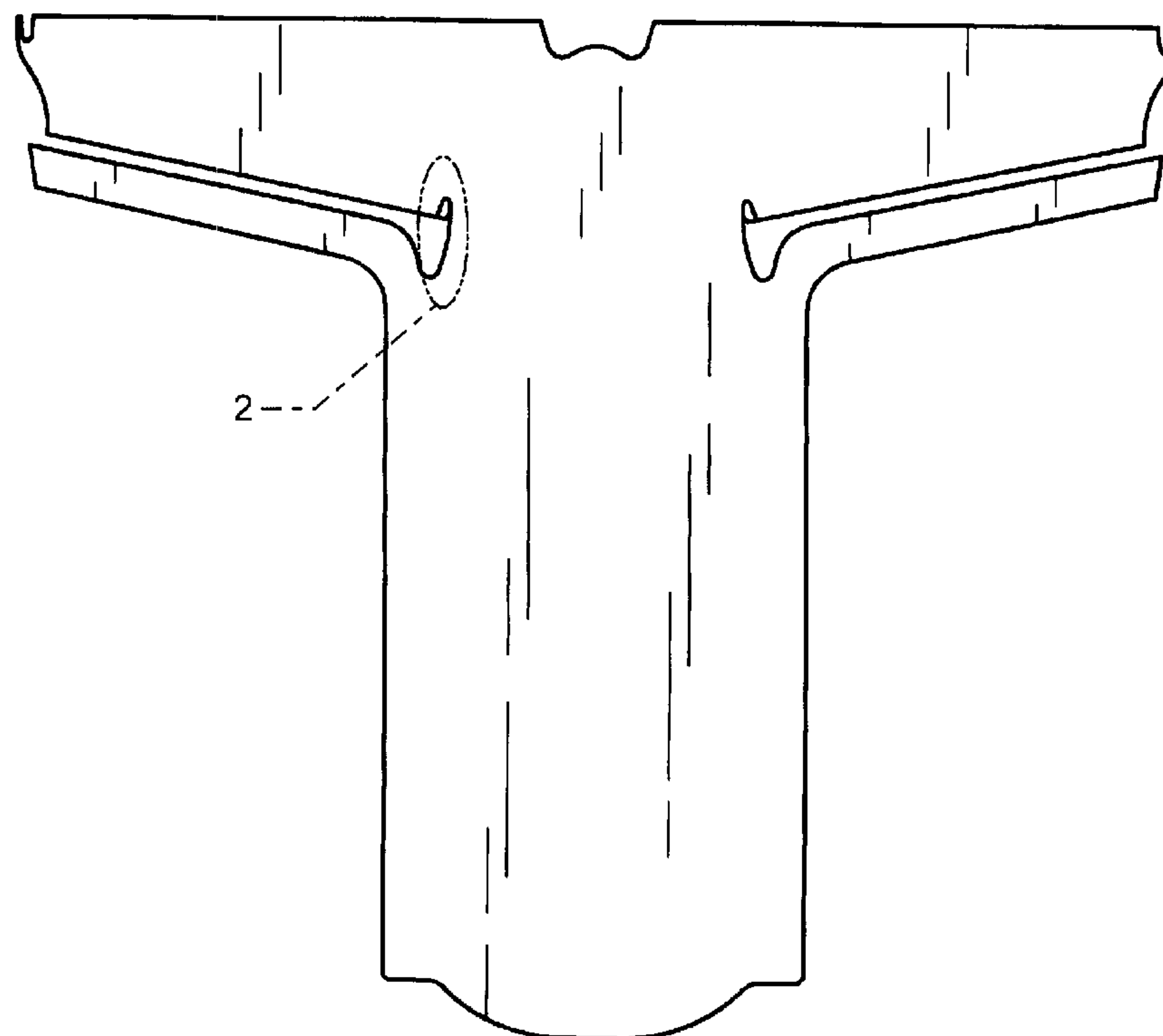
(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a disposable medical gown, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a disposable medical gown;
FIG. 2 is a detailed view of the disposable medical gown shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a rear view of the disposable medical gown;
FIG. 4 is a detailed rear view of the disposable medical gown shown in FIG. 3; and,
FIG. 5 is a detailed rear view of the disposable medical gown shown in FIG. 3.
