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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined fork and spoon, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a combined fork and spoon, showing the spoon end thereof closest to the viewer in right-side-up configuration and the fork end thereof in upside-down configuration;

FIG. 2 is an isometric view showing the fork end thereof closest to the viewer in a right-side-up configuration and the spoon end thereof in upside-down configuration;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, the side elevational view of the opposite side thereof being a mirror image of FIG. 3;

FIG. 4 is a fork end elevational view;

FIG. 5 is spoon end elevational view;

FIG. 6 is another isometric view taken from the opposite end of FIG. 2;

FIG. 7 is another isometric view taken from the opposite end of FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a plan view taken from the top of FIG. 2;

FIG. 9 is a plan view taken from the top of FIG. 1;

FIG. 10 is an isometric view of the under side of a second embodiment of the combined fork and spoon, showing the spoon end thereof closest to the viewer, with both the spoon and fork ends thereof in right-side-up configuration;

FIG. 11 is an isometric view of the top side of the second embodiment;

FIG. 12 is a side elevational view of the second embodiment;

FIG. 13 is a fork end elevational view of the second embodiment;

FIG. 14 is spoon end elevational view of the second embodiment;

FIG. 15 is another isometric view taken from the opposite end of FIG. 11;

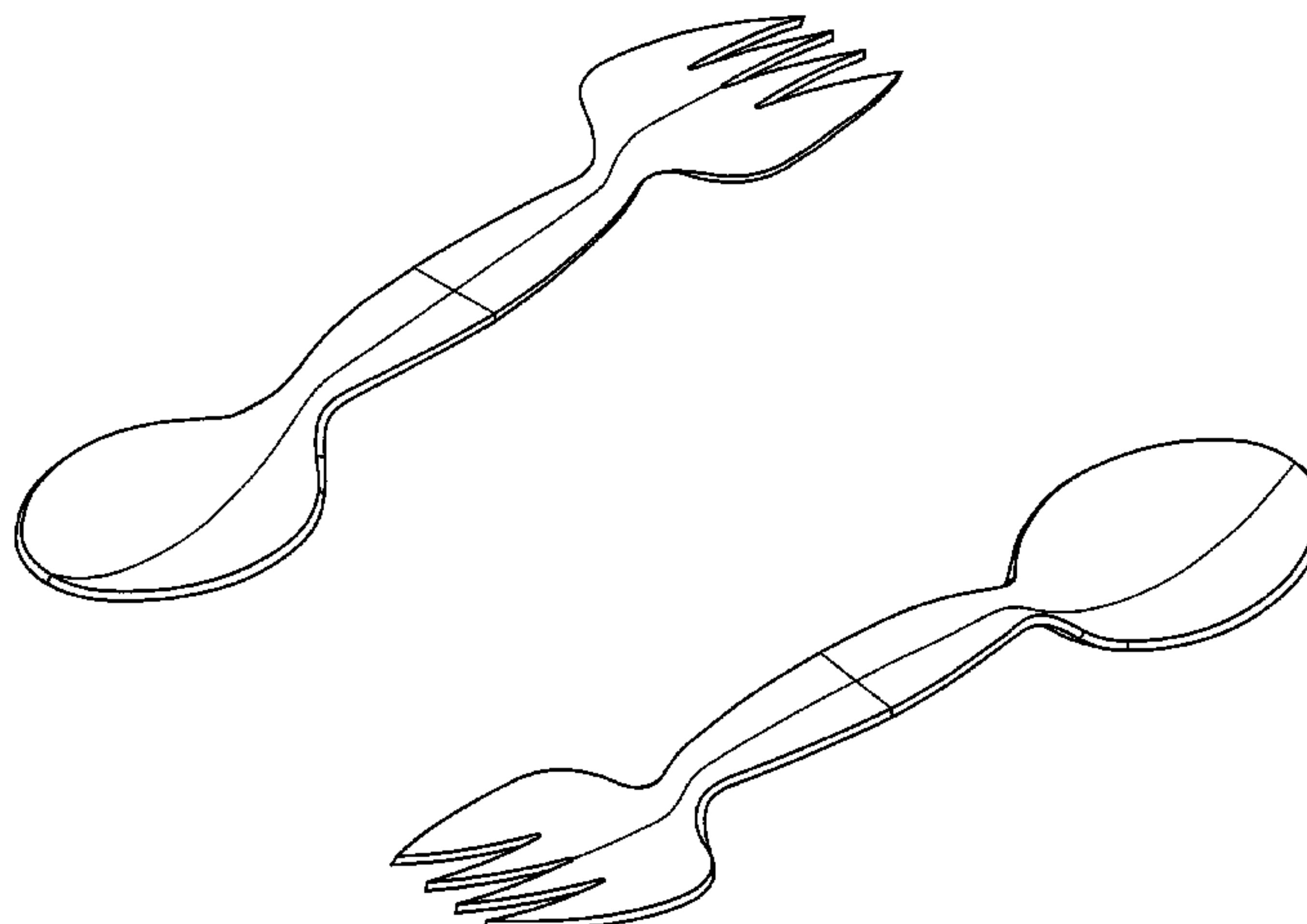
FIG. 16 is another isometric view taken from the opposite end of FIG. 10;

FIG. 17 is a top plan view of the second embodiment; and,

FIG. 18 is a bottom plan view of the second embodiment.

