FIG. 7 is a bottom view of our food jar design.

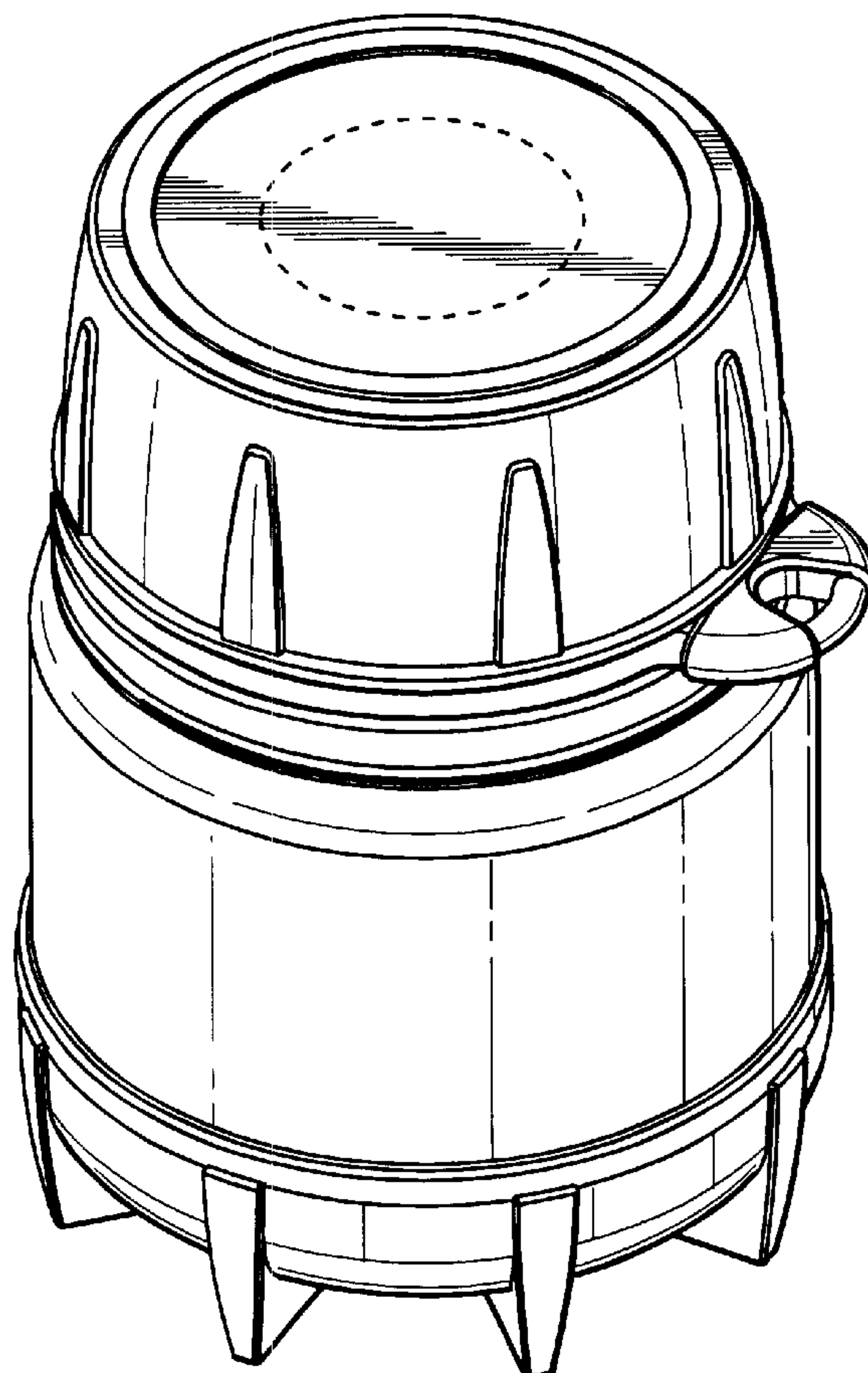

