(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design of goggles for a target game,
as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The application is directed to goggles having the word “ZIP”
cut from the goggles to provide openings for the nose and
eyes and to be used in a target game.

FIG. 3 is a right side view of the goggles for a target game.

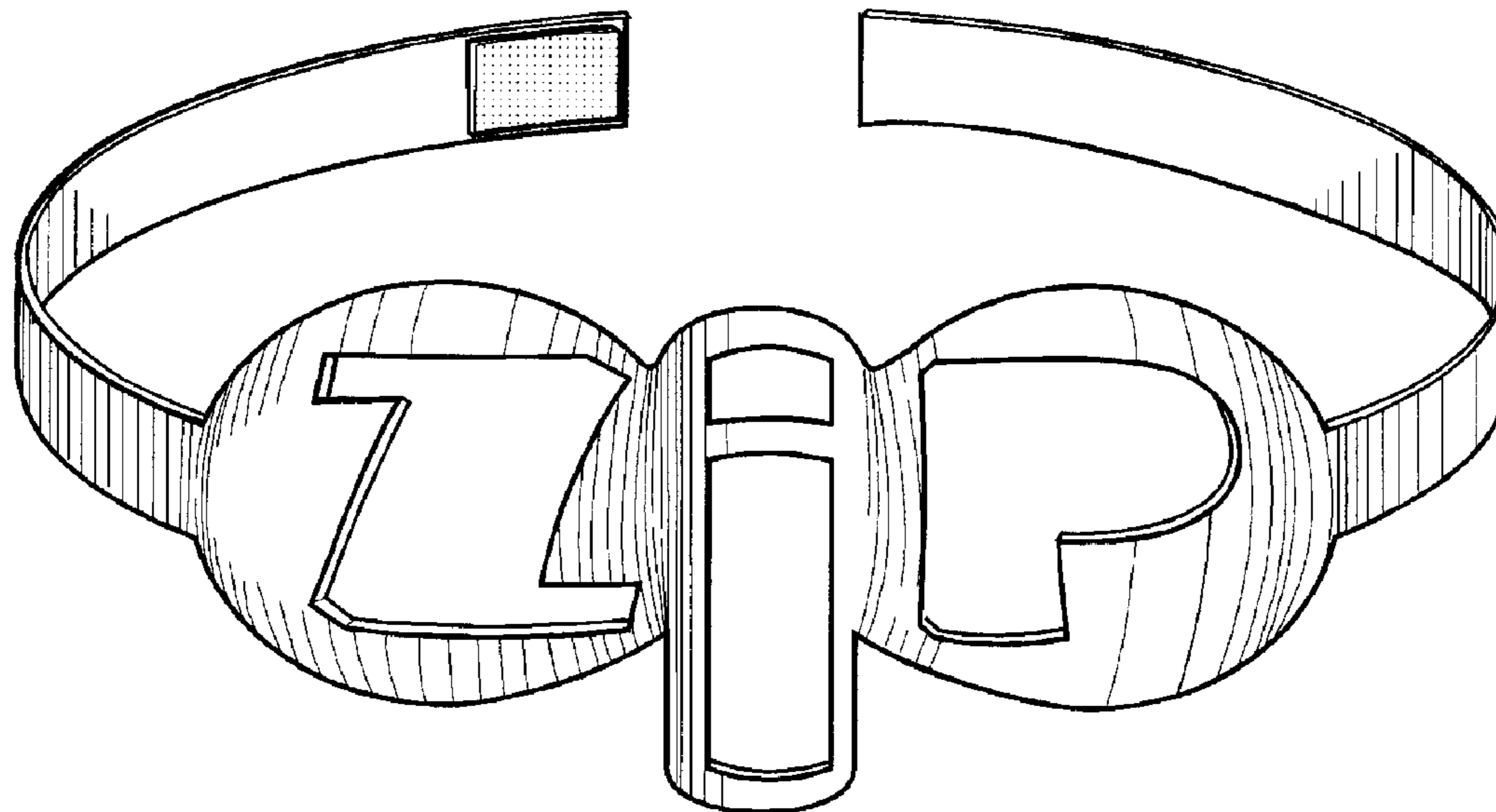
FIG. 4 is a left side view of the goggles for a target game.

