

I claim the ornamental design for a briefcase with internal organization, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the briefcase with internal organization of the invention;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the briefcase with internal organization of the invention;

FIG. 3 is a front view of the briefcase with internal organization of the invention;

FIG. 4 is a left side view of the briefcase with internal organization of the invention;

FIG. 5 is a right side view of the briefcase with internal organization of the invention;


FIG. 6 is a back view of the briefcase with internal organization of the invention;


FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the briefcase with internal organization of the invention; and,


FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the open briefcase with internal organization of FIG. 1.






















