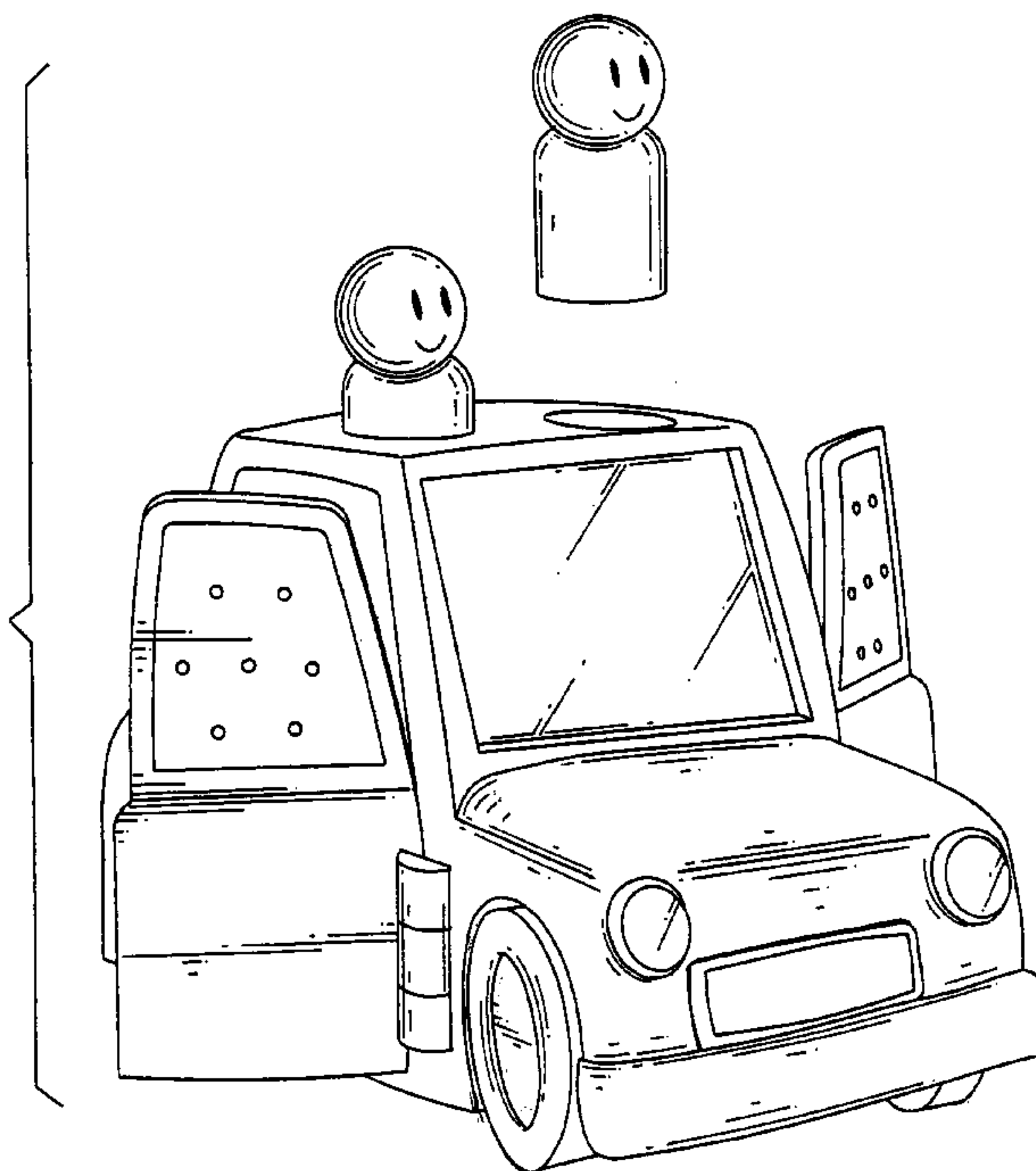
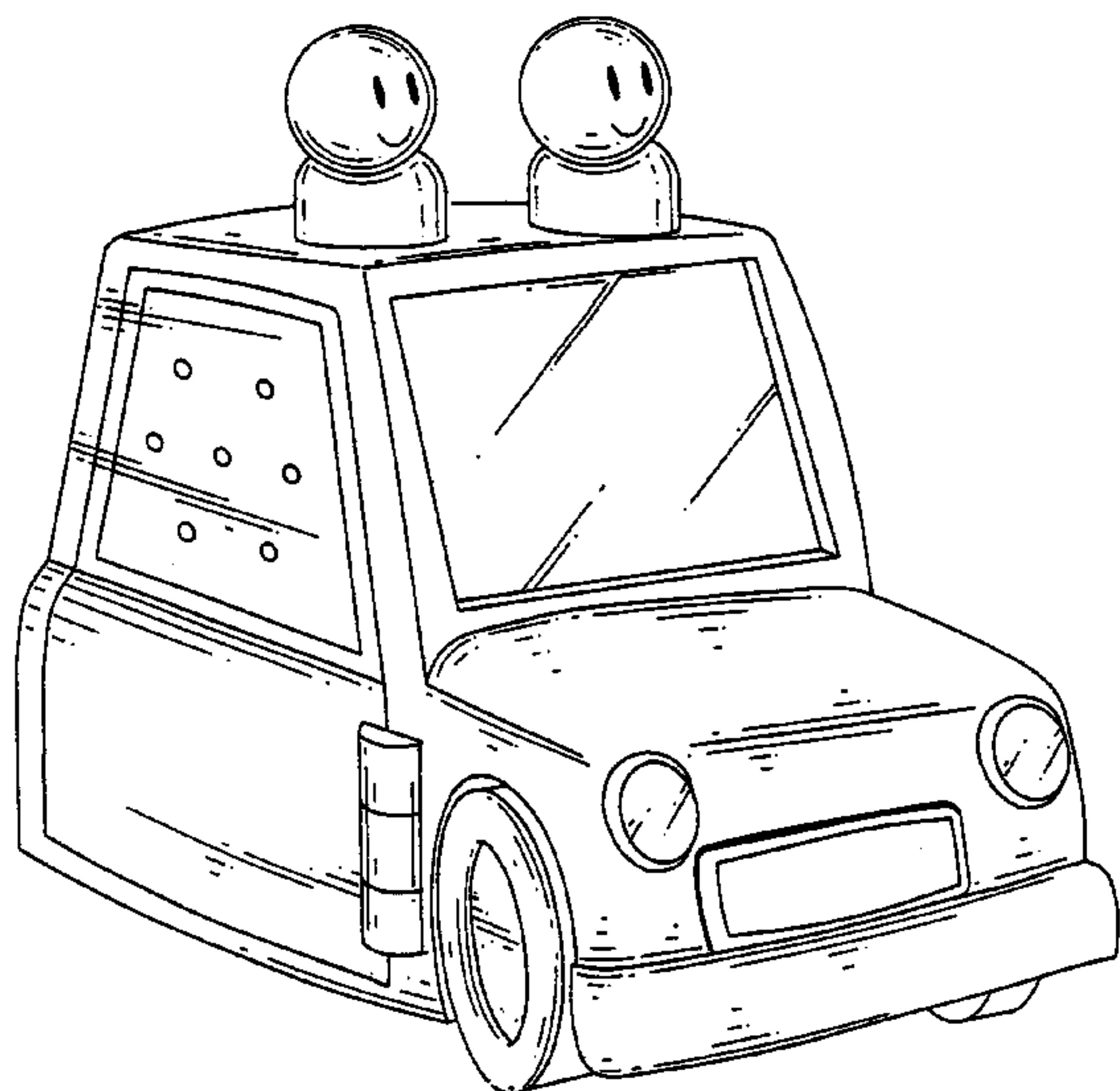
FIG. 7 is an exploded perspective view thereof, wherein a doll is separated from the body of the television set.

