FIG. 3 is a left-side view of the expandable power and data center in accordance with my invention;

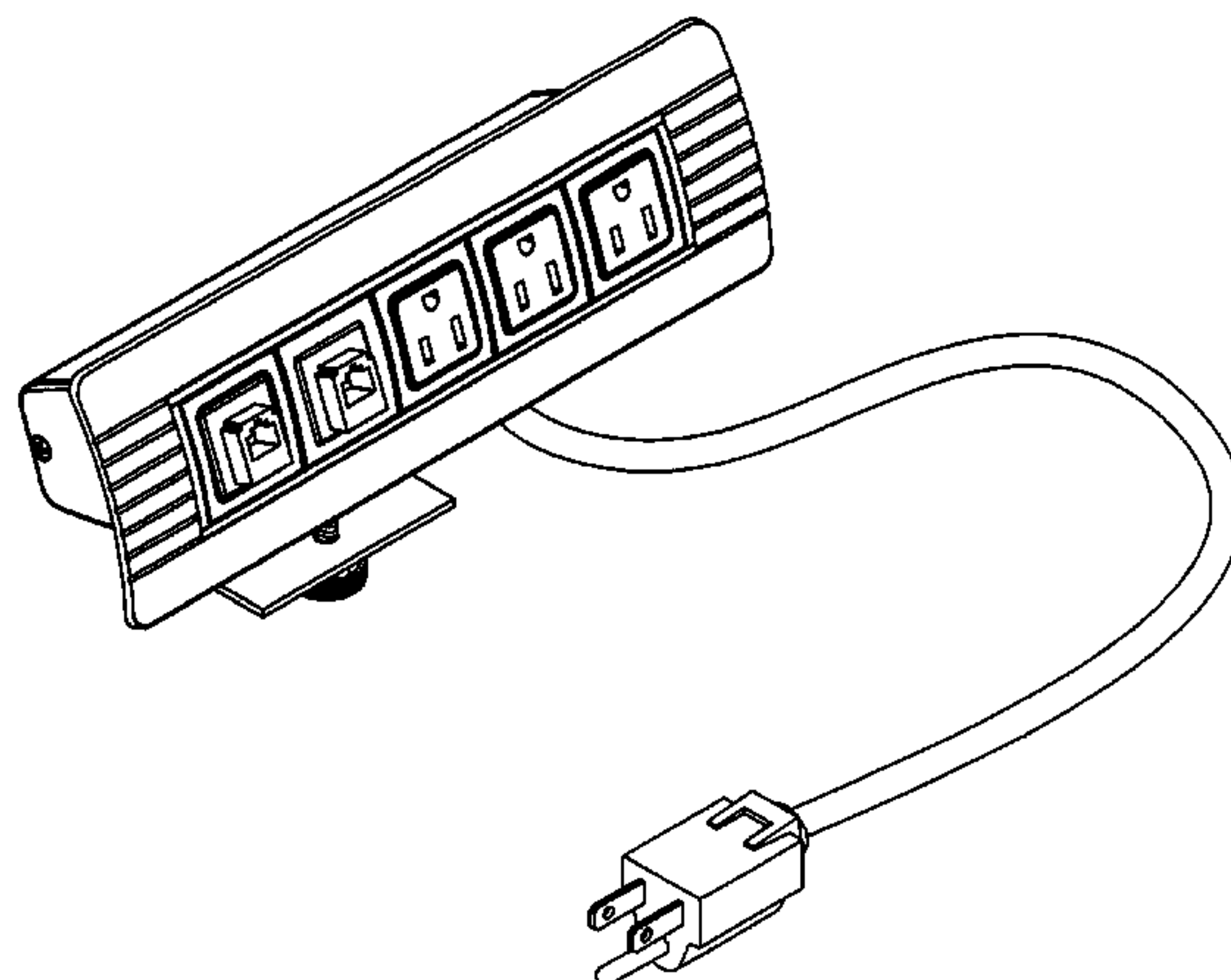
FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of the expandable power and data