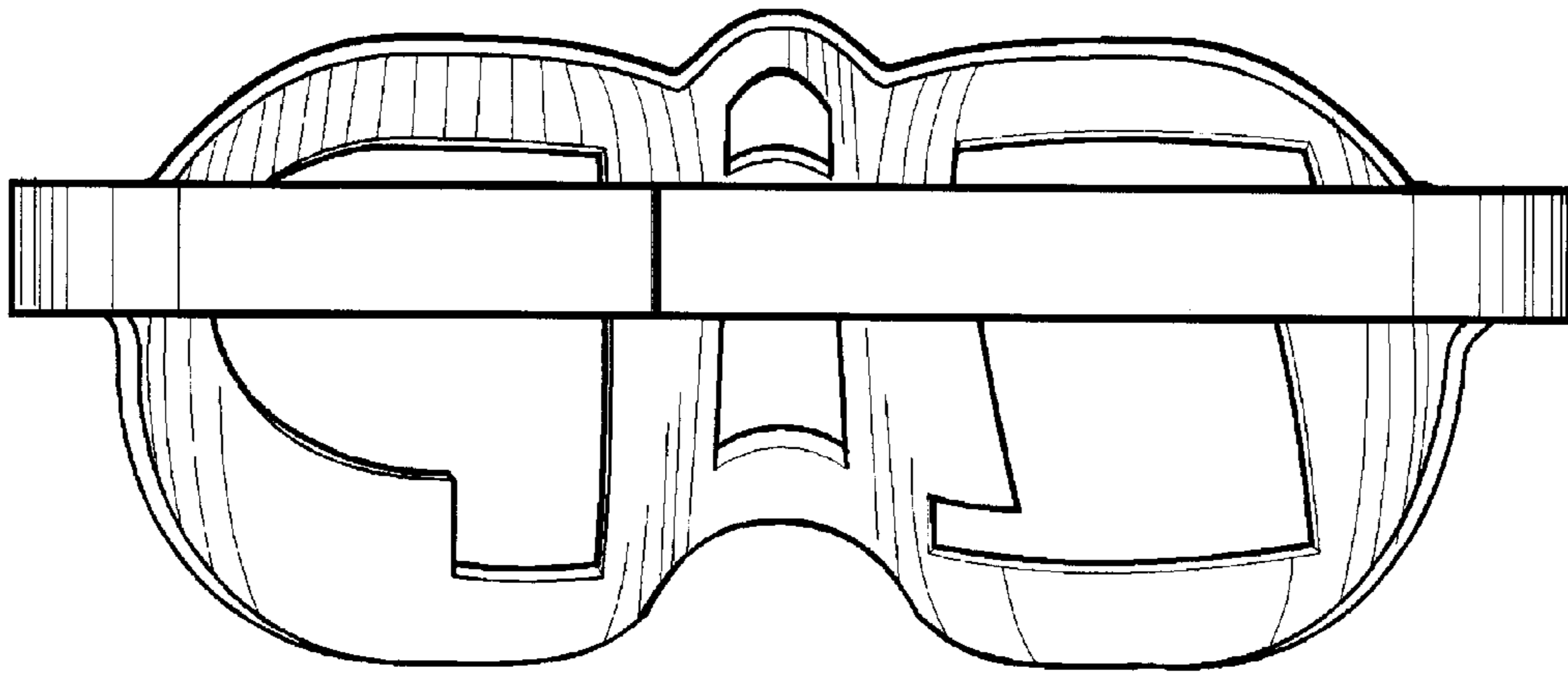

