(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a seat and back cushion support for a chair, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a rear elevational view of a seat and back cushion support for a chair which forms my new design, the broken lines of a chair being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of my design;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

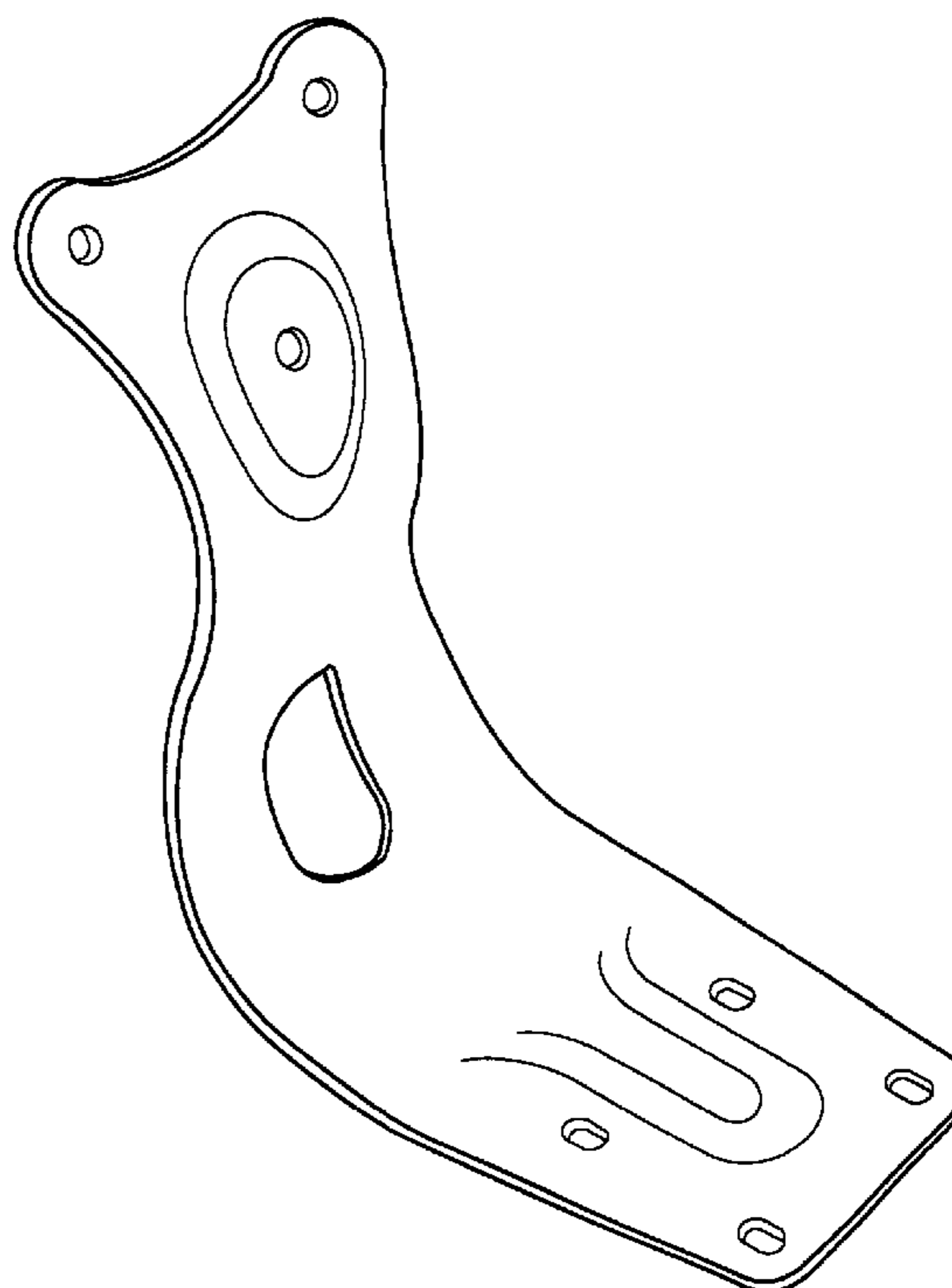
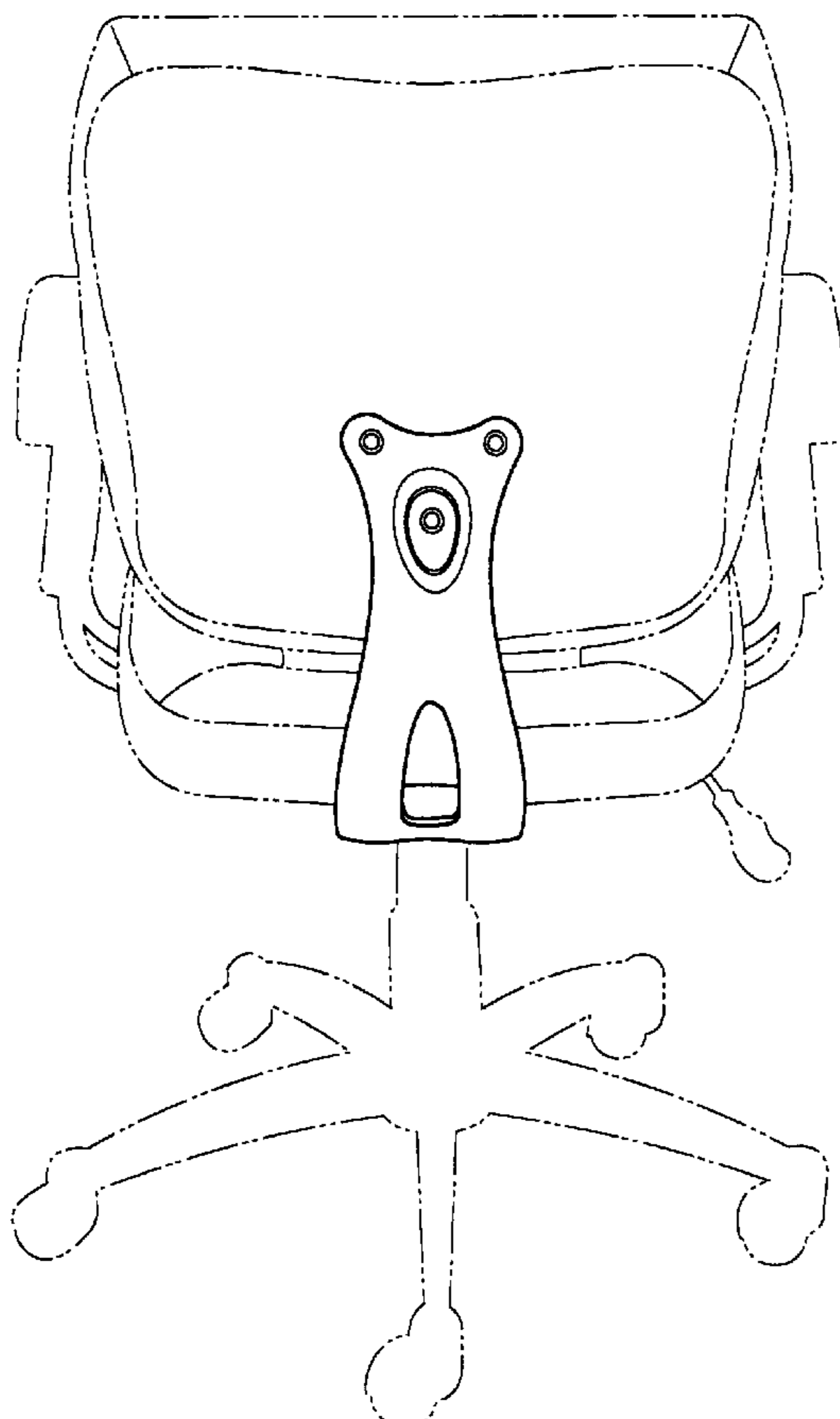
