DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a hair treatment applicator, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top view of the hair treatment applicator of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the hair treatment applicator of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a side view of the hair treatment applicator of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a back view of the hair treatment applicator of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 6 is a front view of the hair treatment applicator of FIG. 1.

The image is a line drawing of a hair treatment applicator. It features a long, curved handle that tapers towards the top. At the top of the handle, there is a series of bristles or applicator tips arranged in a fan-like pattern. 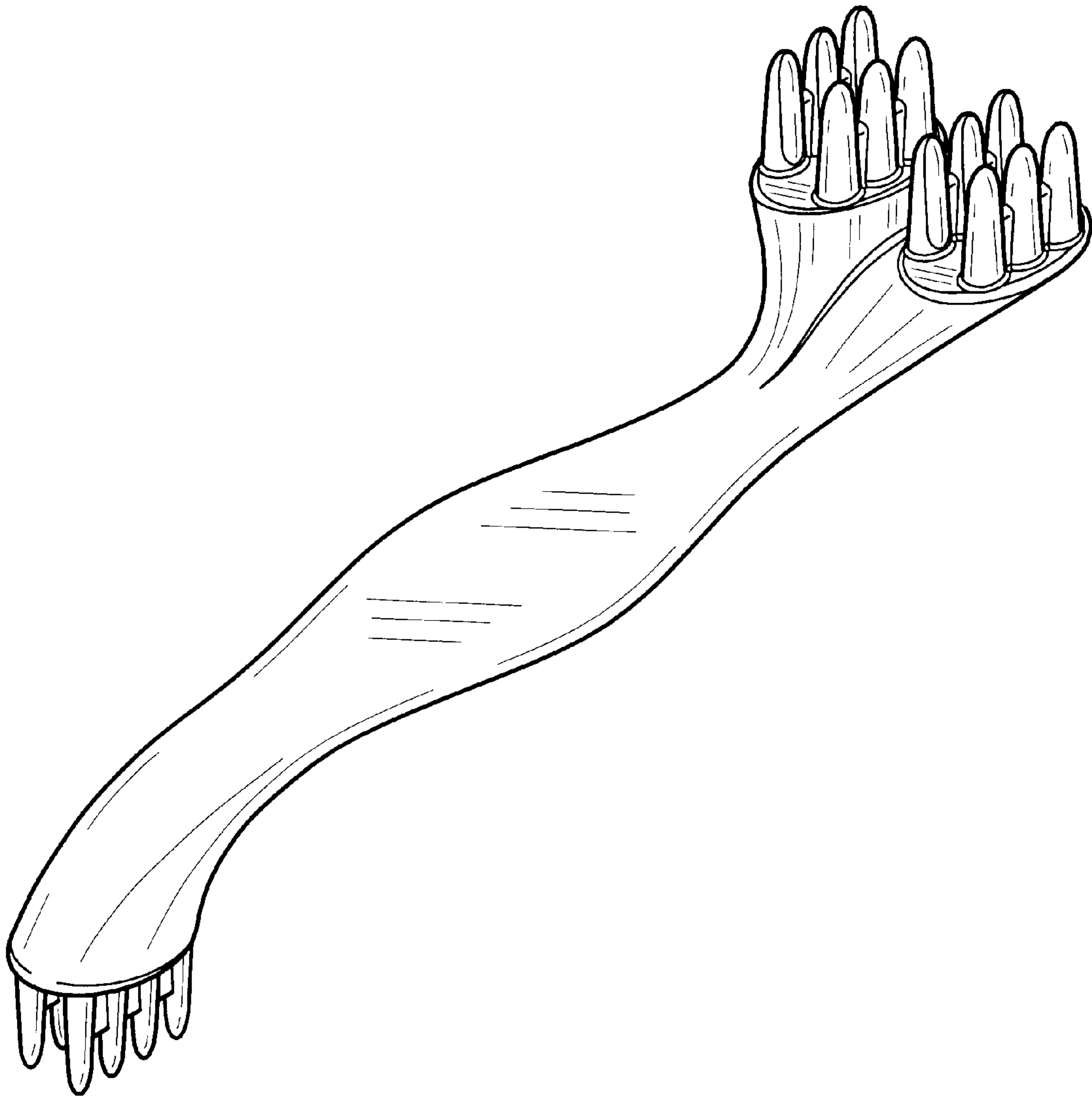

