FIG. 3 is a side elevational view rotated approximately 180° degrees from the FIG. 2 view thereof;

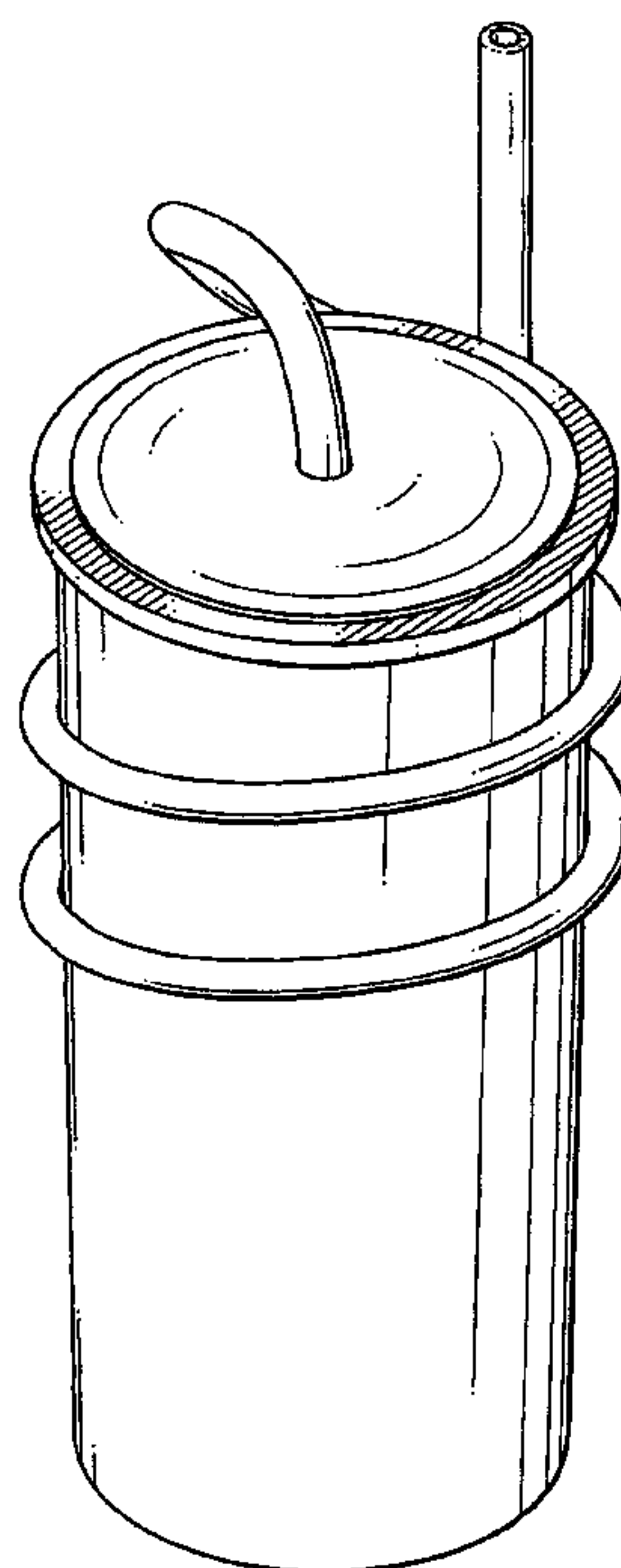
FIG. 4 a side elevational view rotated