(57) **CLAIM**

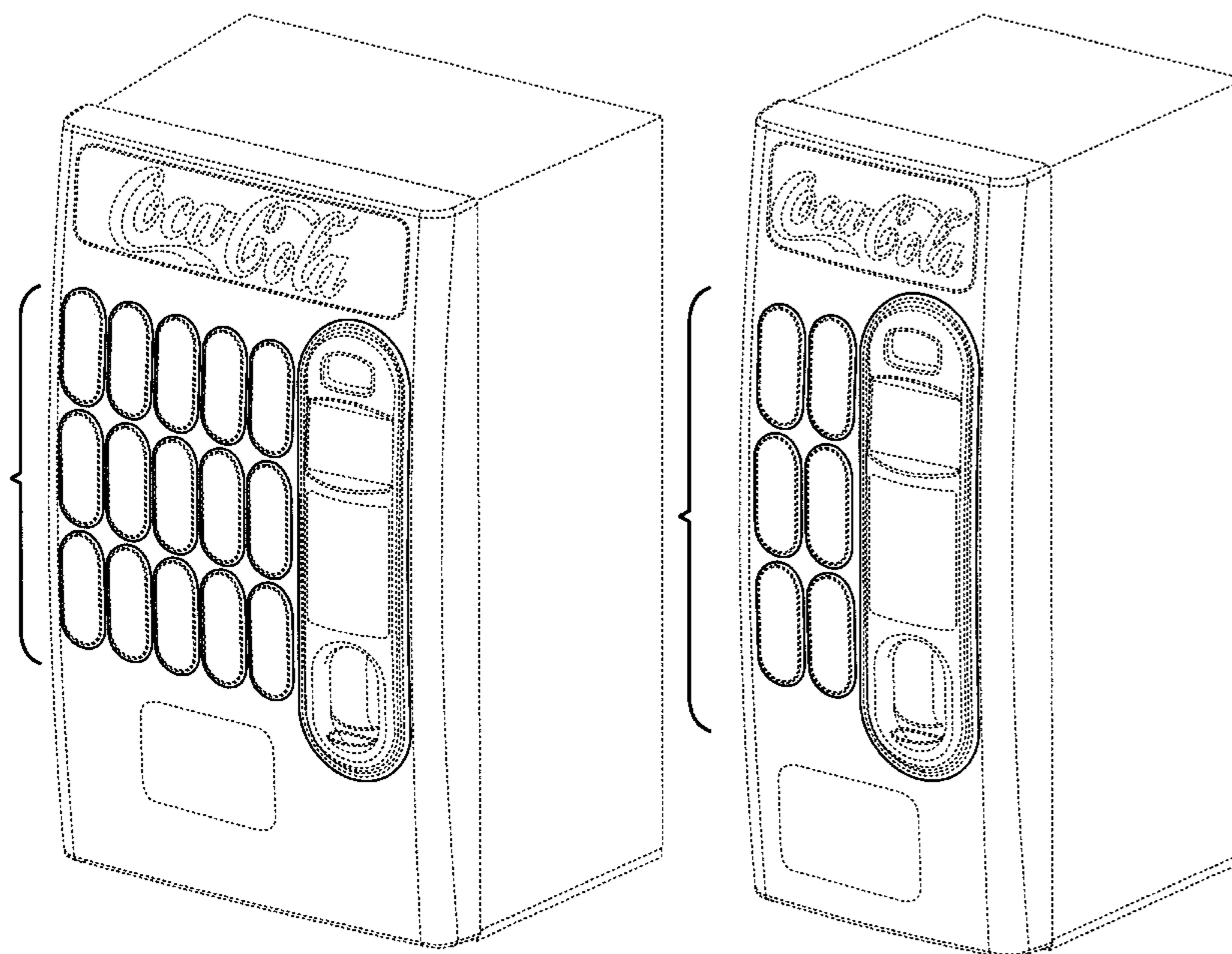
We claim the ornamental design for a vending machine door, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front left side perspective view of a vending machine door showing our new design;

