DESCRIPTION

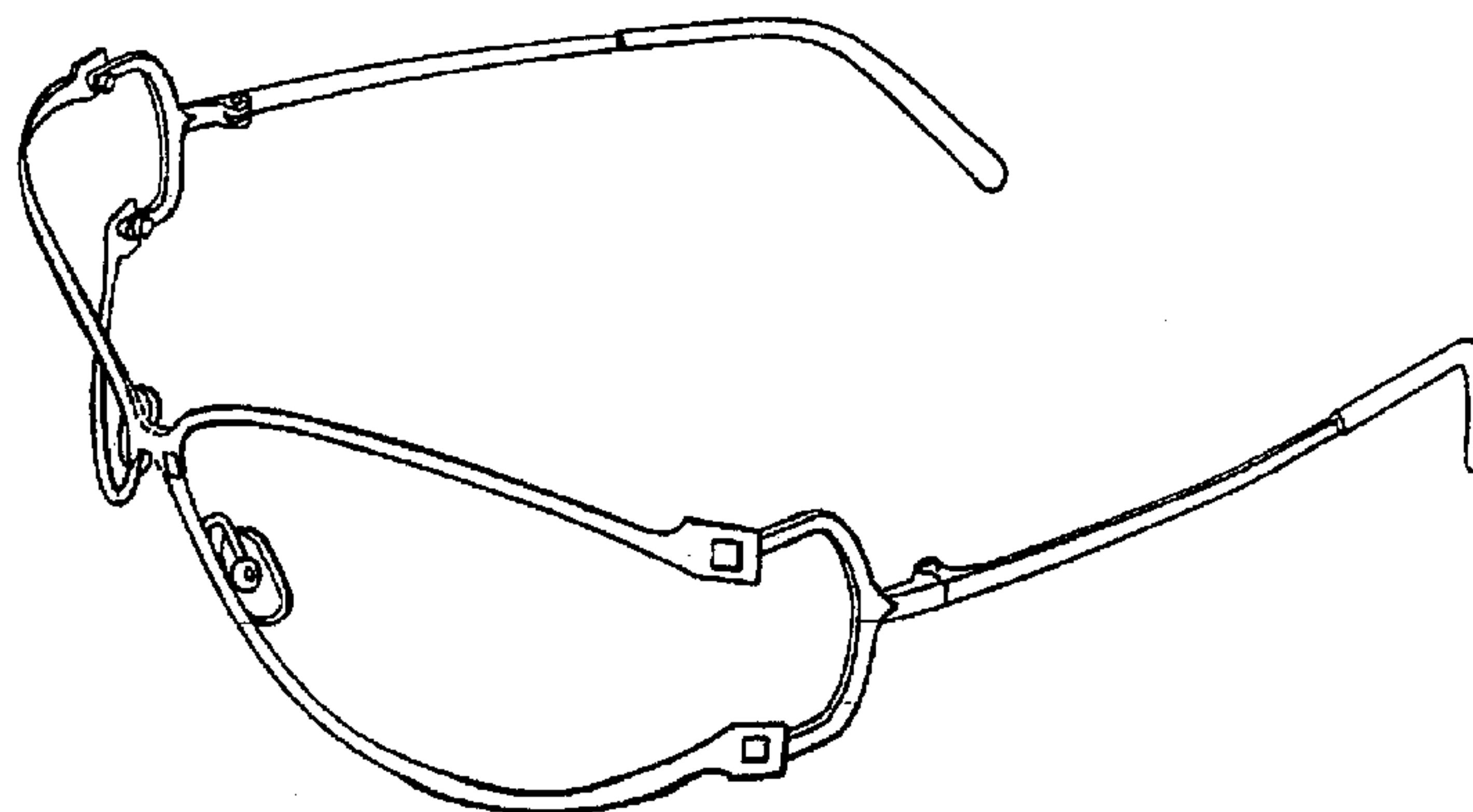

