The ornamental design for a dental flosser with bendable head, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, rear left side perspective view of a dental flosser with bendable head showing my new design in its unbent configuration;

FIG. 2 is a top, front right side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view of the dental flosser of FIG. 3; the left side elevation view is the mirror image of the right side elevation view;

FIG. 6 is a top rear left side perspective view of the dental flosser of FIG. 1, now shown in its bent configuration;

FIG. 7 is a top front right side perspective view of the flosser of FIG. 5;

FIG. 8 is a fragmentary front perspective view of the dental flosser of FIG. 5;

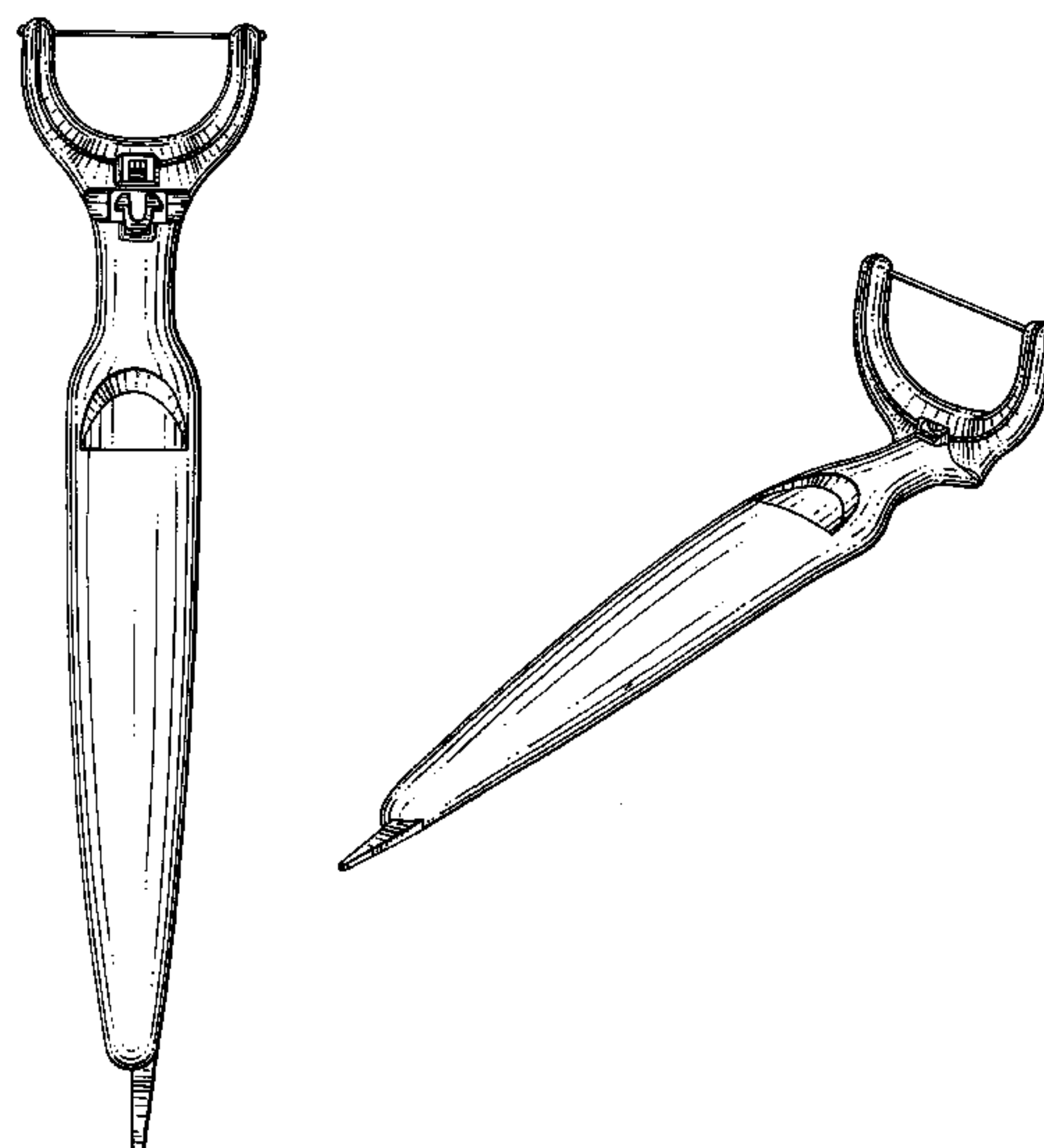
FIG. 9 is a side elevation view of the dental flosser of FIG. 5;

