(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a spout, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

In a preferred embodiment, the nature of this product is as a plumbing fixture in the form of a spout for filling a bath tub.

FIG. 1 is a left, top, front perspective view of a spout embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view thereof being a mirror image of the left side shown;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

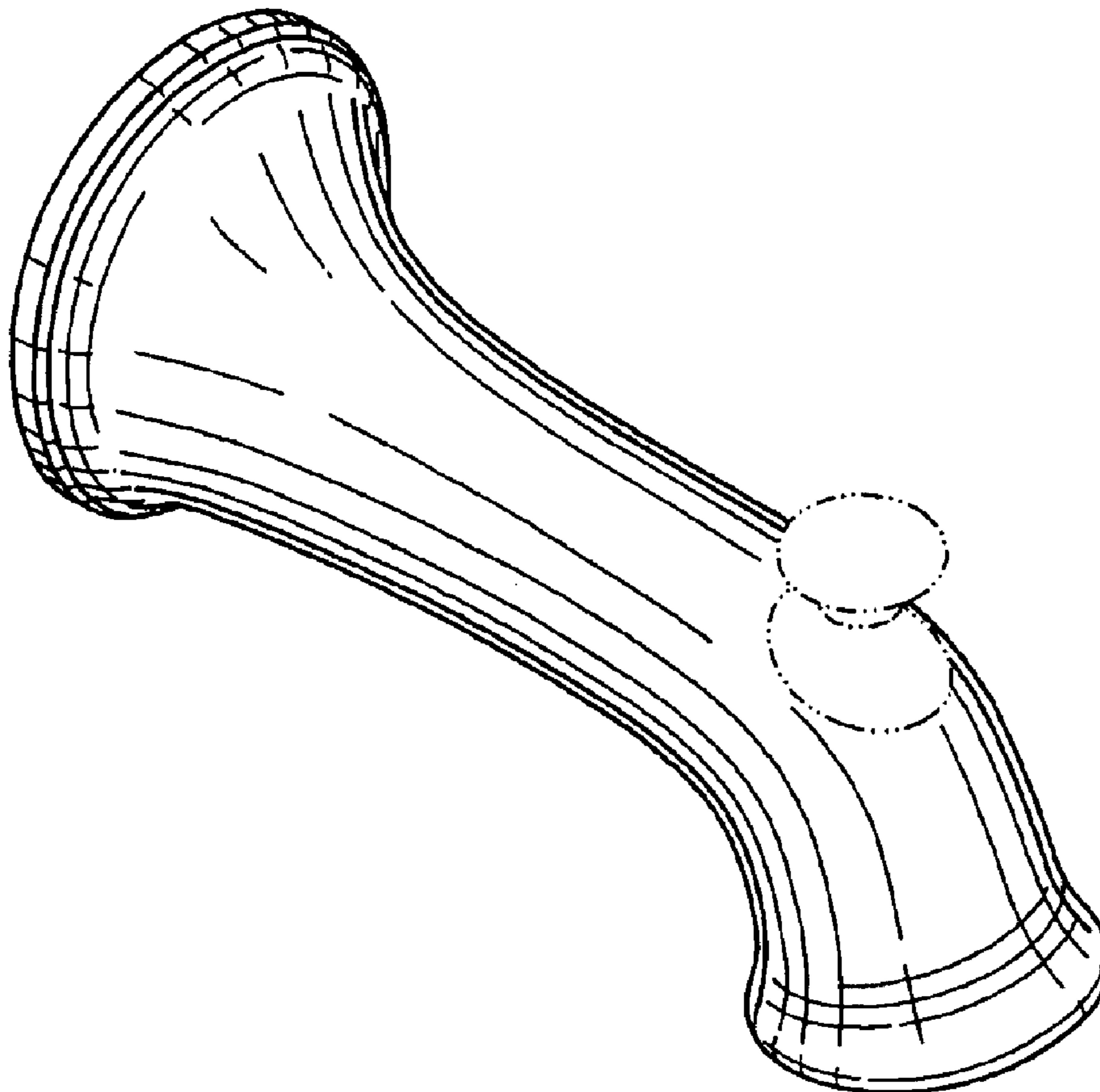
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

The broken line representations of pull-up knob environment in FIGS. 1-4, raised structure in FIGS. 1-3, openings in FIG. 5 and rear structure in FIG. 6 are for the purpose of illustration only, and form no part of the claimed design.