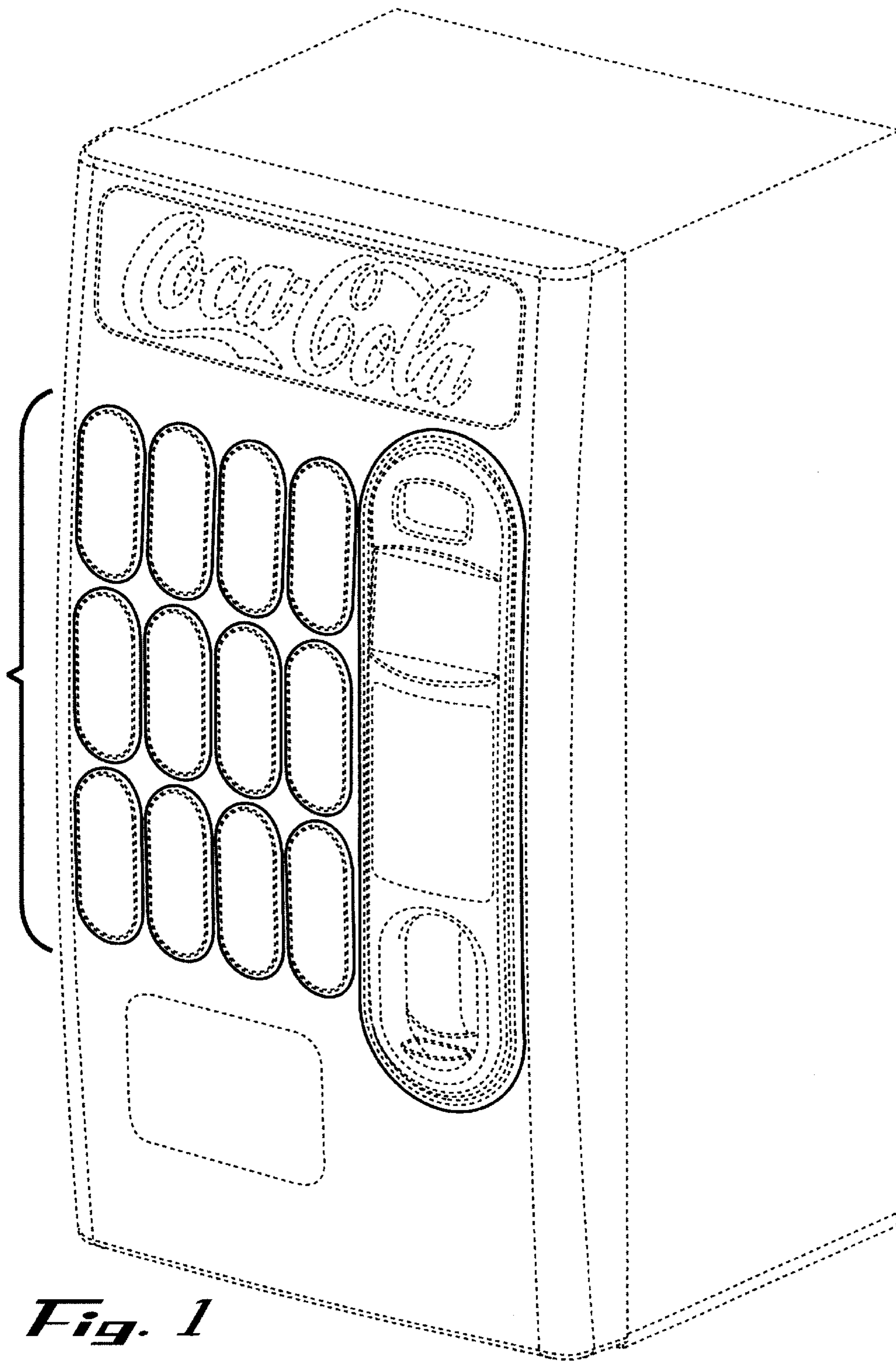

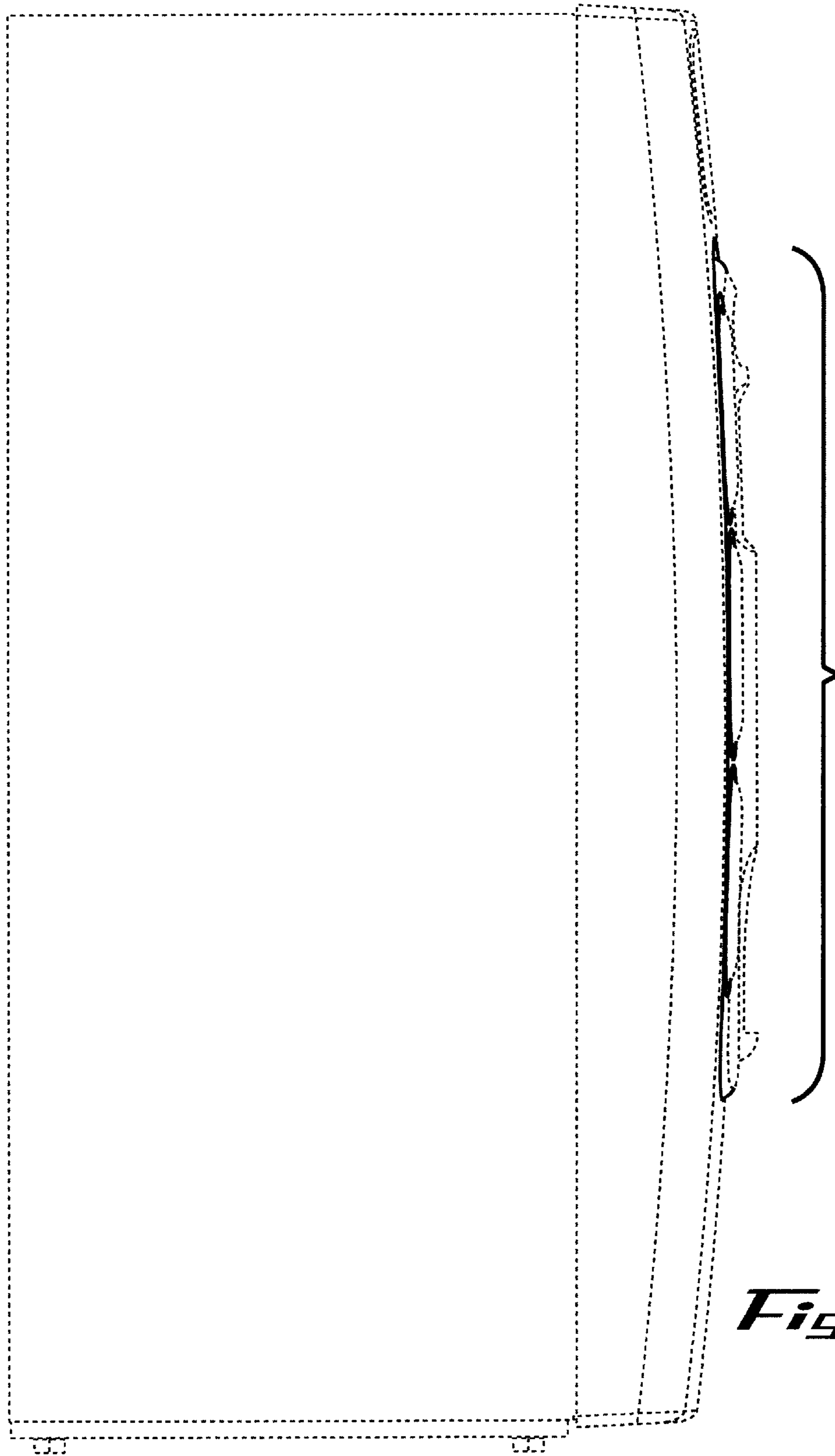