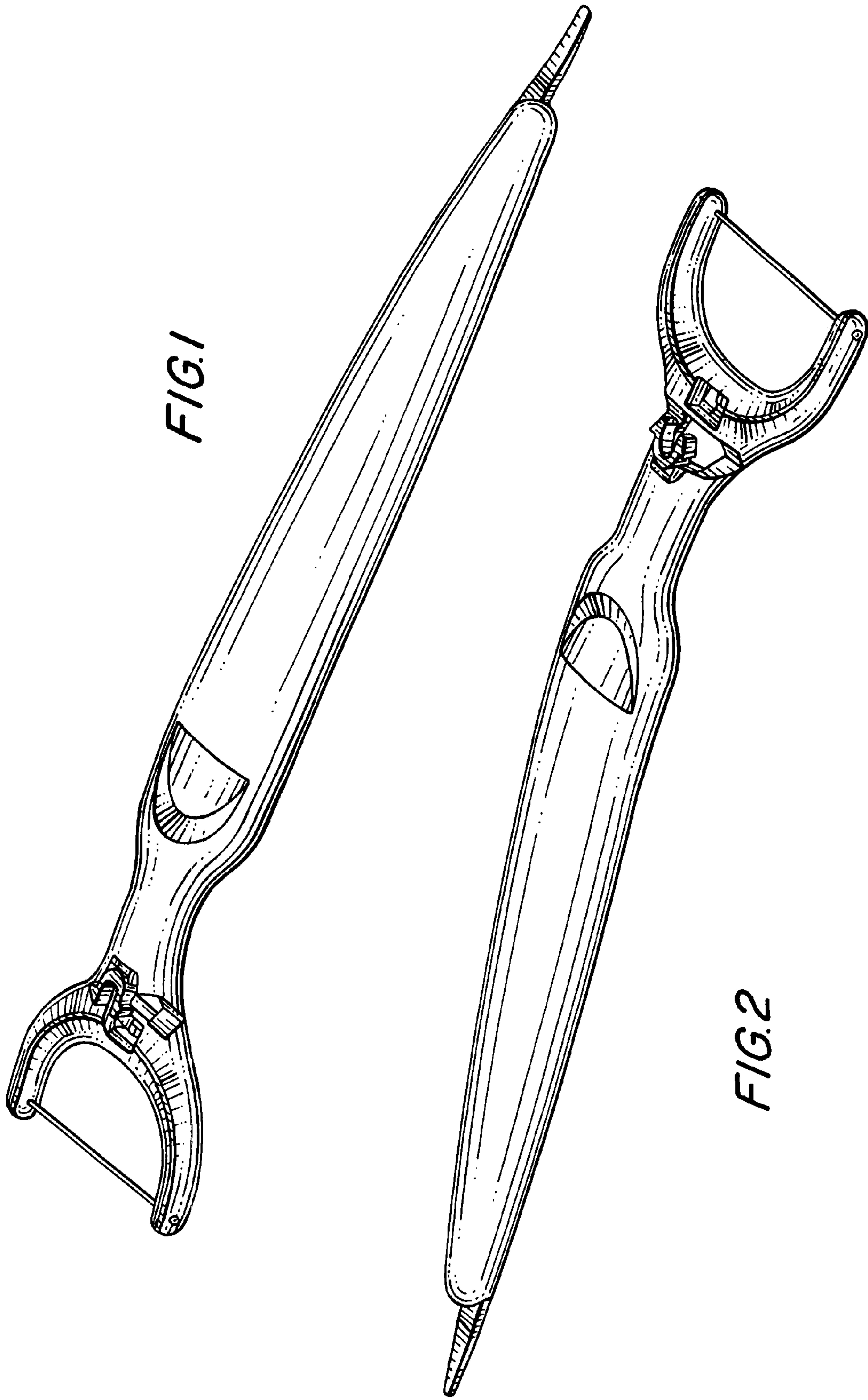
FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of the dental flosser of FIG. 5; and,

