FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.

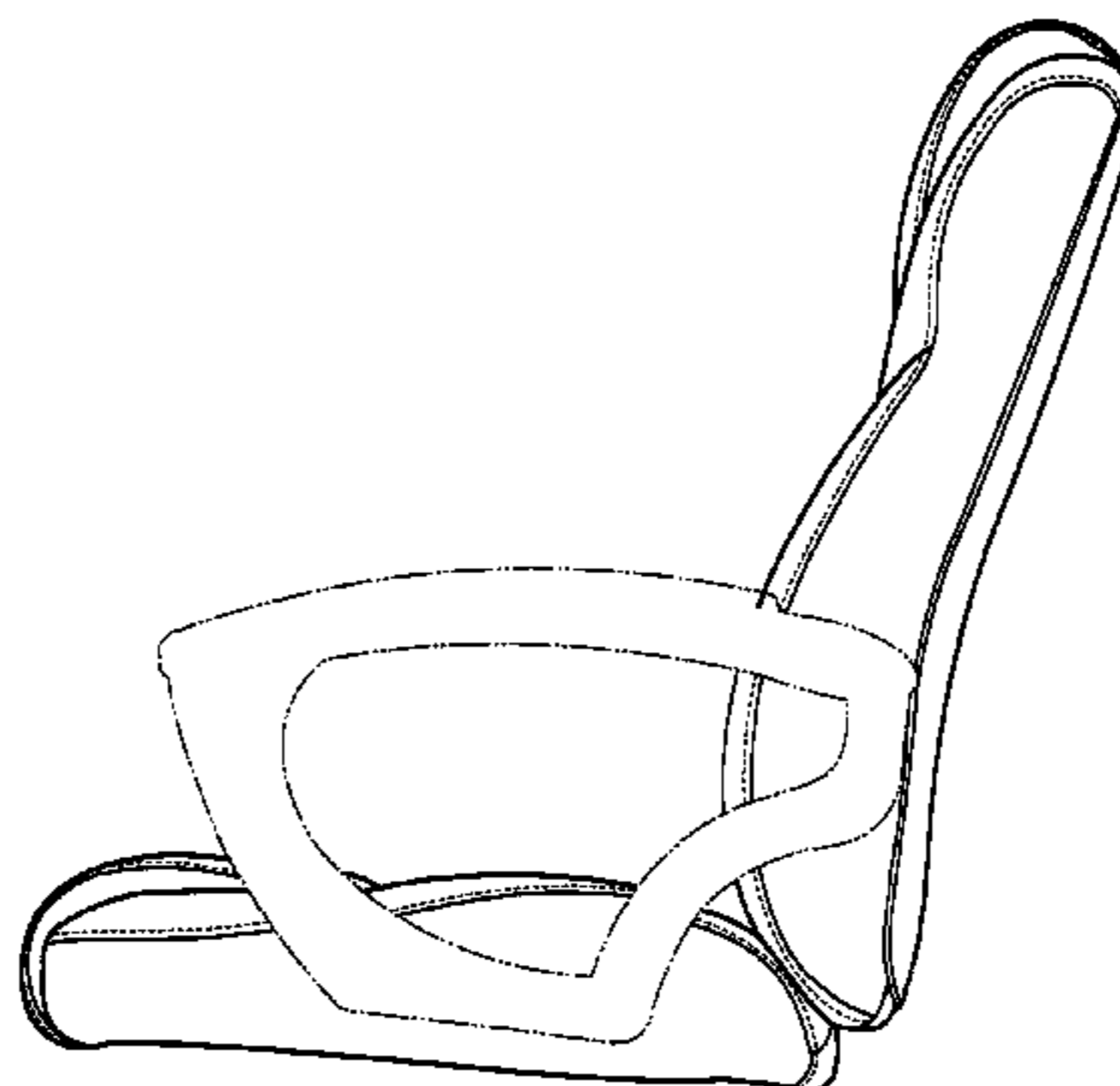
