The ornamental design for an interactive display card, as shown and described.

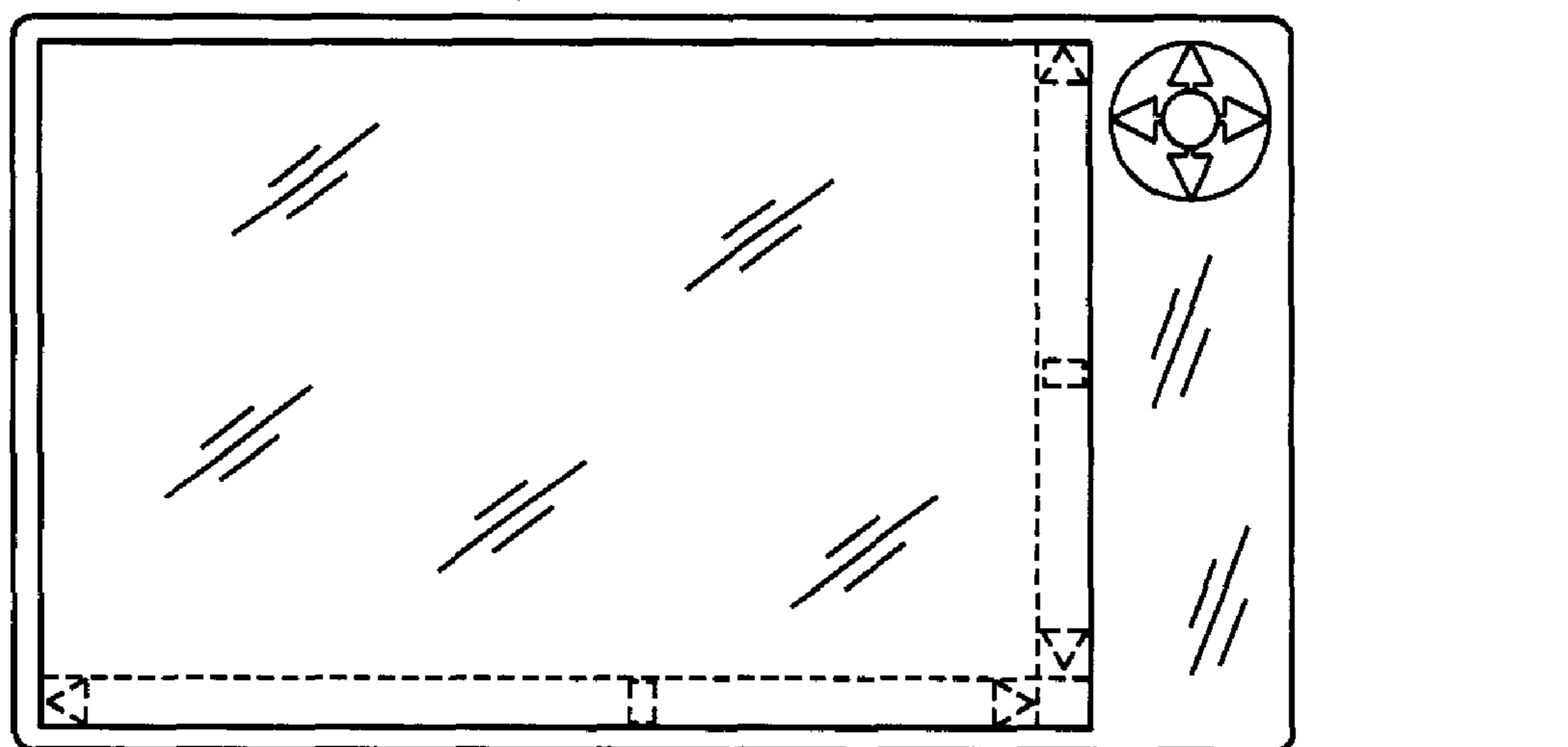
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an interactive display card showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, it being understood that the opposite side is a mirror image and therefore is not shown; and,
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; it being understood that the rear elevational view is a mirror image thereof and therefore is not shown.