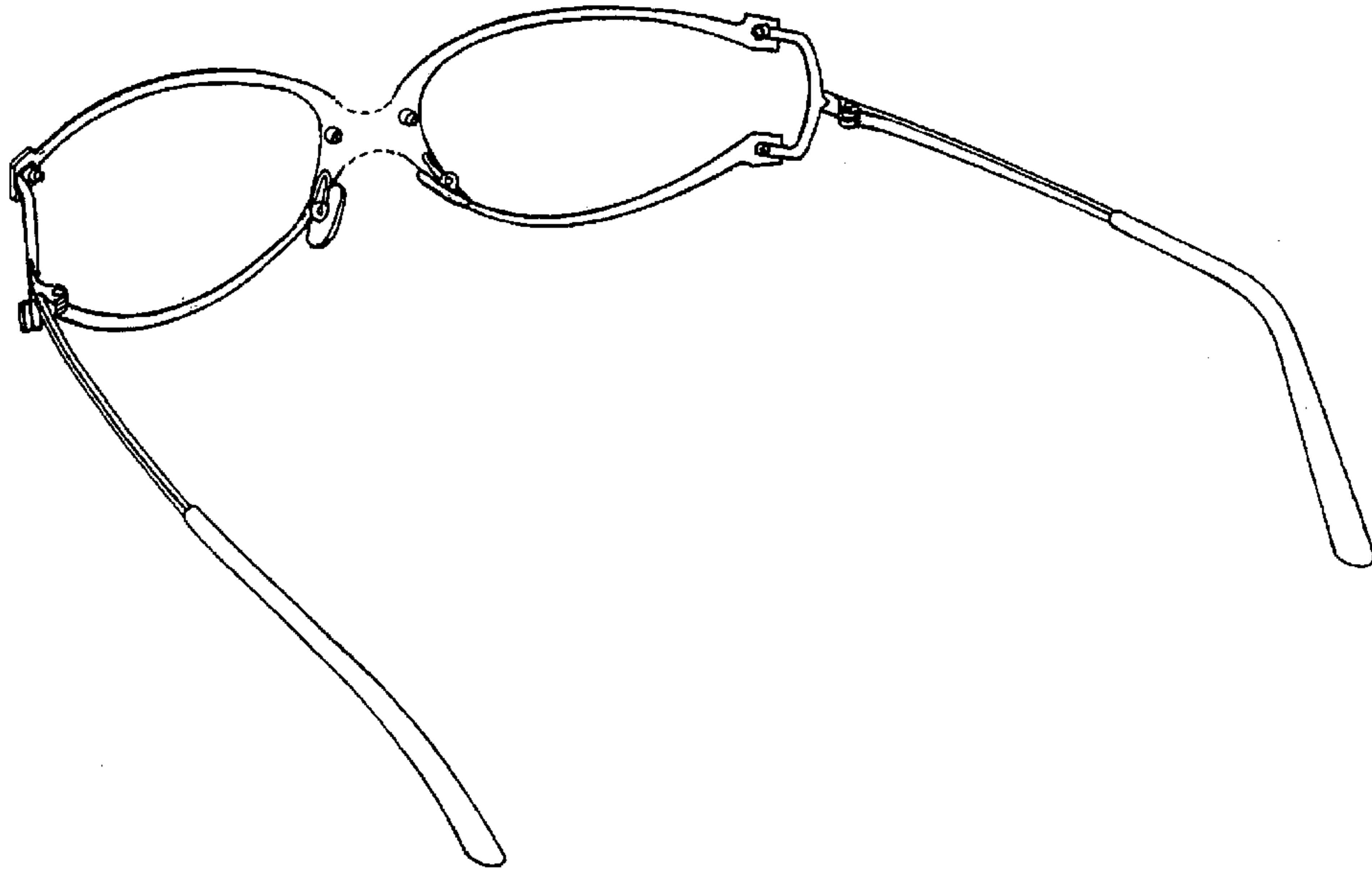