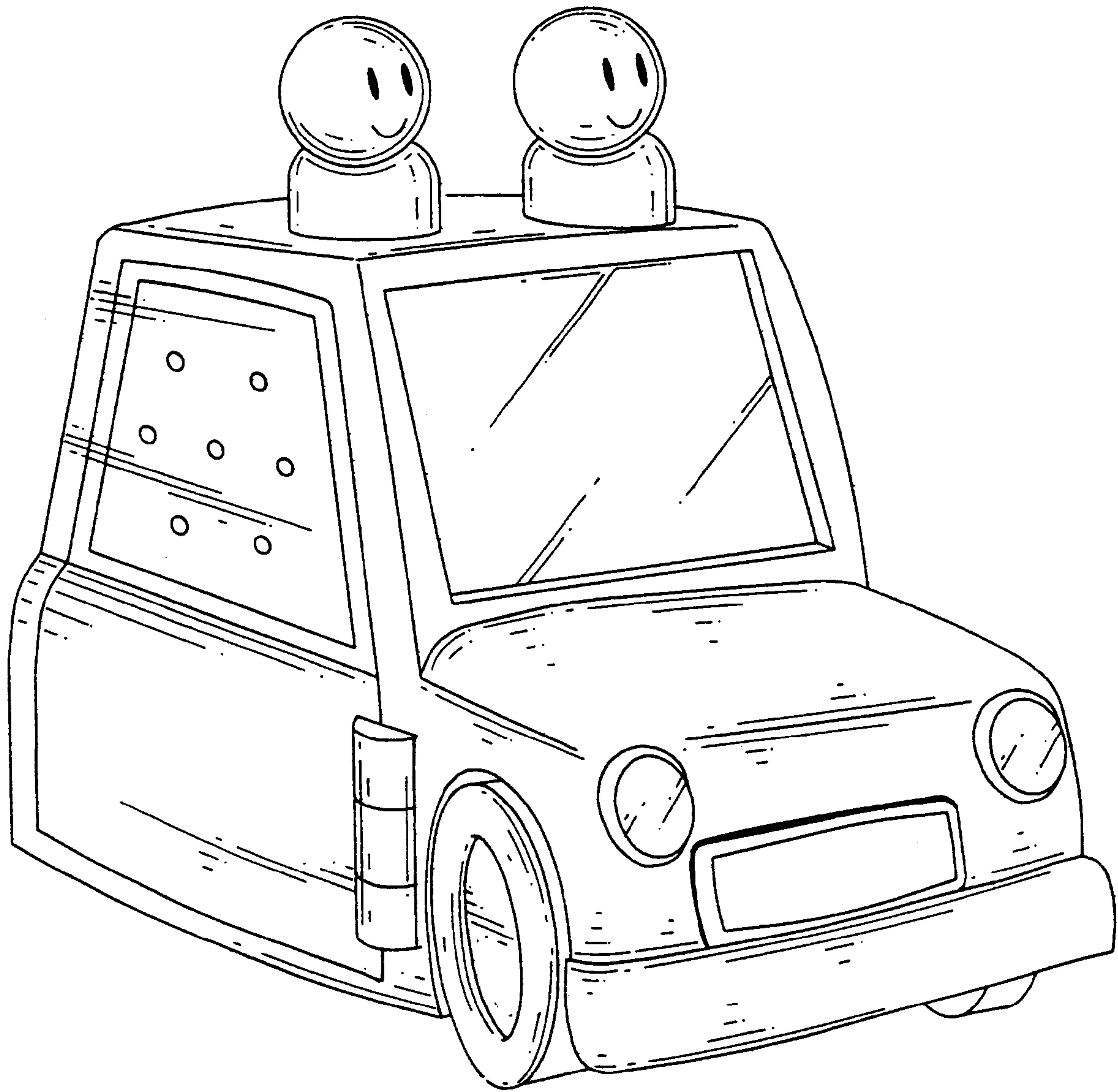