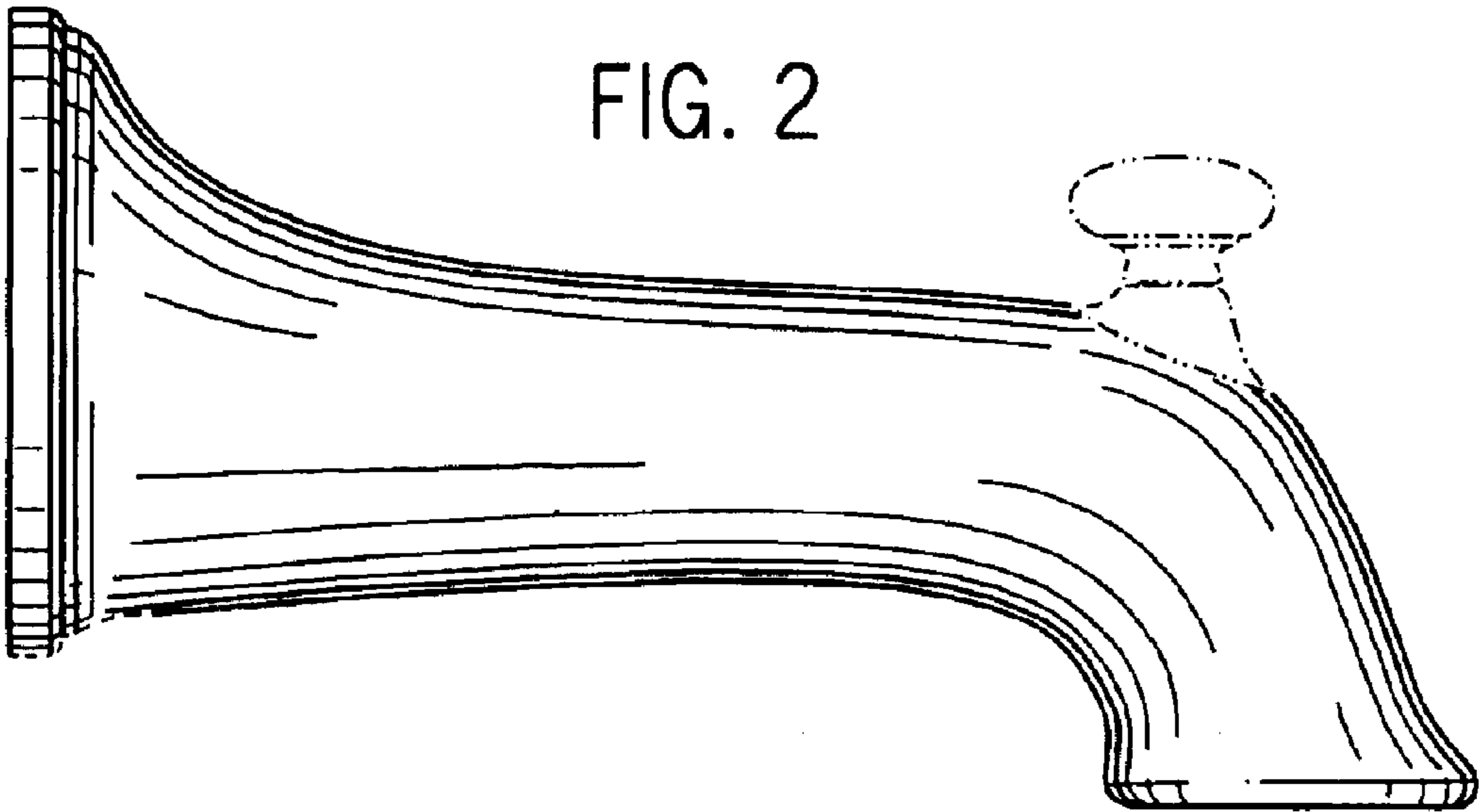