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;

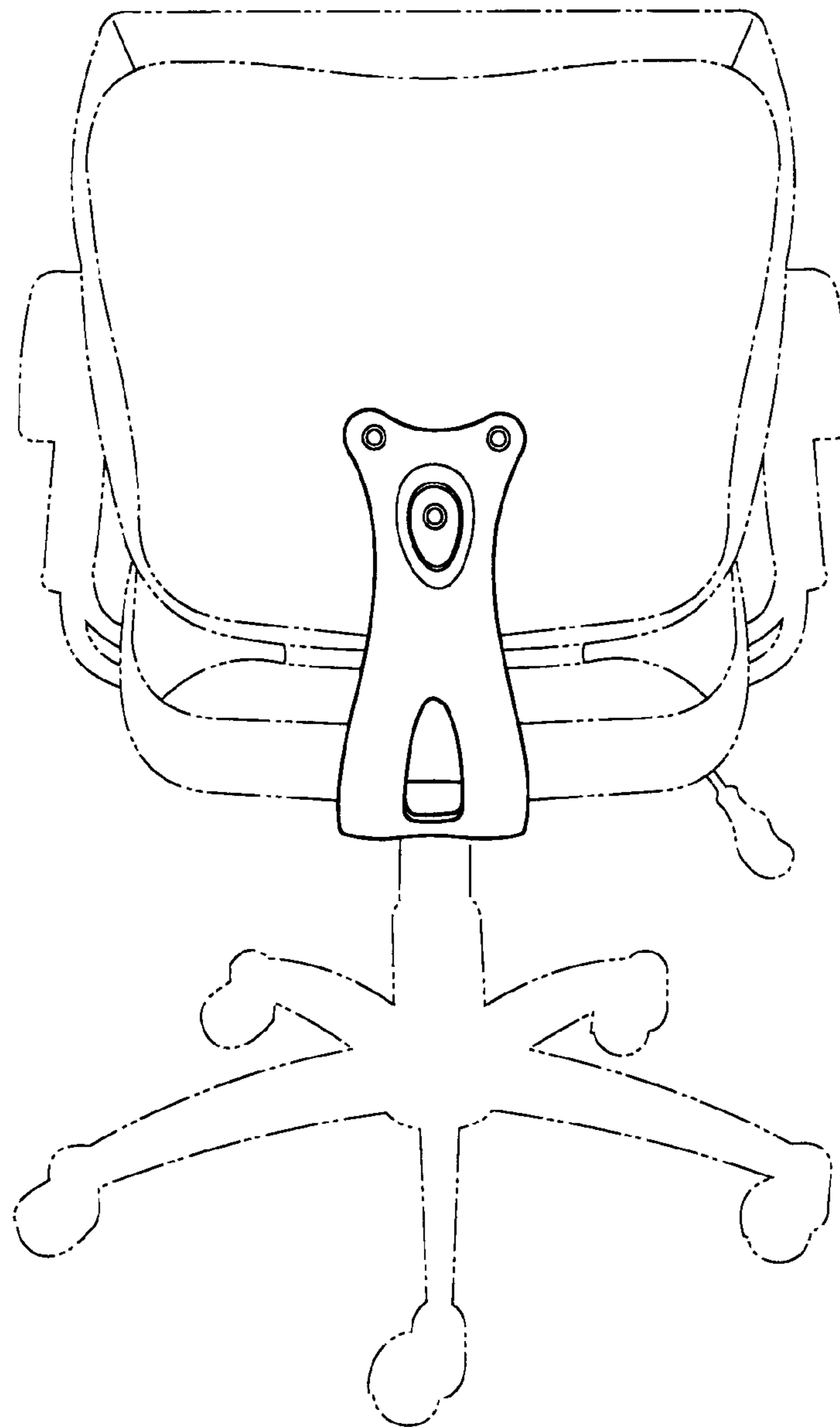
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; and,

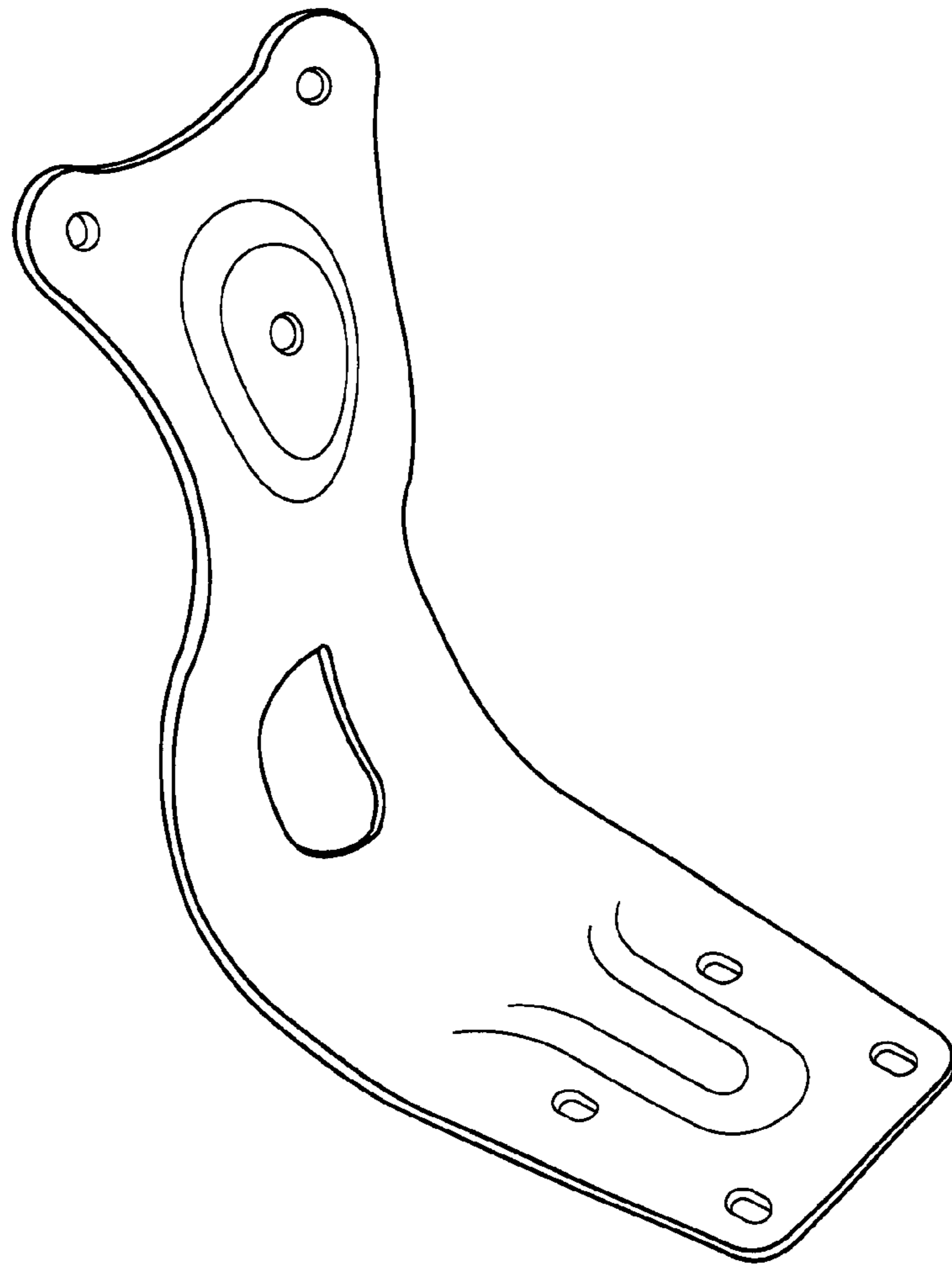
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.

