(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a fishing lure spreading tool, as
described and shown in FIGS. 1 through 7, inclusive.

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a fishing lure spreading tool,
according to a preferred embodiment of the present inven-
tion;

FIG. 2 is a left side view of the fishing lure spreading tool
illustrated in FIG. 1, according to the preferred embodiment;

FIG. 3 is a right side view of the fishing lure spreading tool
illustrated in FIG. 1, according to the preferred embodiment;

FIG. 4 is a front view of the fishing lure spreading tool
illustrated in FIG. 1, according to the preferred embodiment;

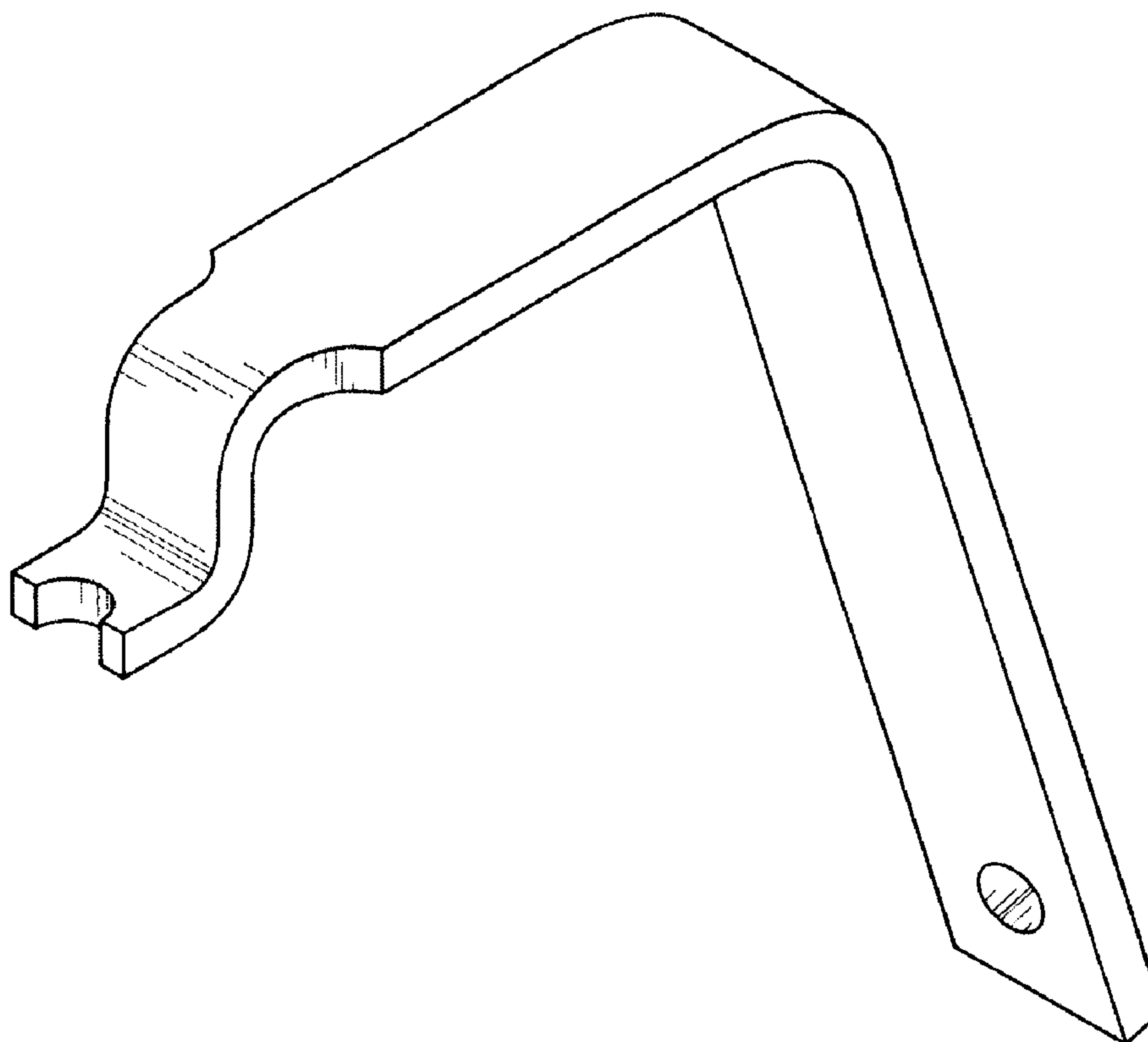
FIG. 5 is a back view of the fishing lure spreading tool

