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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a jug shaped bag with extension,
as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a jug shaped bag with extension
in an uncinched condition, having a top surface with shading
indicating the first preselected fabric and a carry strap.

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a bottom perspective view of FIG. 1;

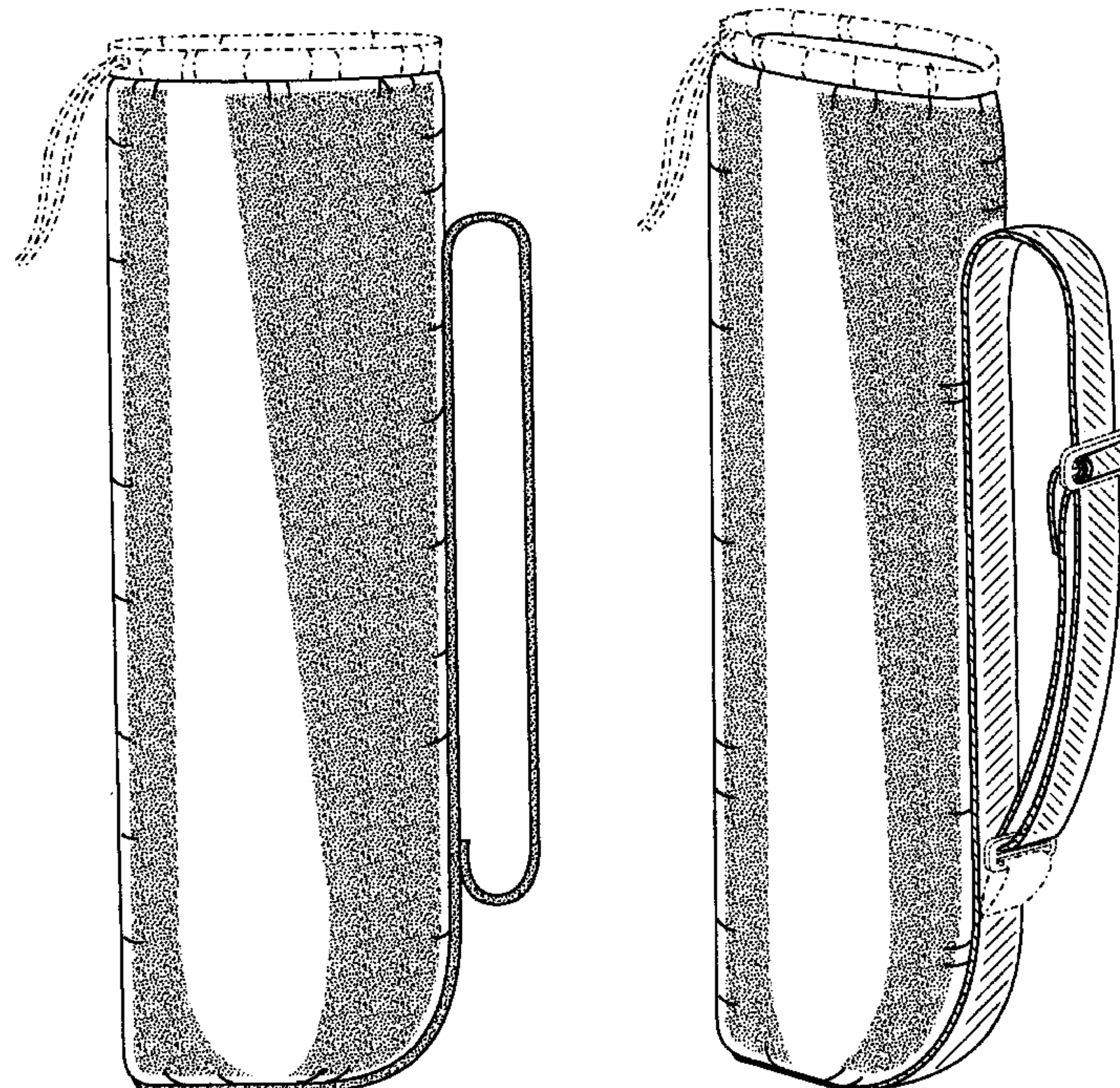
FIG. 5 is a top perspective view of a FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a front perspective view of a jug shaped bag with
extension as in FIG. 3, now shown in a cinched condition;
FIG. 7 is a rear perspective view of a jug shaped bag with
extension as in FIG. 2, now shown in a cinched condition;
and,

FIG. 8 is a front perspective view of a jug shaped bag with
extension as in FIG. 1, now shown with an adjustable carry
strap.