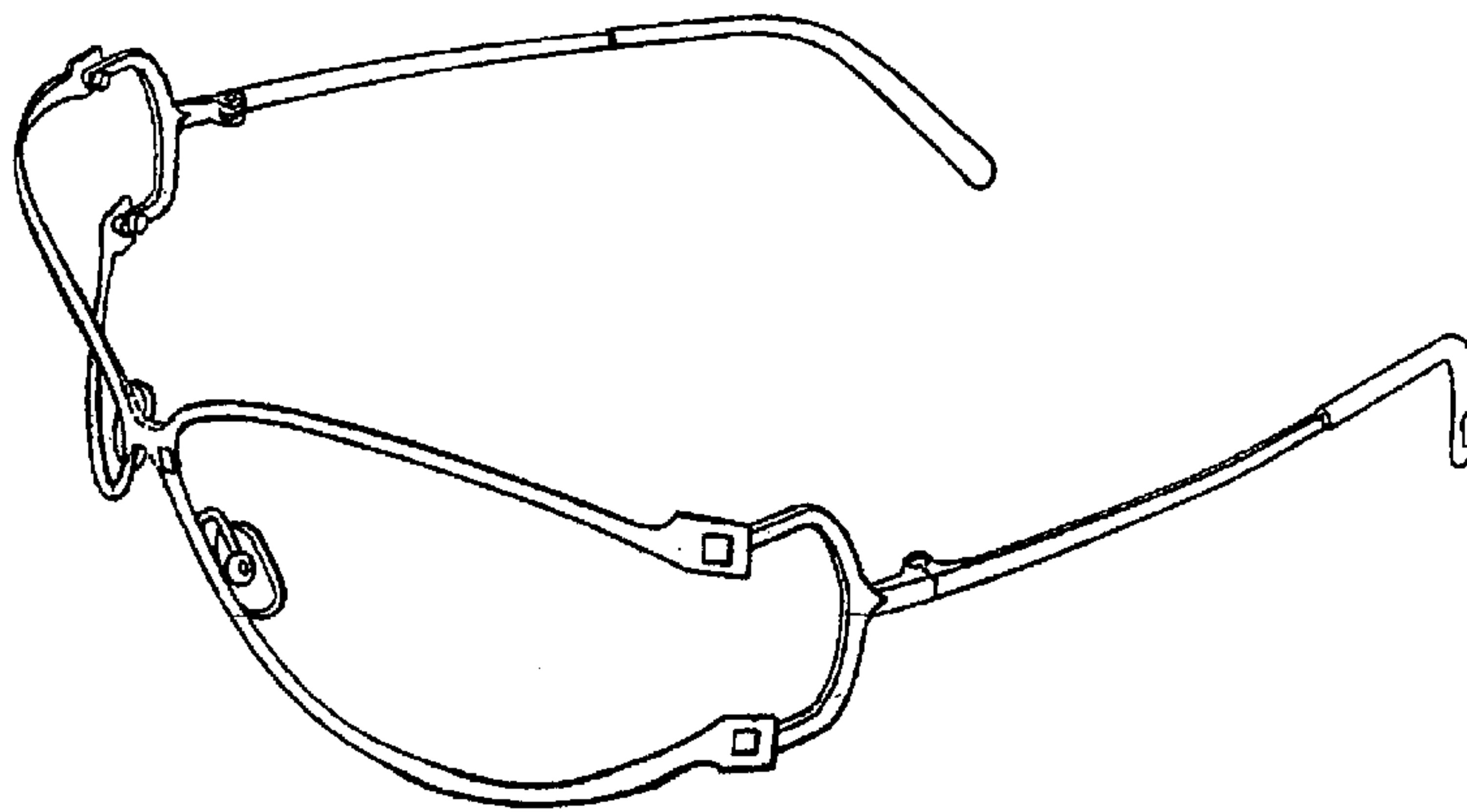

