We claim the ornamental design for a cap, as shown.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front left perspective view of a cap embodying our new design.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the cap of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the cap of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the cap of FIG. 1.

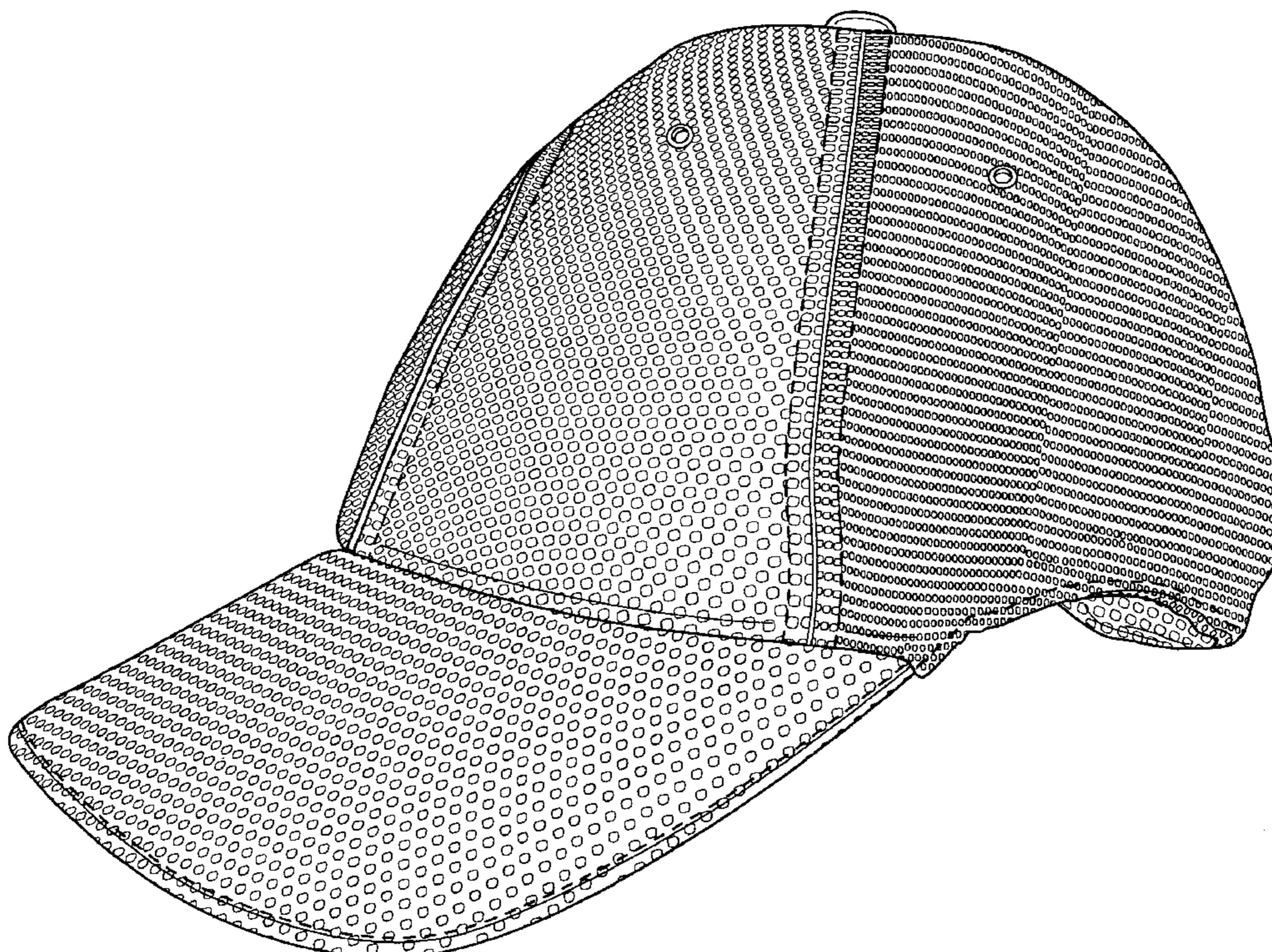
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the cap of FIG. 1.

