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(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for an outsole for a shoe, as
shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom view of an outsole for a shoe showing my
new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side view of the outsole for a shoe in
accordance with the new design shown in FIG. 1;

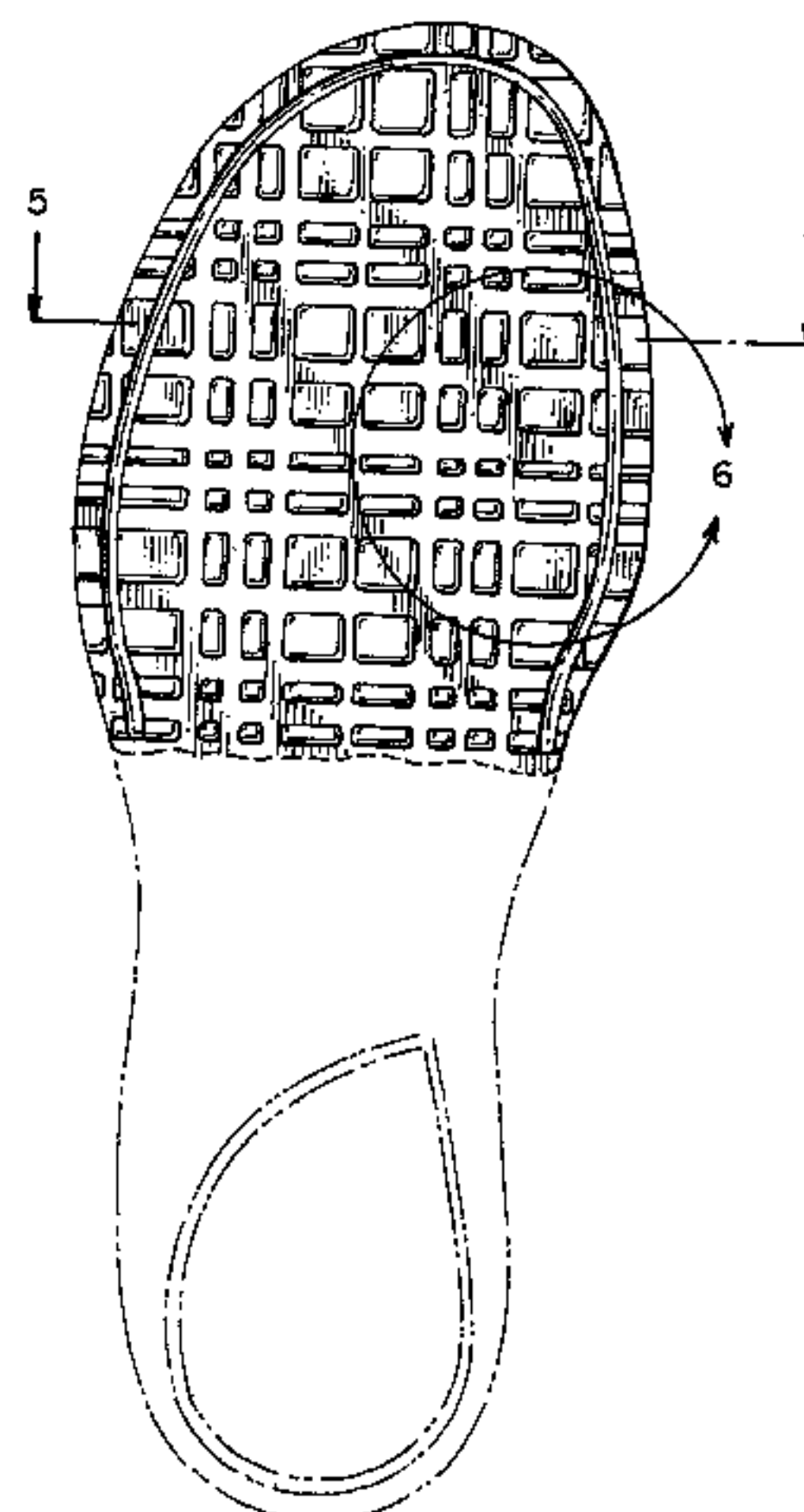
FIG. 3 is a left side view of the outsole for a sole in
accordance with the new design shown in FIGS. 1–2;

FIG. 4 is a front view of the outsole for a shoe in accordance
with the new design shown in FIGS. 1–3;

FIG. 5 is a cross sectional view of the outsole for a shoe in
accordance with the new design shown in FIGS. 1–4; and,
FIG. 6 is an enlarged perspective view of the area referenced
as “6” in FIG. 1.