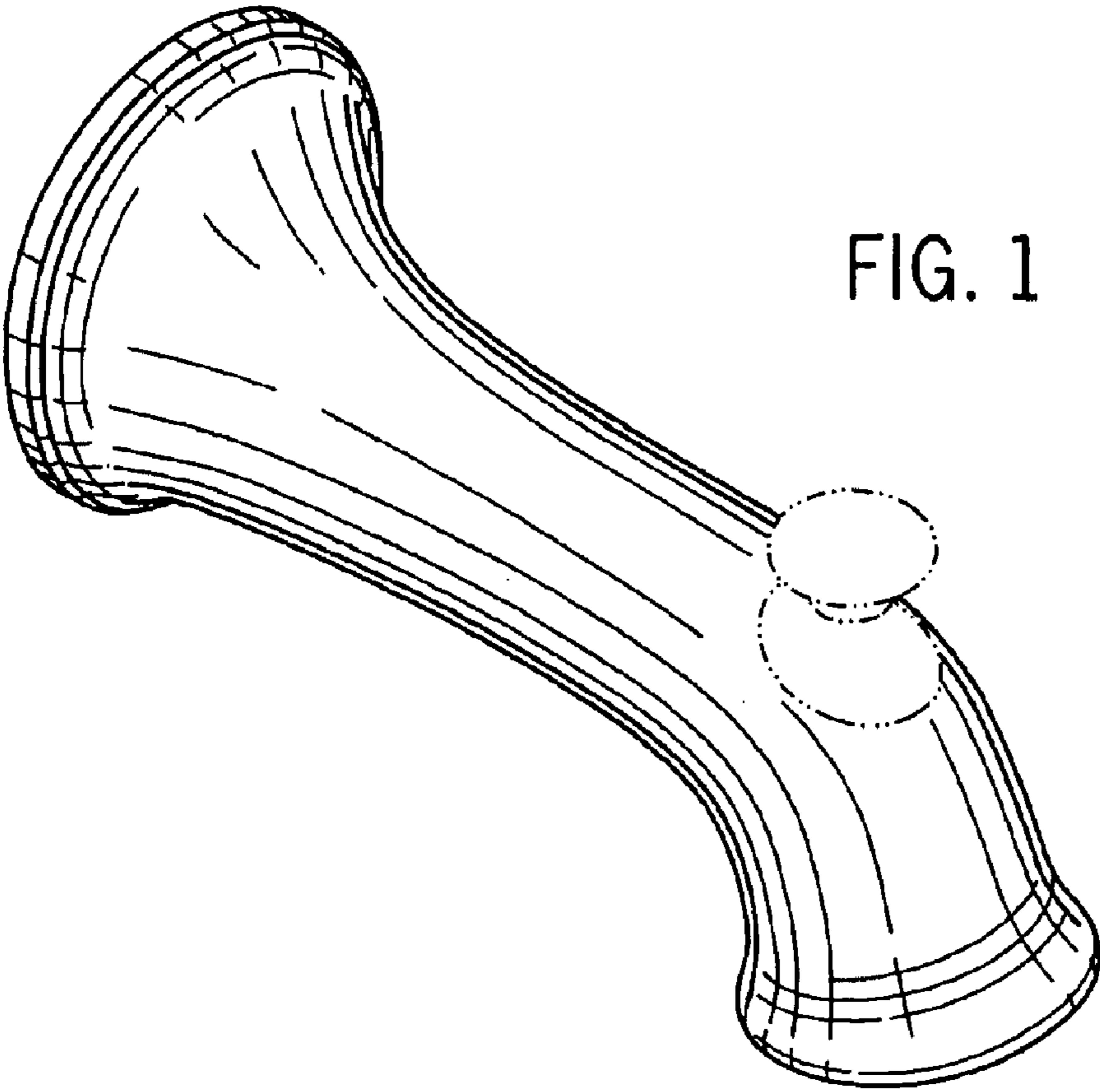

