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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a set of leaching chamber end units, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first leaching chamber embodying the ornamental design of the present invention; FIG. 2 is an expanded perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side view thereof, the opposite side view being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear view thereof.

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second leaching chamber embodying the ornamental design of the present invention;

FIG. 8 is an expanded perspective view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a side view thereof, the opposite side view being a mirror image;

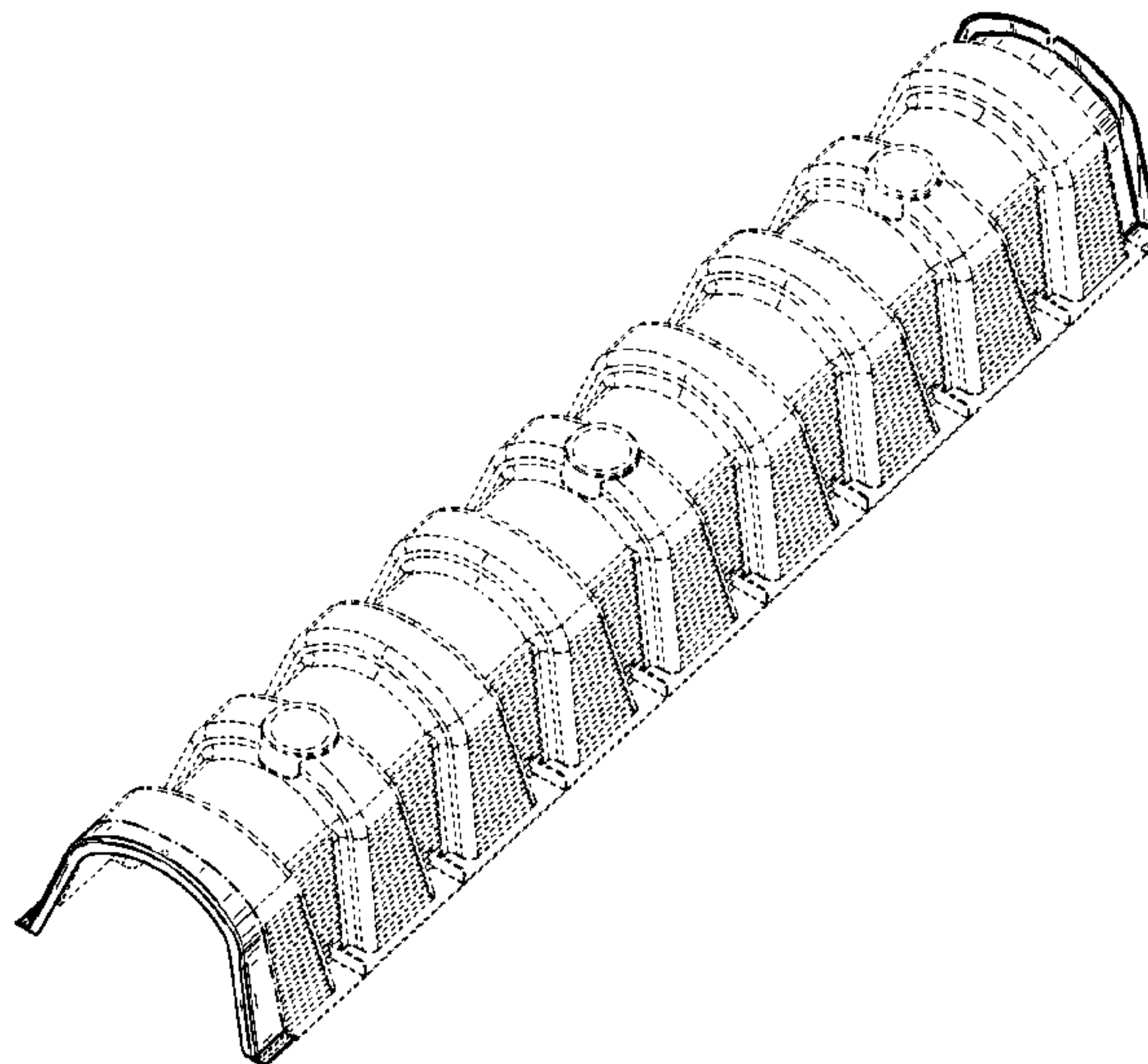
FIG. 10 is a top view thereof;

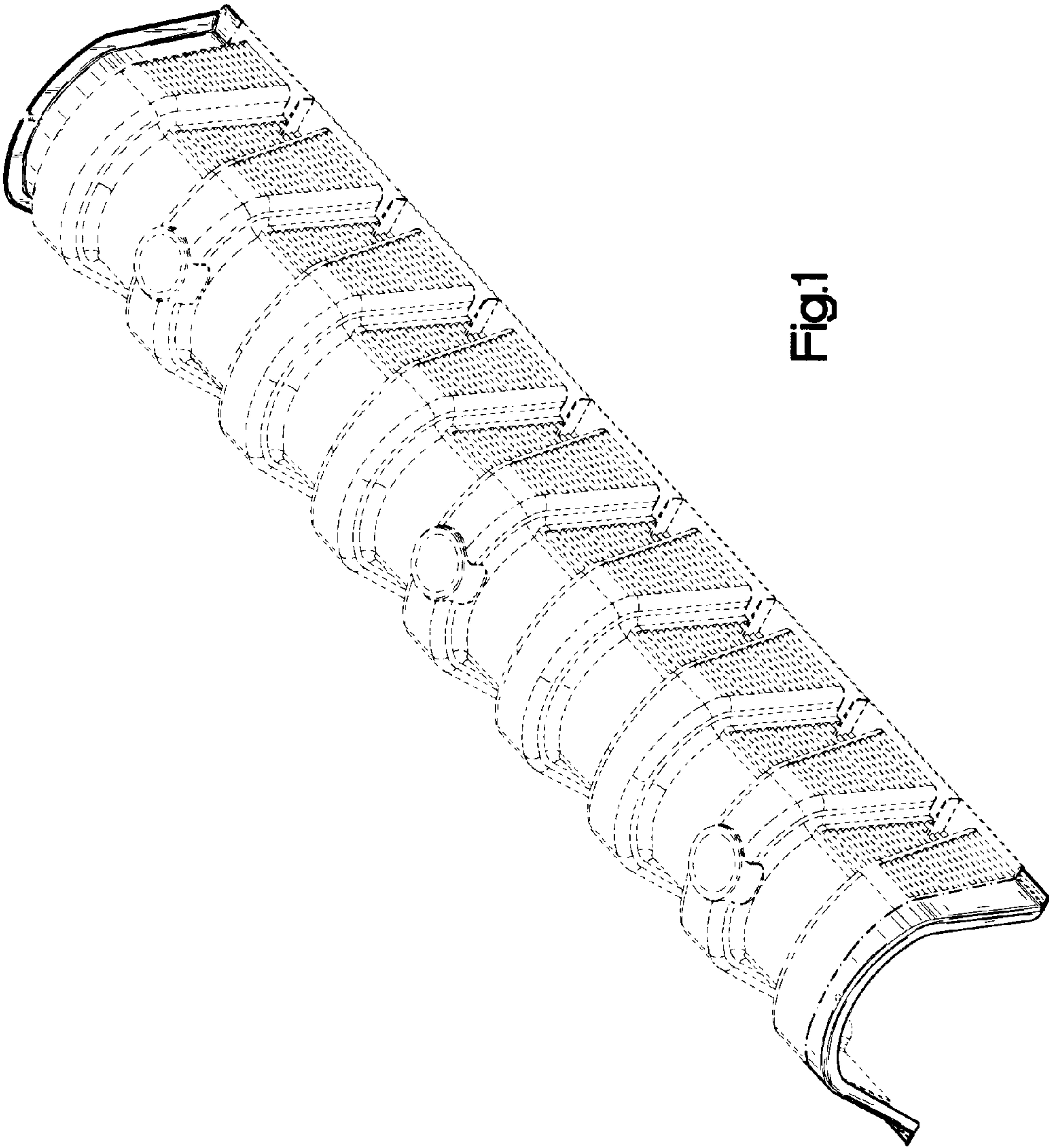

