DESCRIPTION

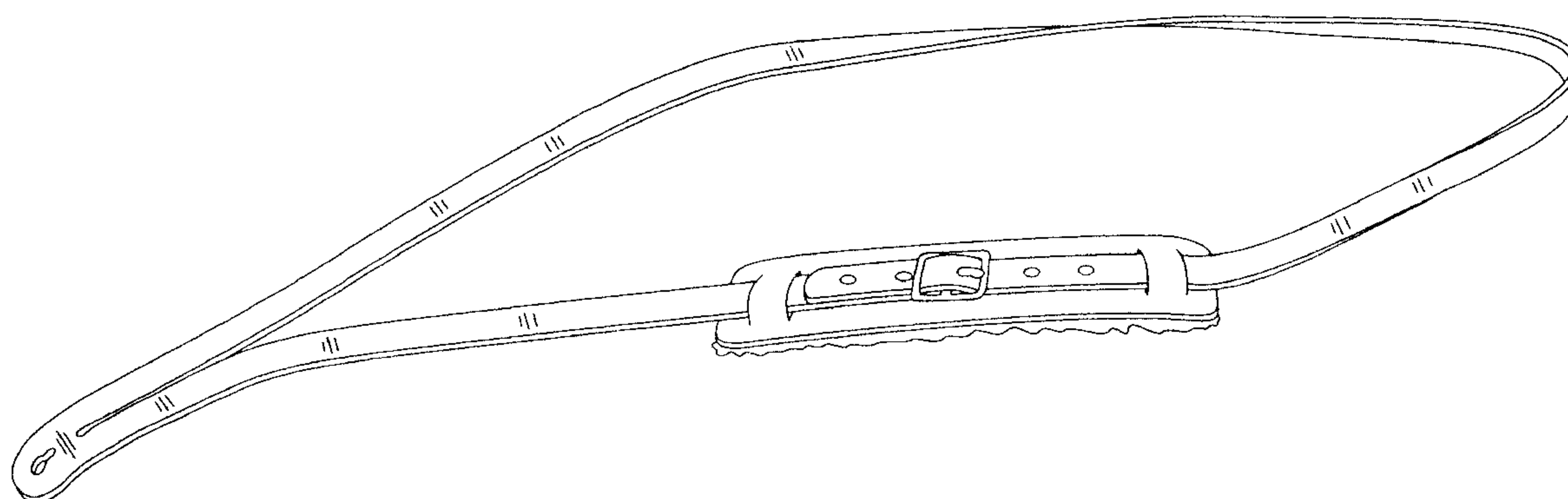
FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of an apparatus for

