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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a utensil handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an environmental front elevation view of a kitchen utensil showing my new design for a utensil handle;

FIG. 2 is a reduced, alternate environmental side elevational view of the utensil handle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a further reduced, alternate environmental perspective view of the utensil handle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the utensil handle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of the utensil handle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is perspective view of the utensil handle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged partial front elevational view of the utensil handle shown in FIG. 1;

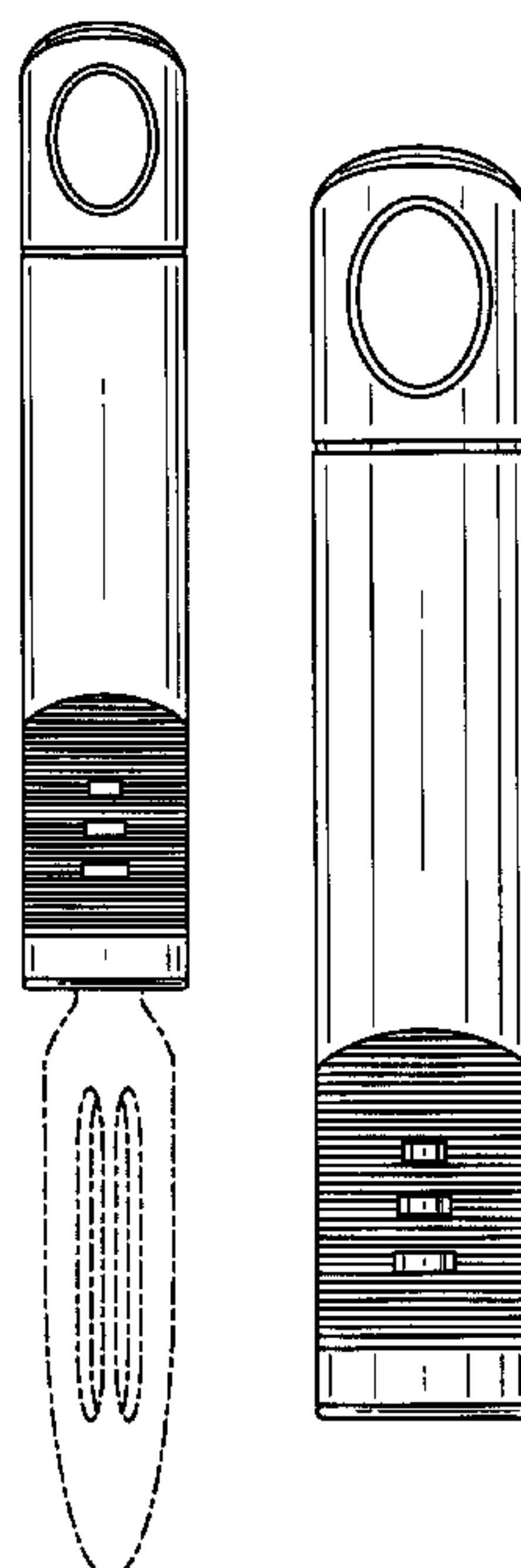
FIG. 8 is an enlarged partial side elevational view of the utensil handle shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 9 is an enlarged partial bottom perspective view of the utensil handle shown in FIG. 1.

The broken lines at the end of the utensil handle, opposite the handle, in FIGS. 1–3 are illustrative of environmental structure only and form no part of the claimed design.

FIGS. 7–9 show portions of the utensil handle removed for clarity of illustration.

