The ornamental design for a fish carrier, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, left side top perspective view of a first embodiment of a fish carrier showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a right-side elevational view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a left-side elevational view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof, the opposite, rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof.

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

FIG. 7 is a front, left side and top perspective view of the second embodiment of a fish carrier showing my new design;

FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 10 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a front elevational view thereof, the opposite, rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 13 is a front, left side and top perspective view of the third embodiment of a fish carrier showing my new design;

FIG. 14 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 15 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 16 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 17 is a front elevational view thereof, the opposite, rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 18 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 19 is a front, left side and top perspective view of the fourth embodiment of a fish carrier showing my new design;

FIG. 20 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 21 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 22 is a top plan view thereof;

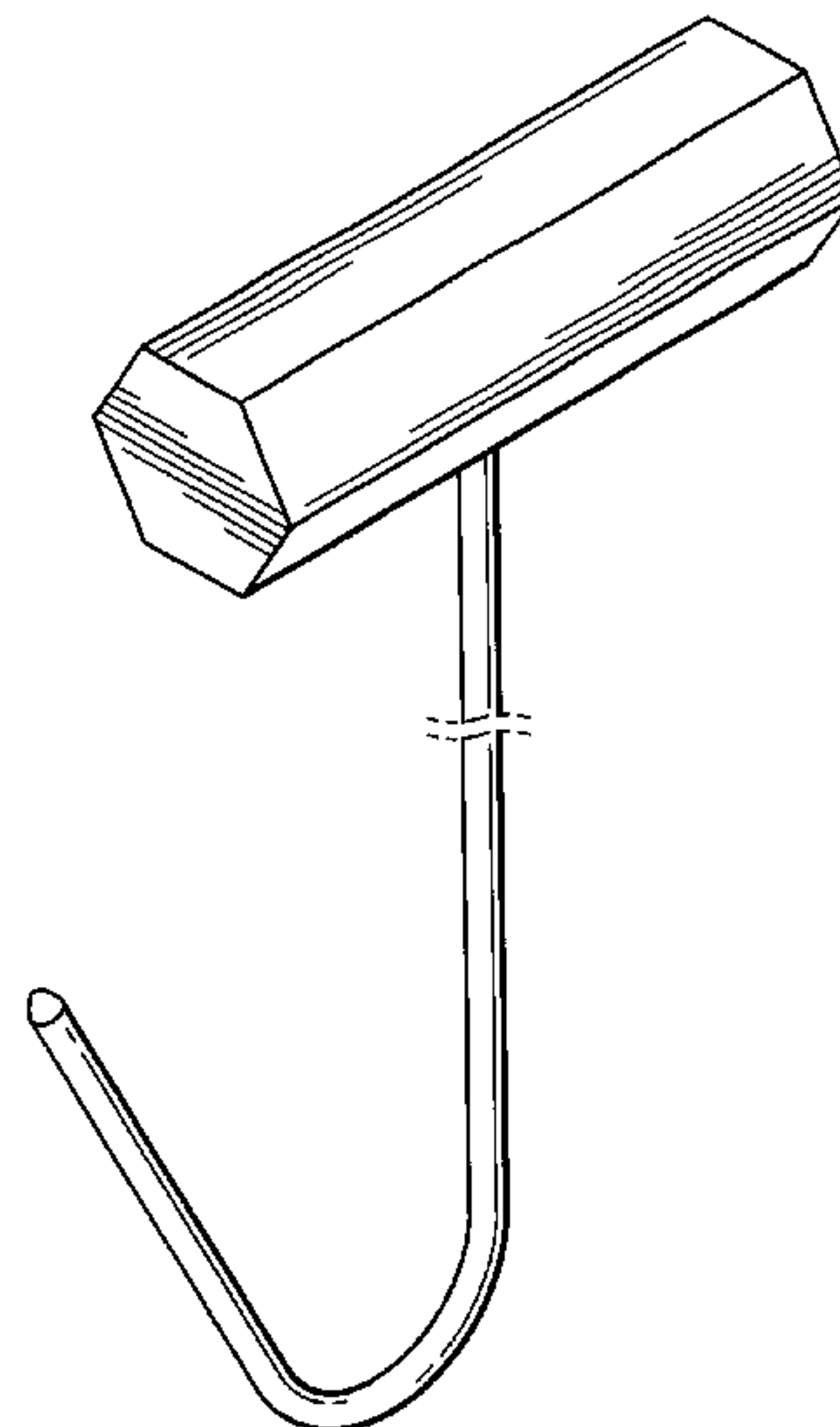
FIG. 23 is a front elevational view thereof, the opposite; rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof; and,