 The elements shown in dashed line are not part of the claimed invention.

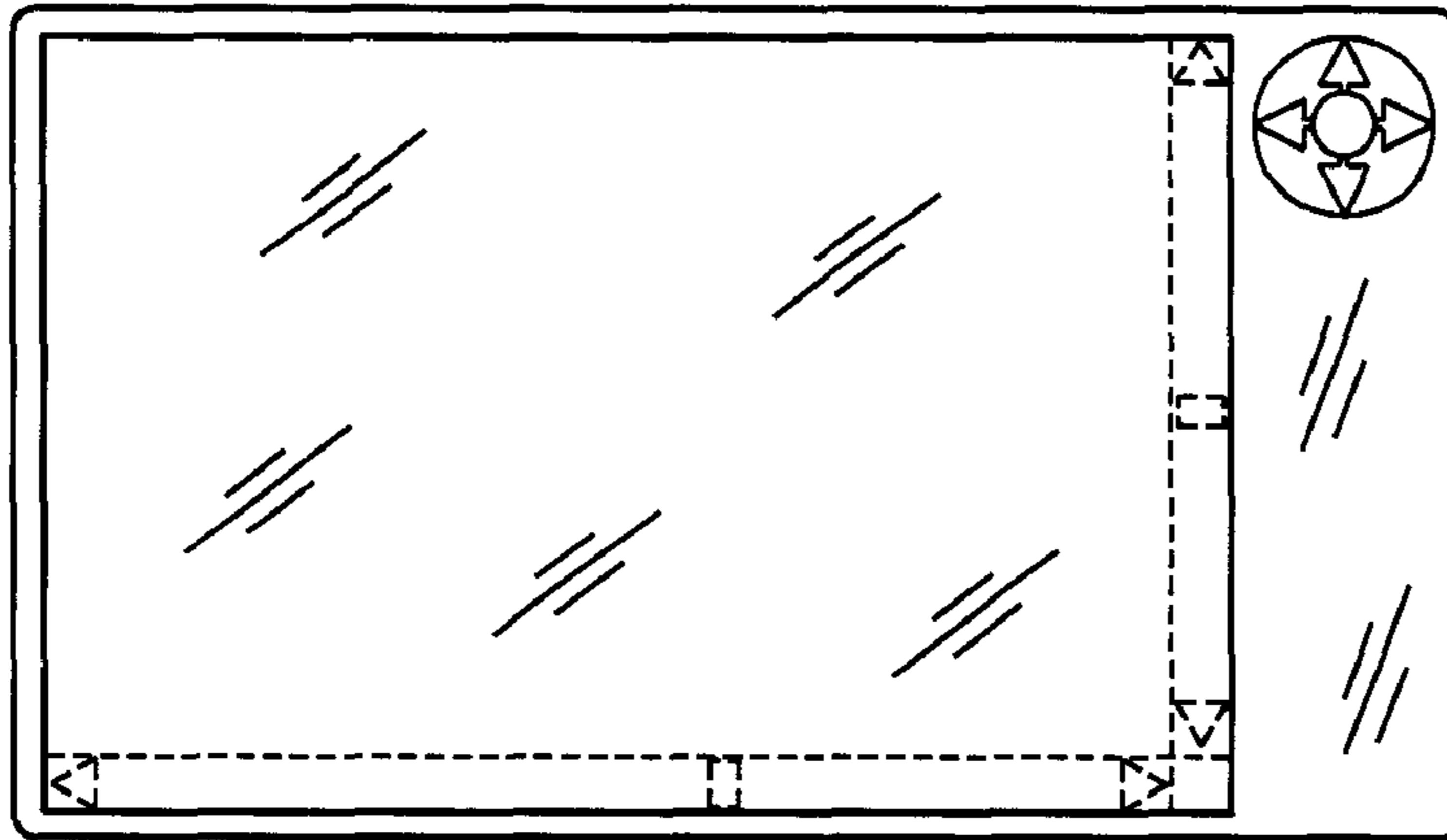

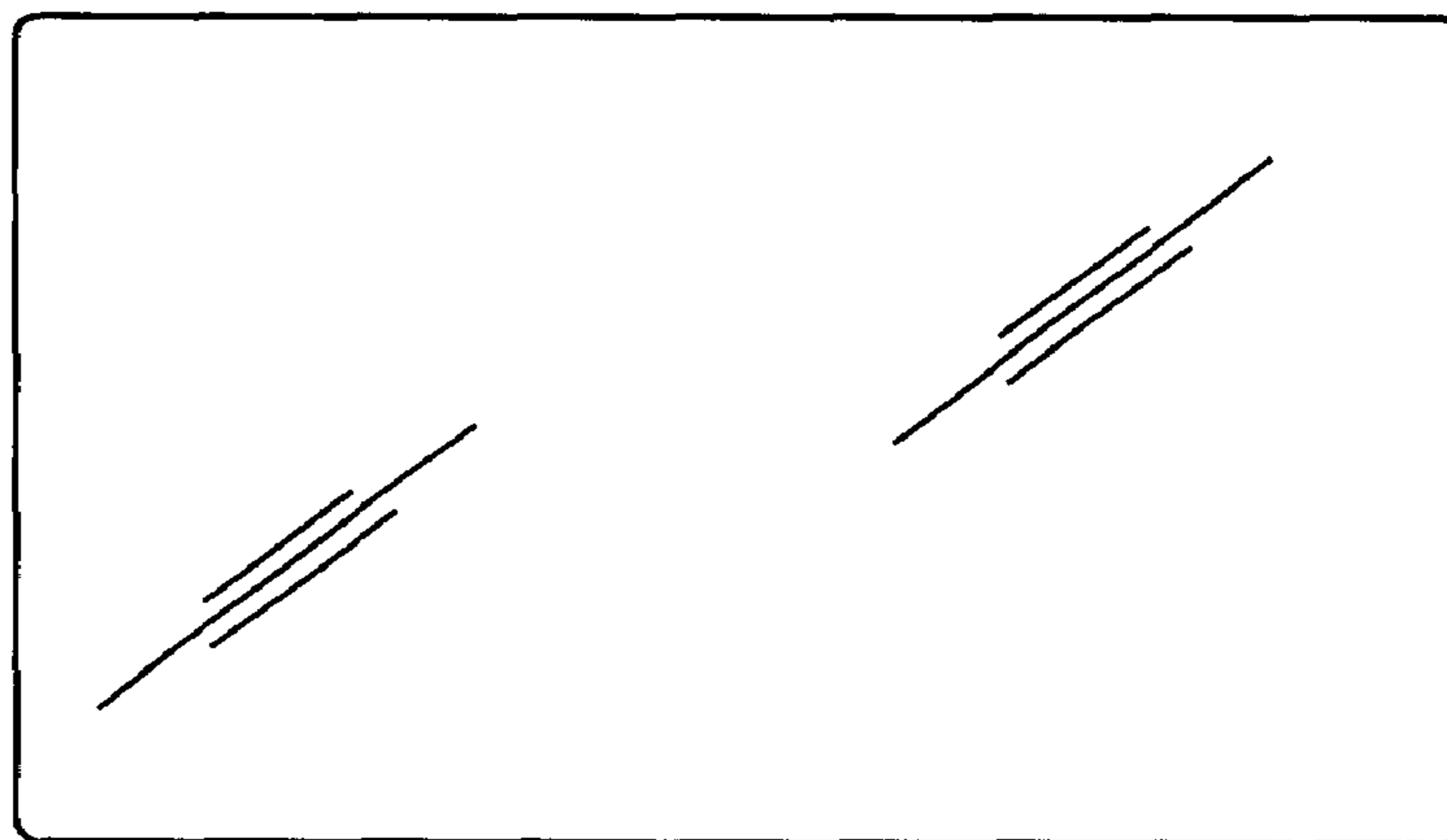
