DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the water softener of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of the water softener of the present invention, the portions shown in broken lines forming no part of the design sought to be patented;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view of the water softener of the present invention the broken lines shown forming no part of the claimed design;

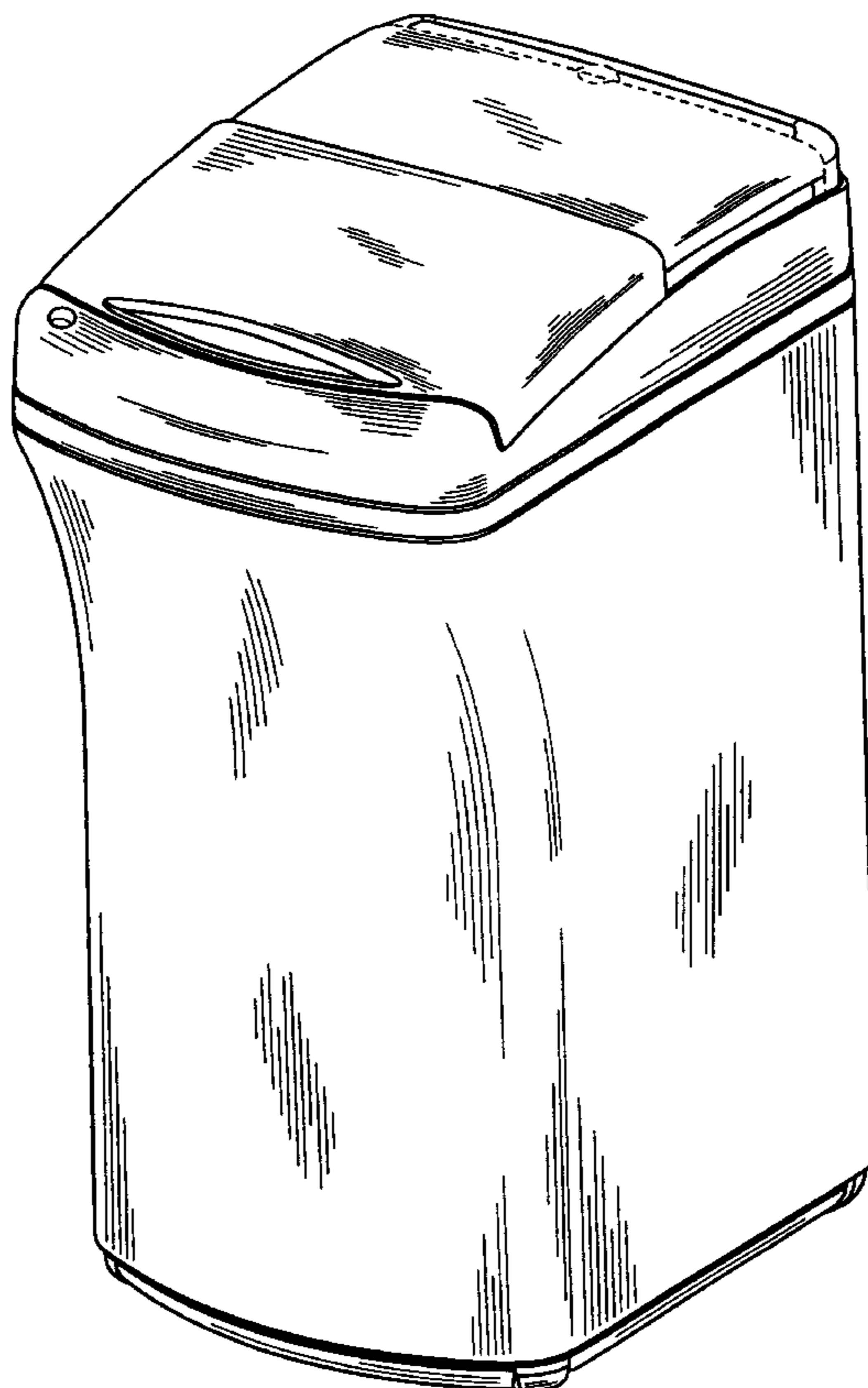
