#### (57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a sponge and scrubber holder, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the sponge and scrubber holder according to the invention;

FIG. 2 is a top view of the sponge and scrubber holder as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front view of the sponge and scrubber holder as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a side view of the sponge and scrubber holder as shown in FIG. 1;


FIG. 5 is a rear view of the sponge and scrubber holder as shown in FIG. 1, showing a first operational mode of the sponge and scrubber holder according to the invention;

FIG. 6 is a side view of the sponge and scrubber holder as shown in FIG. 1; shown from the opposite side as that shown in FIG. 4 and showing a first operational mode of the sponge and scrubber holder according to the invention;


FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the sponge and scrubber holder as shown in FIG. 1;






