embodiment of the invention; and,

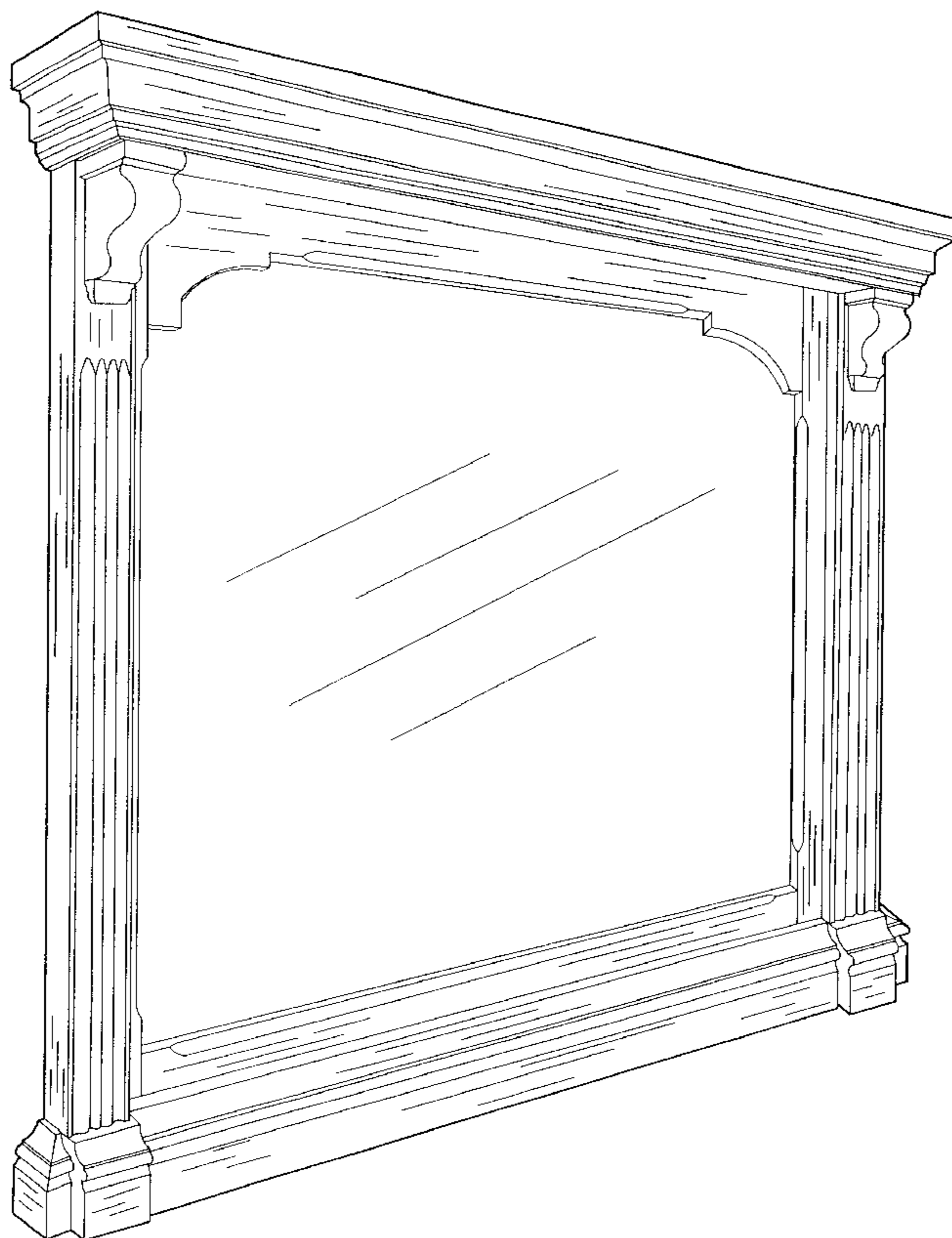
FIG. 4 is a side view of a mirror according to an embodiment