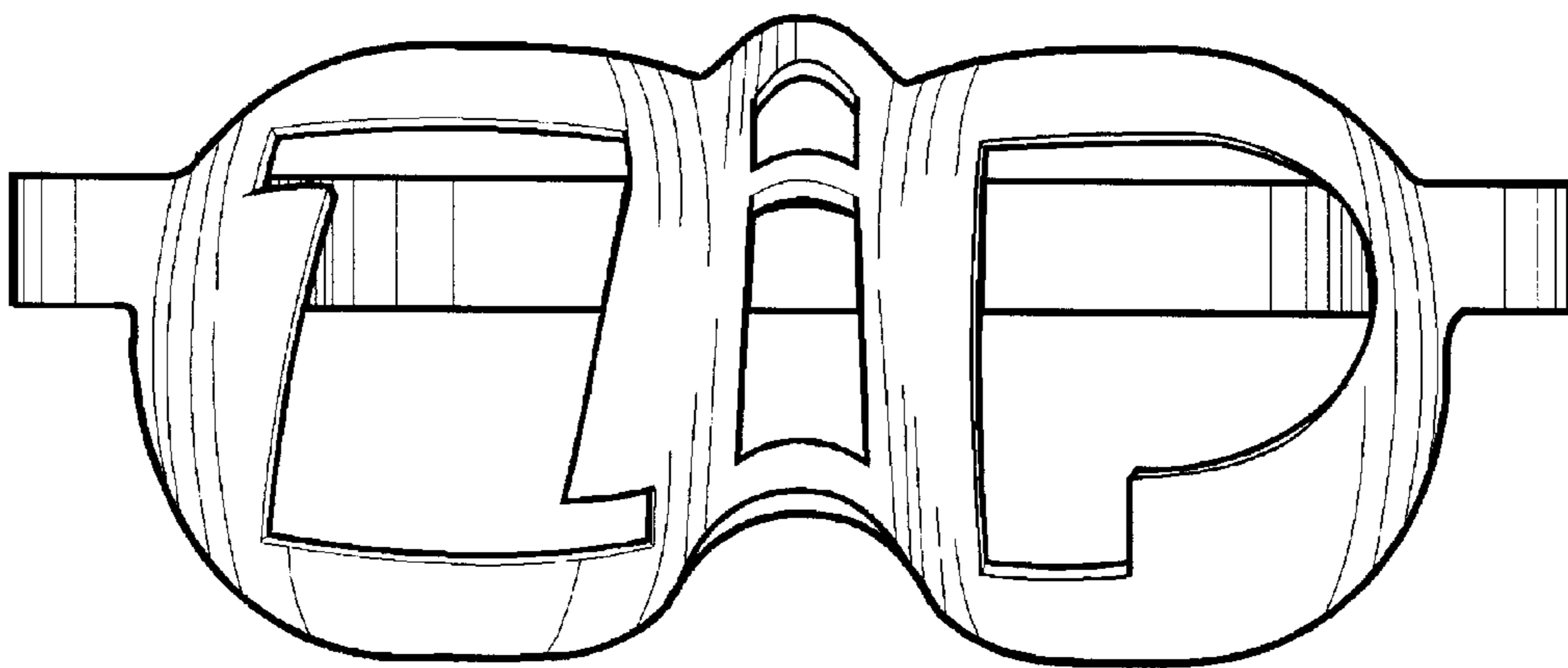

