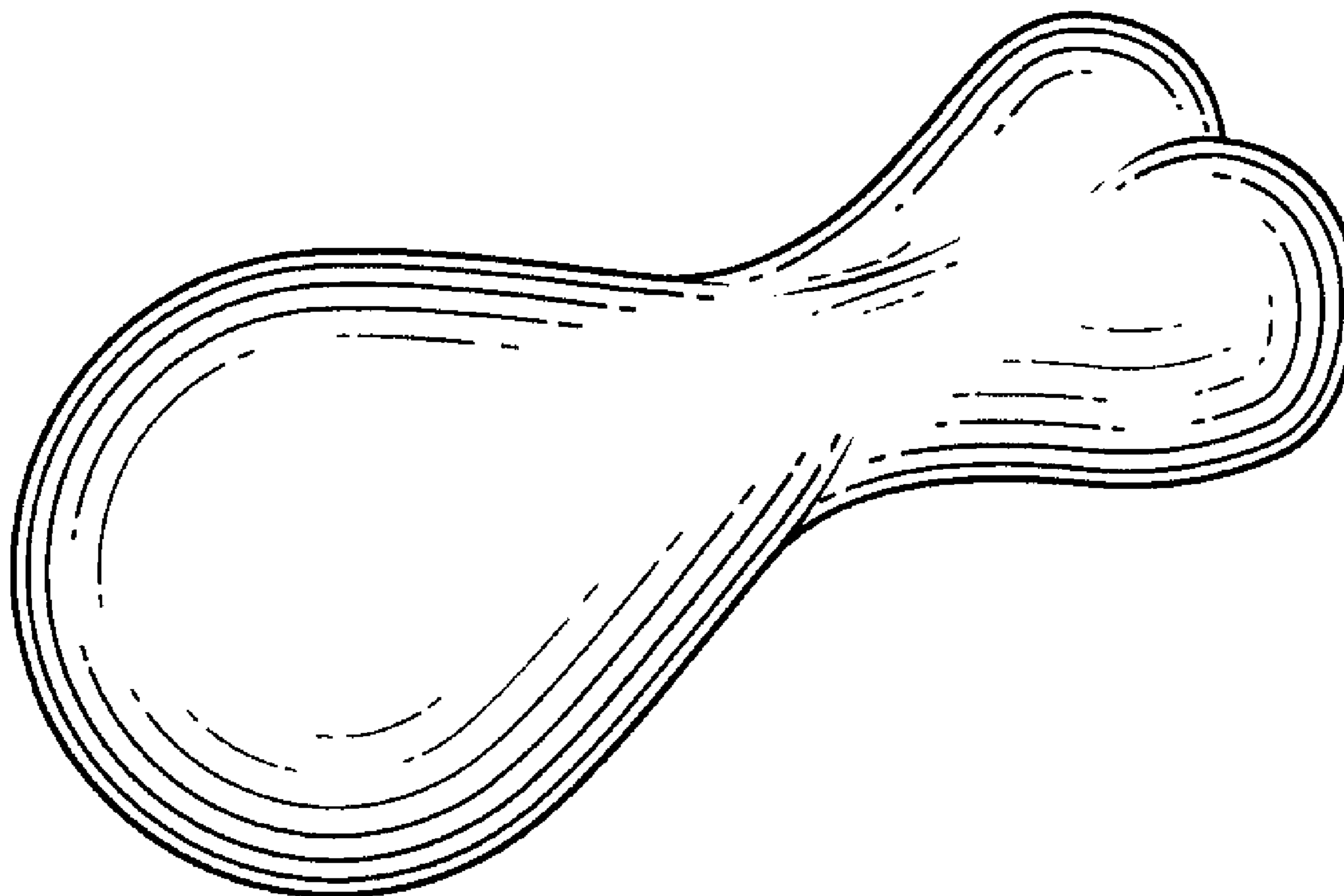

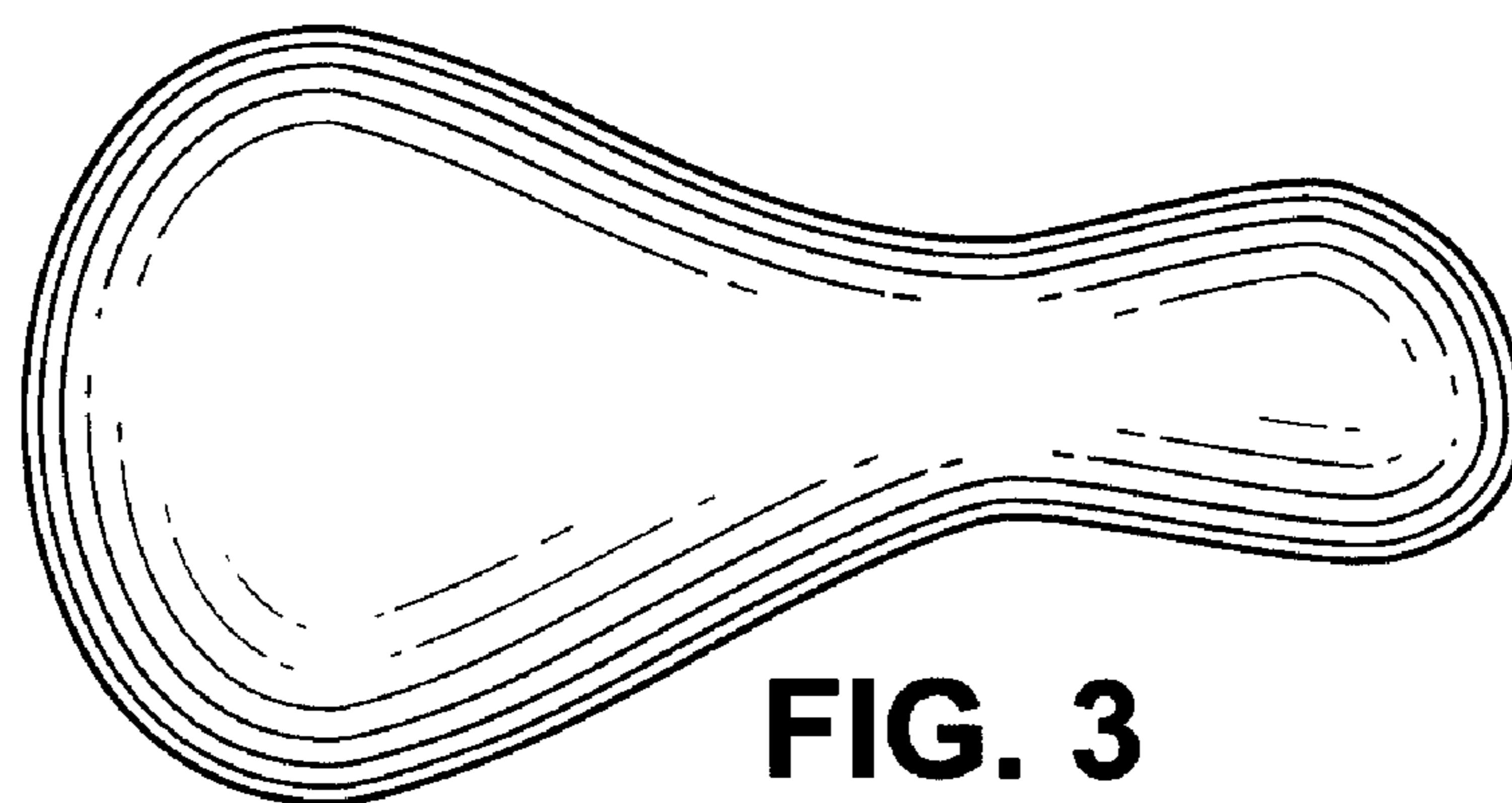