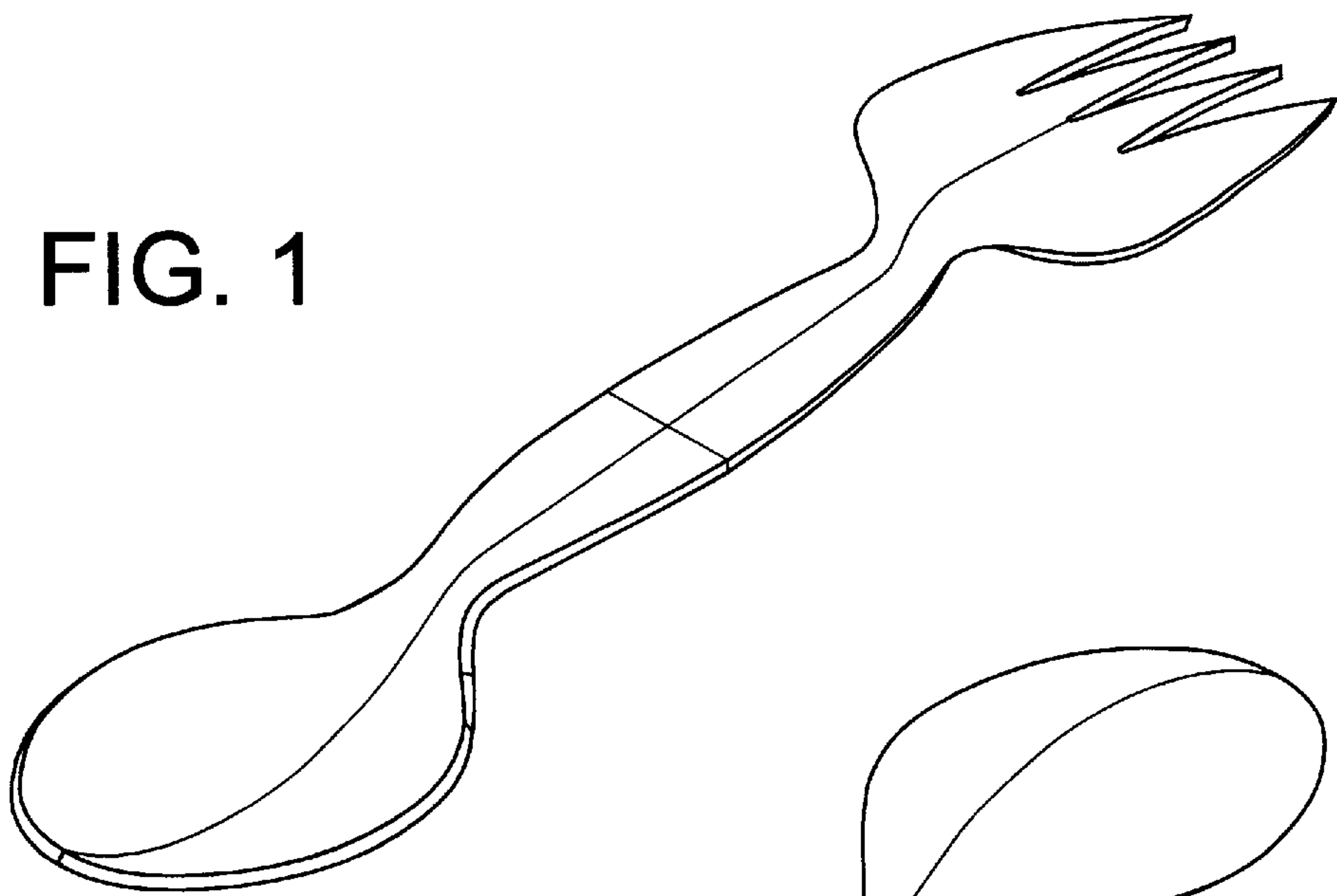

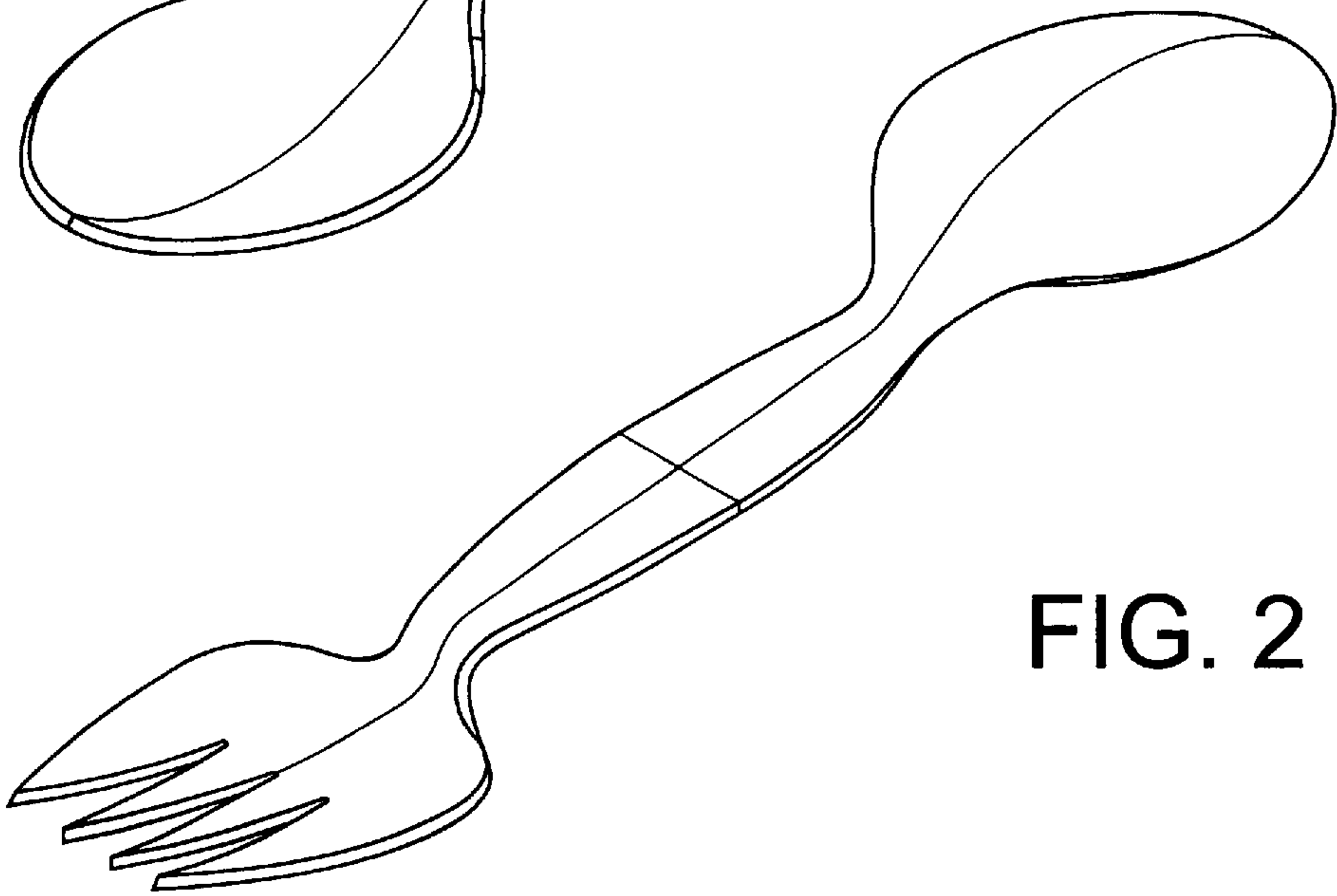