FIG. 6 is a top view of the fishing lure spreading tool

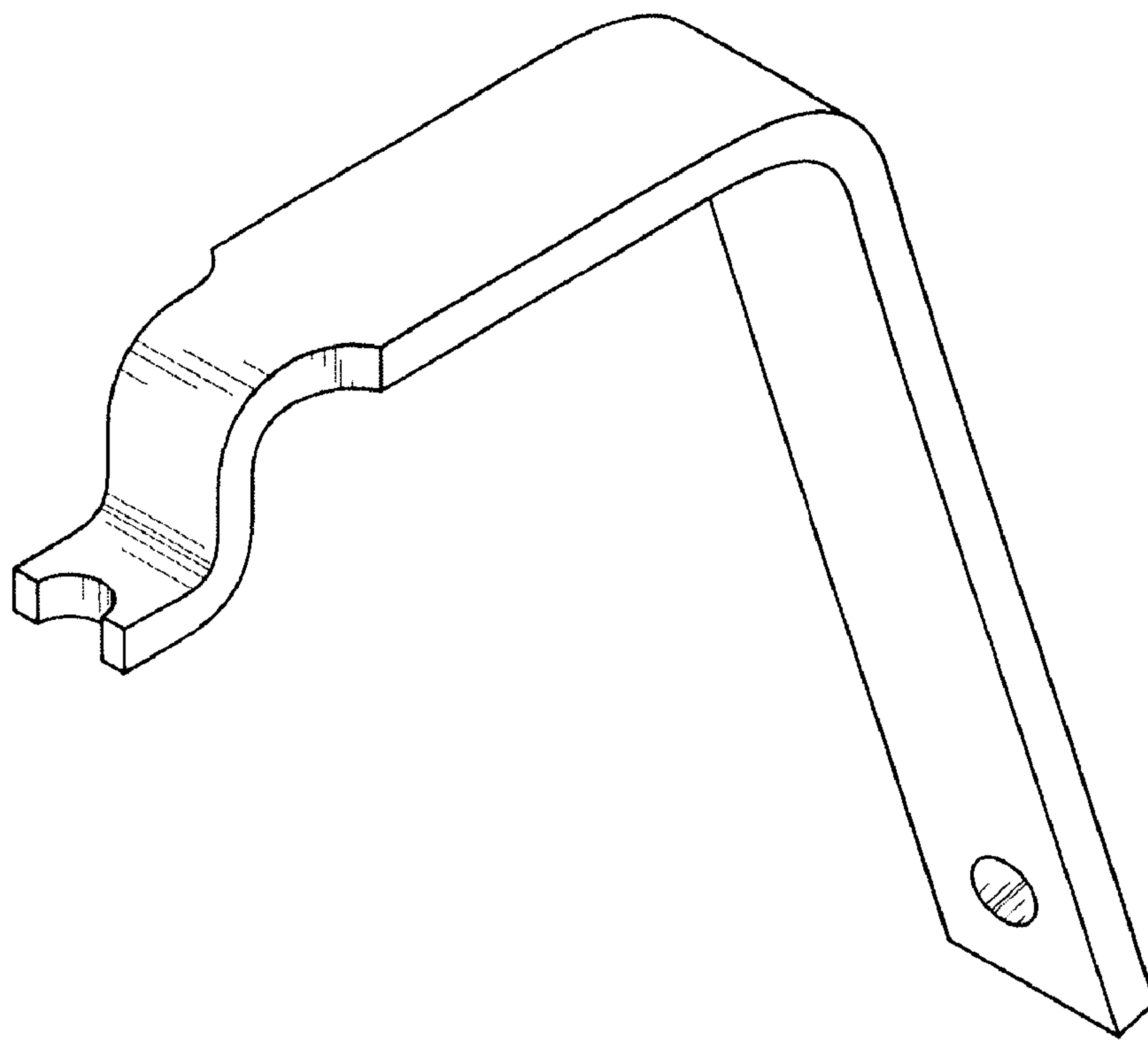

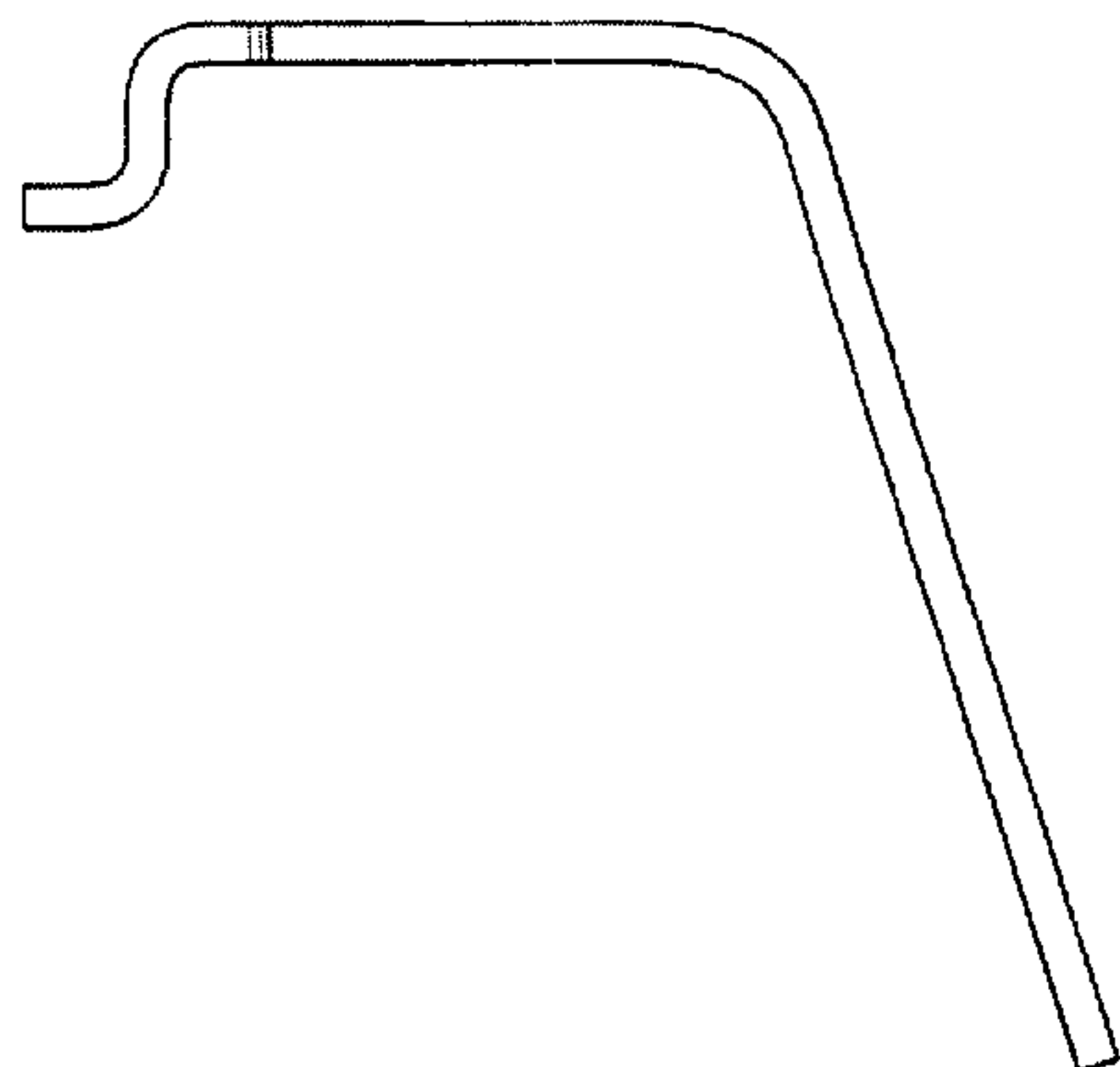

