(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the design in the colors red and black, the broken lines forming no part of the design;

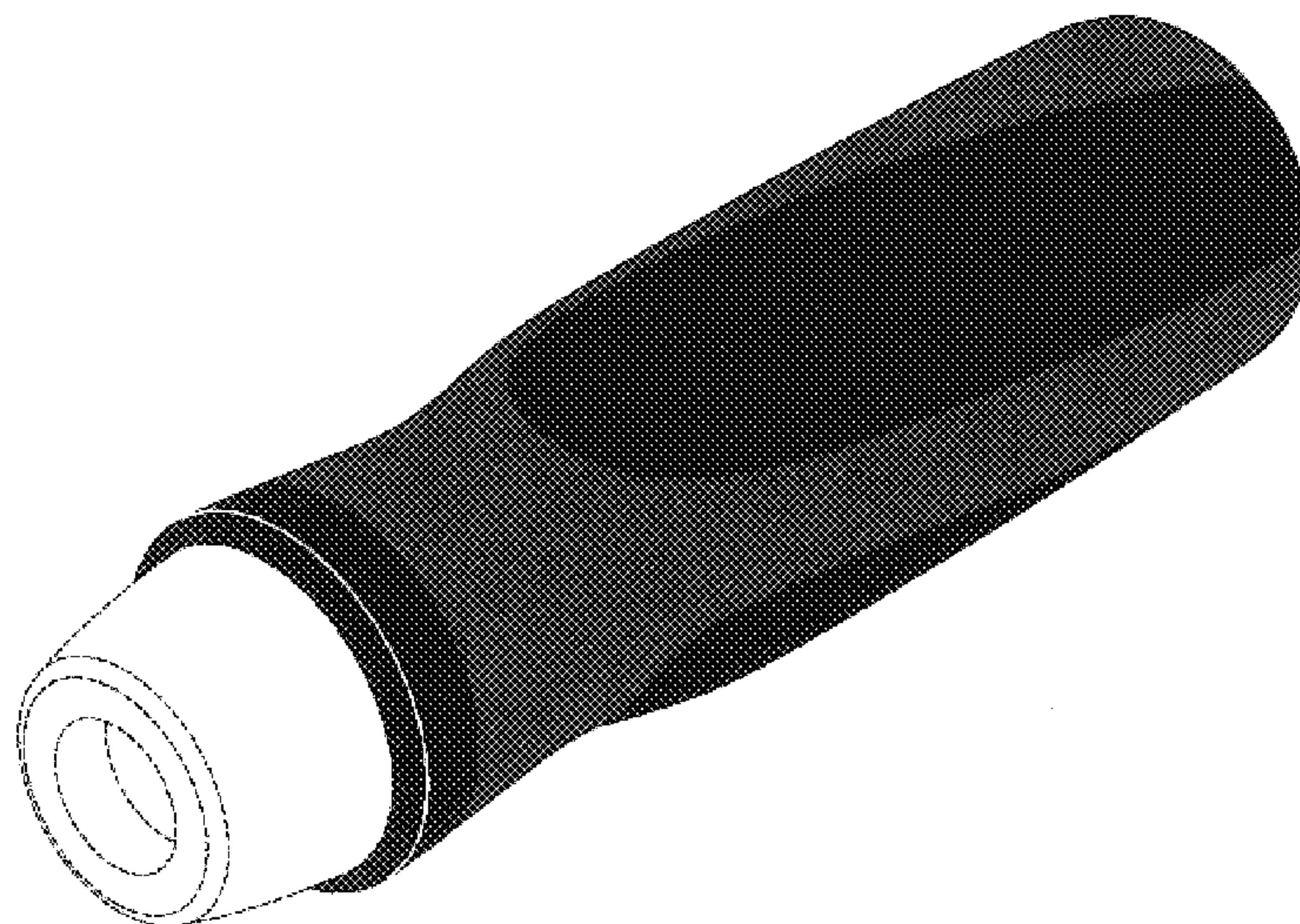