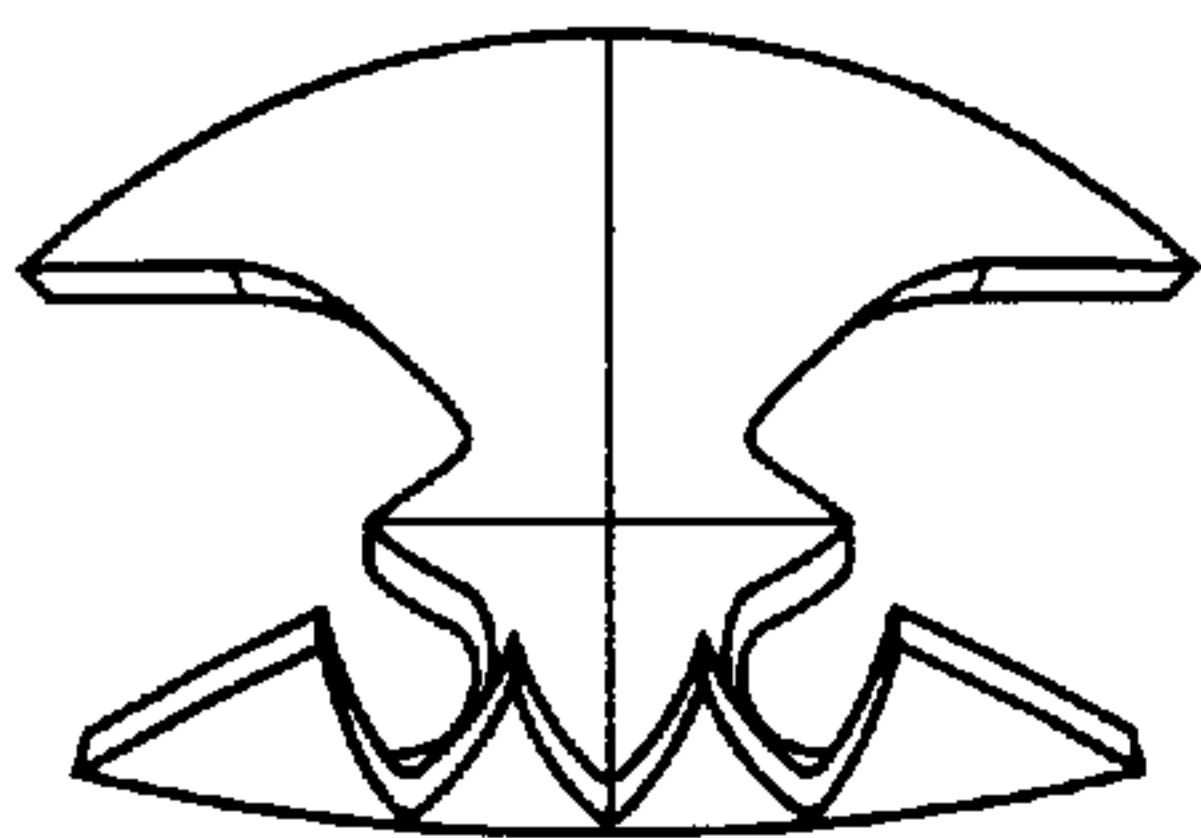
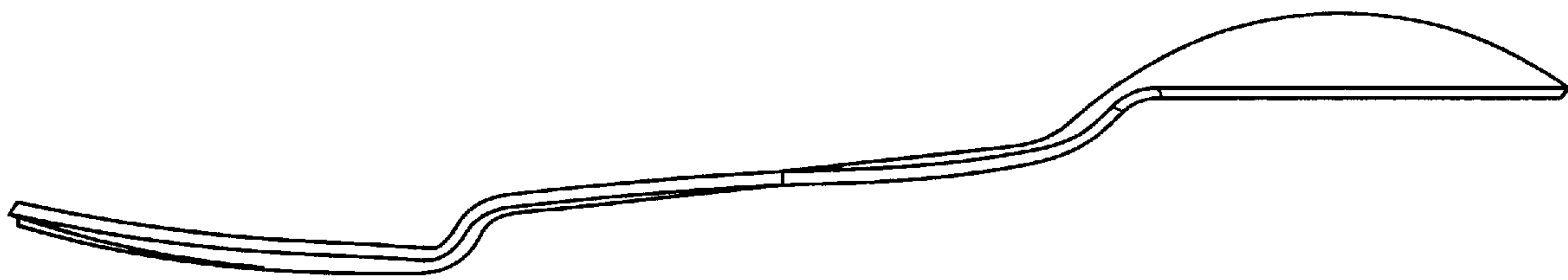