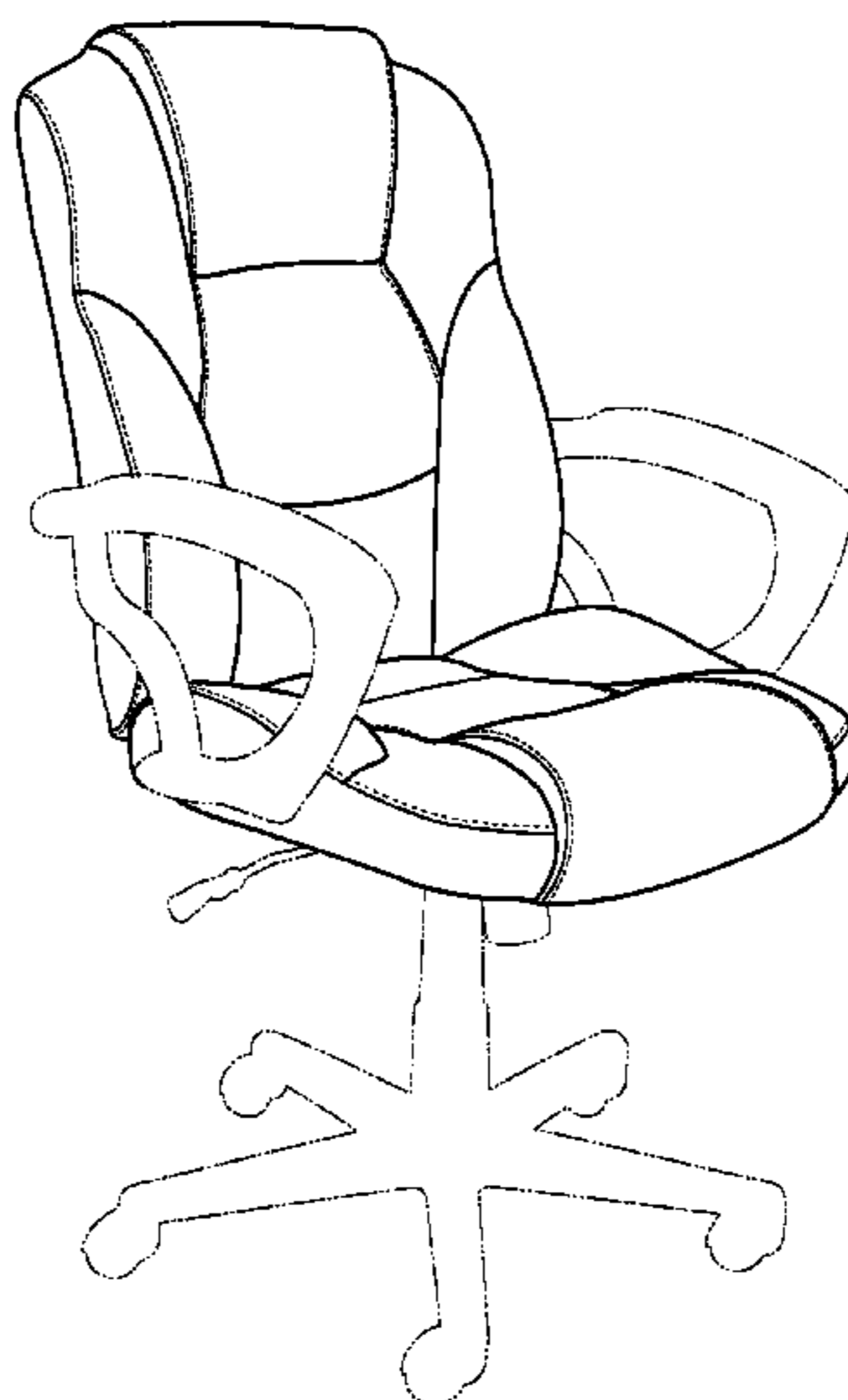
The short, broken lines on the chair in FIGS. 1–6 are understood to represent stitching.

