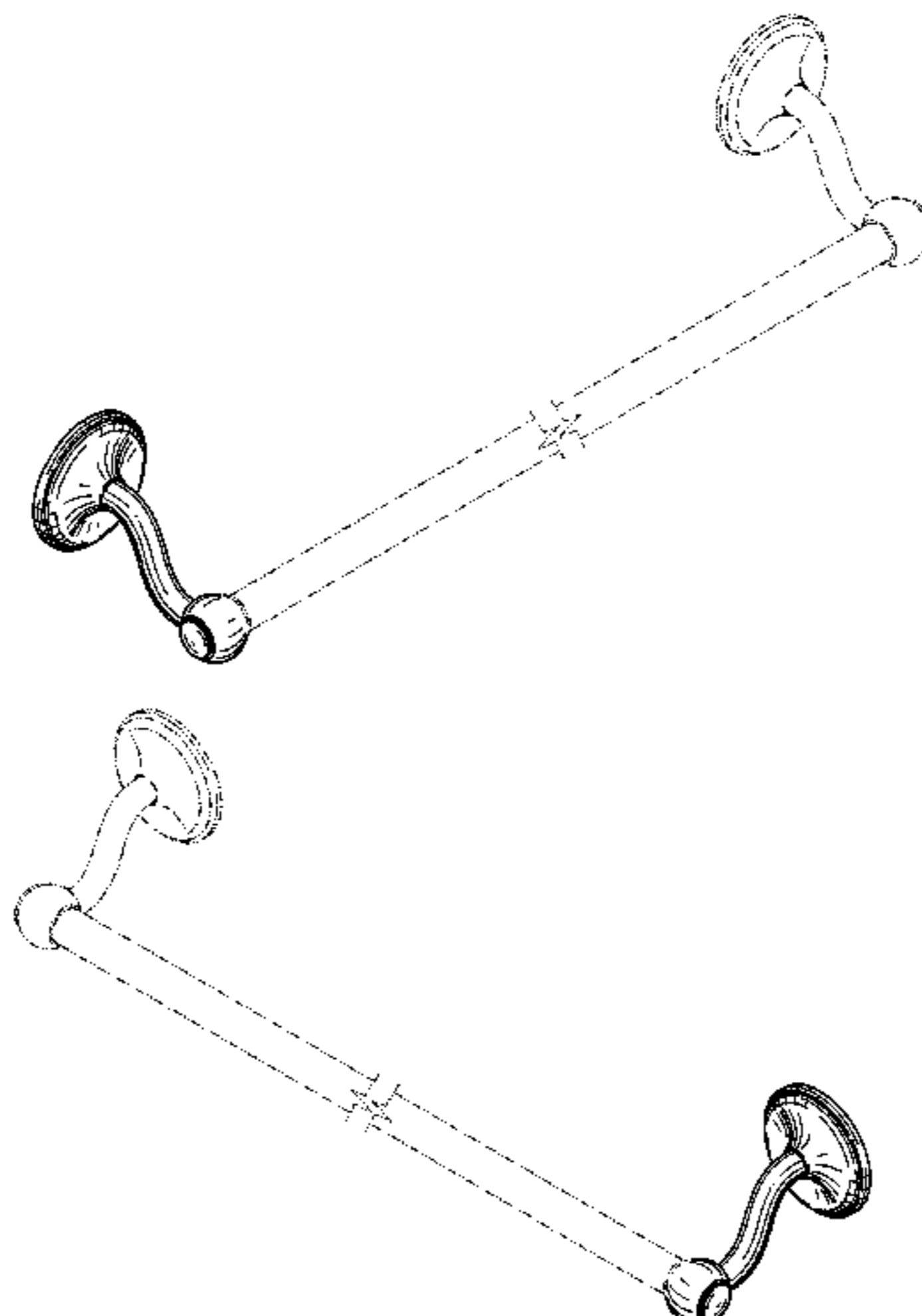
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a wall mountable support, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

In a preferred embodiment, the nature of this product is a wall mountable support such as can be used with a toilet paper holder and a towel bar.  