The broken line disclosure, figure lead lines excepted, represents the tear away portion of the article.

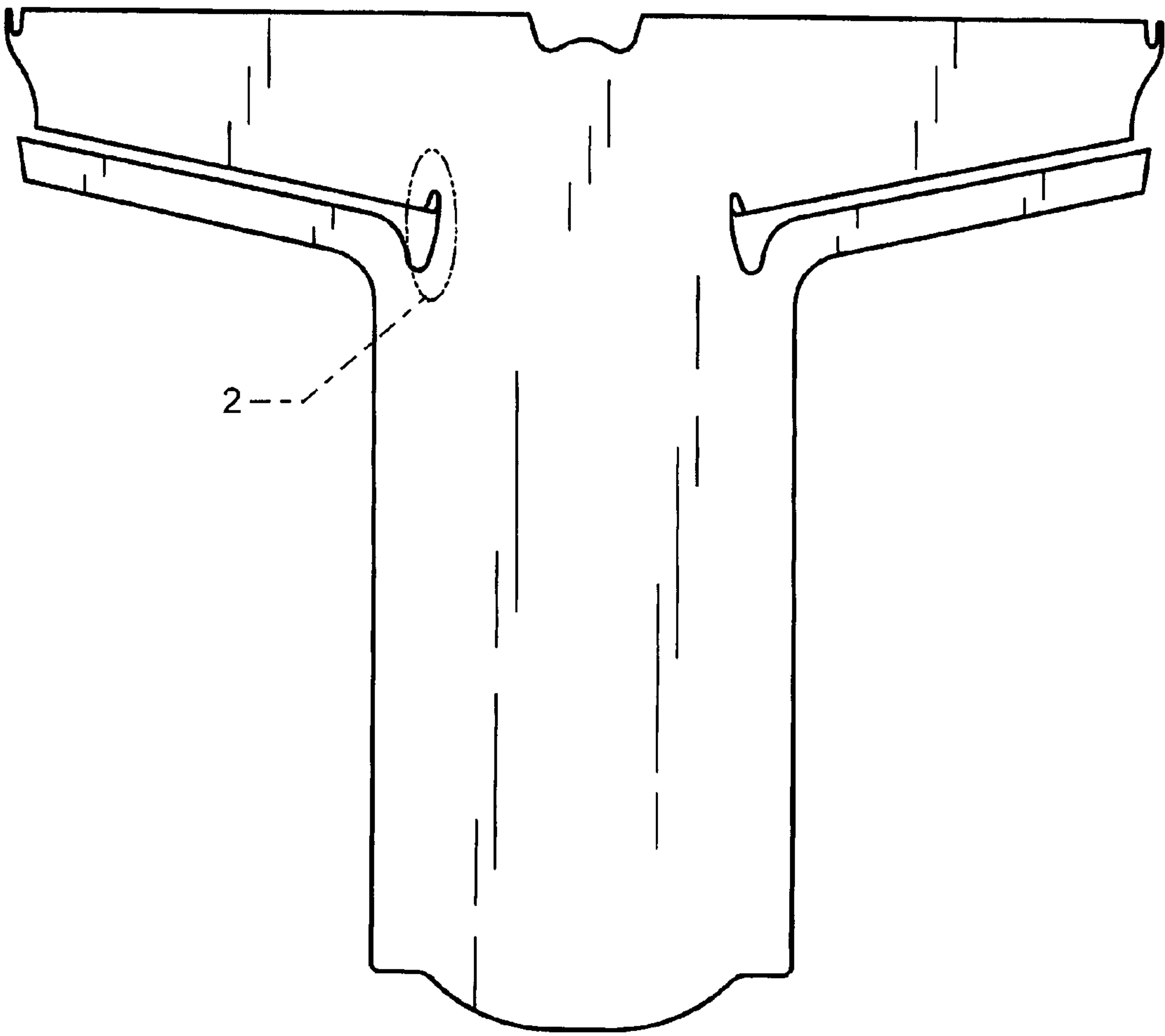