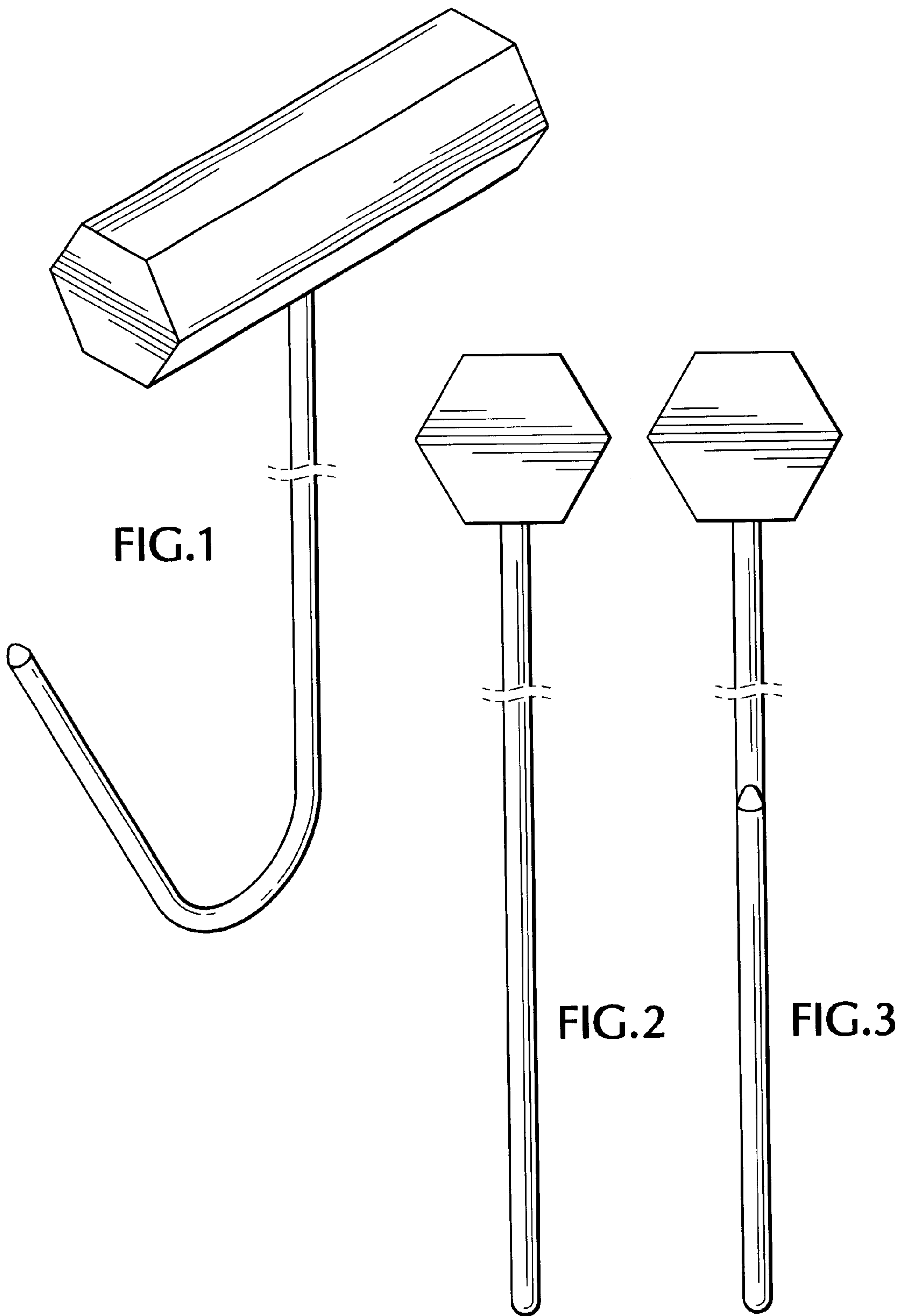
FIG. 24 is a bottom plan view thereof.