FIG. 1 is a left, top, front perspective view of a wall mountable support according to my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view thereof being a mirror image the left side shown;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 7 is a right, top, front perspective view of a wall mountable support according to another embodiment of my new design, the front elevational, left elevational, top plan, bottom plan and rear elevational views thereof being mirror images of the views shown in FIGS. 2-6;  
FIG. 8 is a left, top, front perspective view of a wall mountable support according to another embodiment of my new design; and,  
FIG. 9 is a front elevational view thereof.  
The broken line representations of bar and mounting environment in FIGS. 1-2 and 4-9 and rear bracket structure in FIG. 6 are for the purpose of illustration only, and form no part of the claimed design.

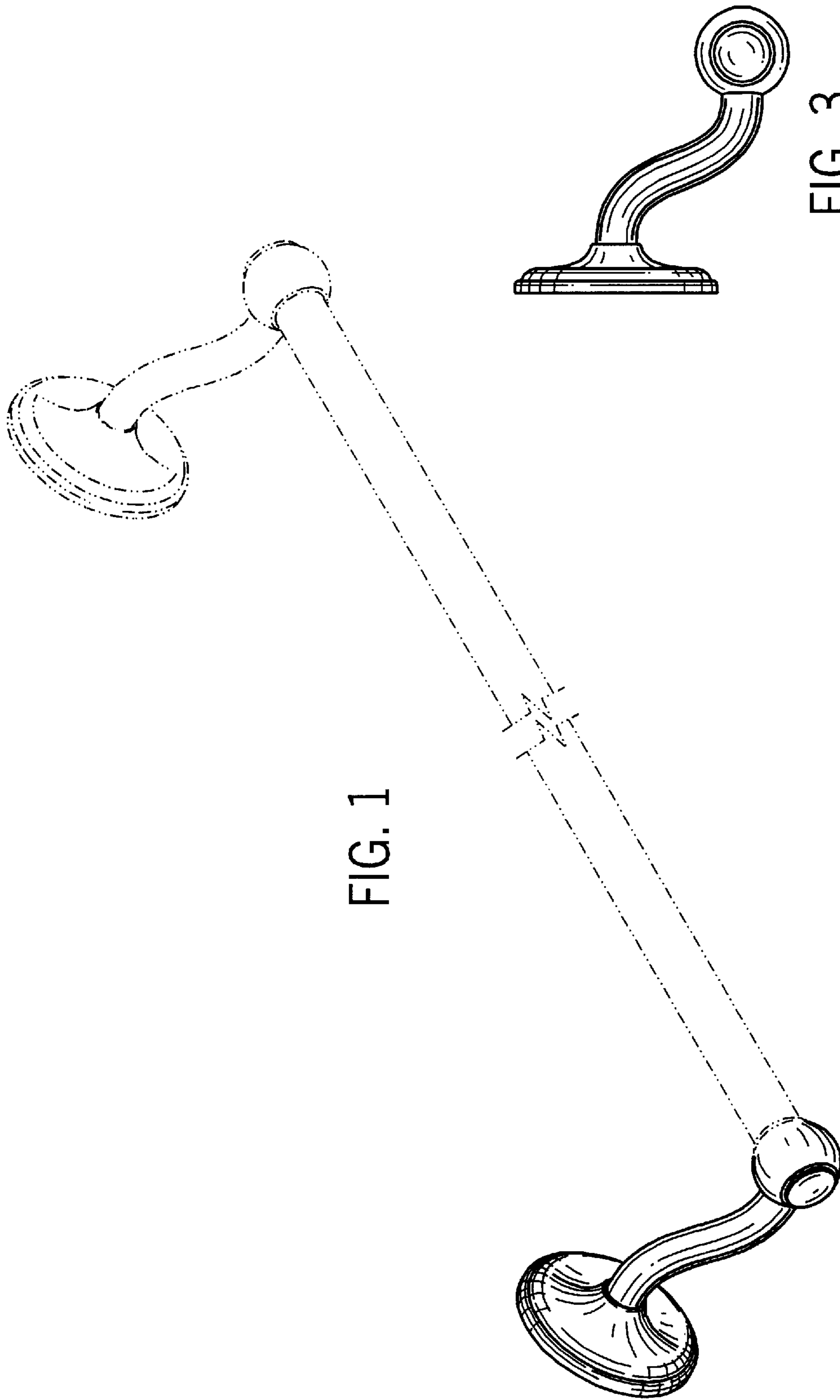

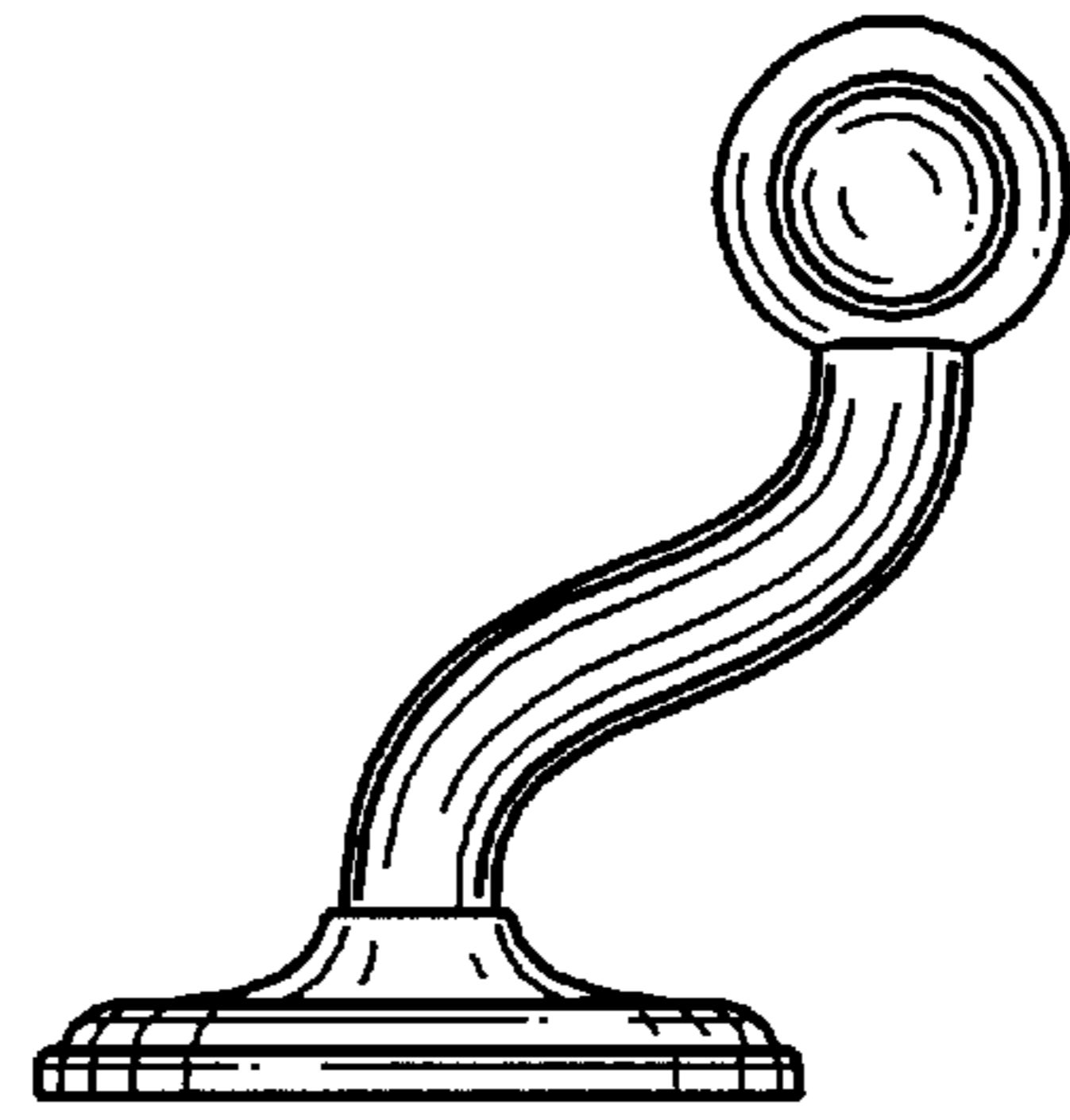
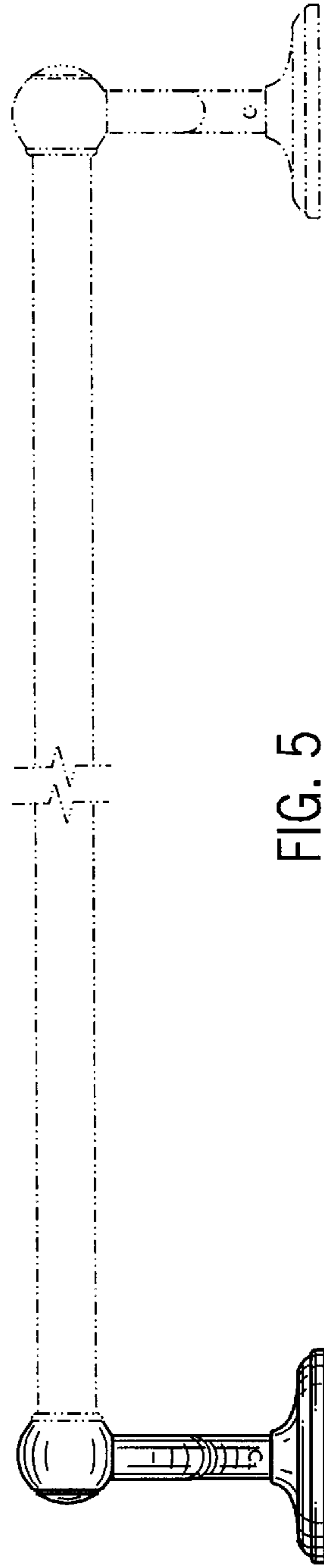
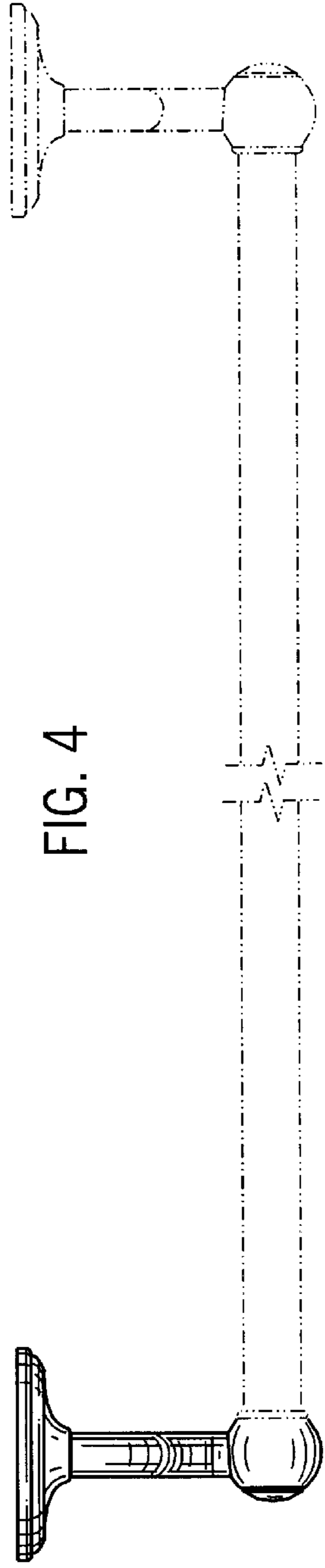