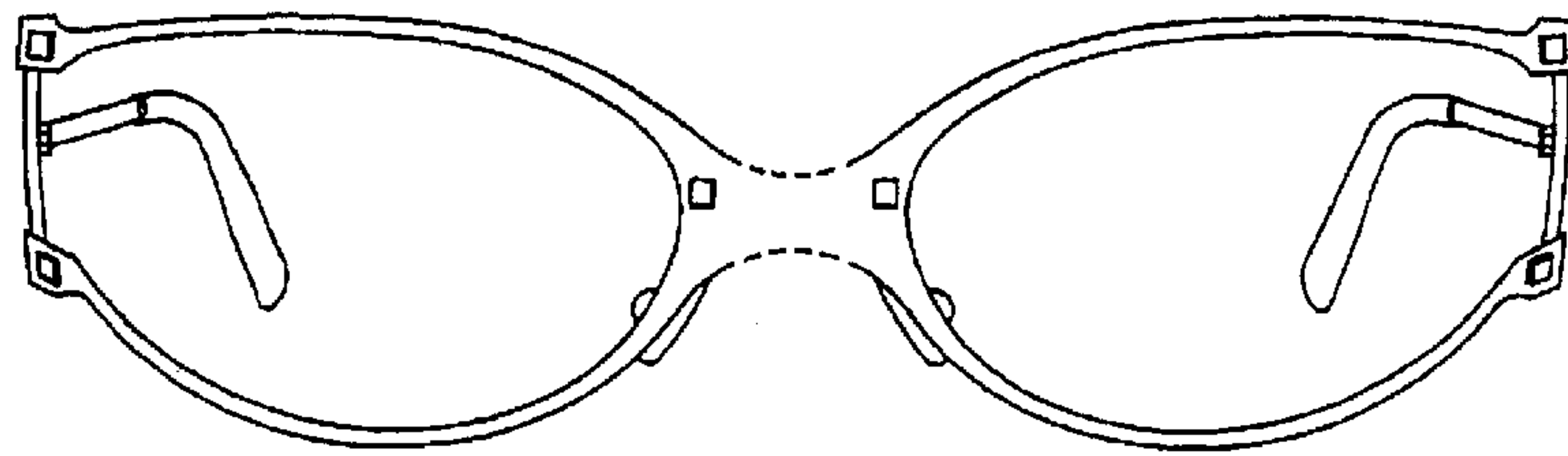

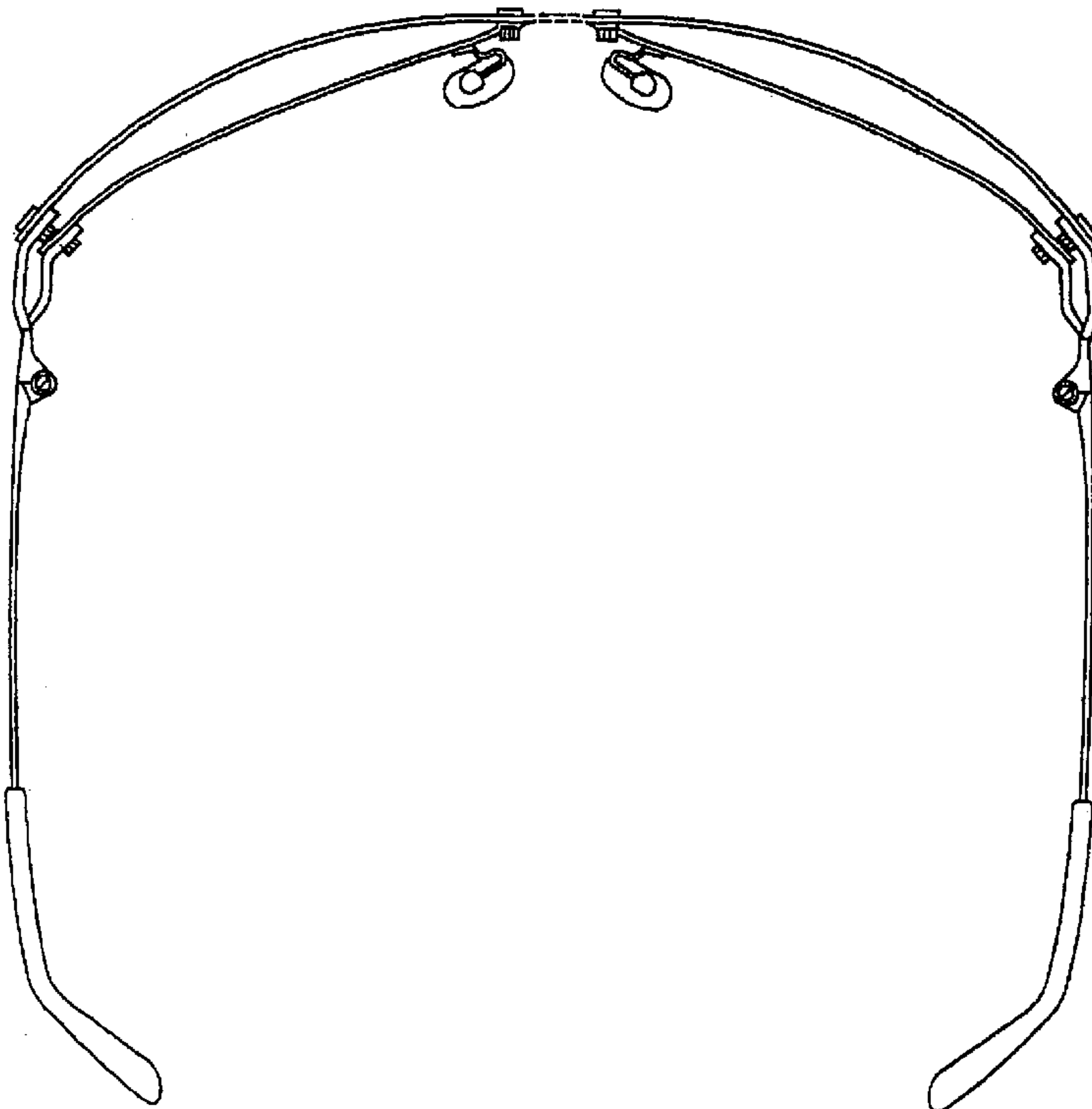