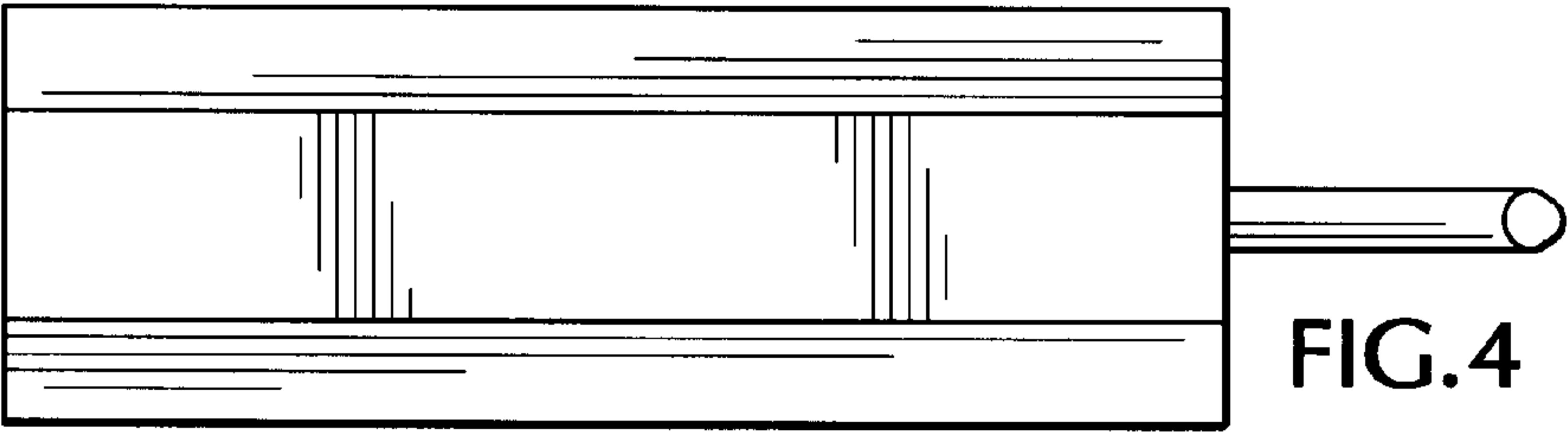

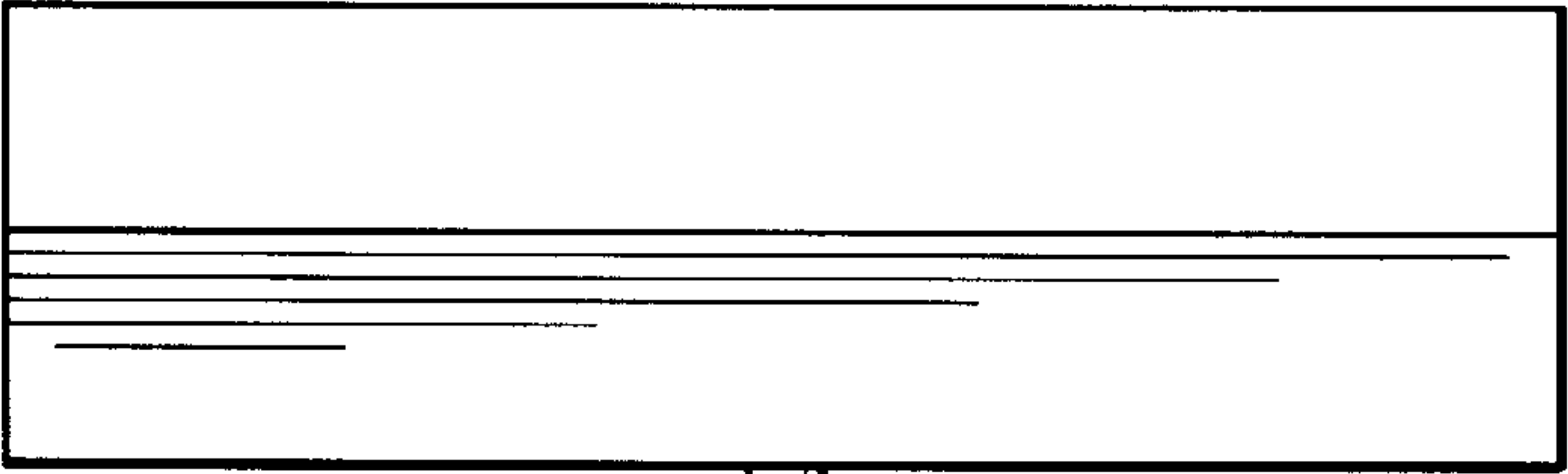