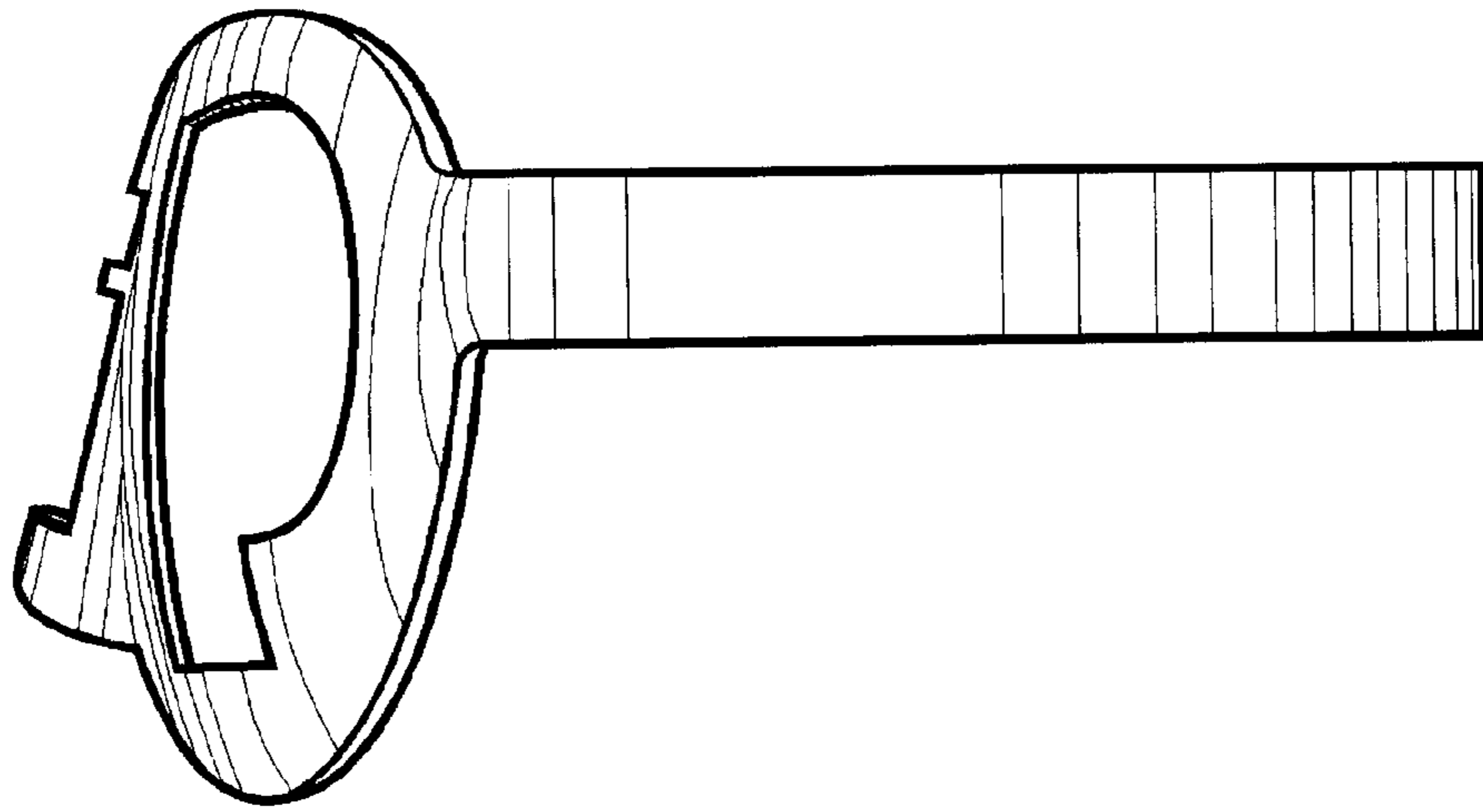

