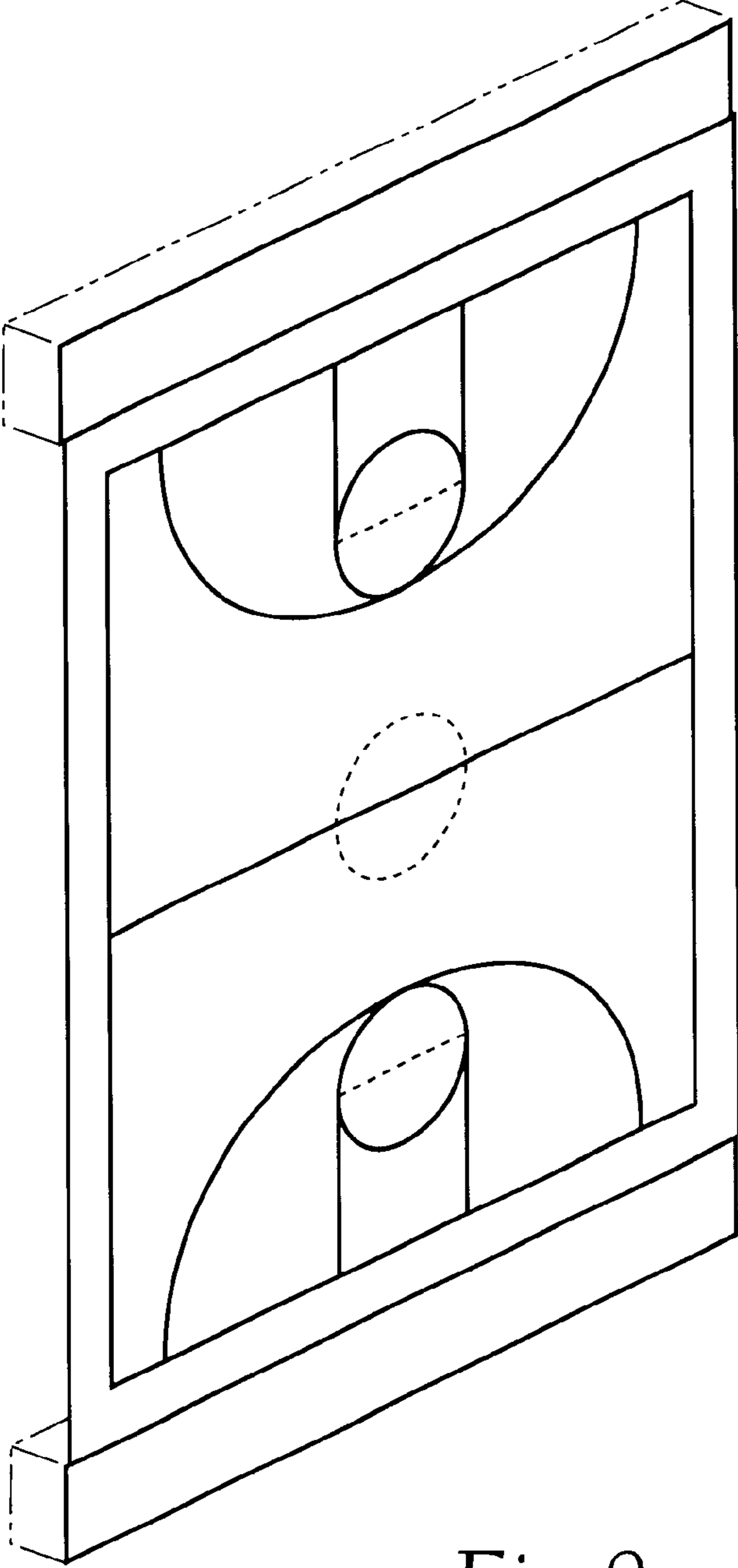