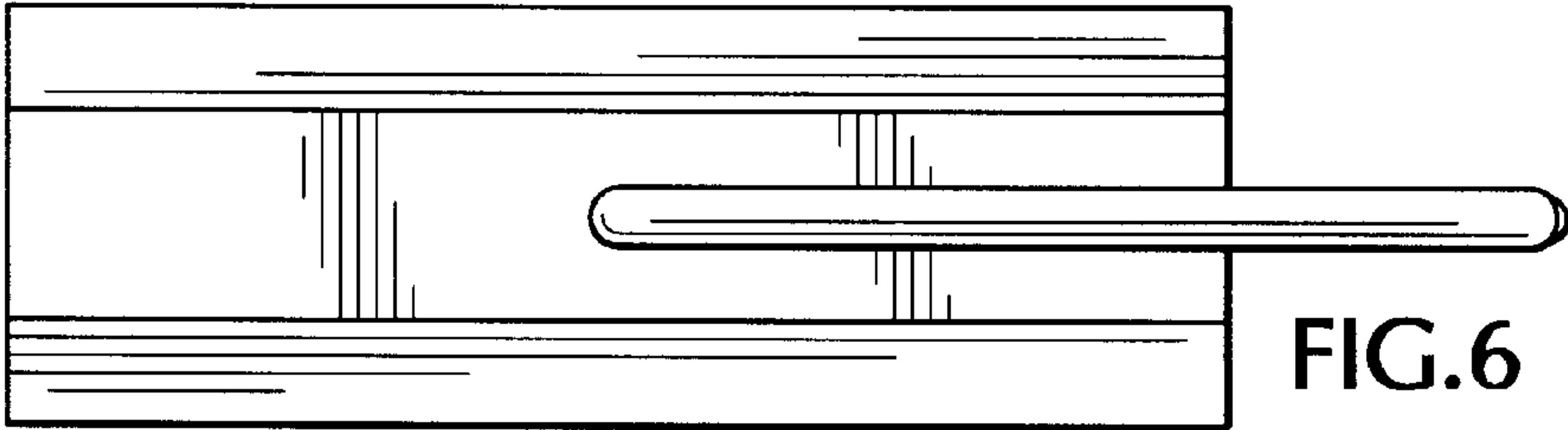
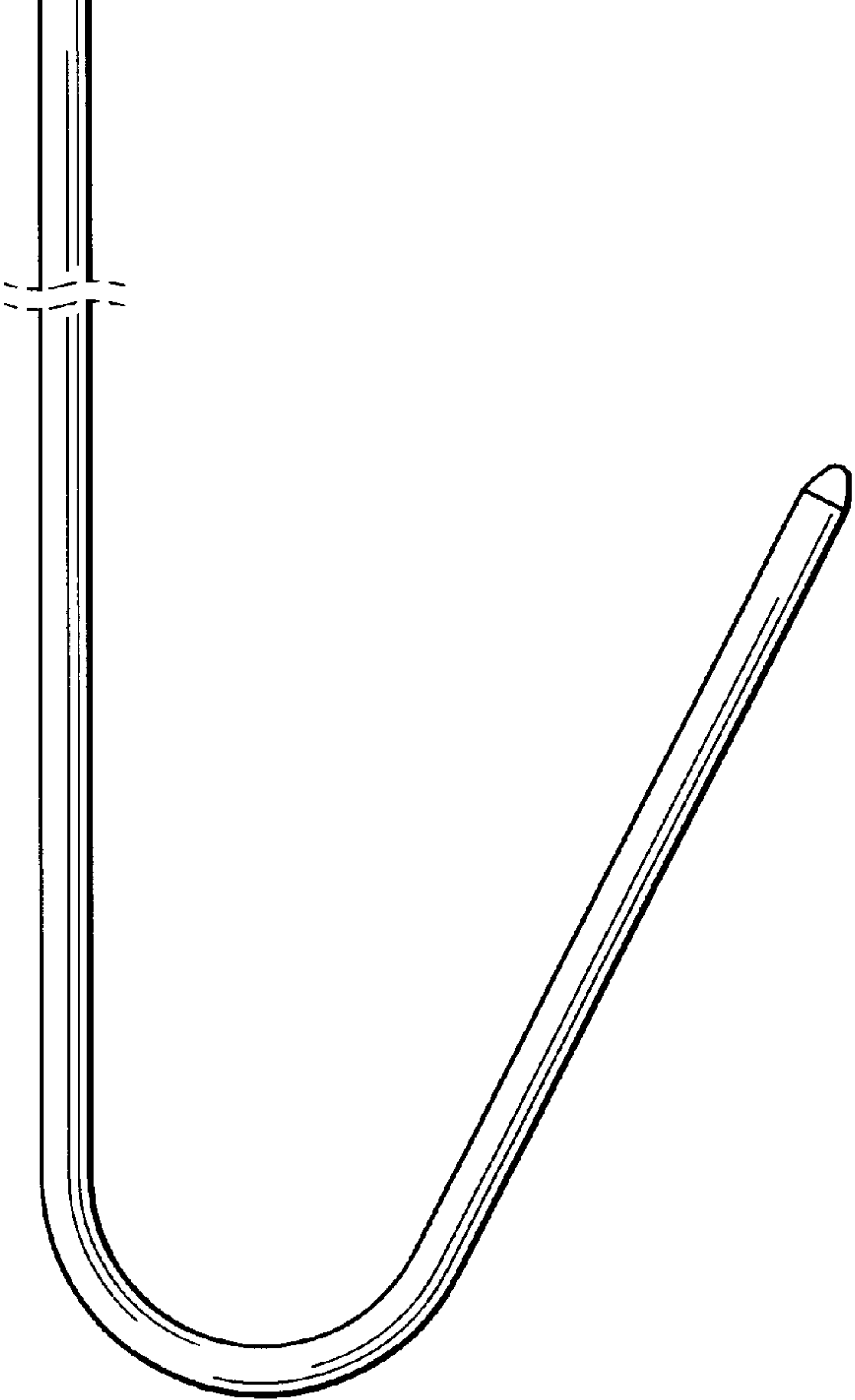