approximately 90° degrees from the FIG. 3 view thereof;

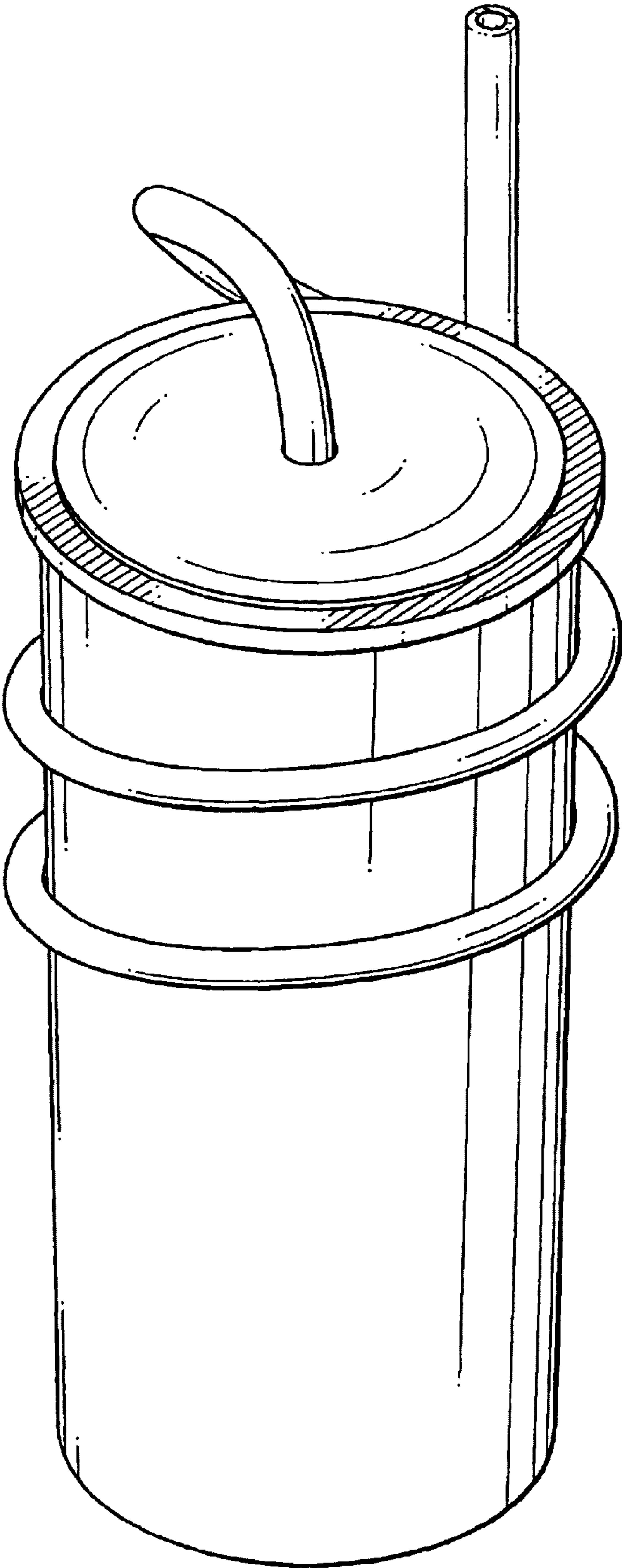