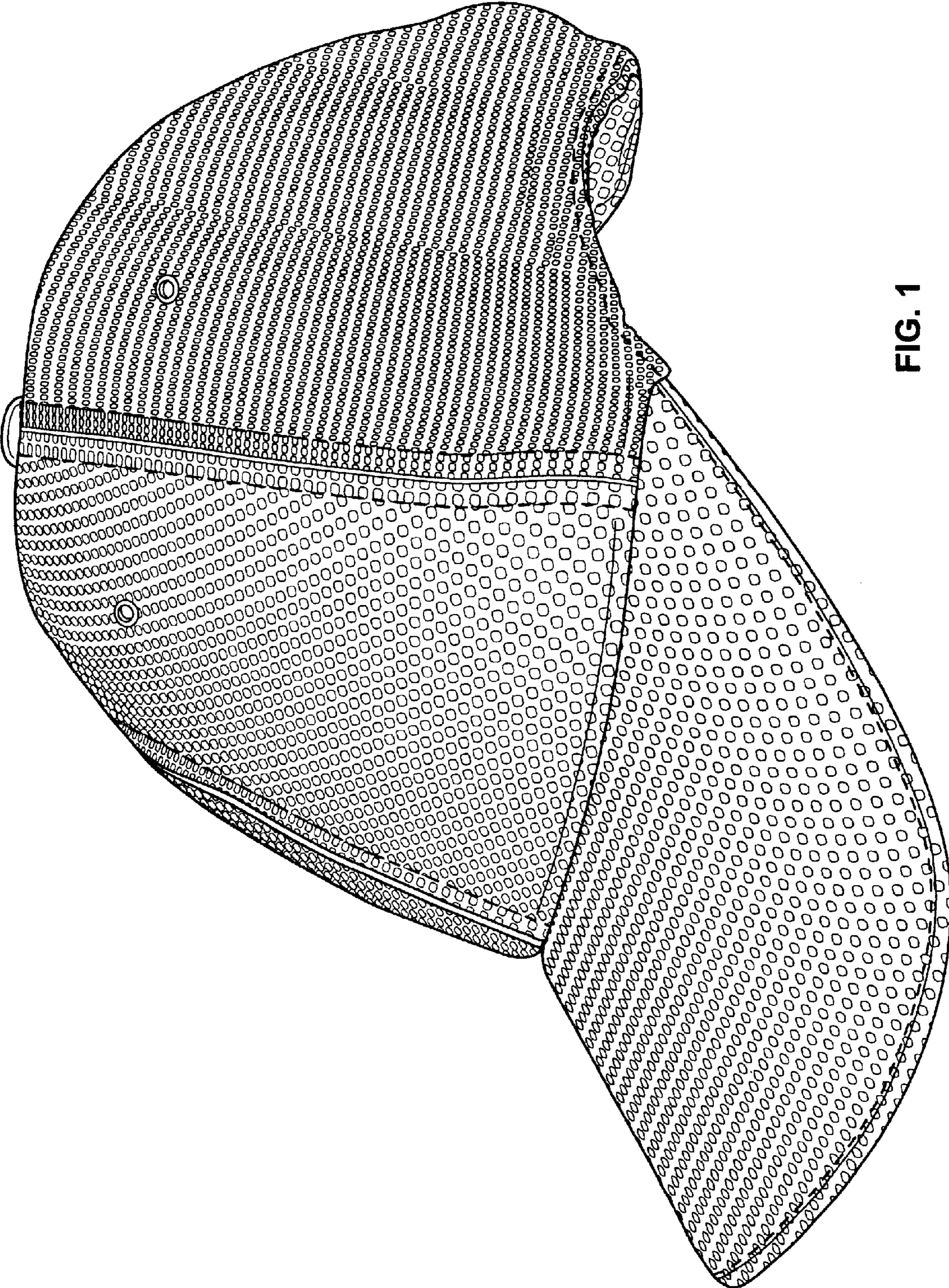