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the water softener of the present invention the broken lines shown forming no part of the claimed design;

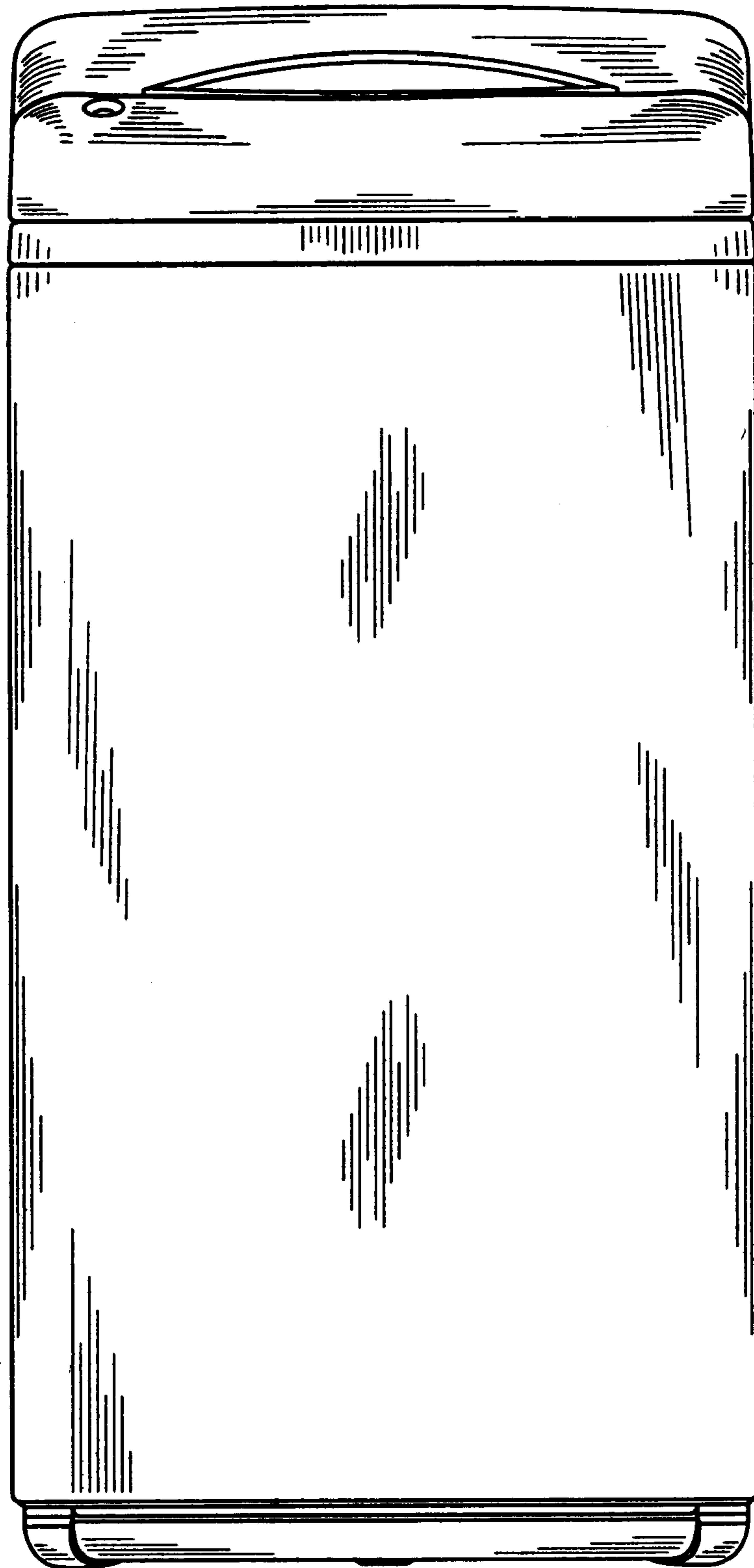