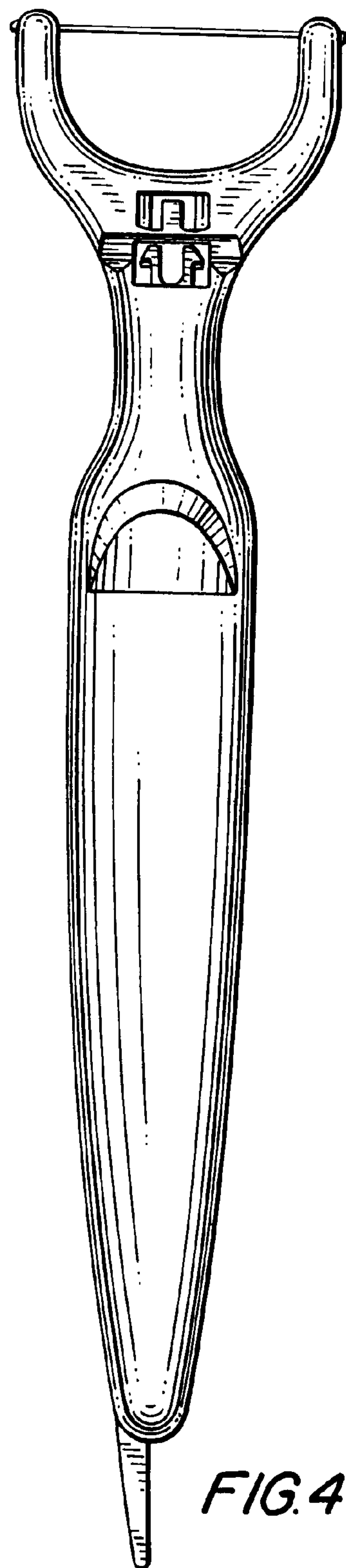
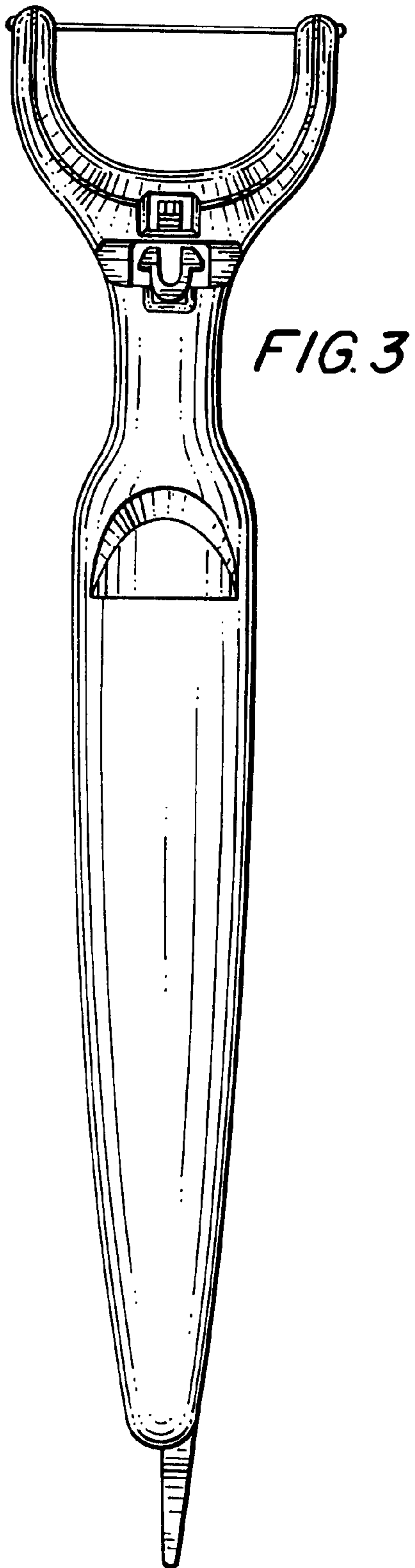
FIG. 11 is a rear perspective view of the dental flosser of FIG. 5.