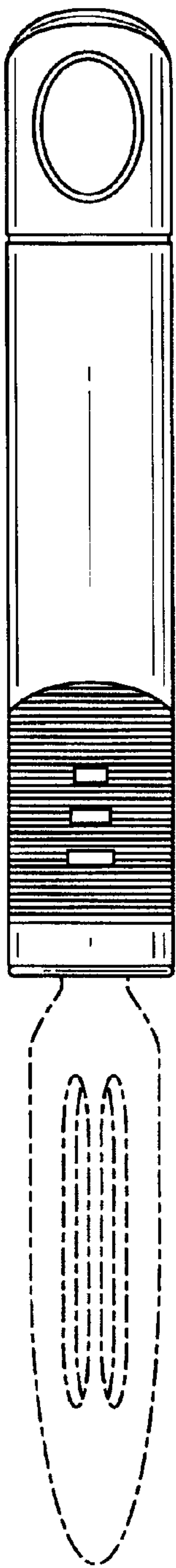

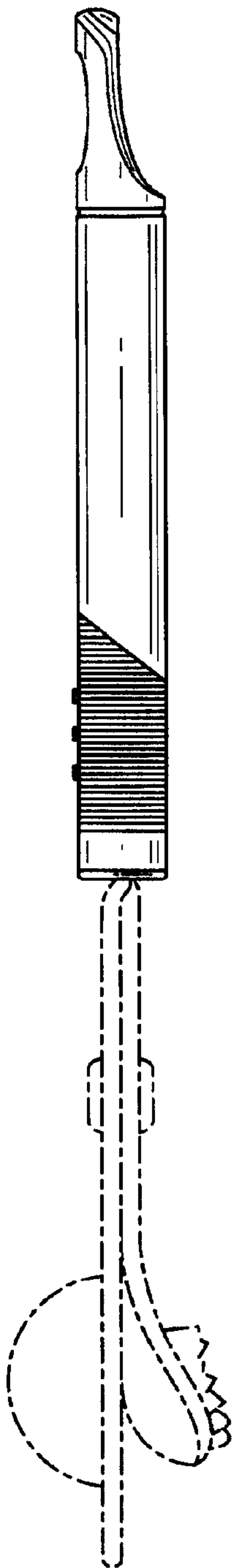