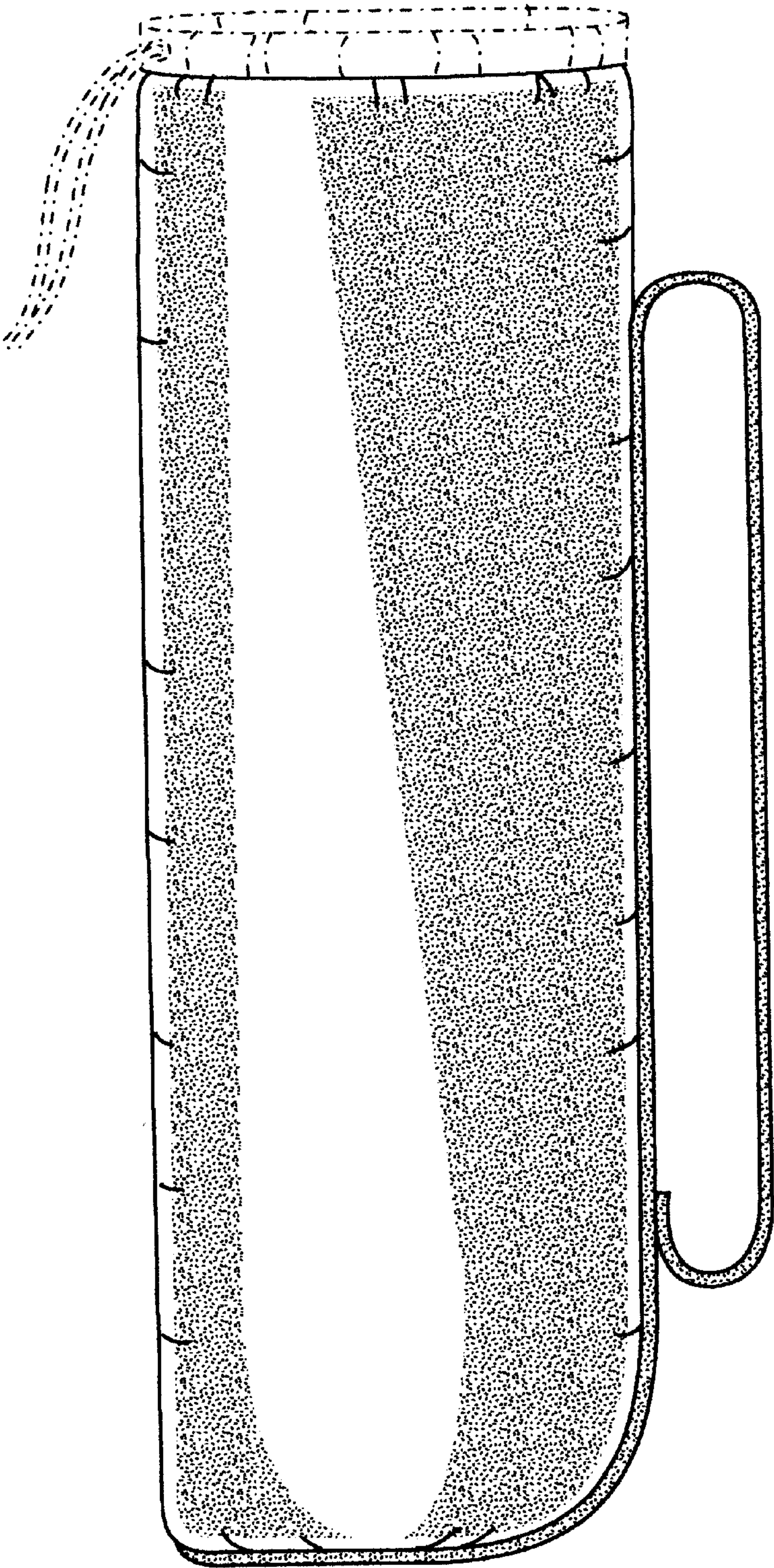