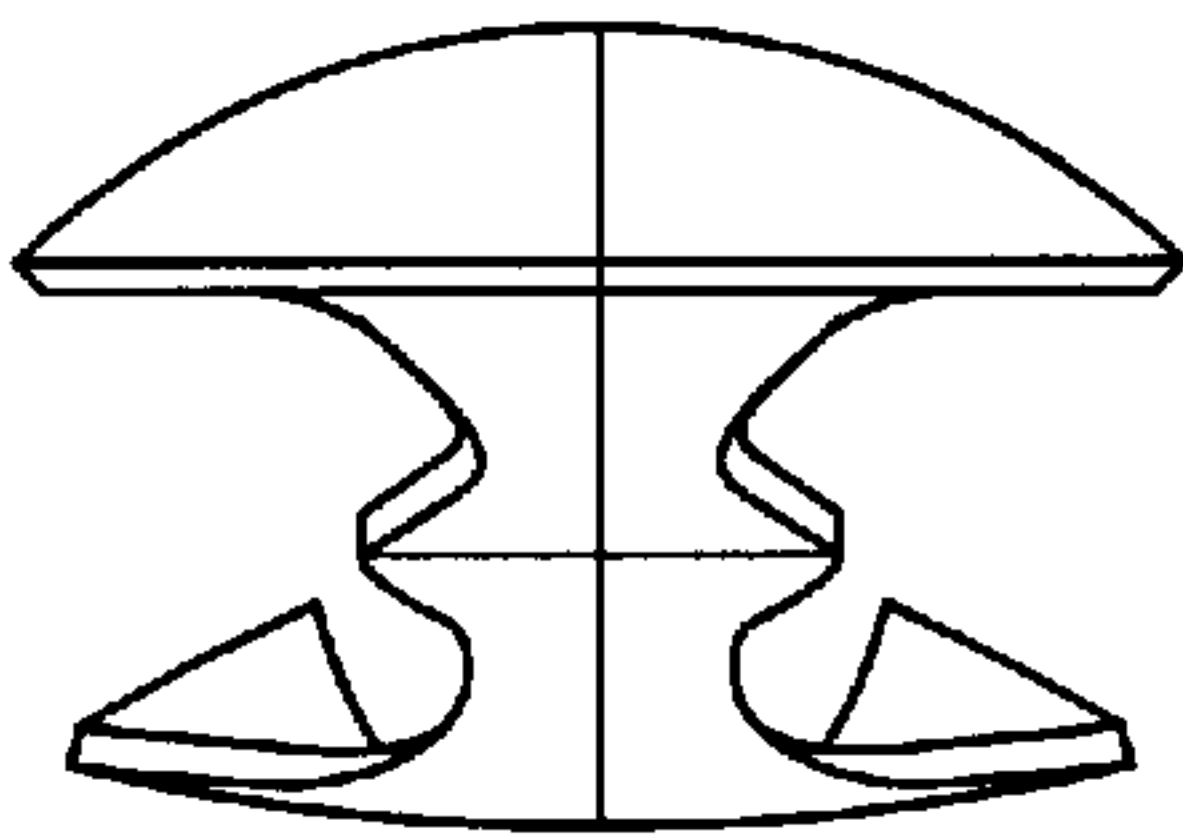

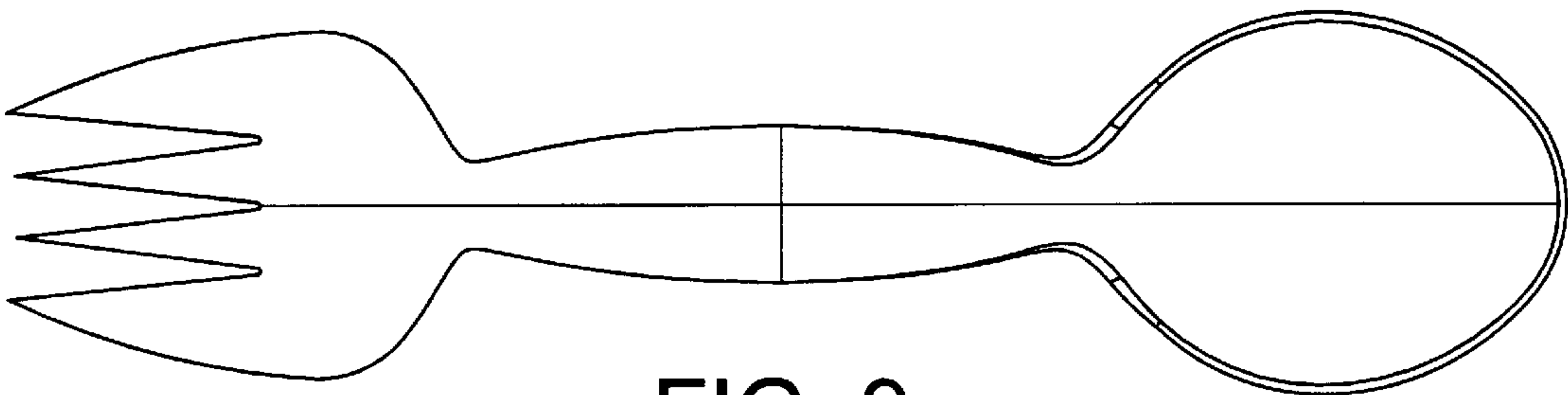