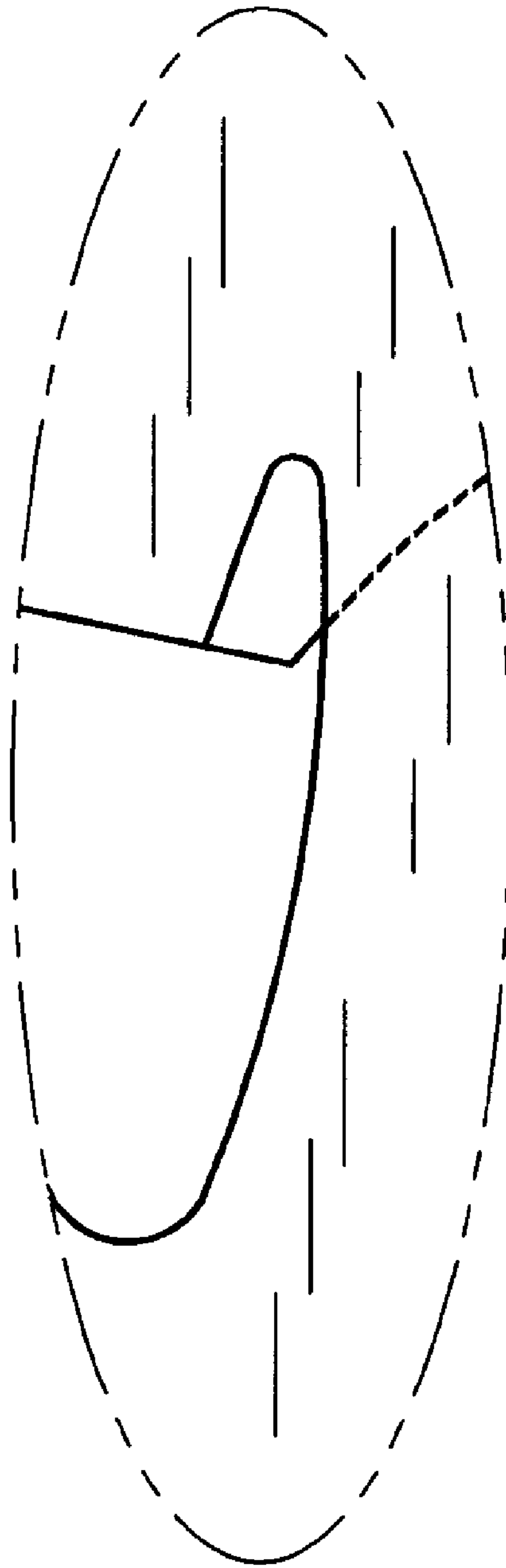

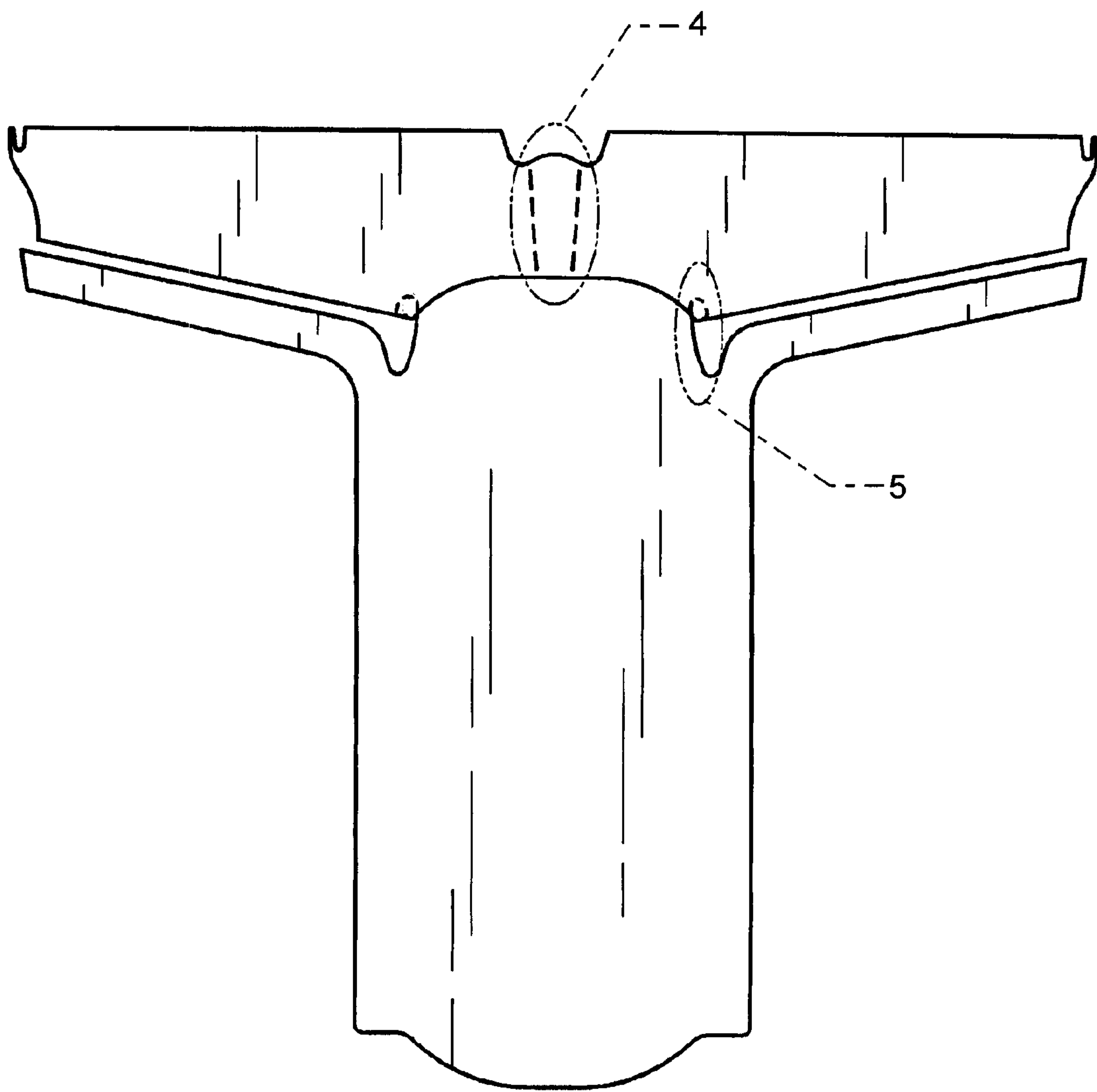