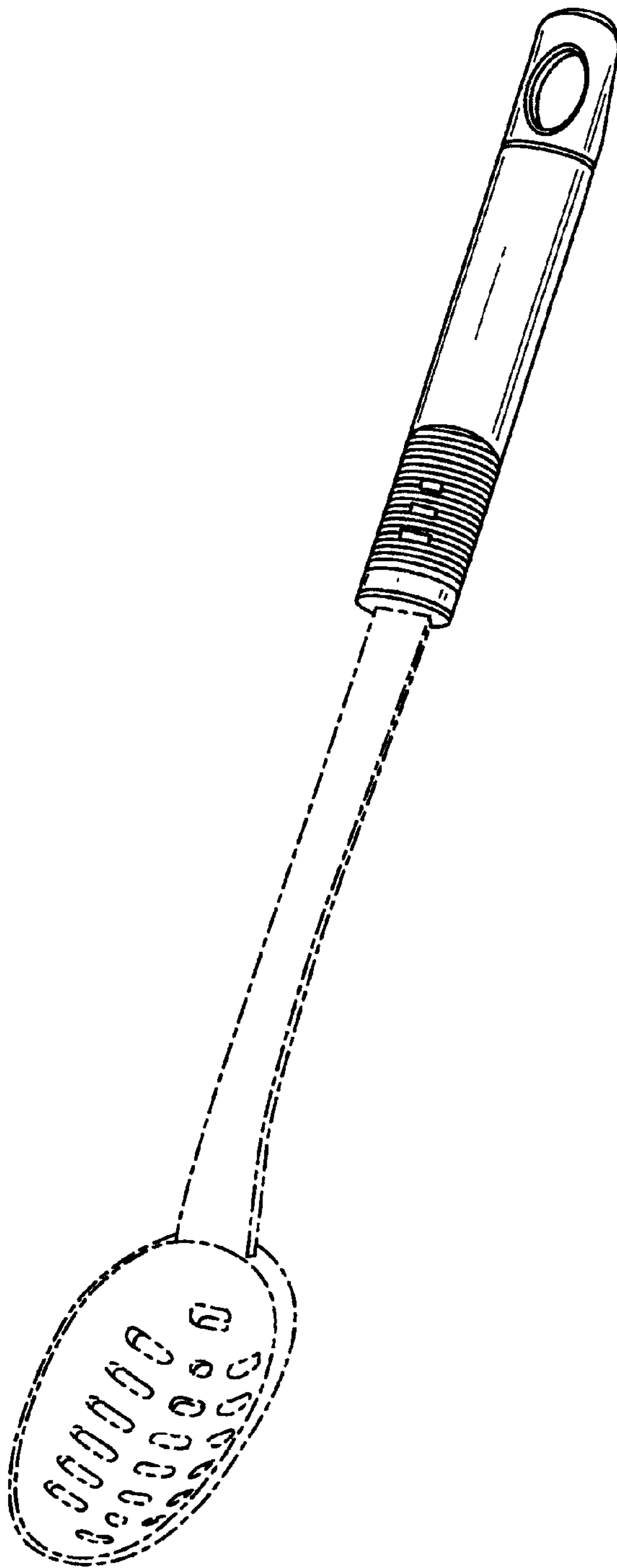

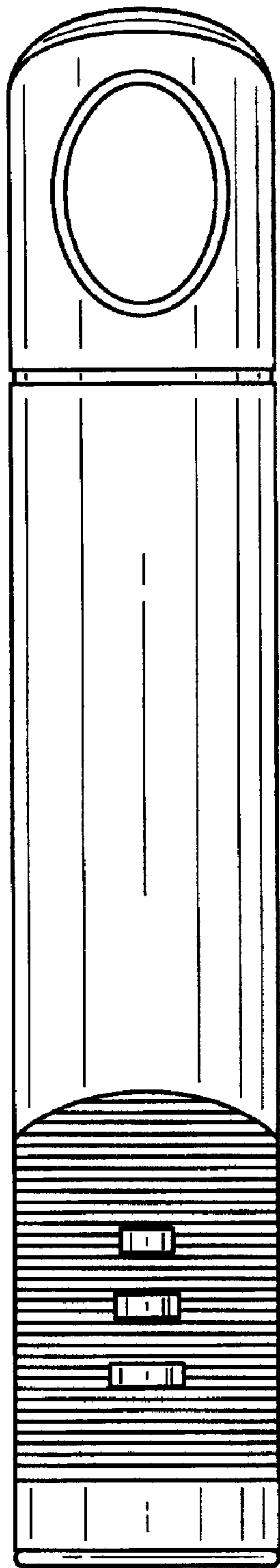