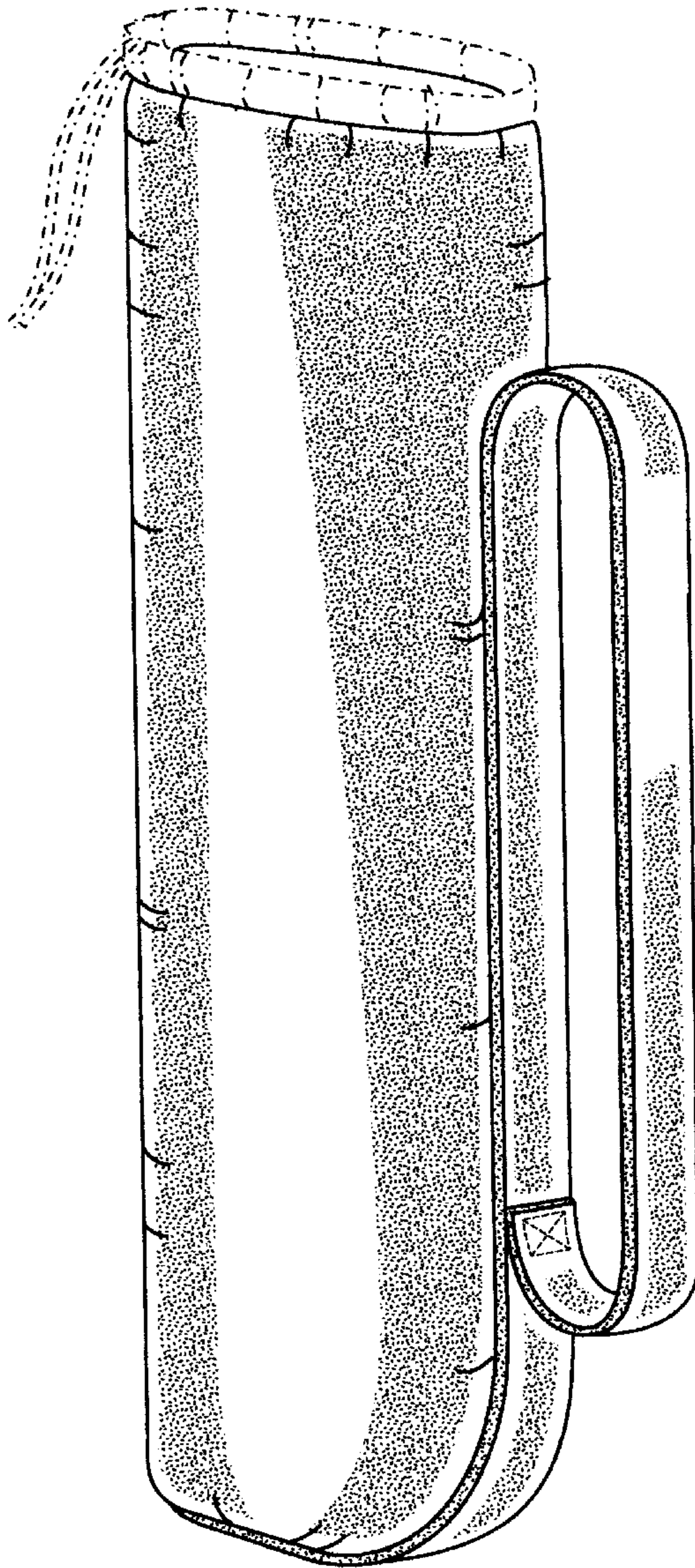