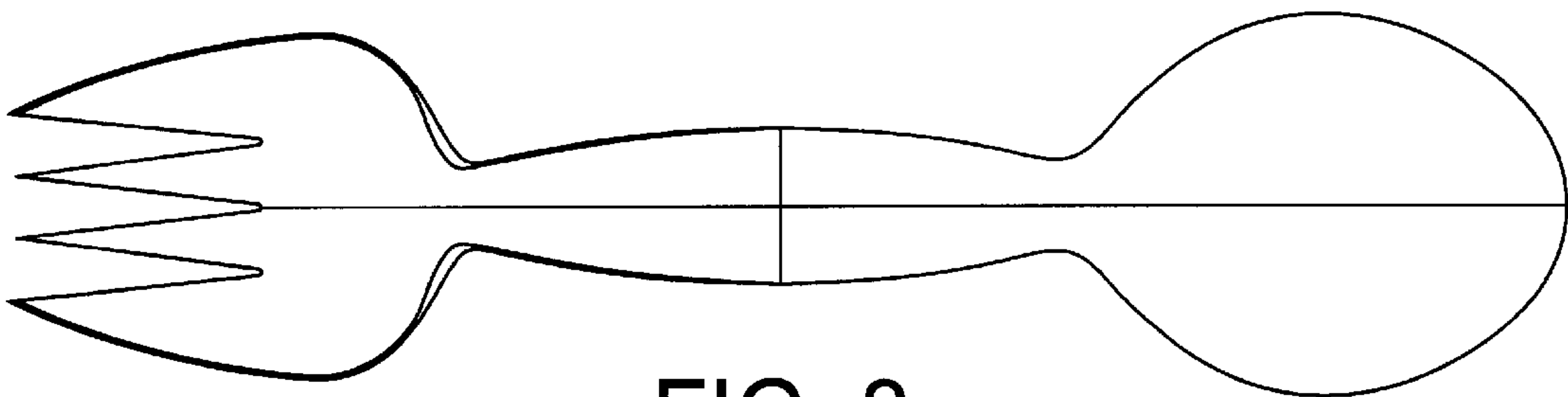
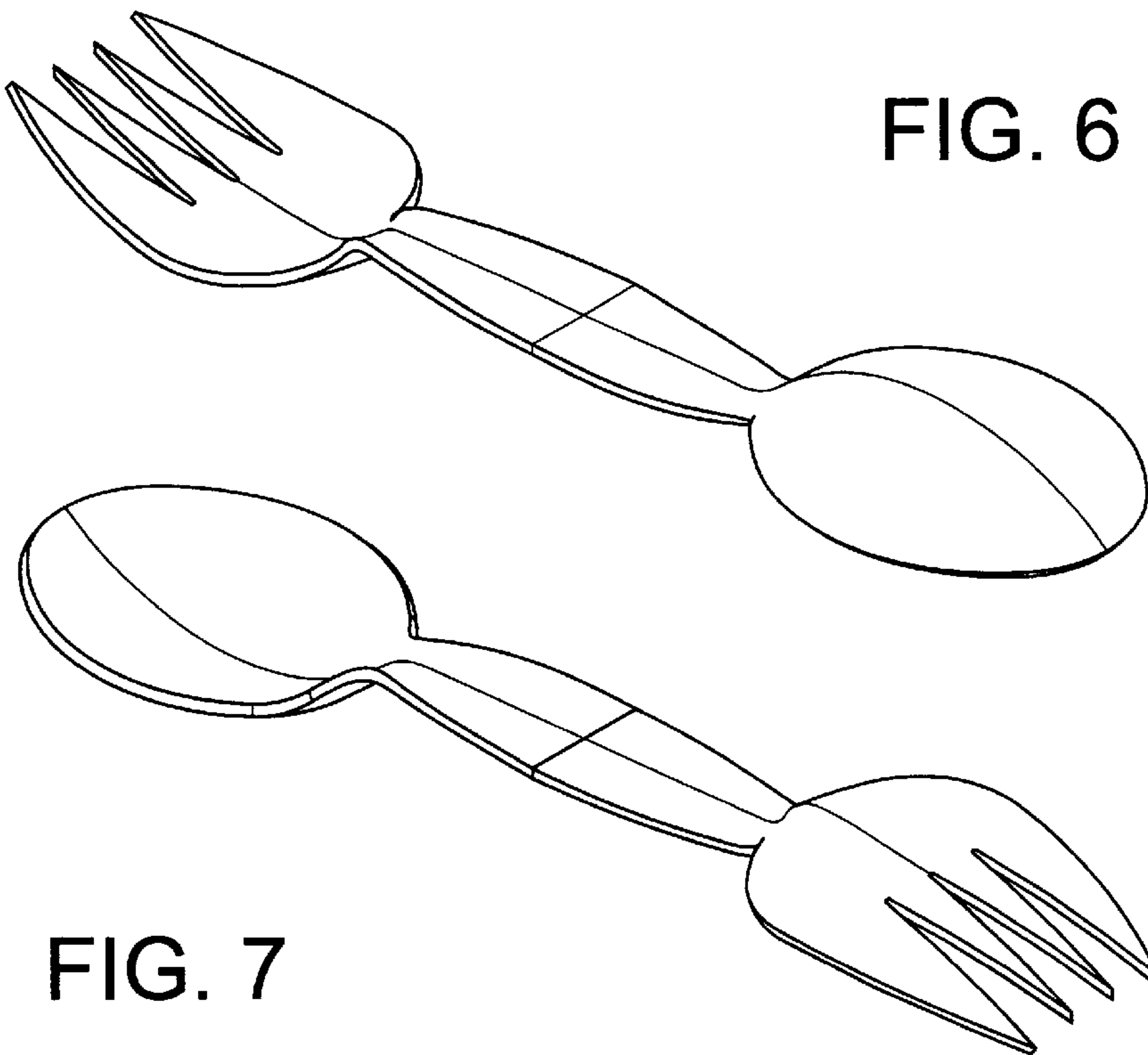

