FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side elevation view being identical thereto.

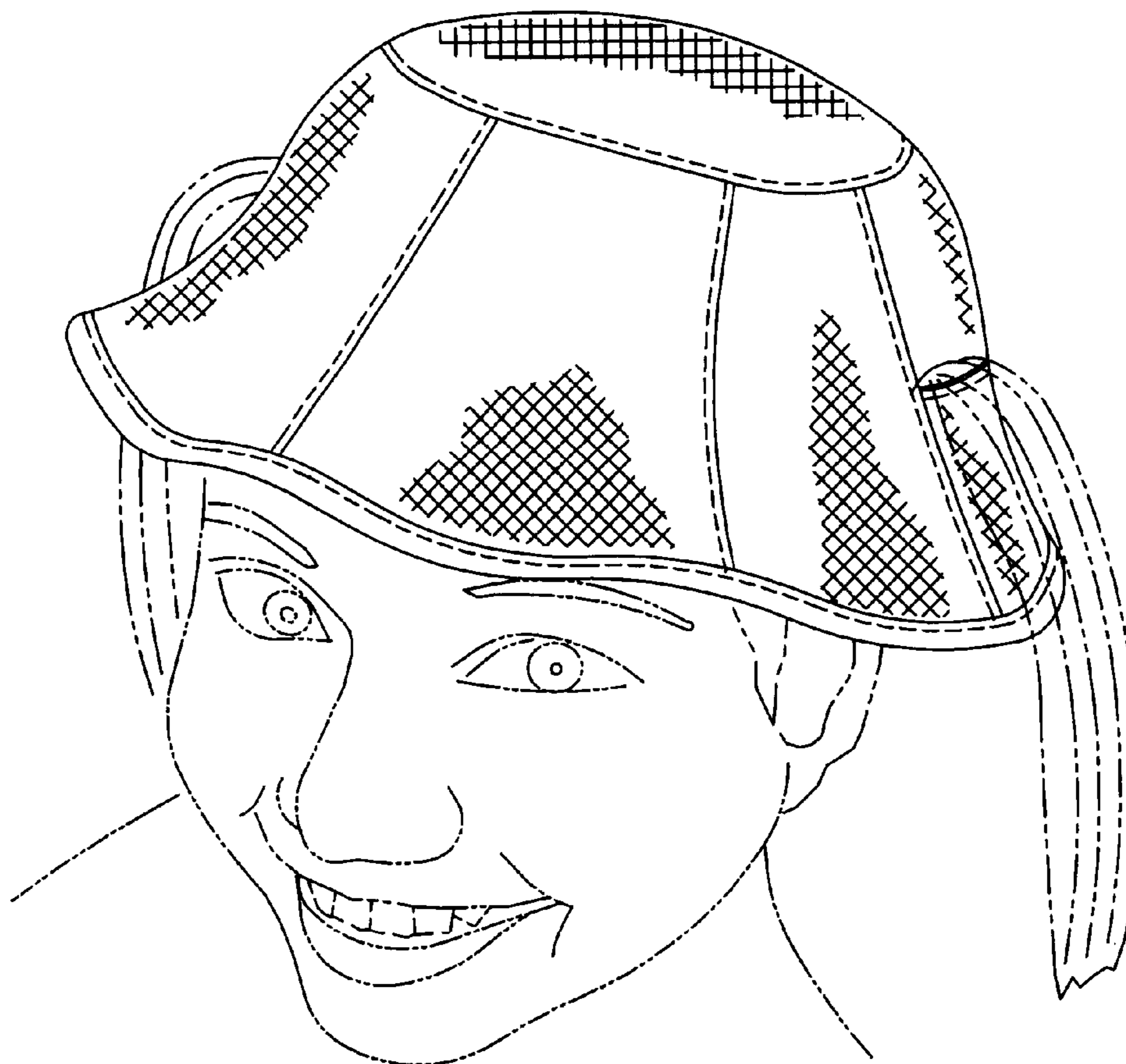