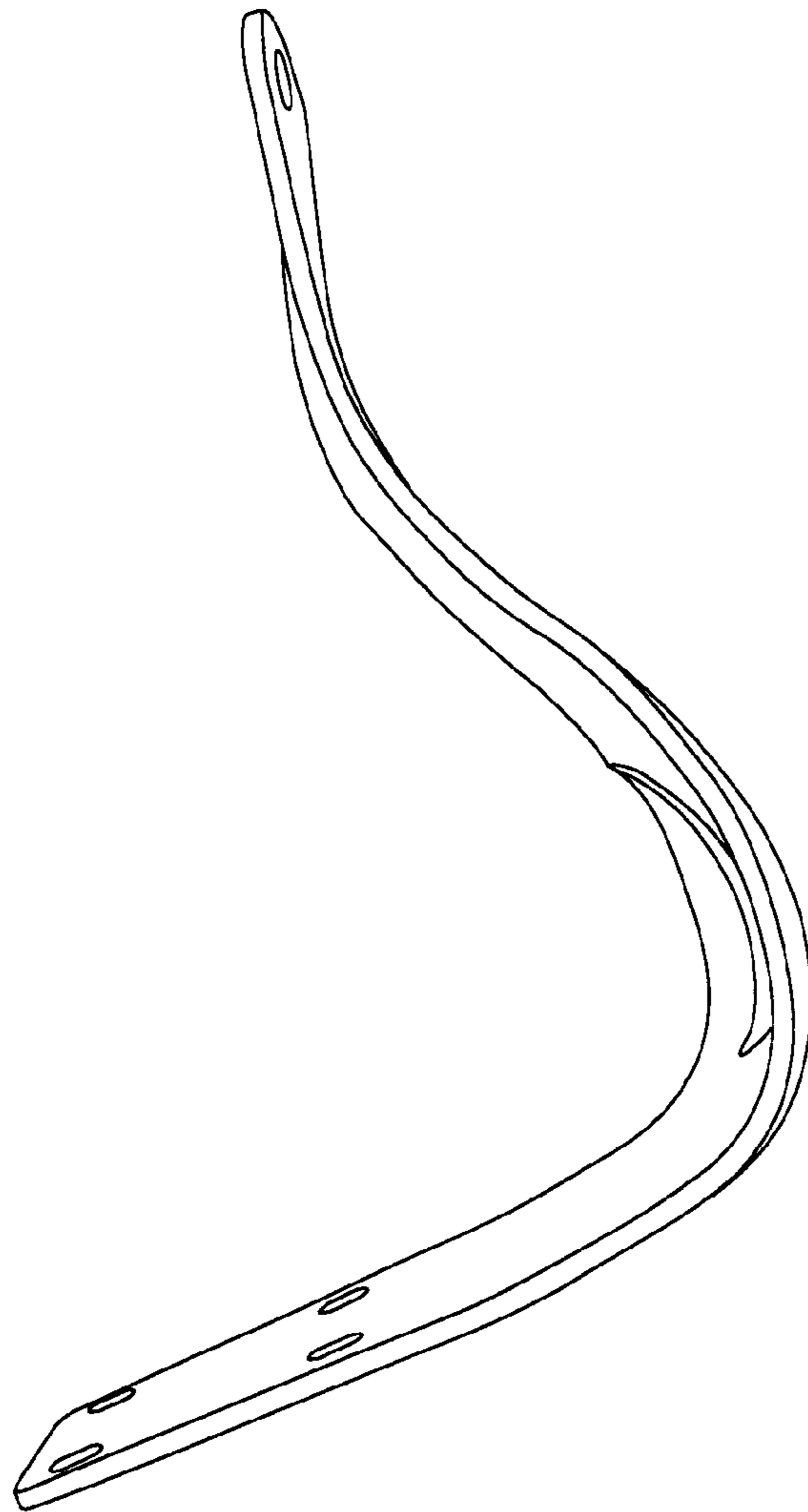