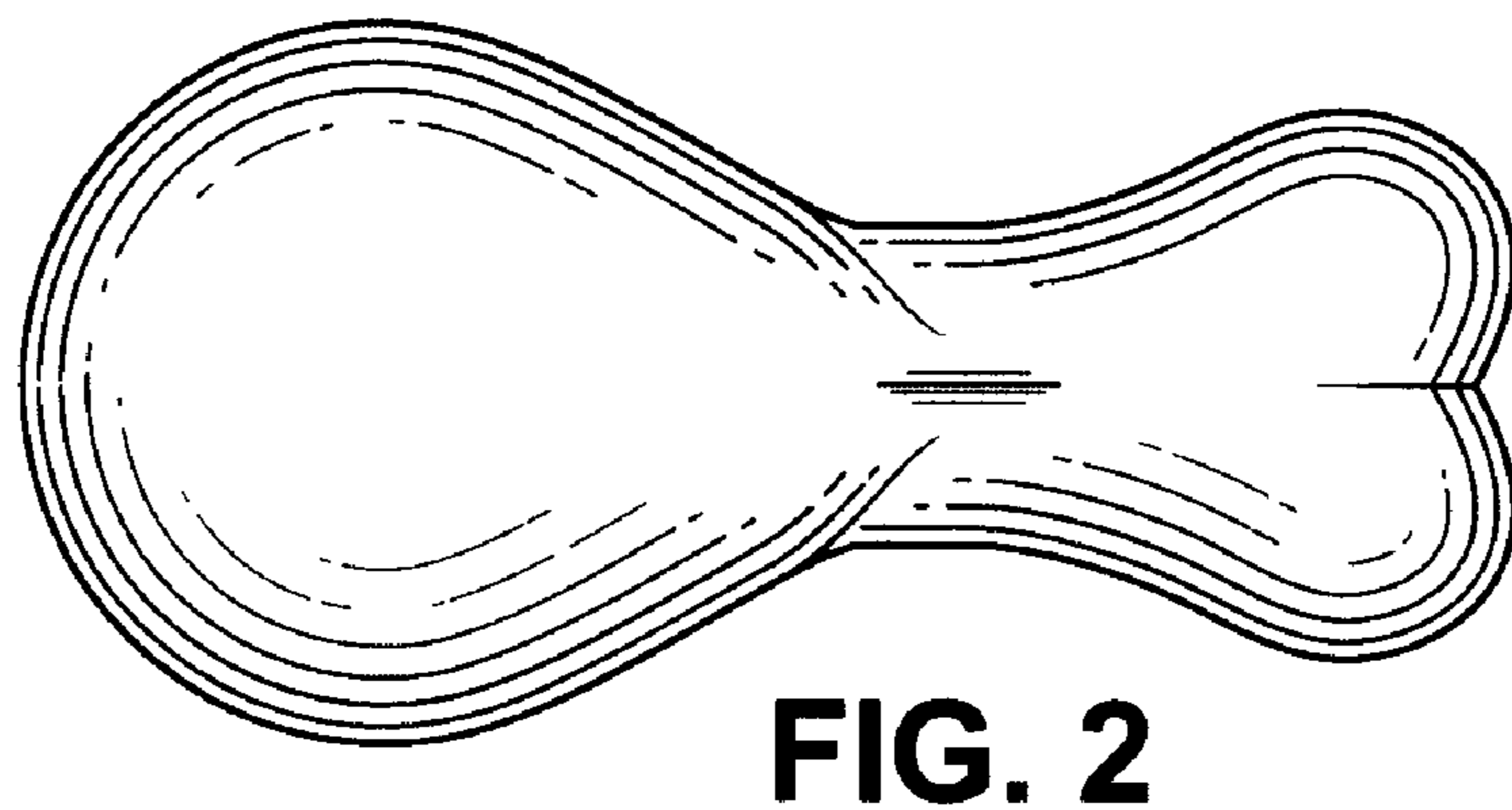
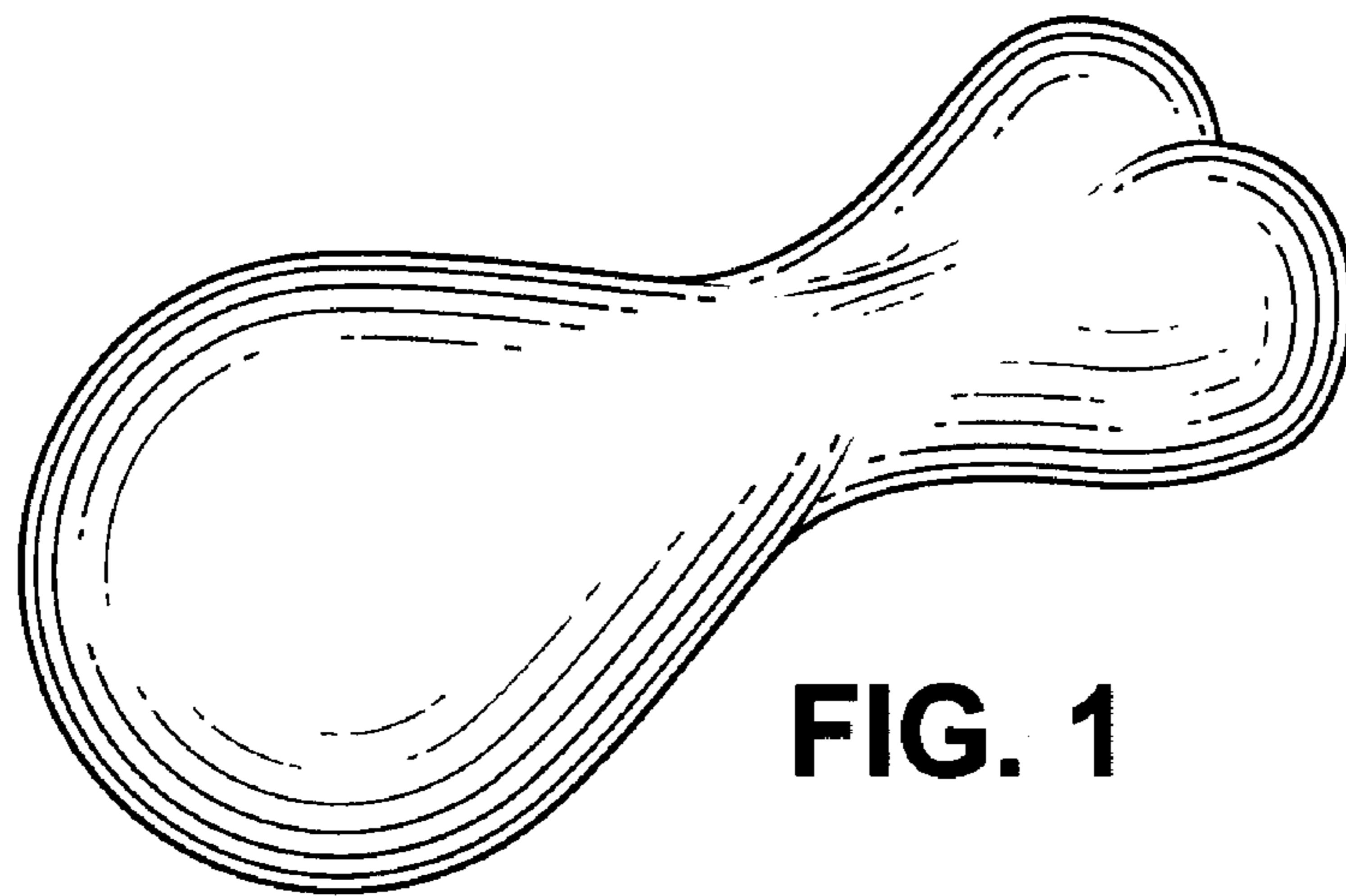