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of the design in the colors red and black, the broken lines forming no part of the design;

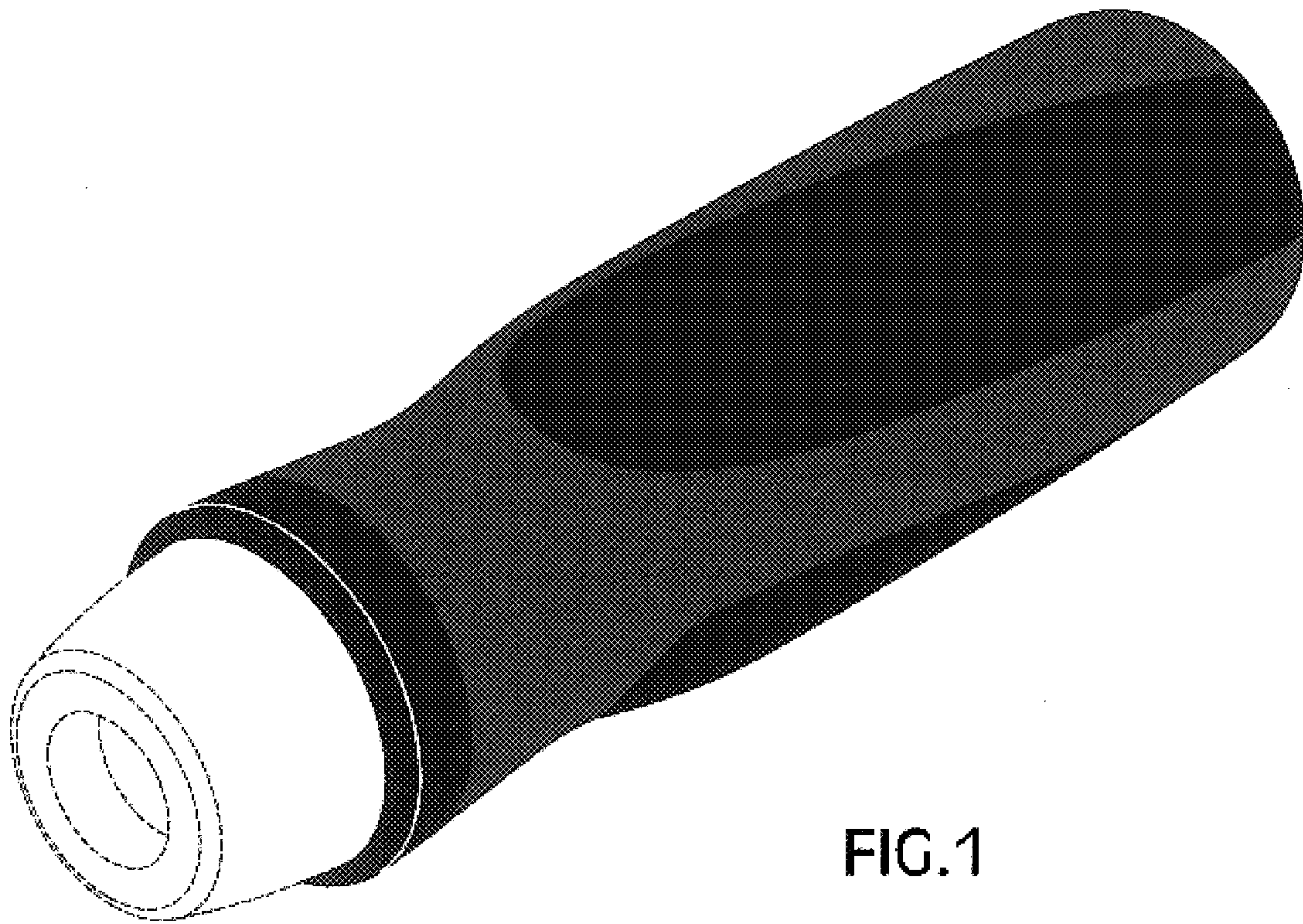

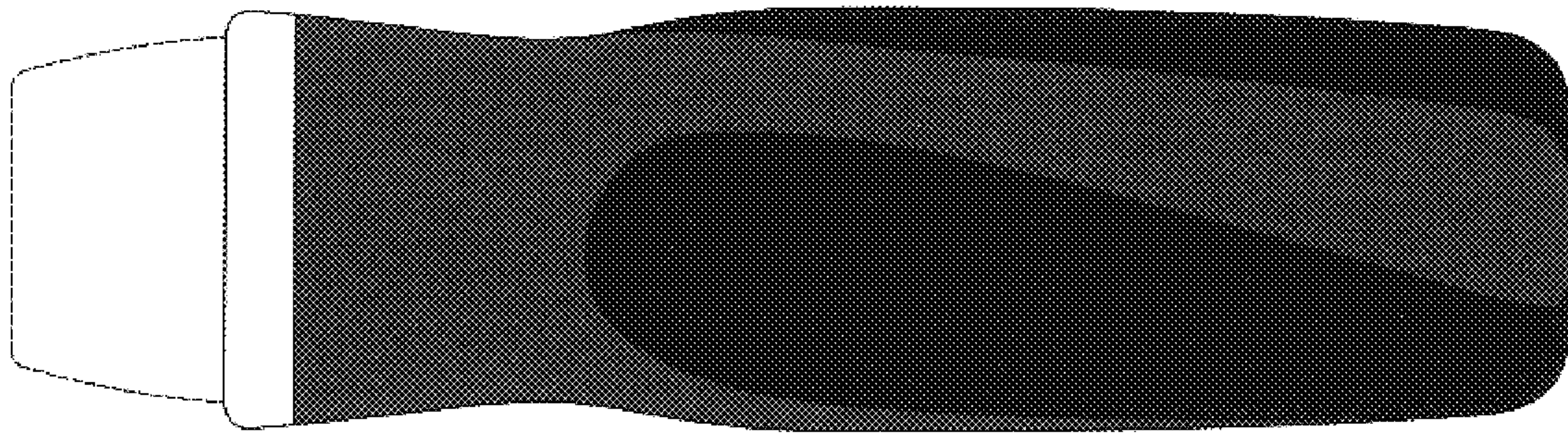

