#### CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tin purse, as shown and described.

#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a tin purse showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 5 is rear elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 a bottom plan view thereof.
The broken line showing of a handle, small protrusions on the front and back, and a clasp, in the views, is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.