The ornamental design for an edible pet chew, substantially

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the front end, left side and
top of the edible pet chew, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the left side thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of the right side thereof;

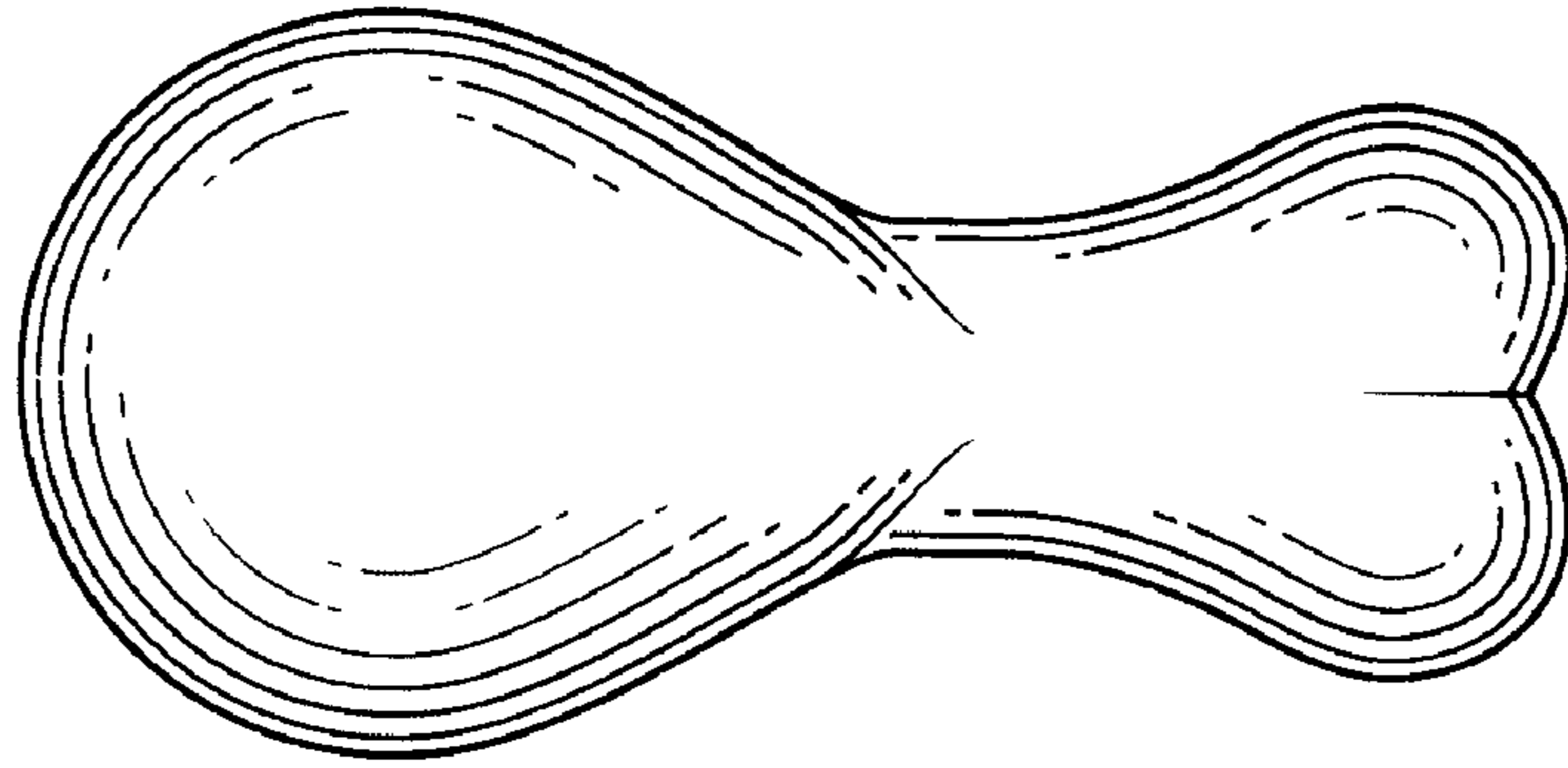

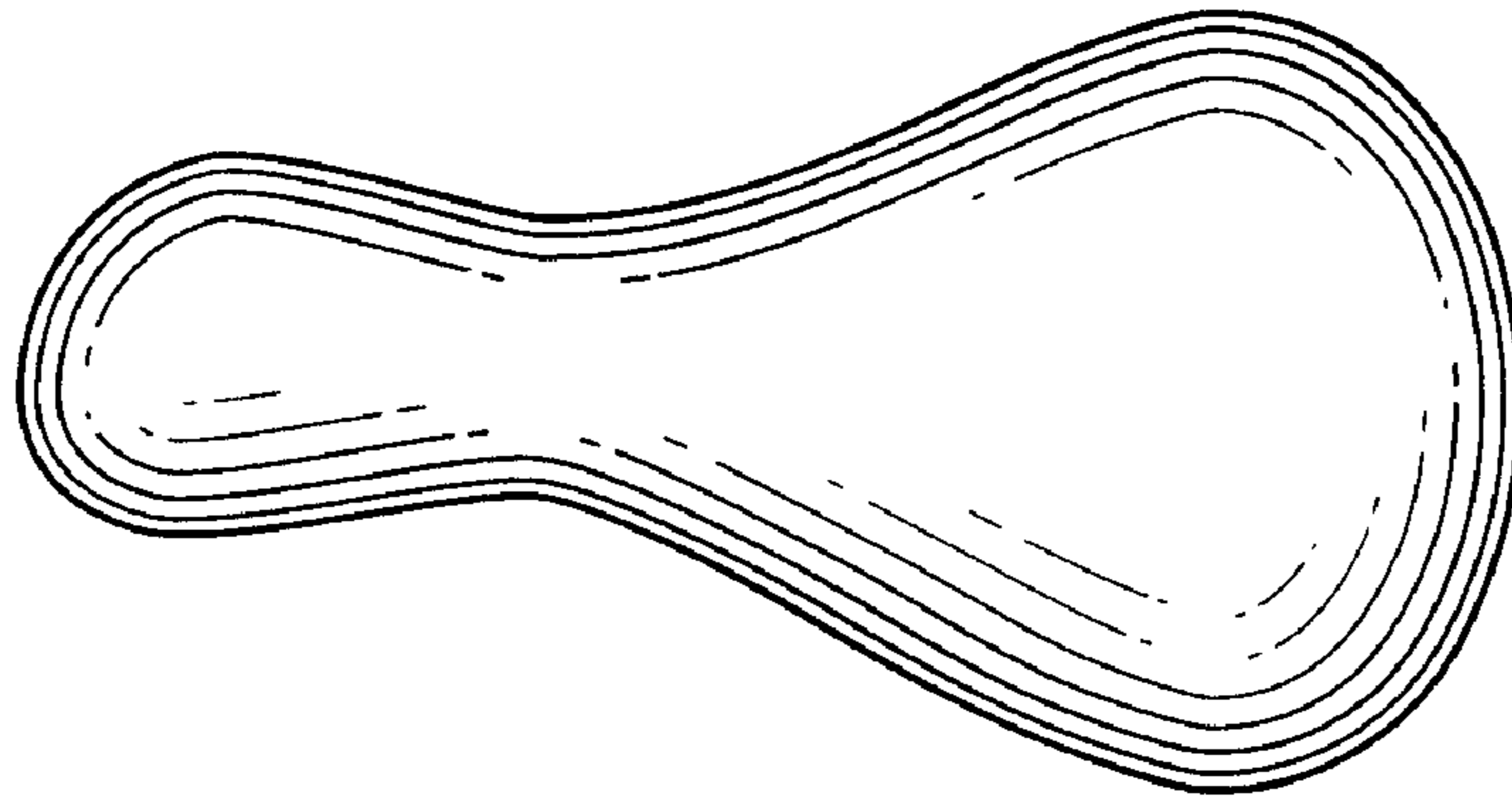