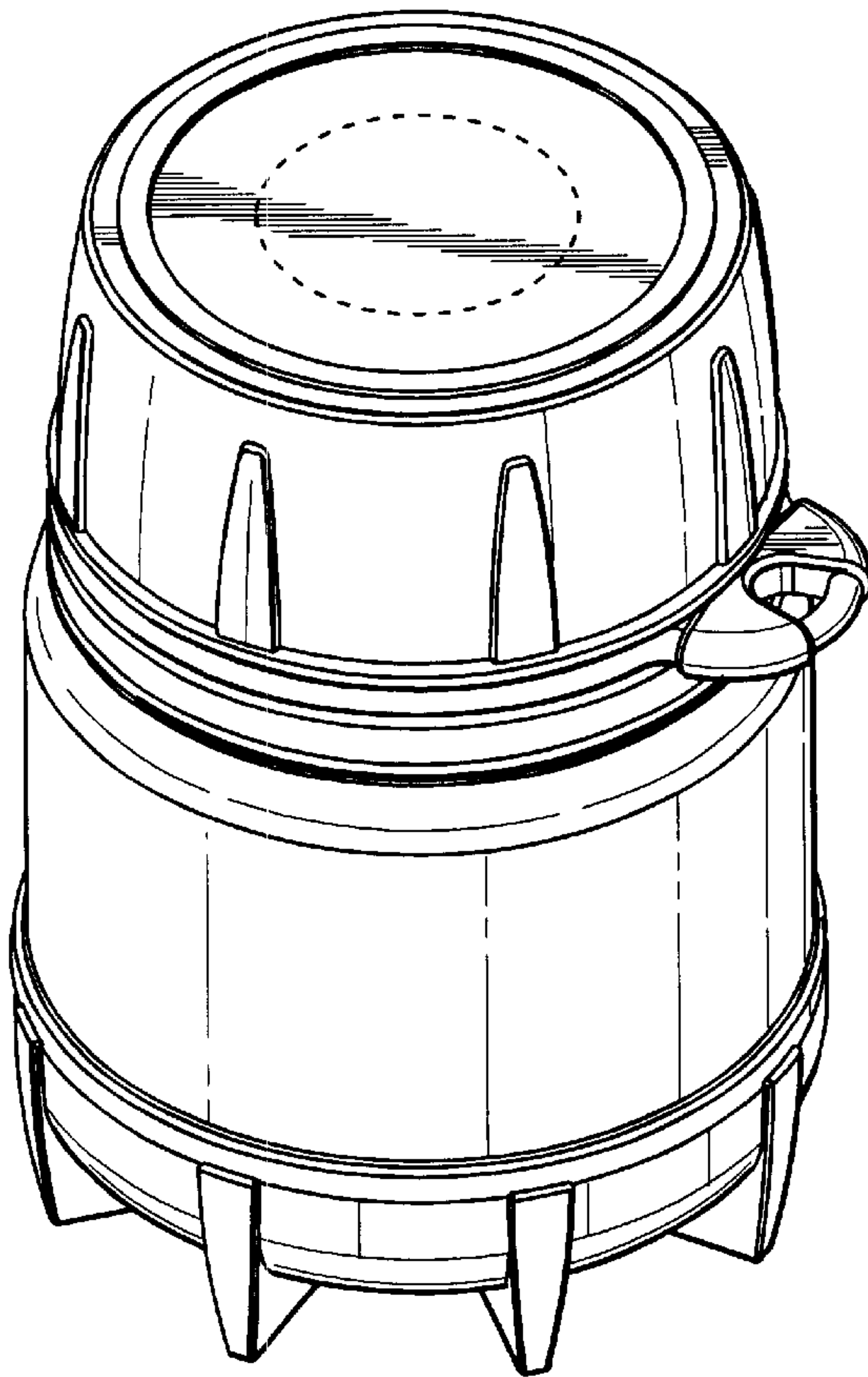