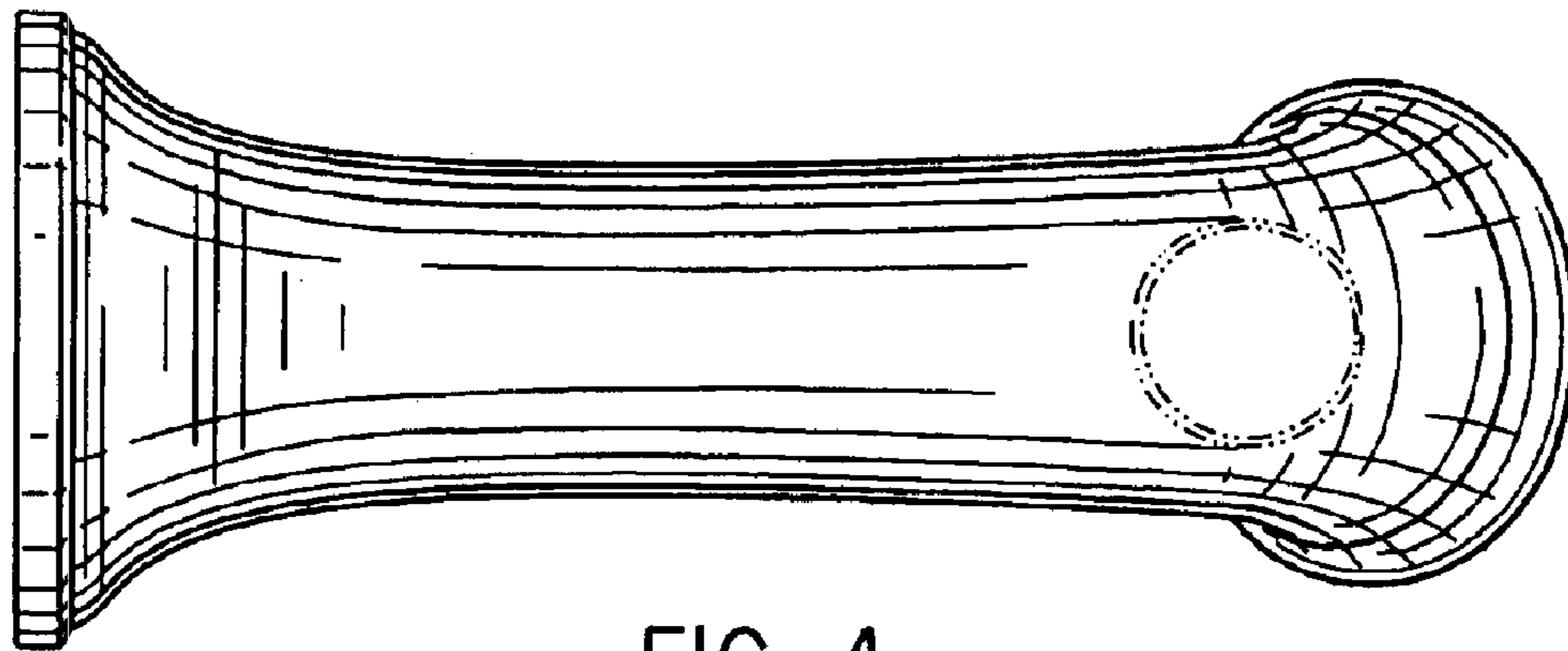
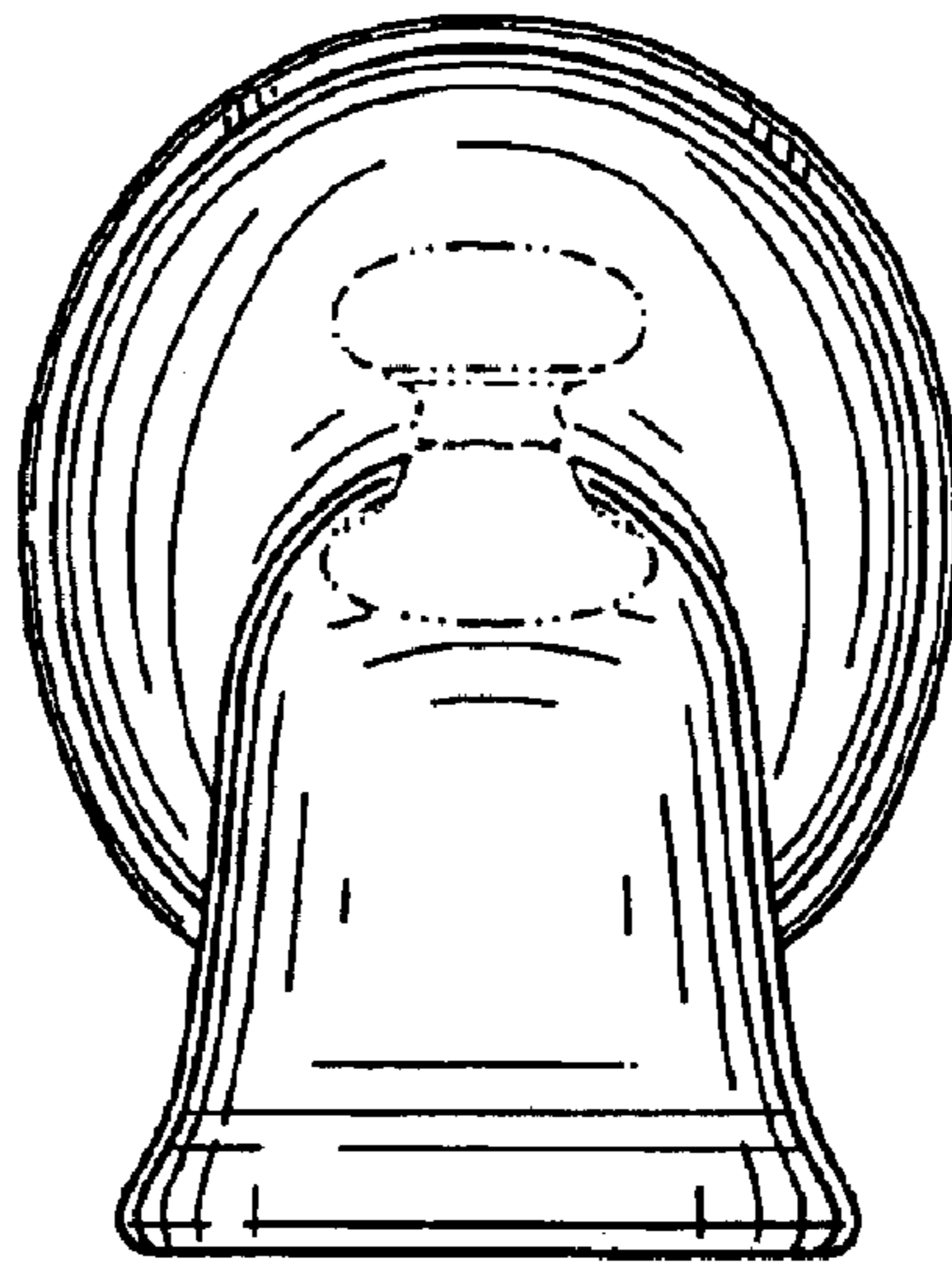

