The ornamental design for a garment with shoulder protector, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a garment with shoulder protector, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

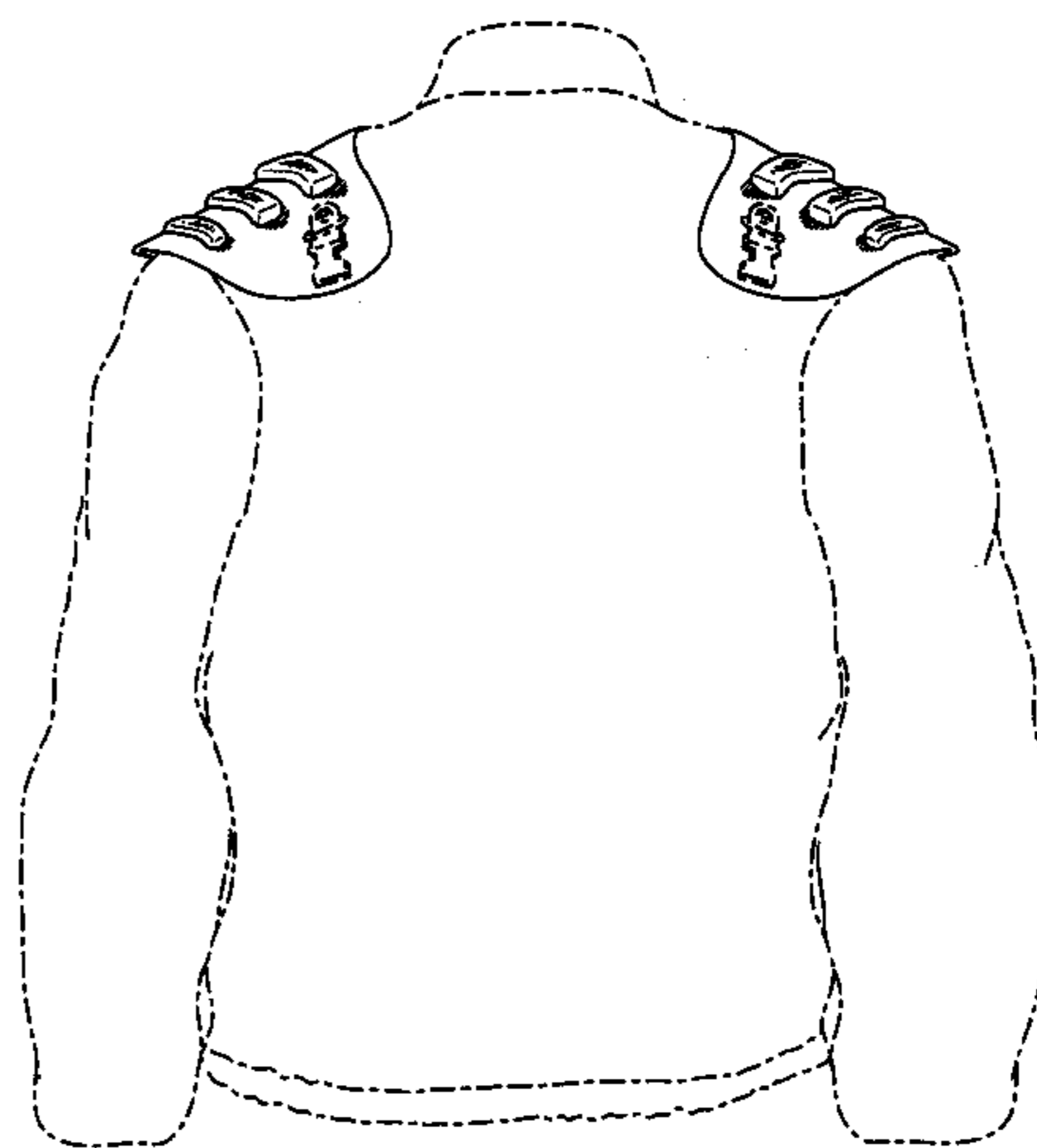
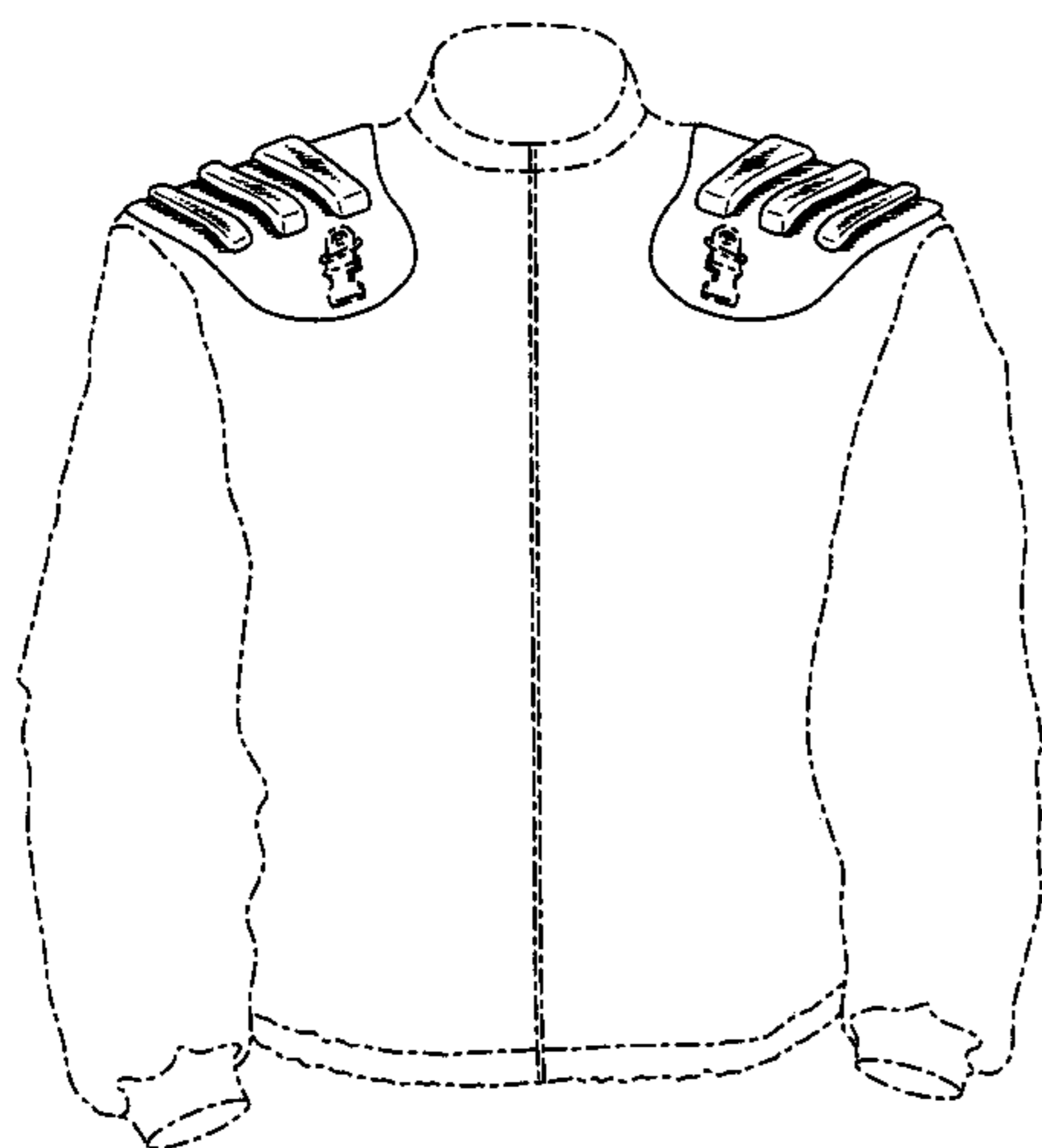