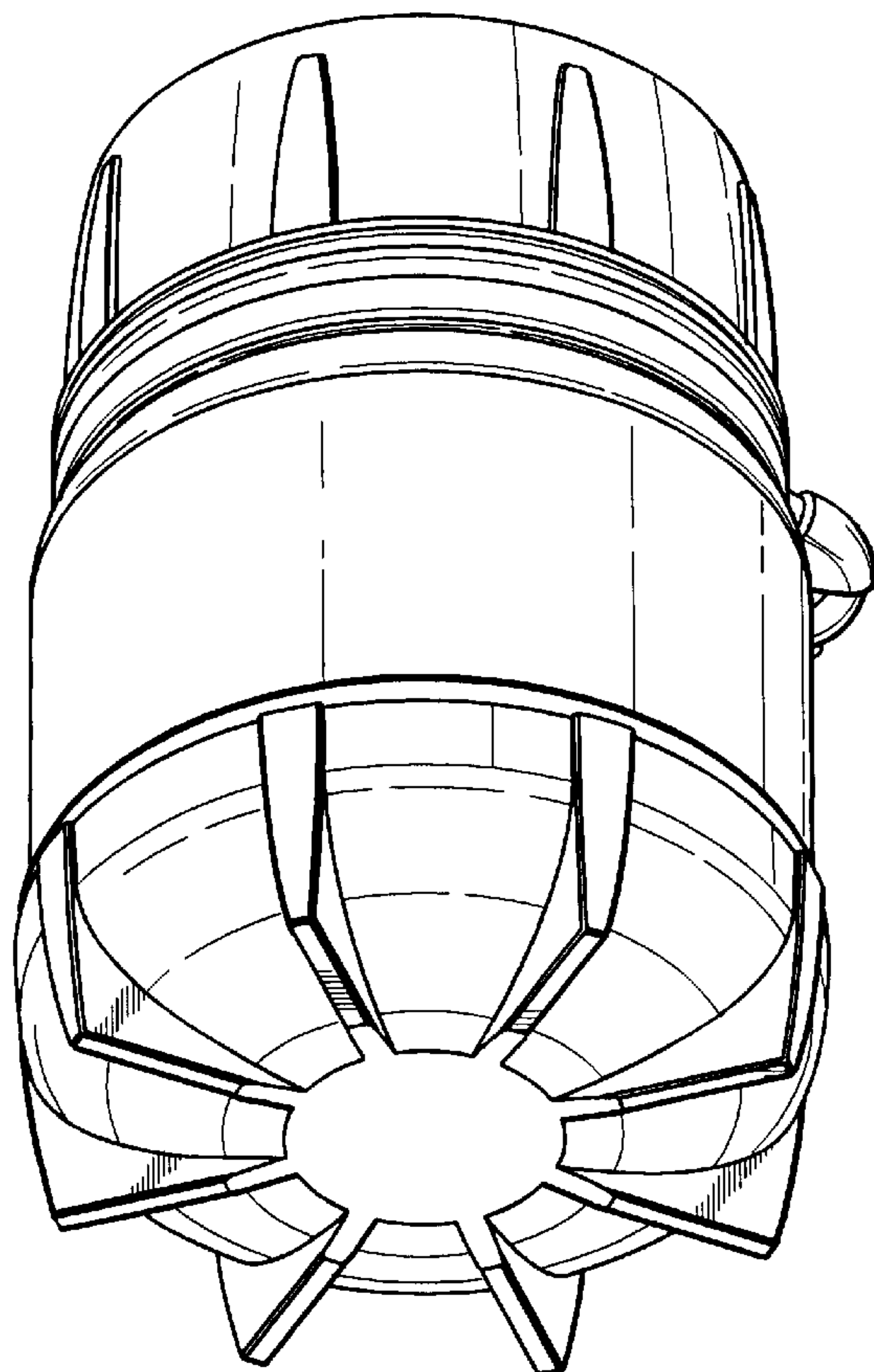