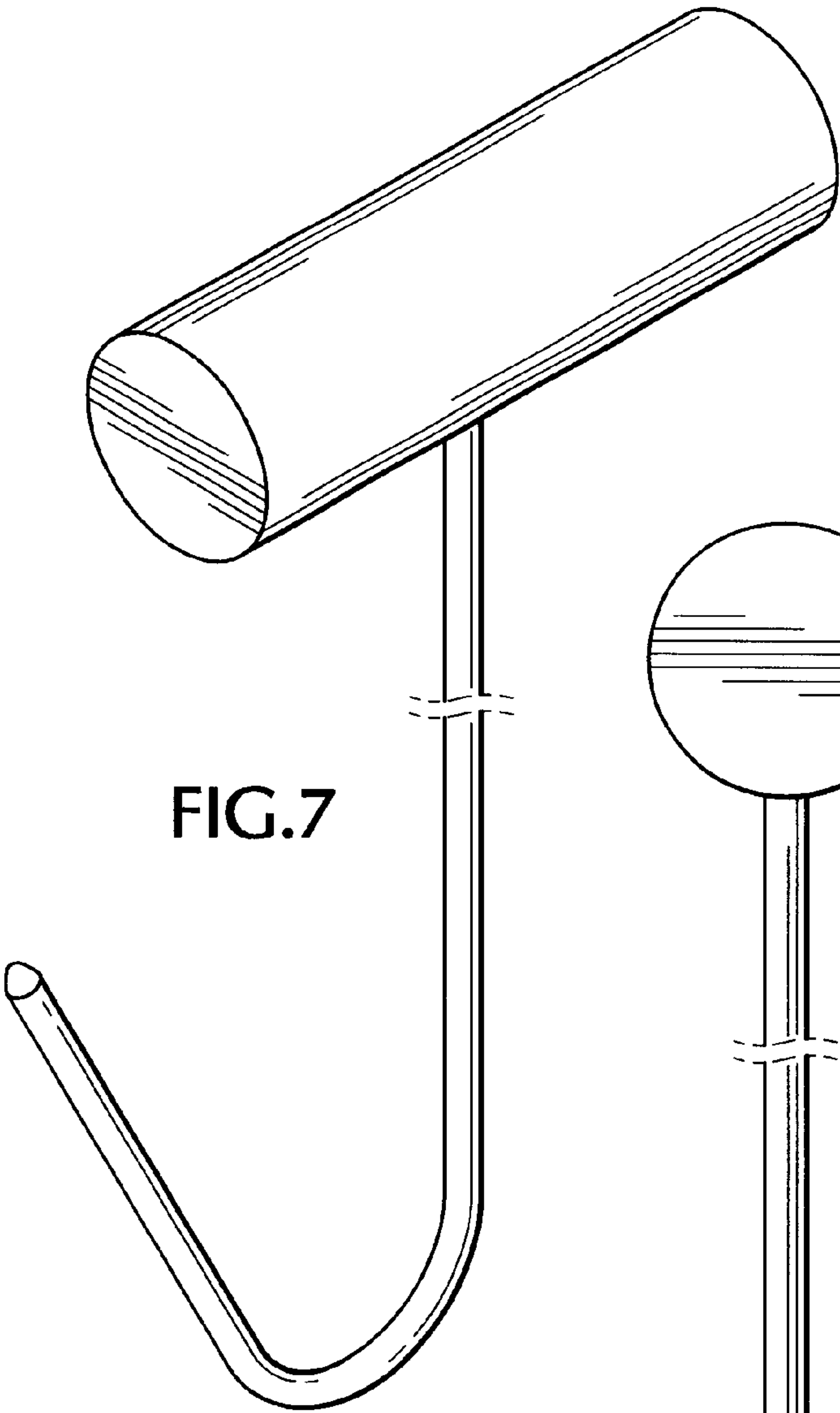

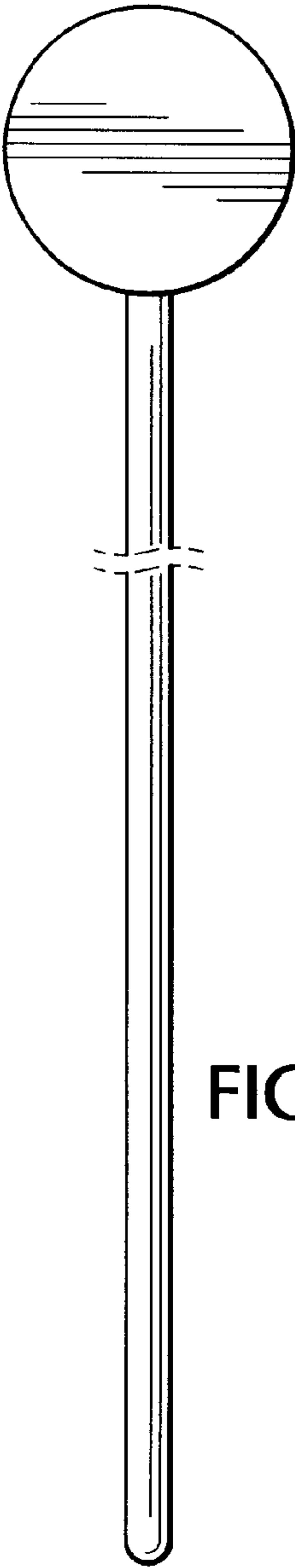

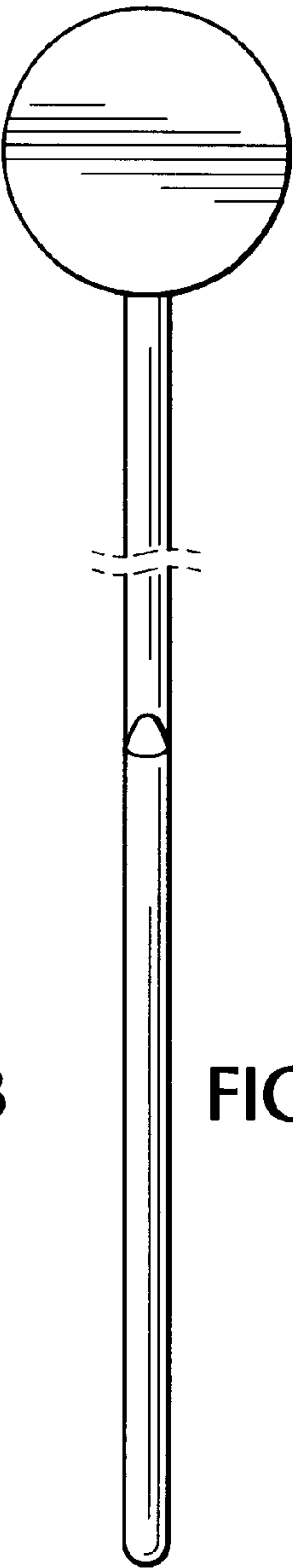