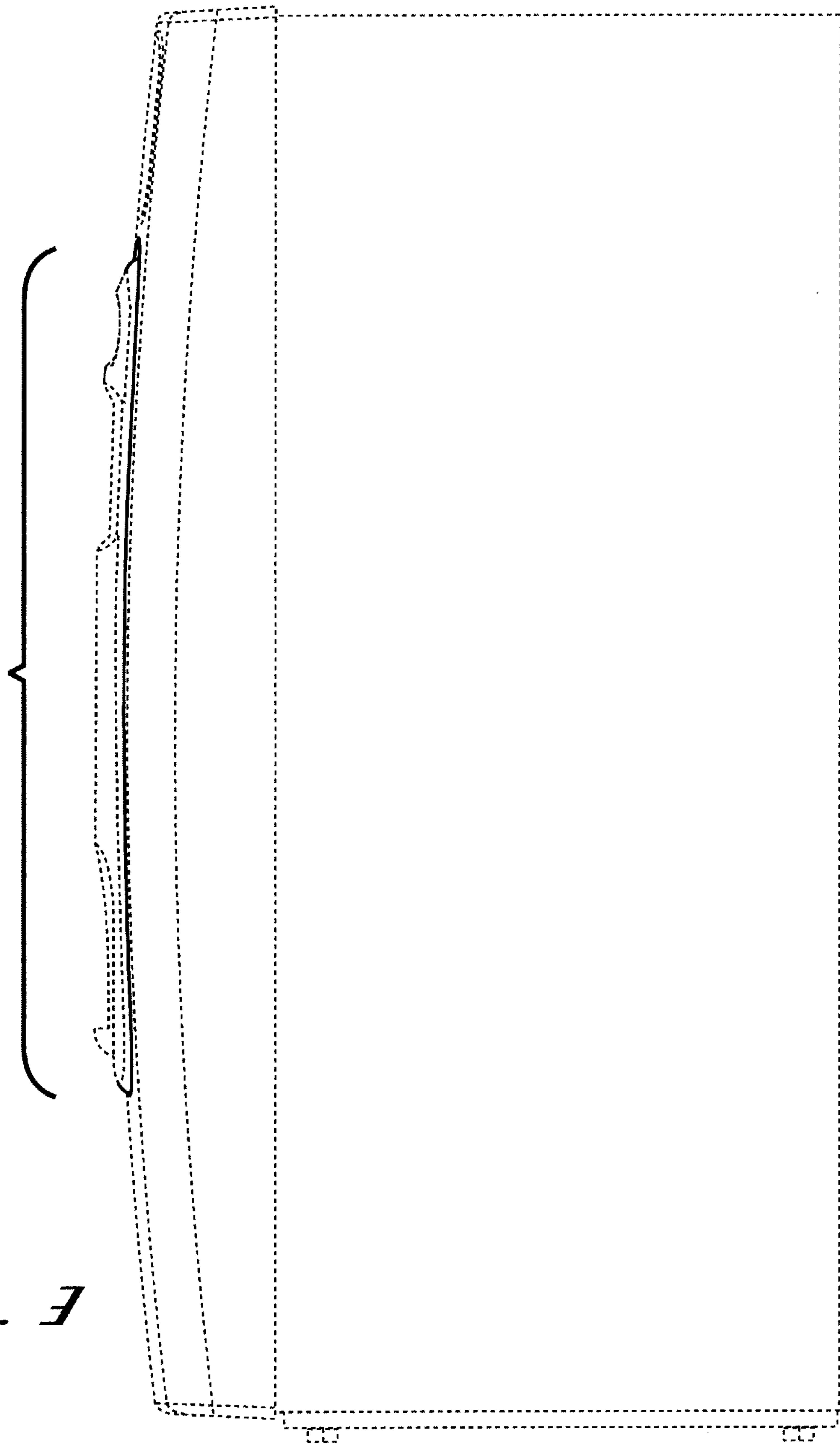

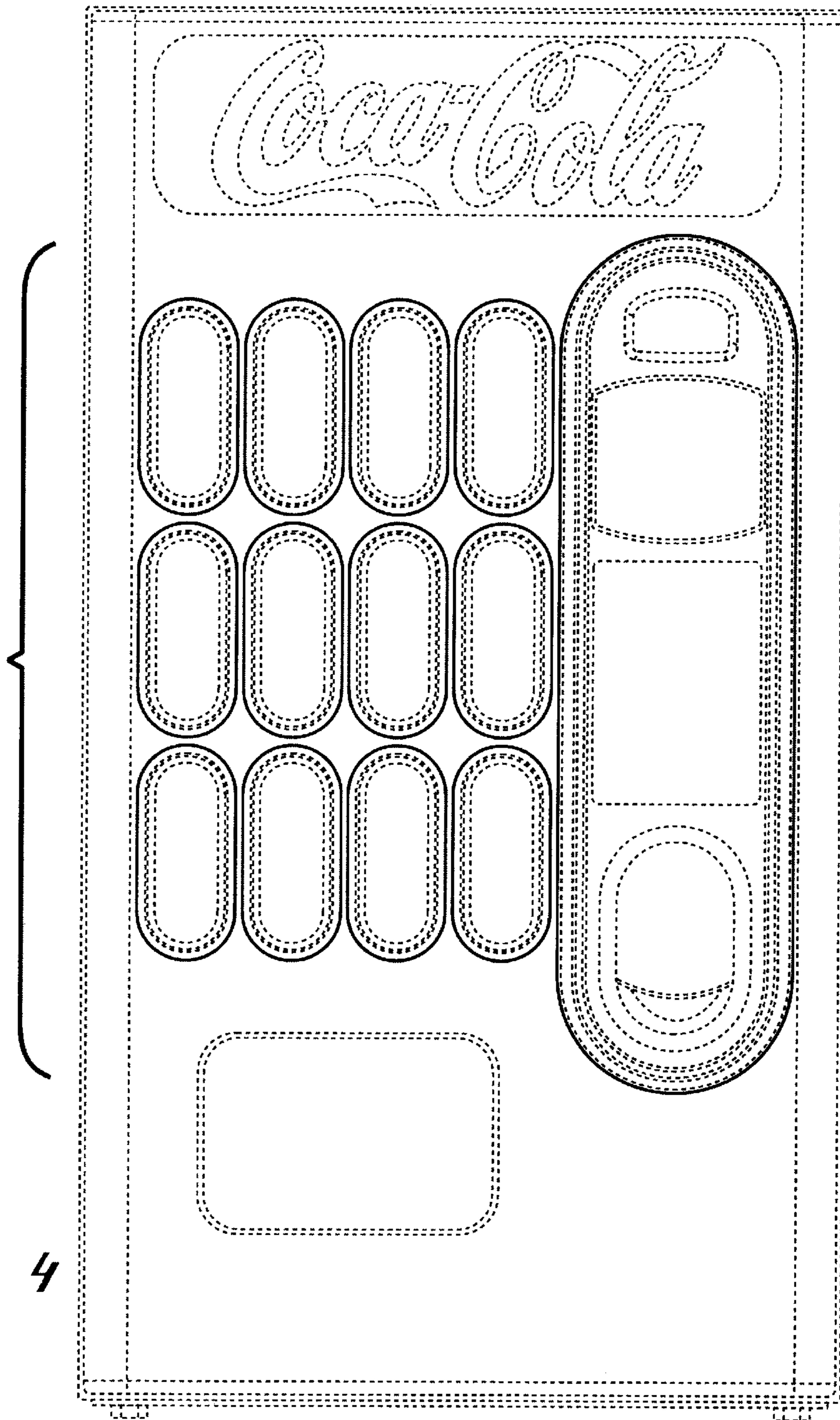

