DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a lunch purse with zip of the present invention;

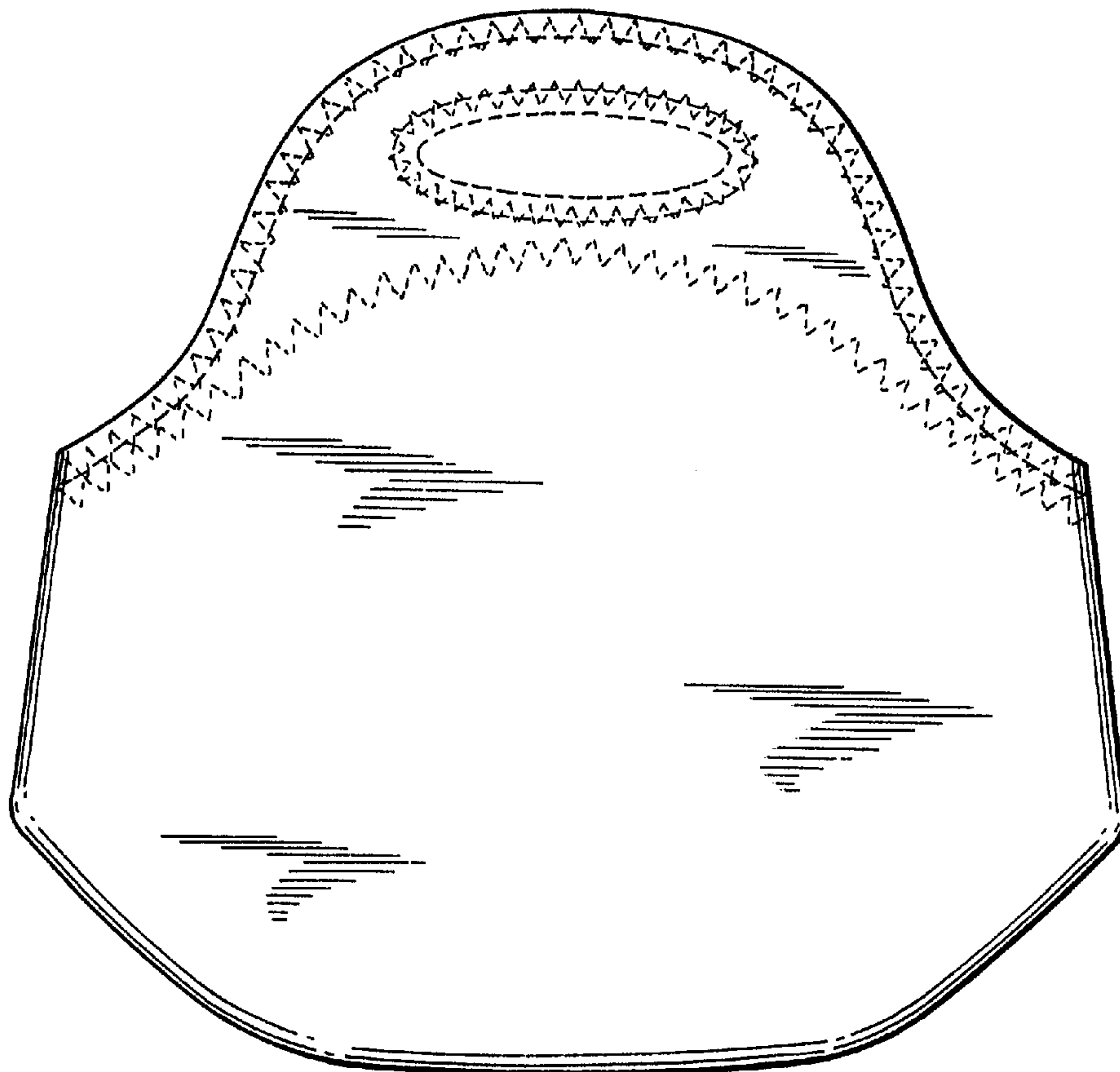
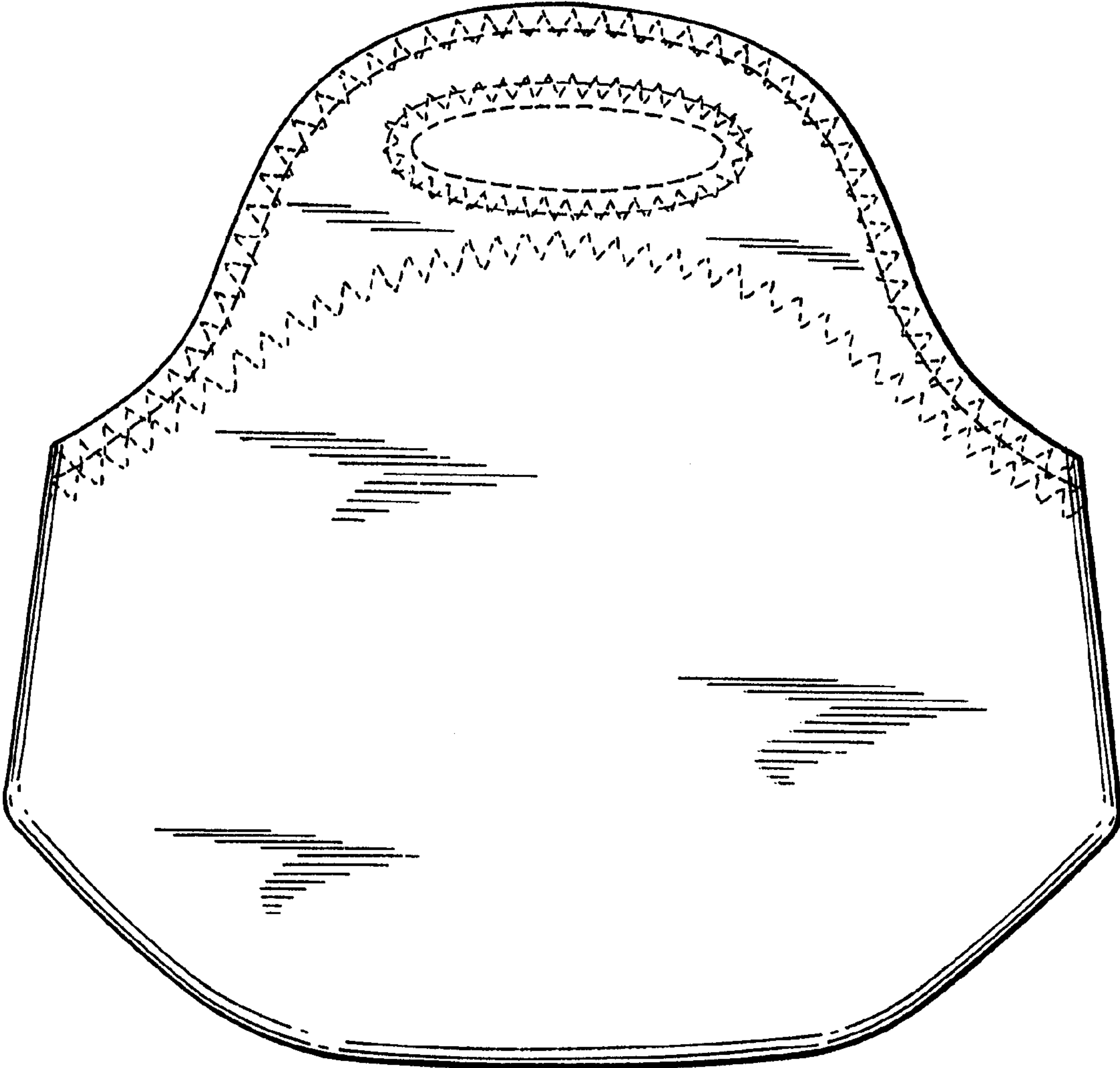

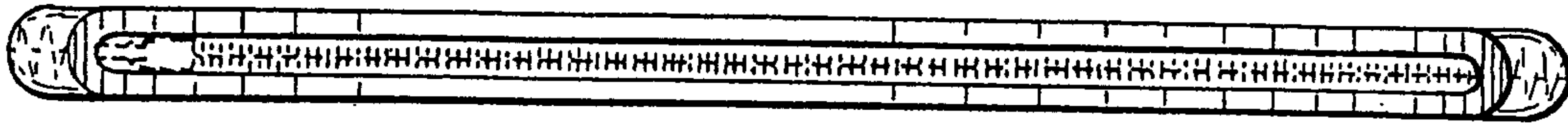