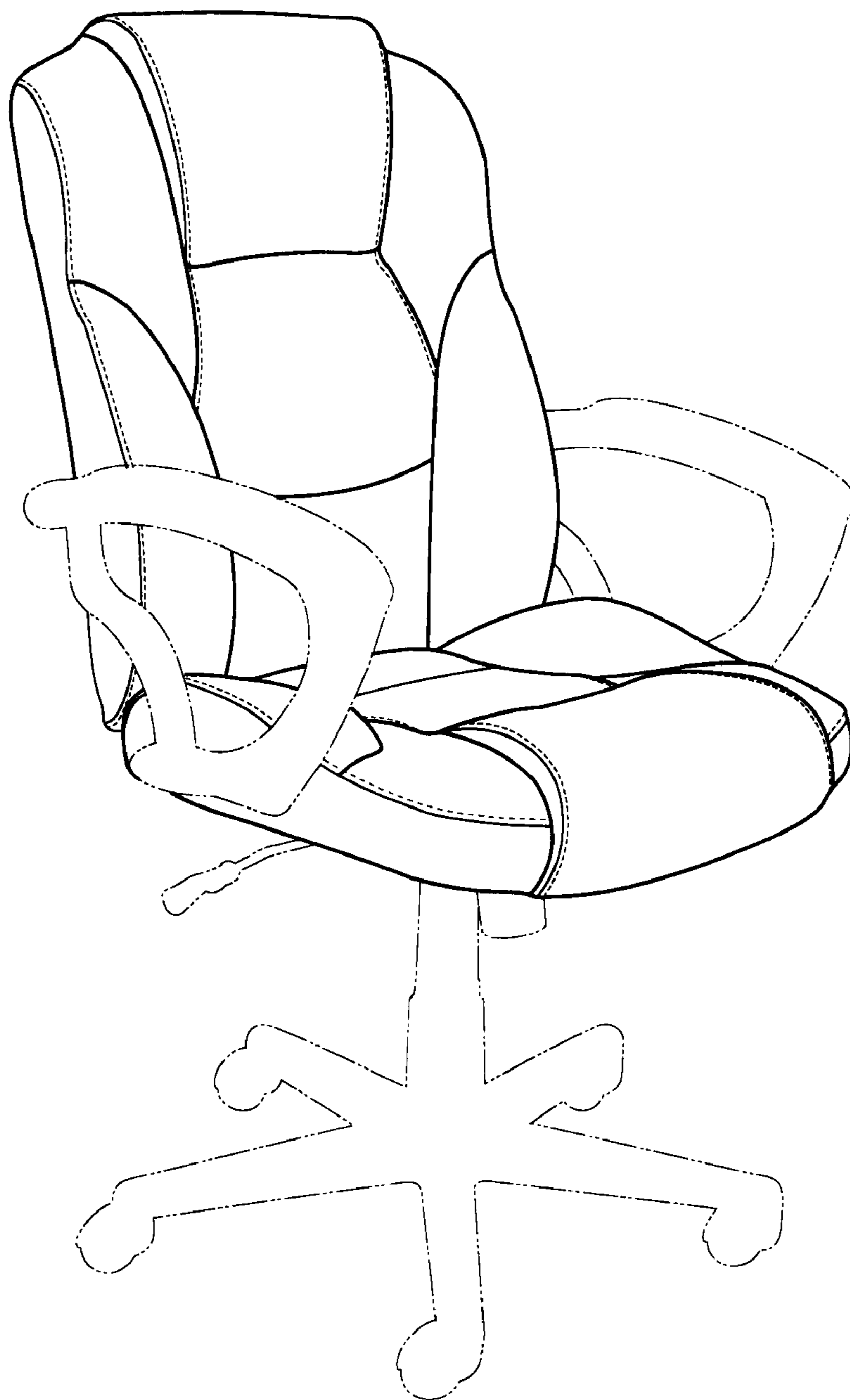