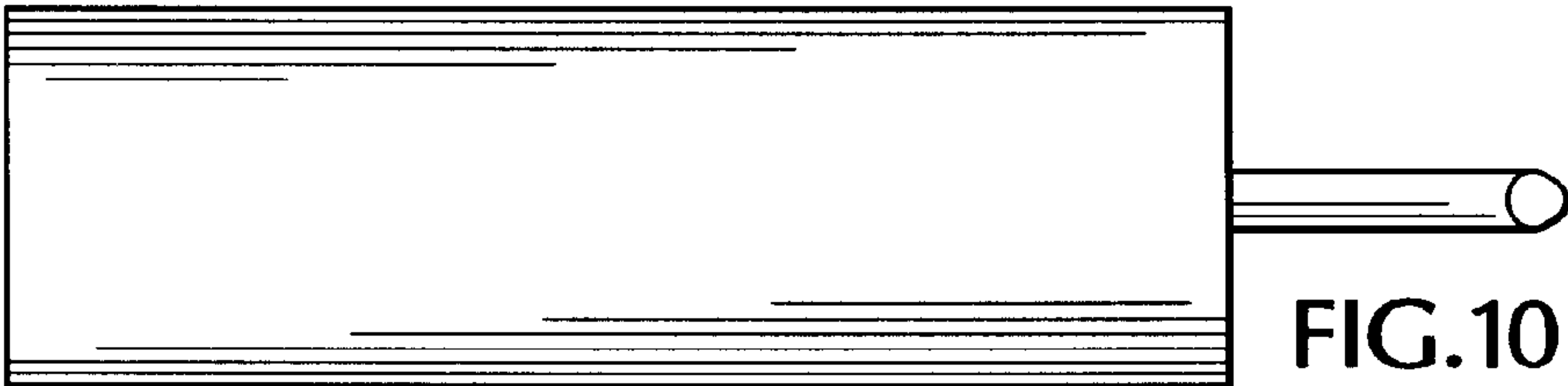

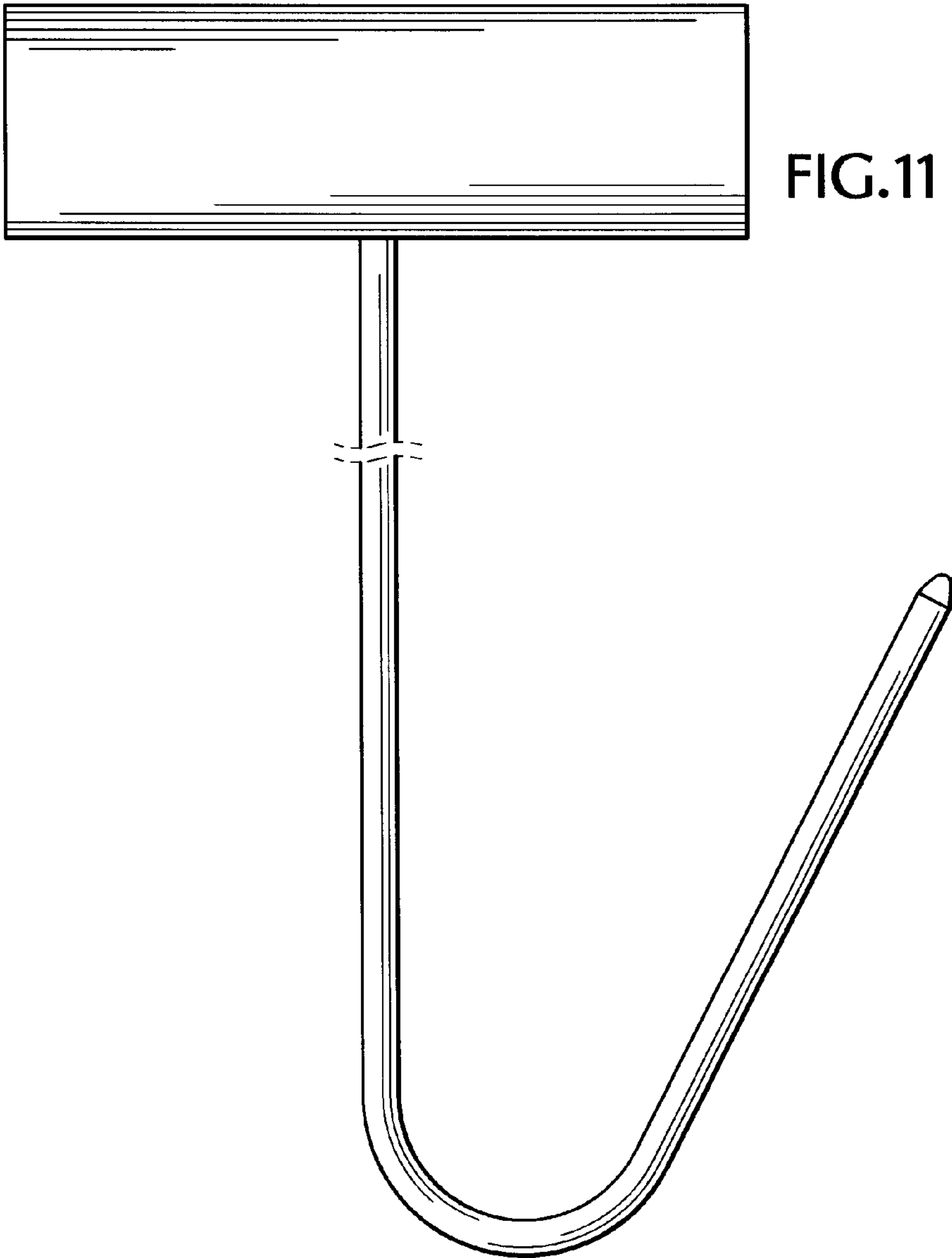

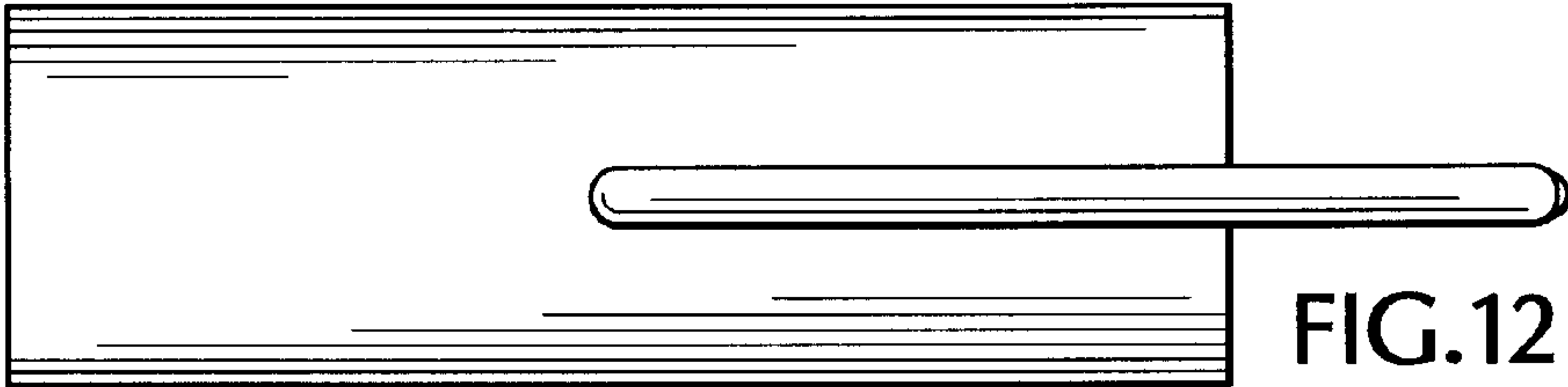