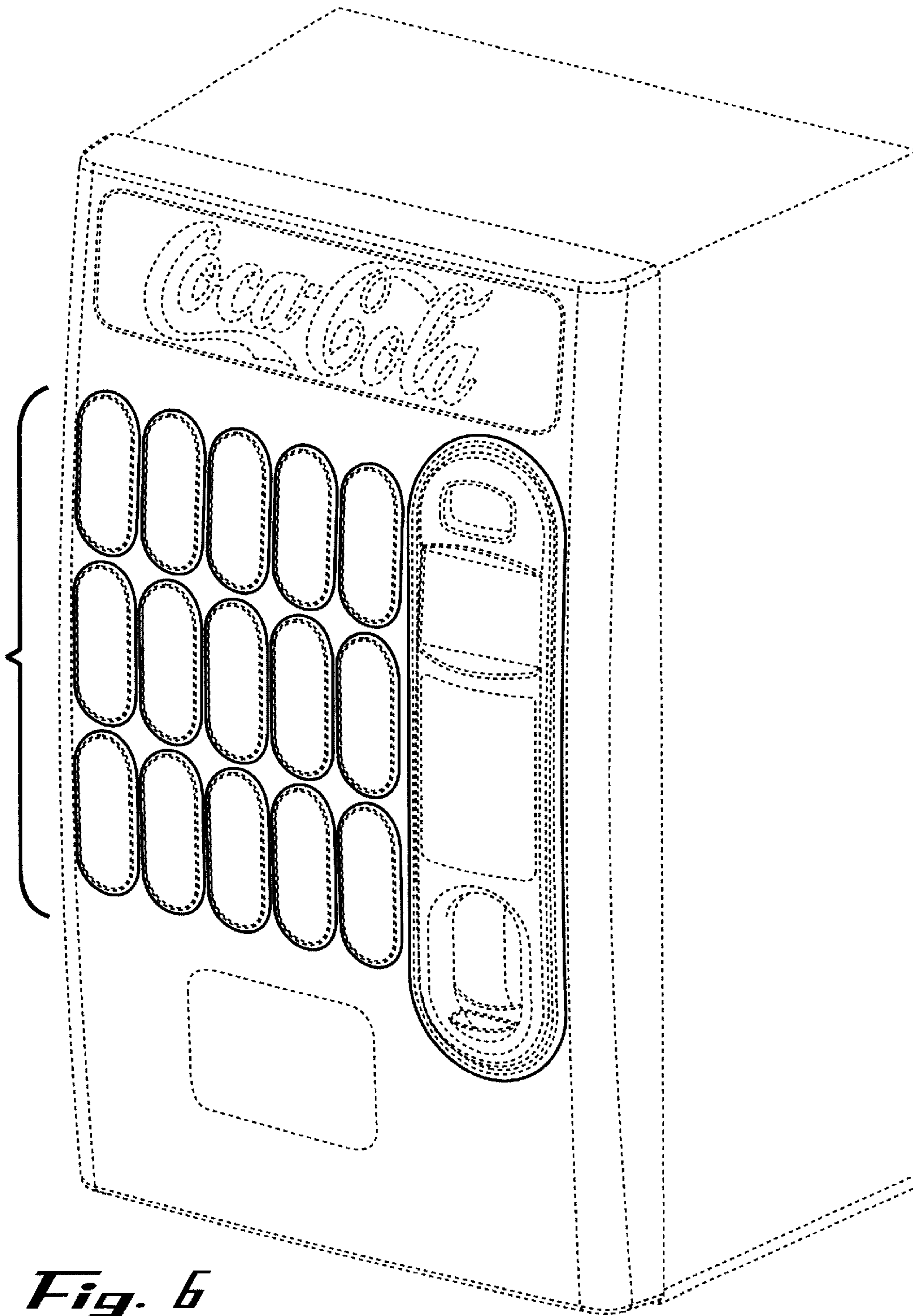

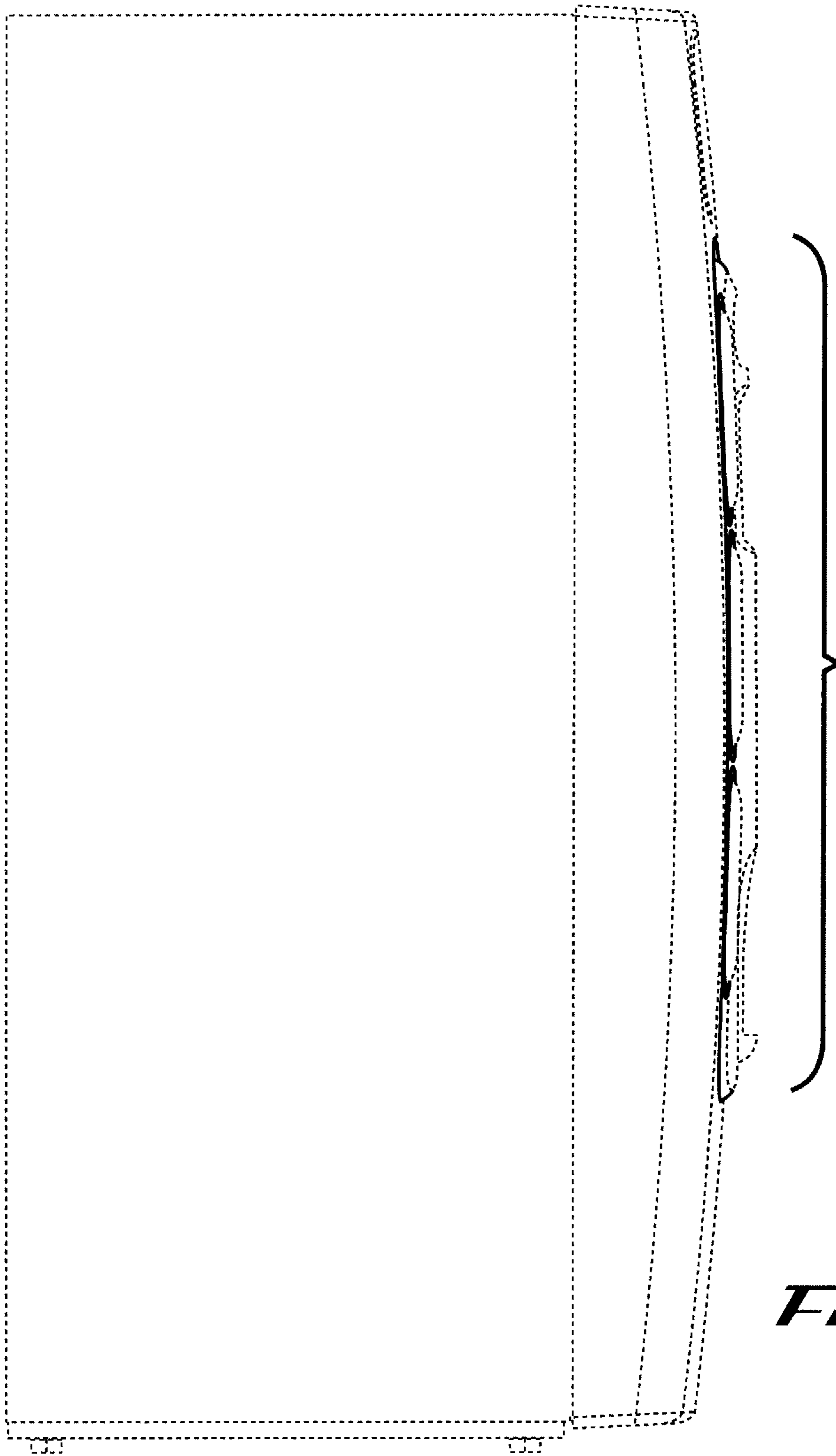