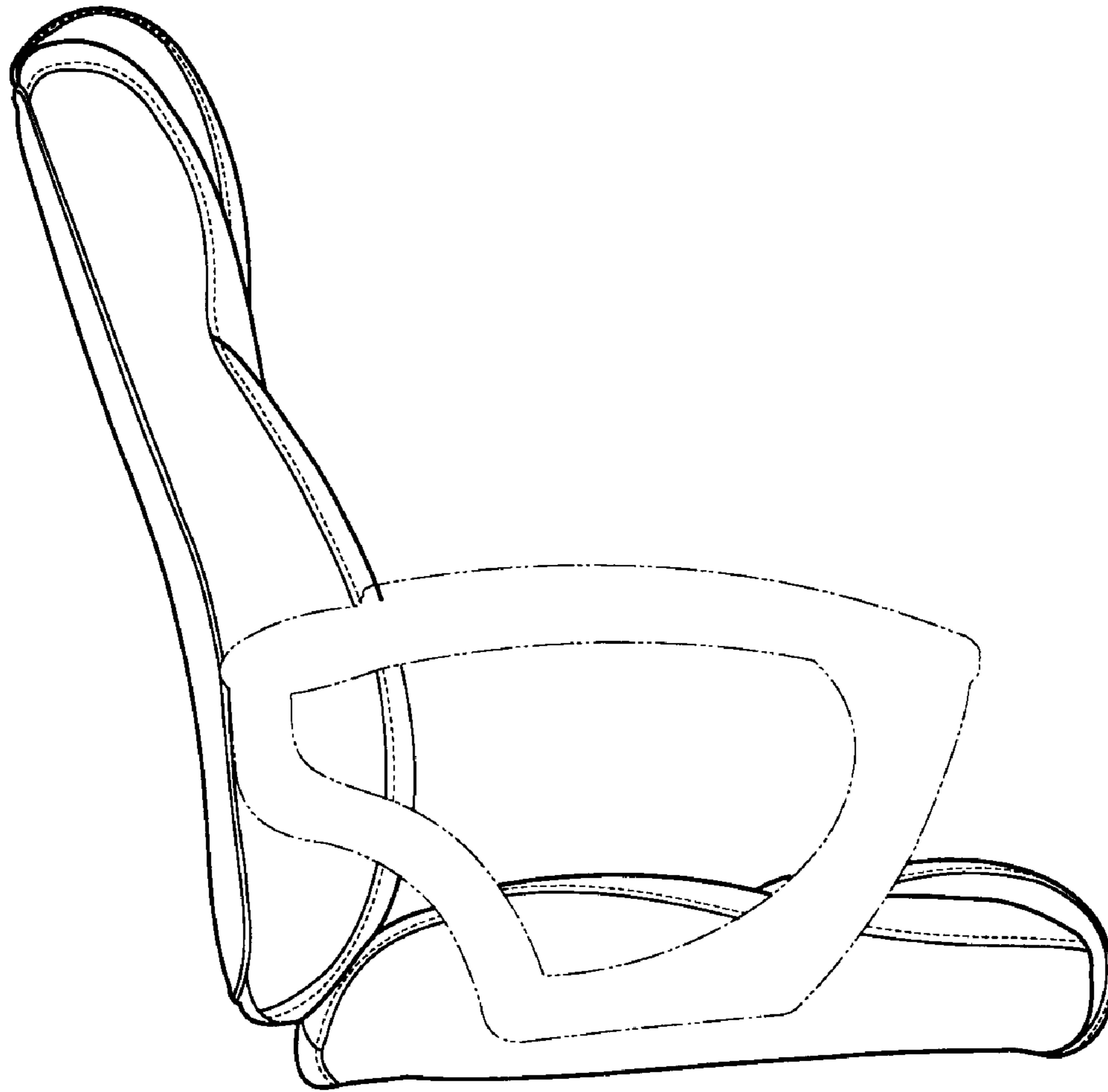