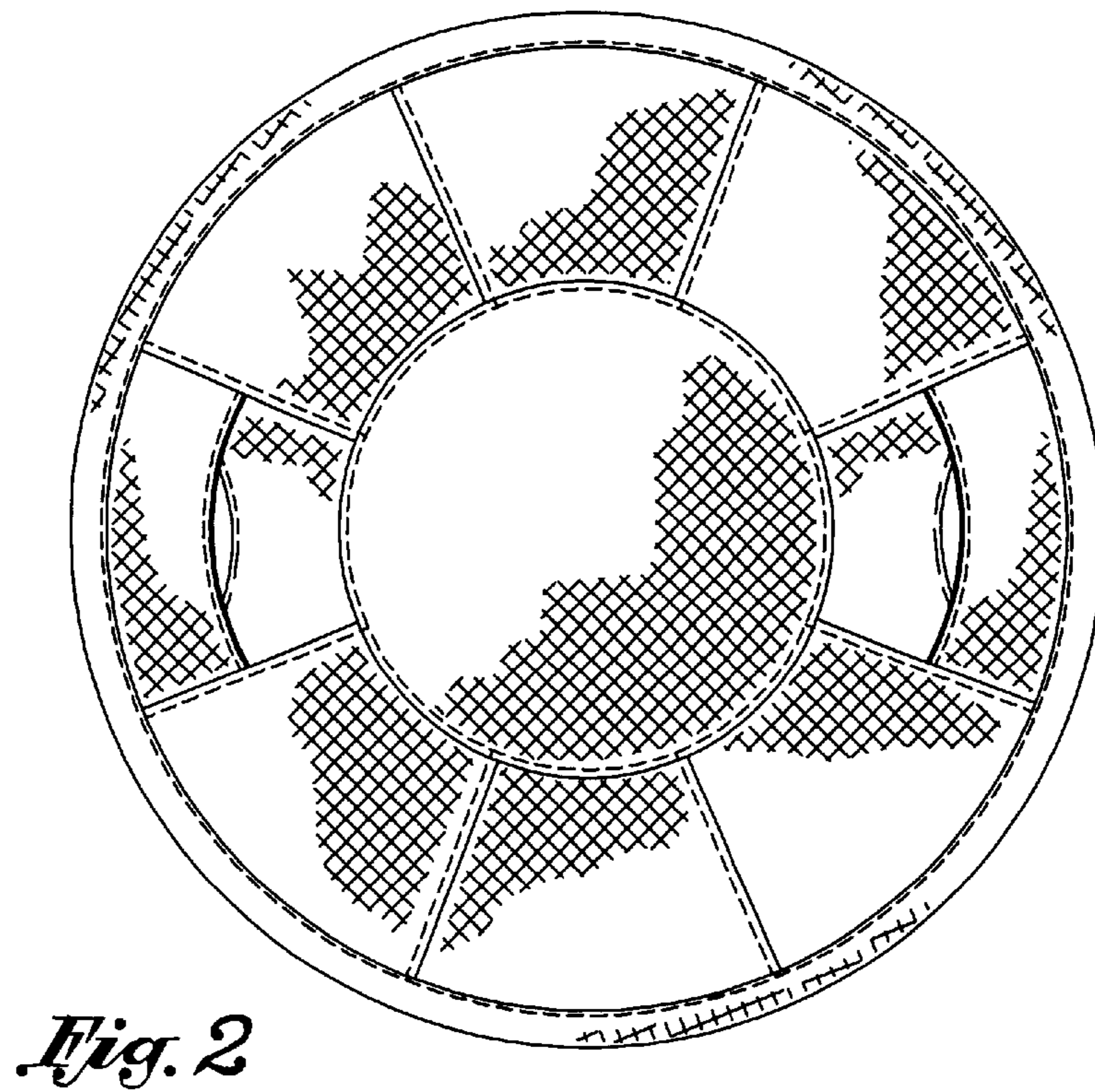