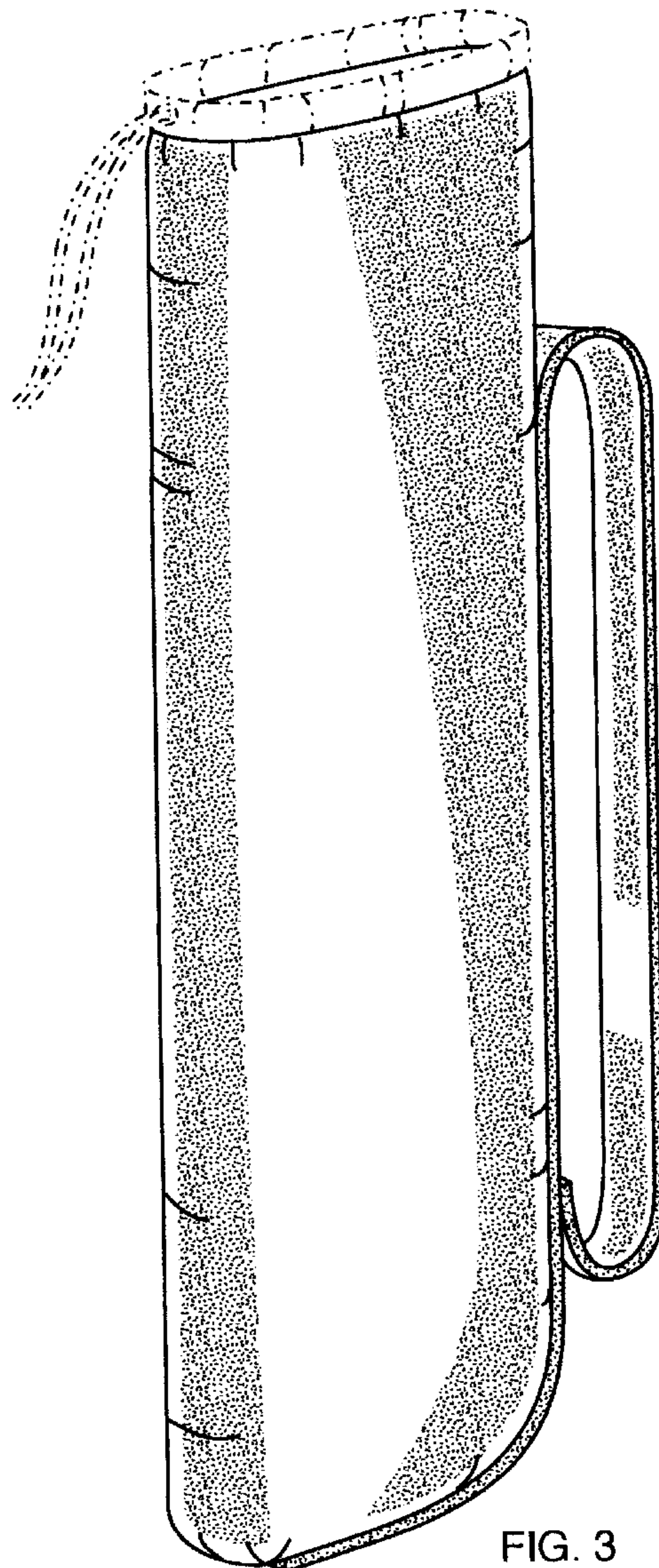