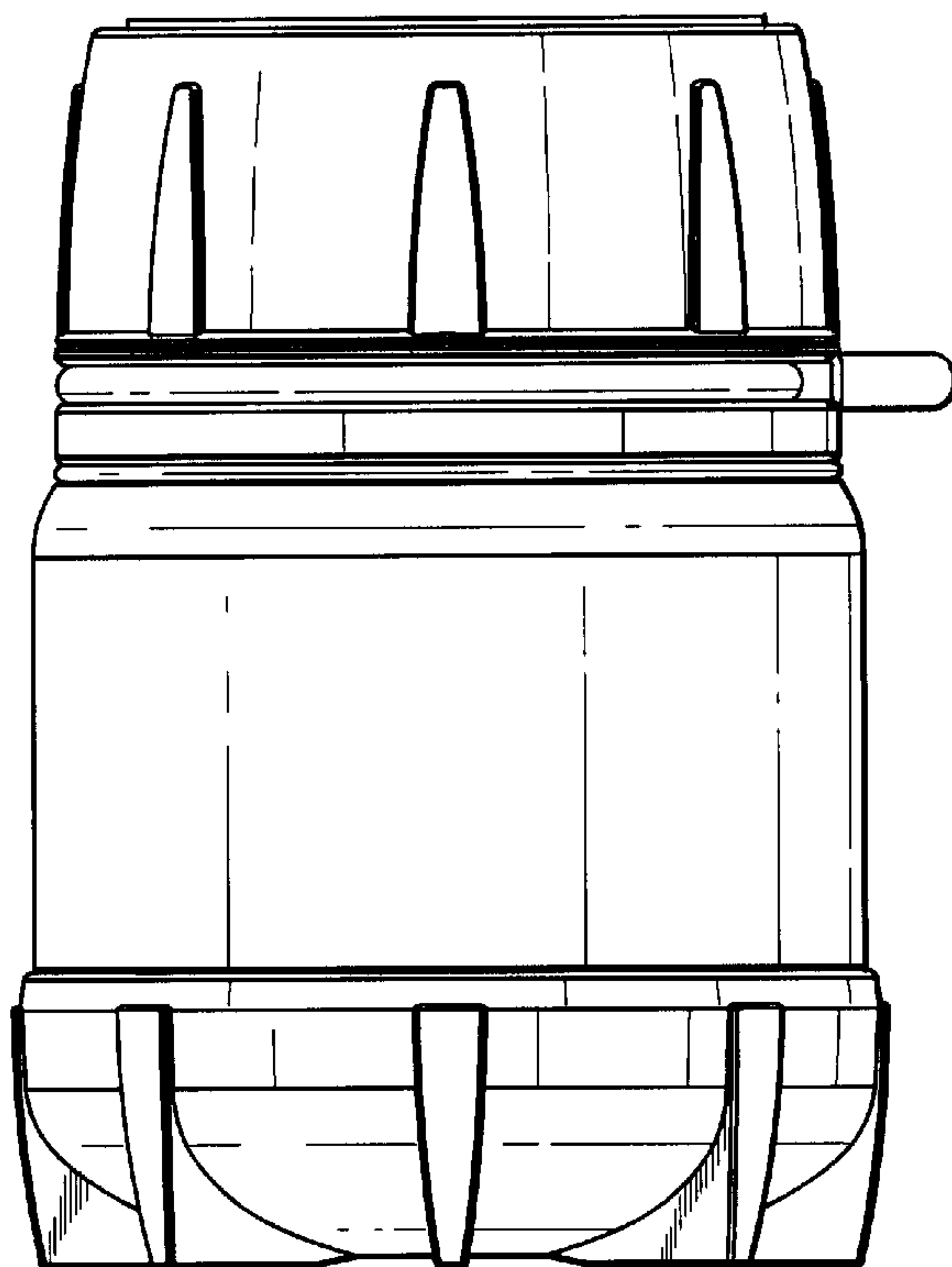

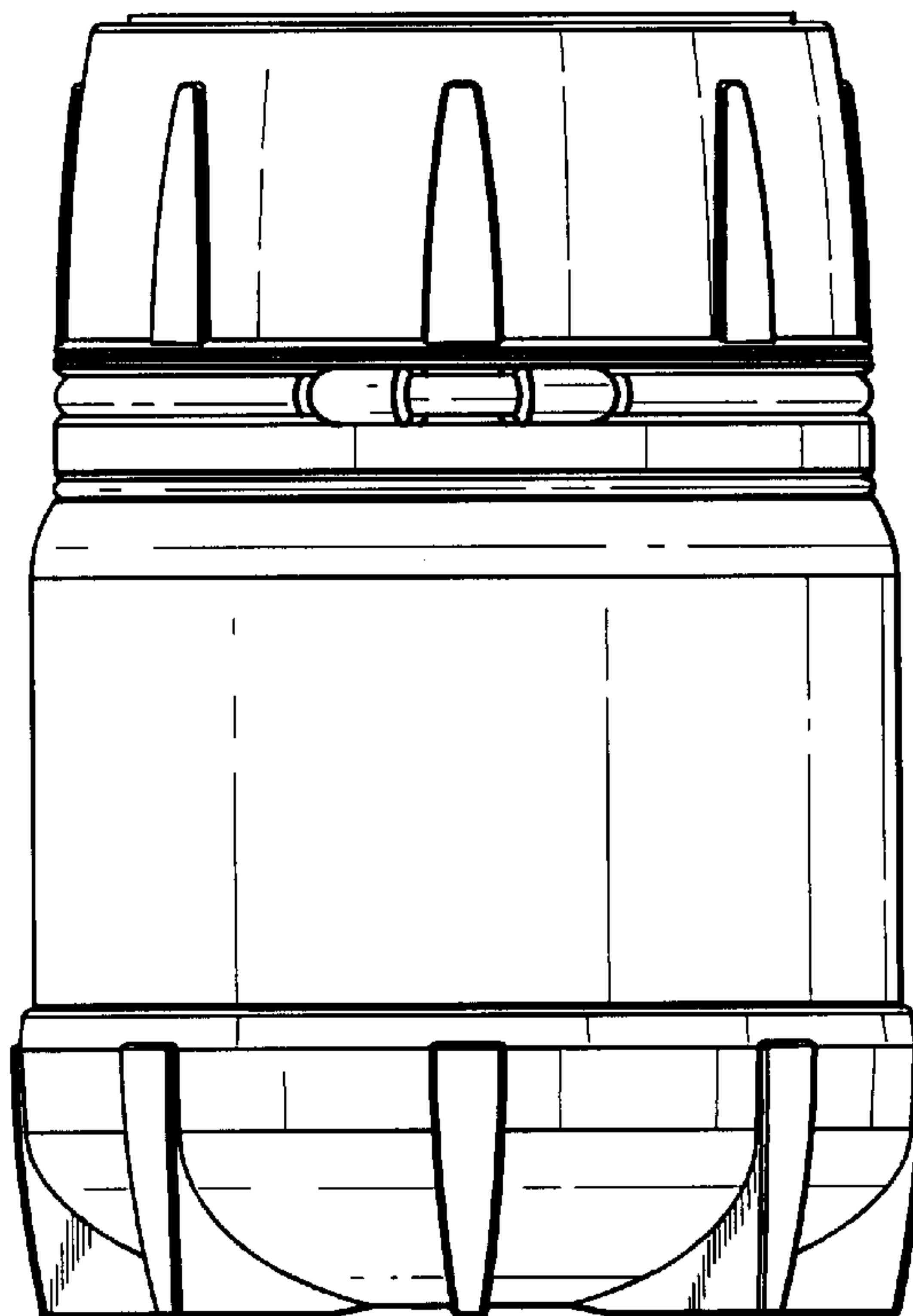