center in accordance with my invention;

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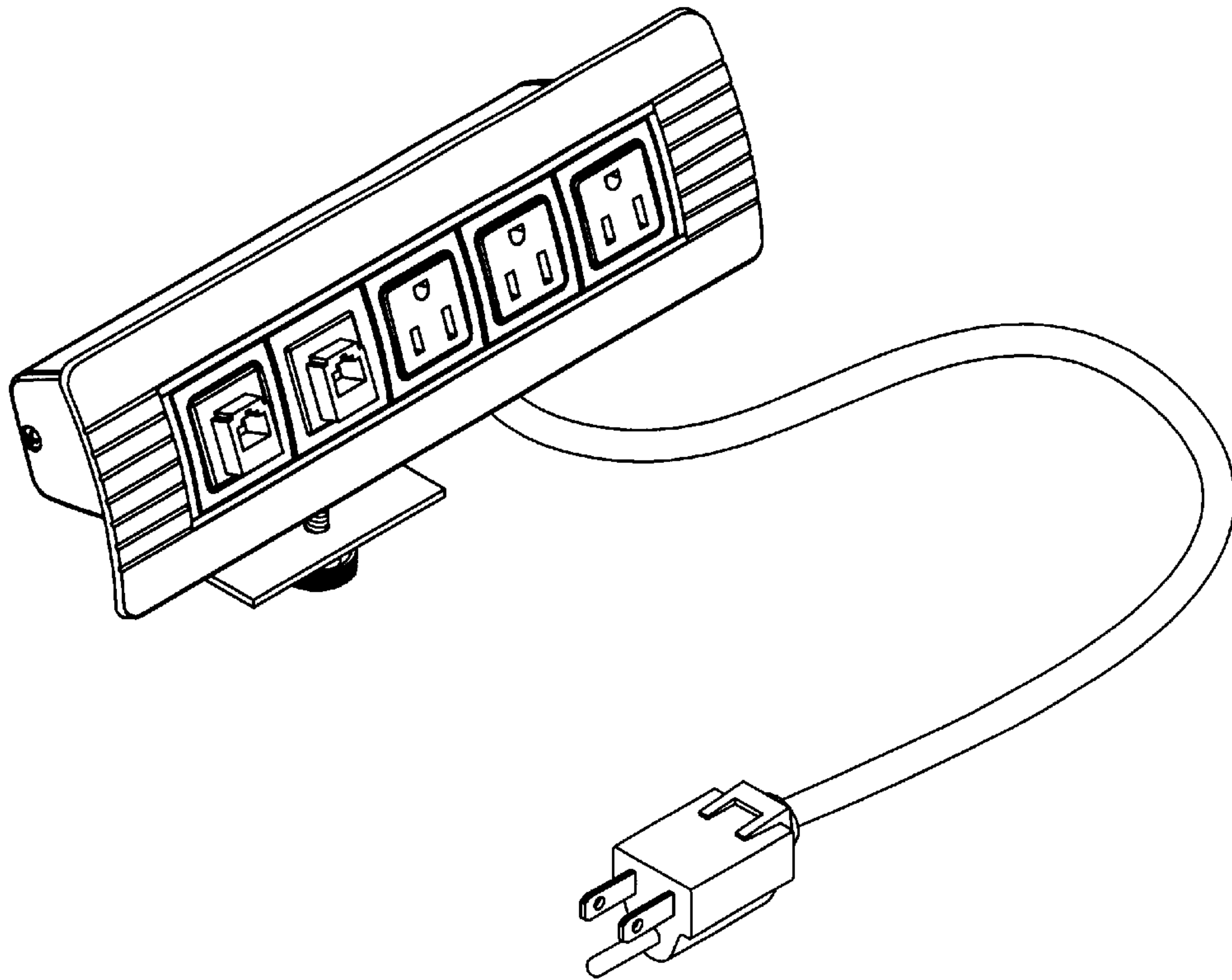