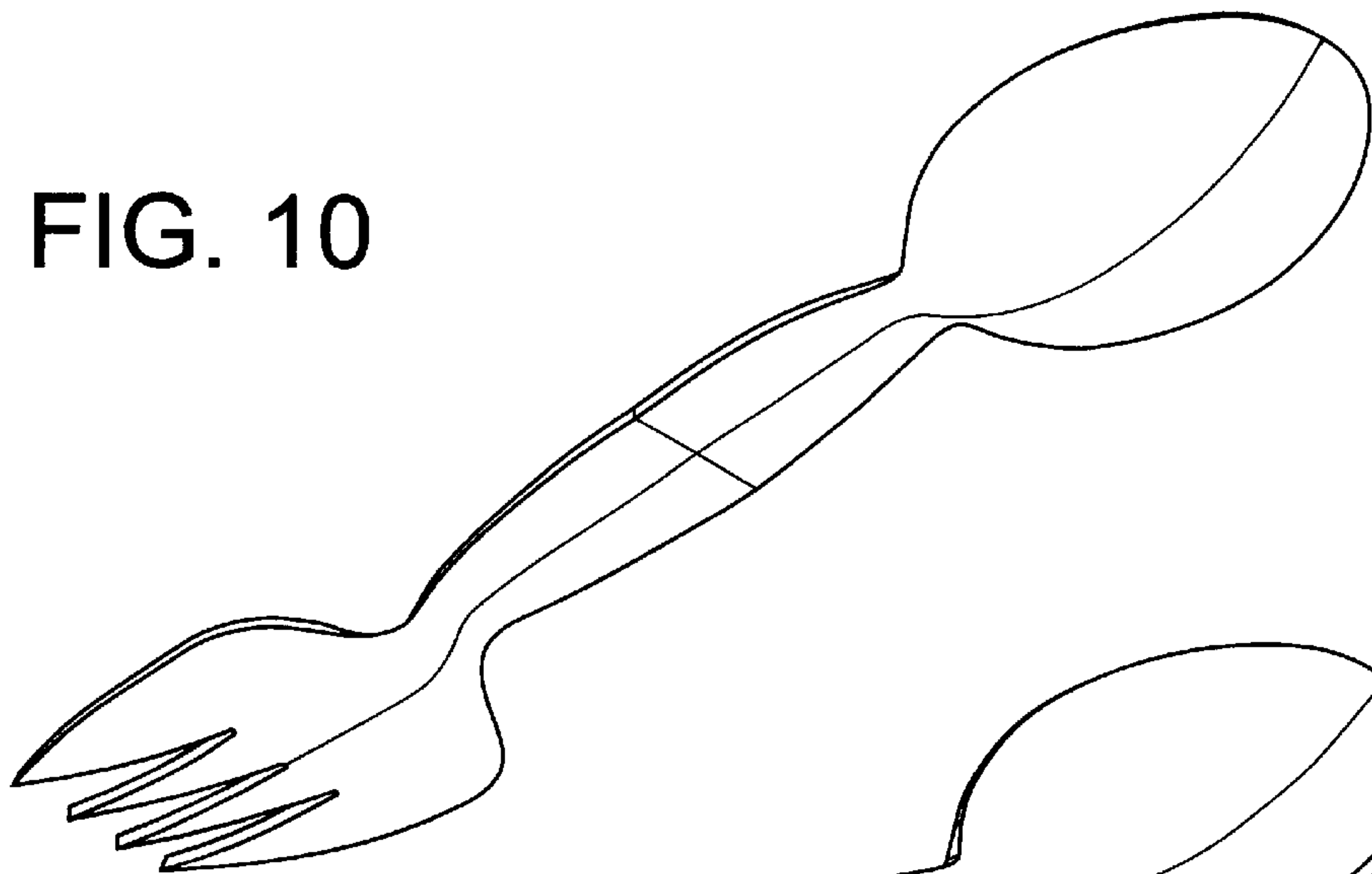

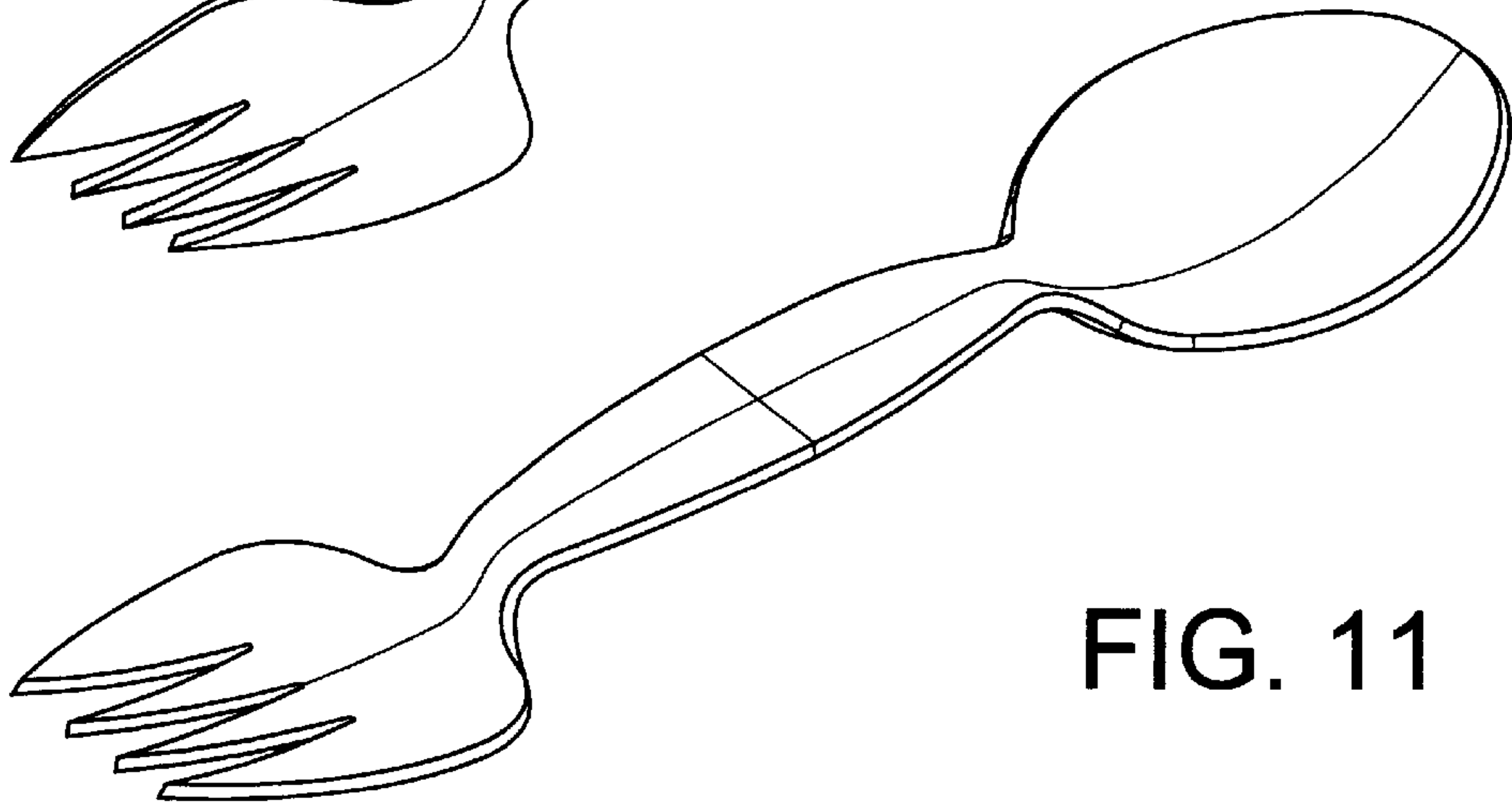

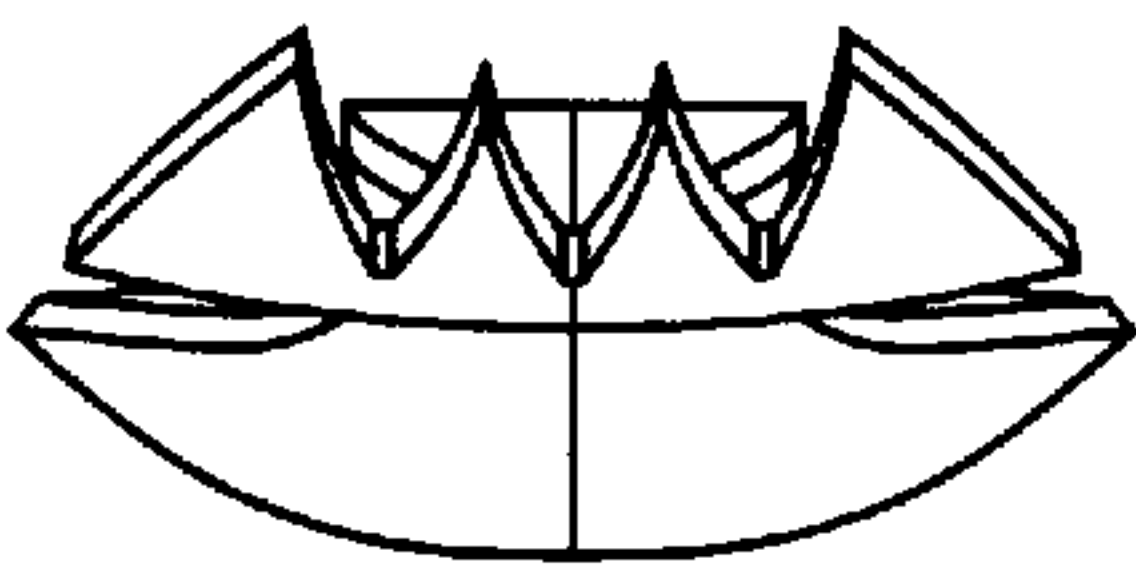
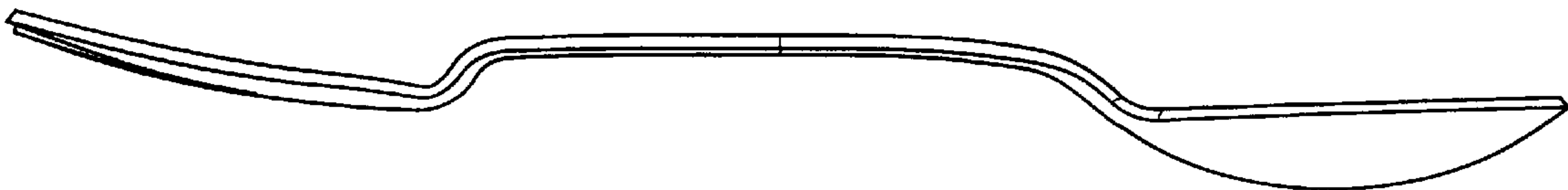