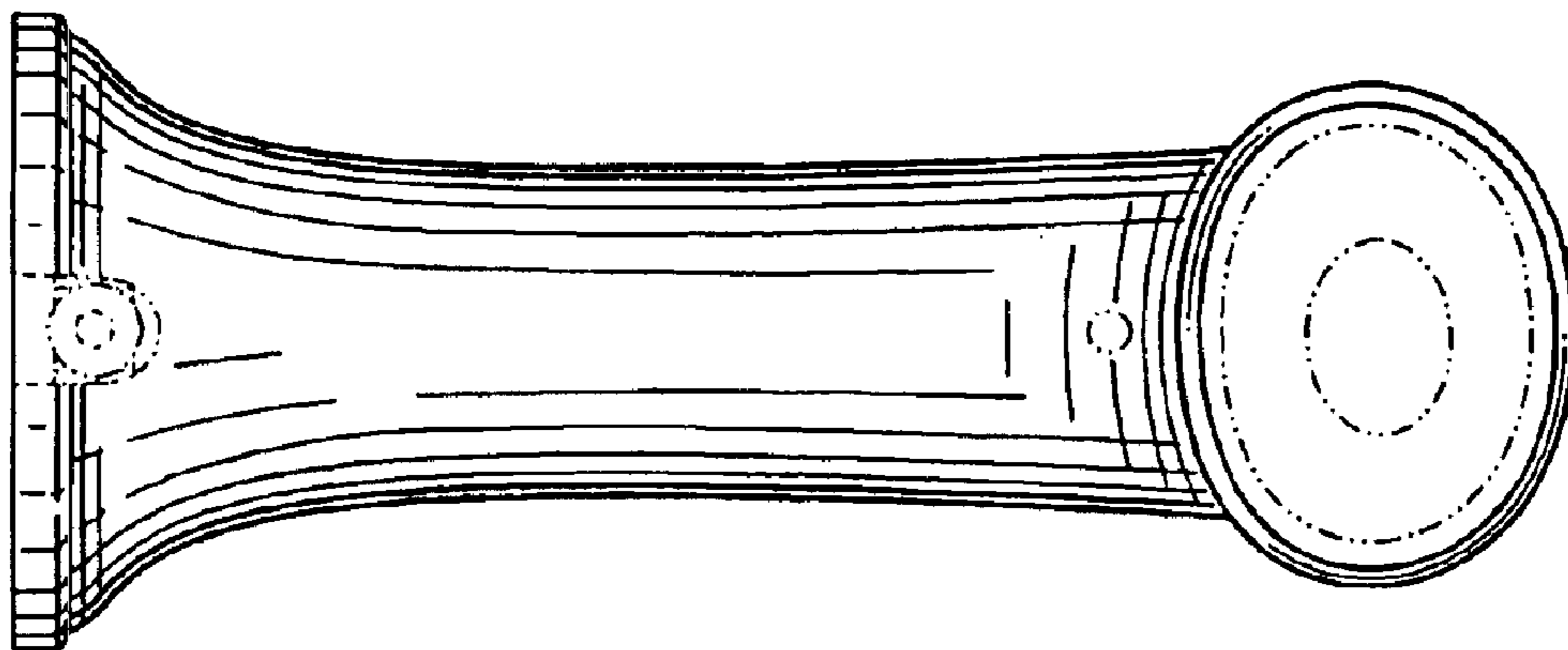