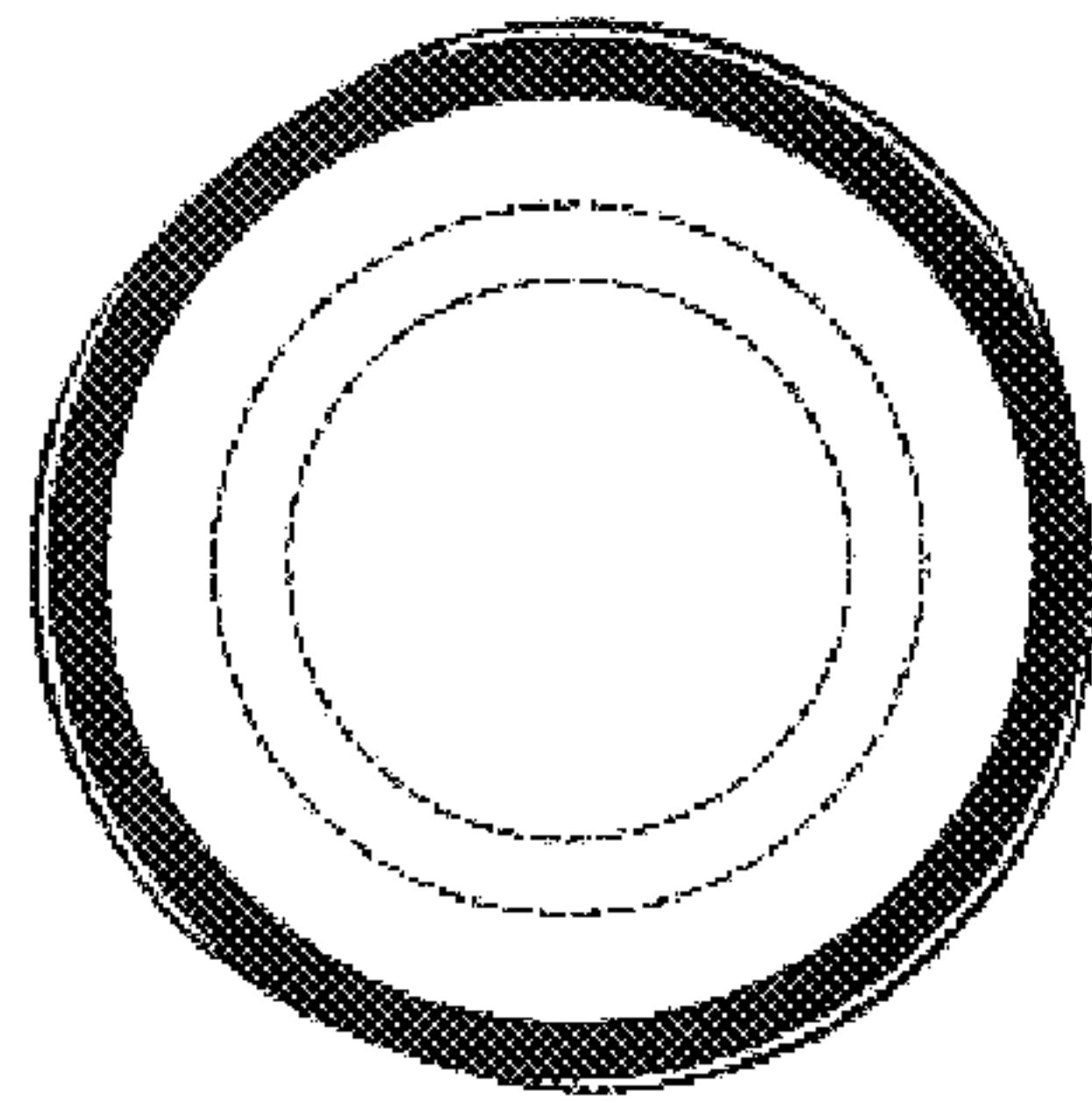

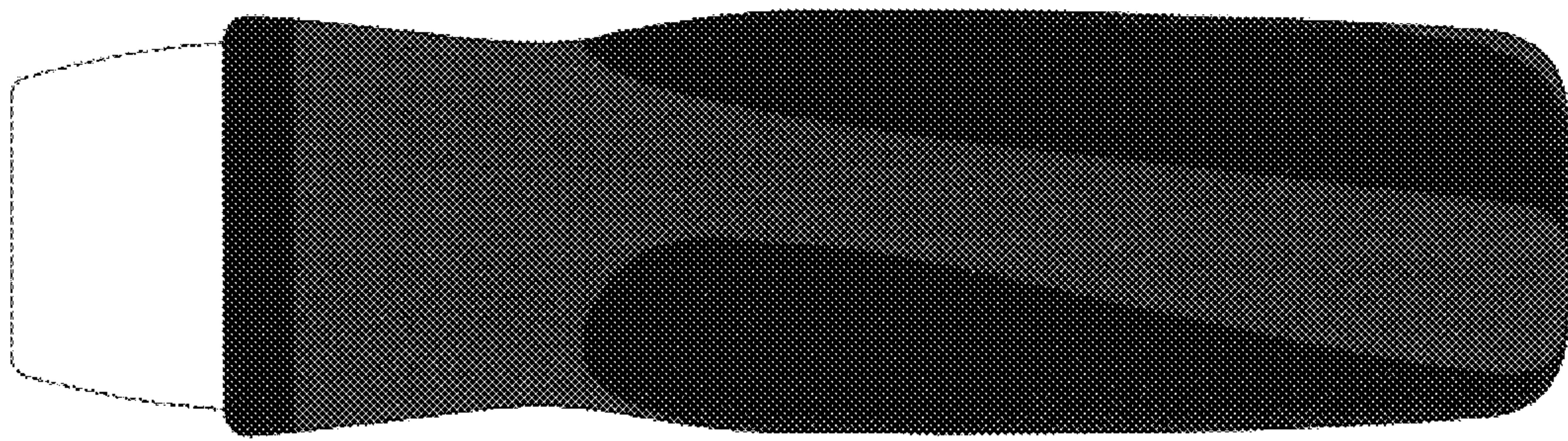

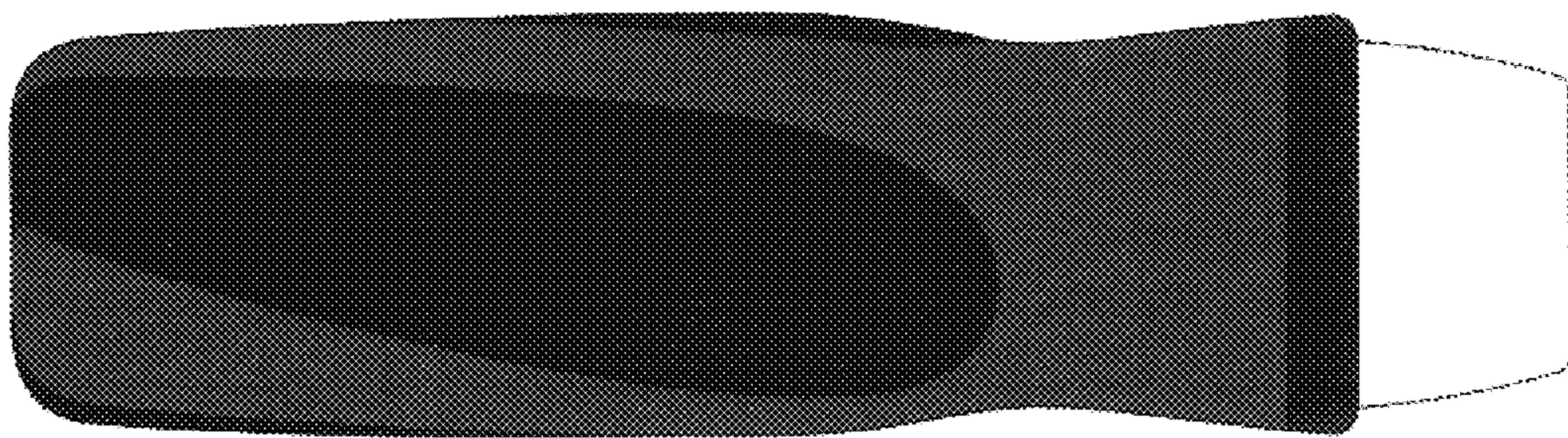

