CLAIM (57)

I claim the ornamental design for a reversible cover for electronic chassis, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a reversible cover for electronic chassis showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof, enlarged;


FIG. 3 is a top end perspective view of the design of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is another top end perspective view thereof, tilted forwardly and rotated to the left;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged perspective view thereof, rotated to the right, and the broken line showing of a duplex electric socket is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design; and,

FIG. 6 is a reduced rear perspective view thereof, the broken line showing of the back of a duplex electric socket is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.