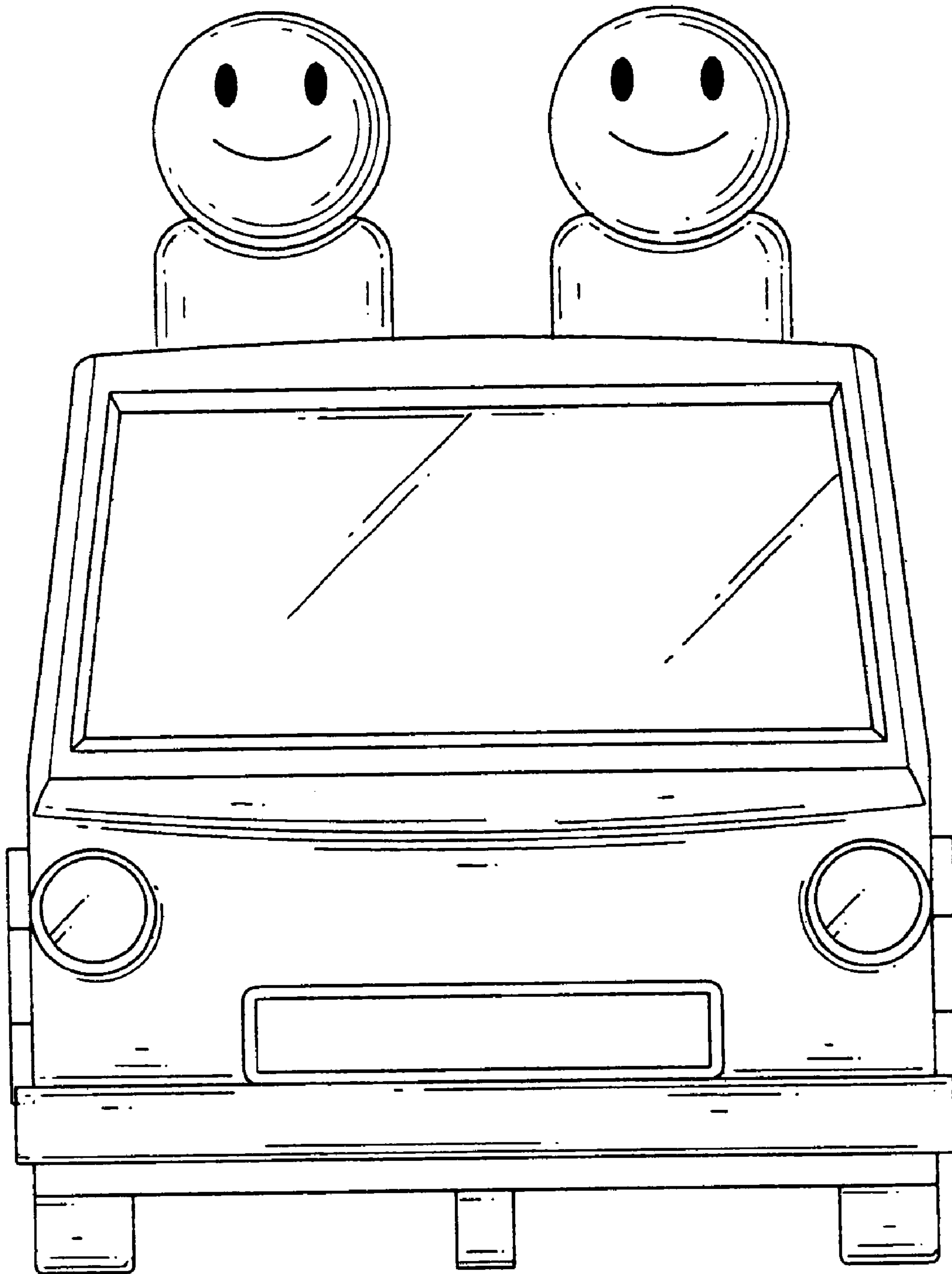