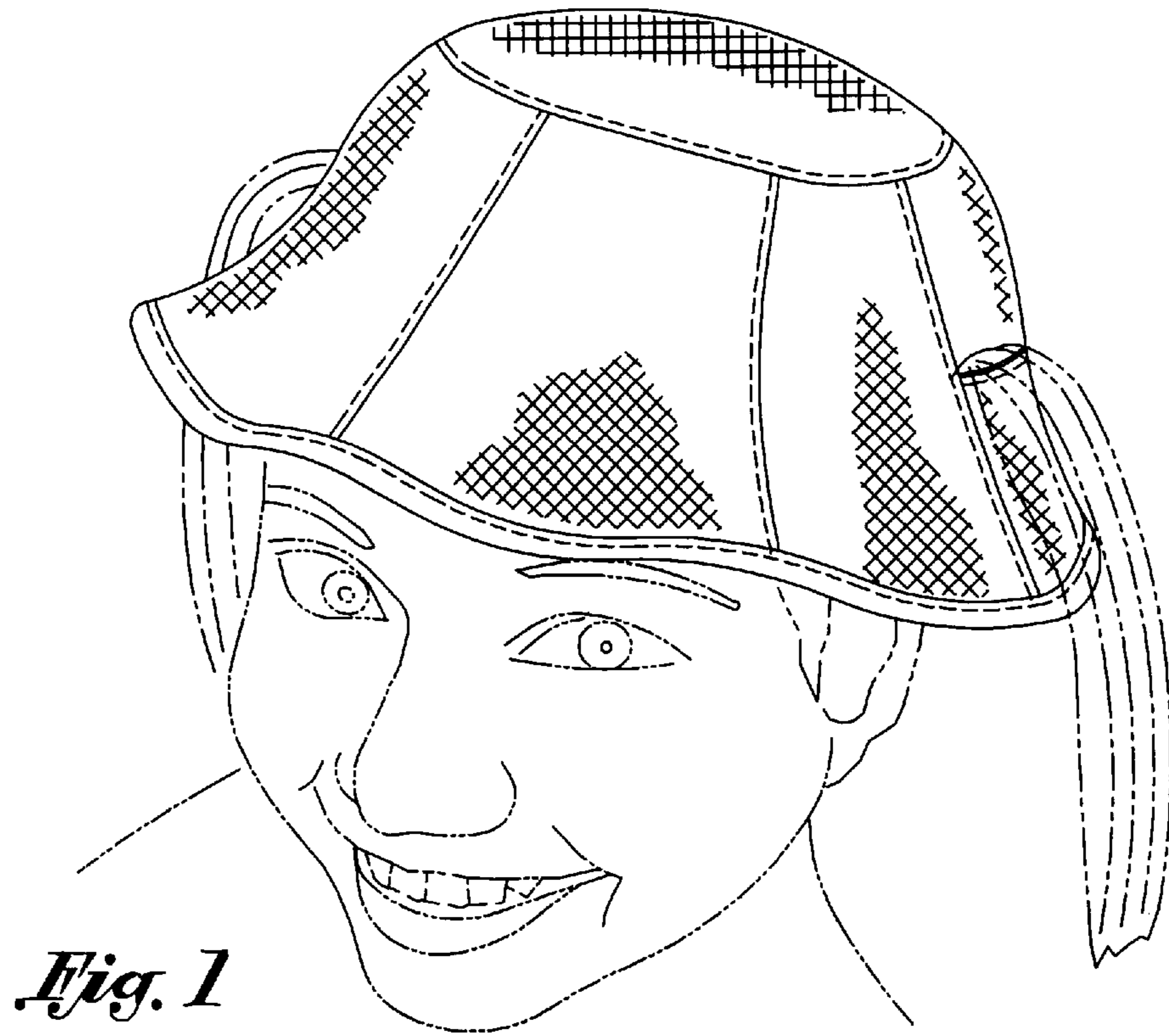

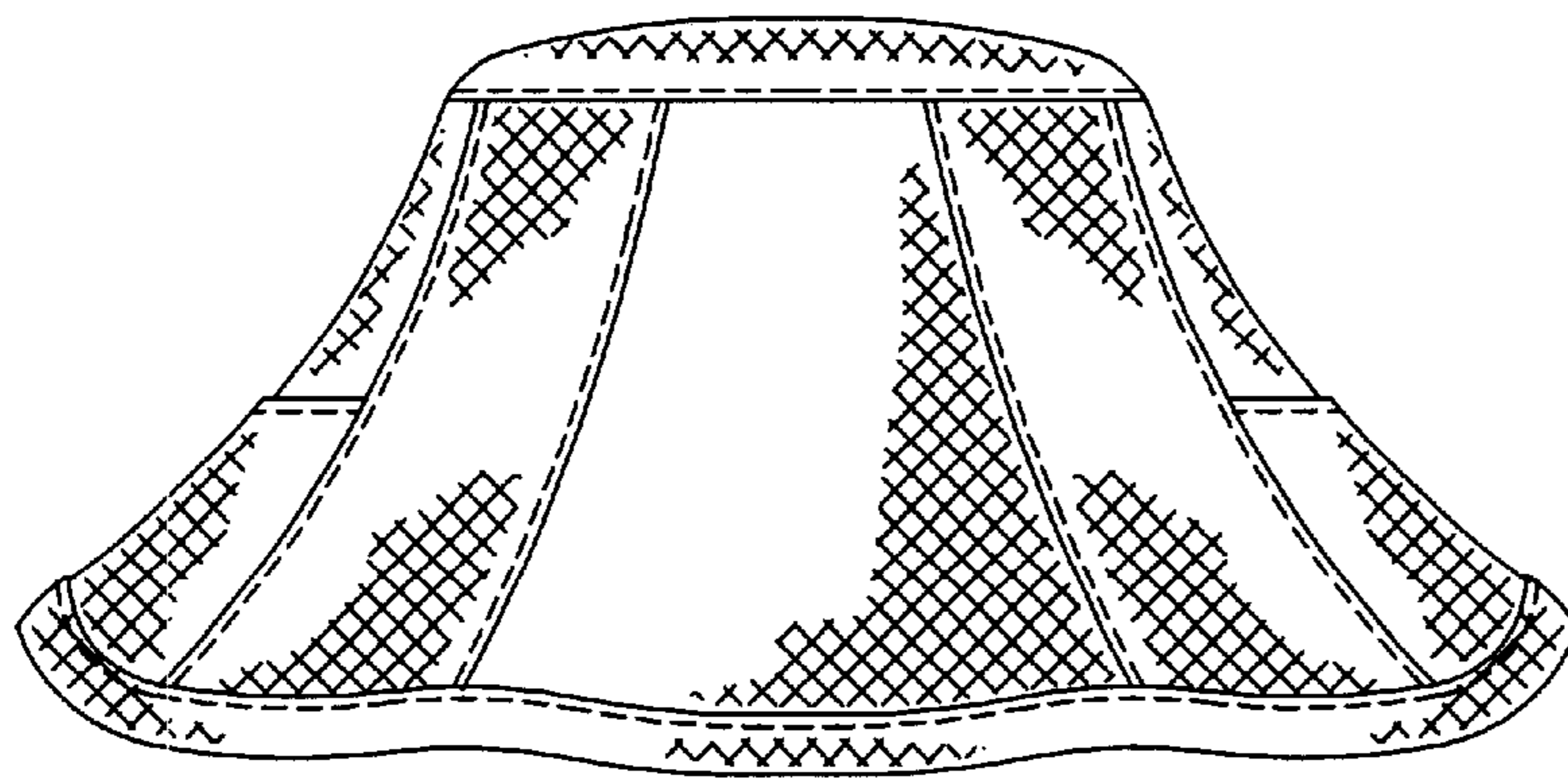