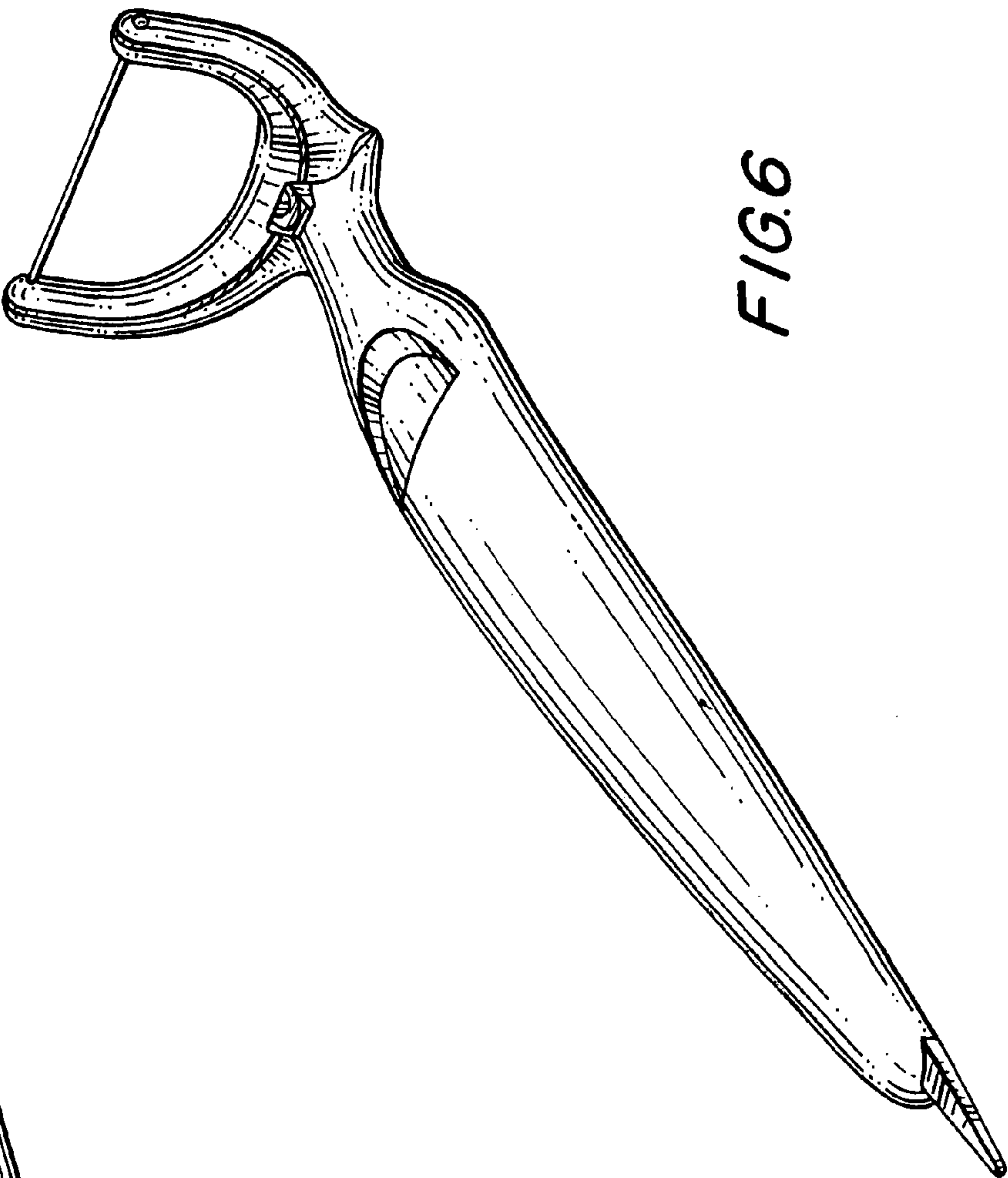
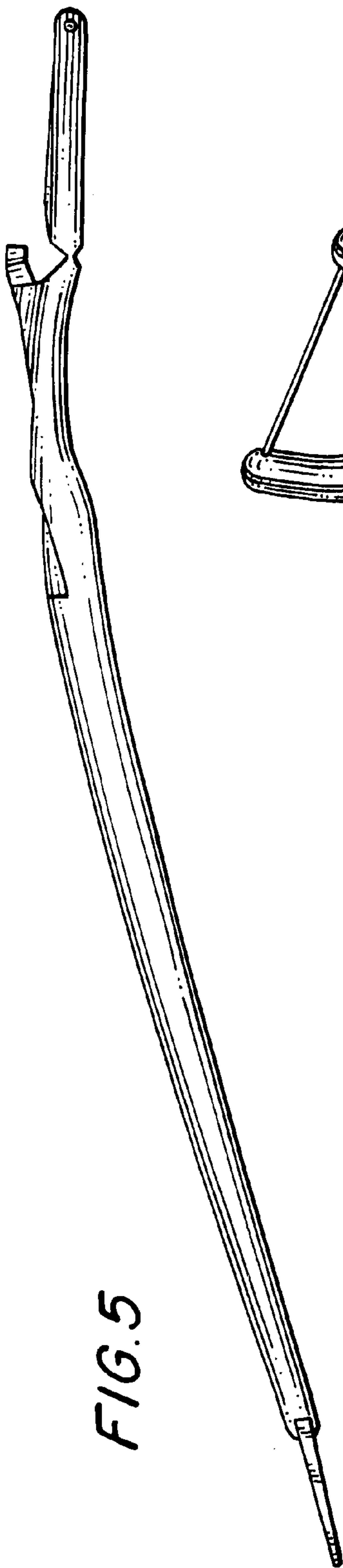

