FIG. 1 is a front, top side perspective view;

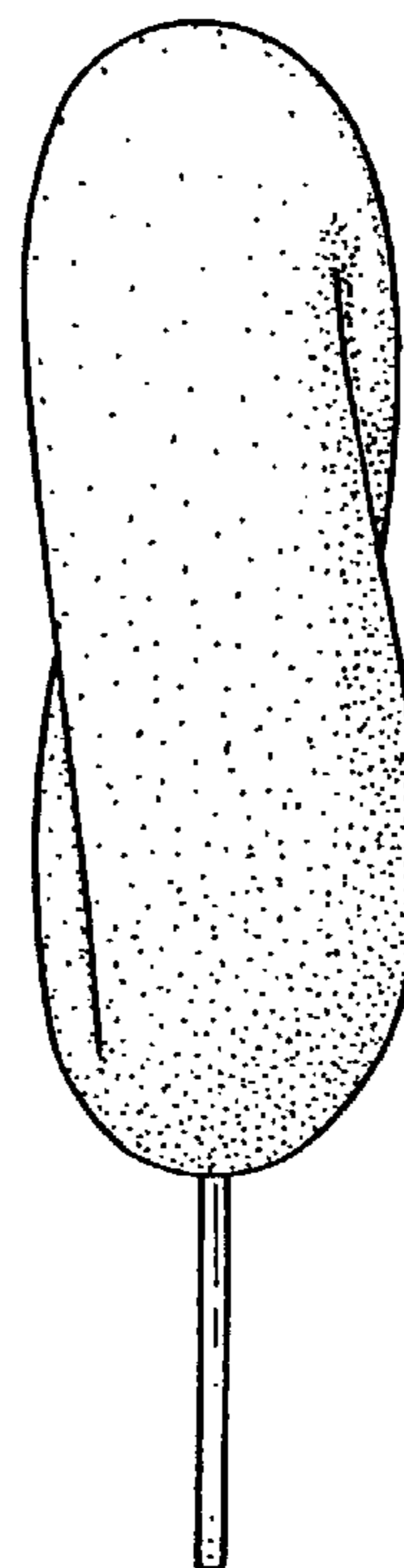