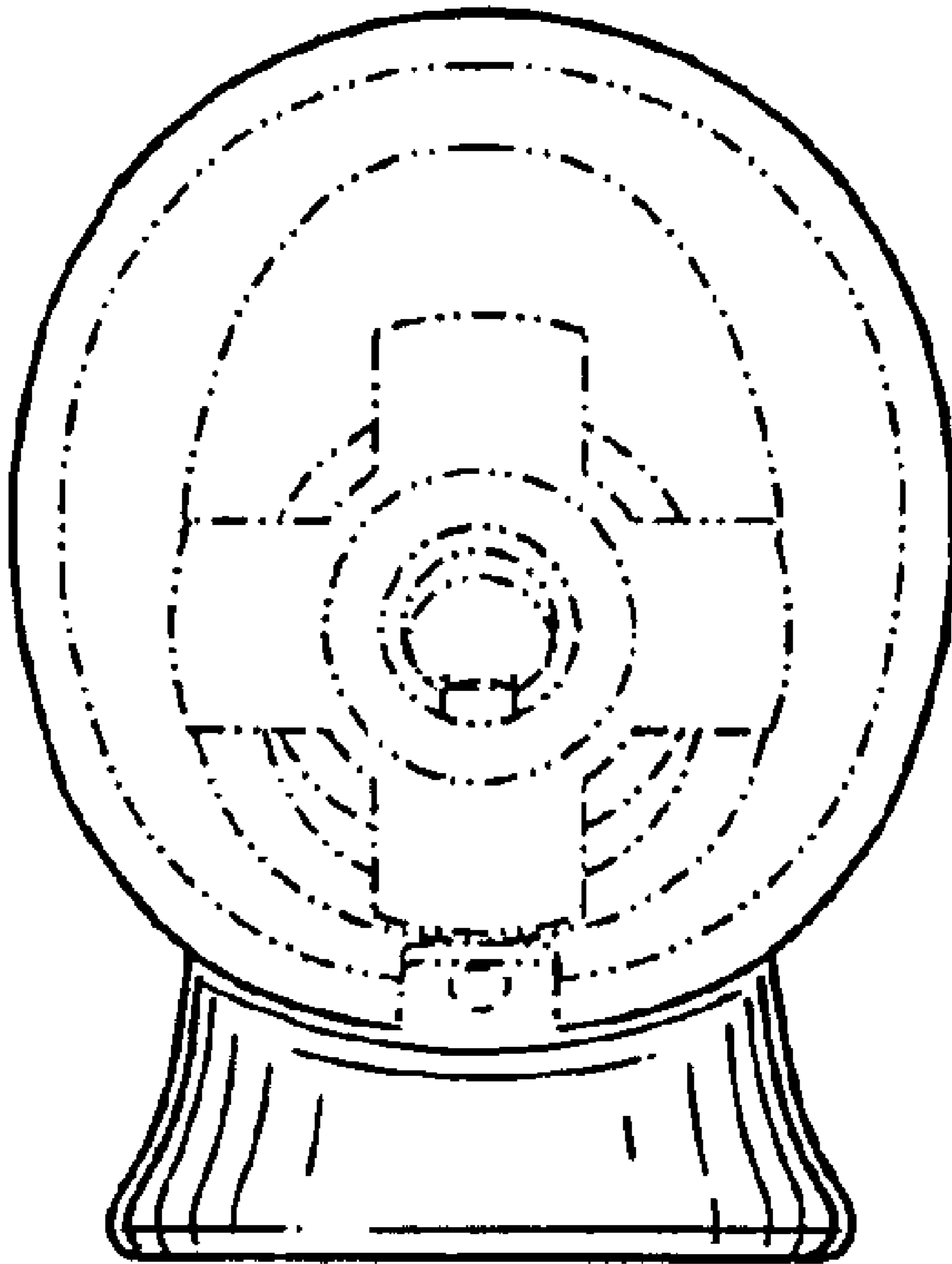