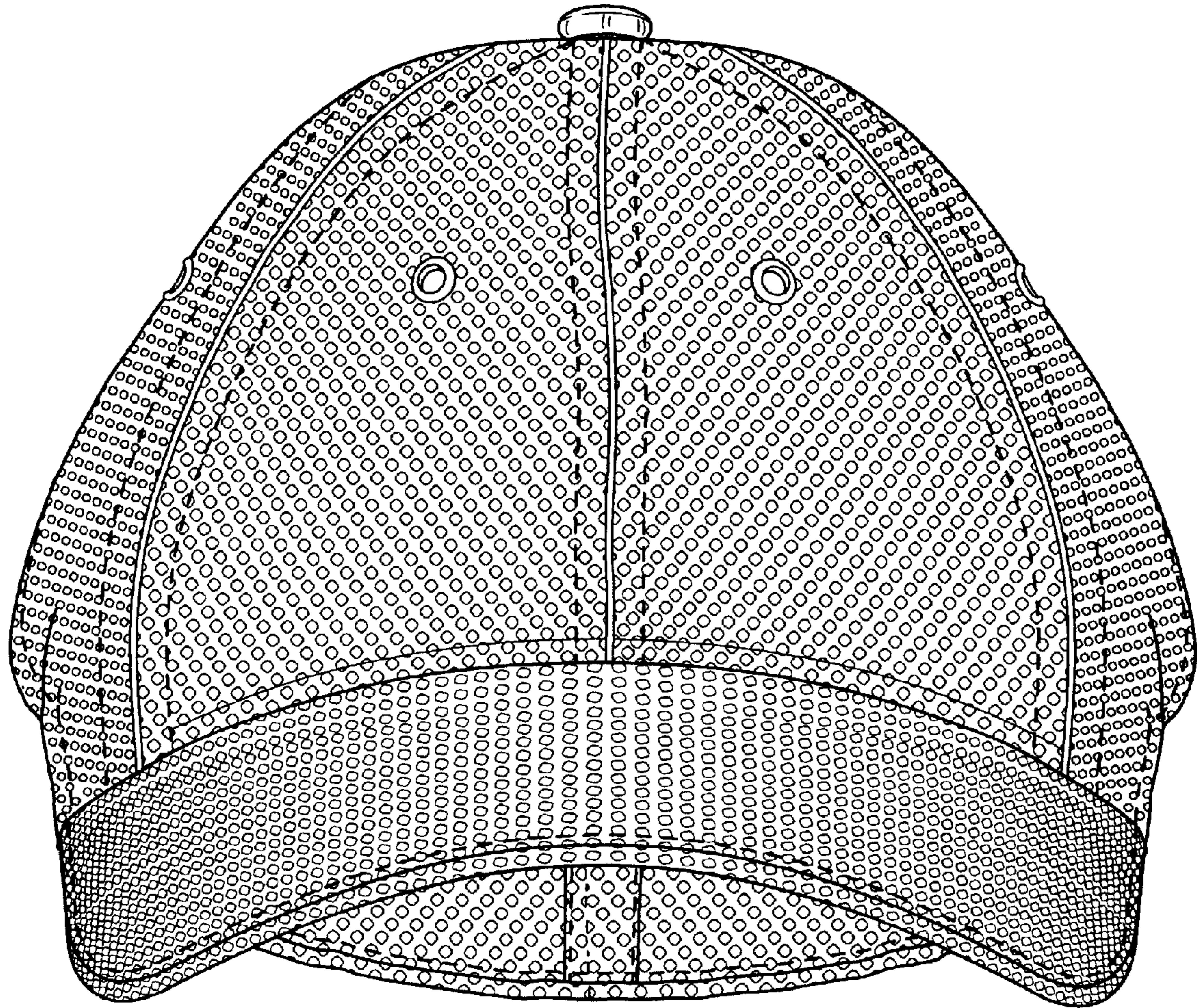