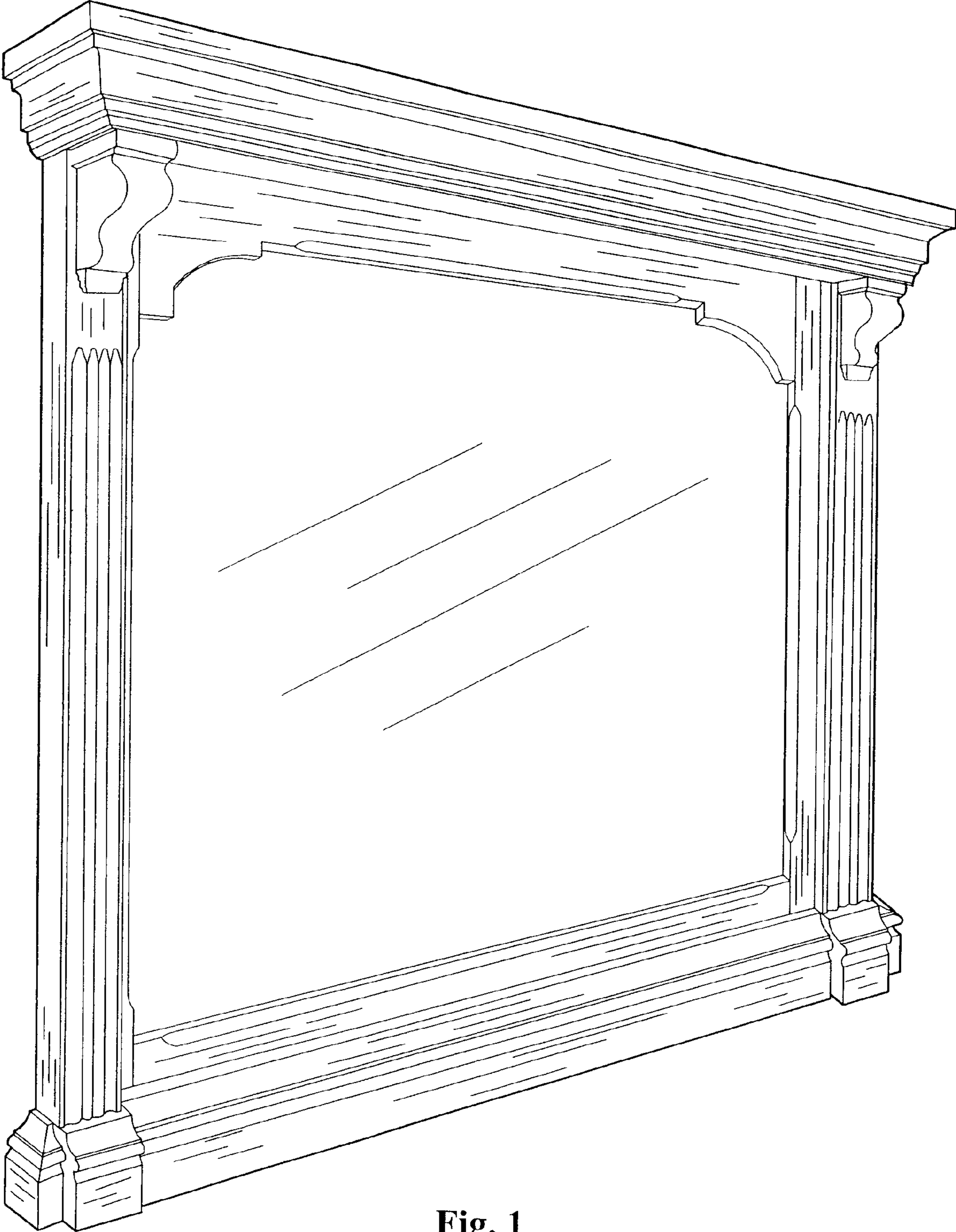

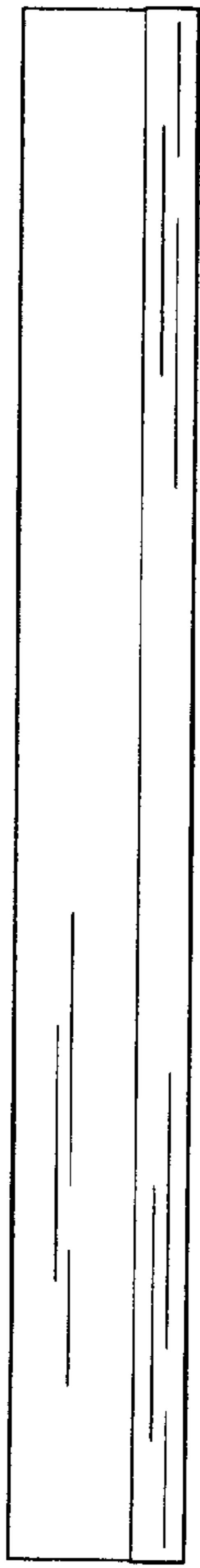

