(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a garment hanger, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a garment hanger, showing my new design, the rear elevation view is a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view thereof;

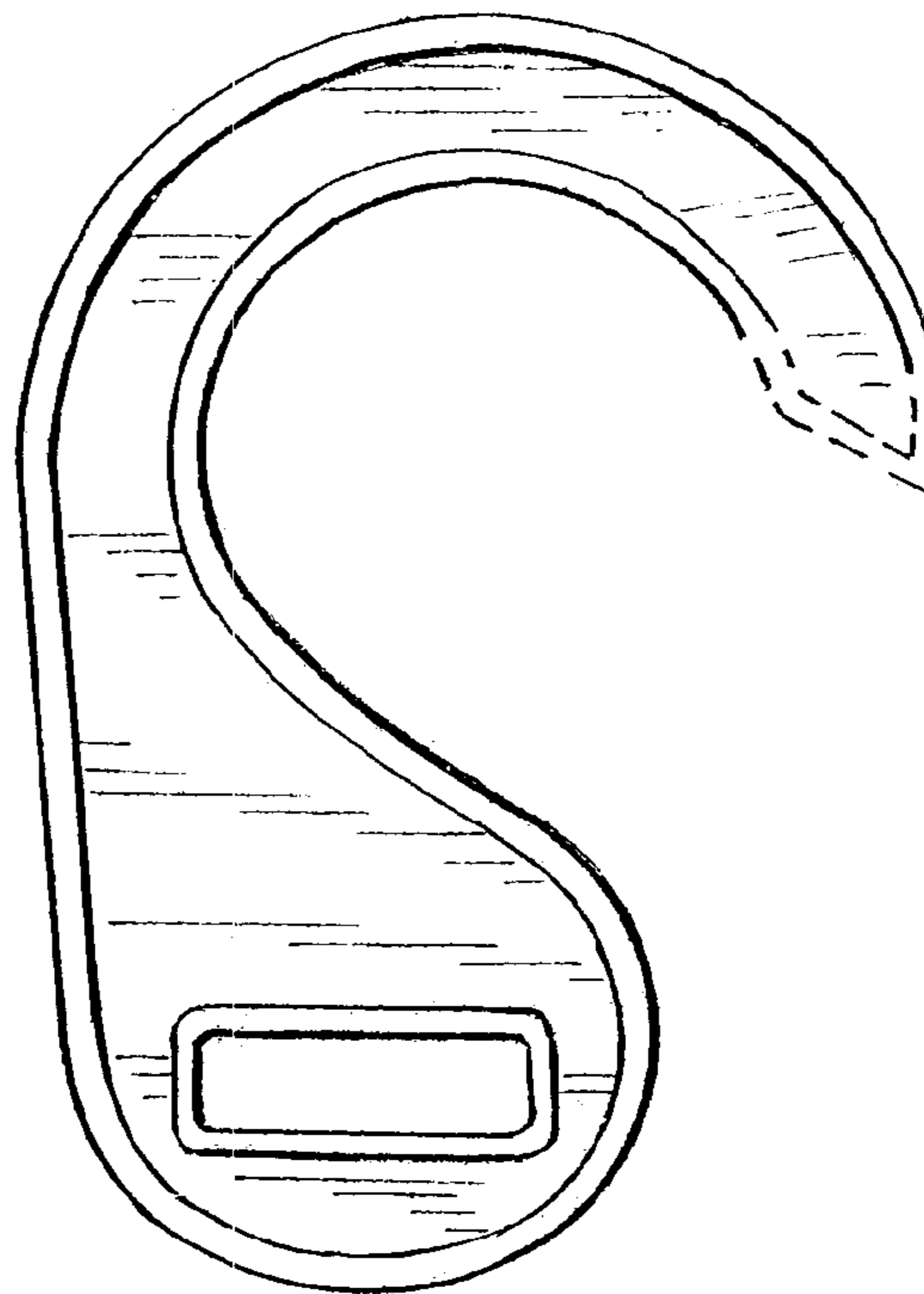