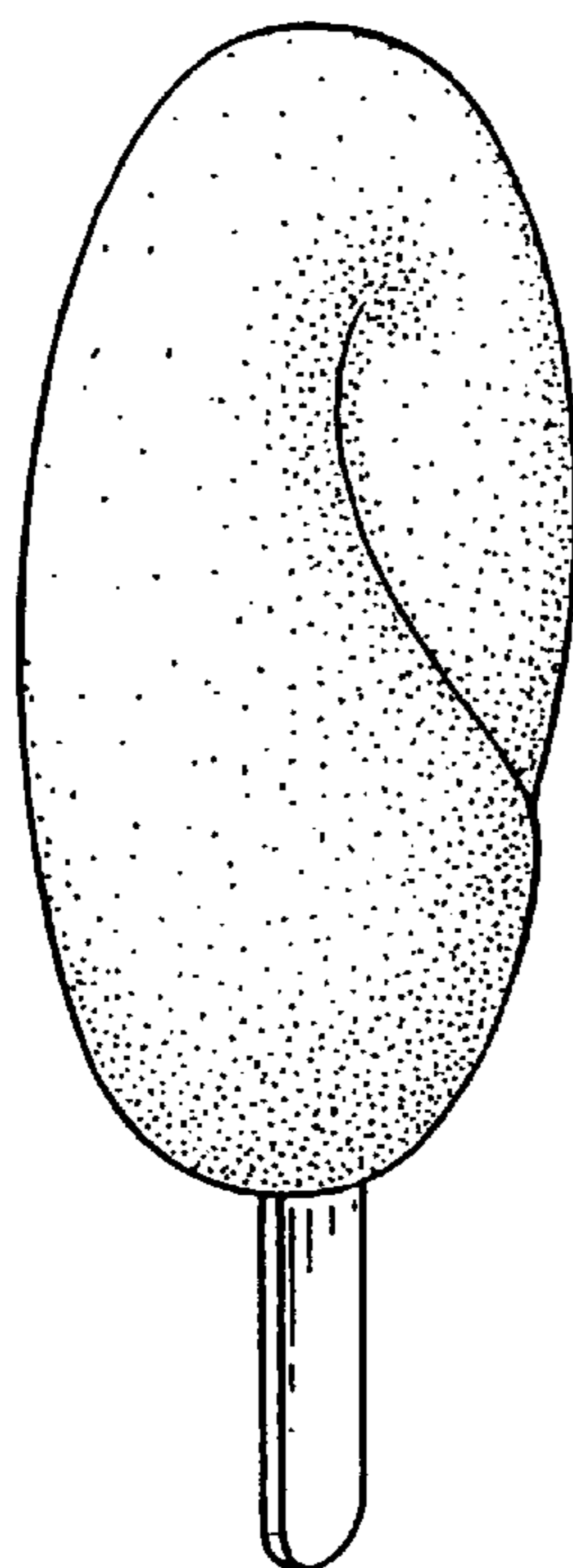
FIG. 2 is a front view;

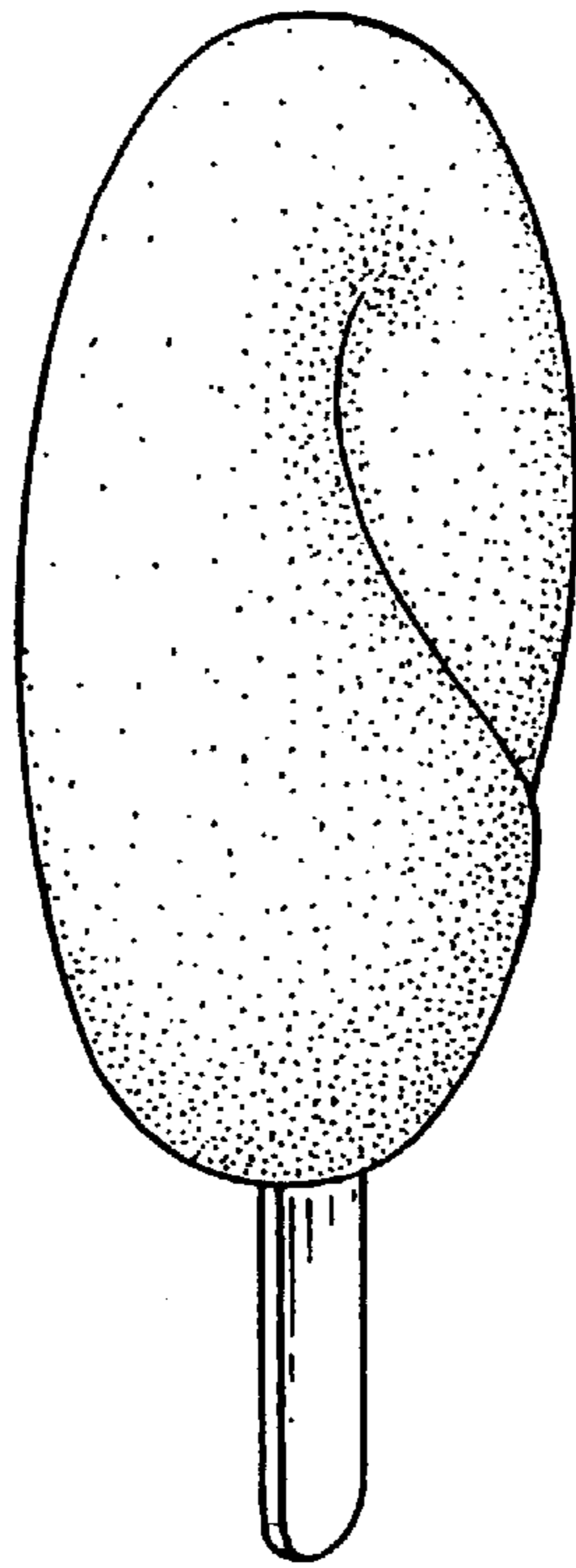