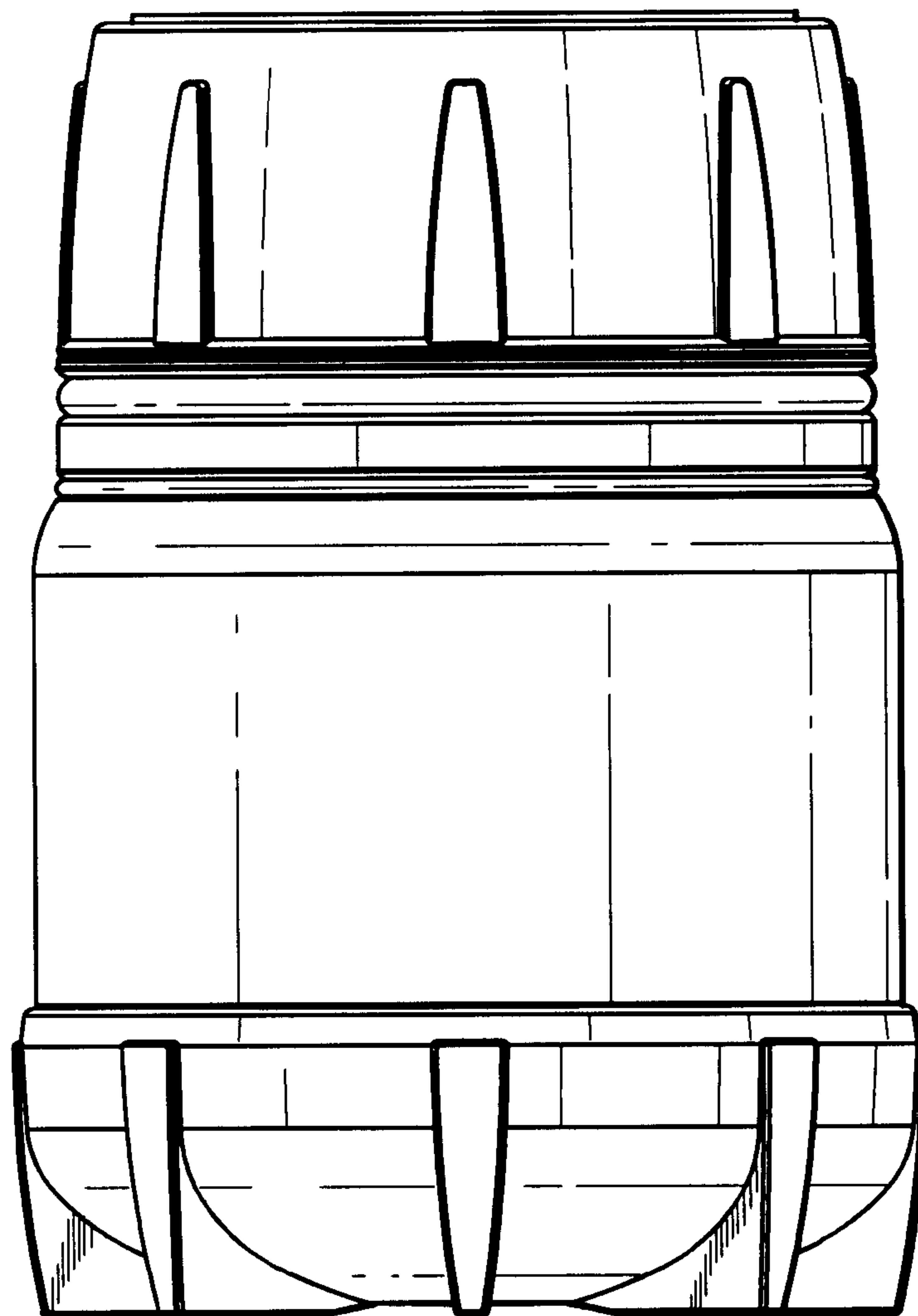