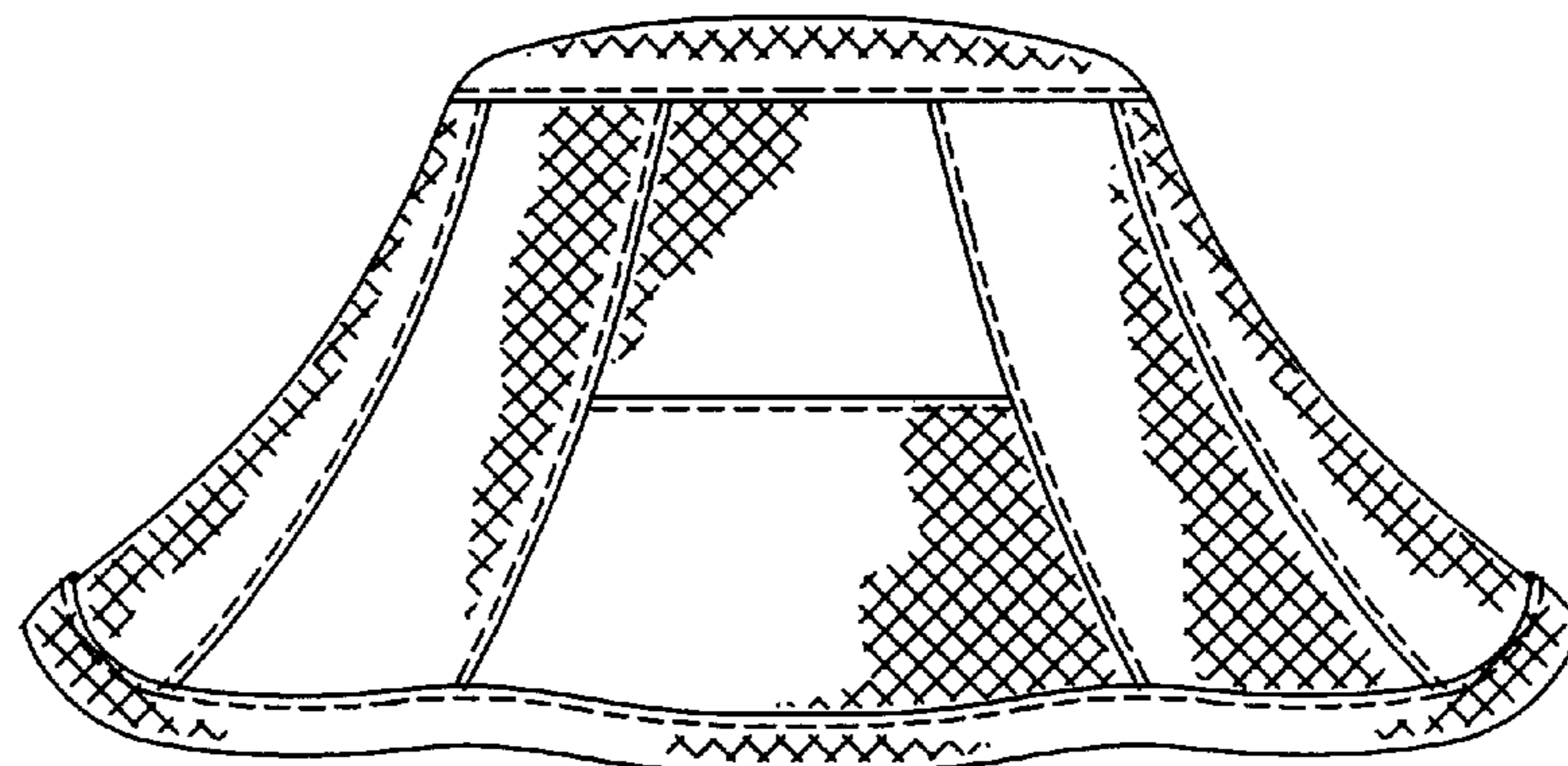
