The ornamental design for a camouflage pattern for sheet
material, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

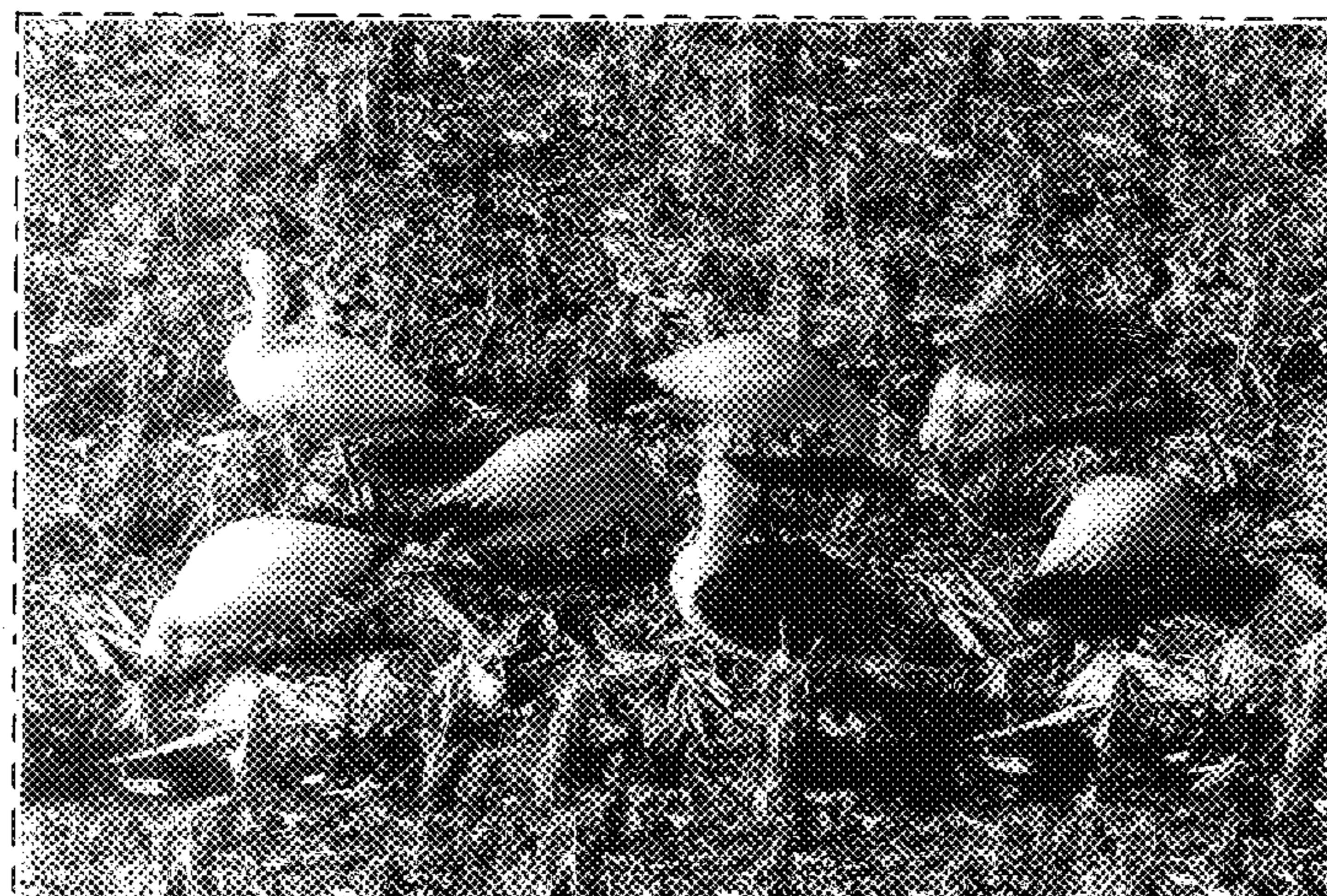
The patent or application file contains at least one drawing

The Sole FIGURE is a top plan view of a camouflage pattern
for sheet material. The broken line boundaries define a

throughout the length and width of the sheet material.

The broken lines form no part of the claimed design.