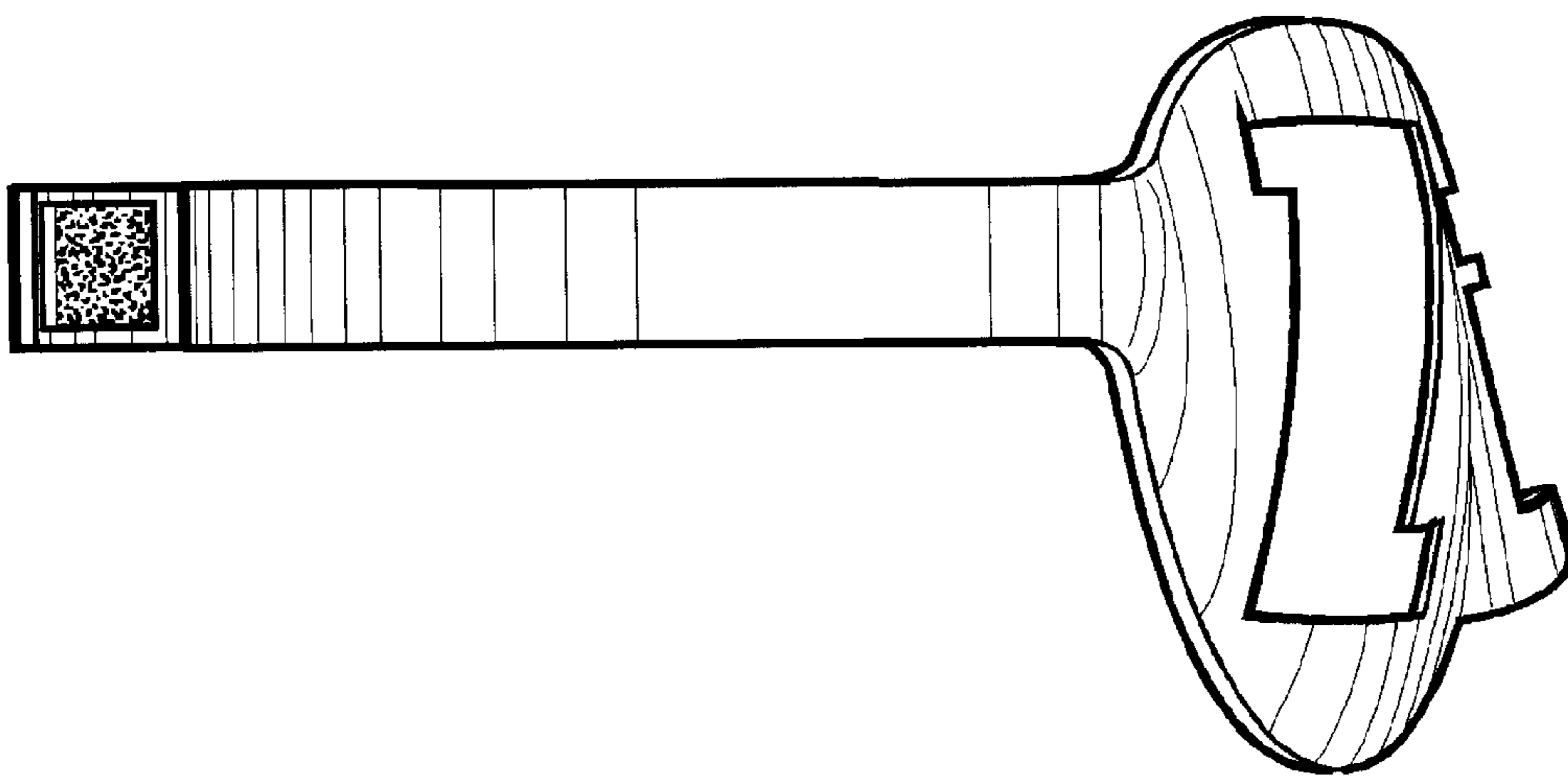

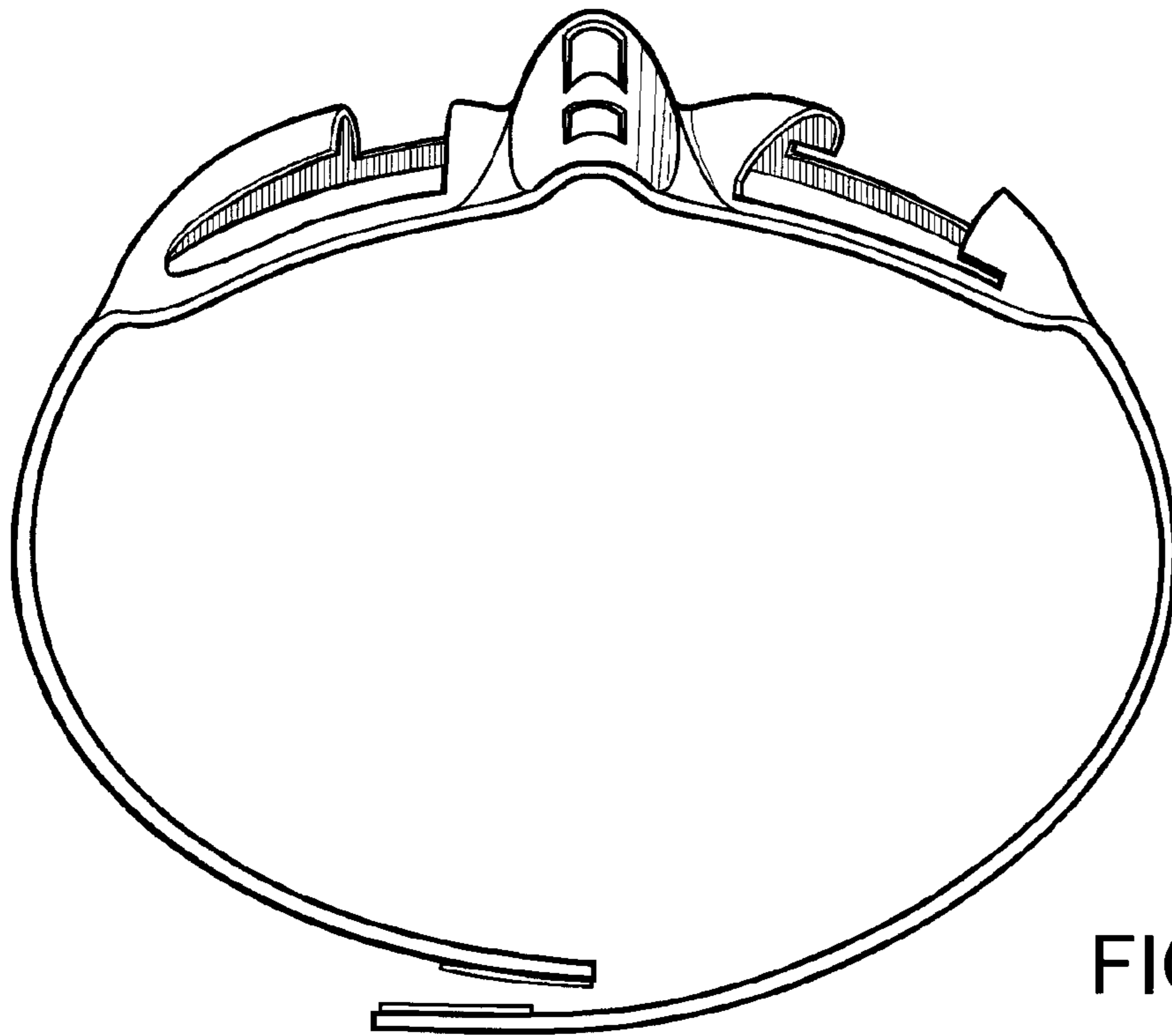