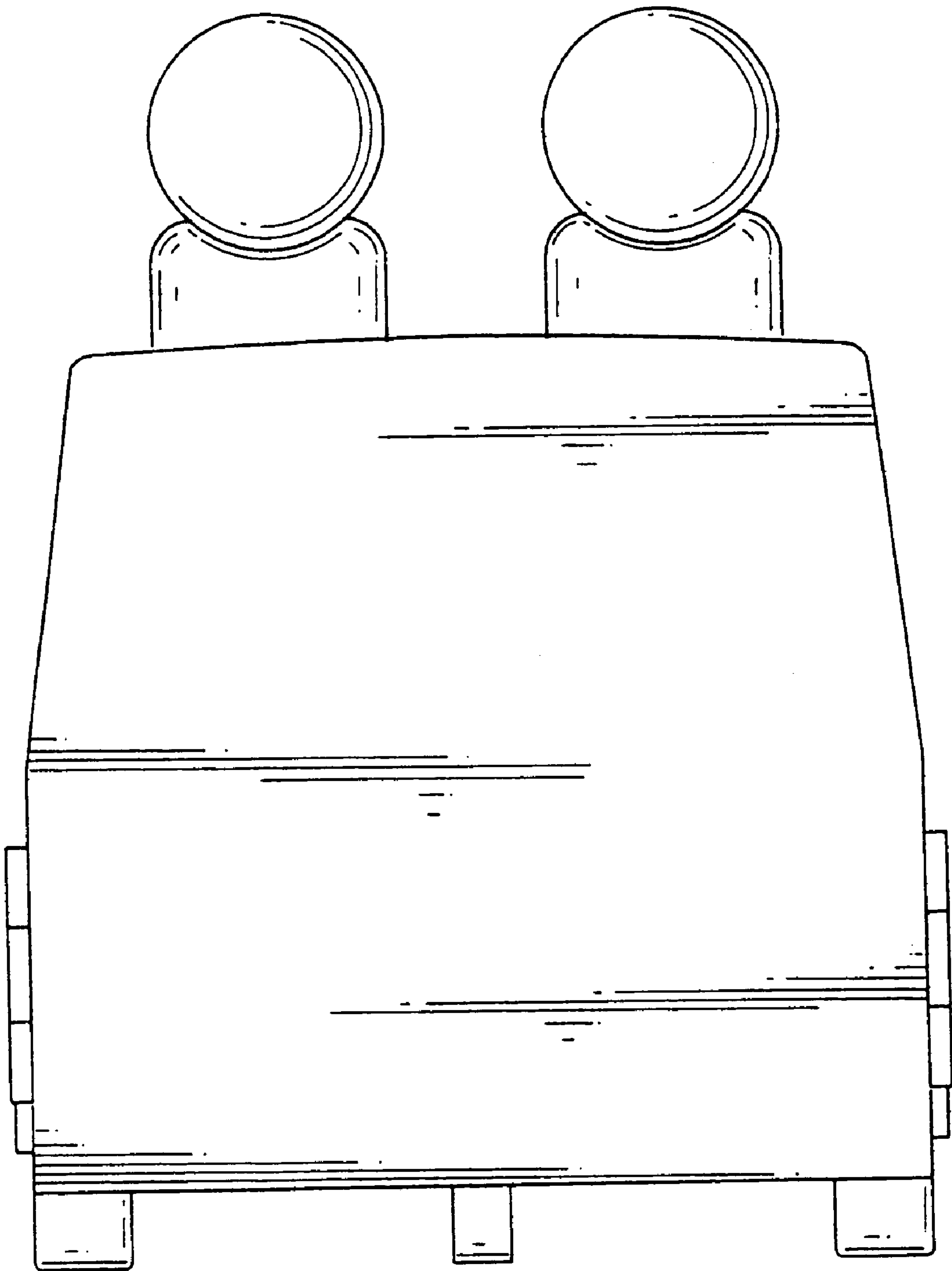