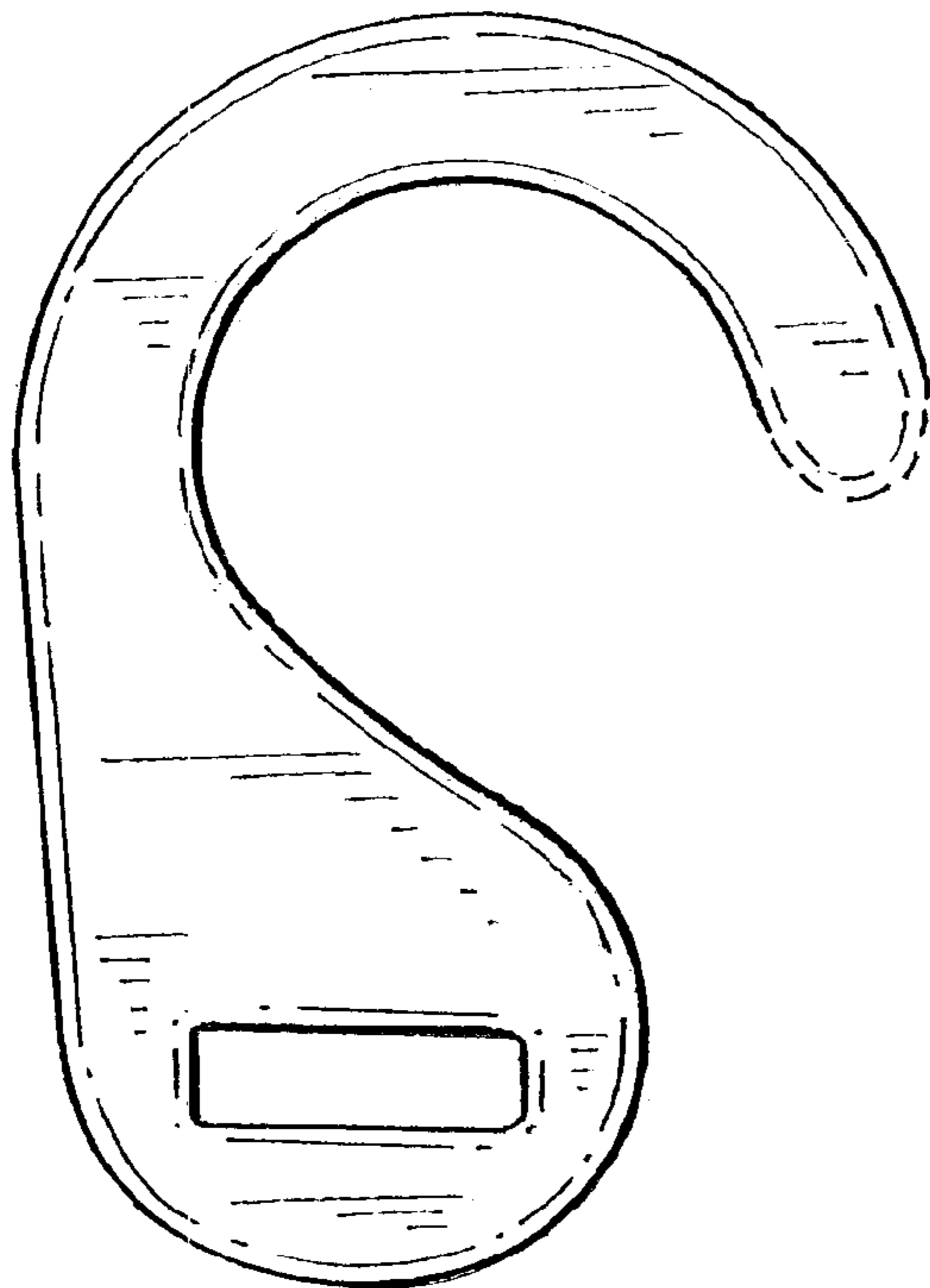
FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of a second embodiment of a garment hanger, showing my new design, the rear elevation