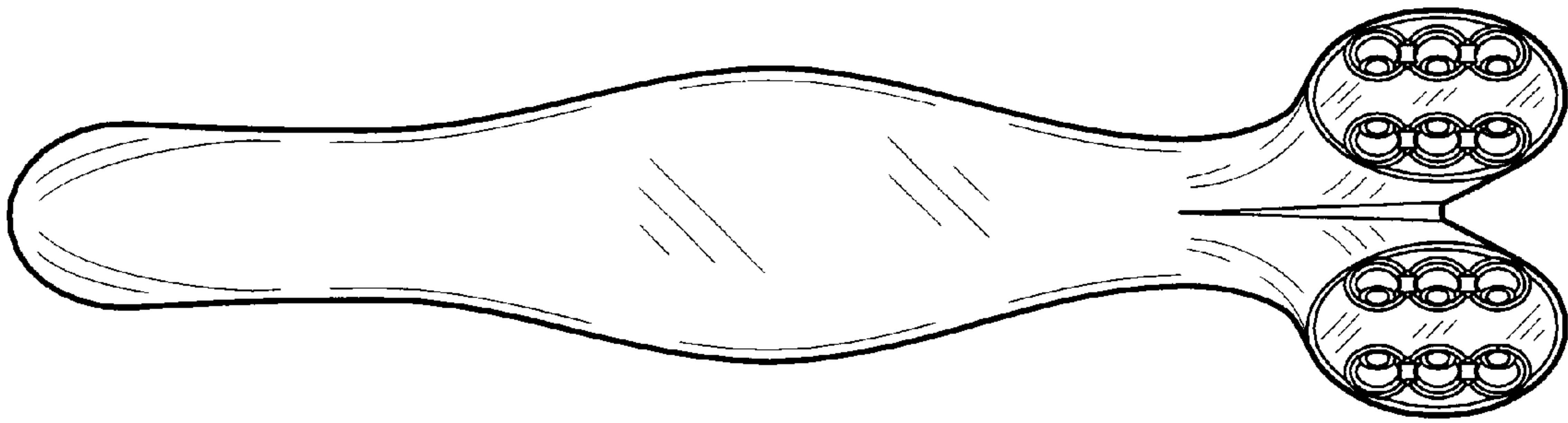

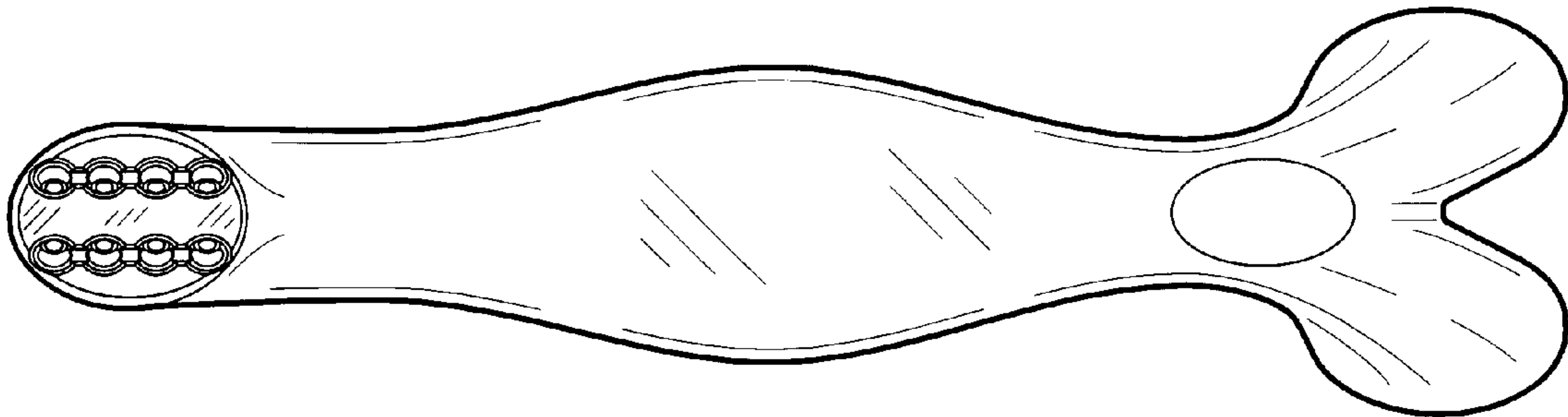

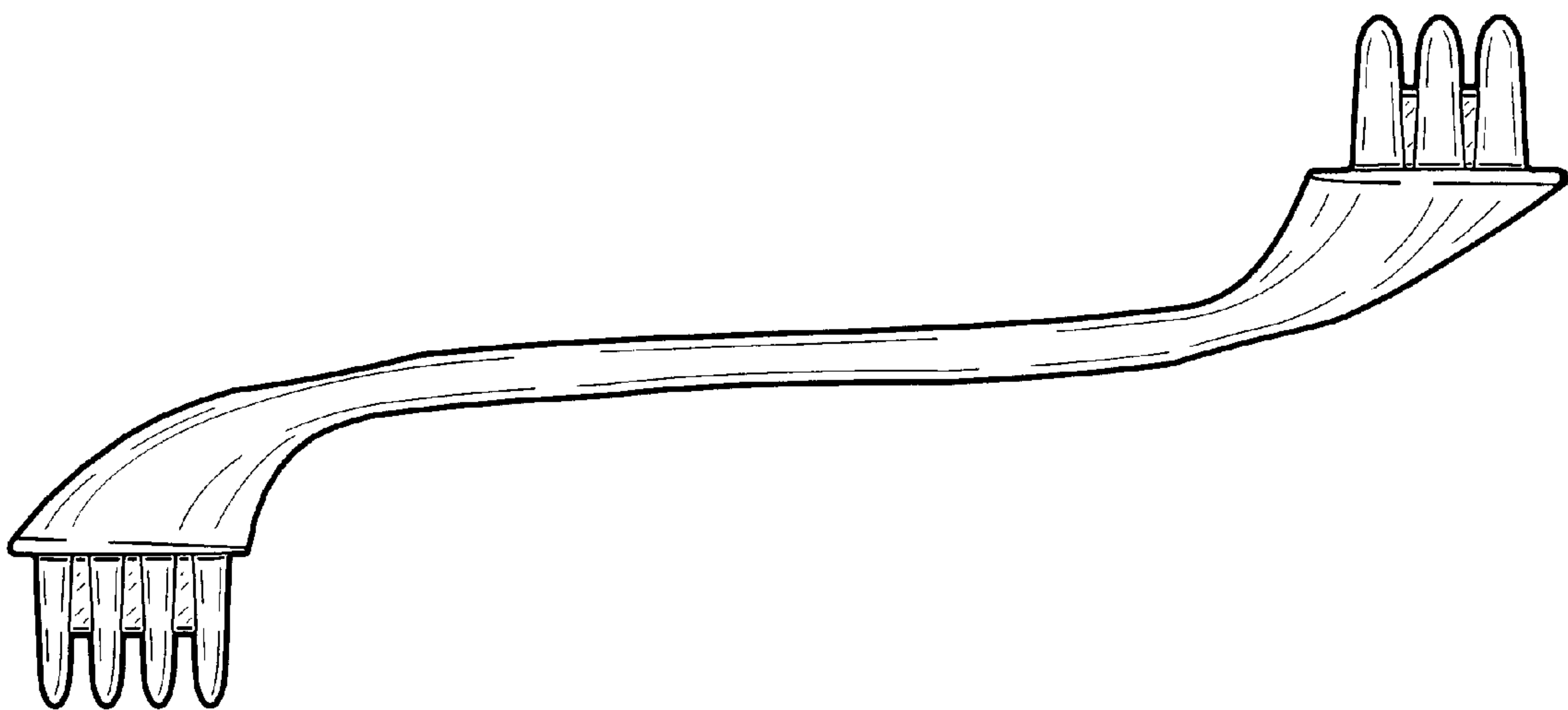

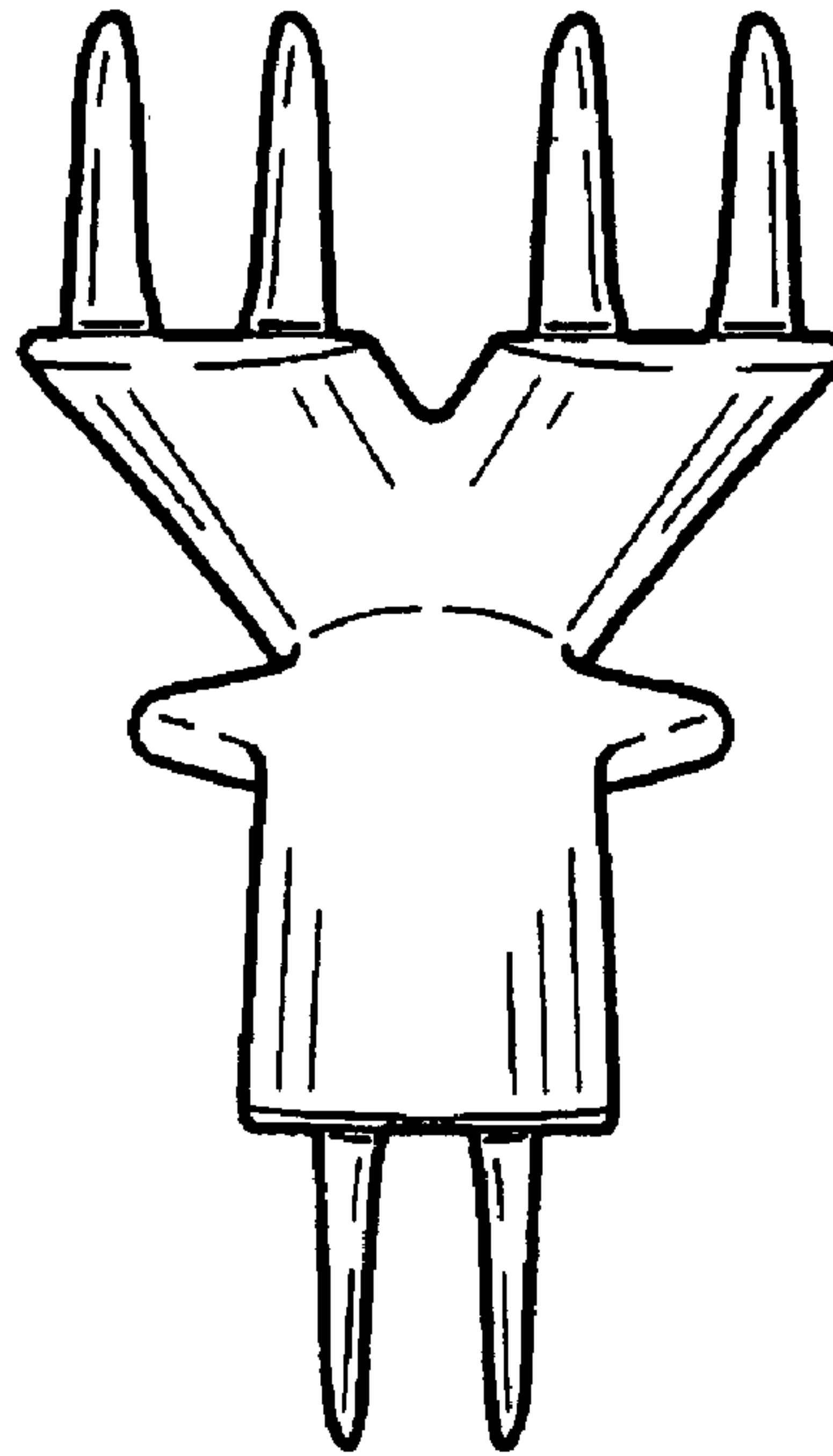

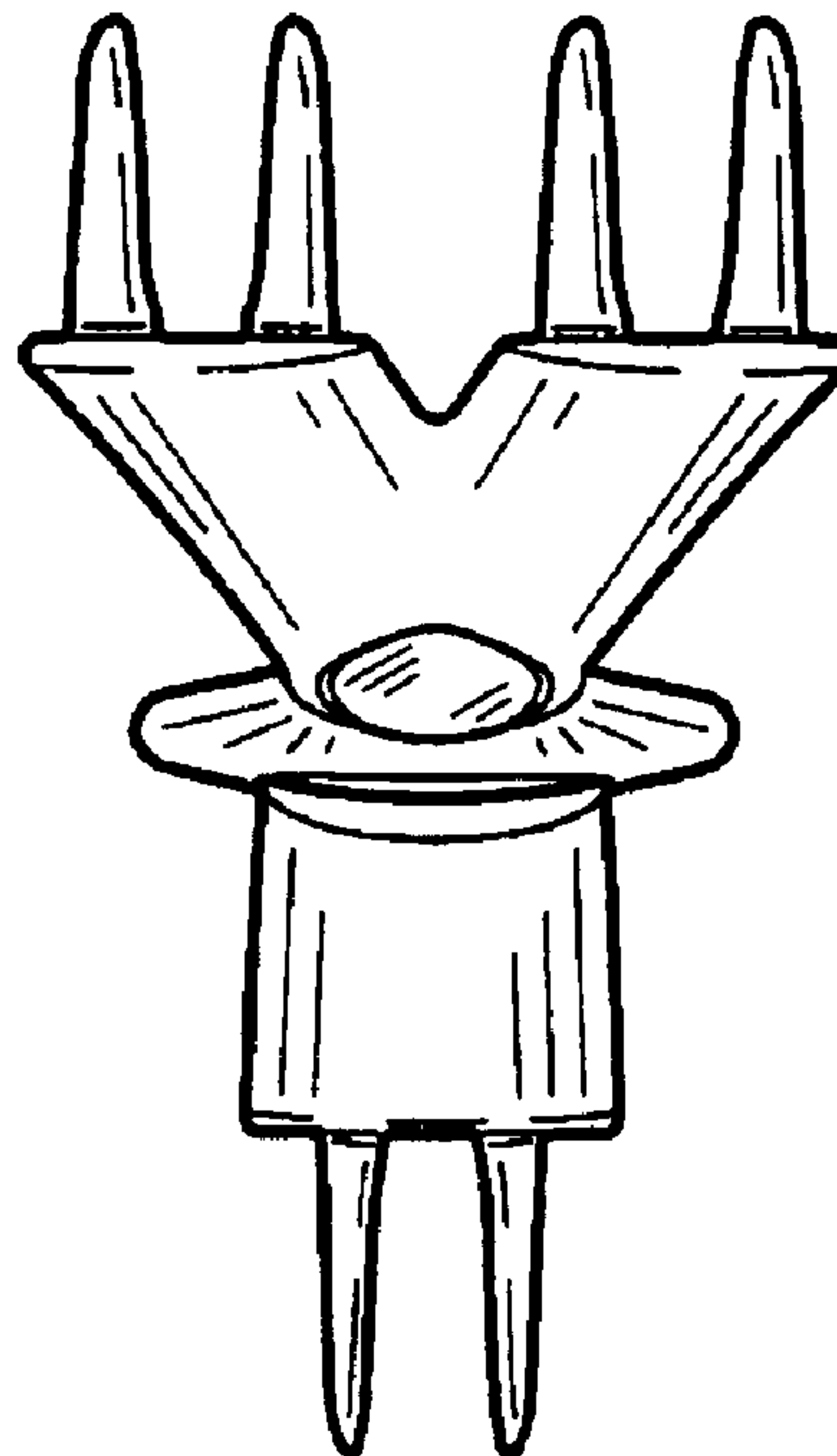