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof;

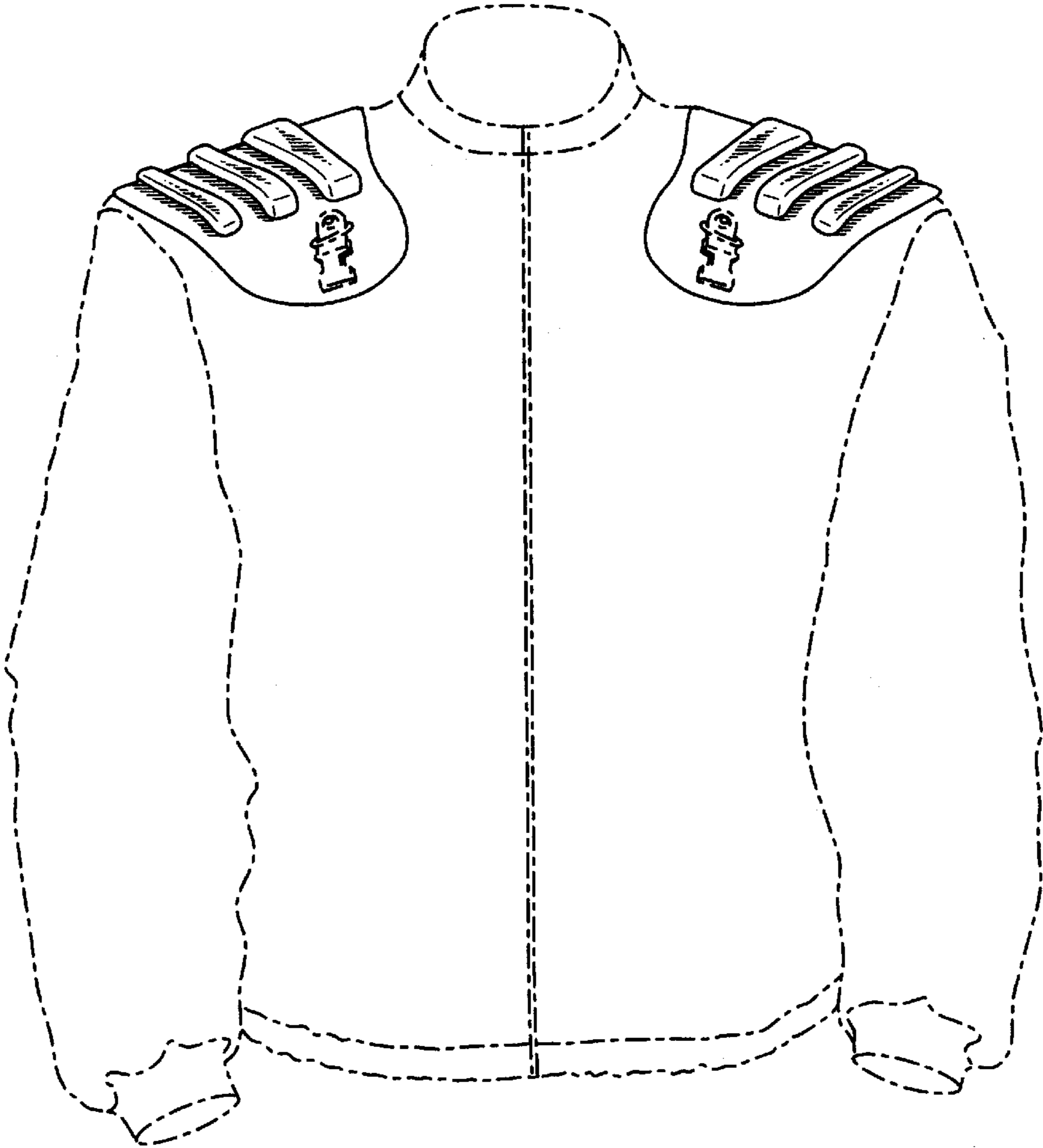

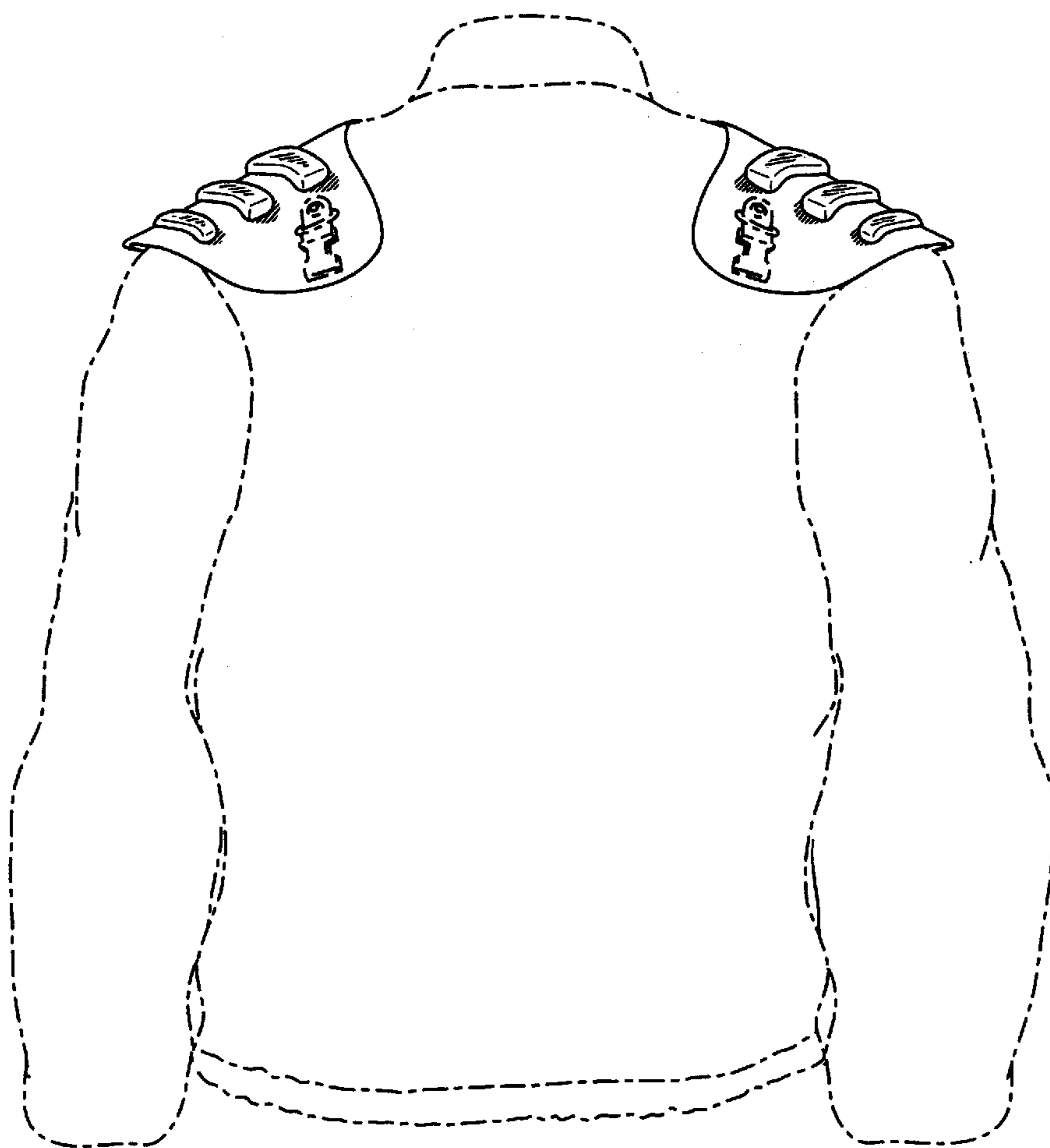