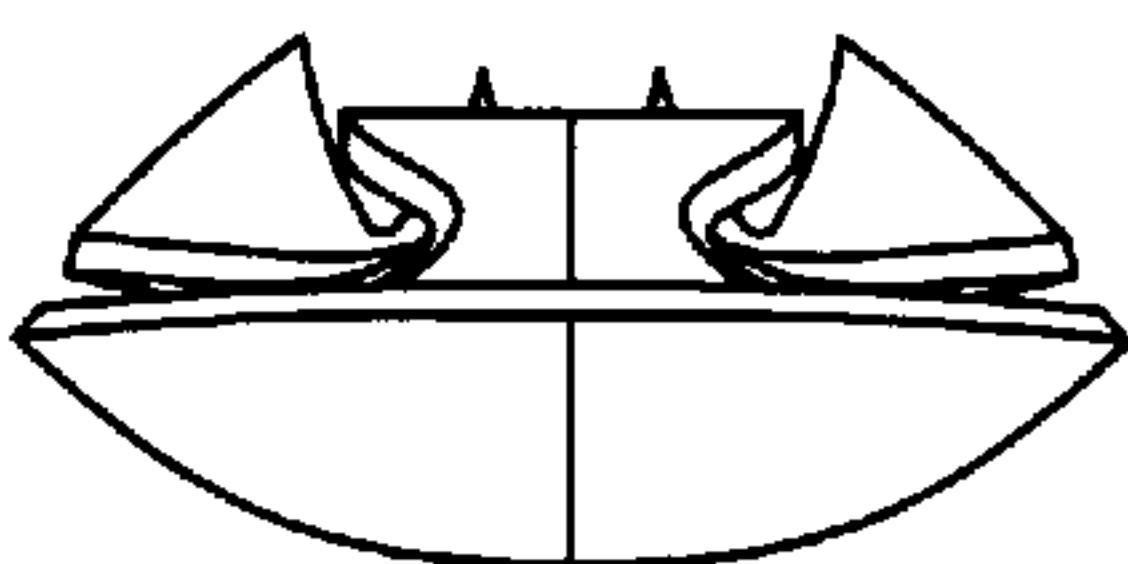

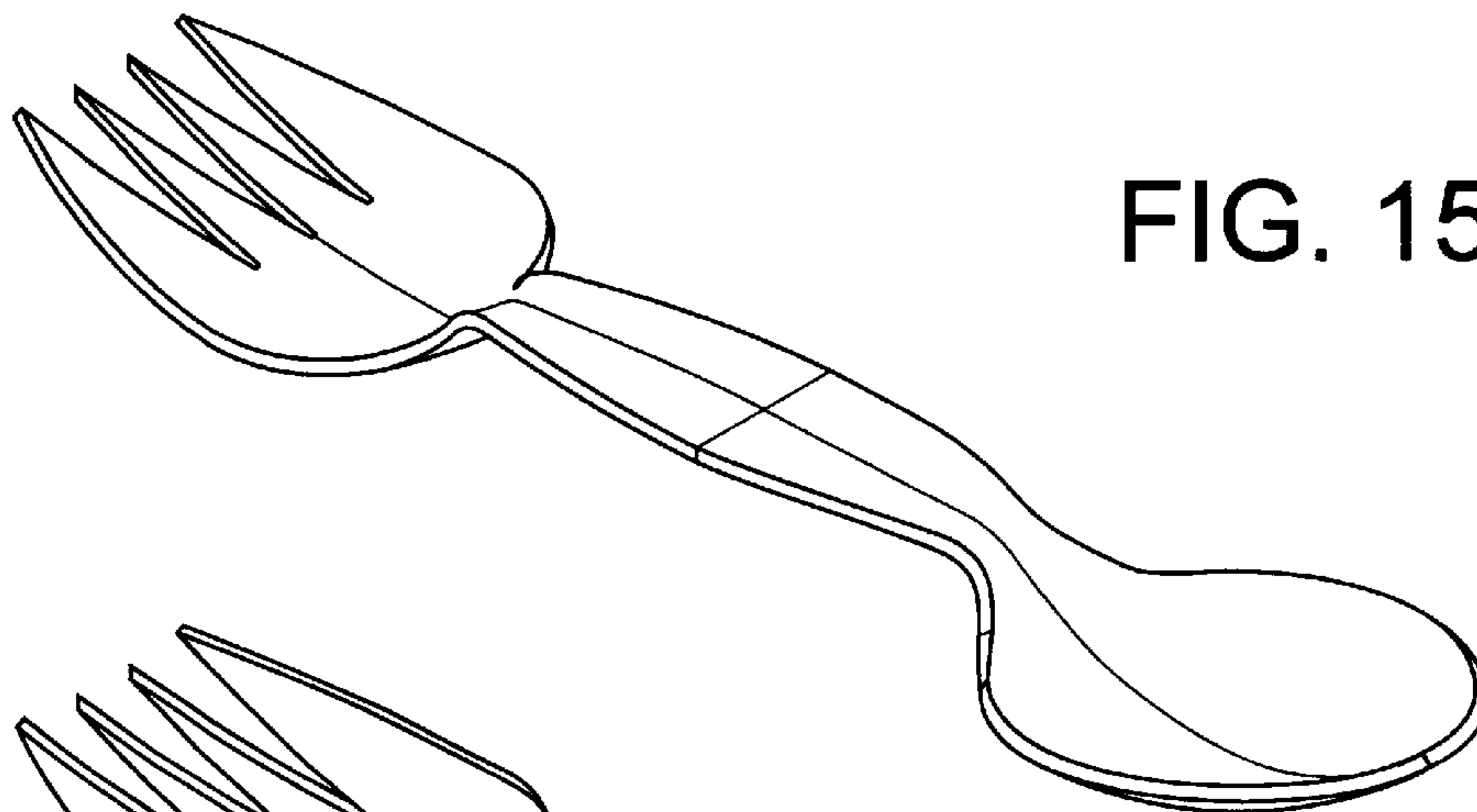

