DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a left side view of a shoe scraper design showing my new design.

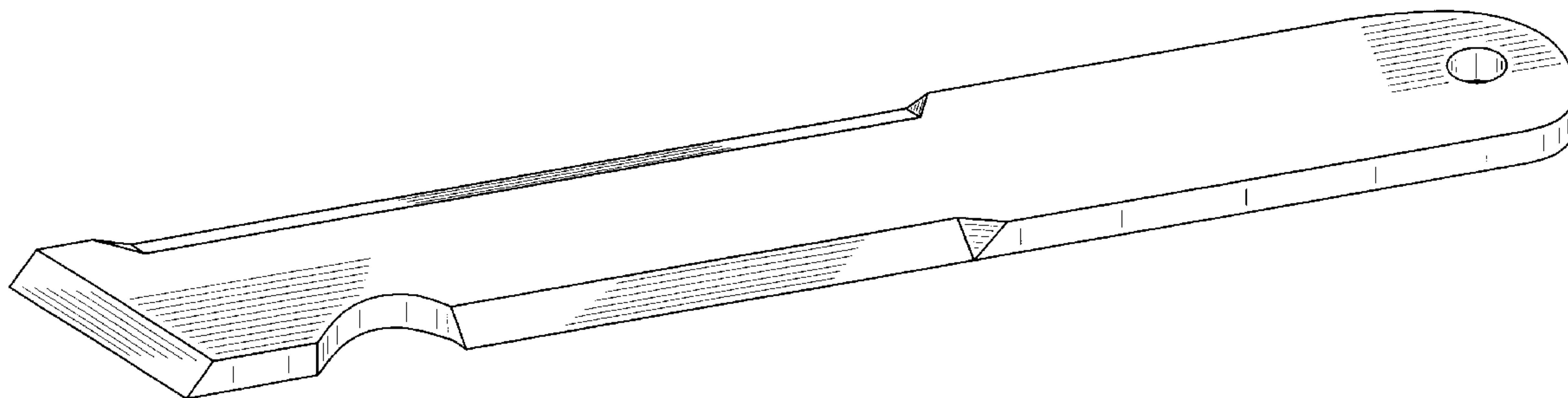
FIG. 5 is a right side view of a shoe scraper design showing my new design.