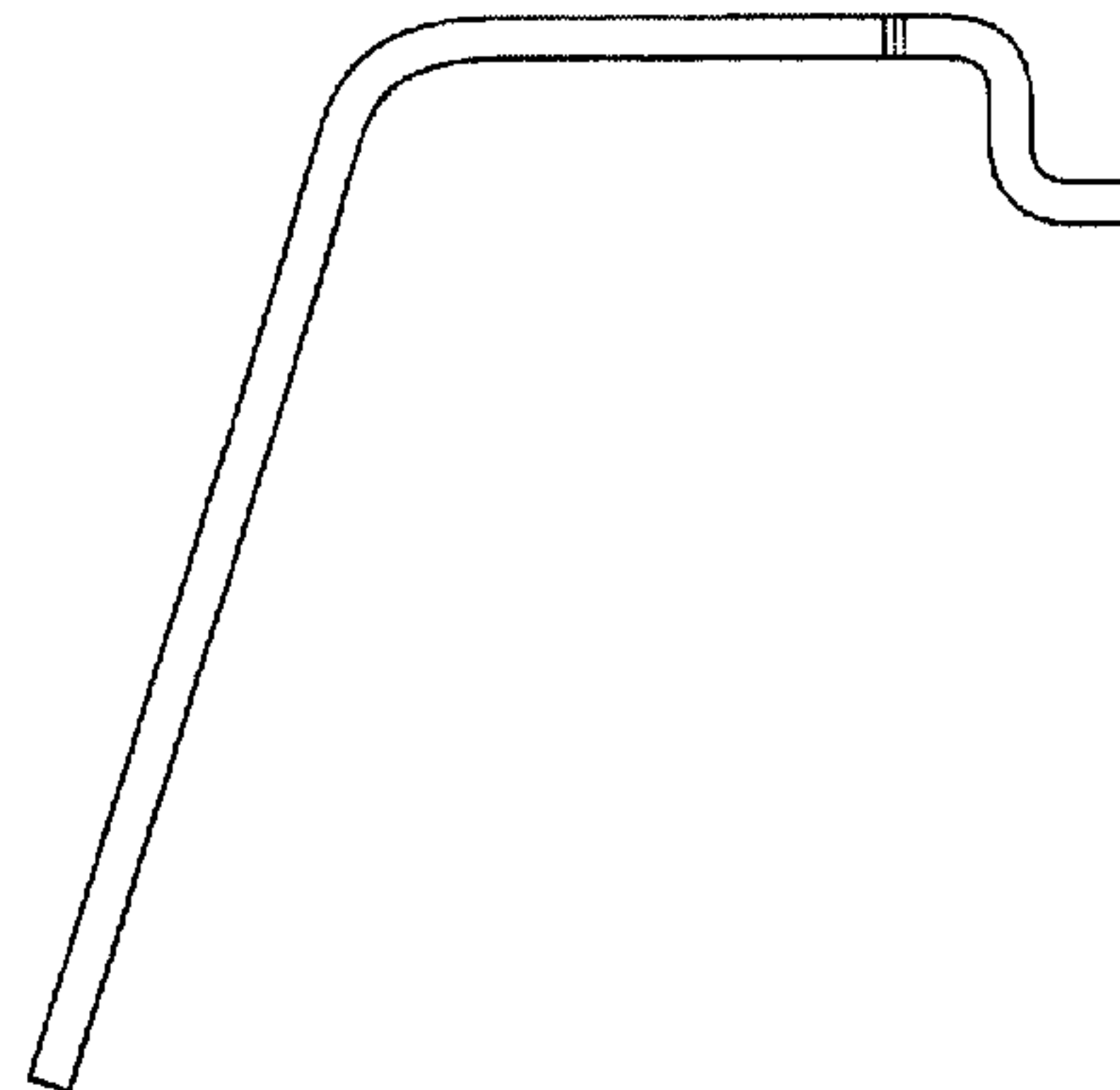

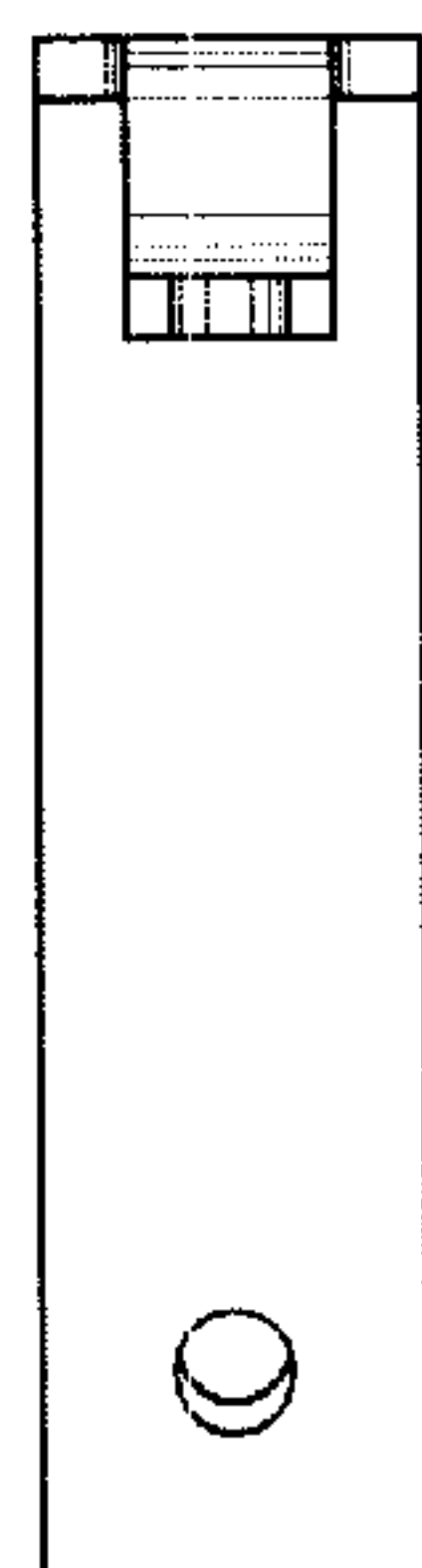