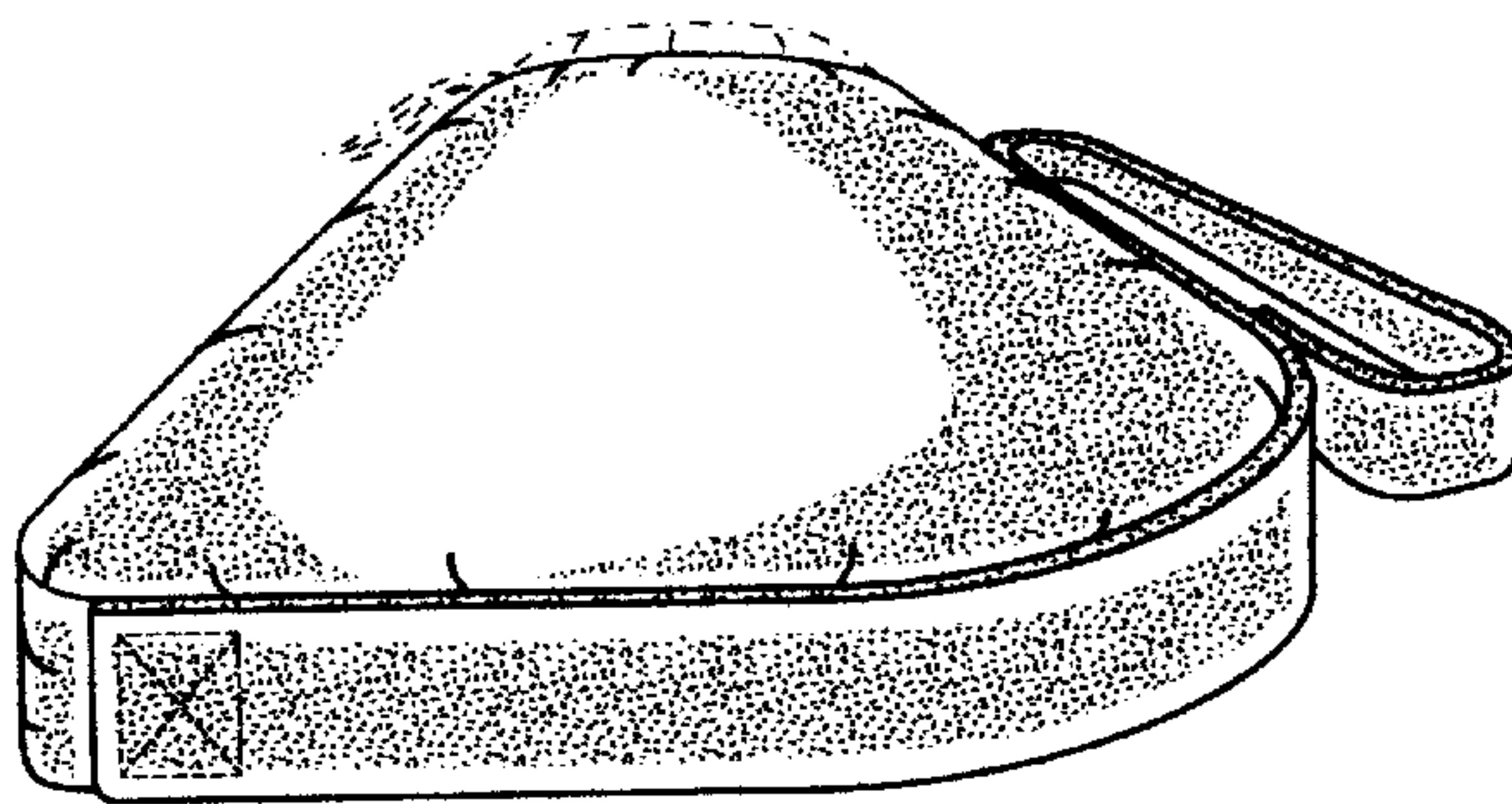

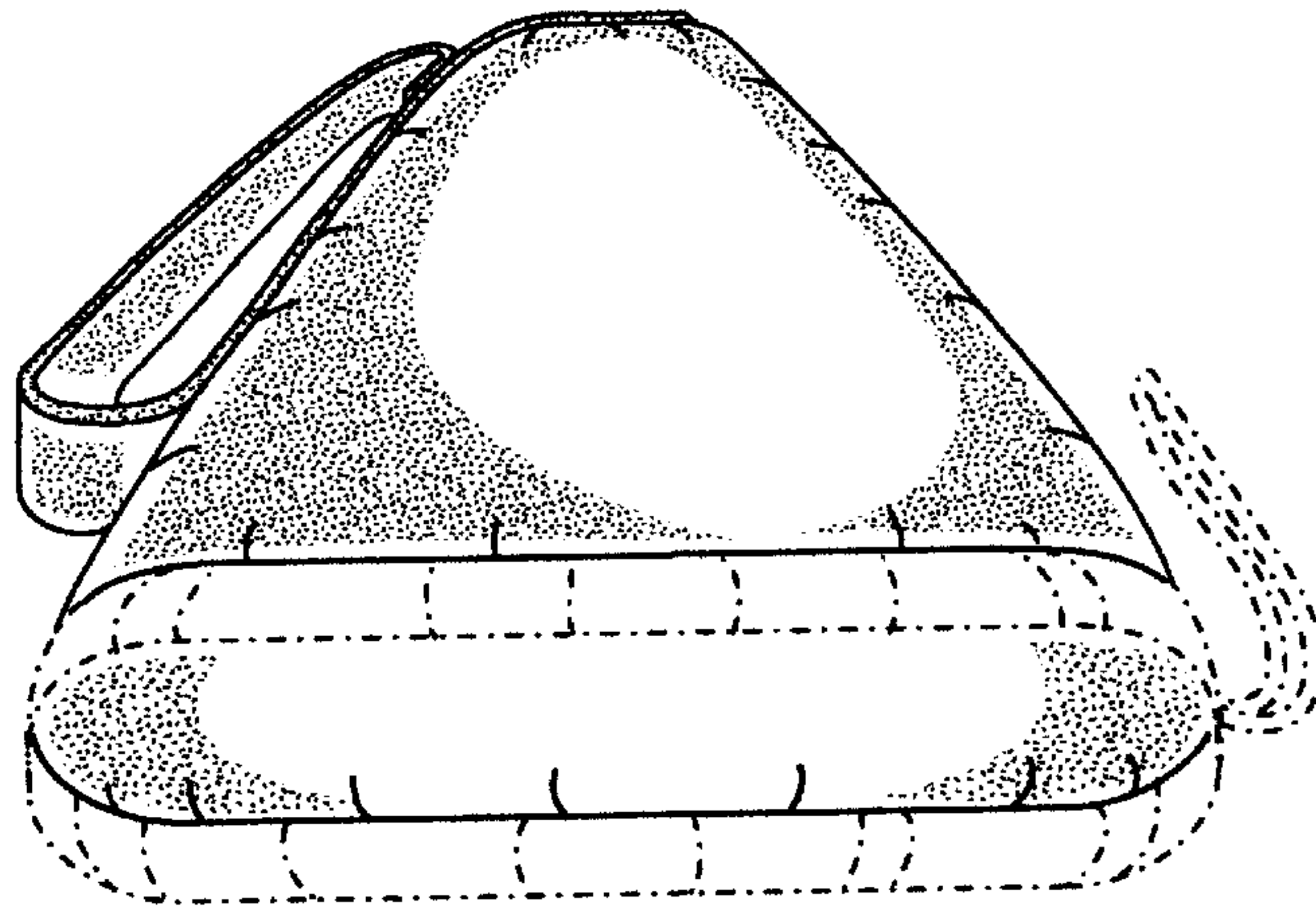