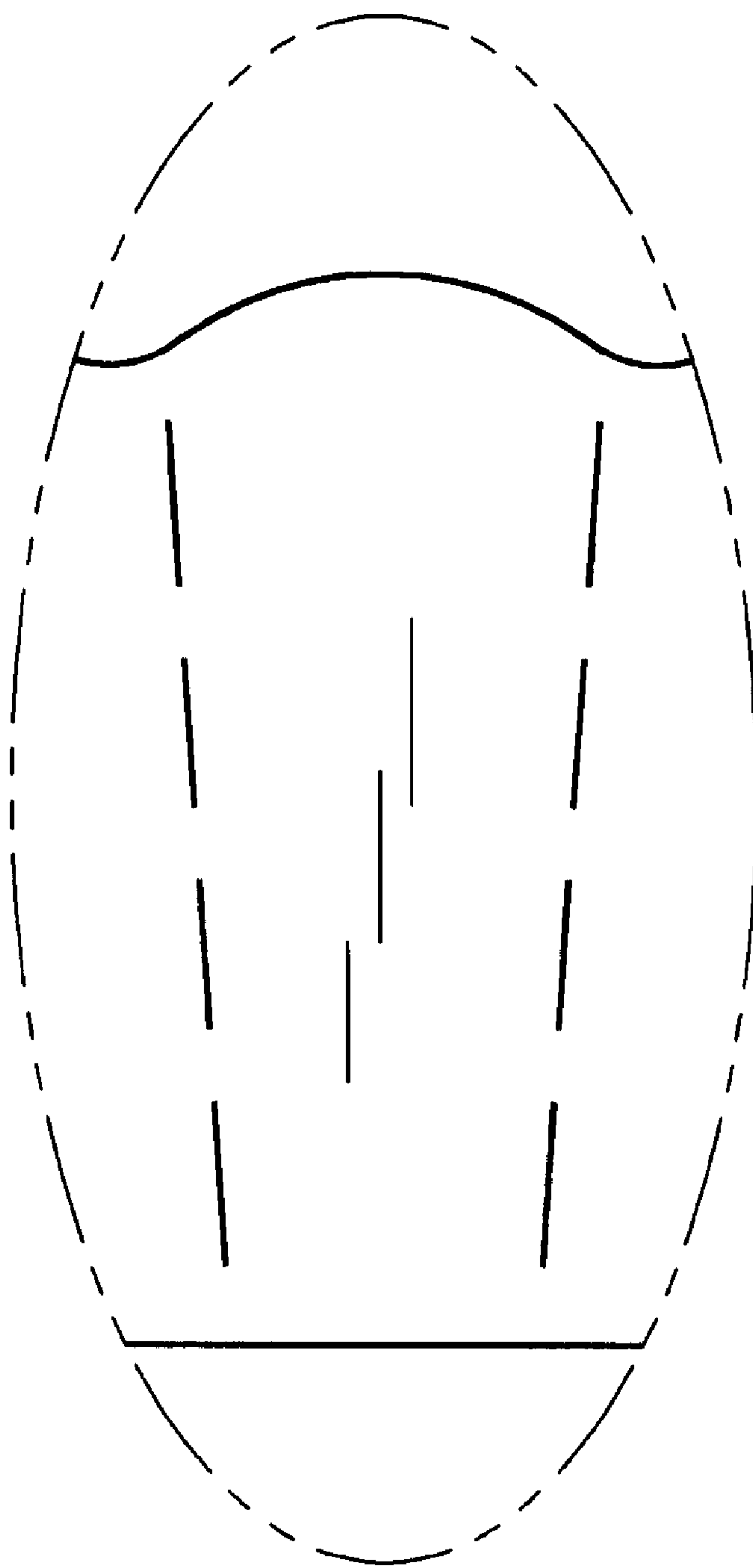

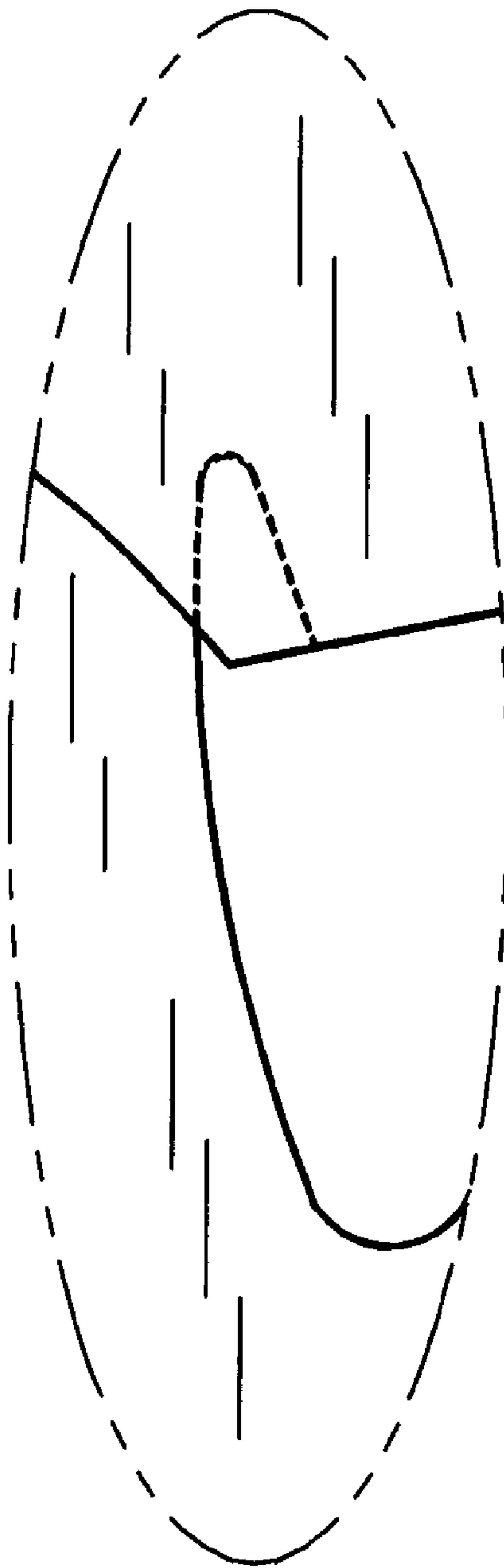