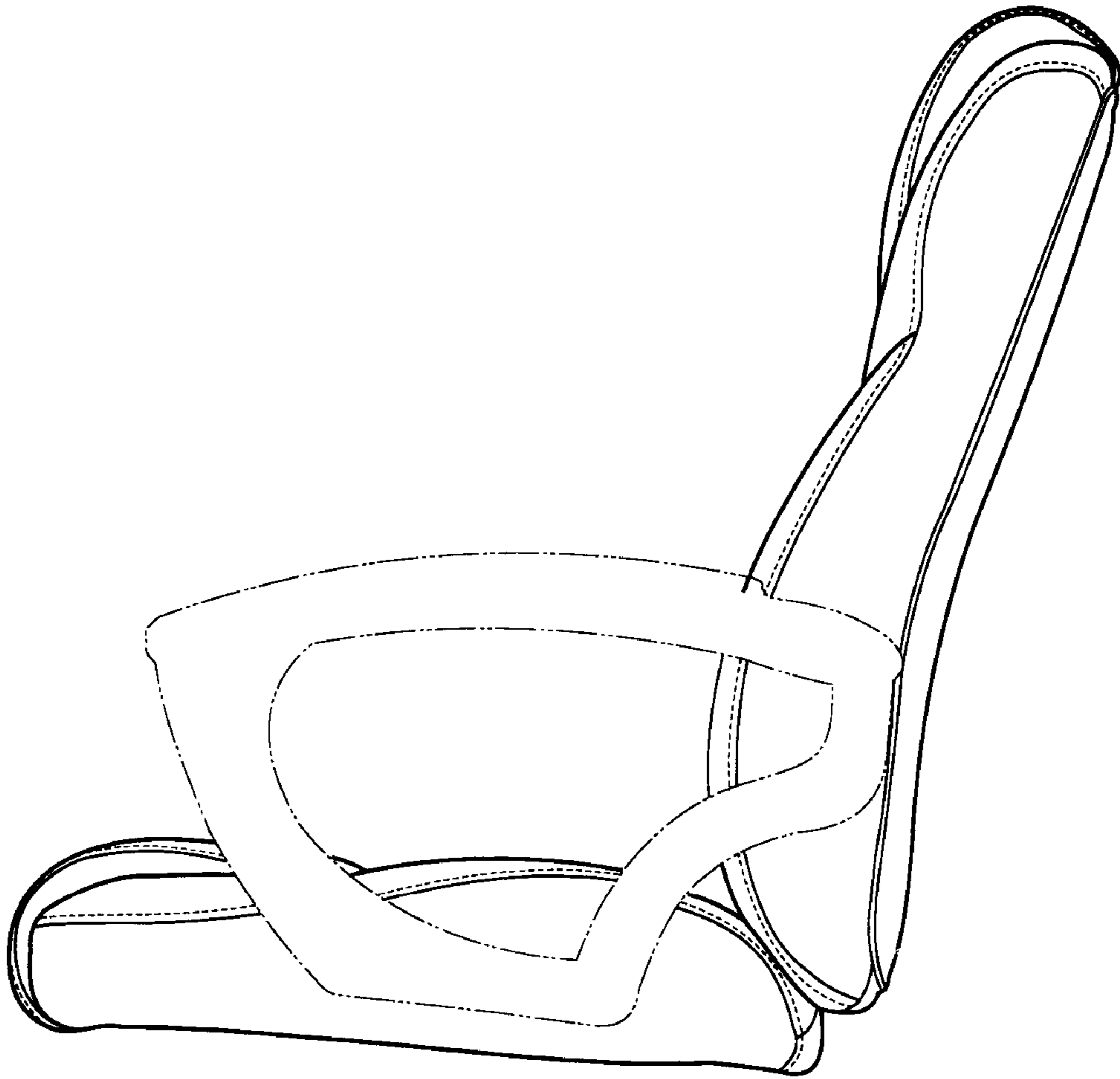