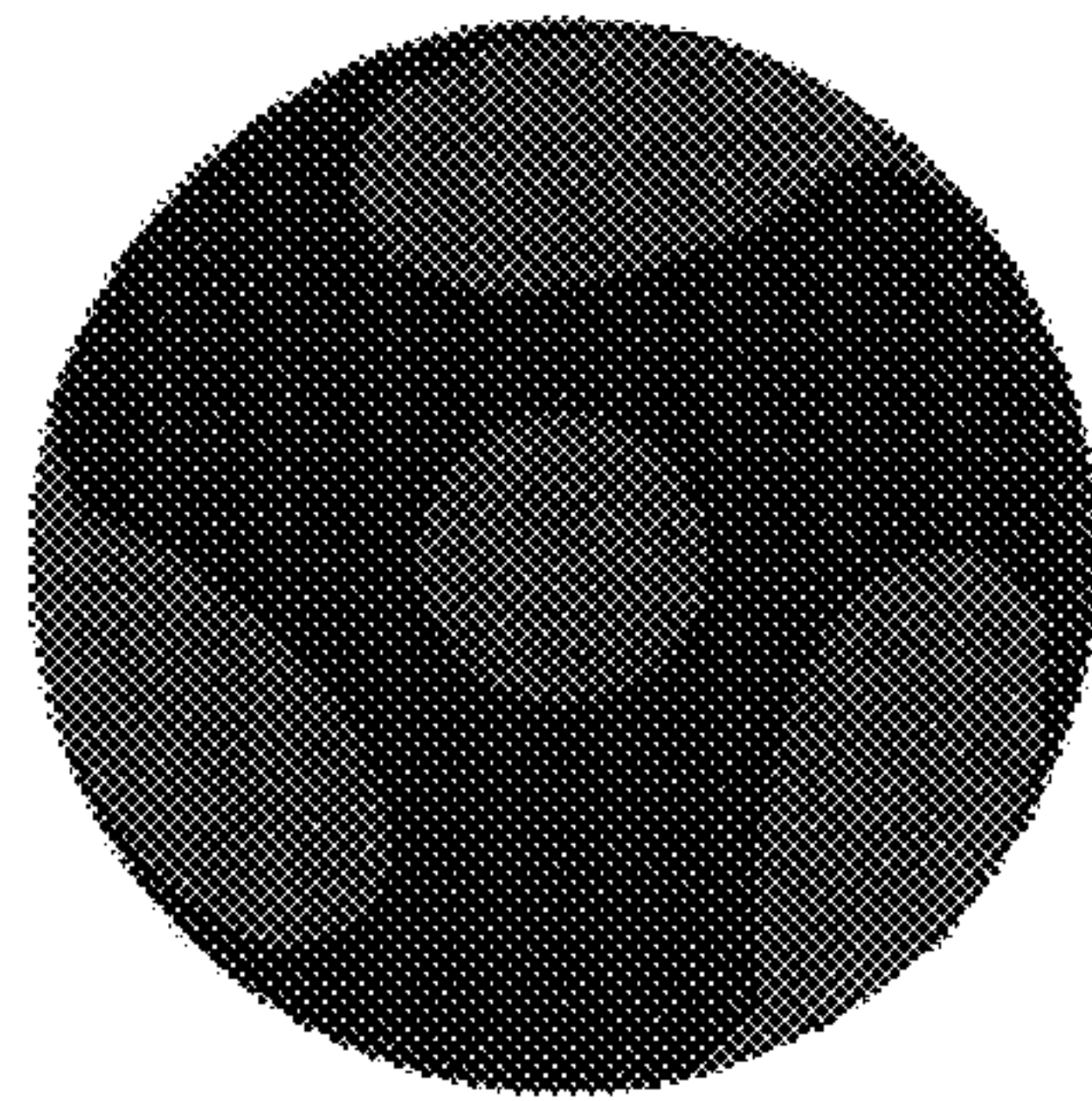

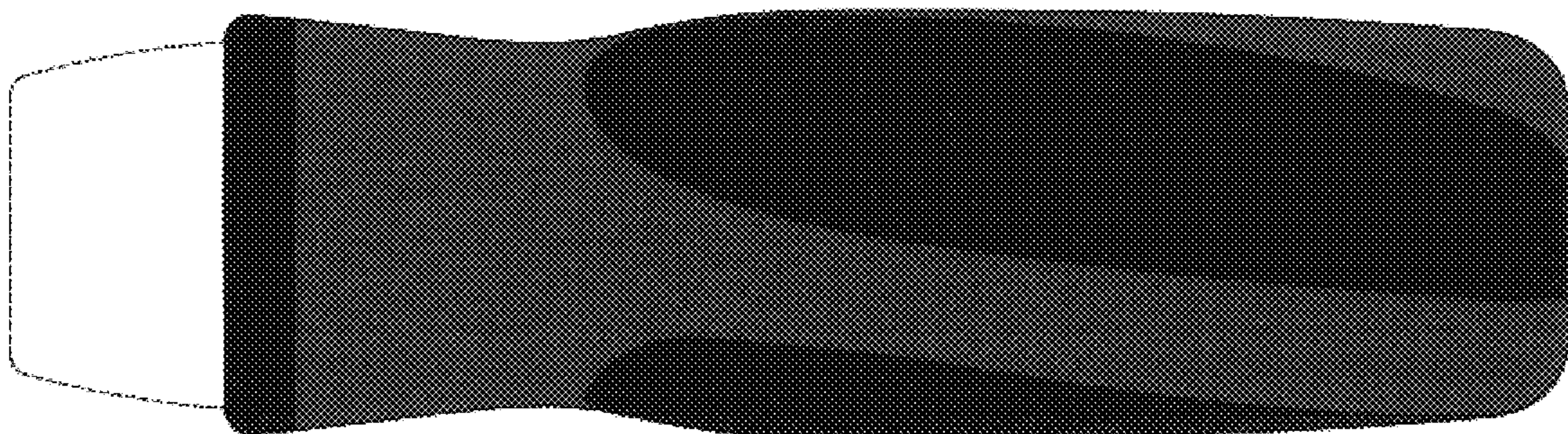