FIG. 5 a side elevational view rotated approximately 180° degrees from the FIG. 4 view thereof;

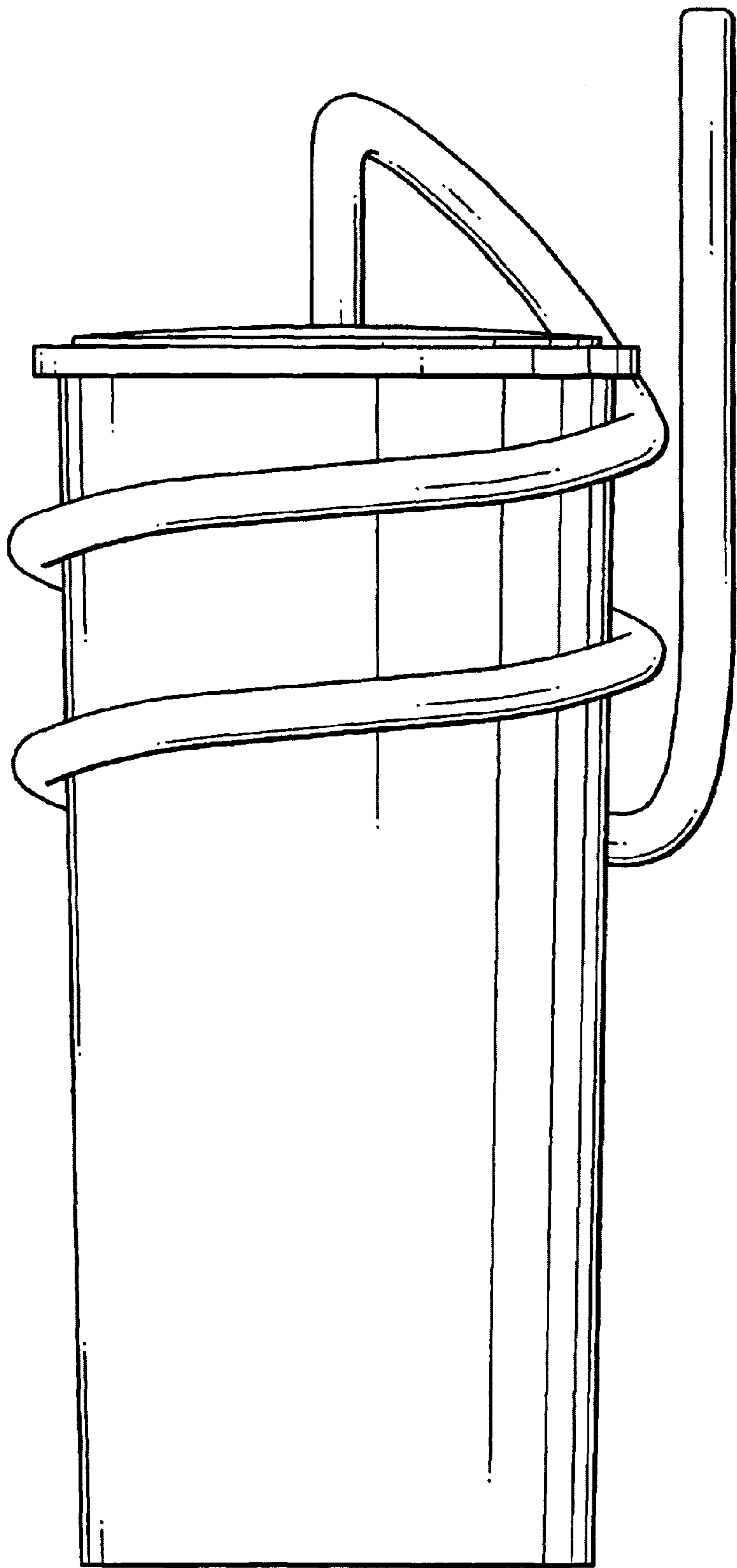

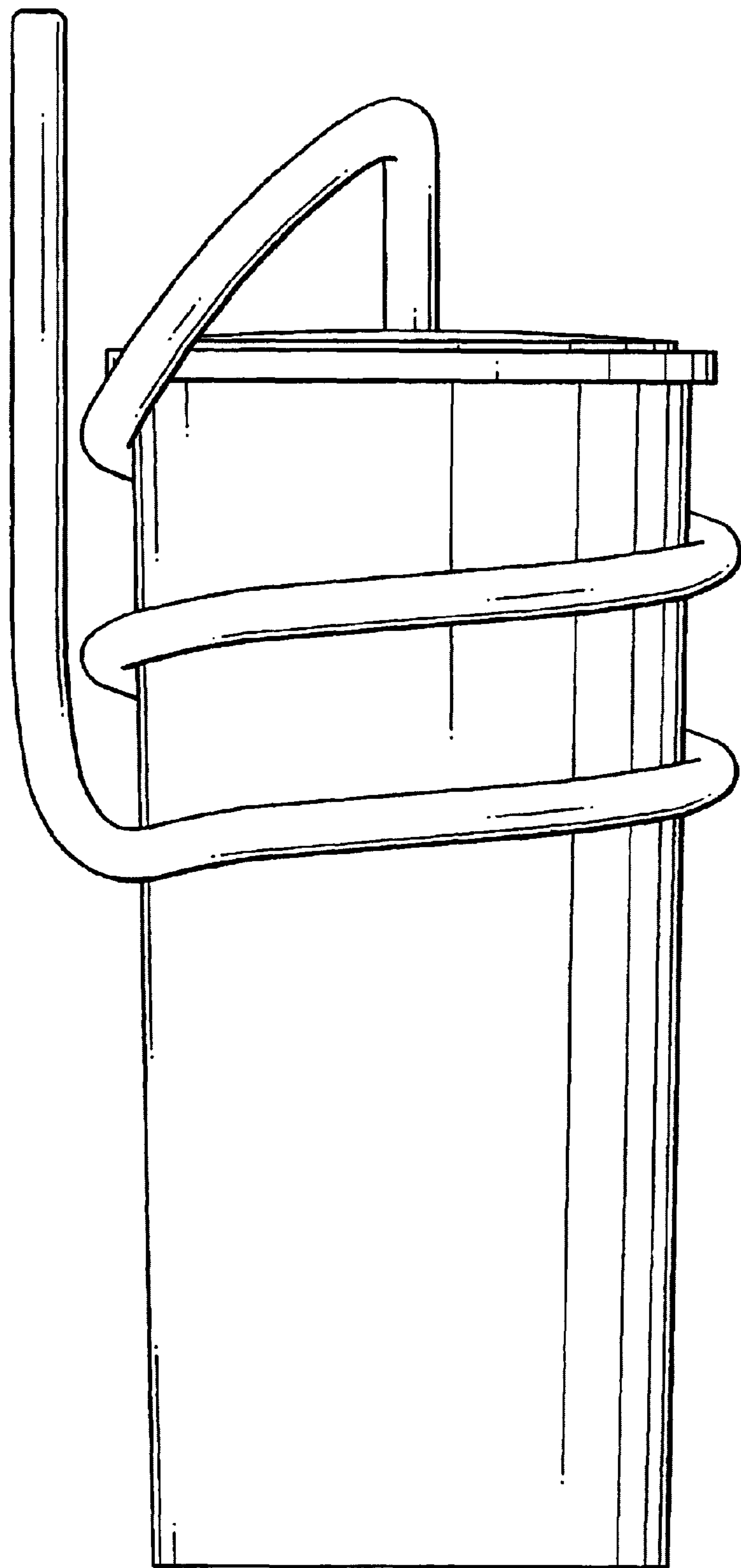