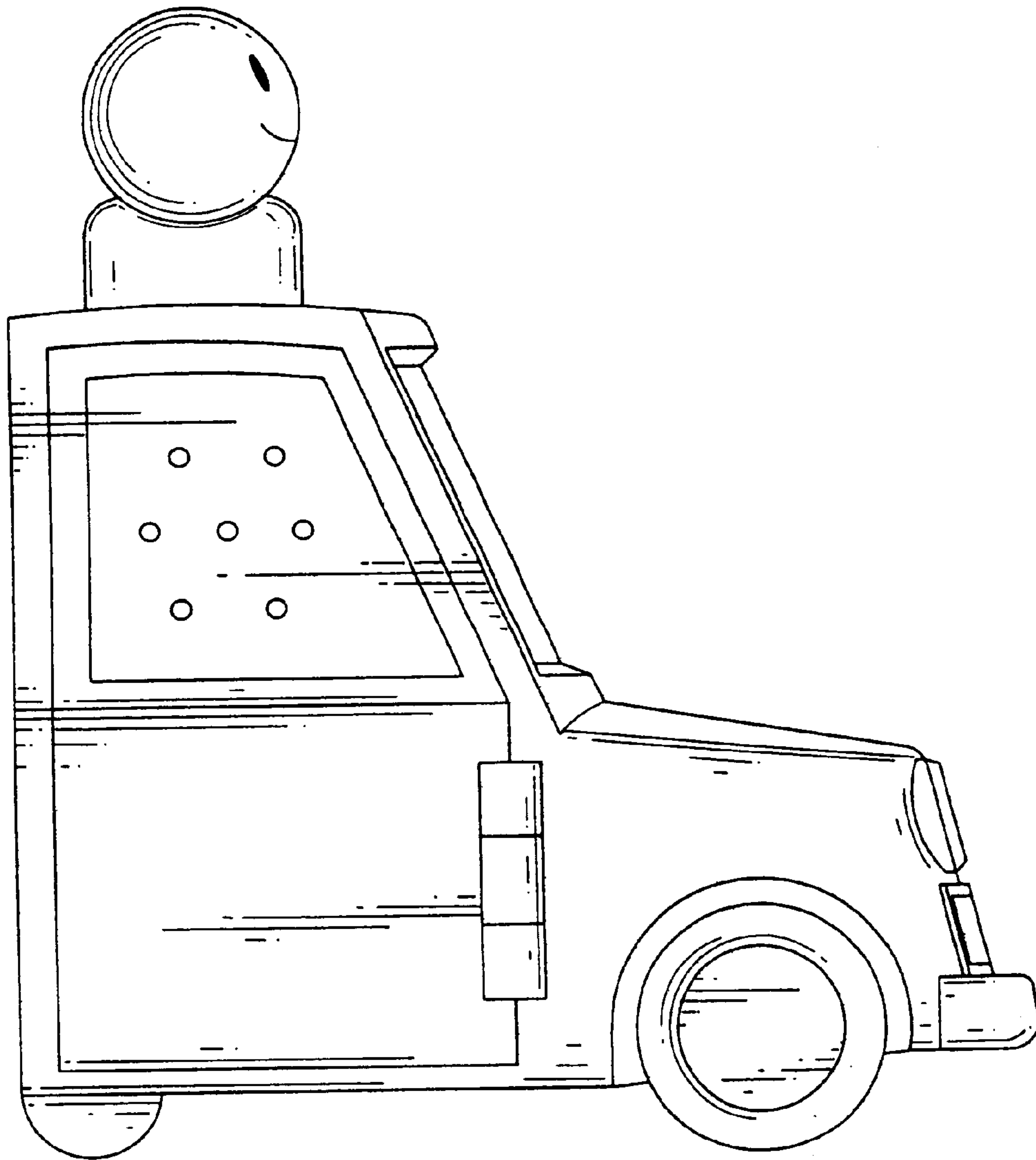

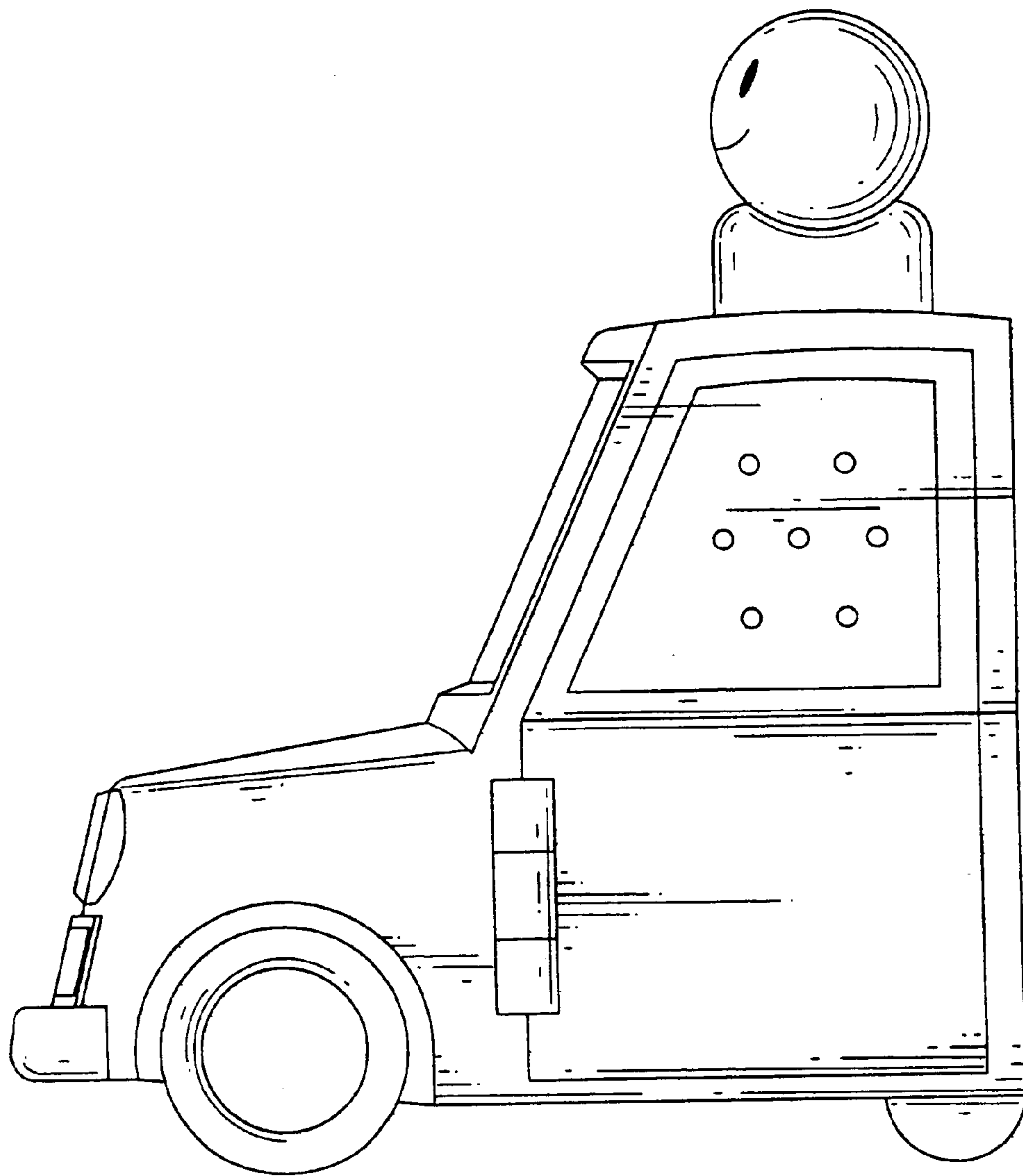