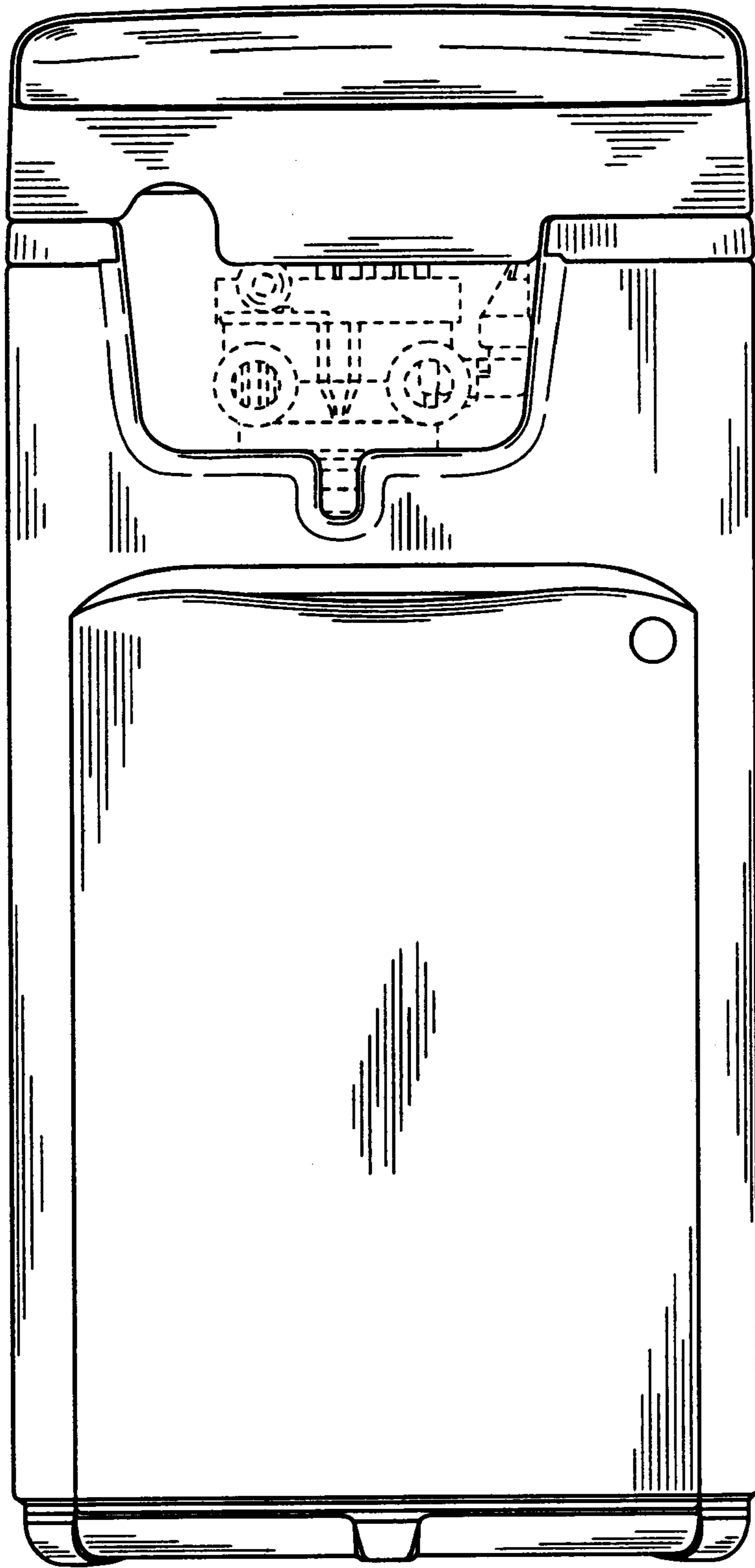

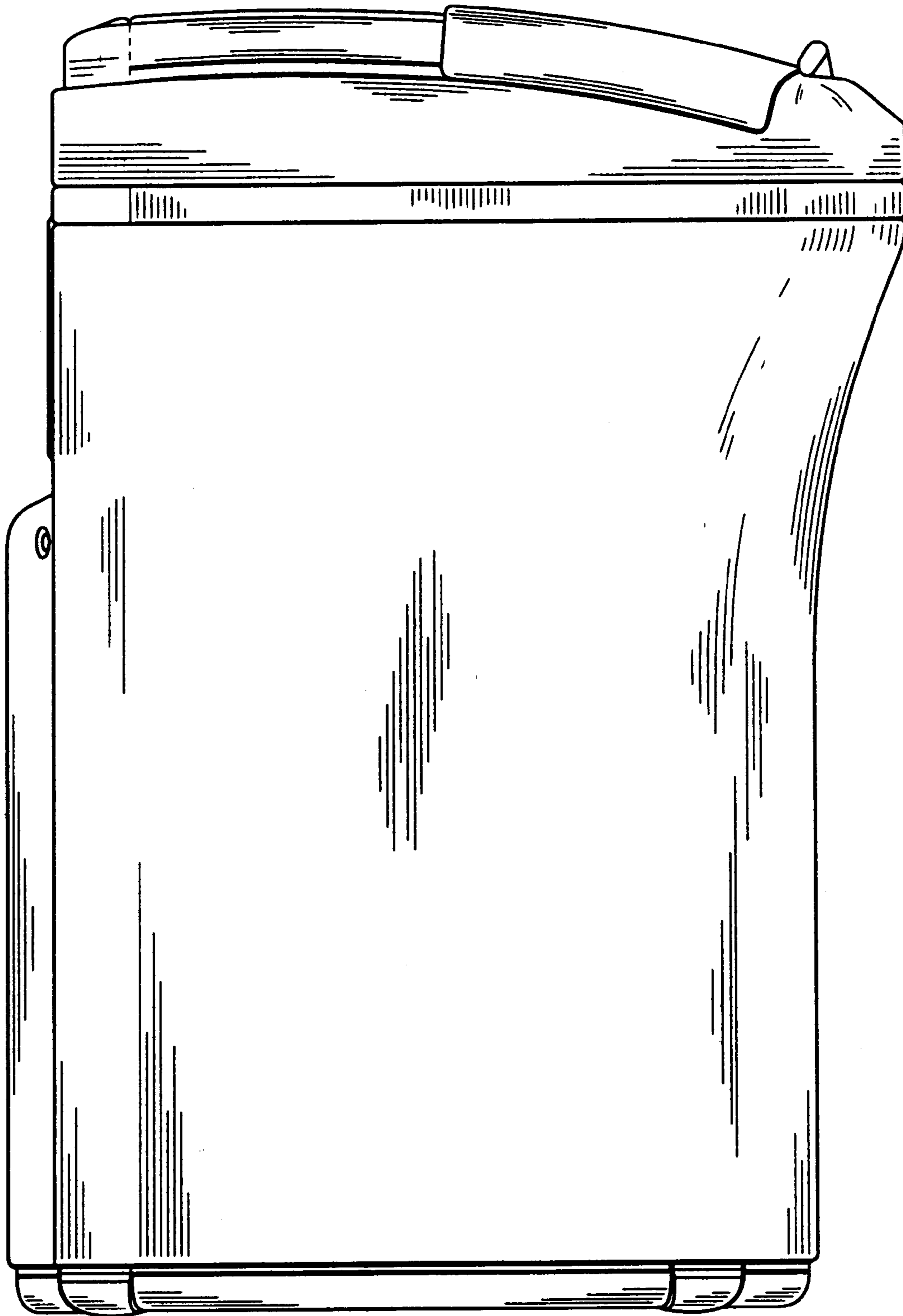

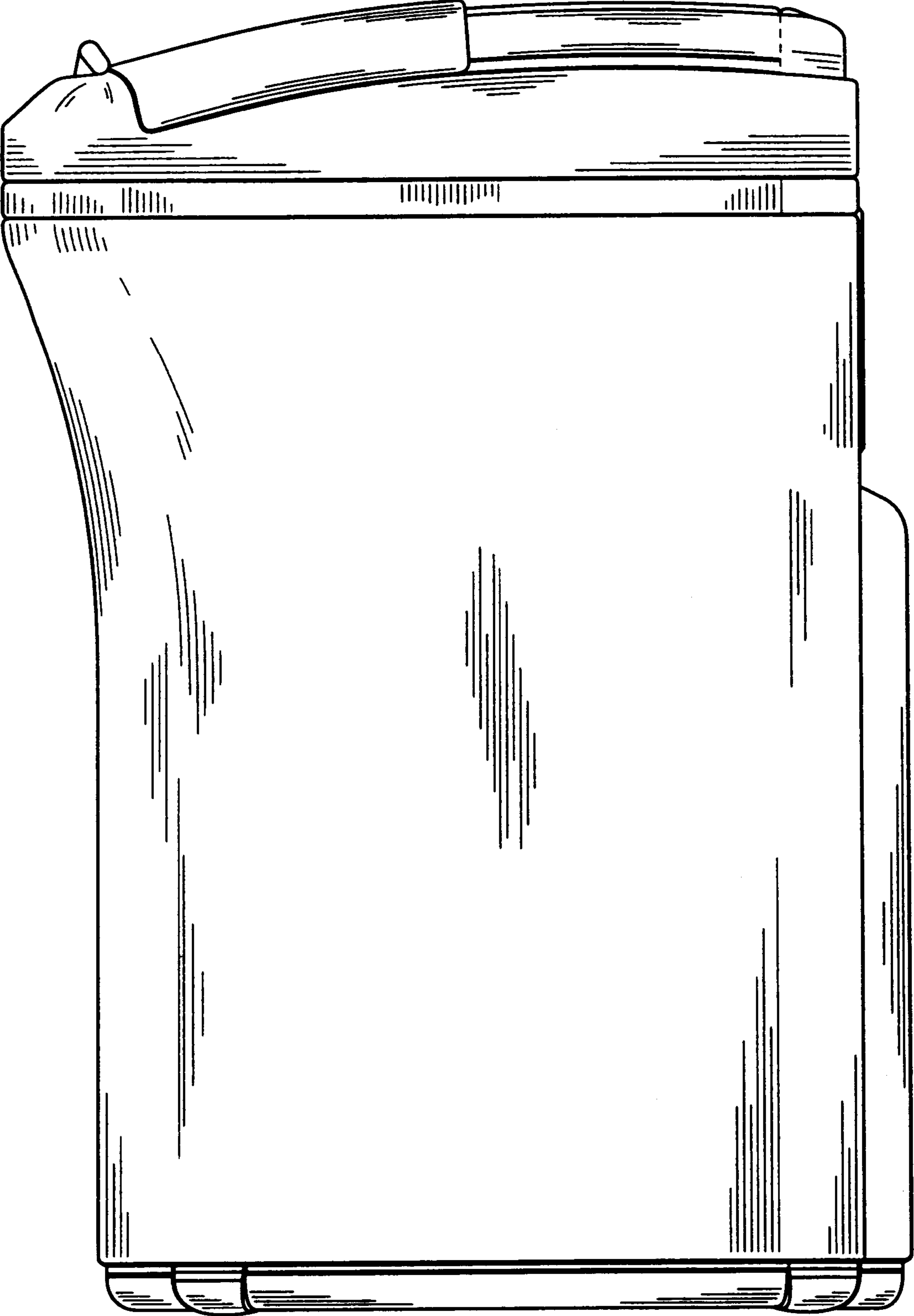