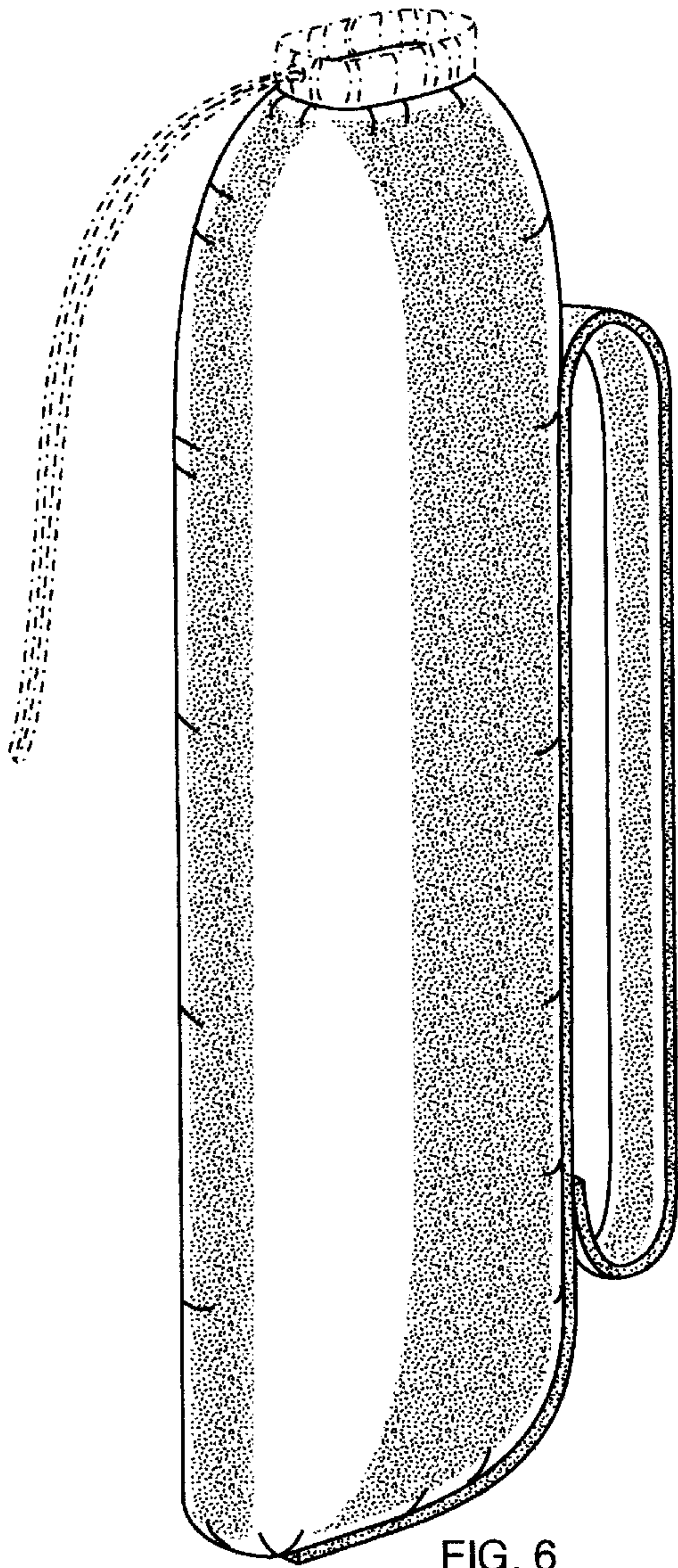