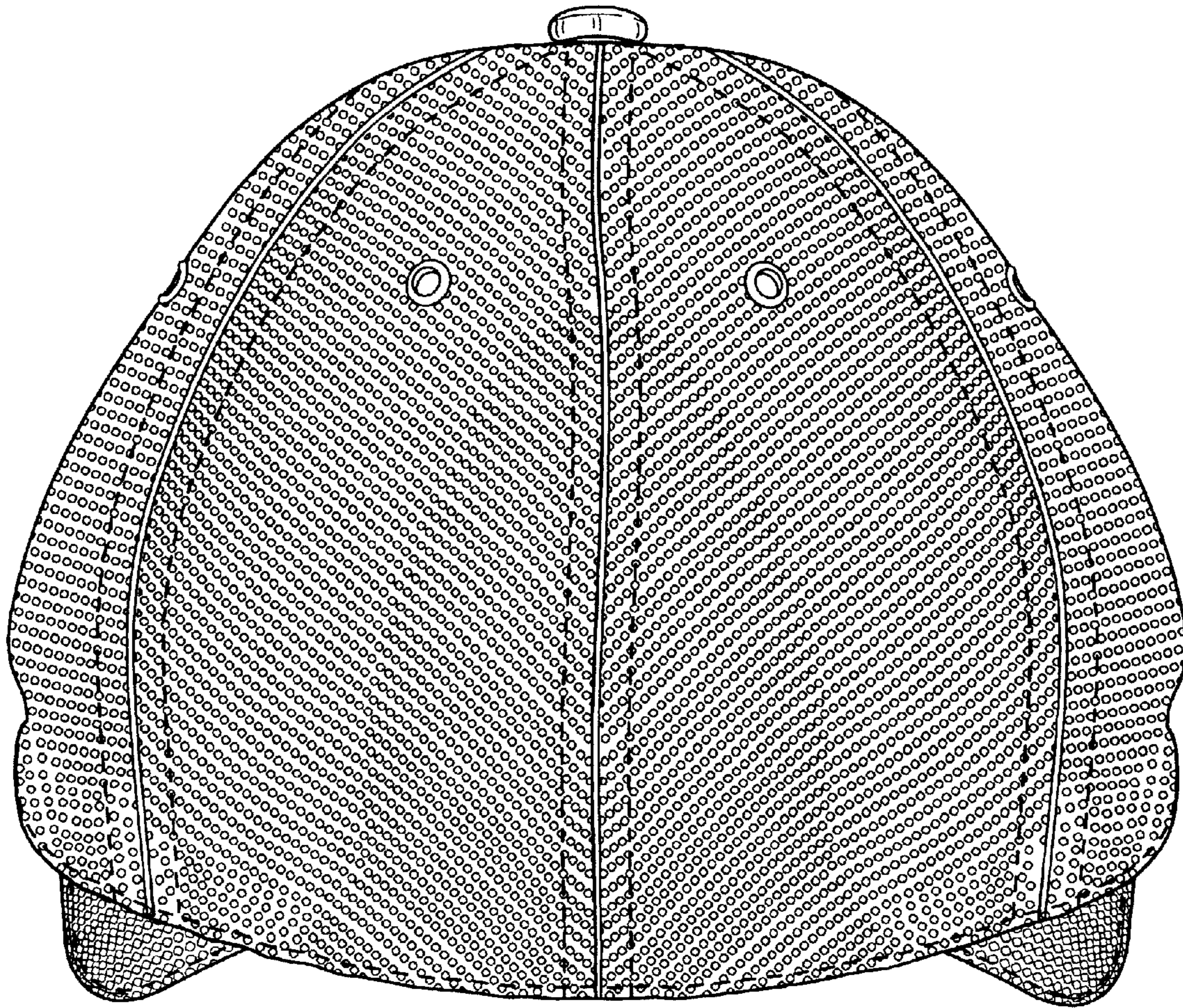