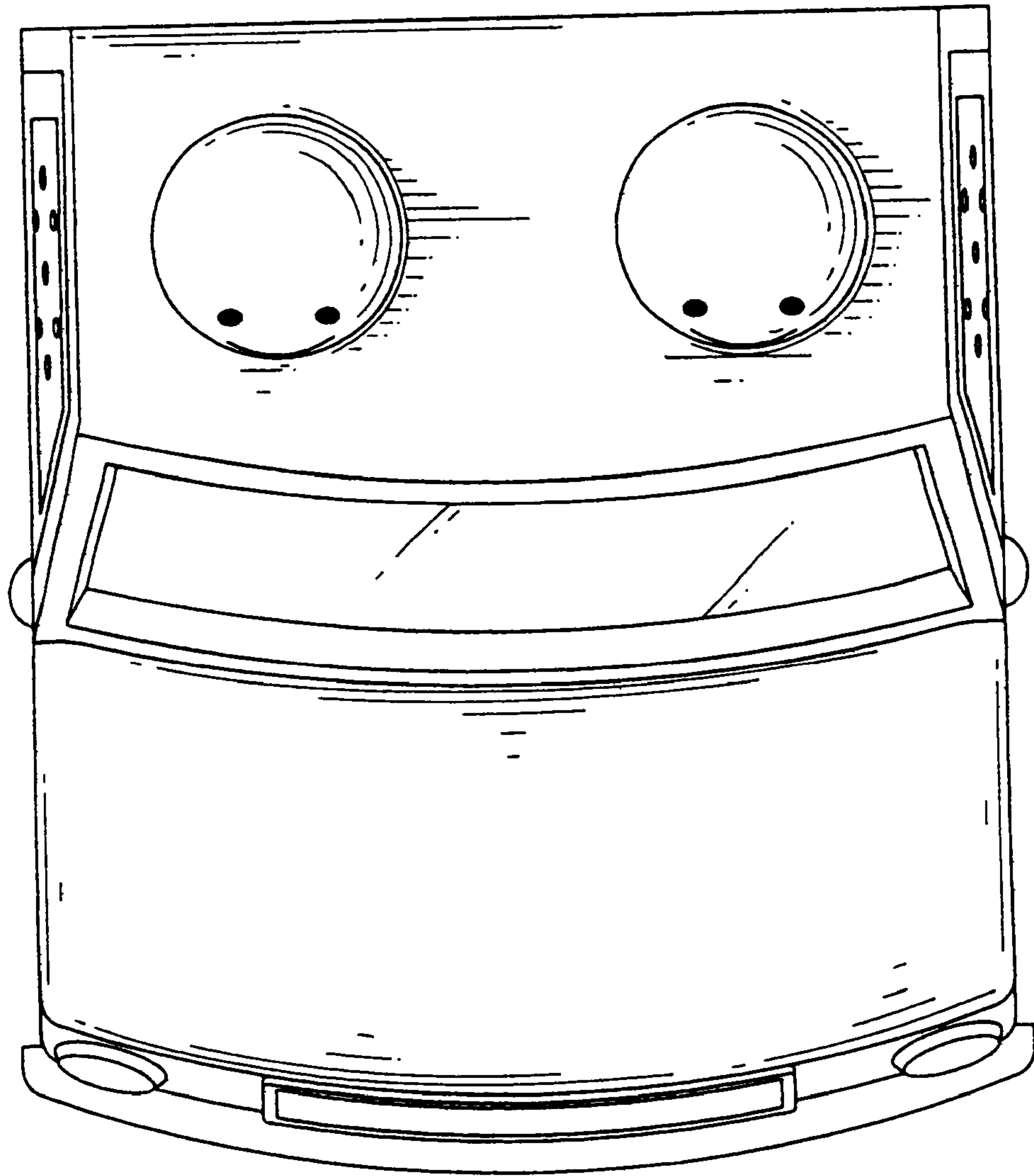