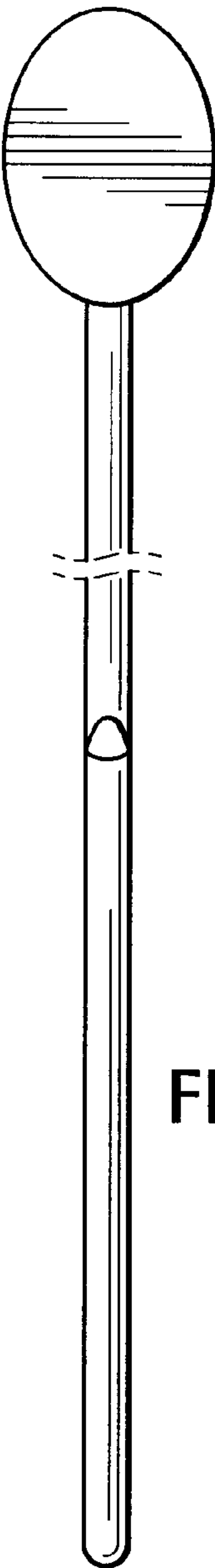
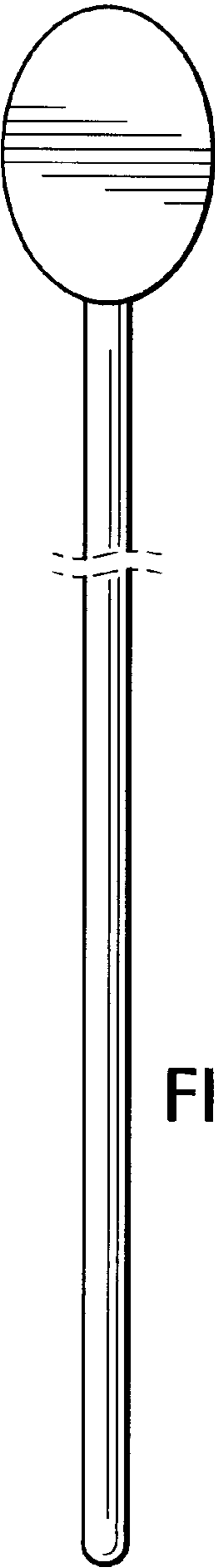
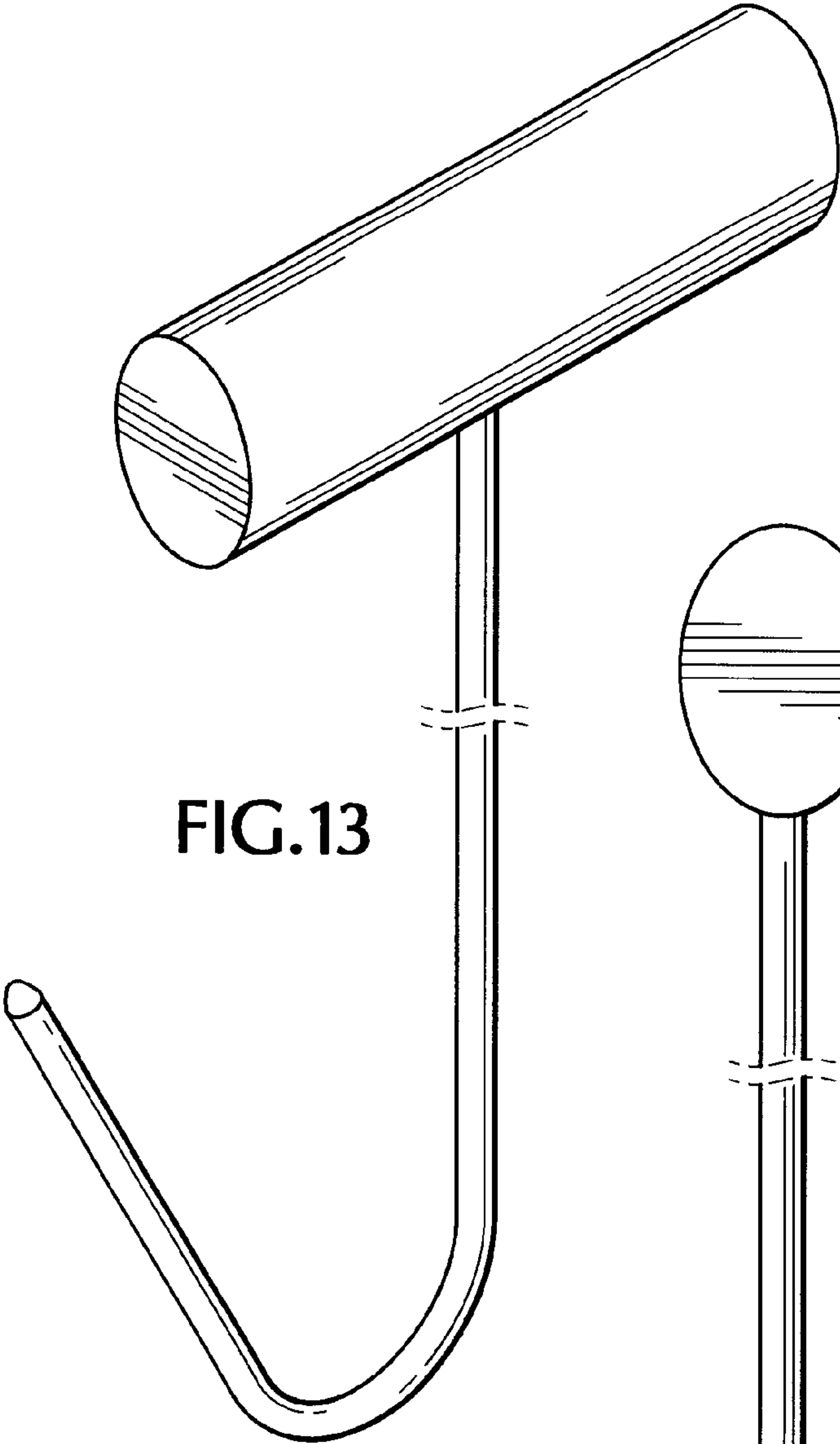