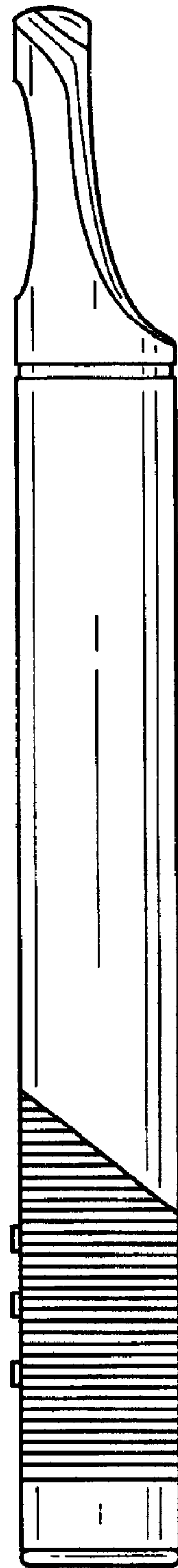

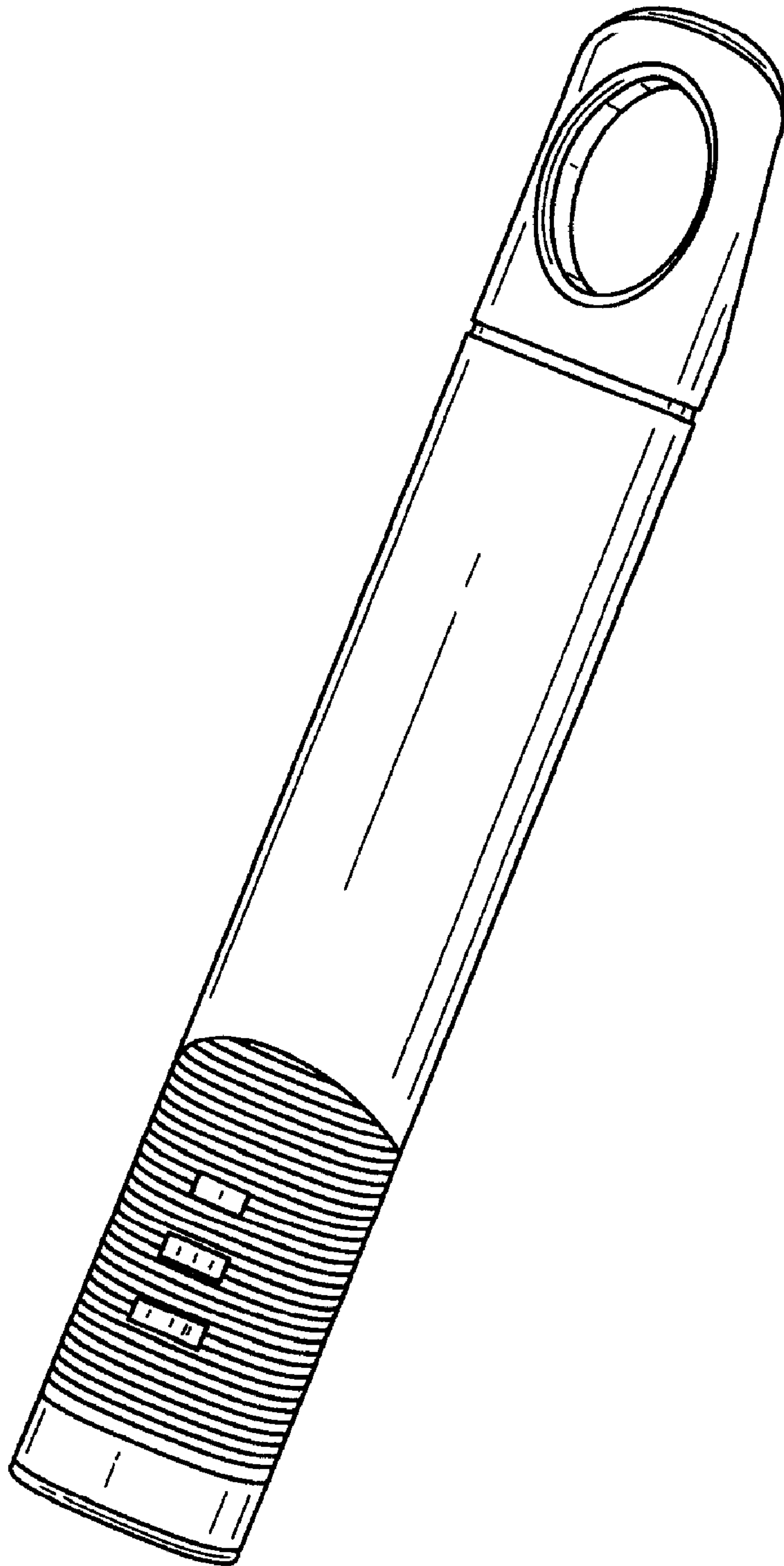

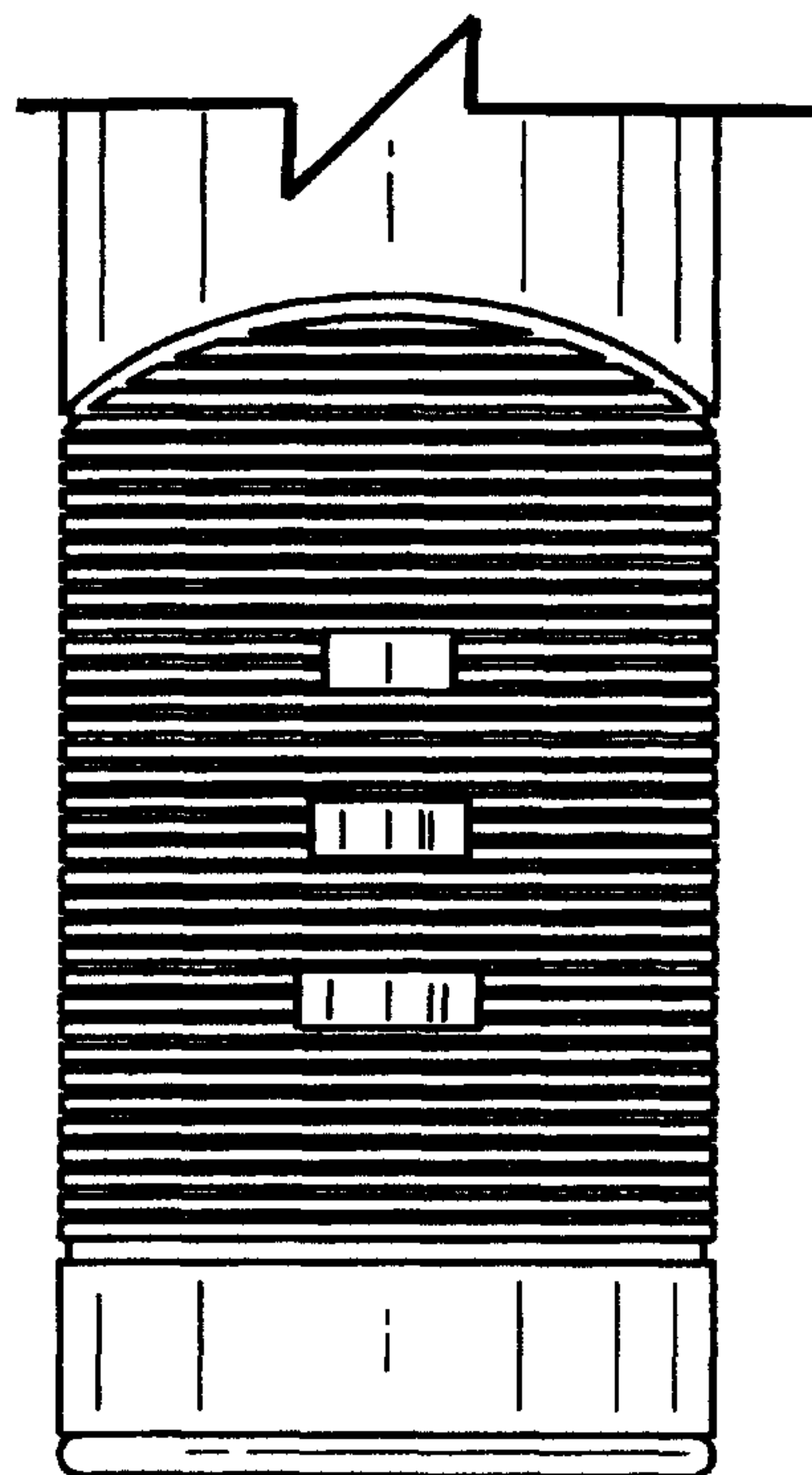