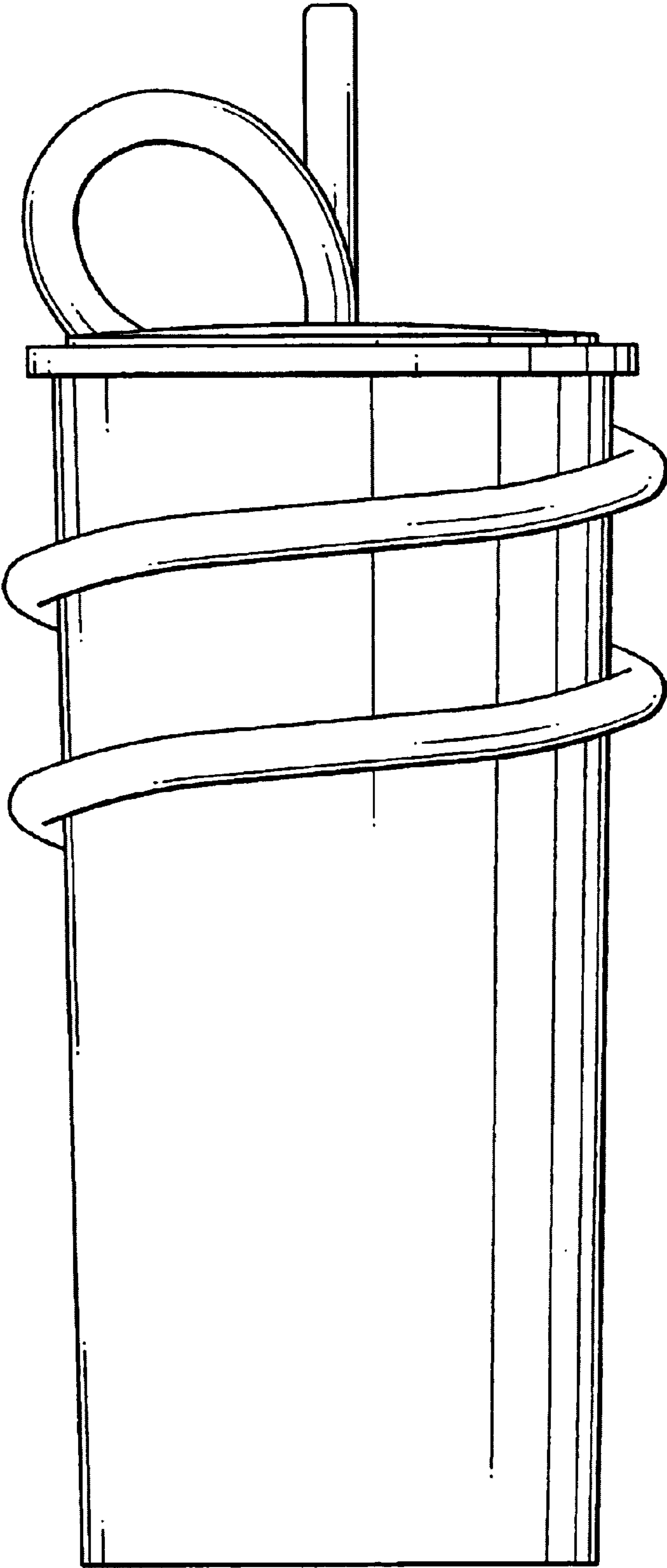

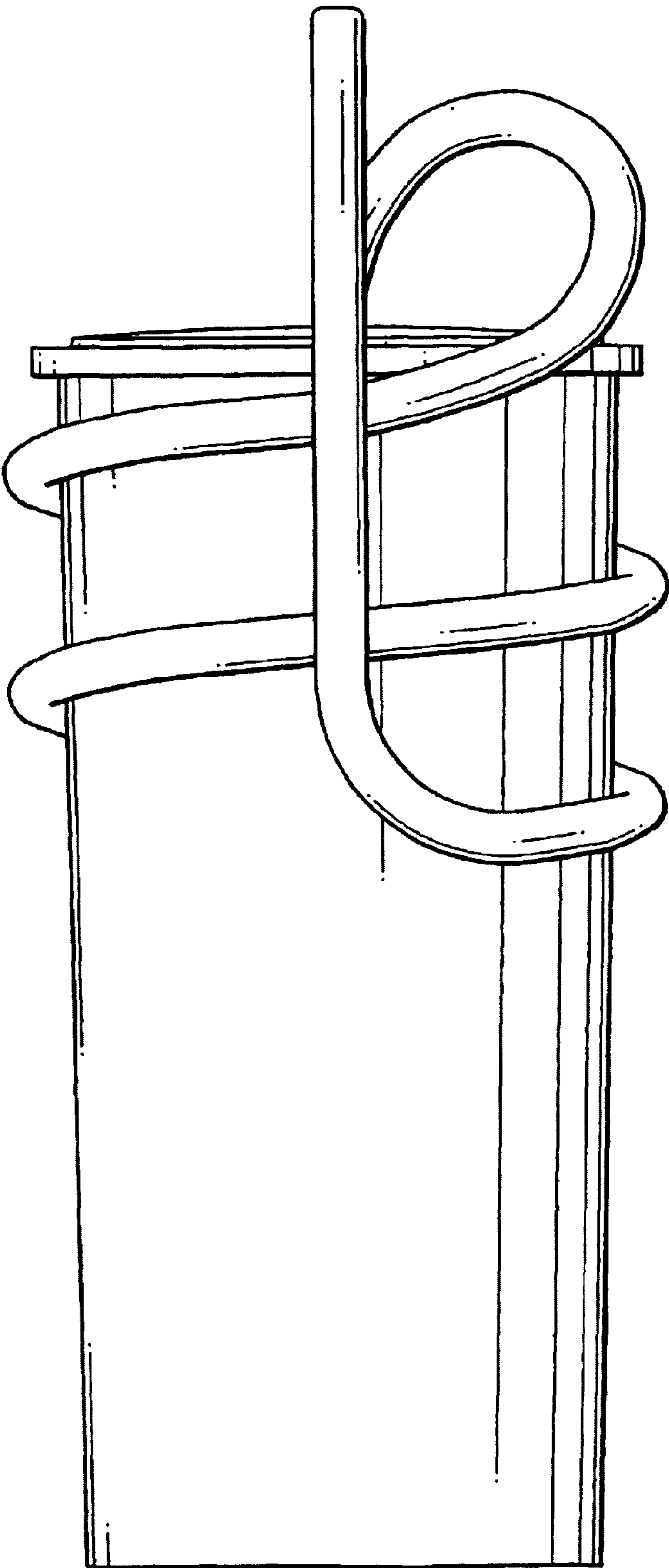