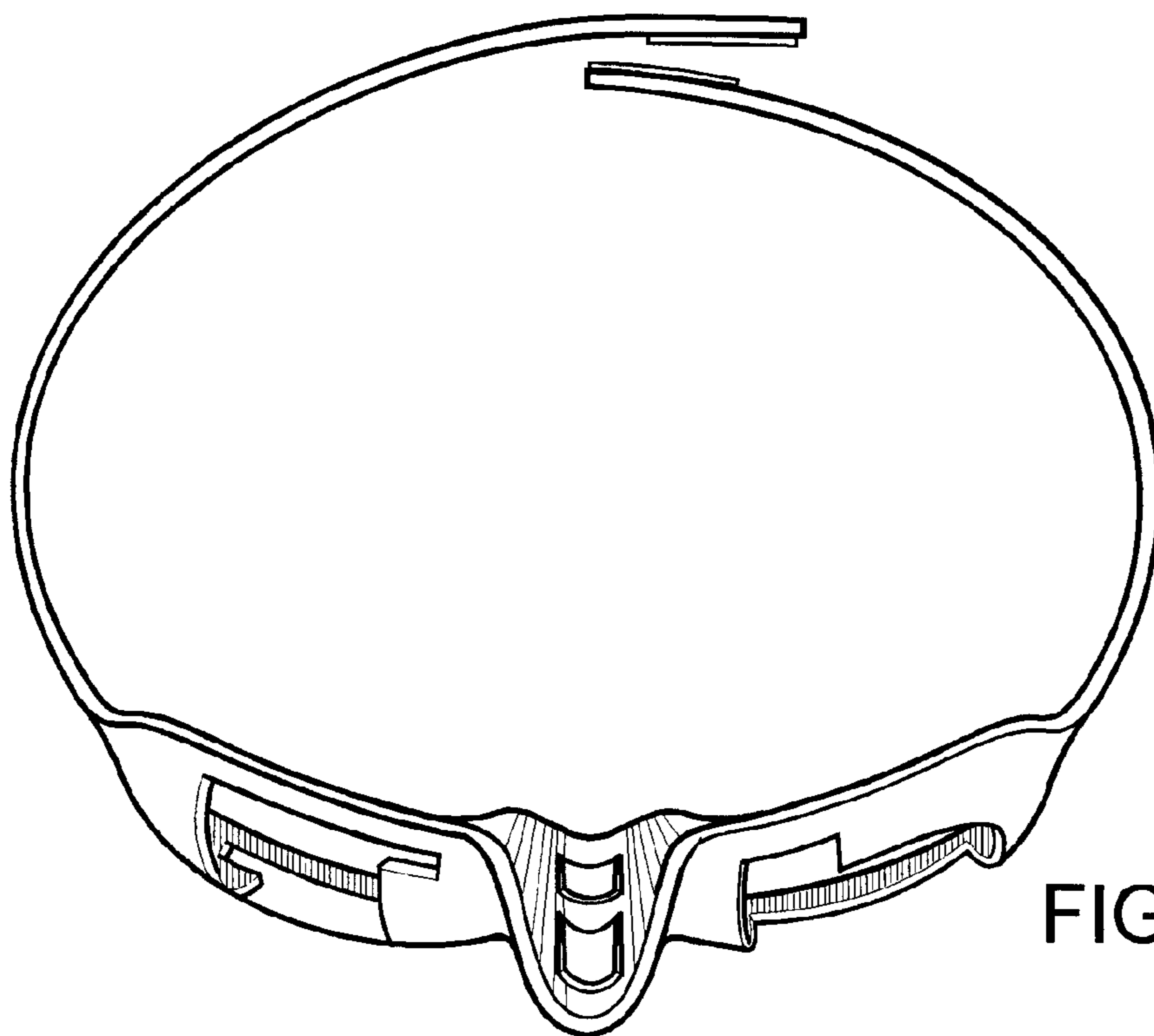