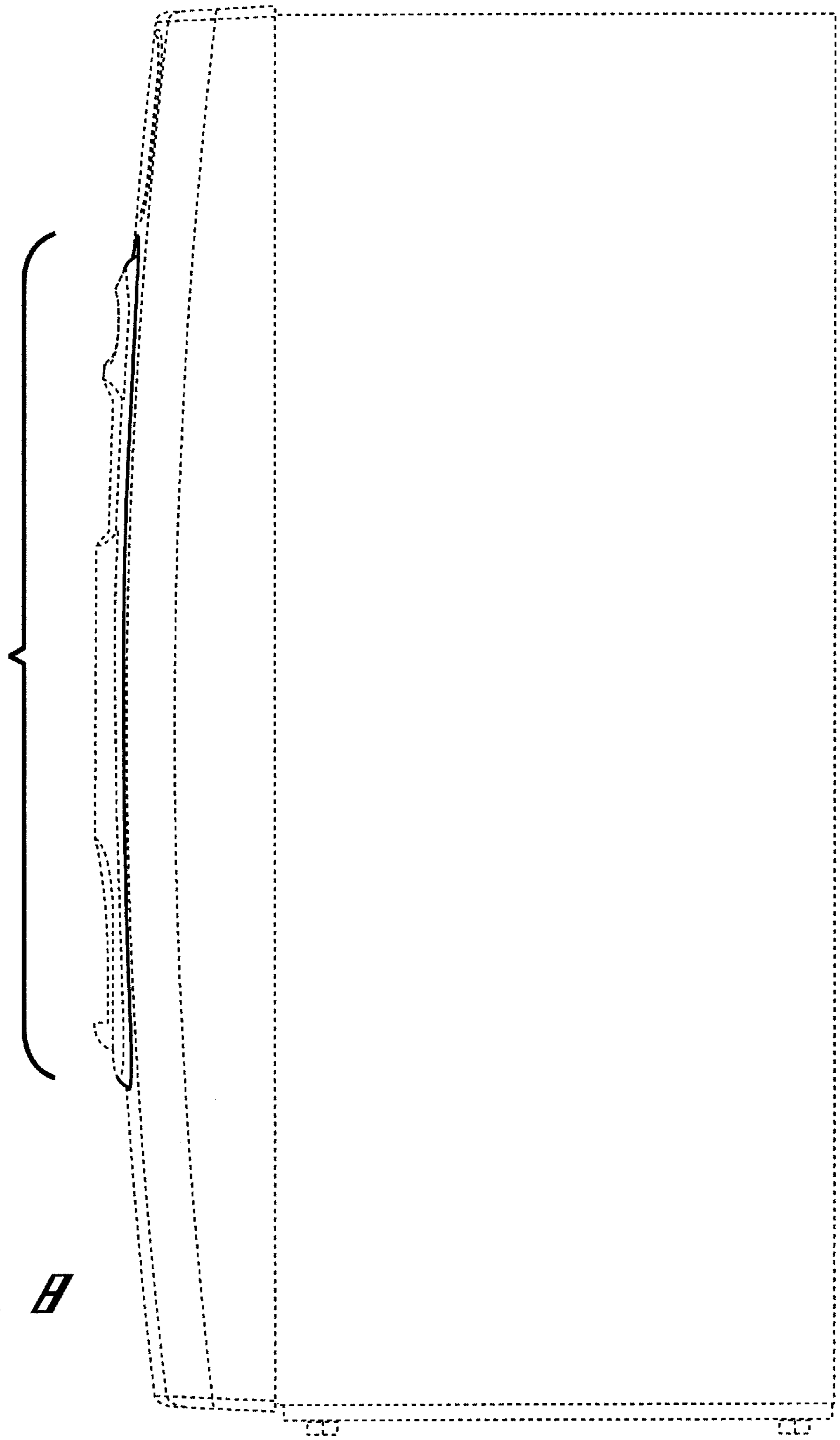

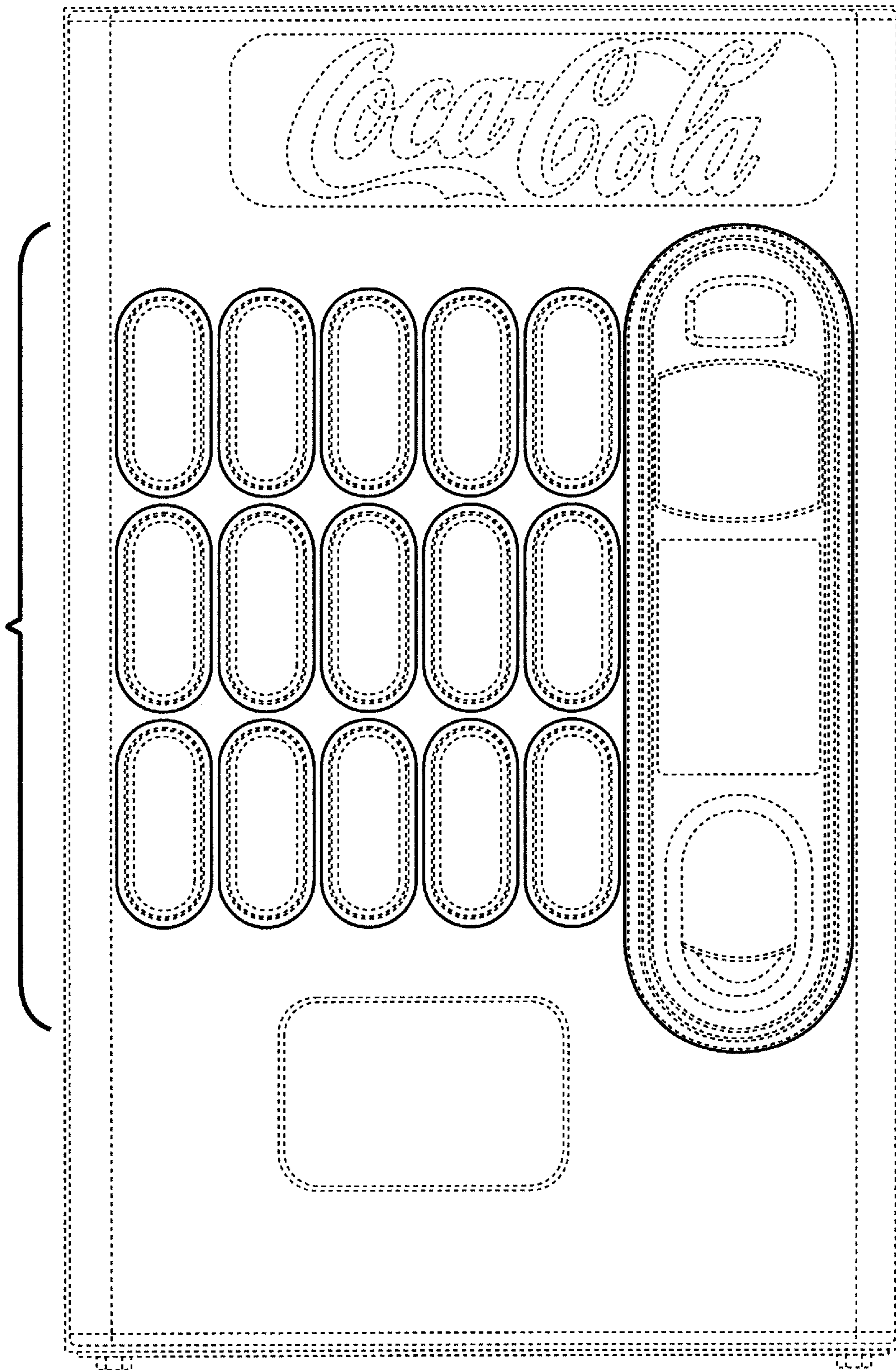