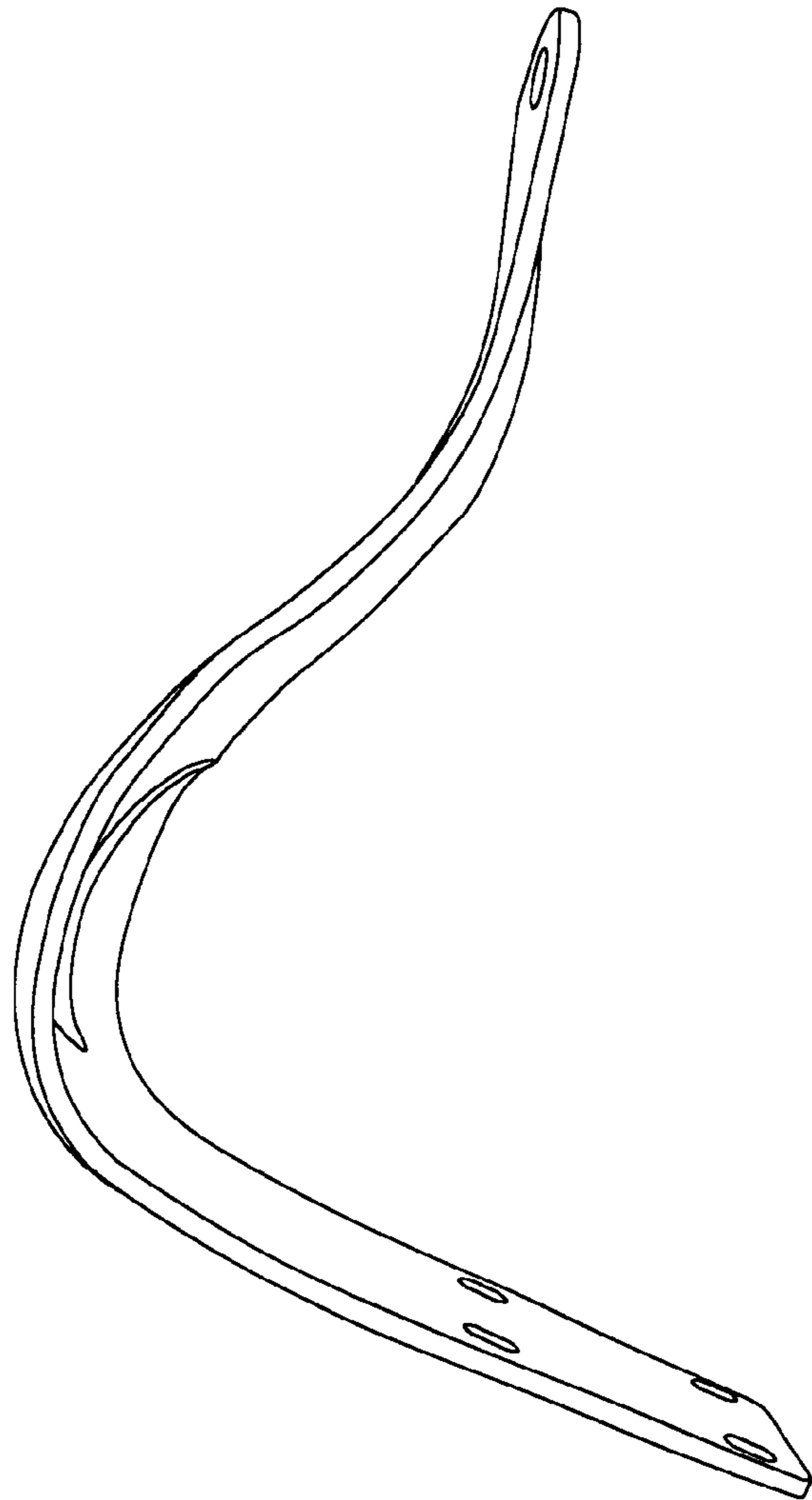