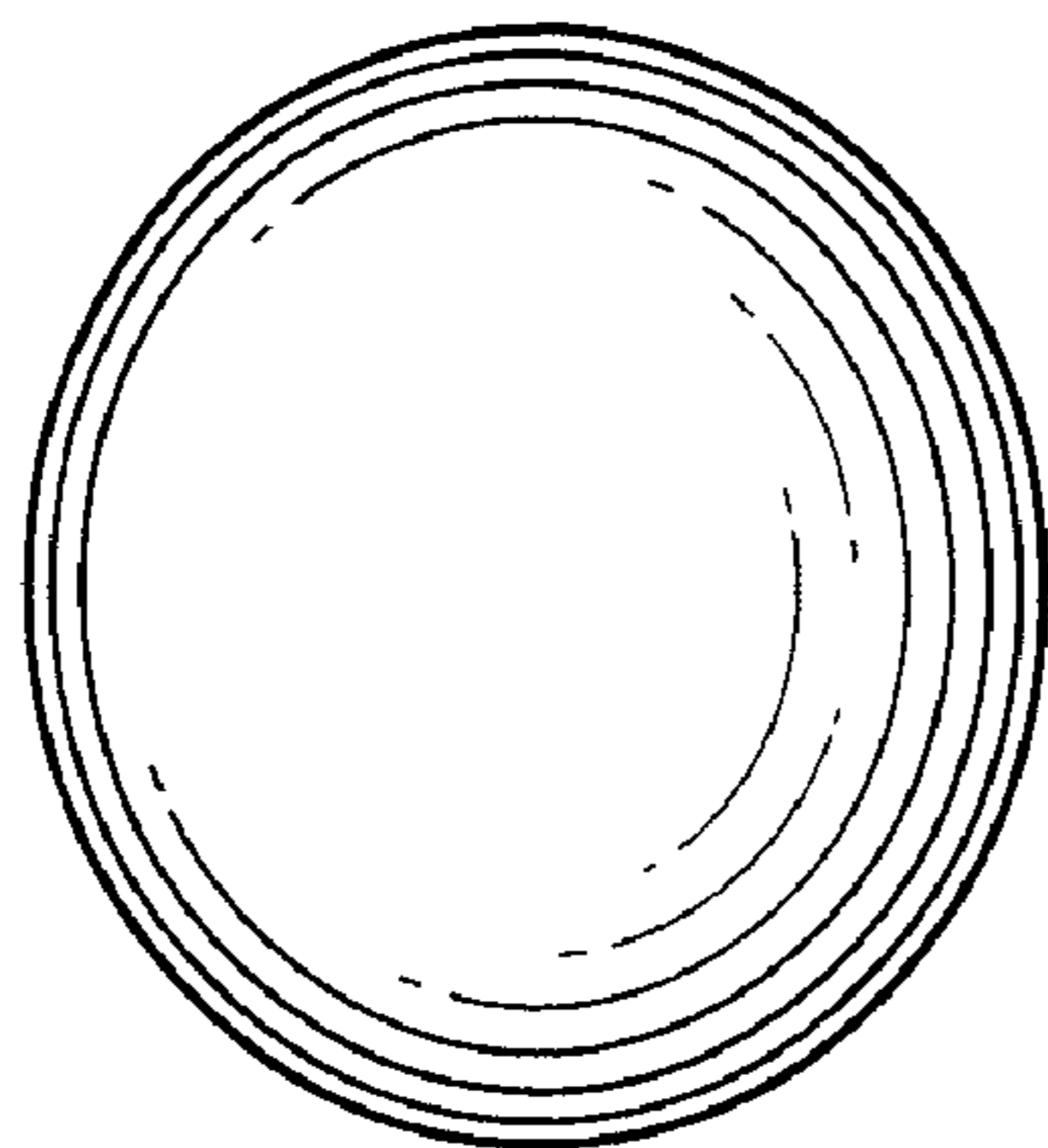

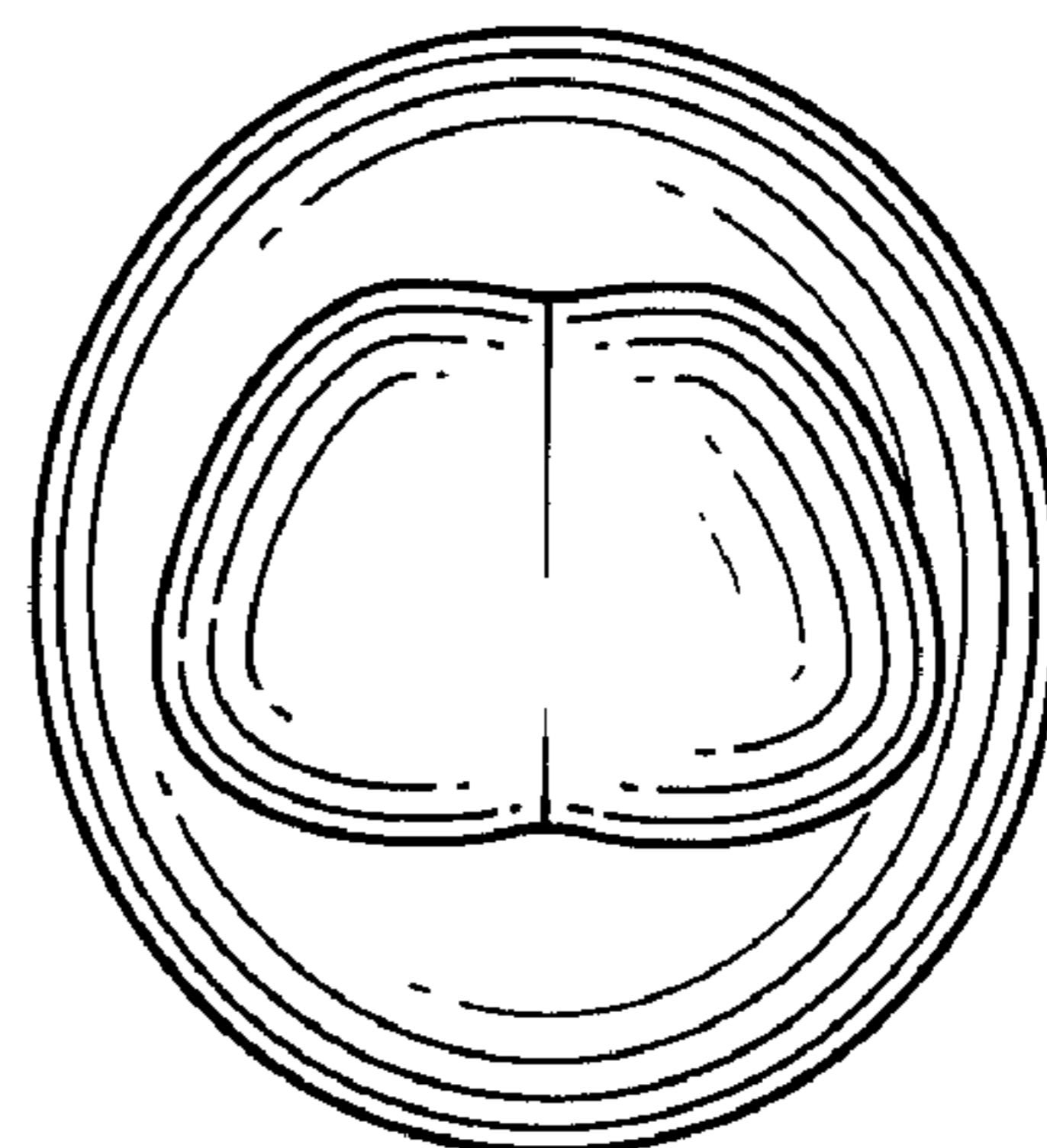