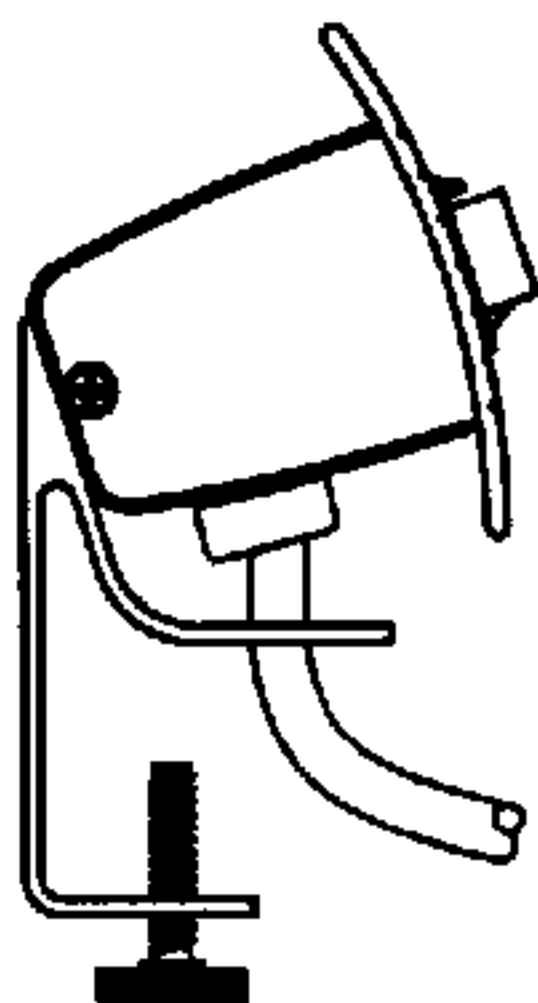

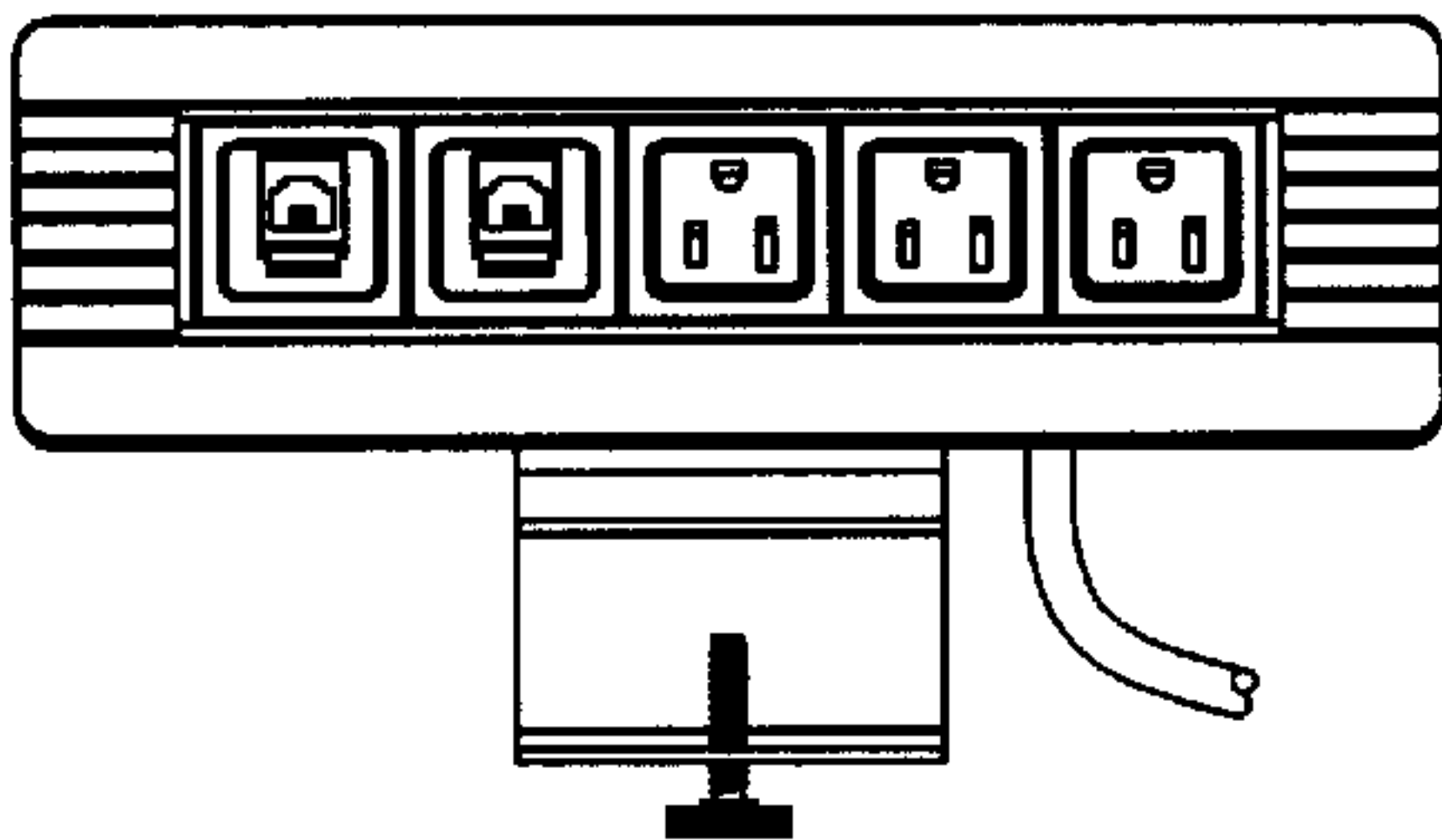