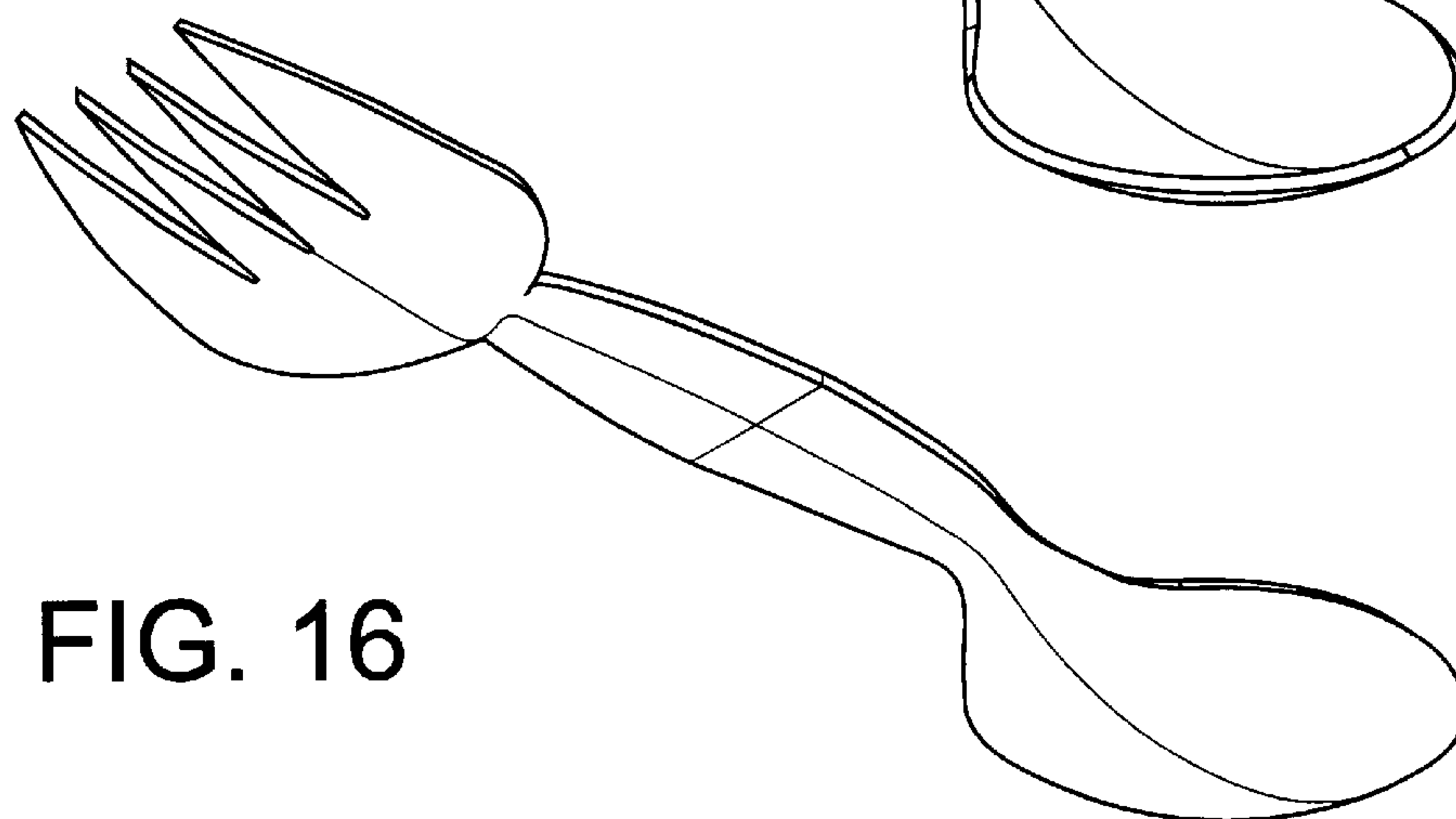

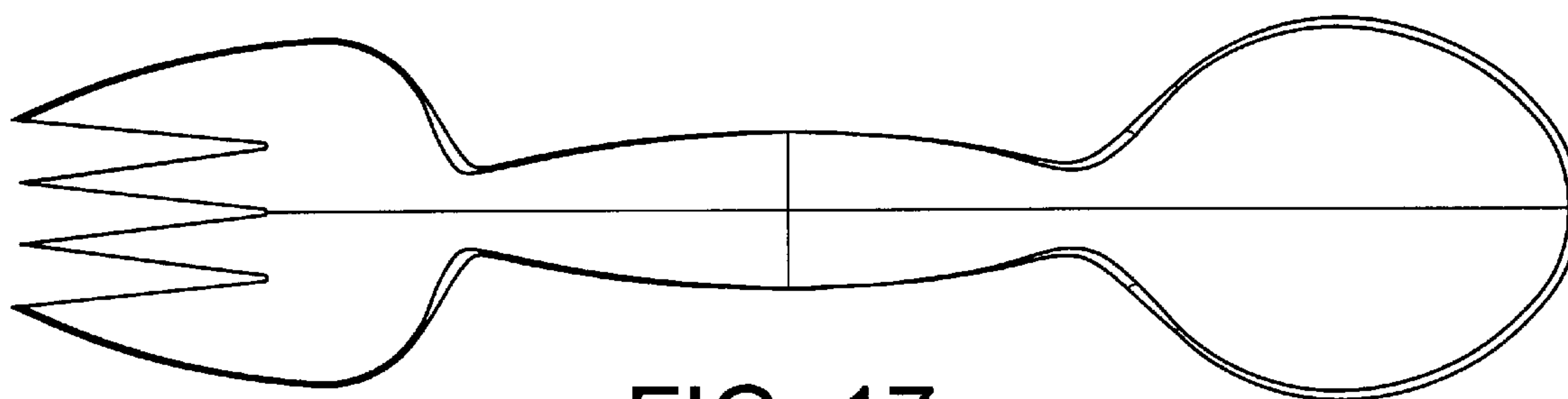

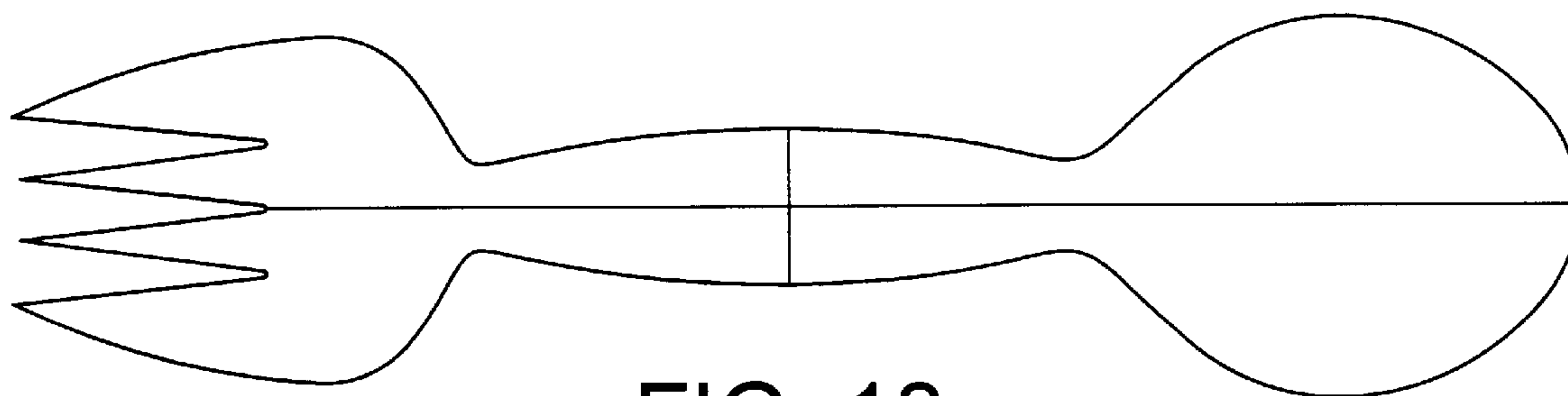