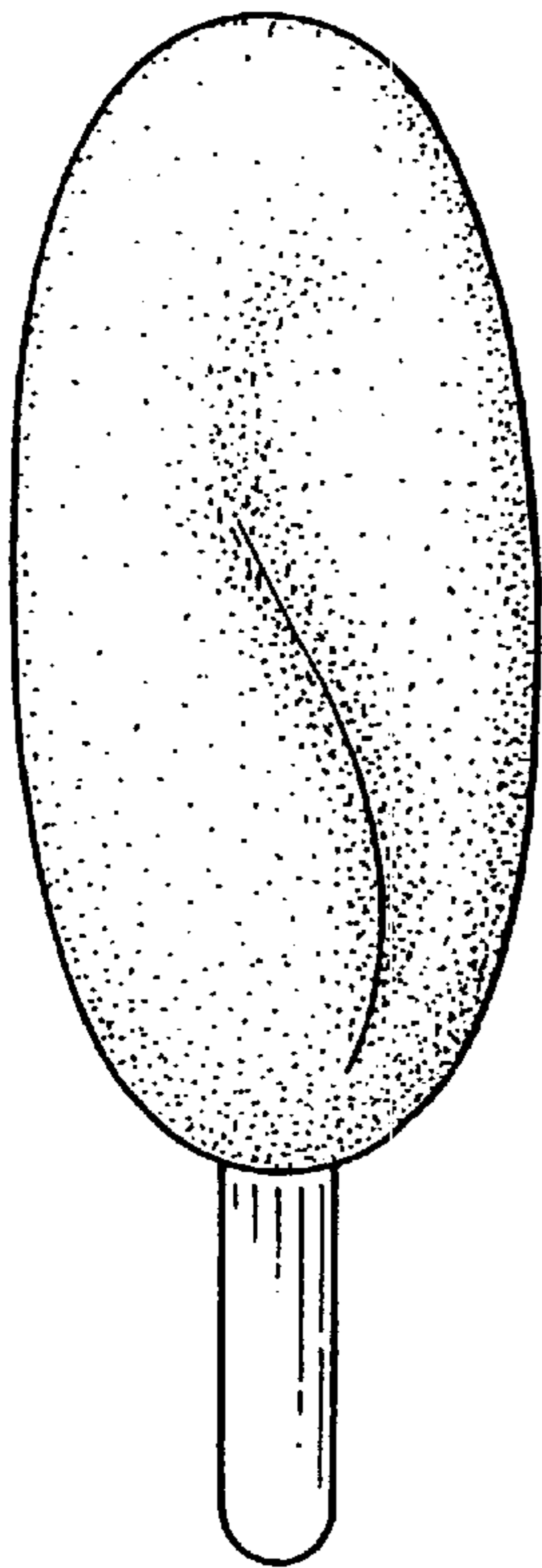

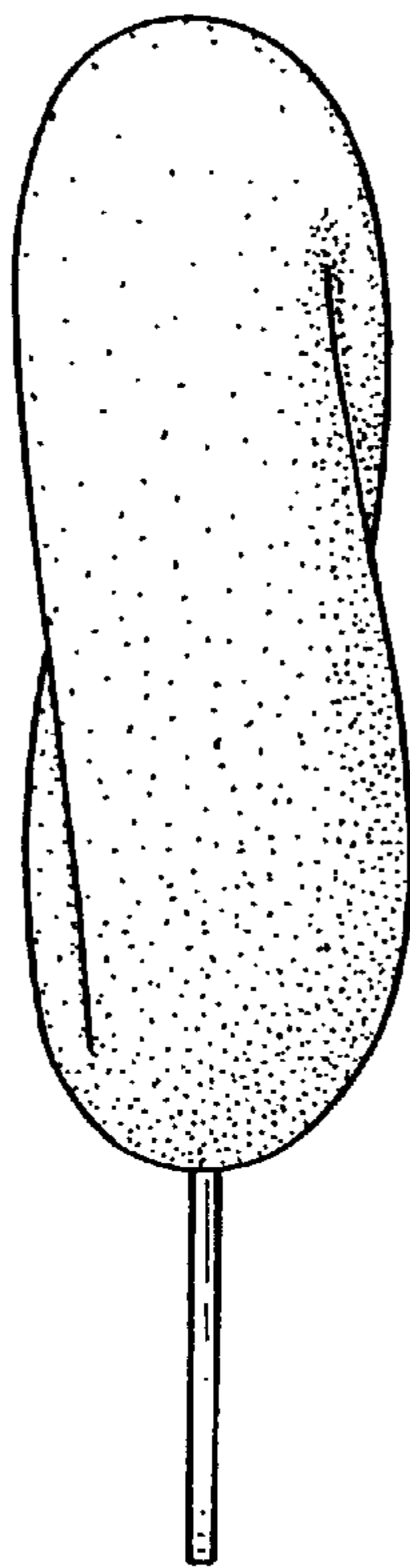