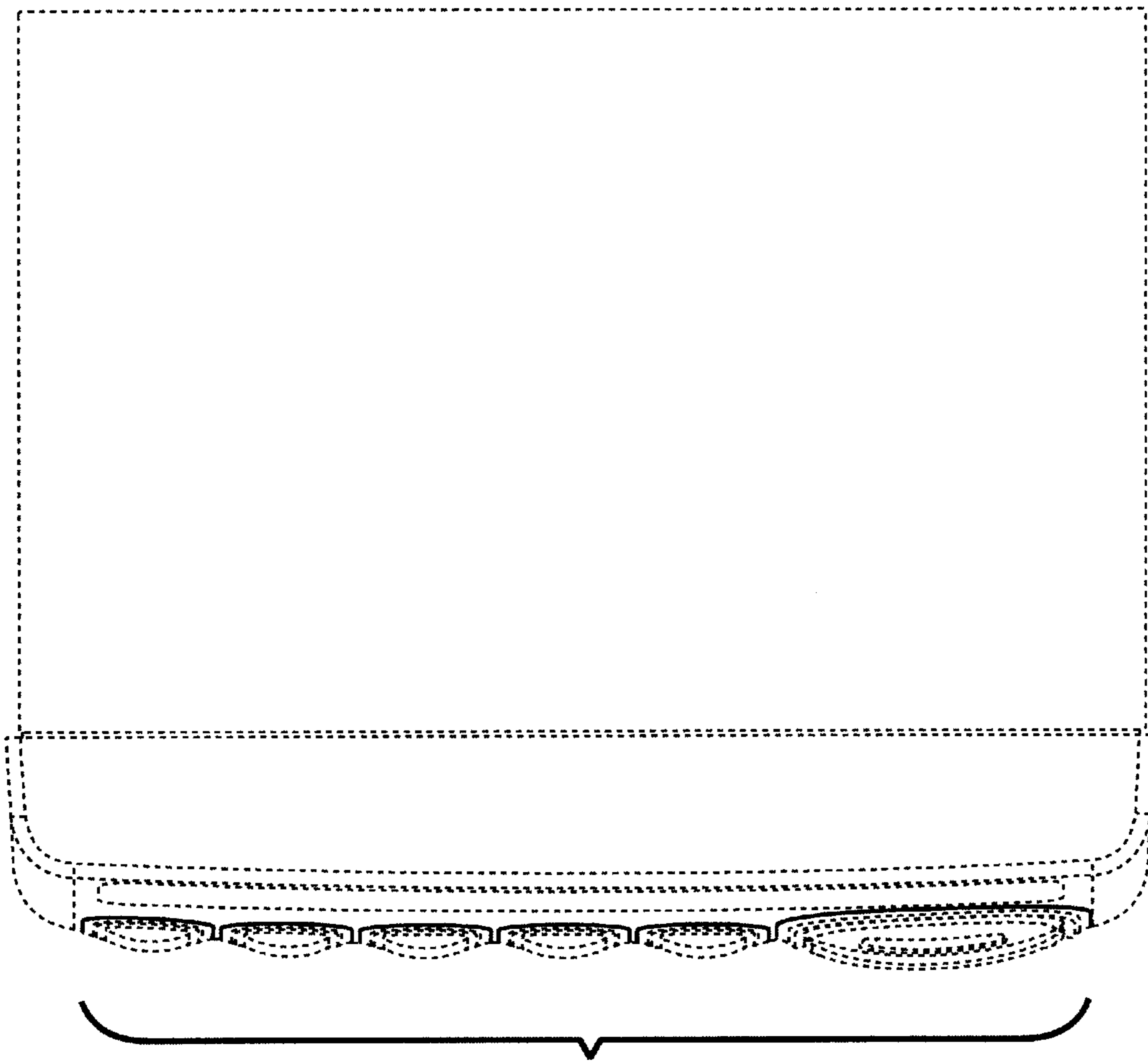

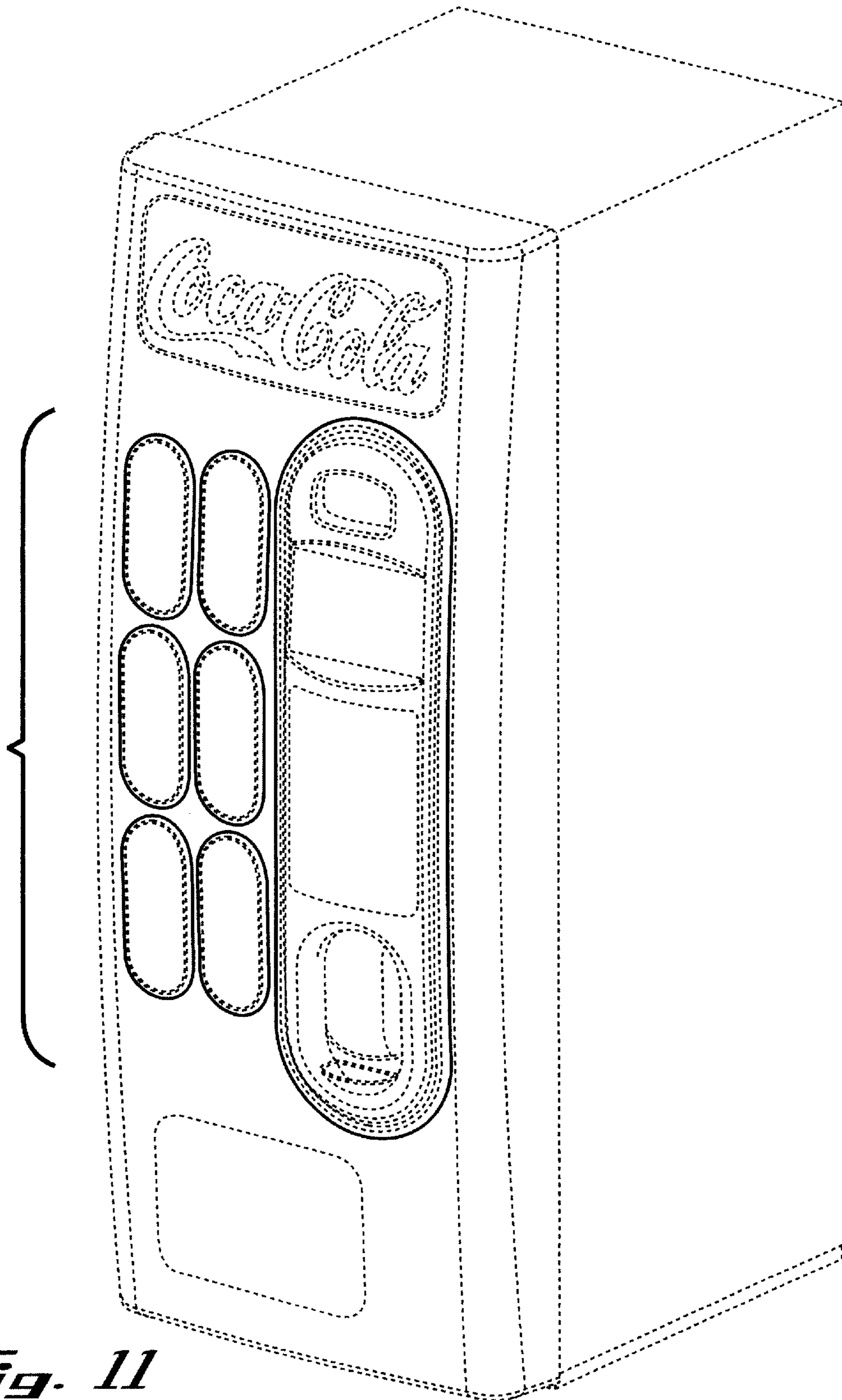