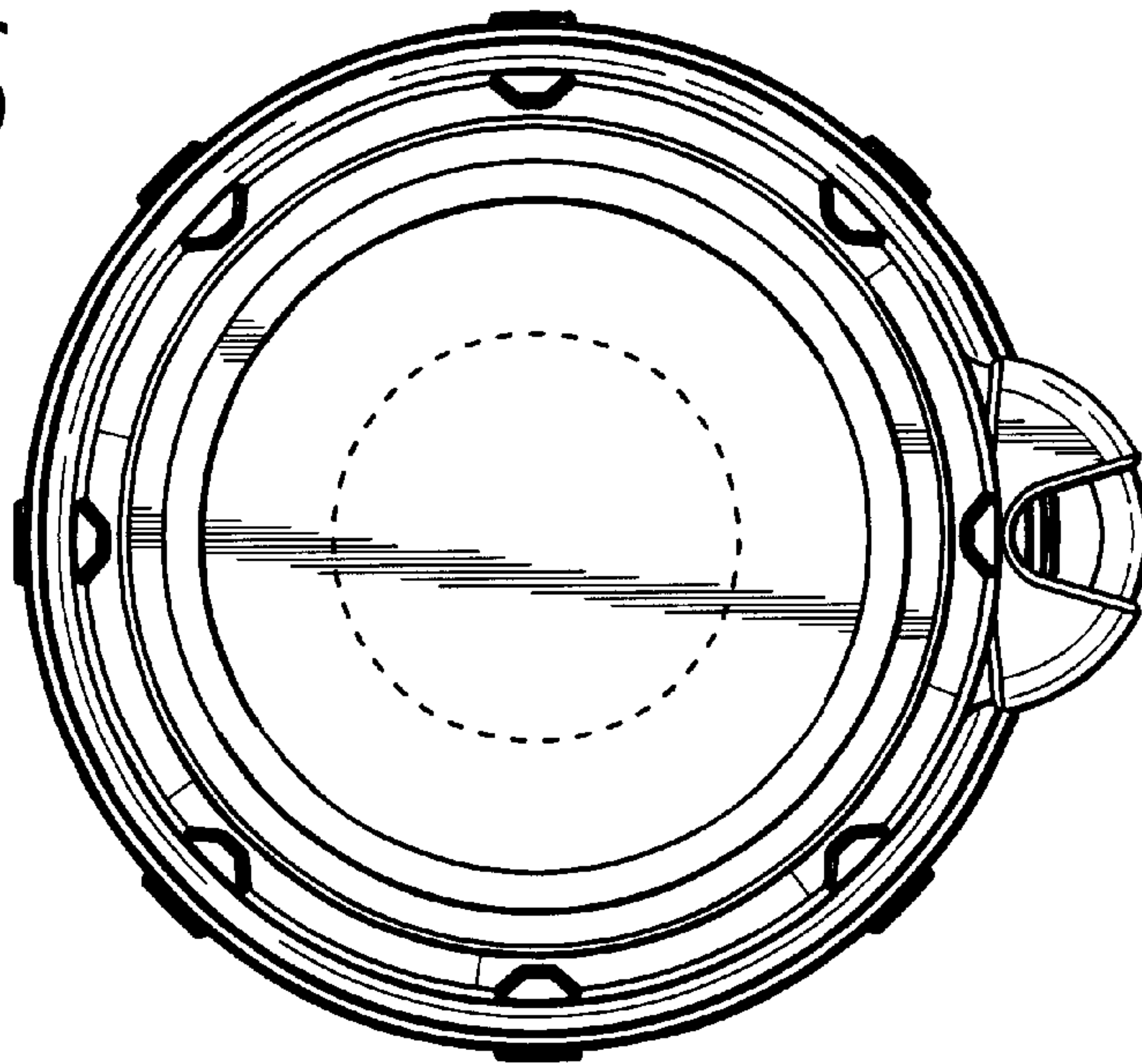