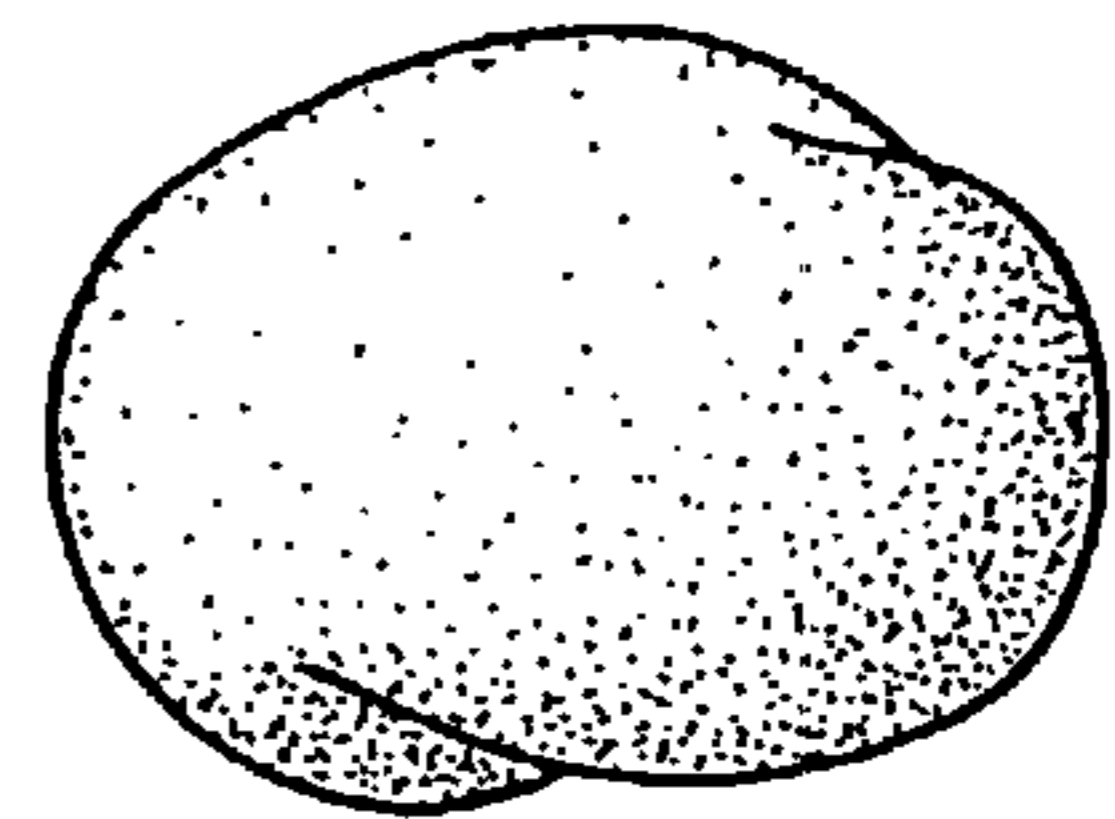

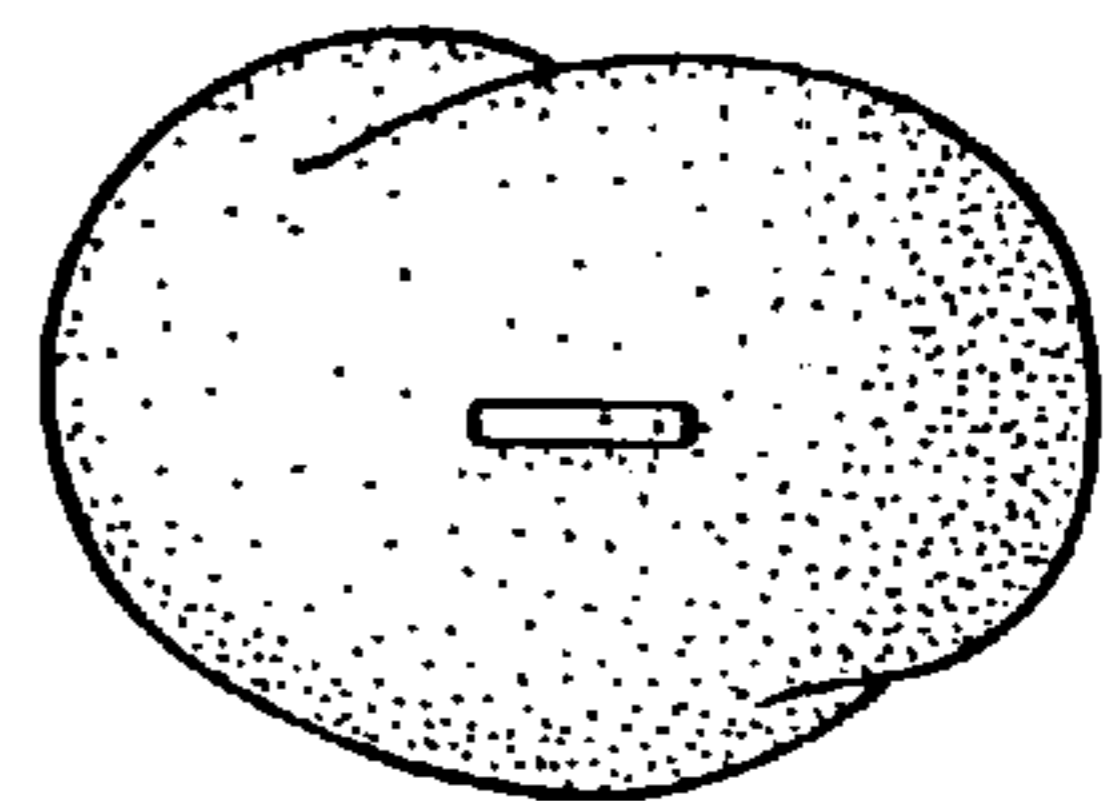