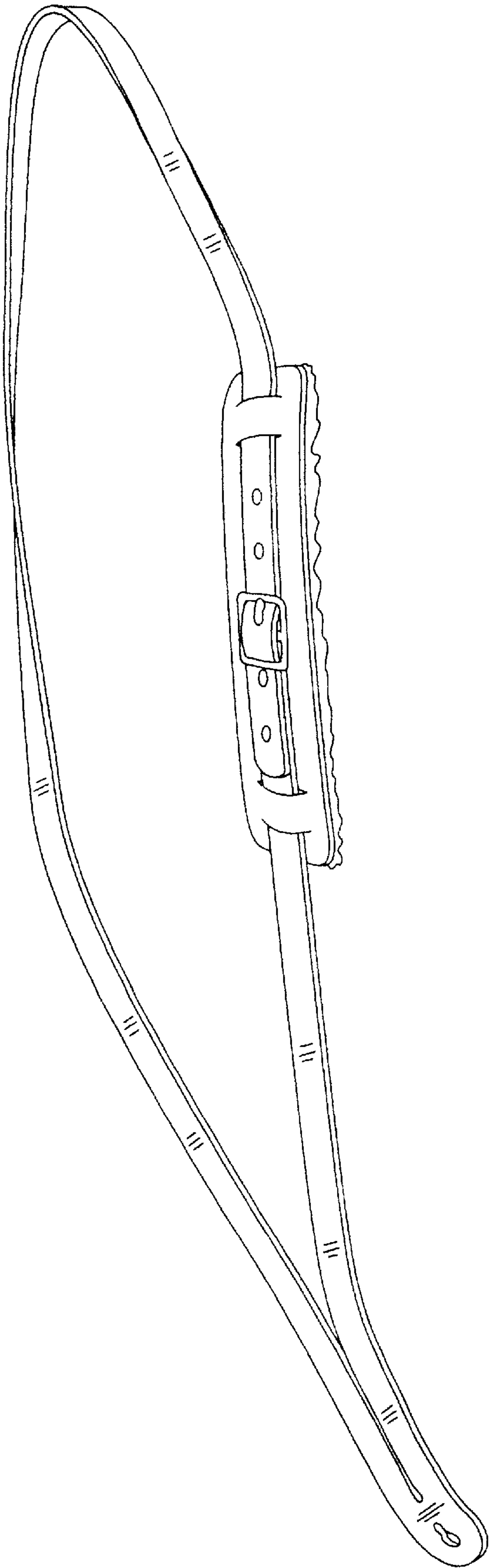

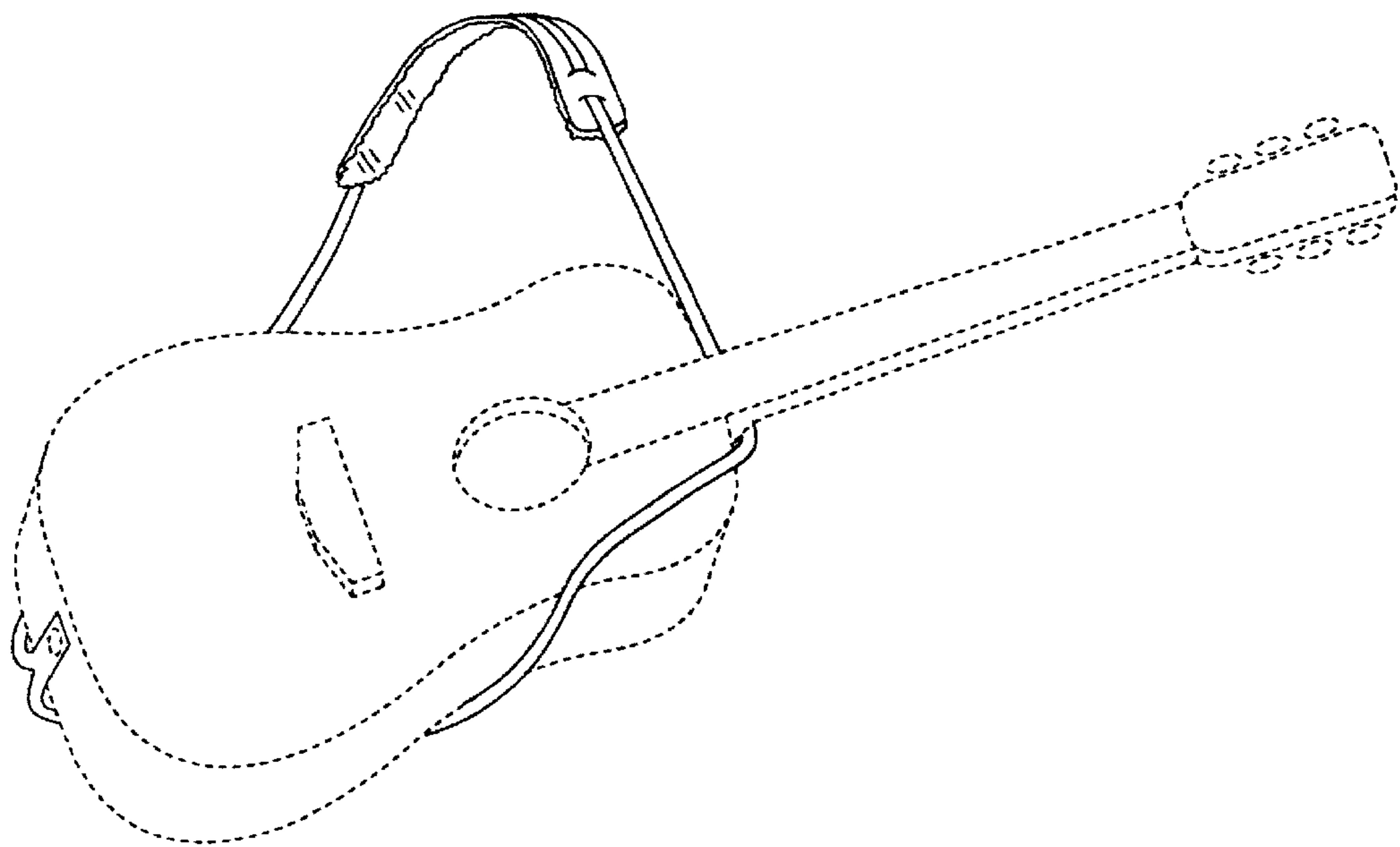

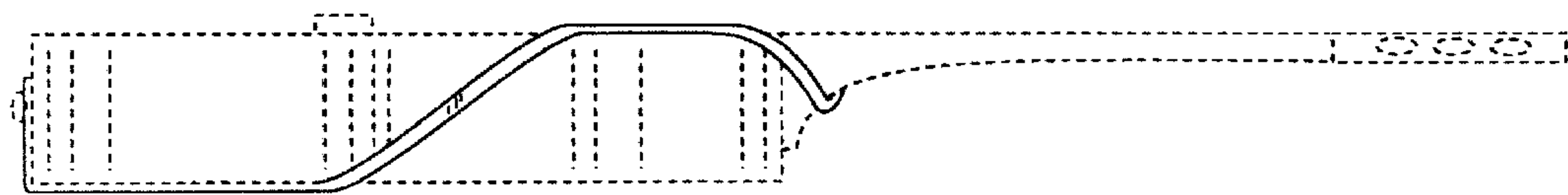