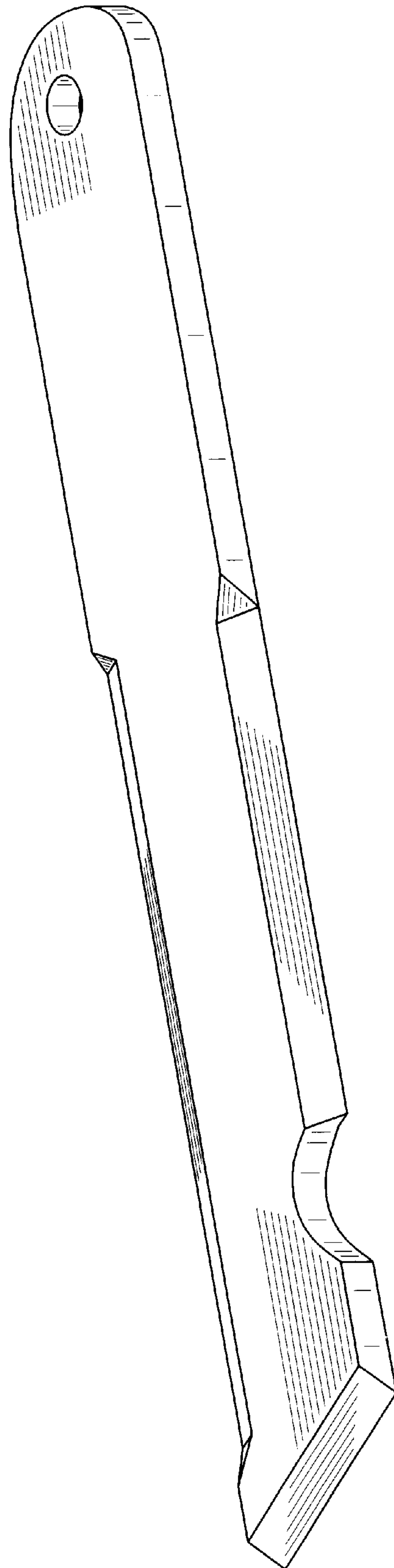

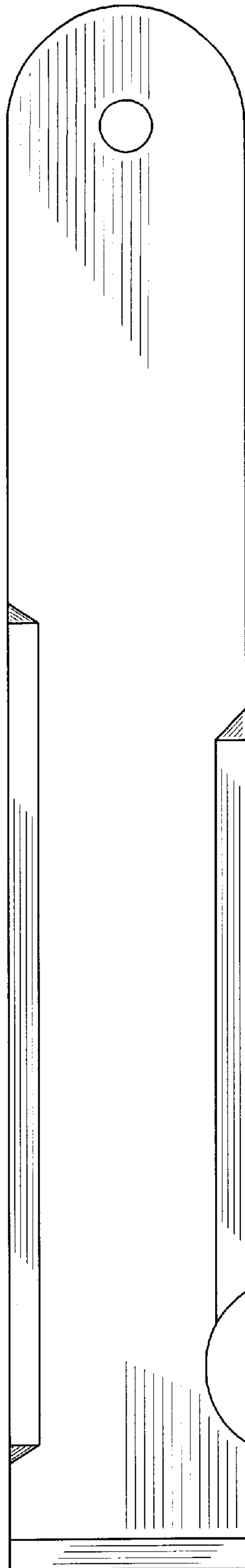

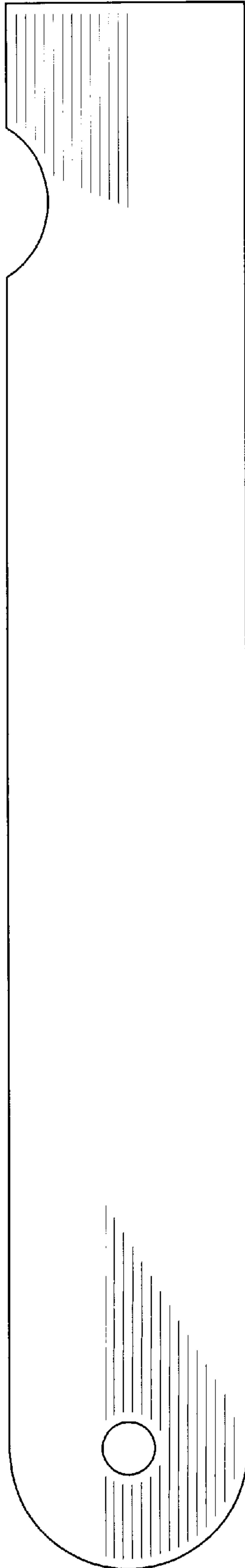

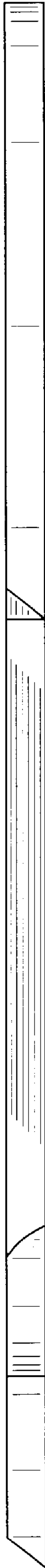

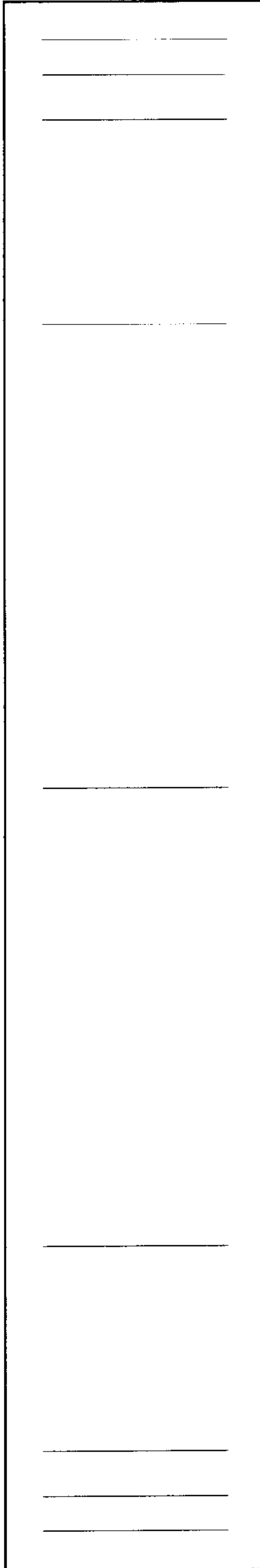

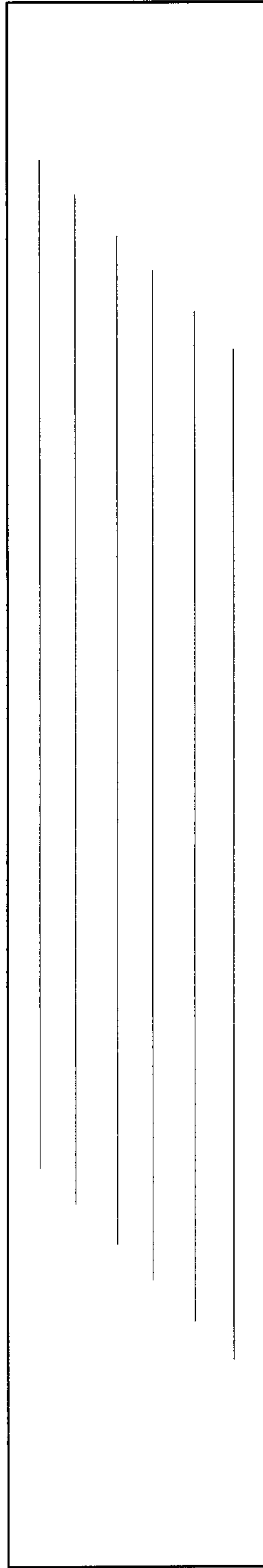