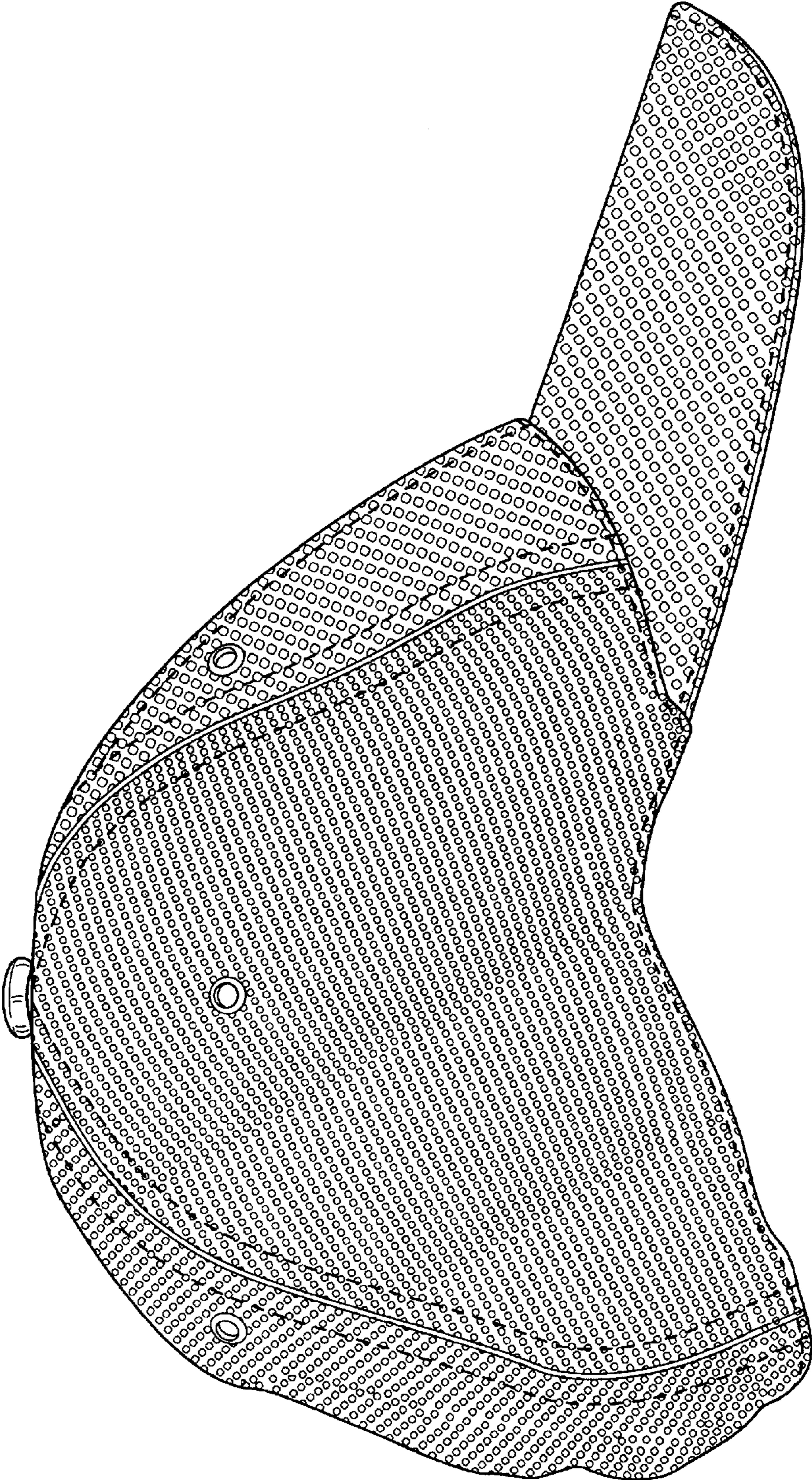