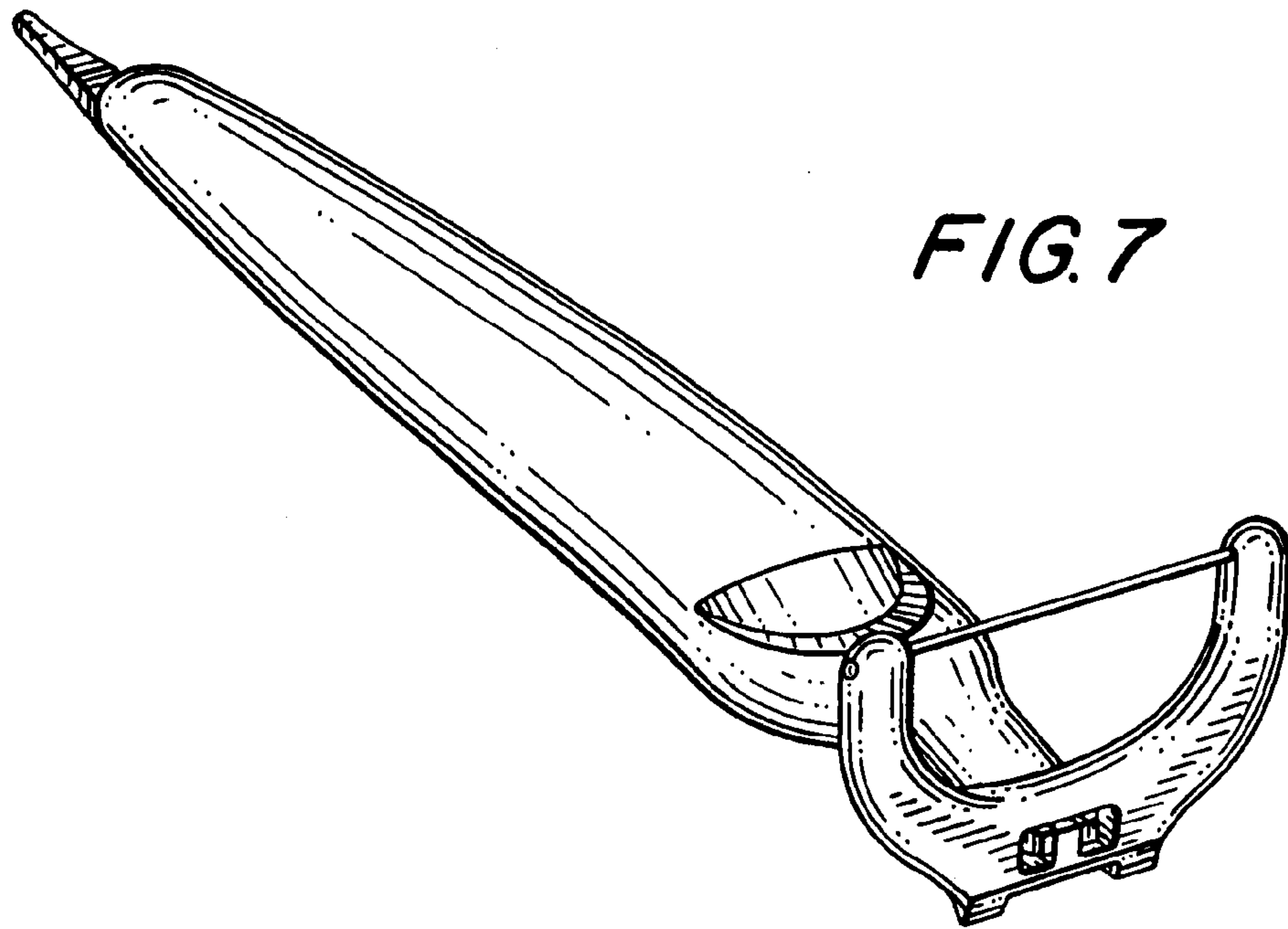