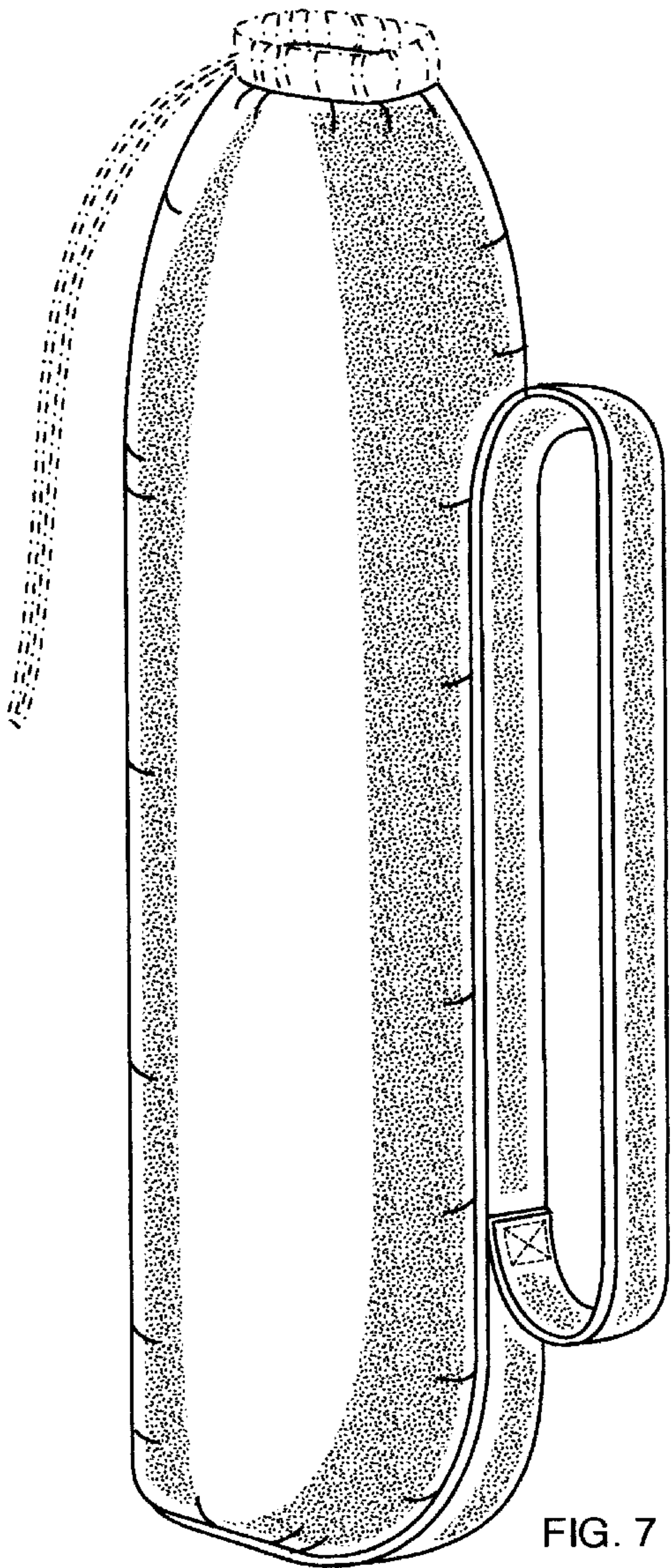