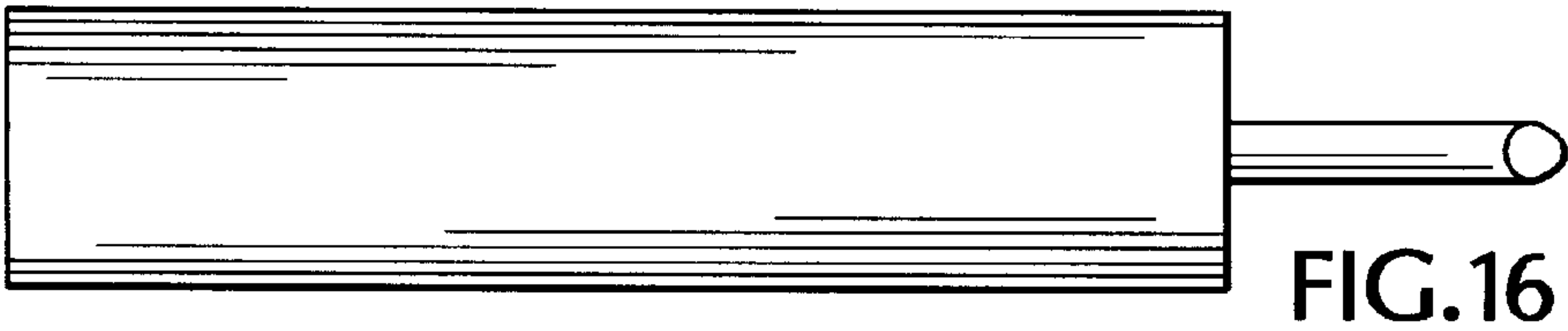

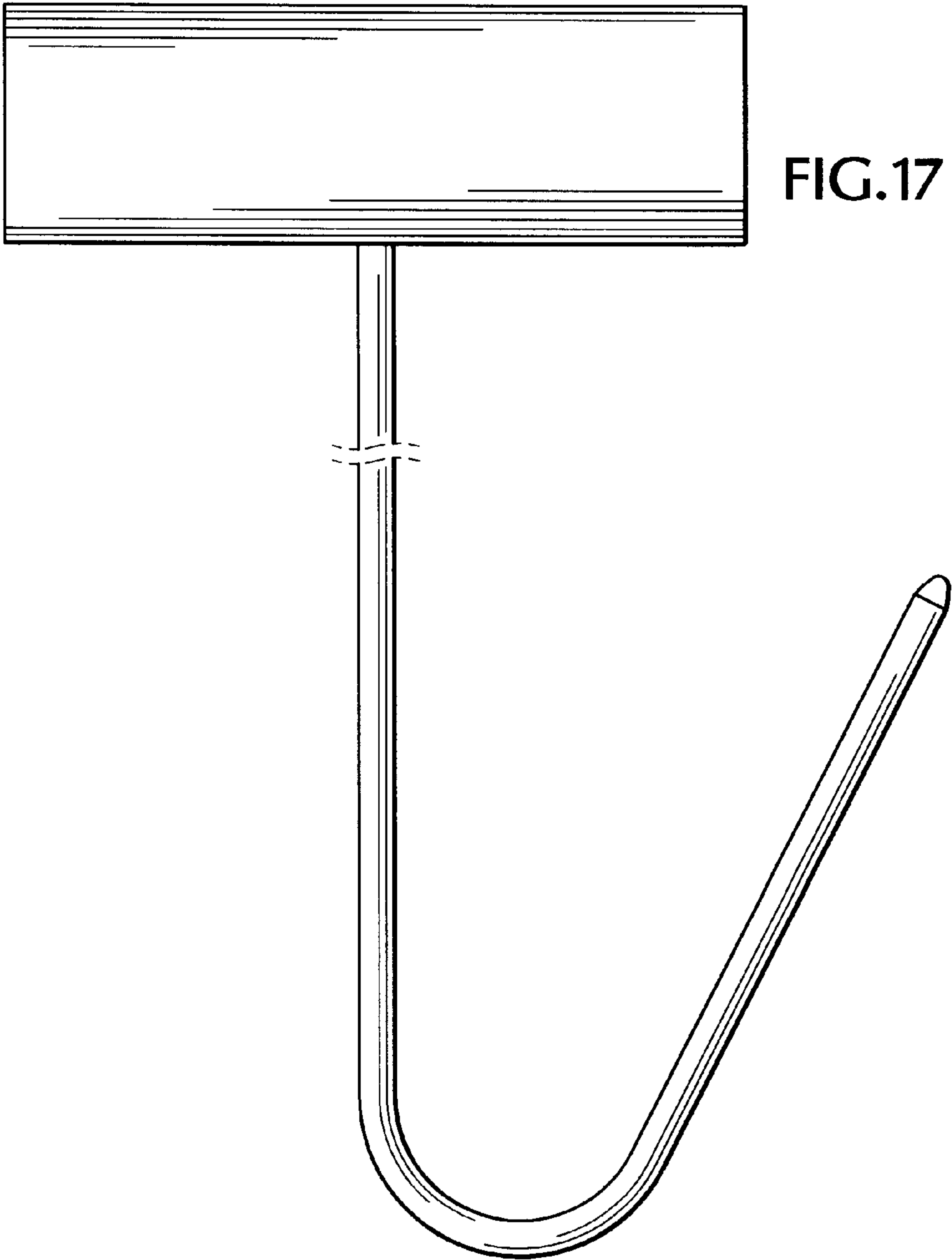

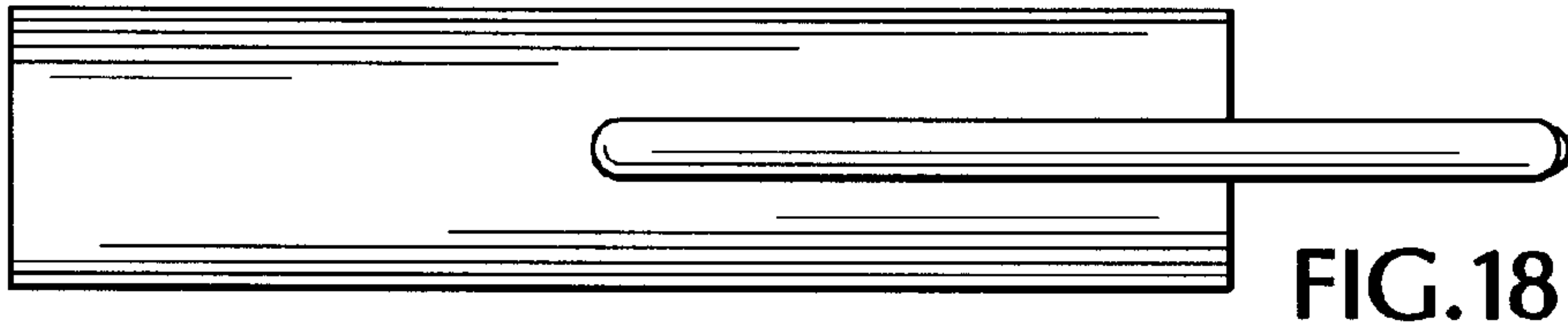