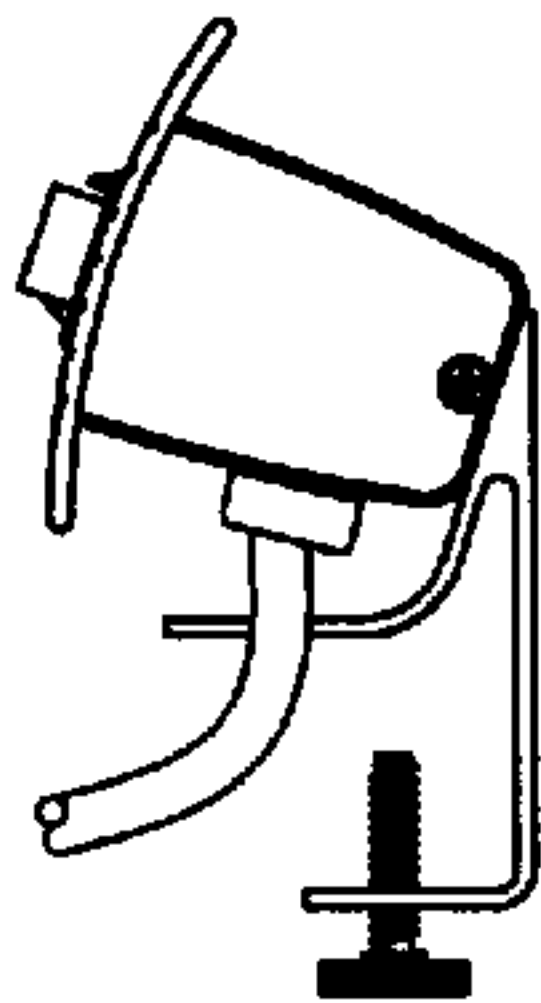

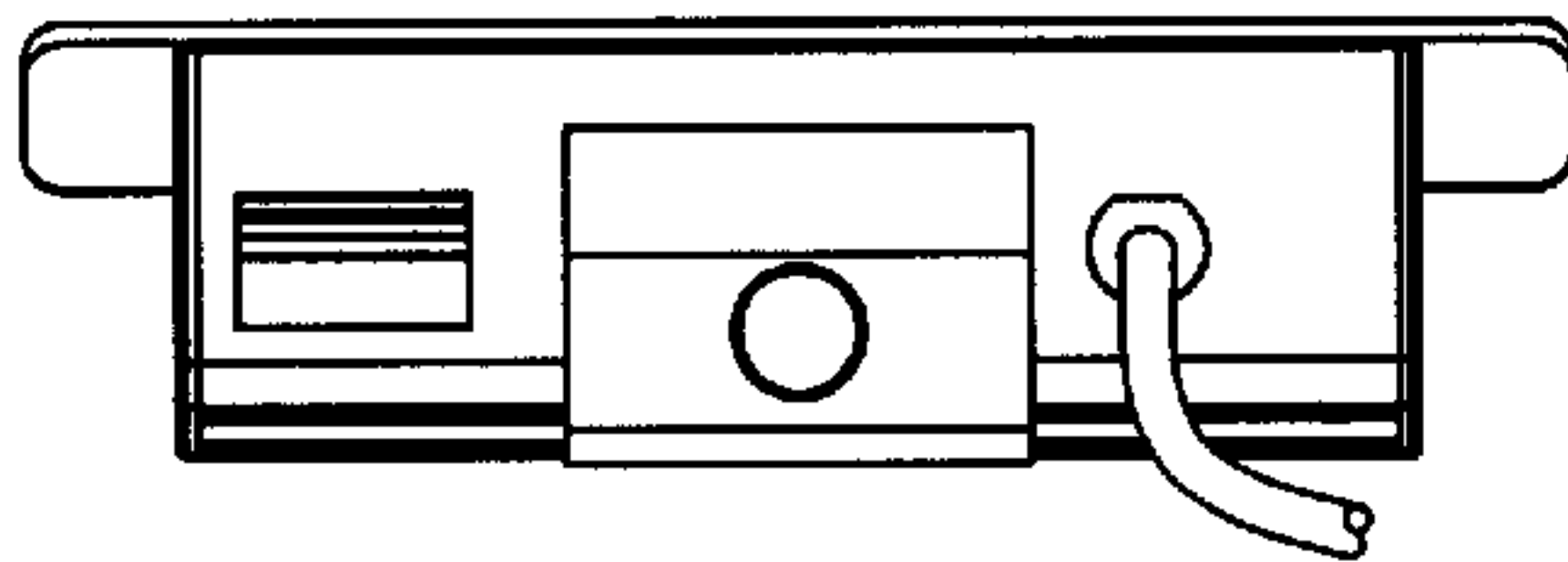

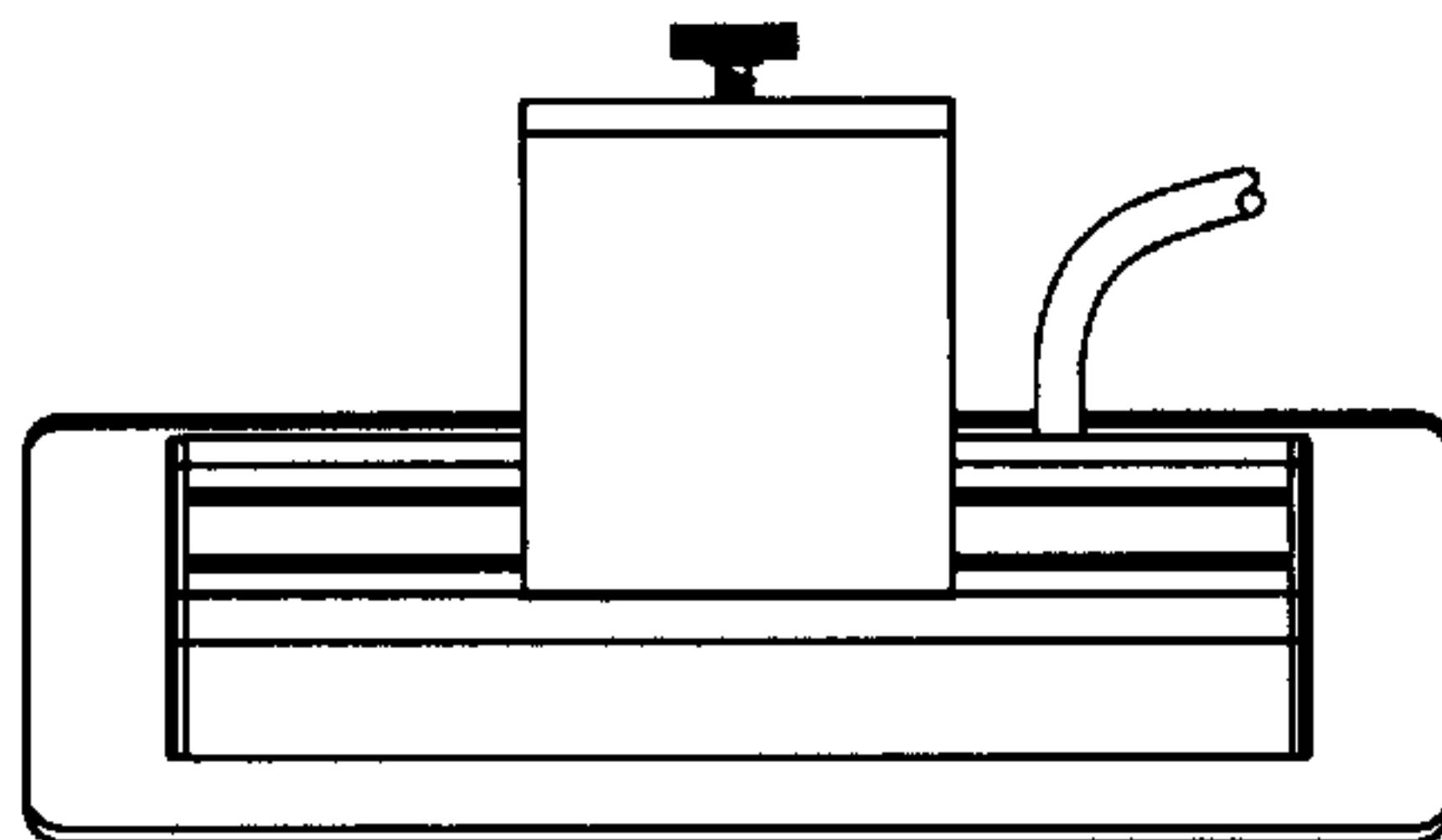