The broken lines showing a shoe upper in FIGS. 1–4
represent the portions of the design that form no part of the
claim. The broken wavy line immediately adjacent to the
claimed surface in FIGS. 1–3, represents the boundary of the
design with the broken line itself forming no part of the
claim.

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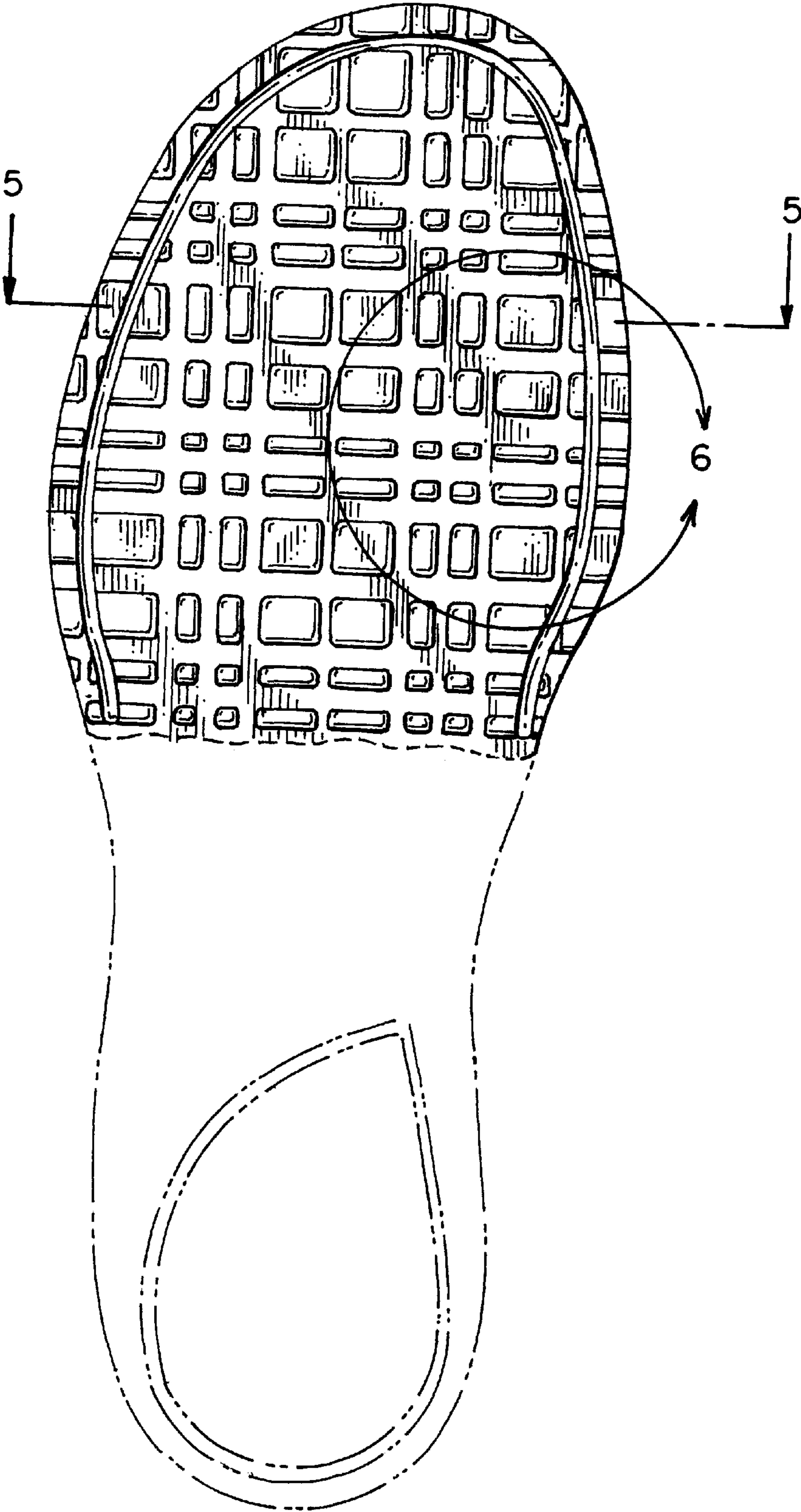

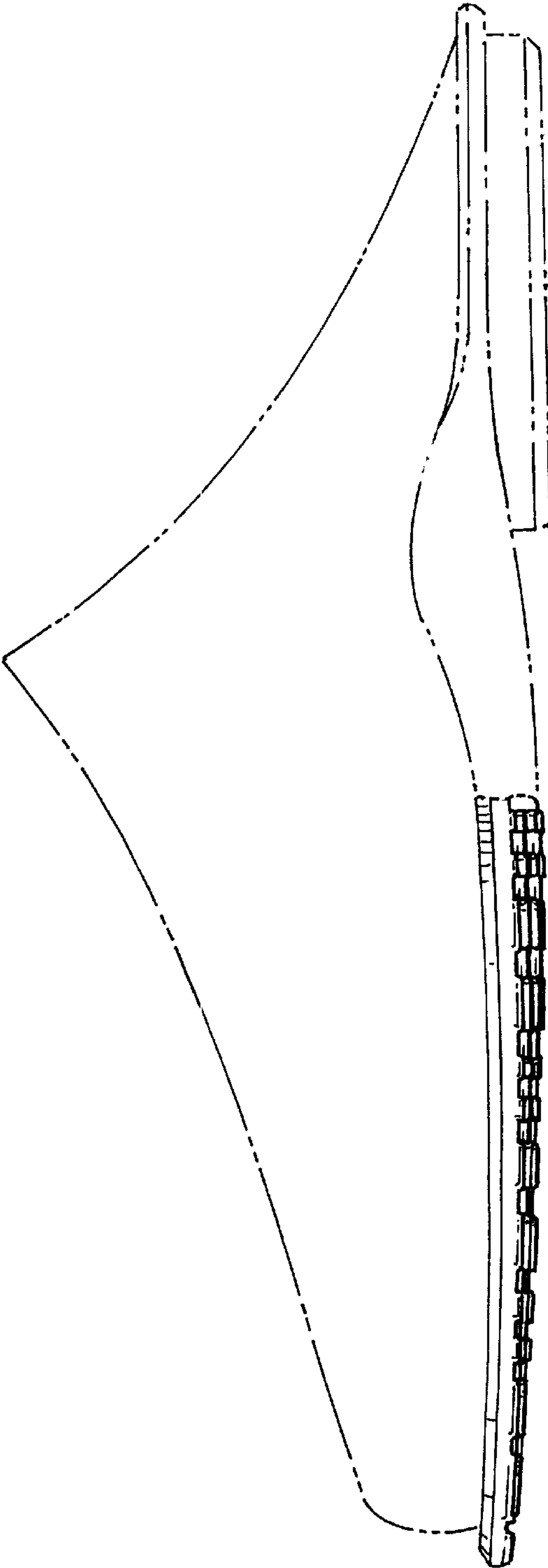

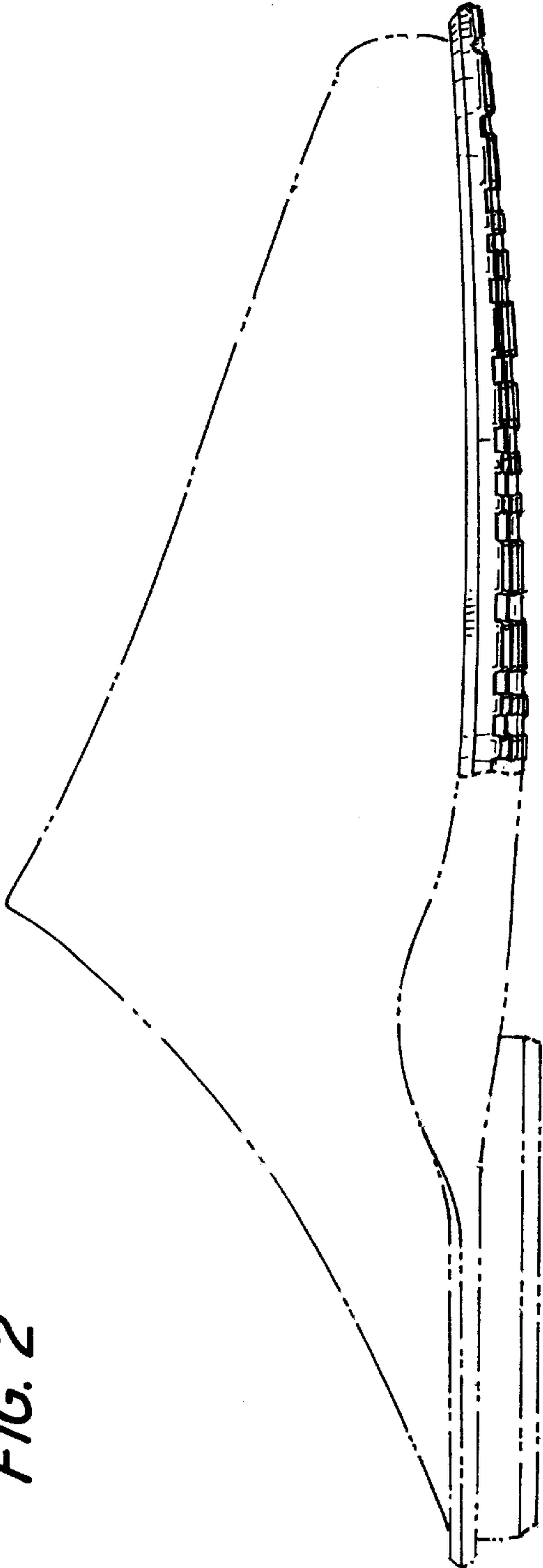