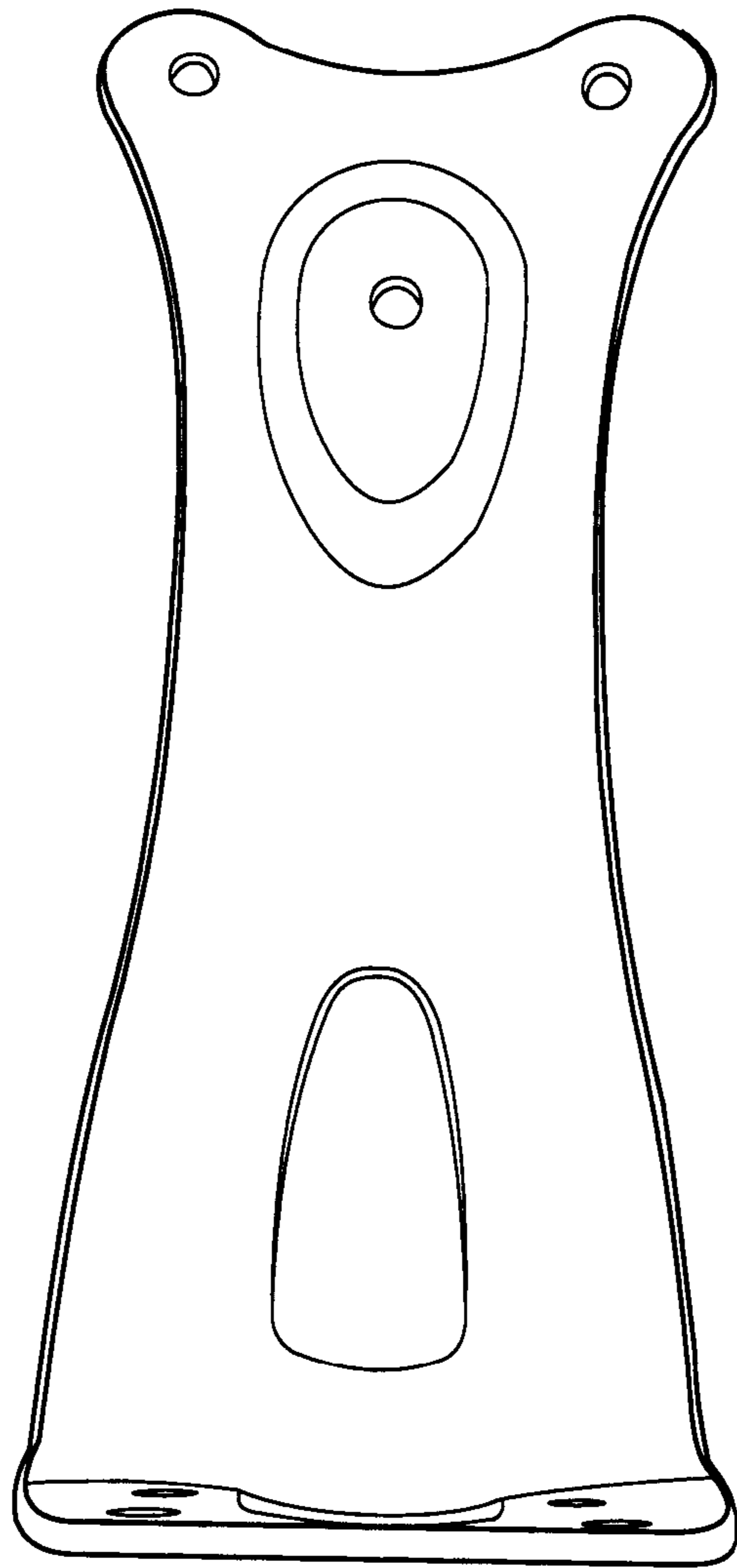

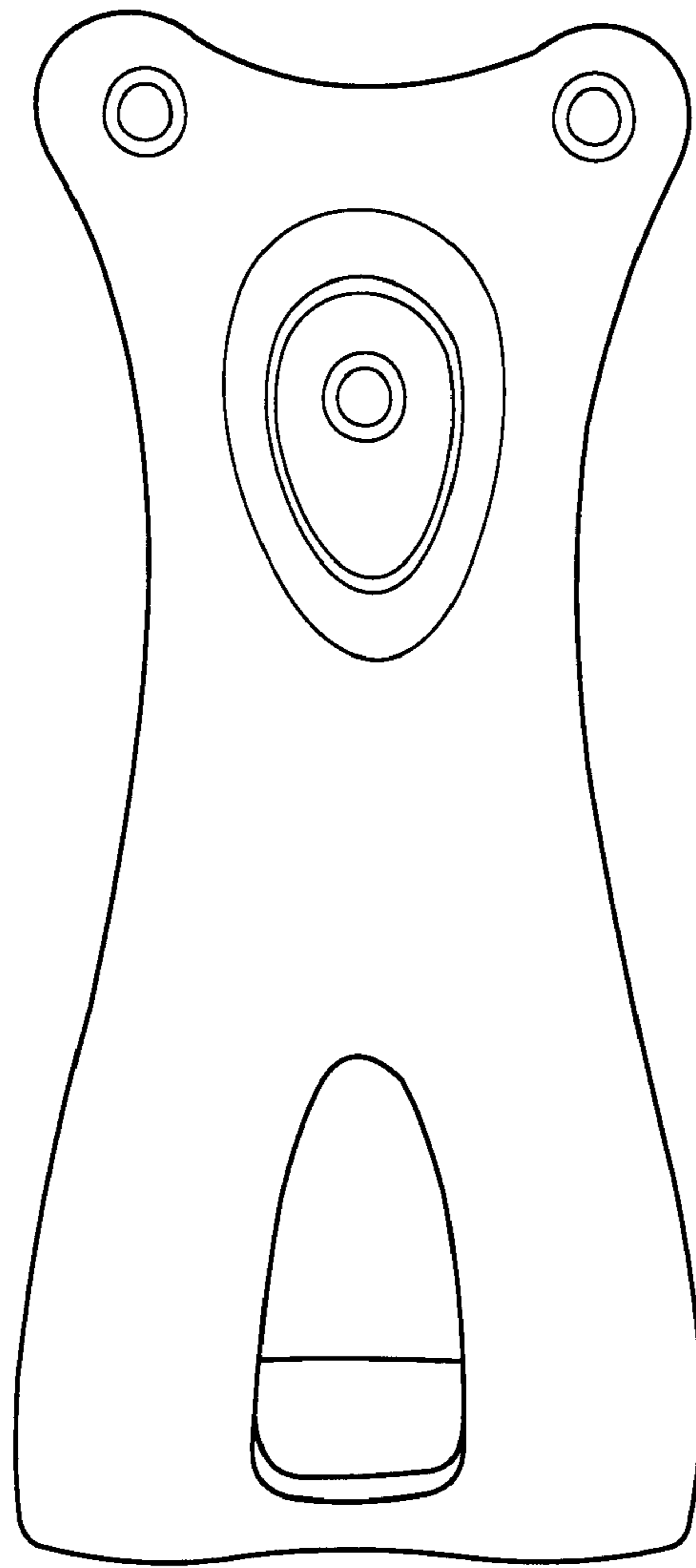

