(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a faucet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

In a preferred embodiment, the nature of this product is as a plumbing fixture in the form of a faucet with a pull-out spout primary useful for washing various items and/or body parts.

FIG. 1 is a left, top, front perspective view of a faucet embodying our new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

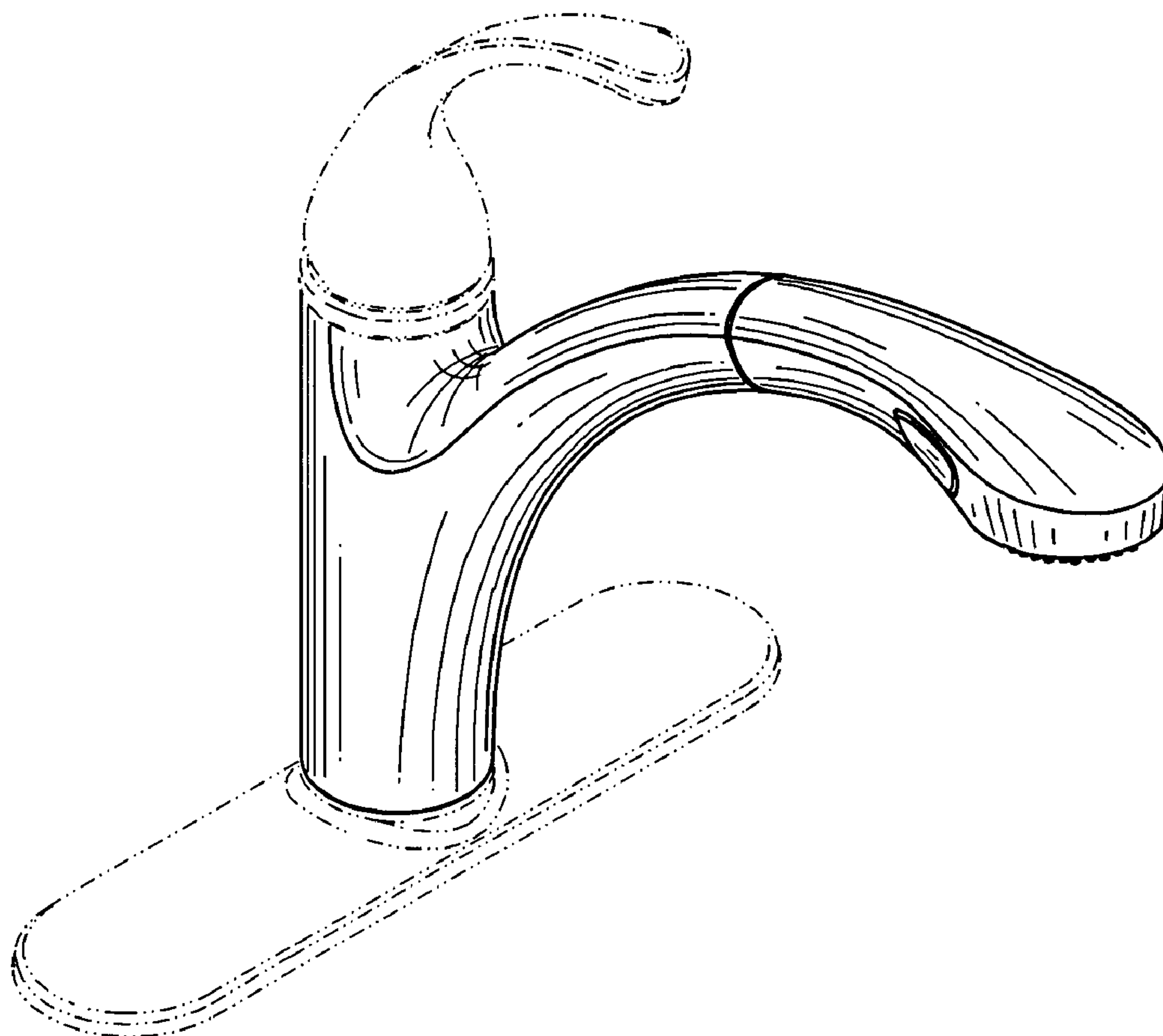
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;

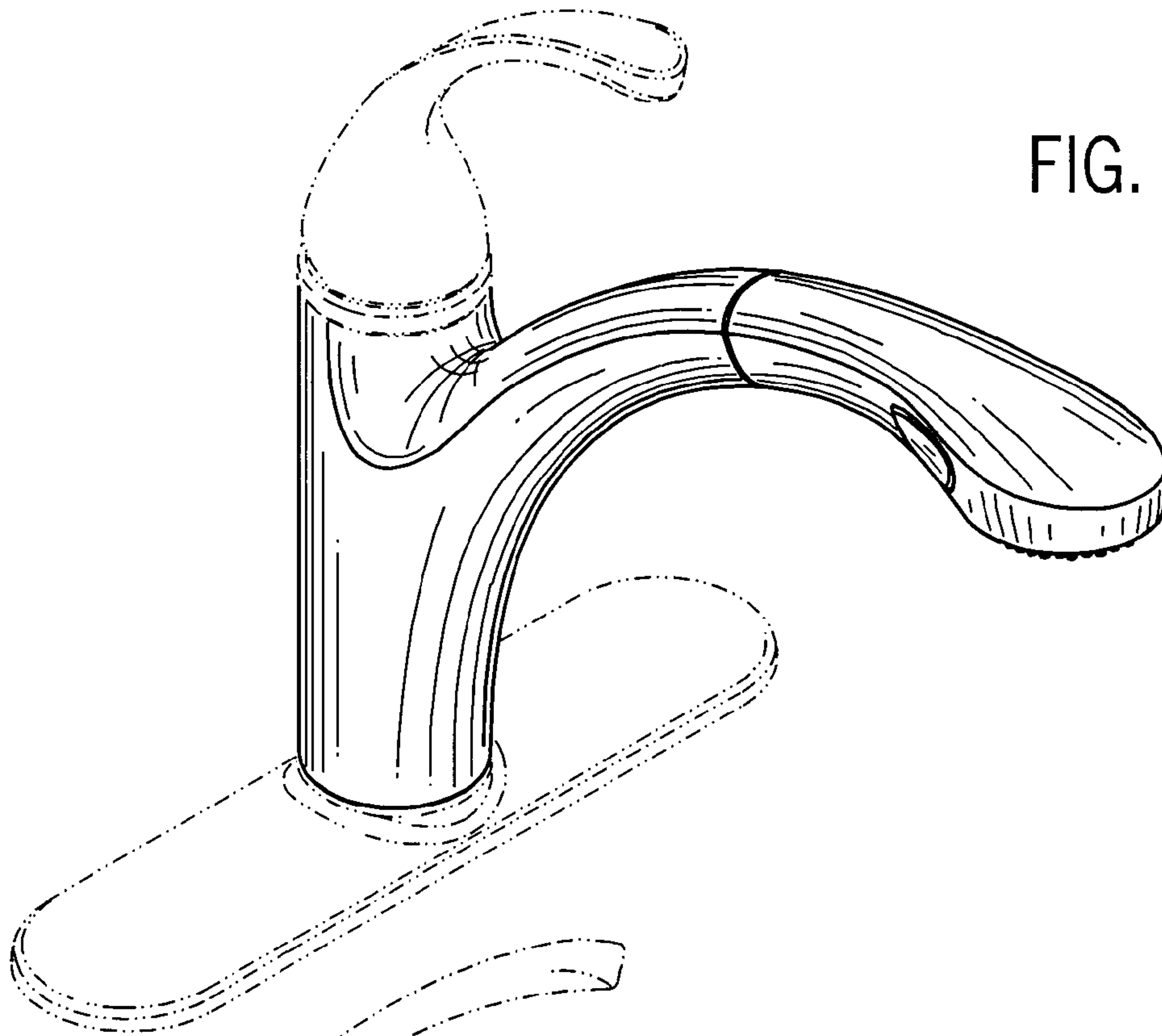