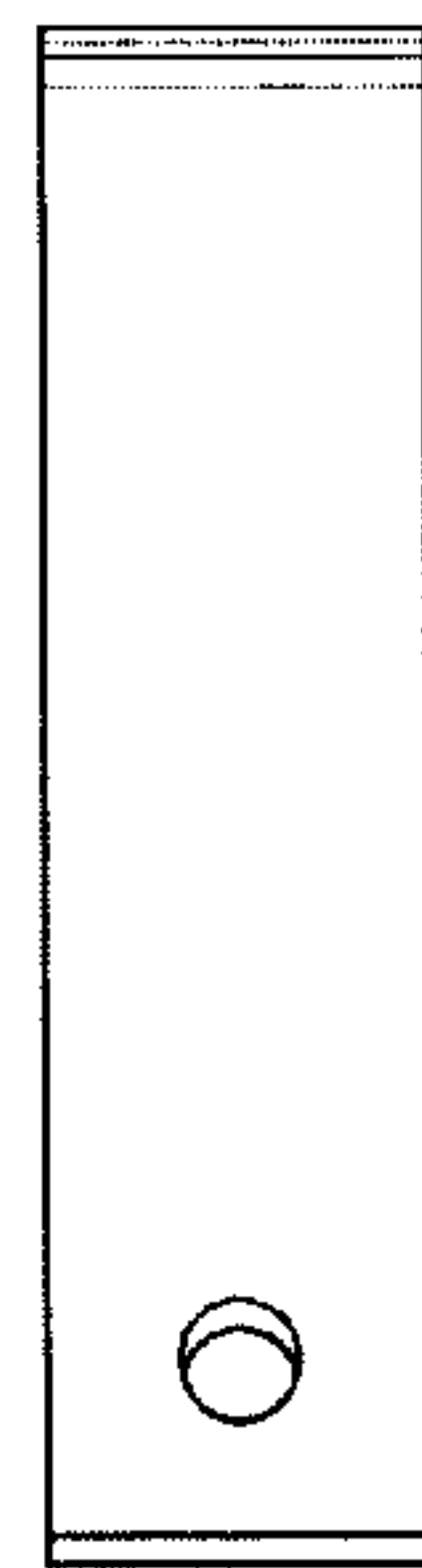

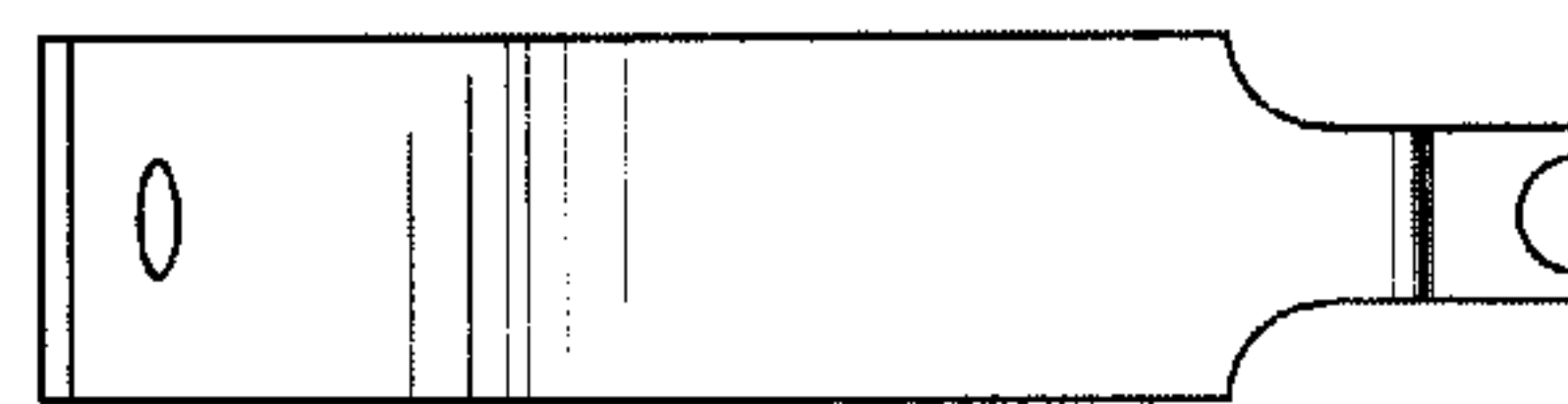