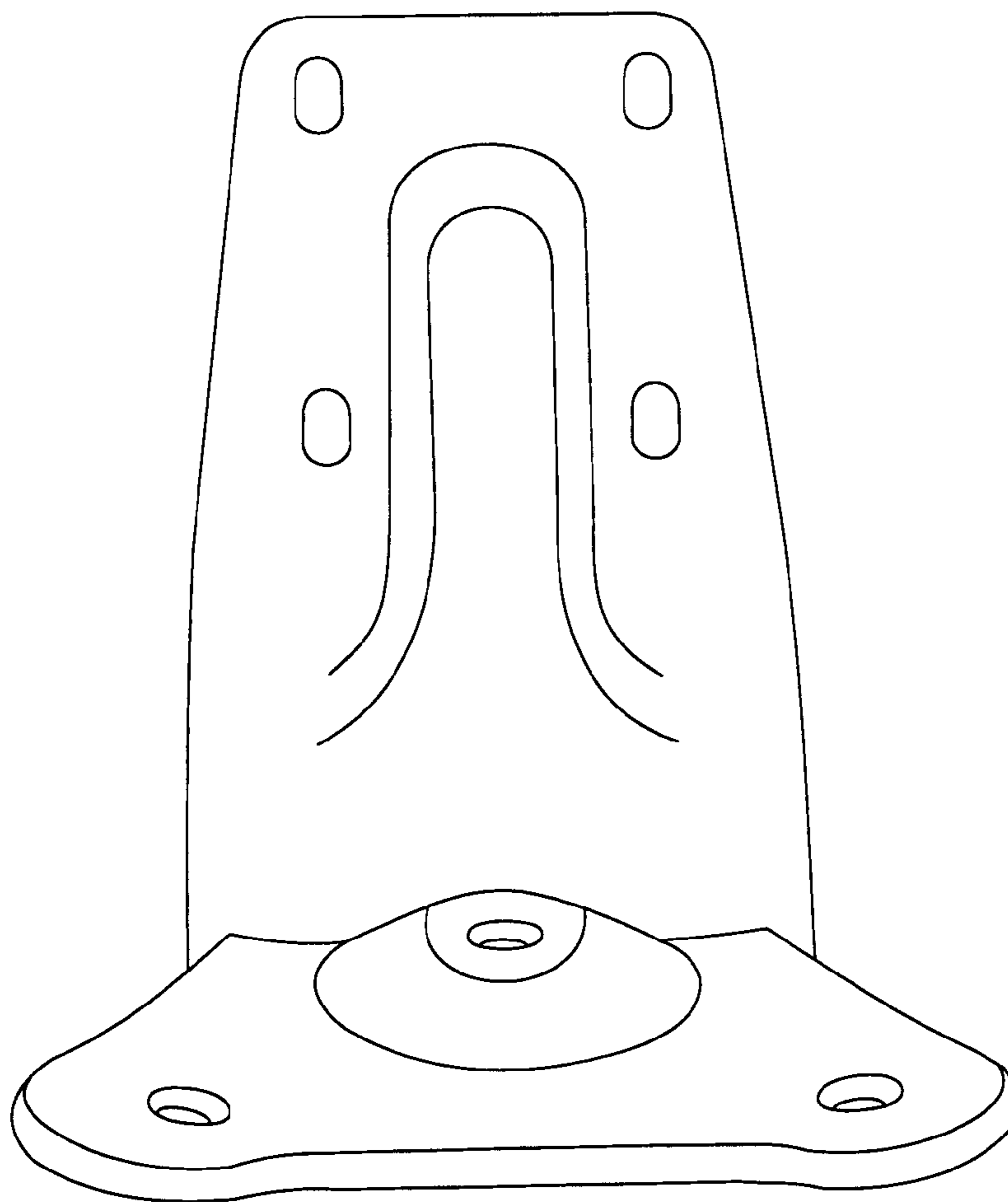