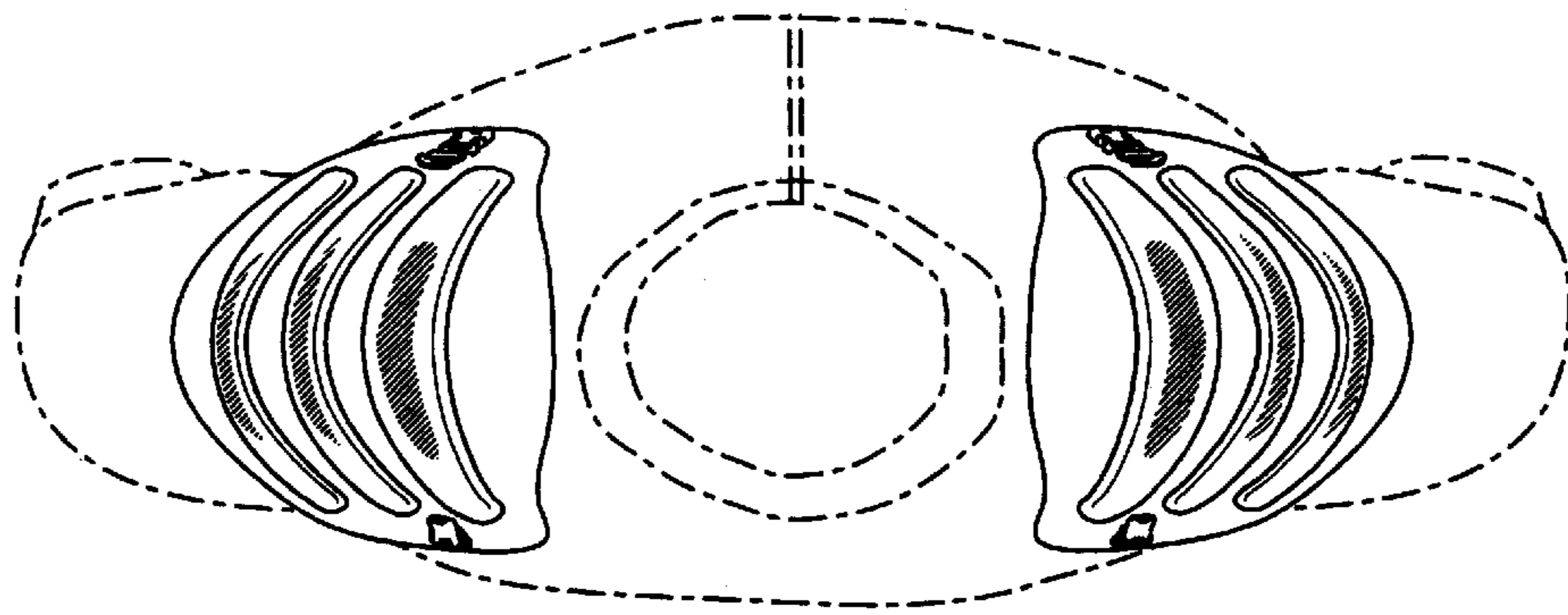

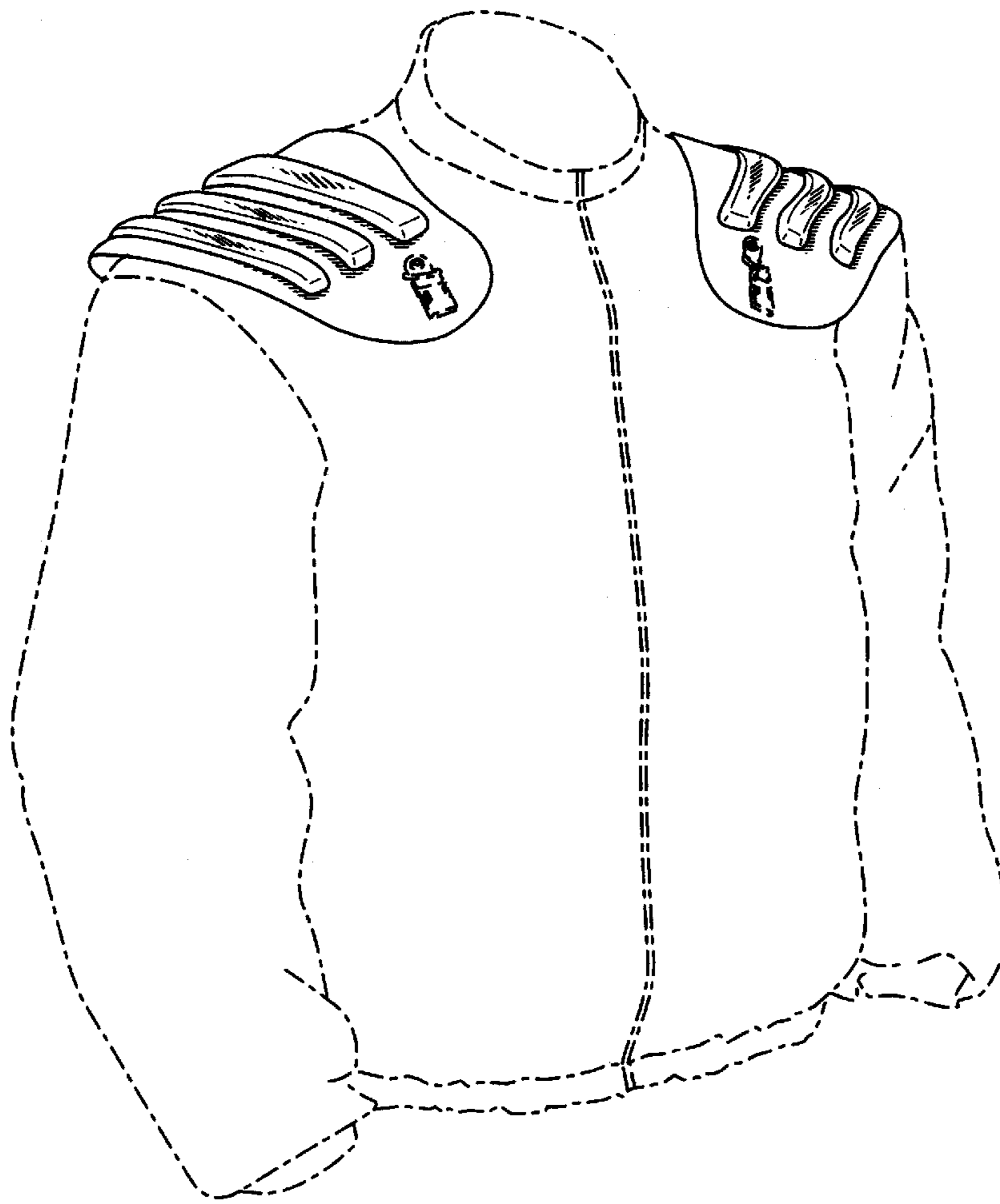