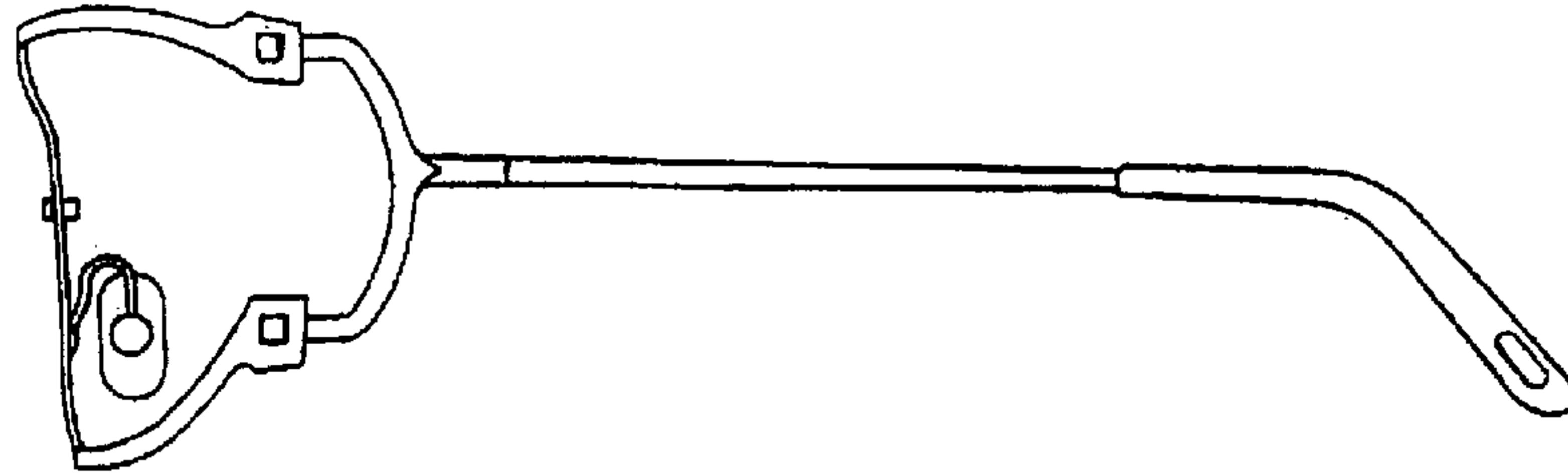