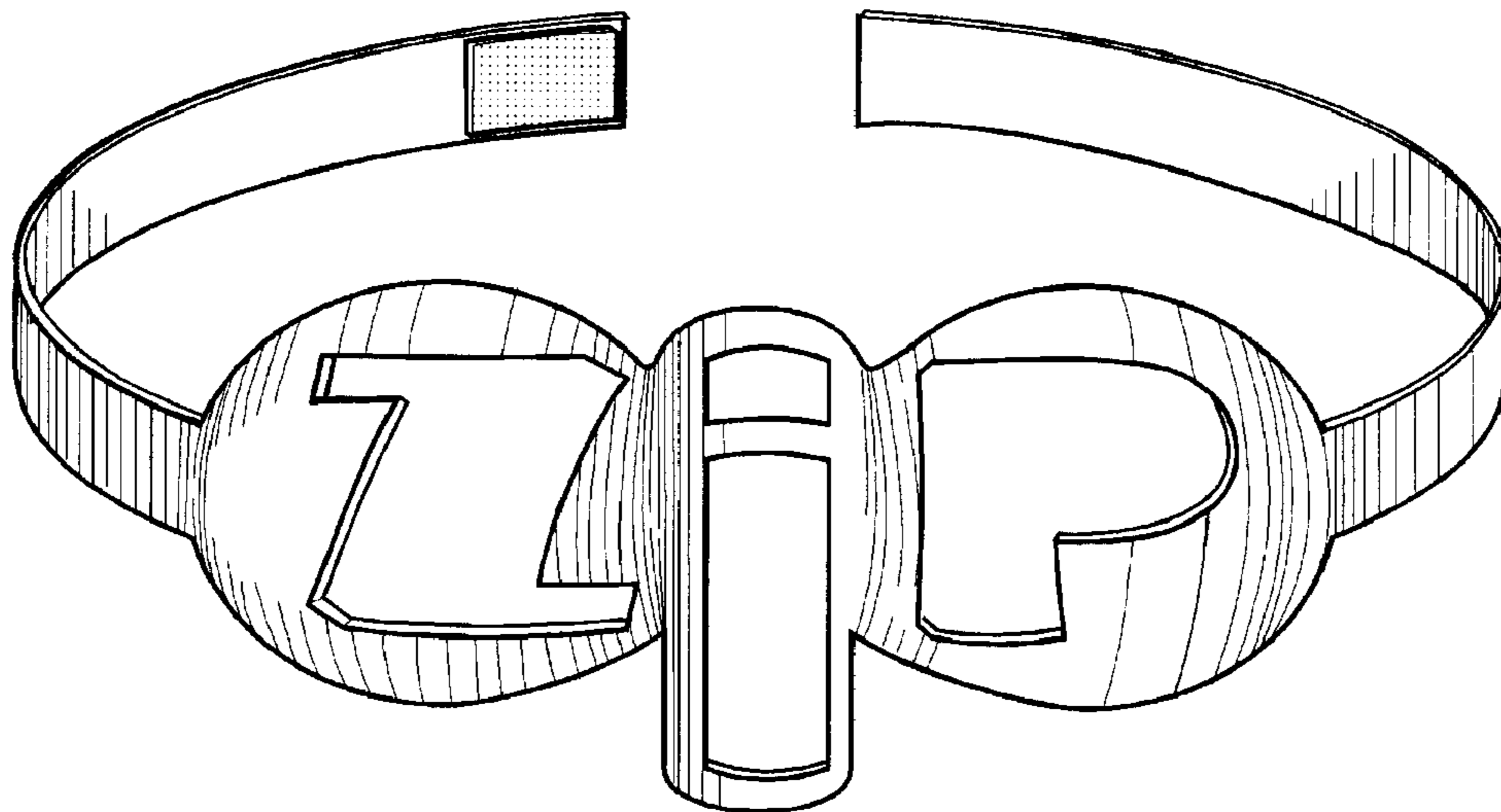