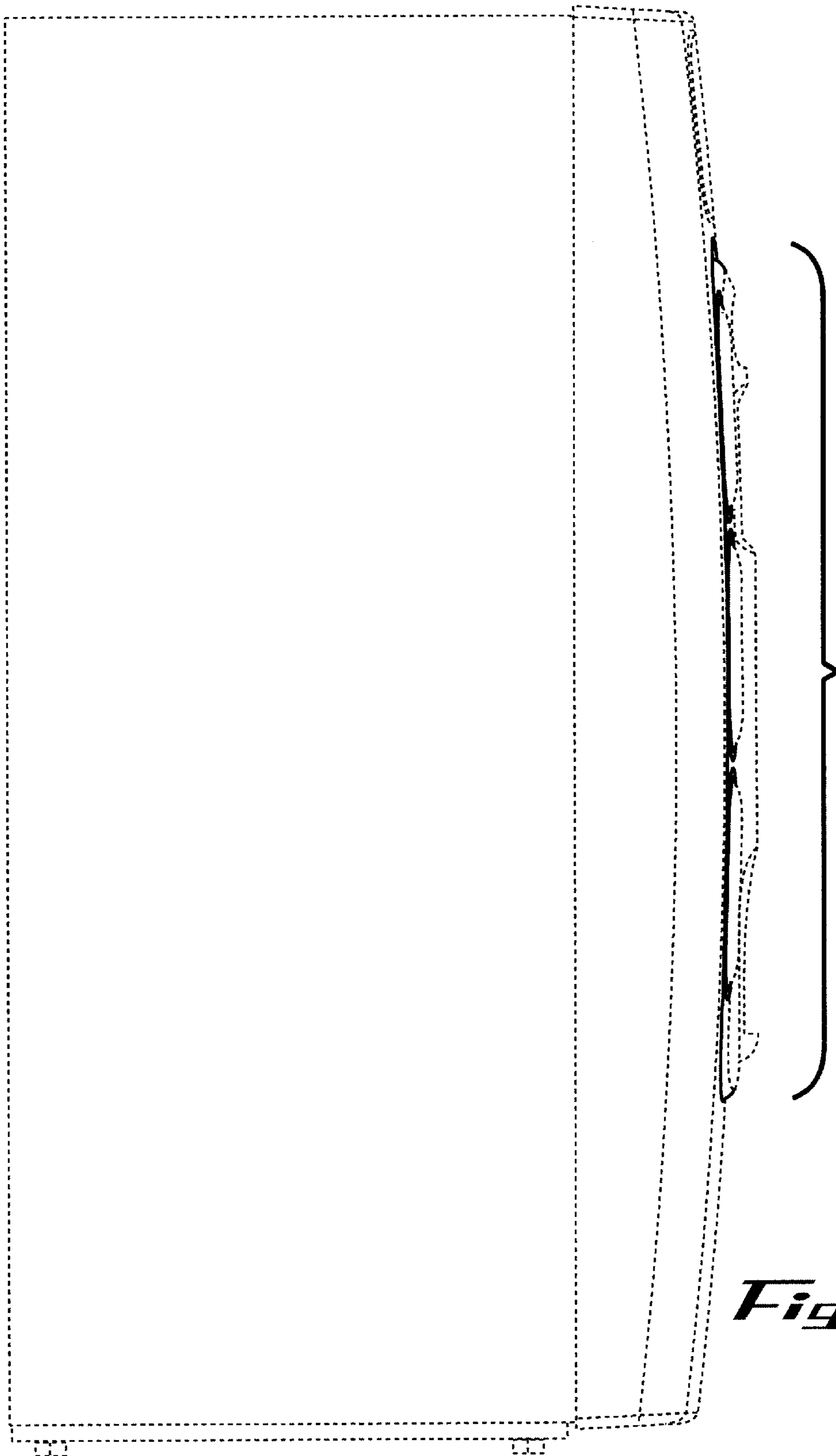

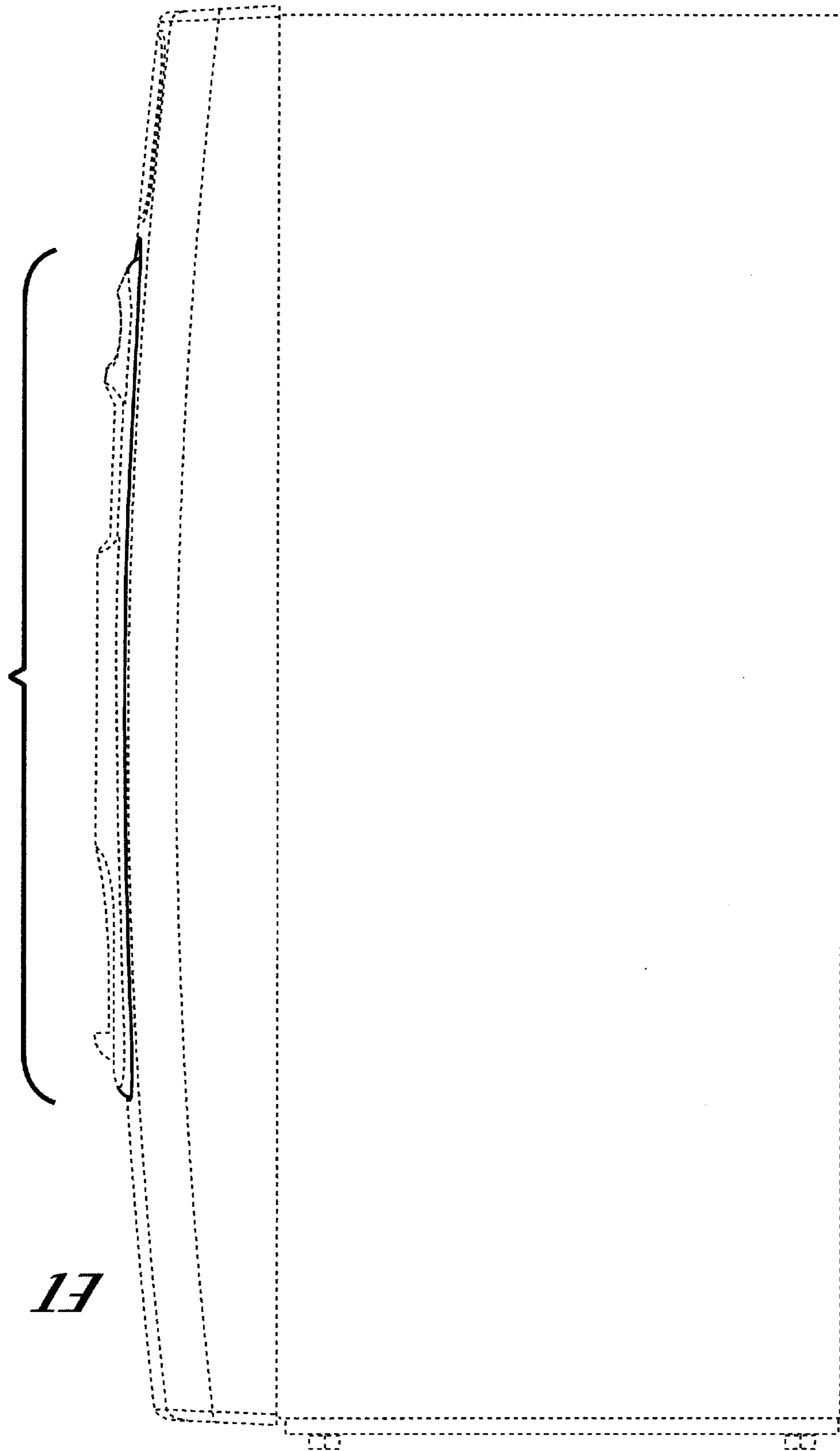