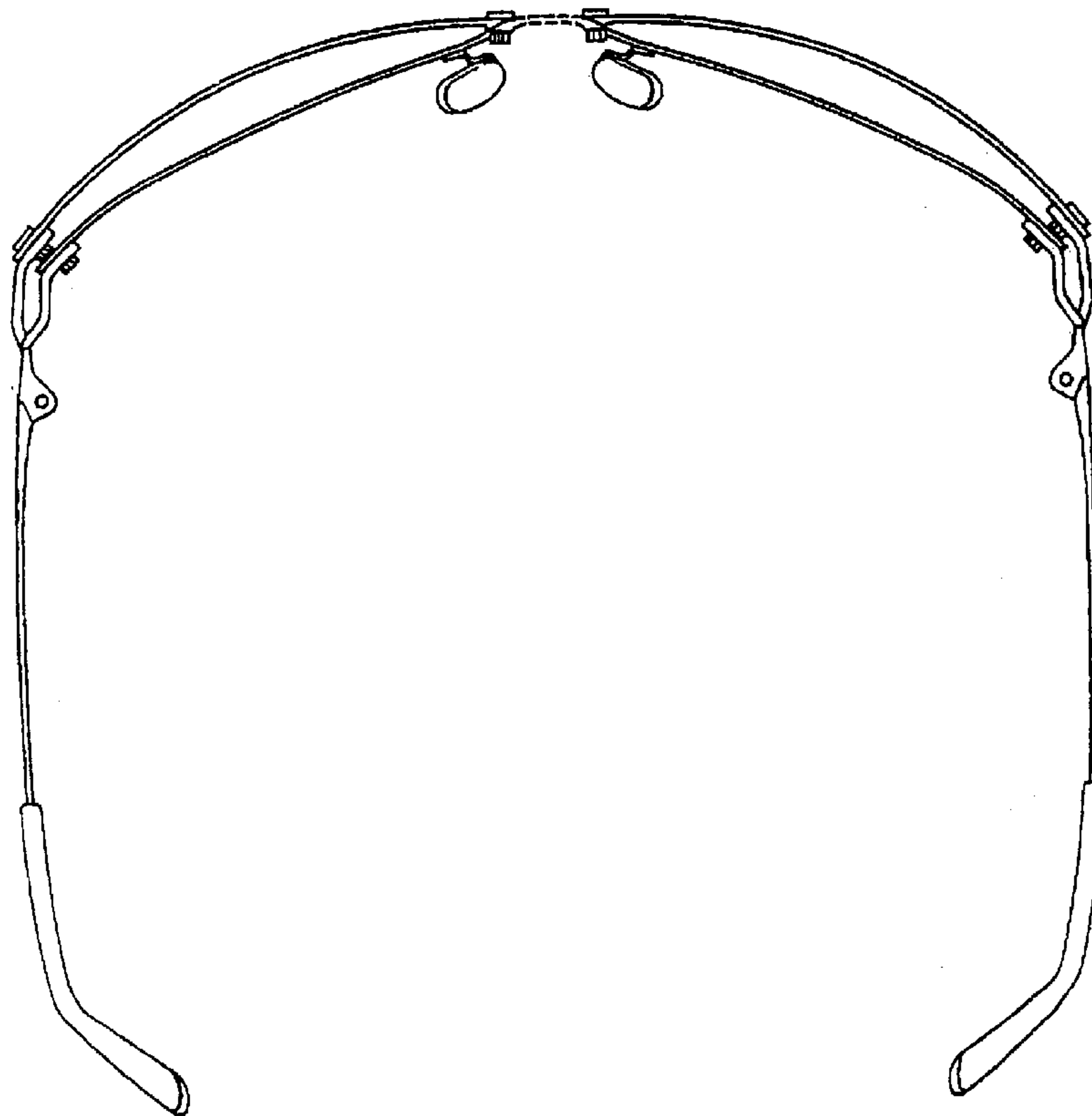