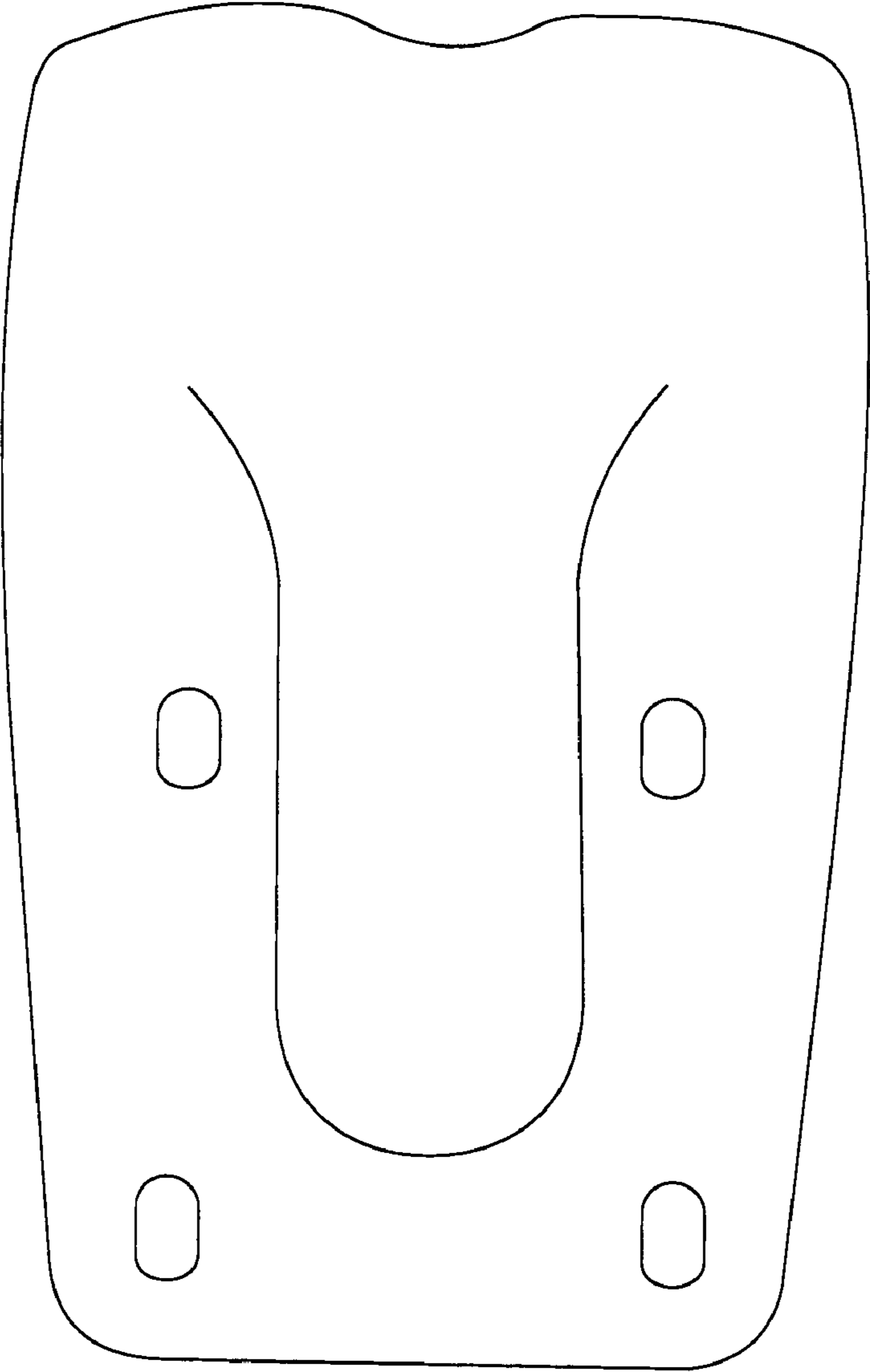