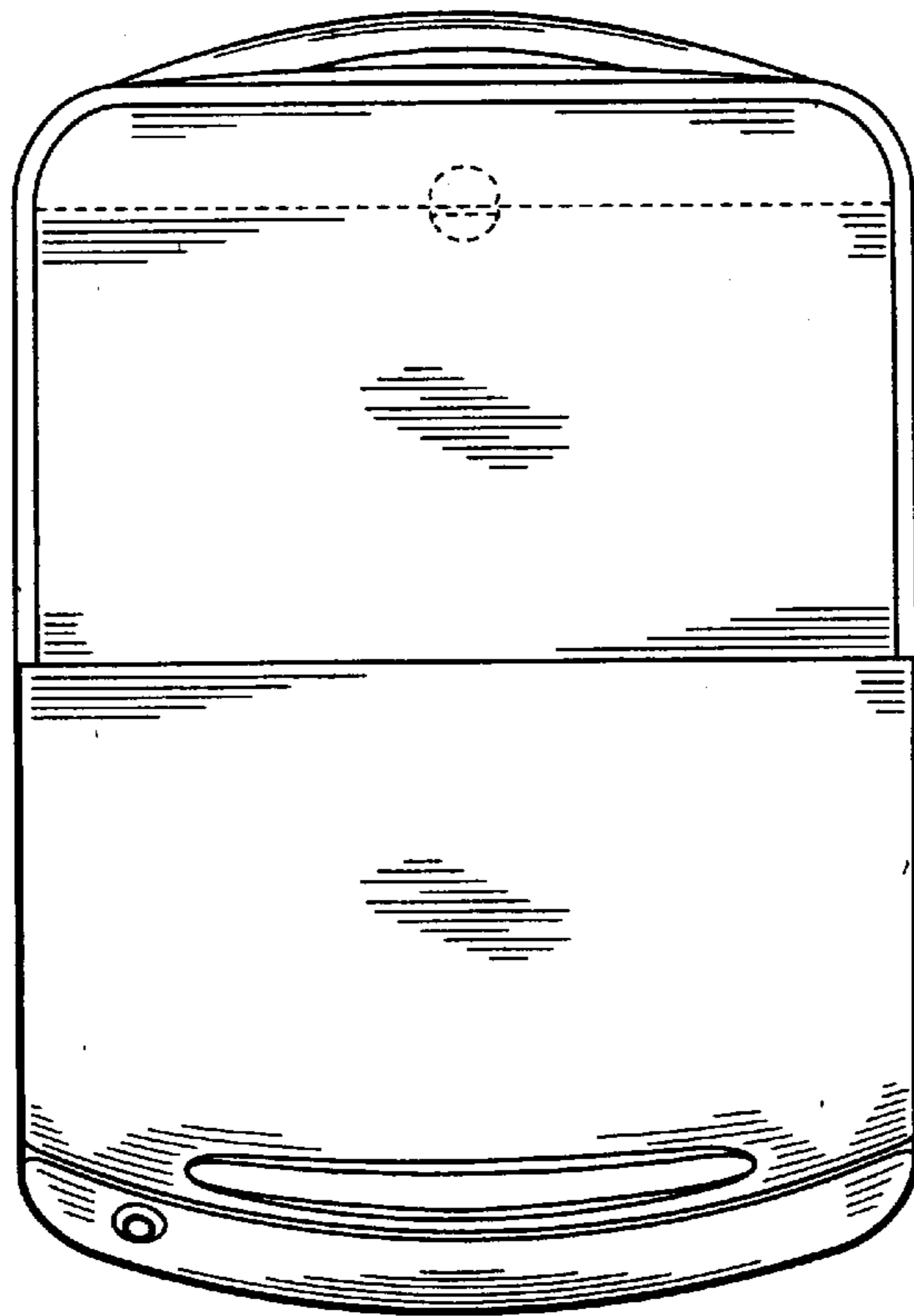

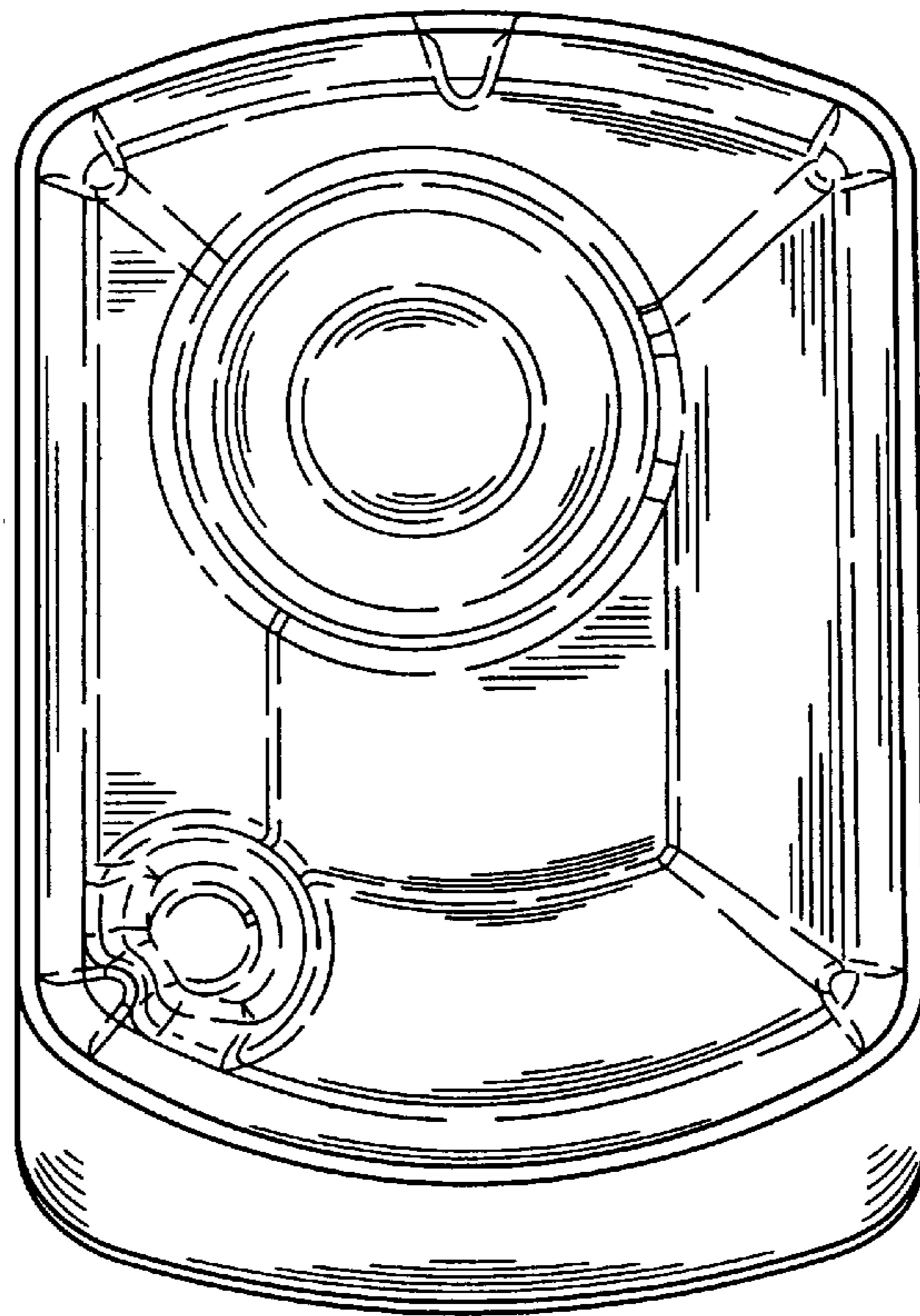

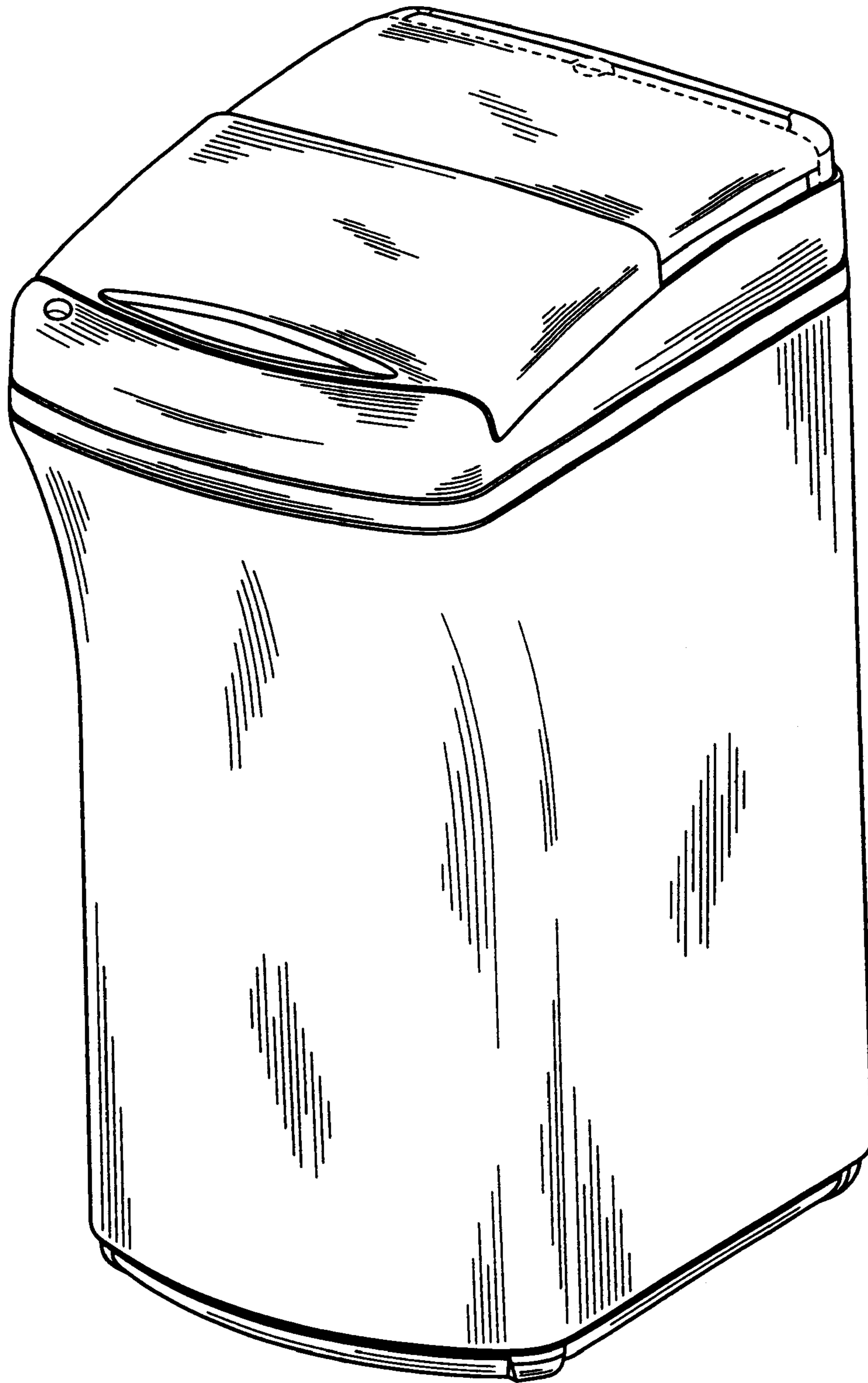