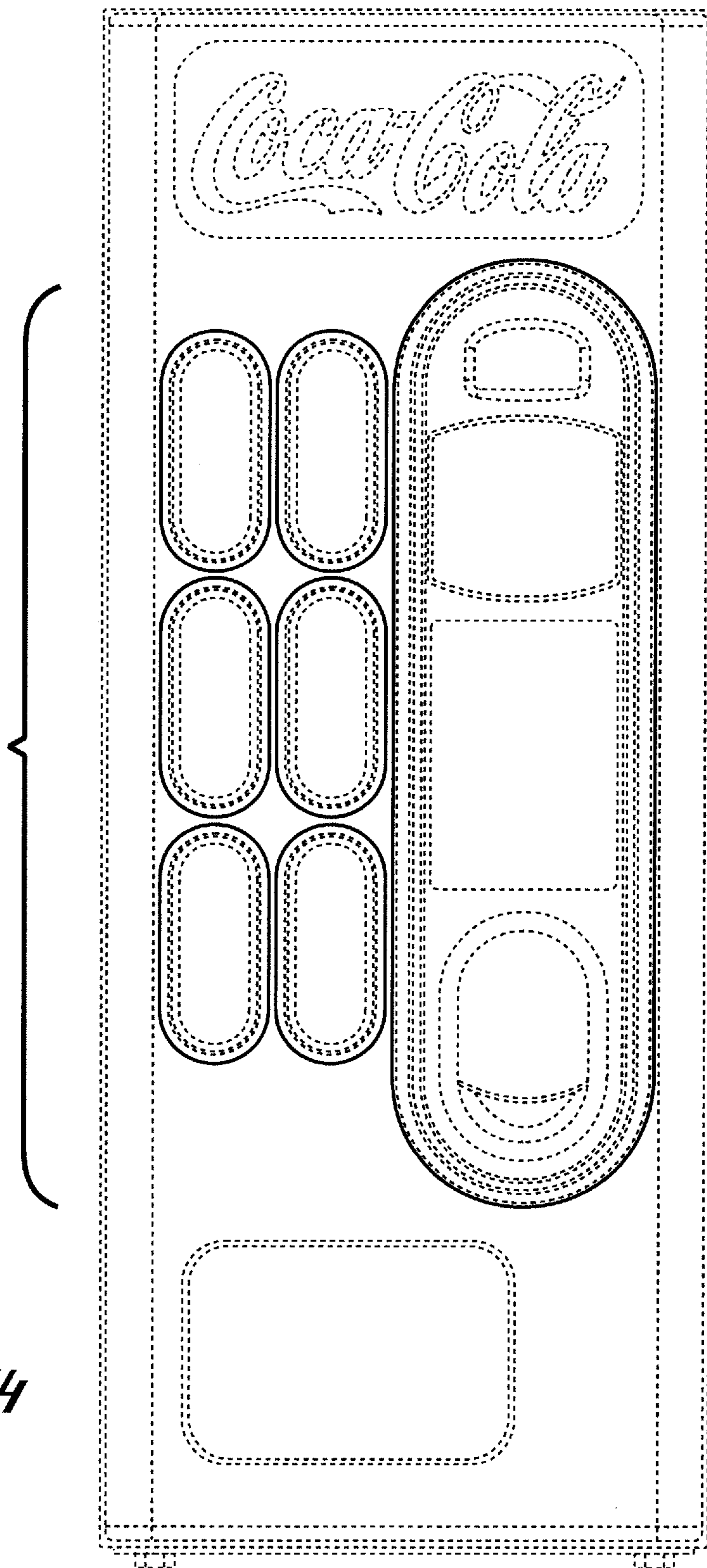

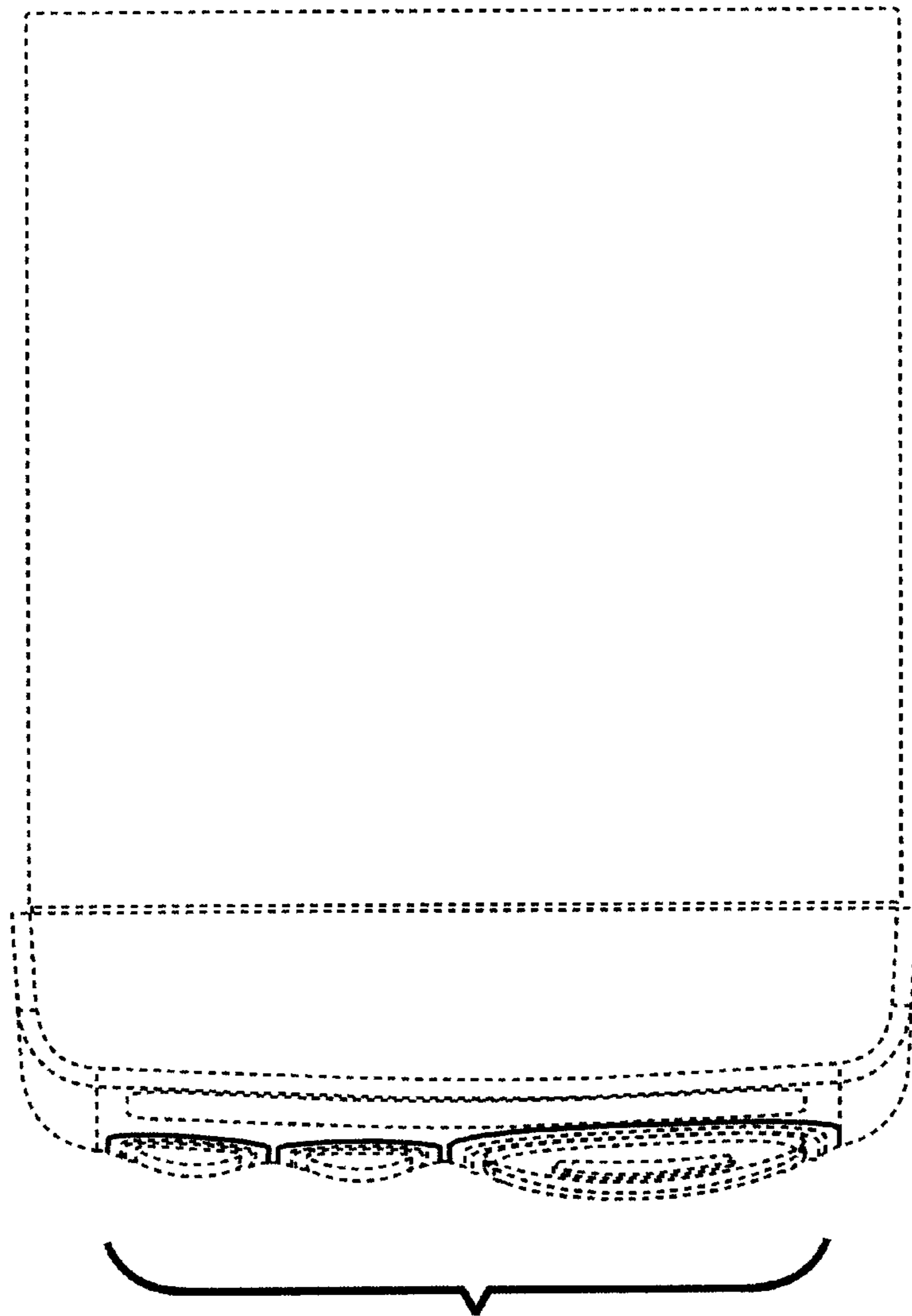
