(57)CLAIM

The ornamental design for a lady bug-shaped brush with six spots, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The claimed lady bug-shaped brush with six spots is used for cleaning shoes and clothing. FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a lady bug-shaped brush with six spots showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof.