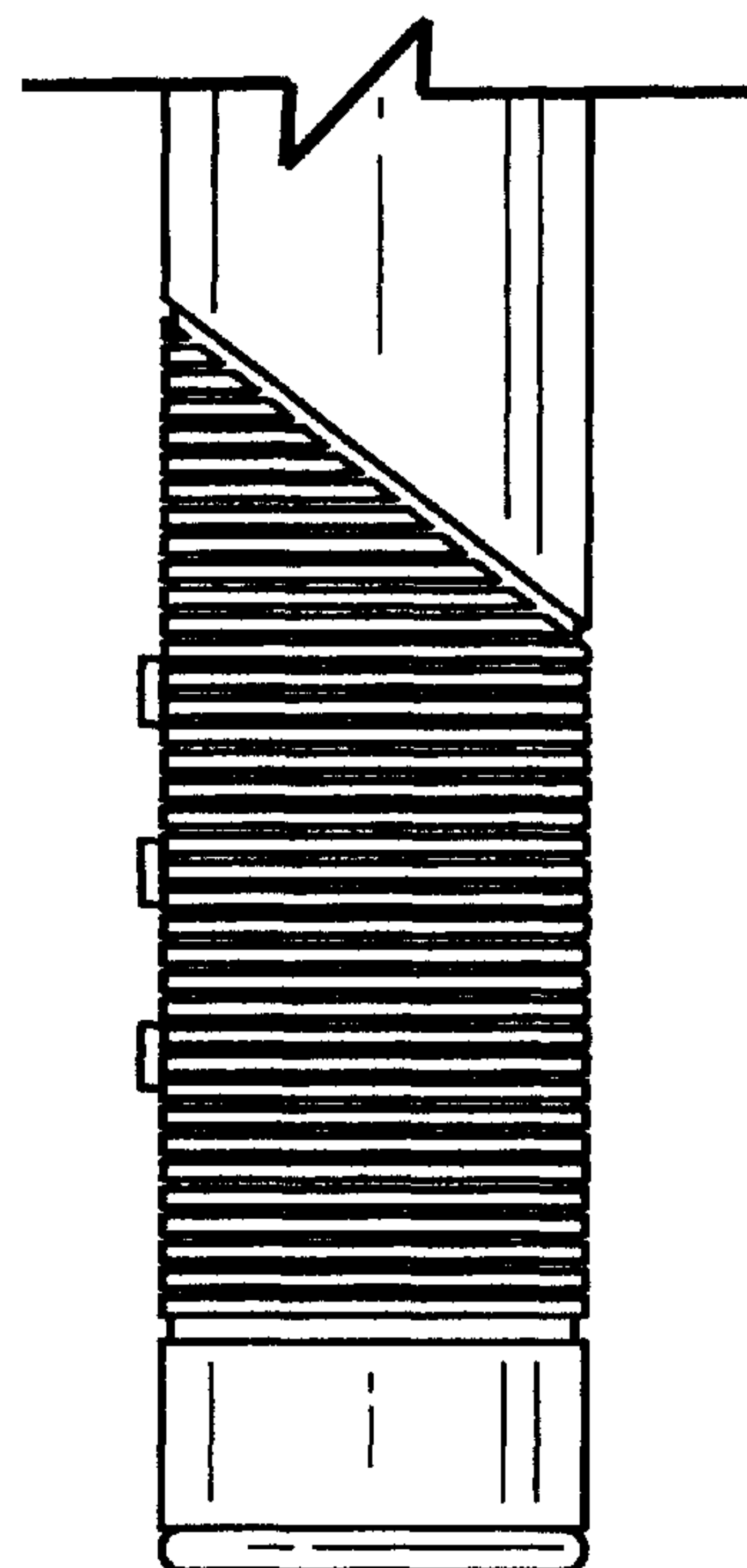

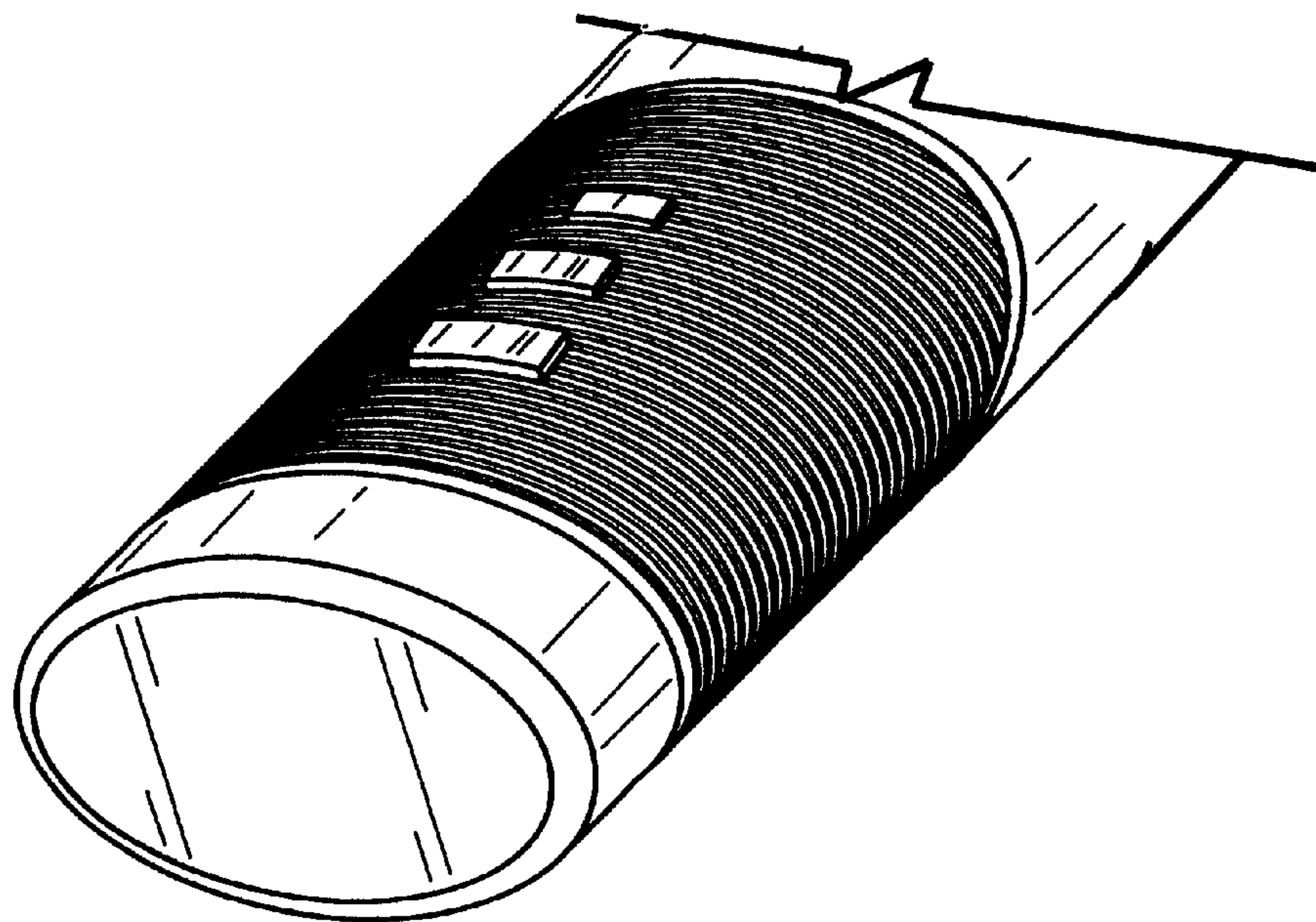