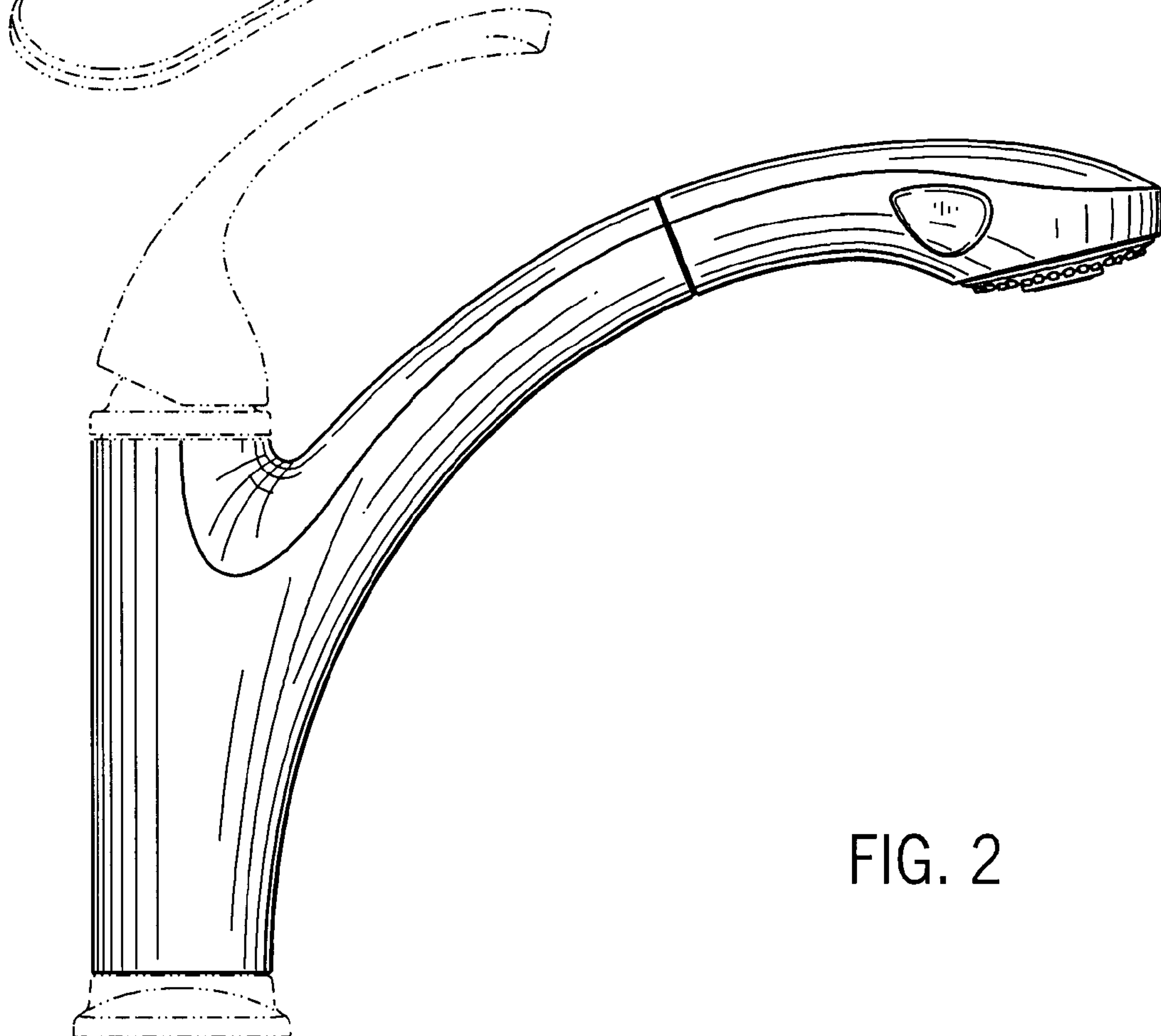

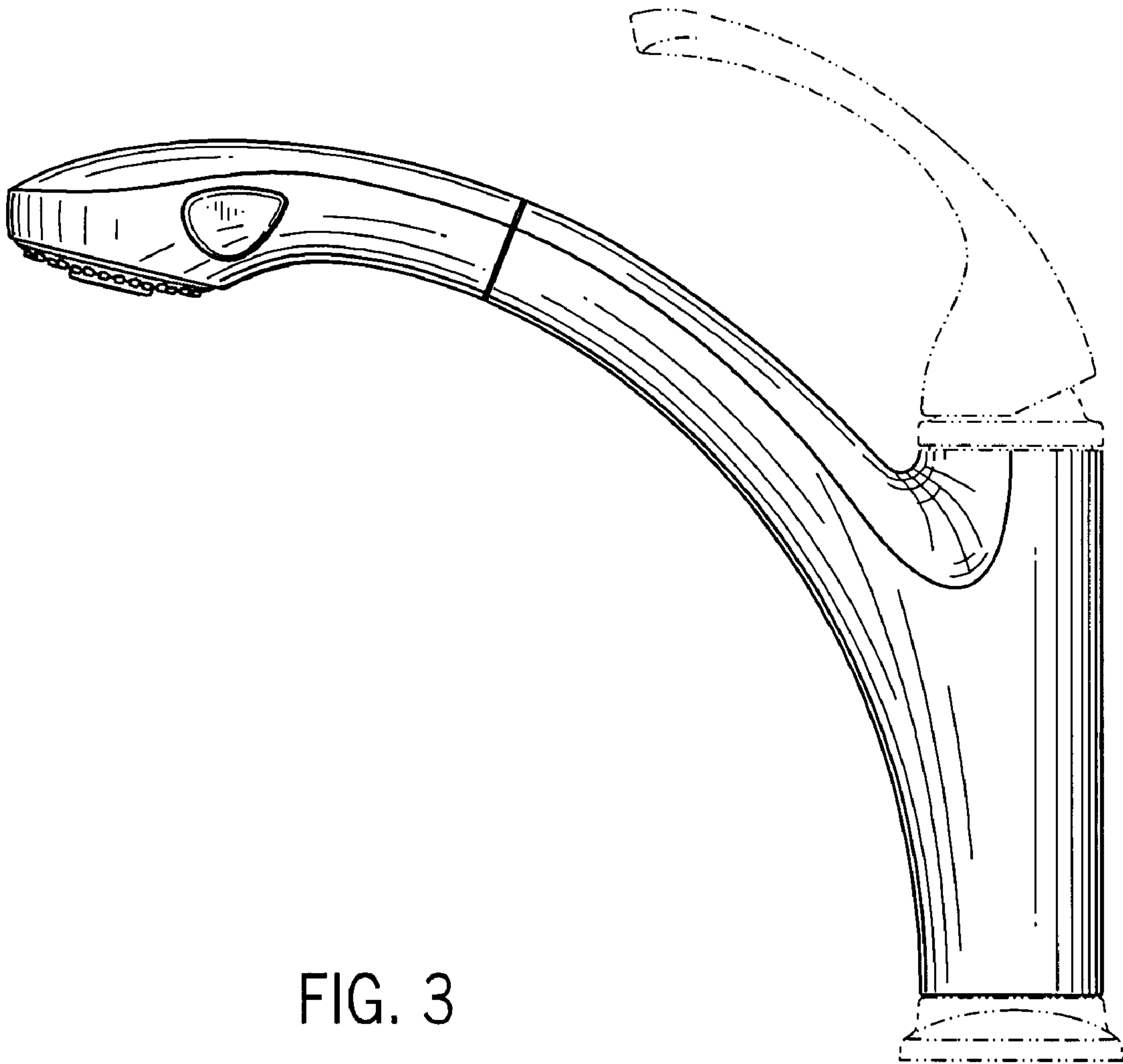