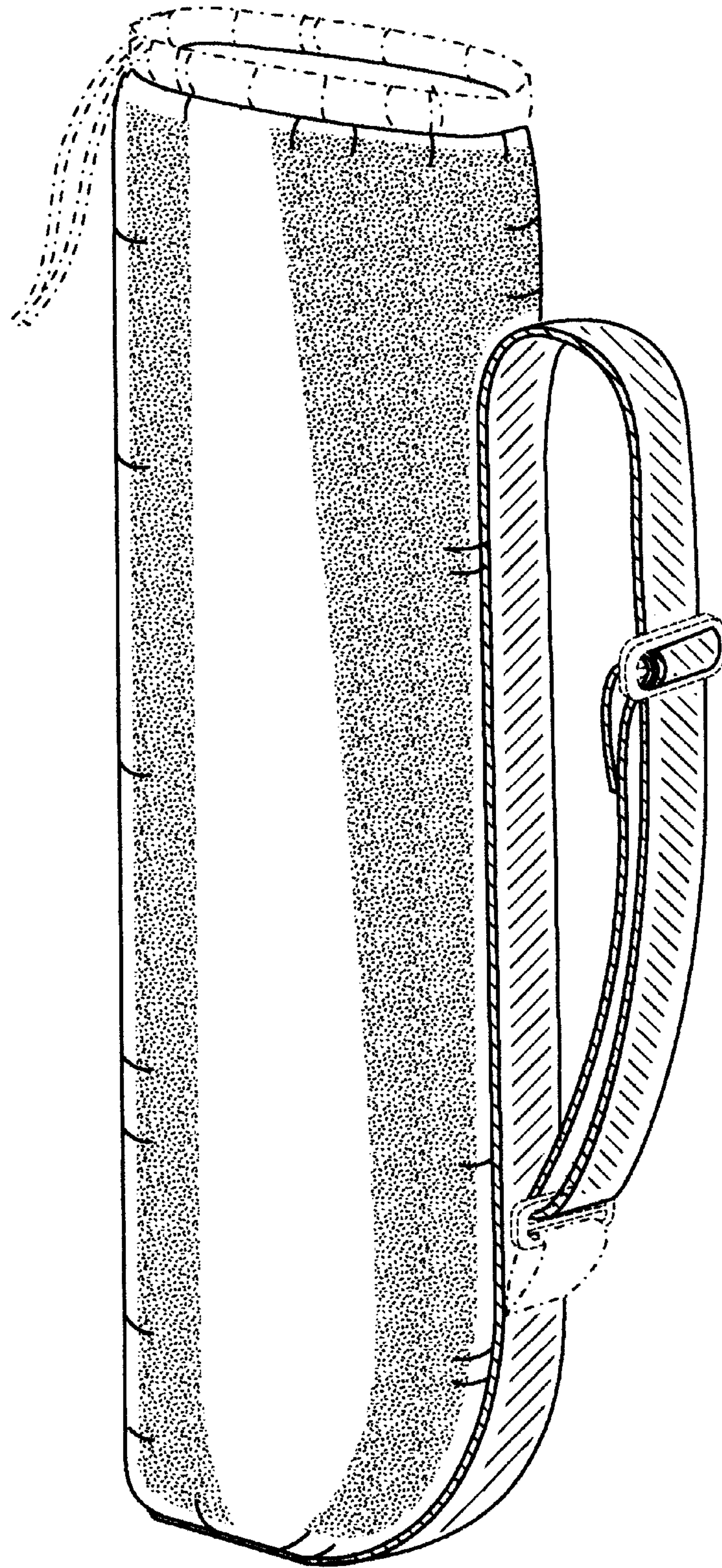