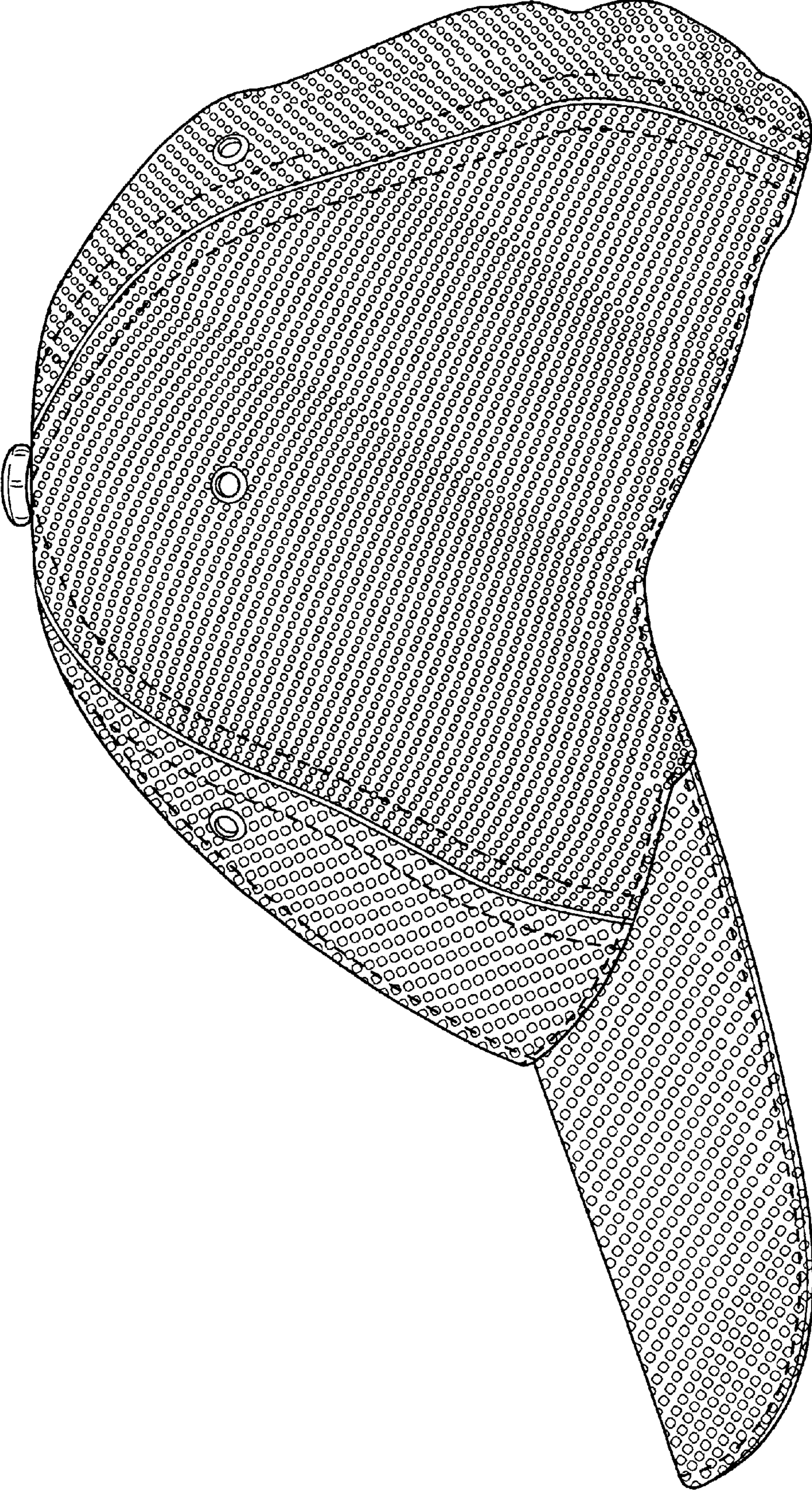