view is a mirror image thereof;

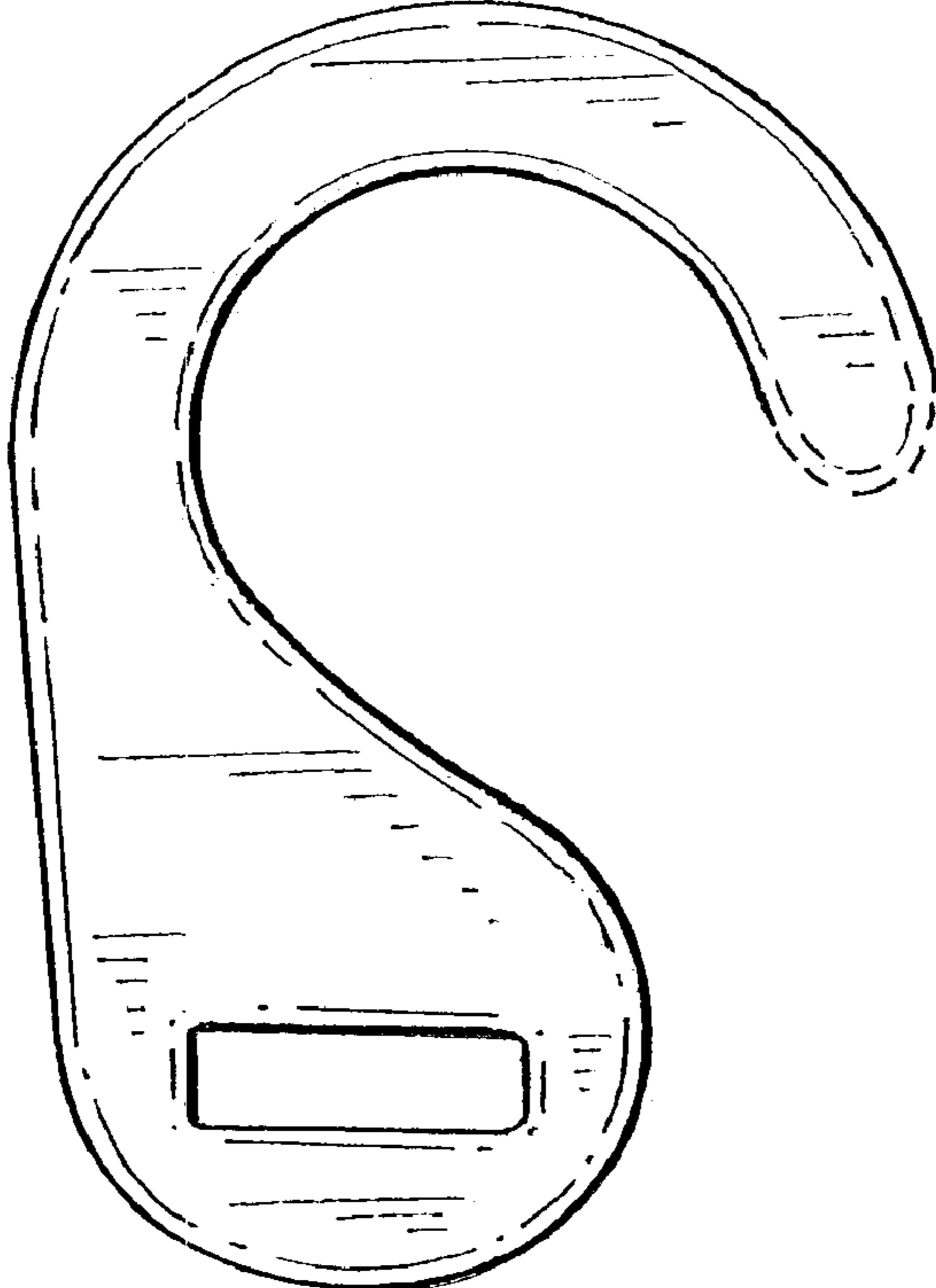

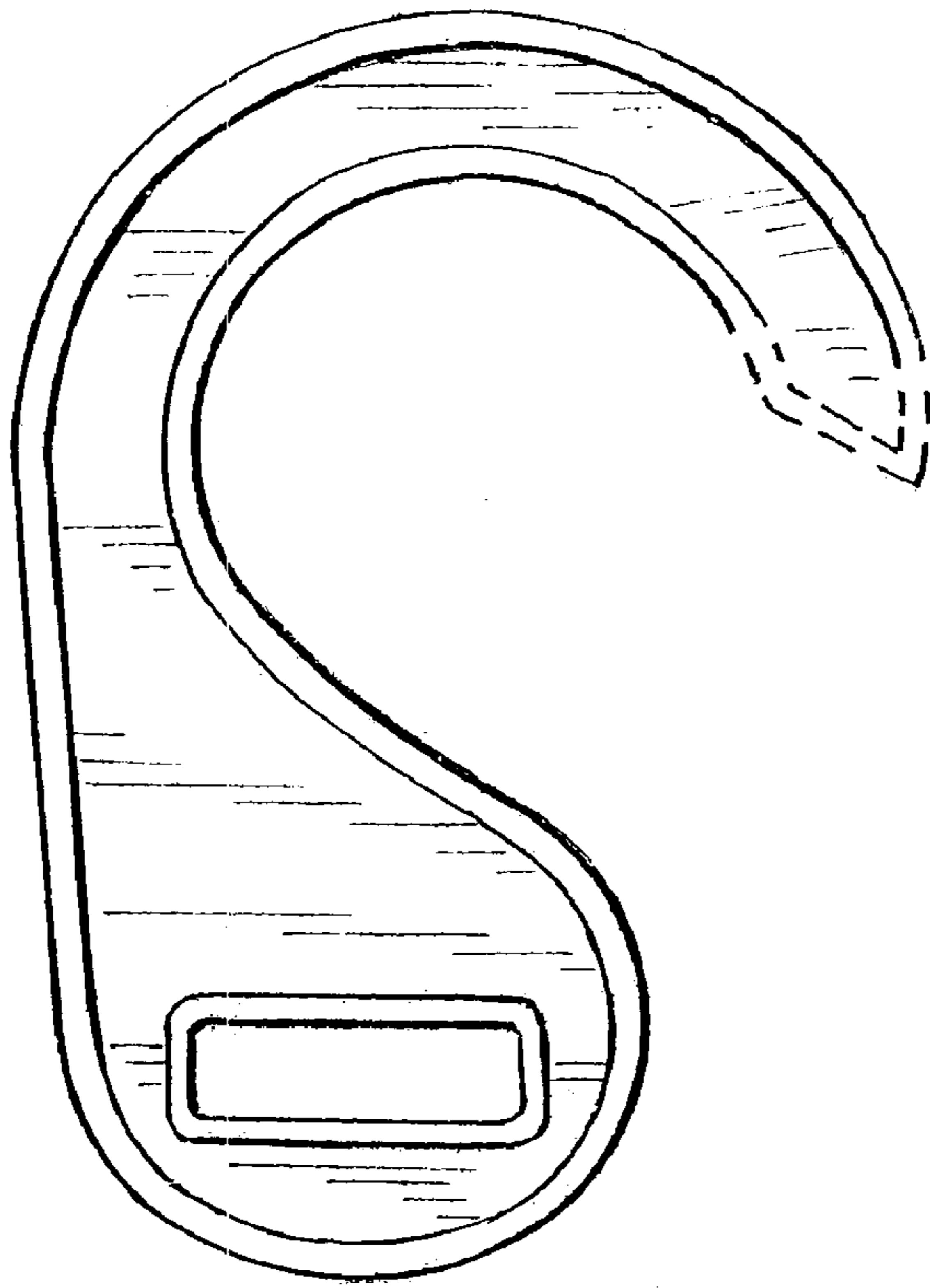

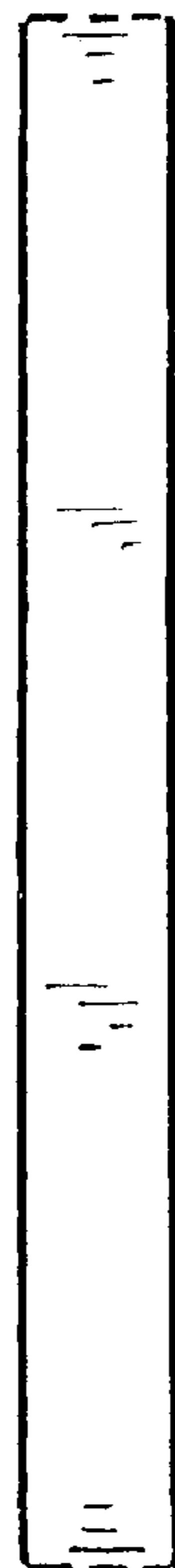