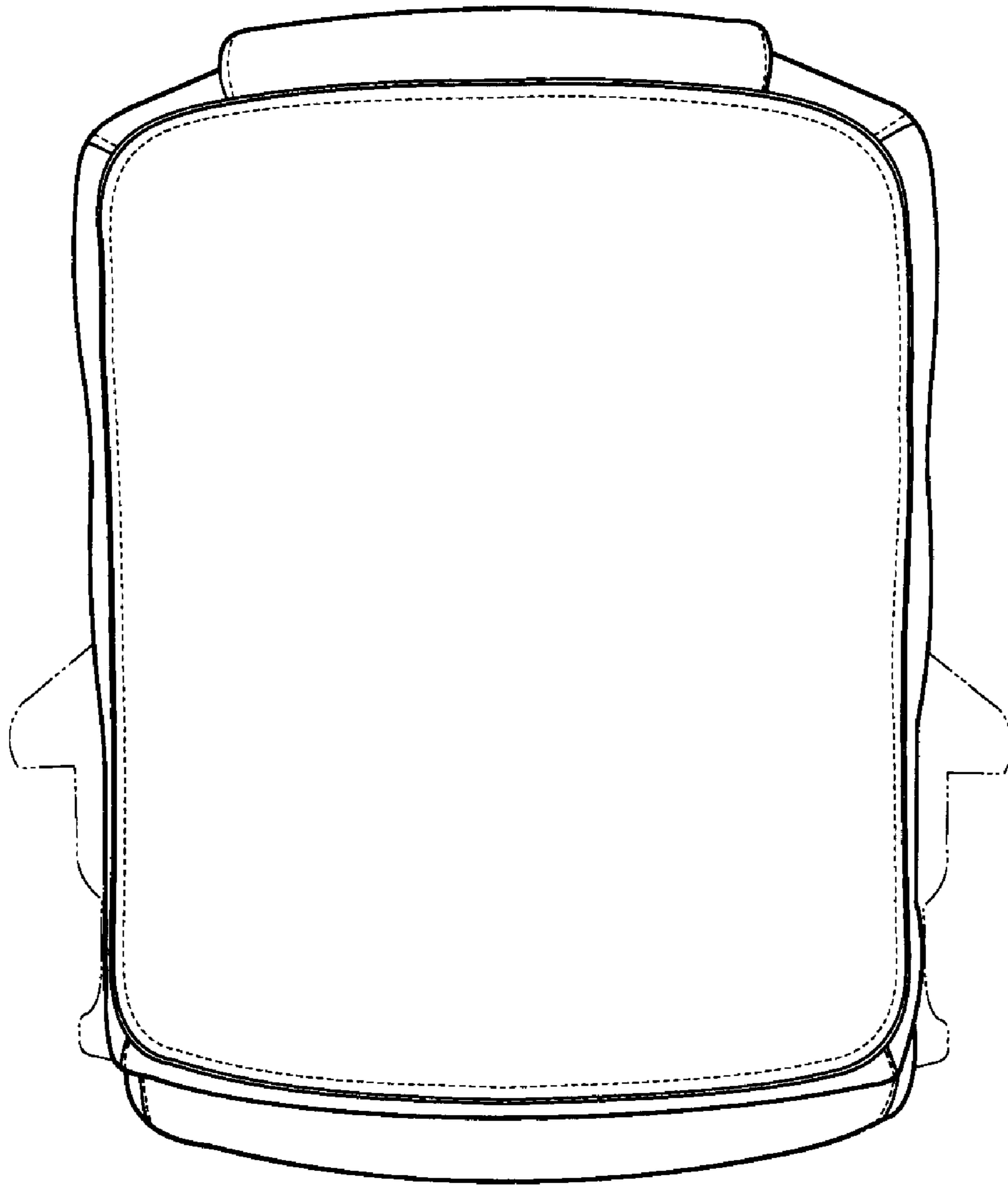

