#### (57)**CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a combined jewelry component and a cap, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

Cross reference to other related design Patent Applications: Another design patent application 29/255,392 also filed on Mar. 6, 2006 entitled: "Screw for Jewelry Components".

FIG. 1 is an exploded perspective view of the combined jewelry component and a cap, with the cap removed; according to the present invention;

FIG. 2 is an exploded perspective view having a combined jewelry component and a cap, with the cap attached; according to the present invention;

FIG. 3 is the front view of the combined jewelry component and a cap, with the cap removed, the rear view is identical to the front view;

FIG. 4 is the right side view of the combined jewelry component and a cap, with the cap removed, the left view is identical to the right view.

FIG. 5 is the bottom view of the jewelry component and the bottom view of the cap, with the cap is removed from the jewelry component;

FIG. 6 is the top view of the jewelry component and and the top view of the cap, with the cap removed from the jewelry component;


FIG. 7 is the front view of the combined jewelry component and a cap, with the cap attached, the rear view is identical to the front view;


FIG. 8 is the right side view of the combined jewelry component and a cap, with the cap attached; the left view is identical to the right view;

FIG. 9 is the bottom view of the combined jewelry component and a cap, with the cap attached; and,

FIG. 10 is the top view of the combined jewelry component and a cap, with the cap attached.