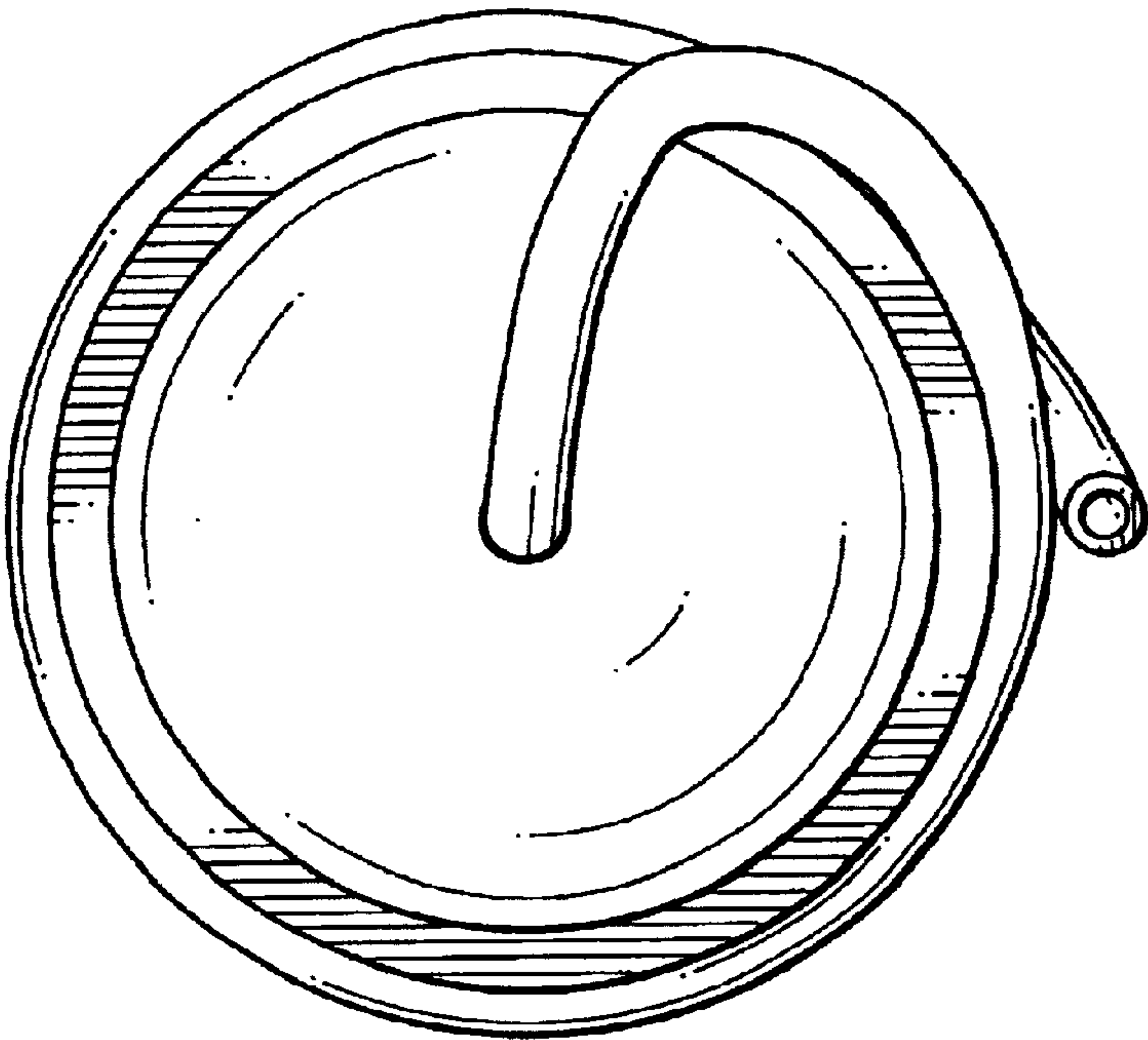

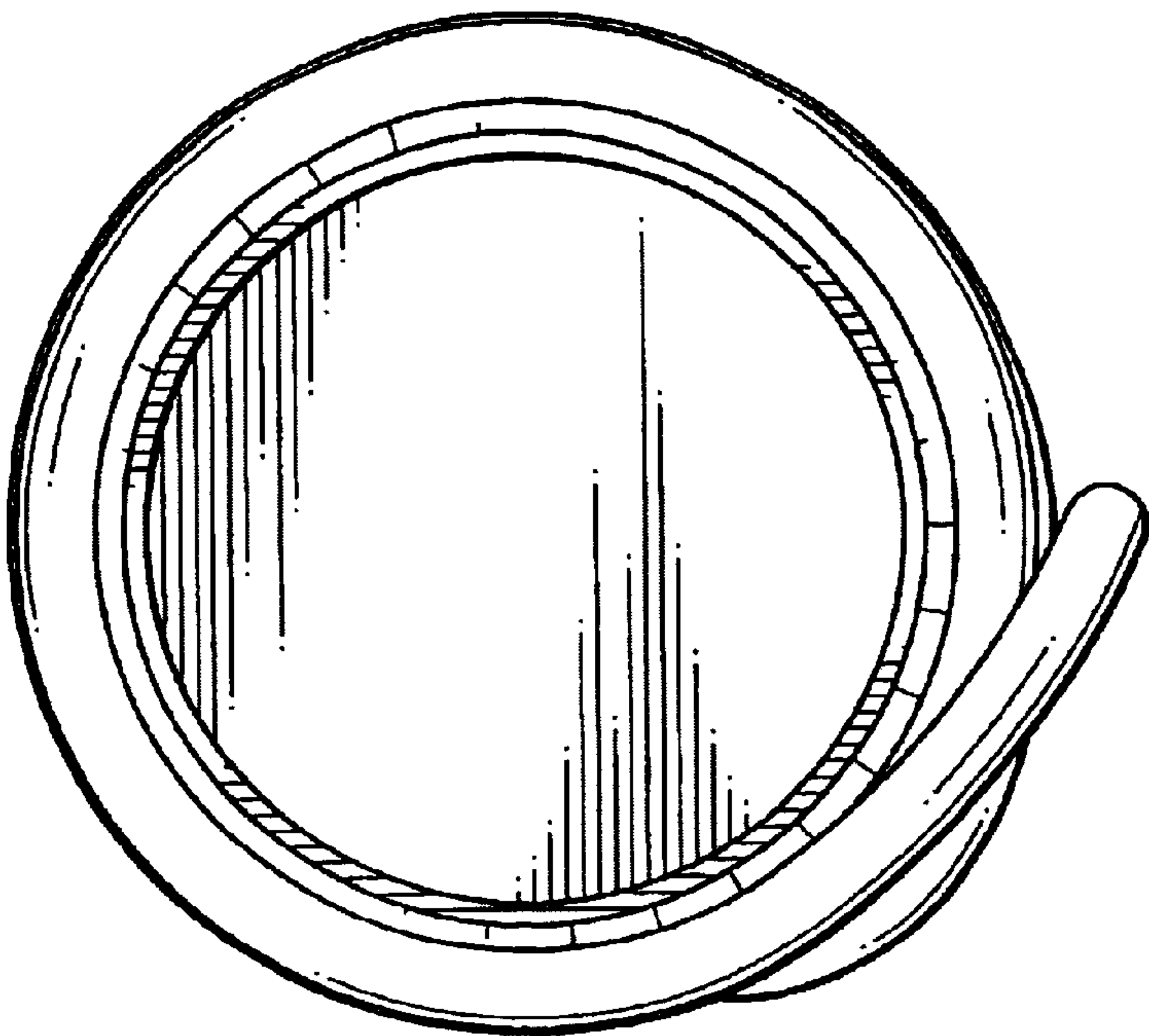