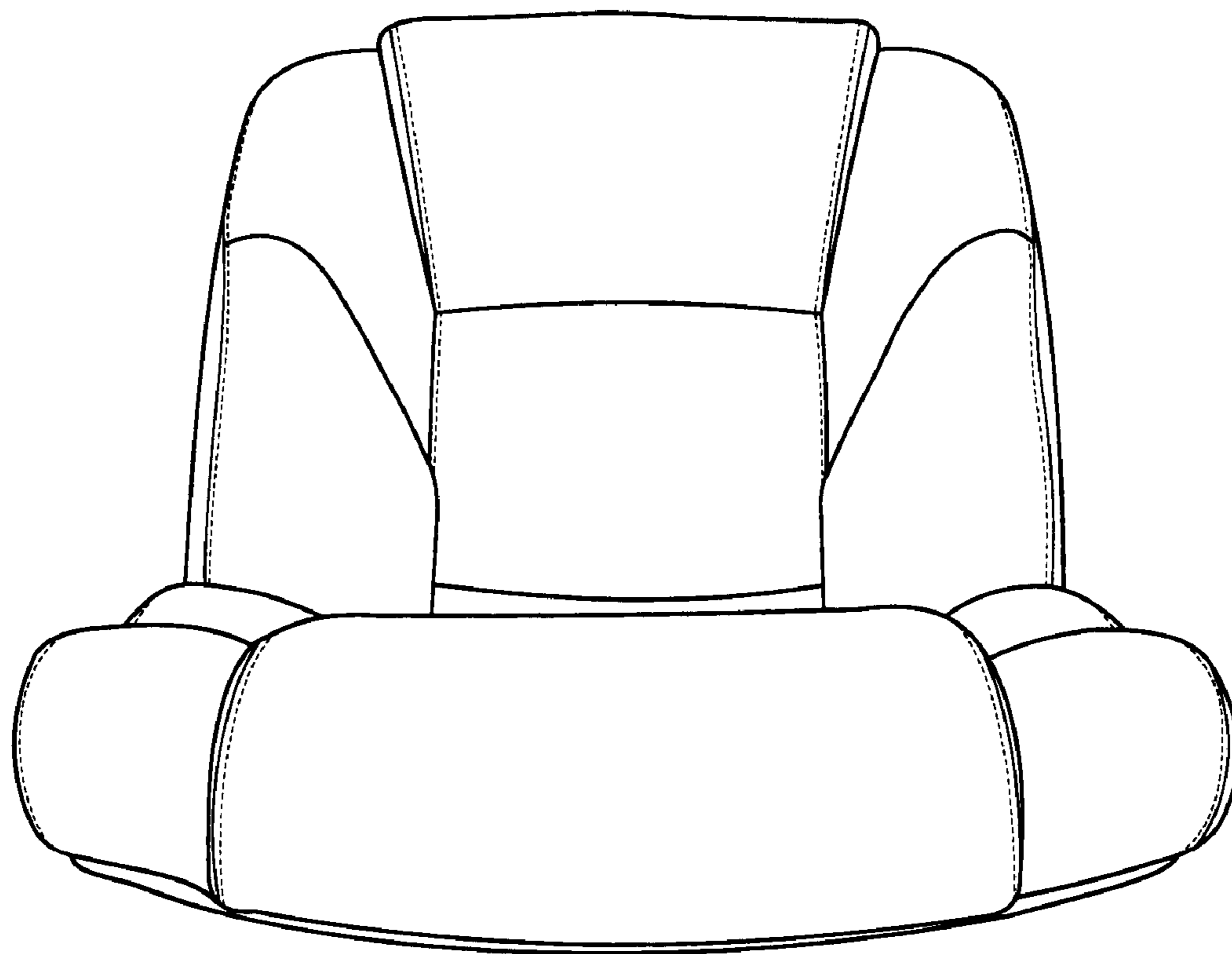