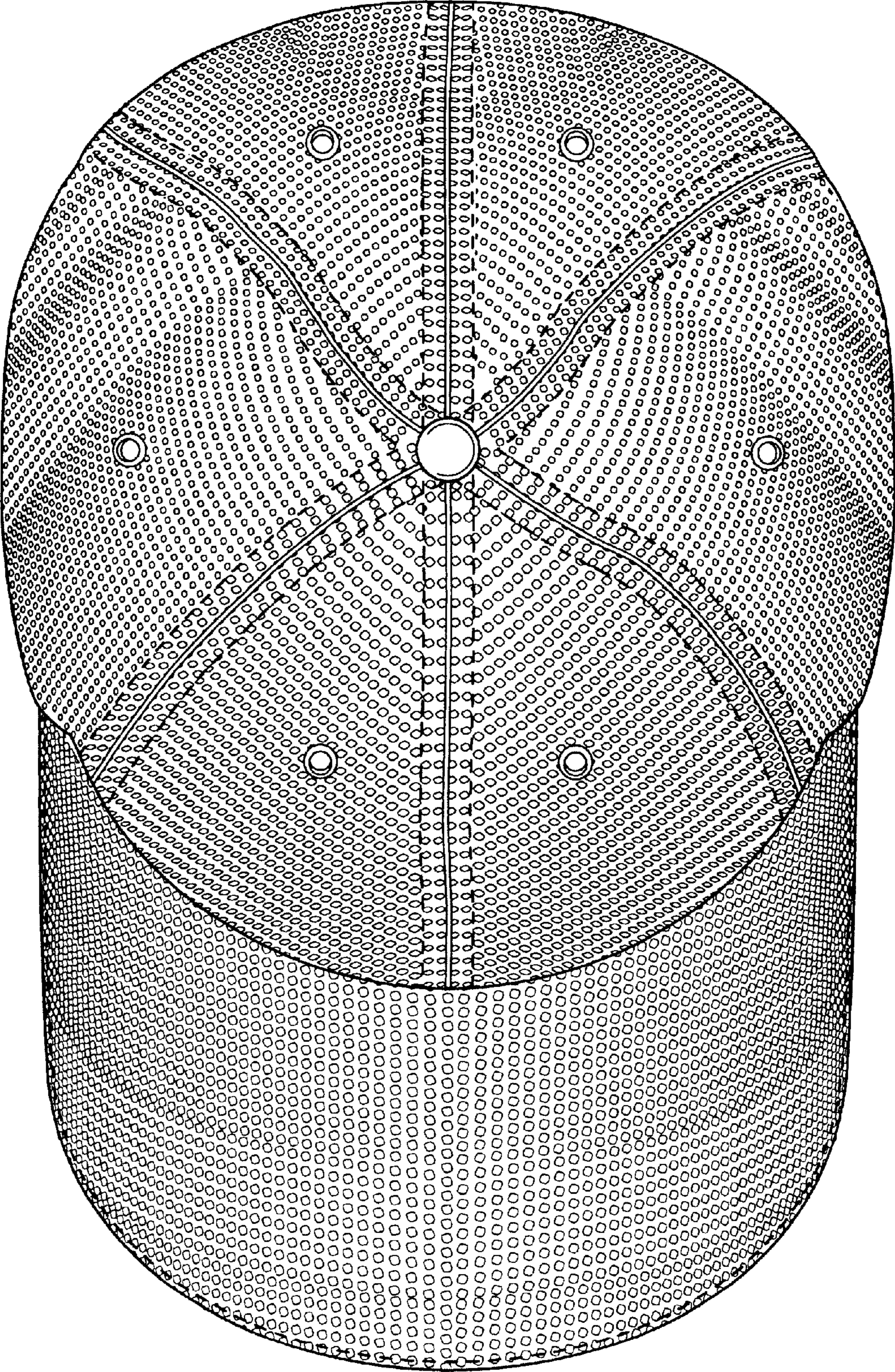