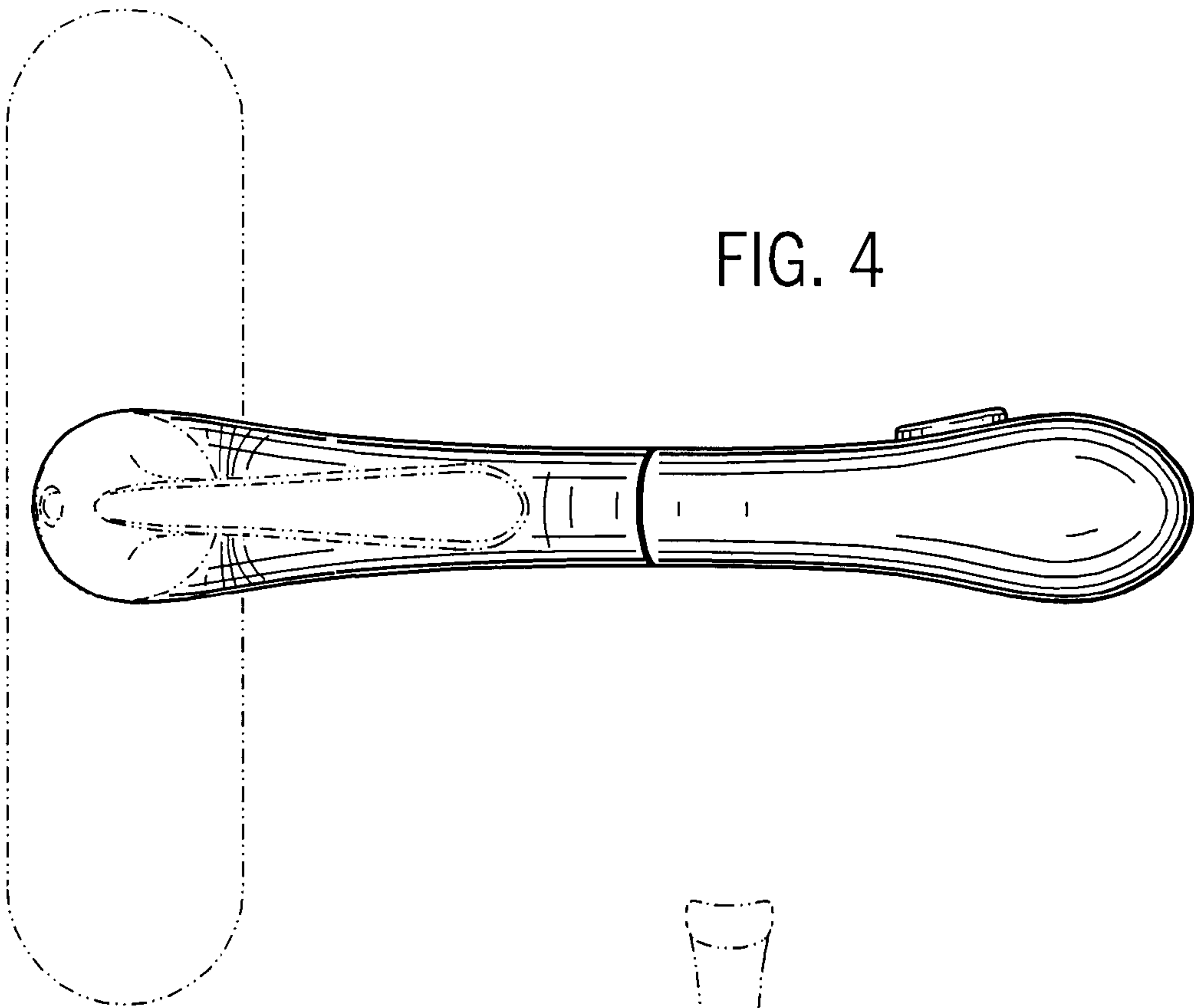

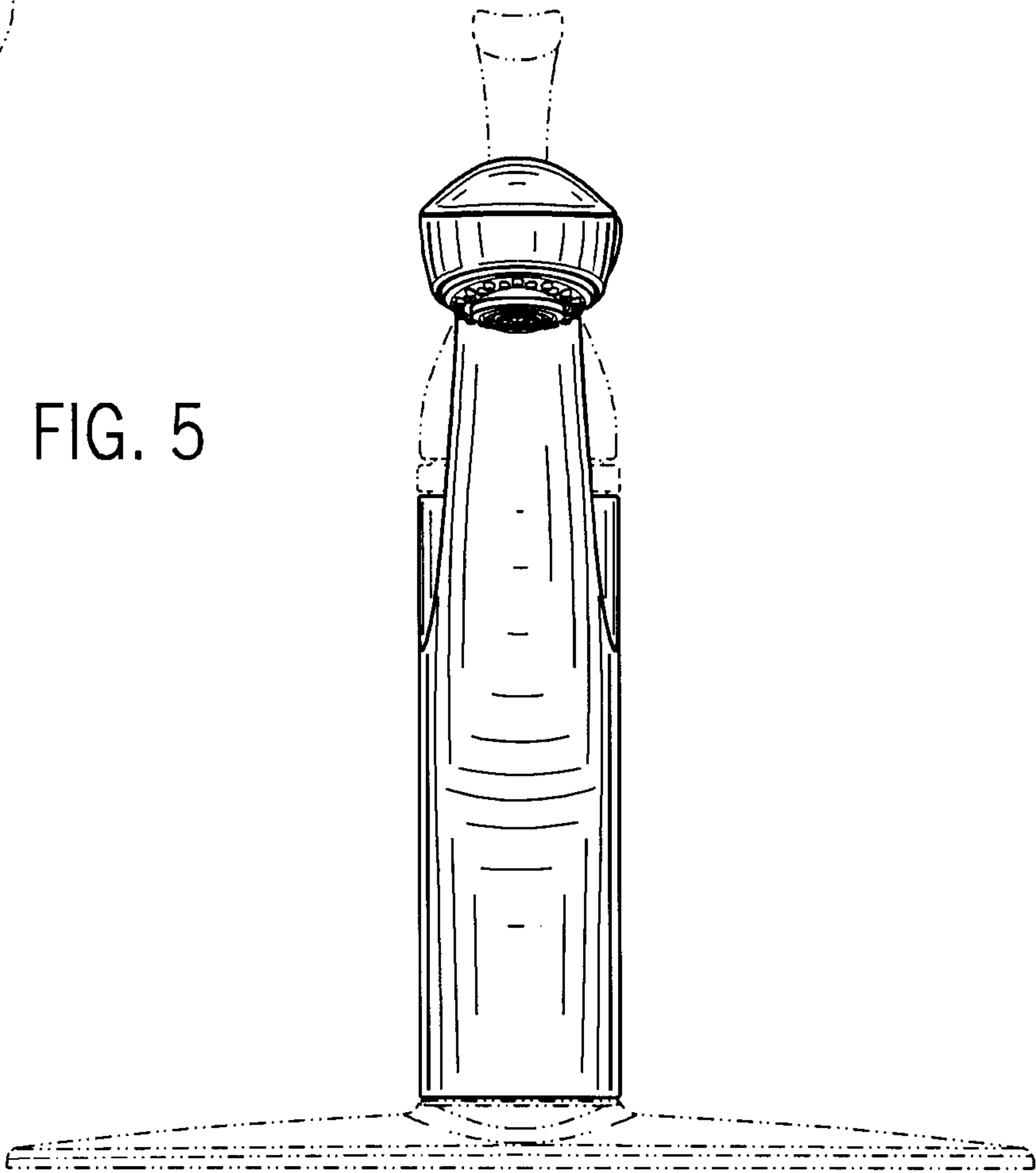

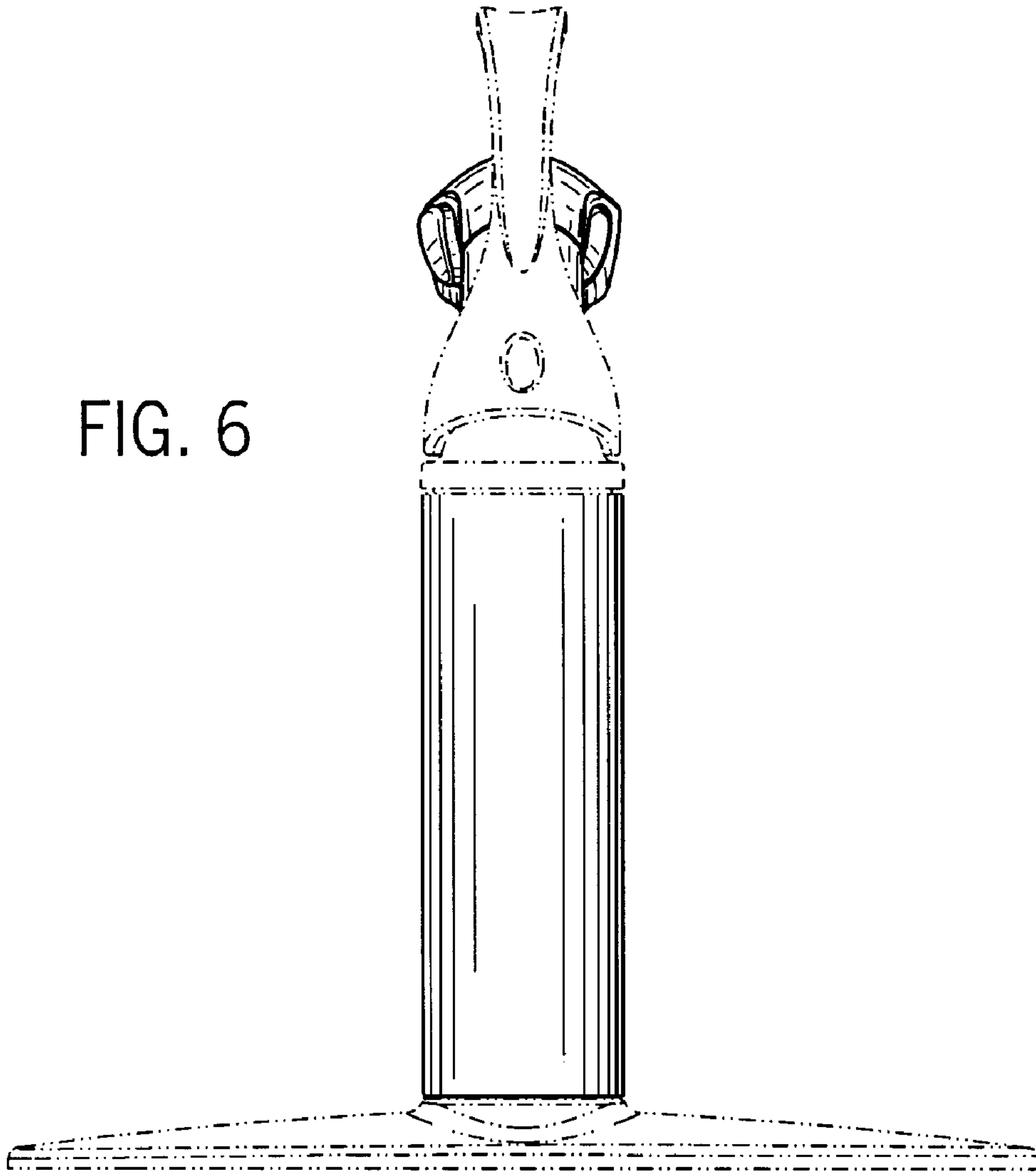