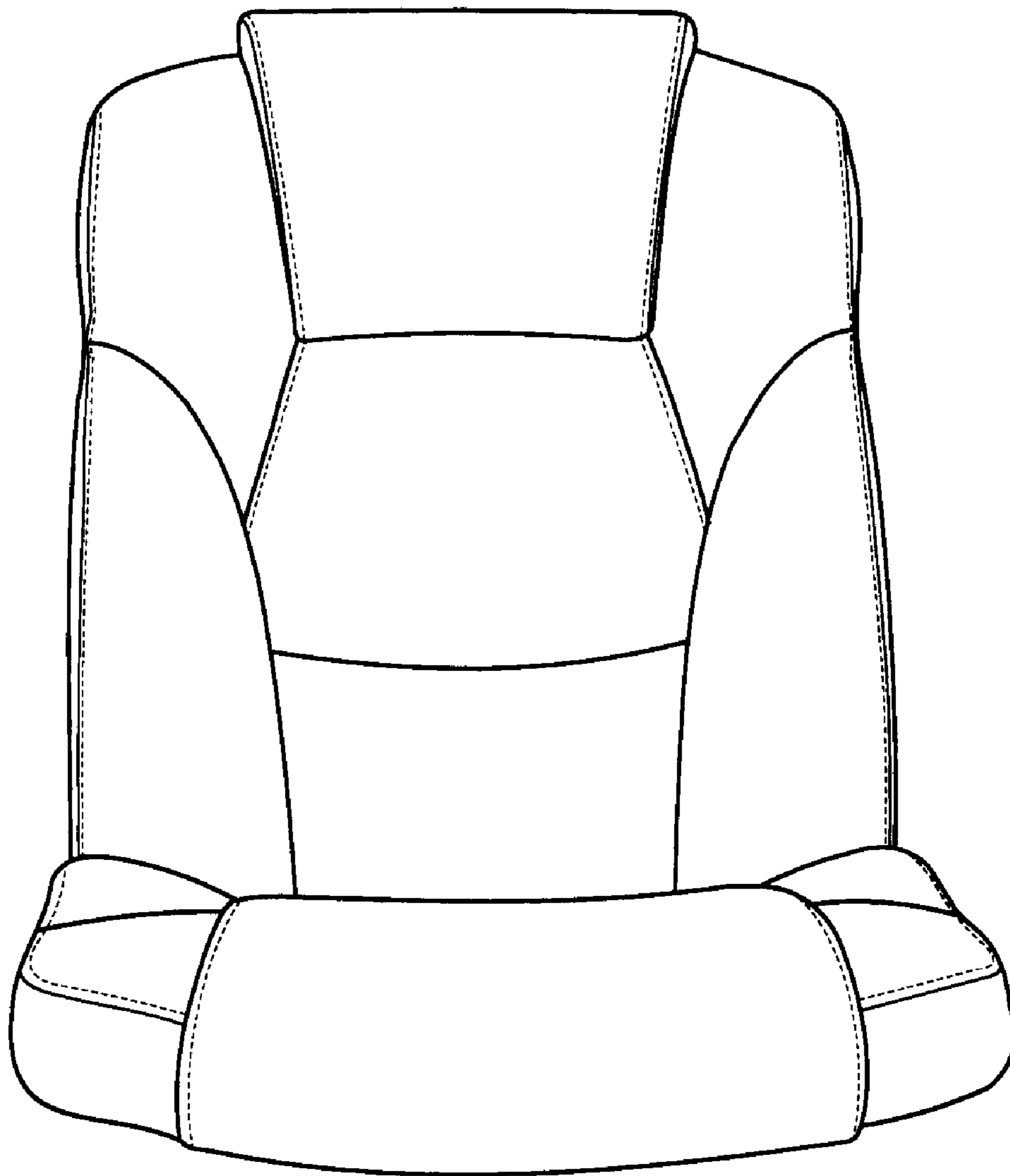