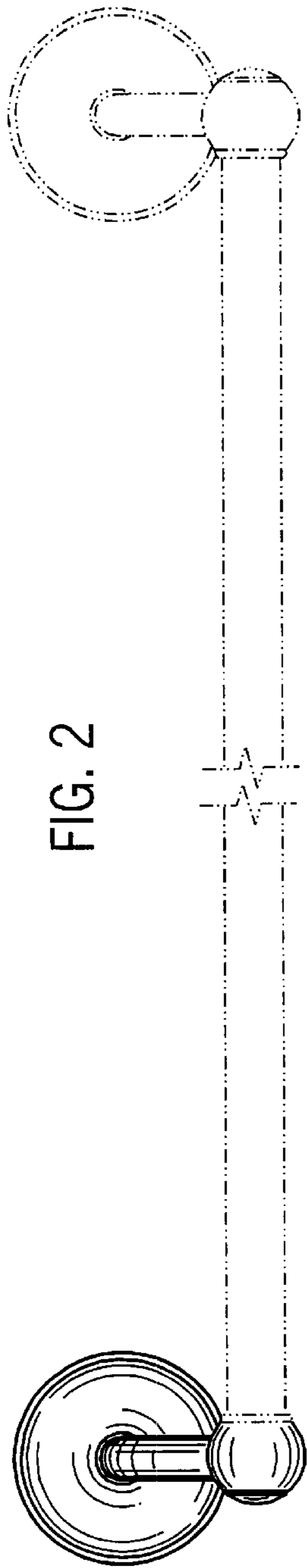

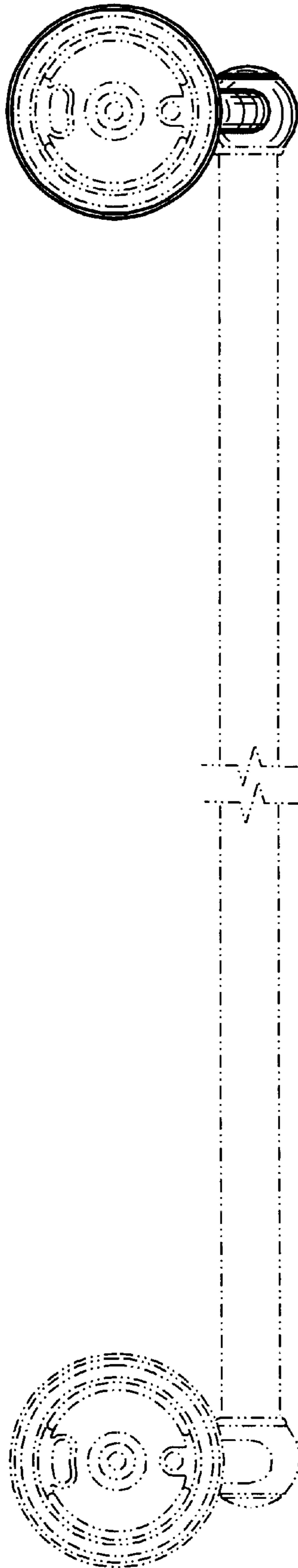

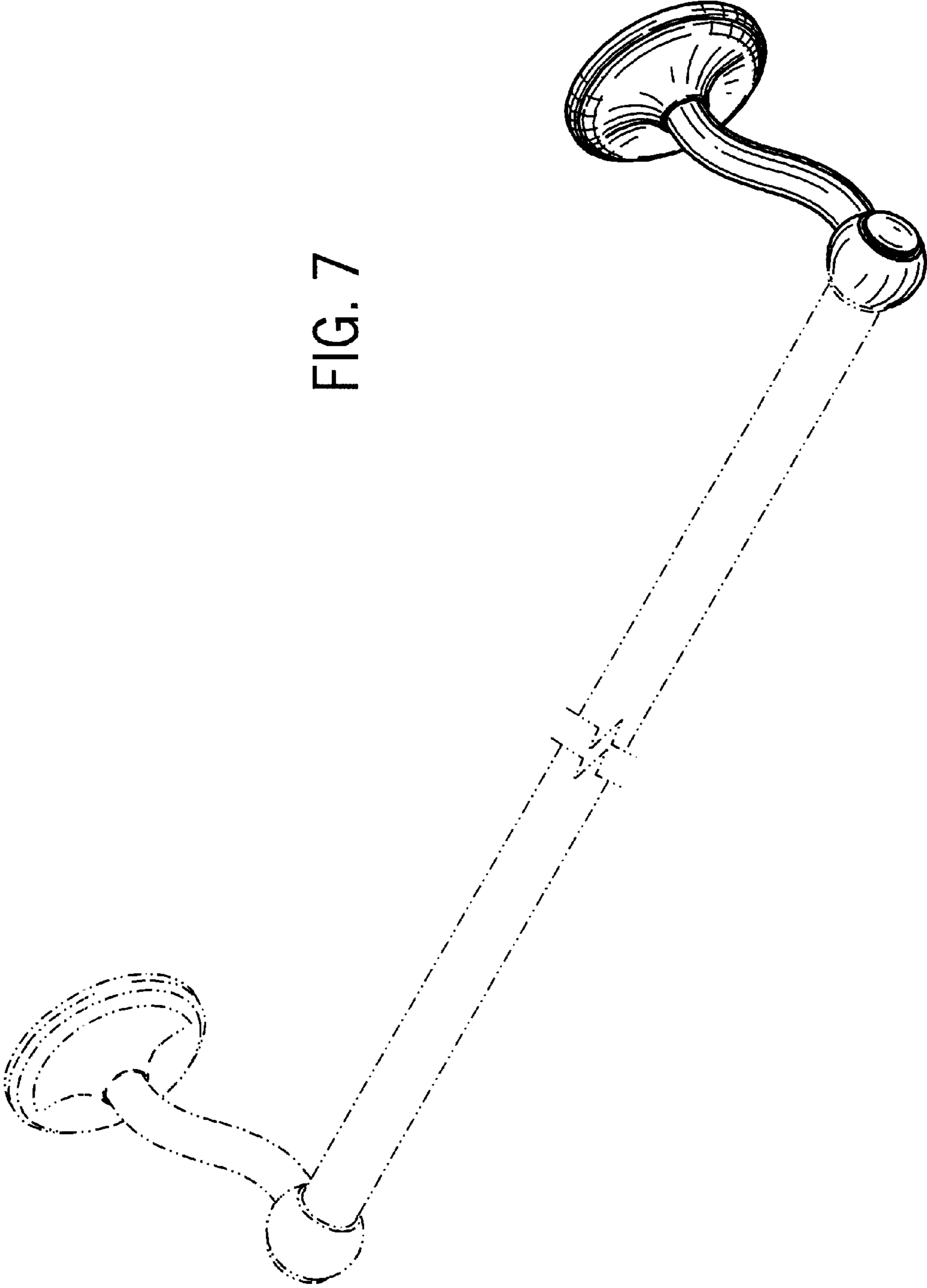

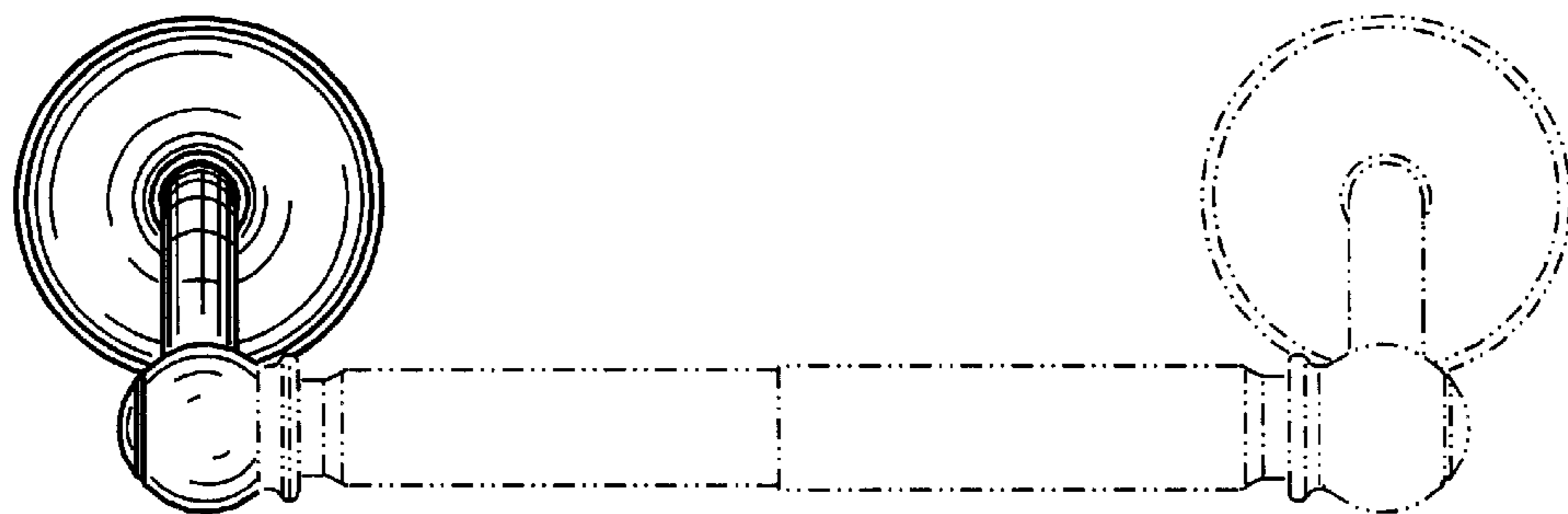
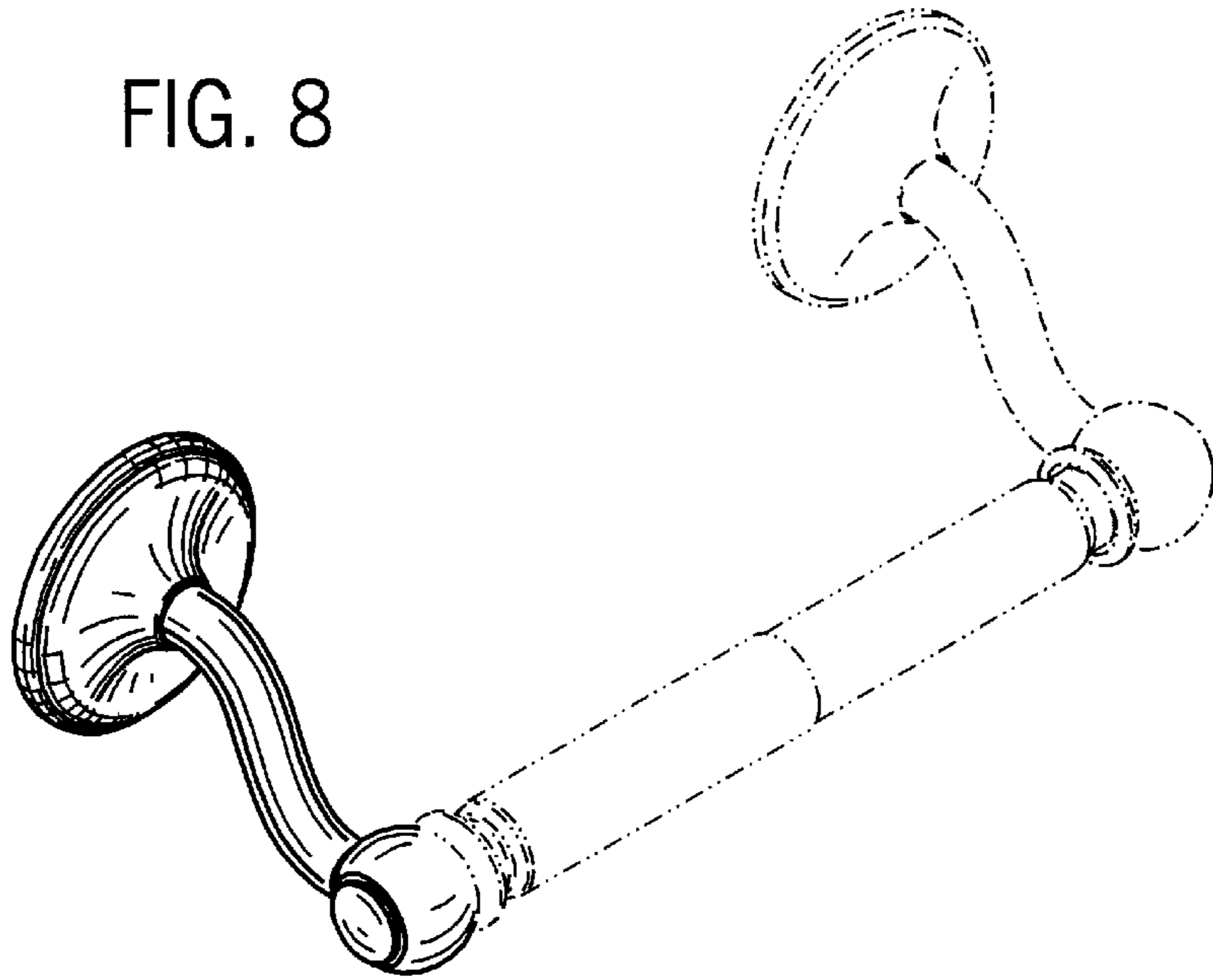