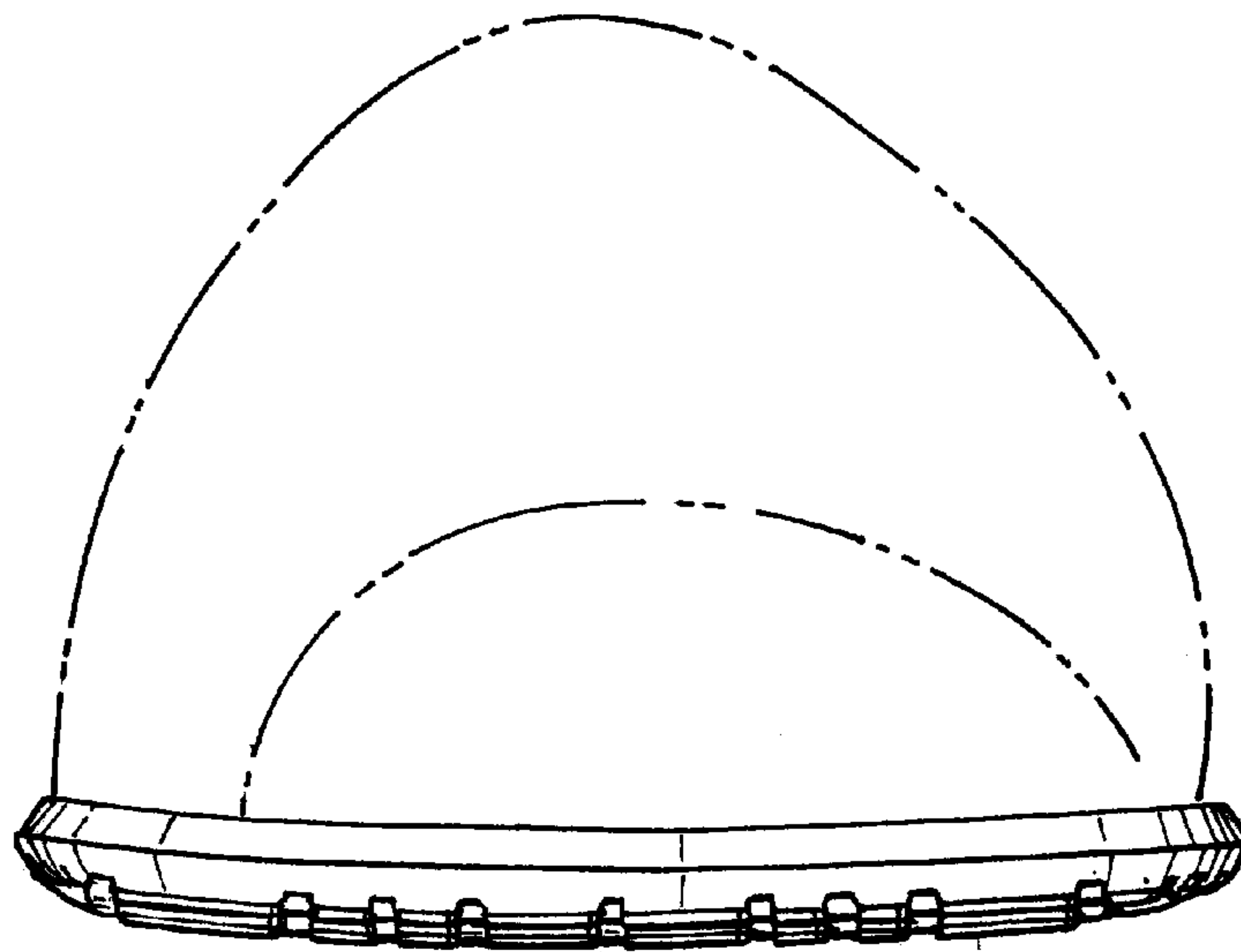

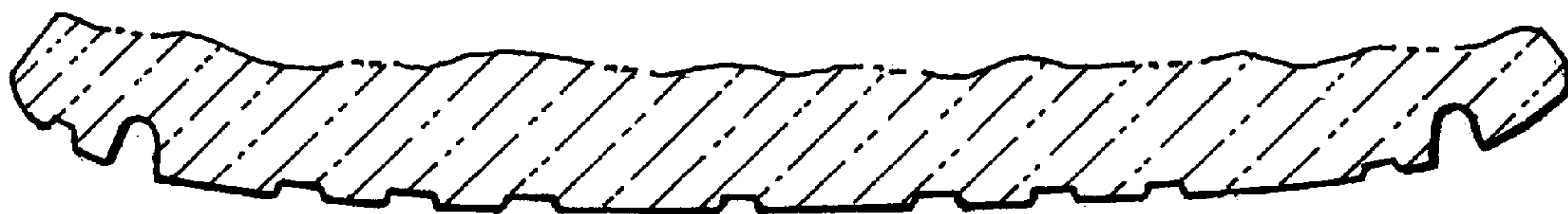

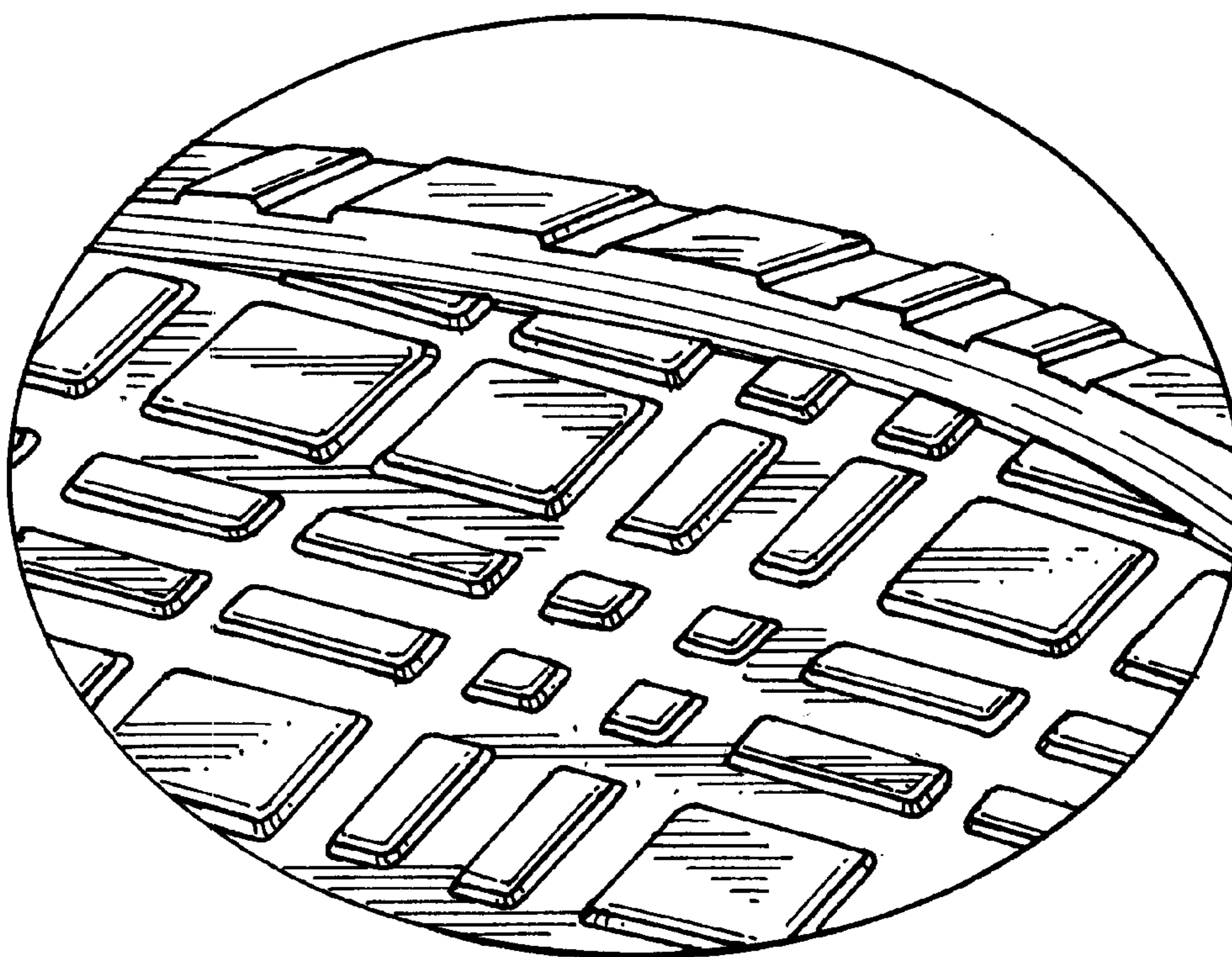