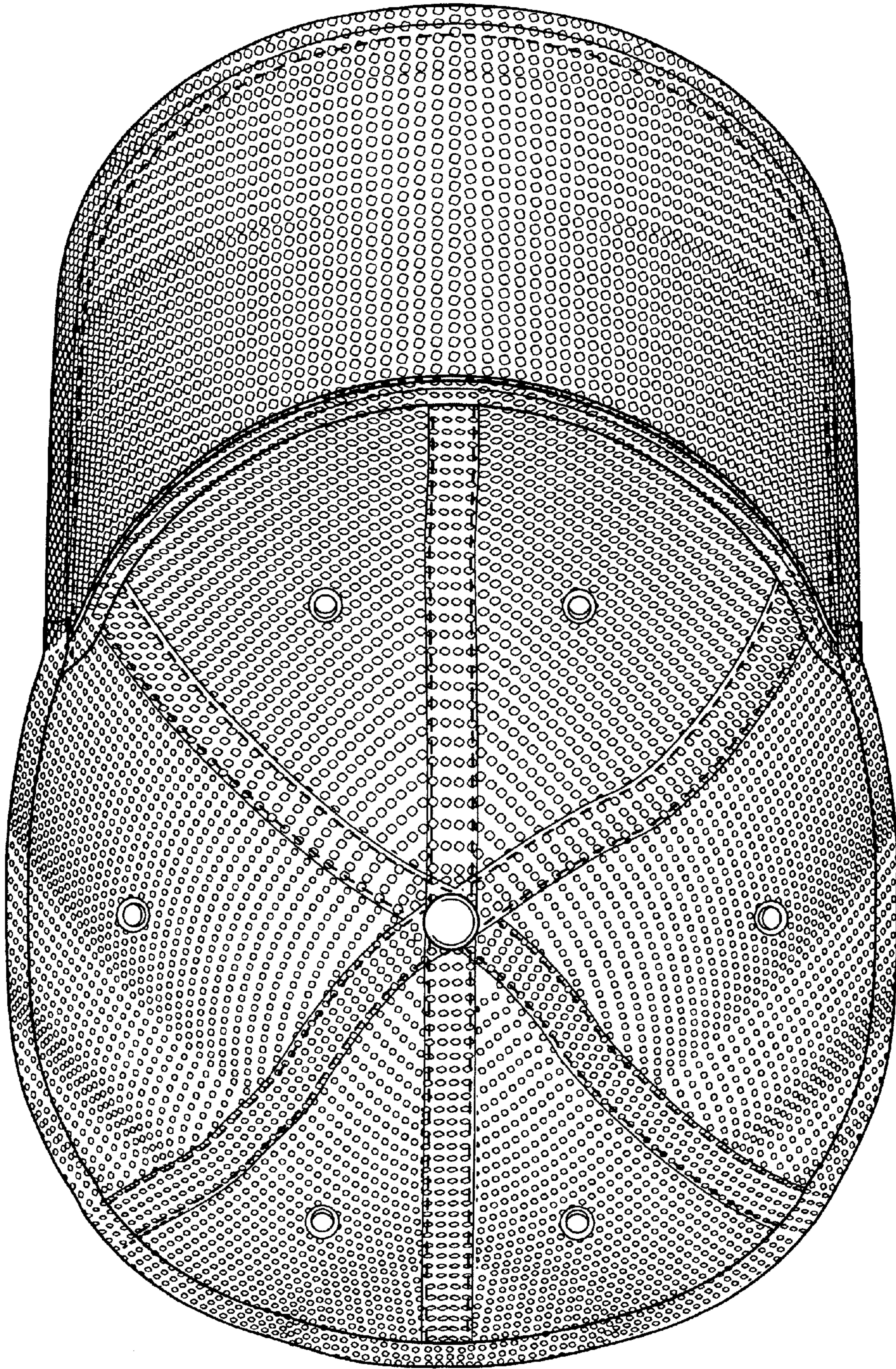