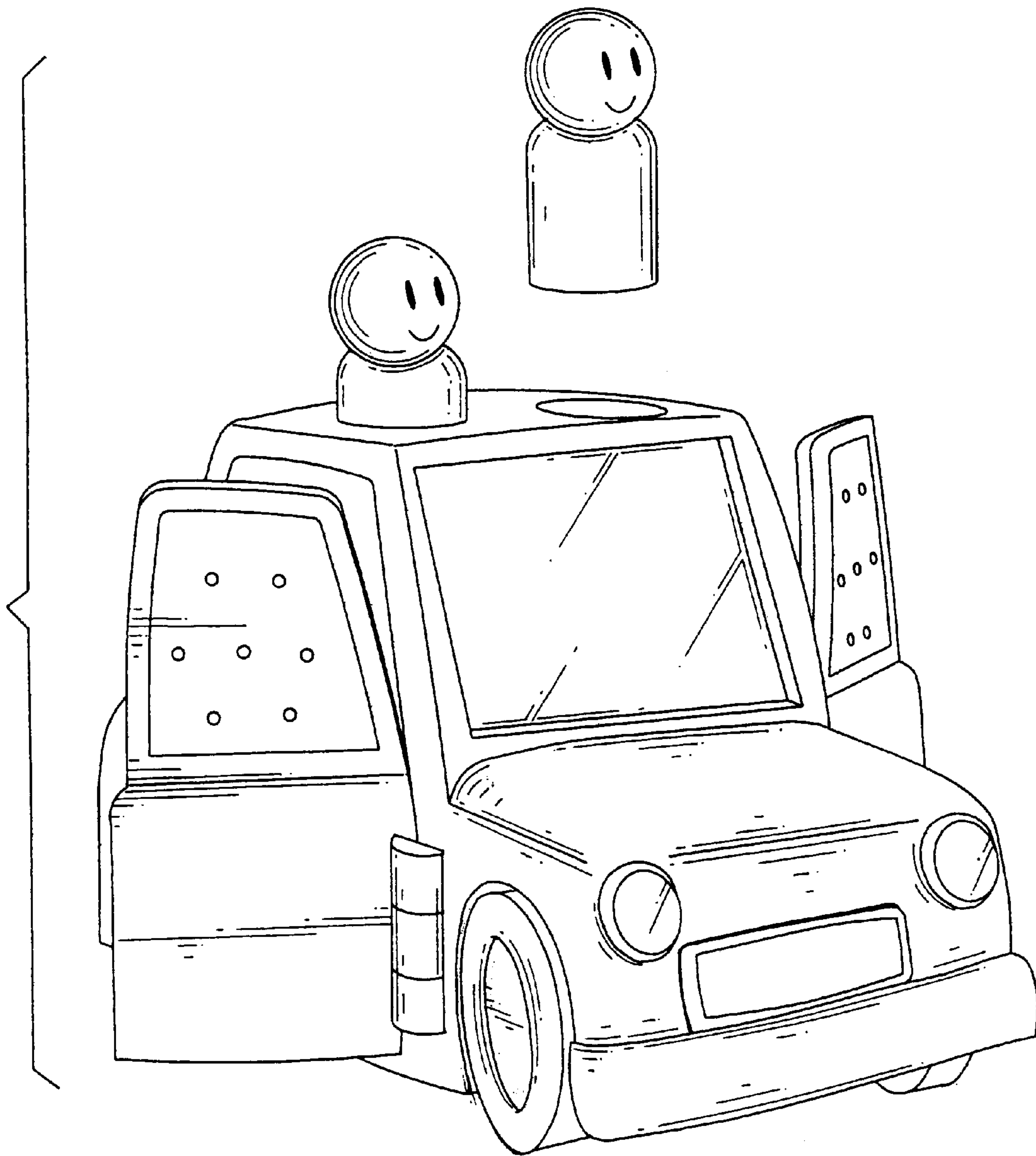