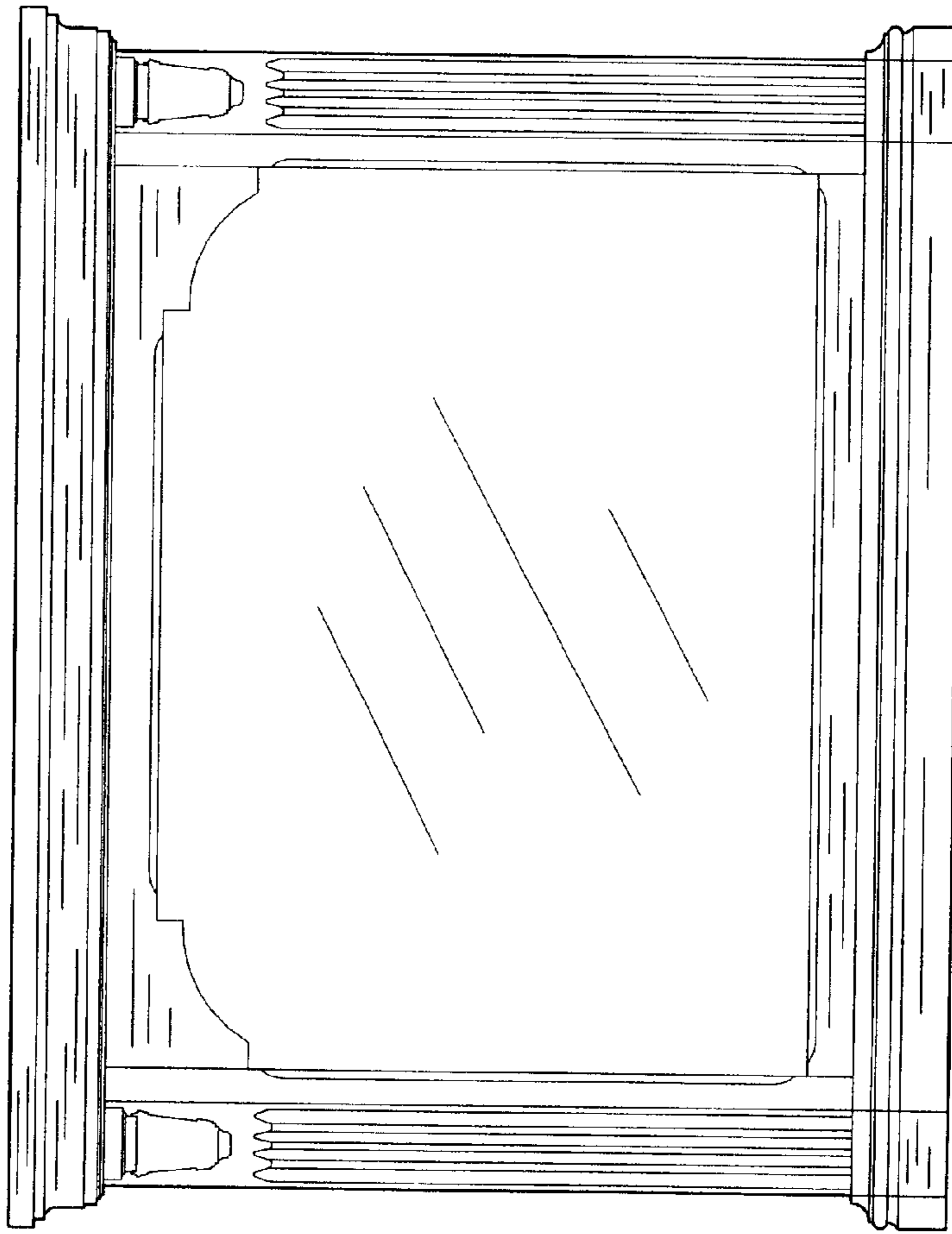

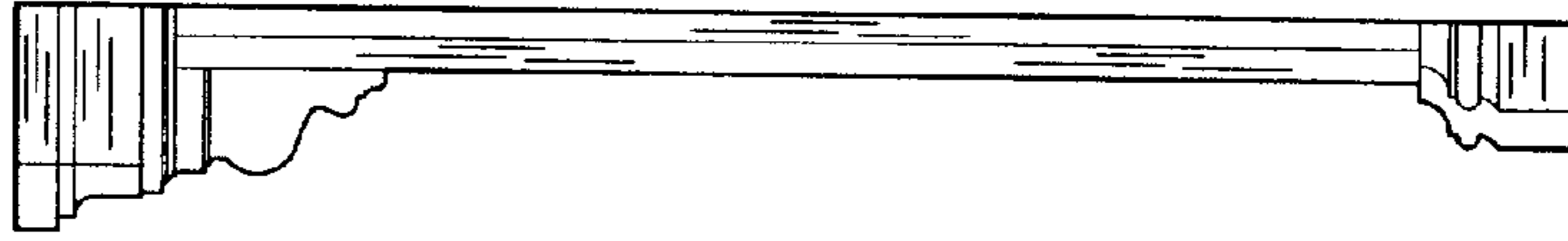