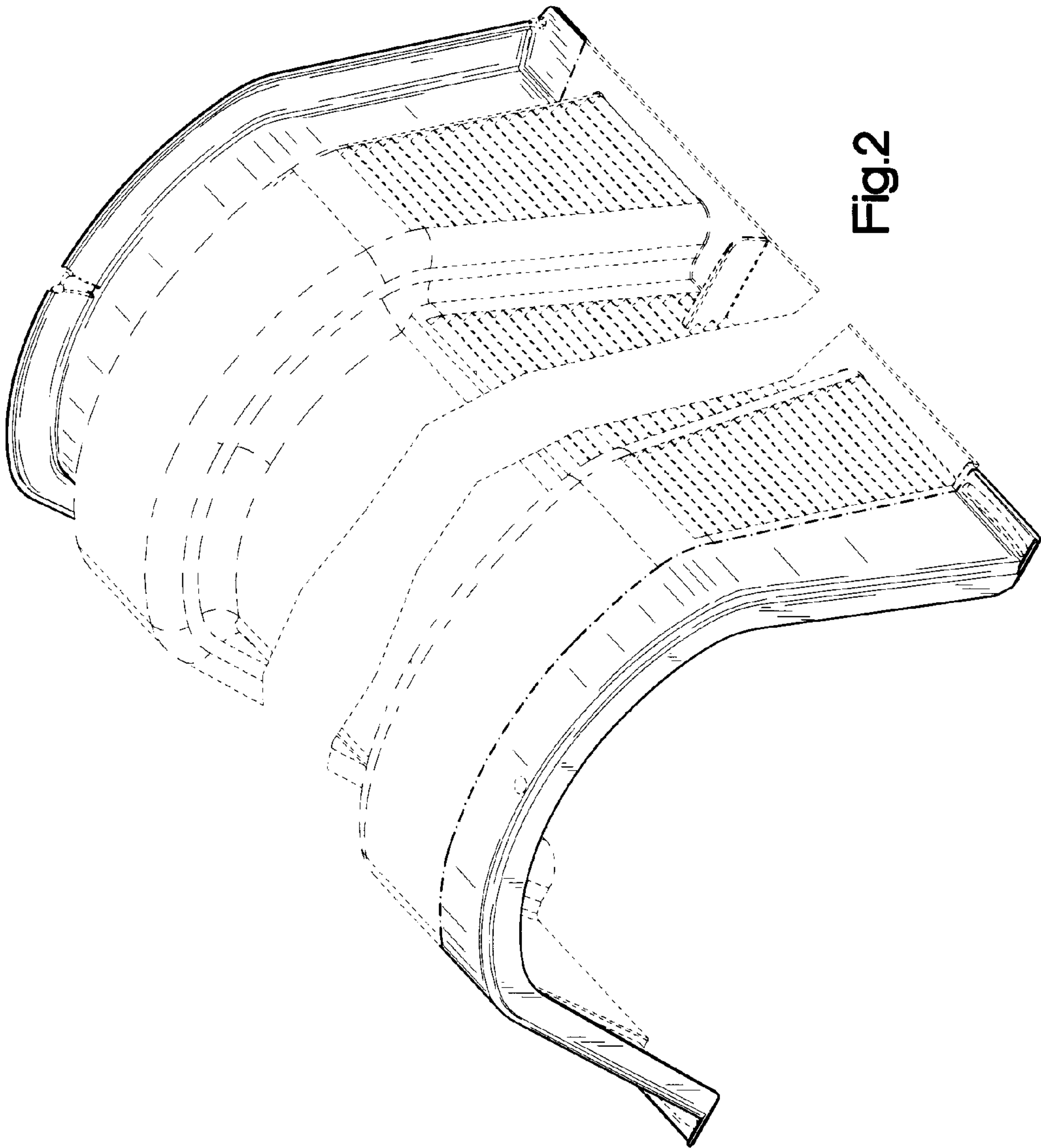

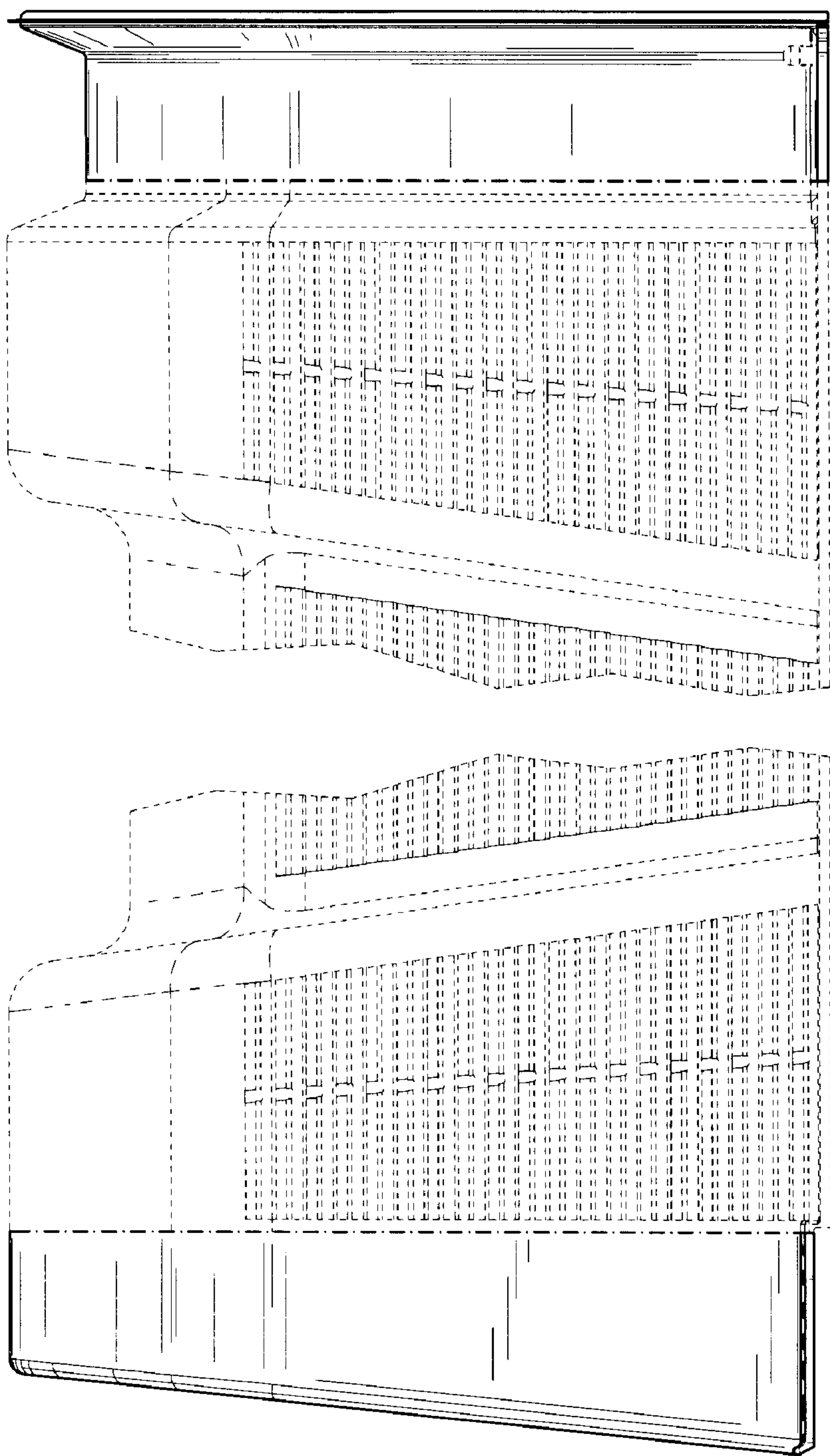

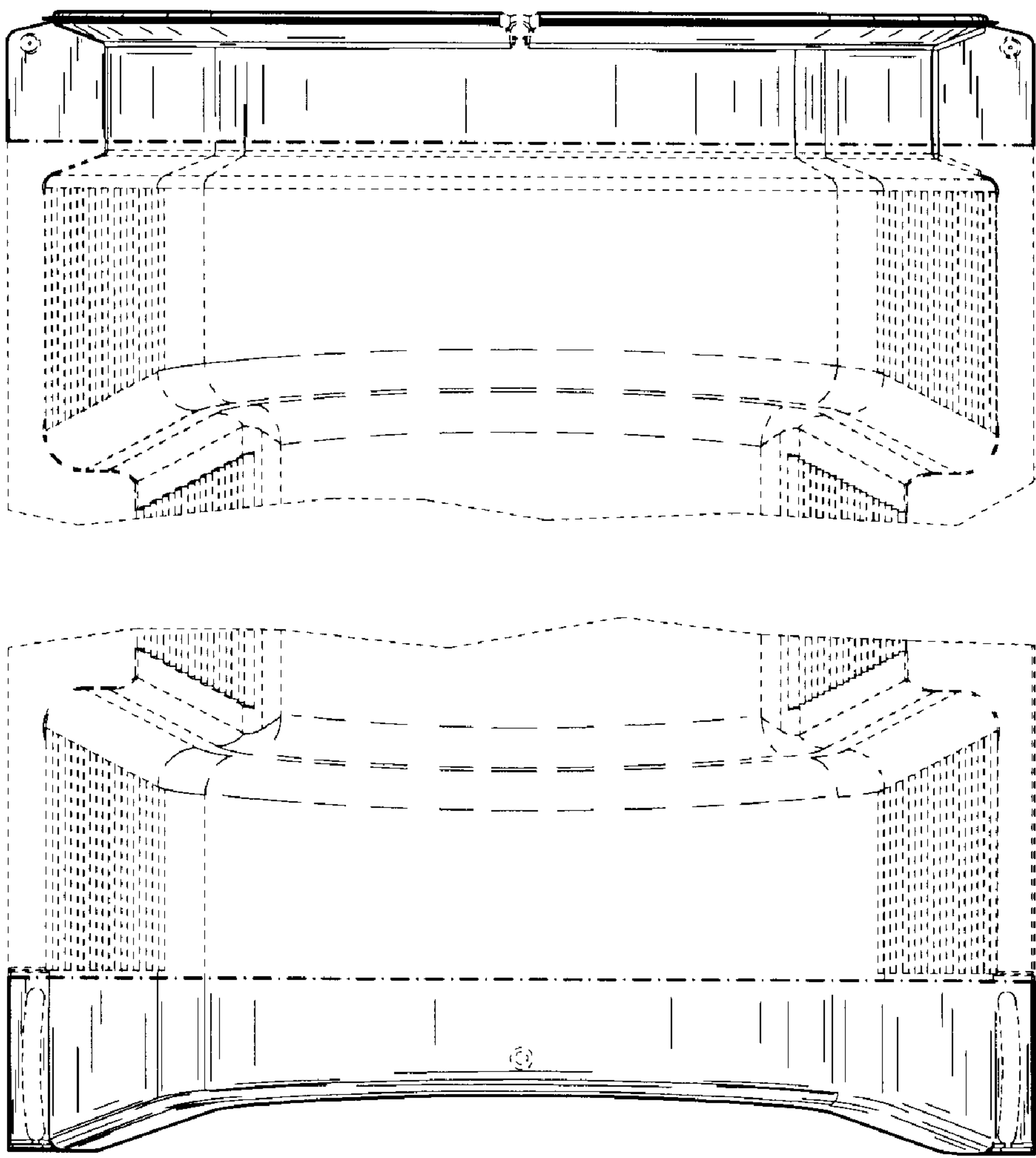

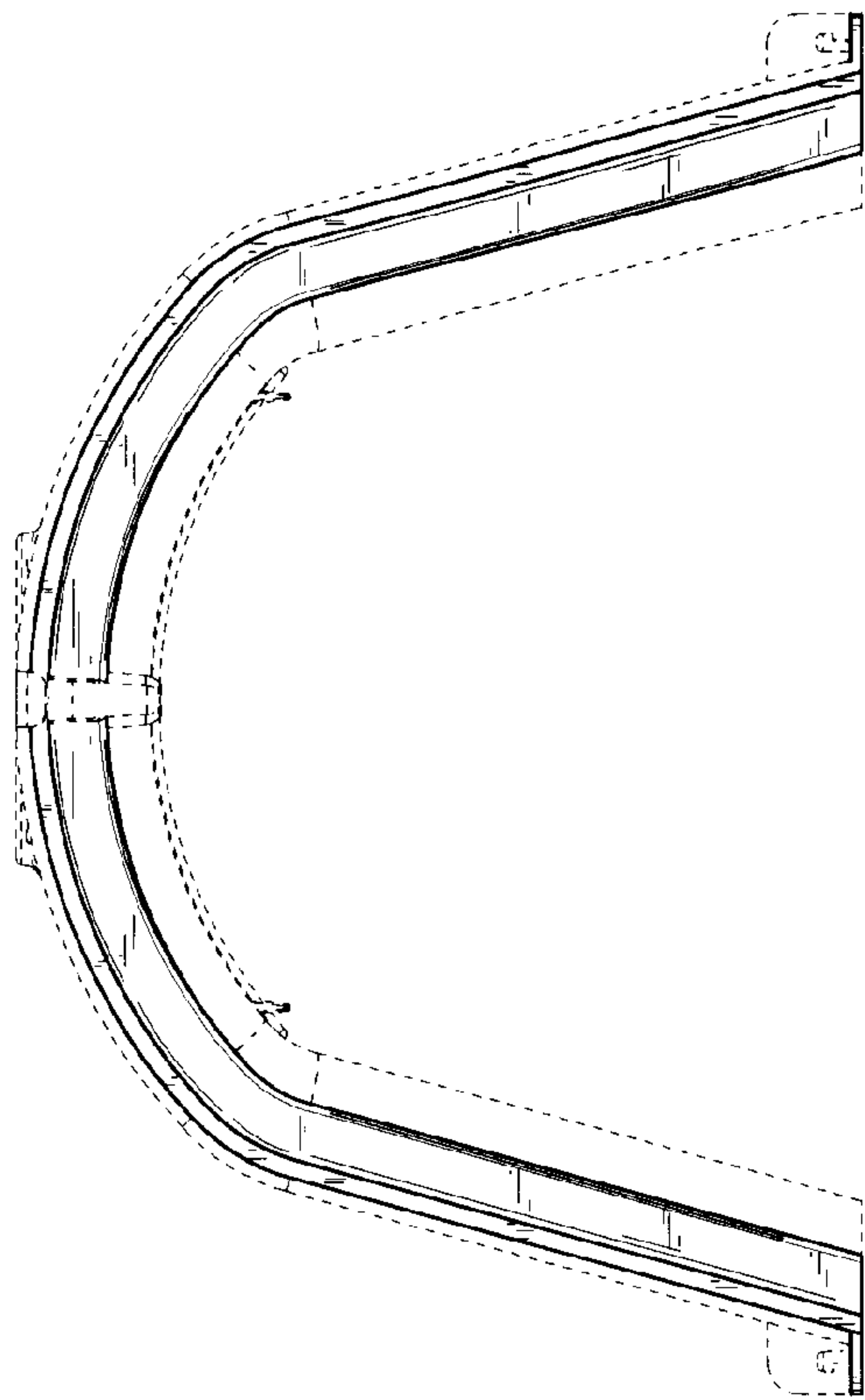

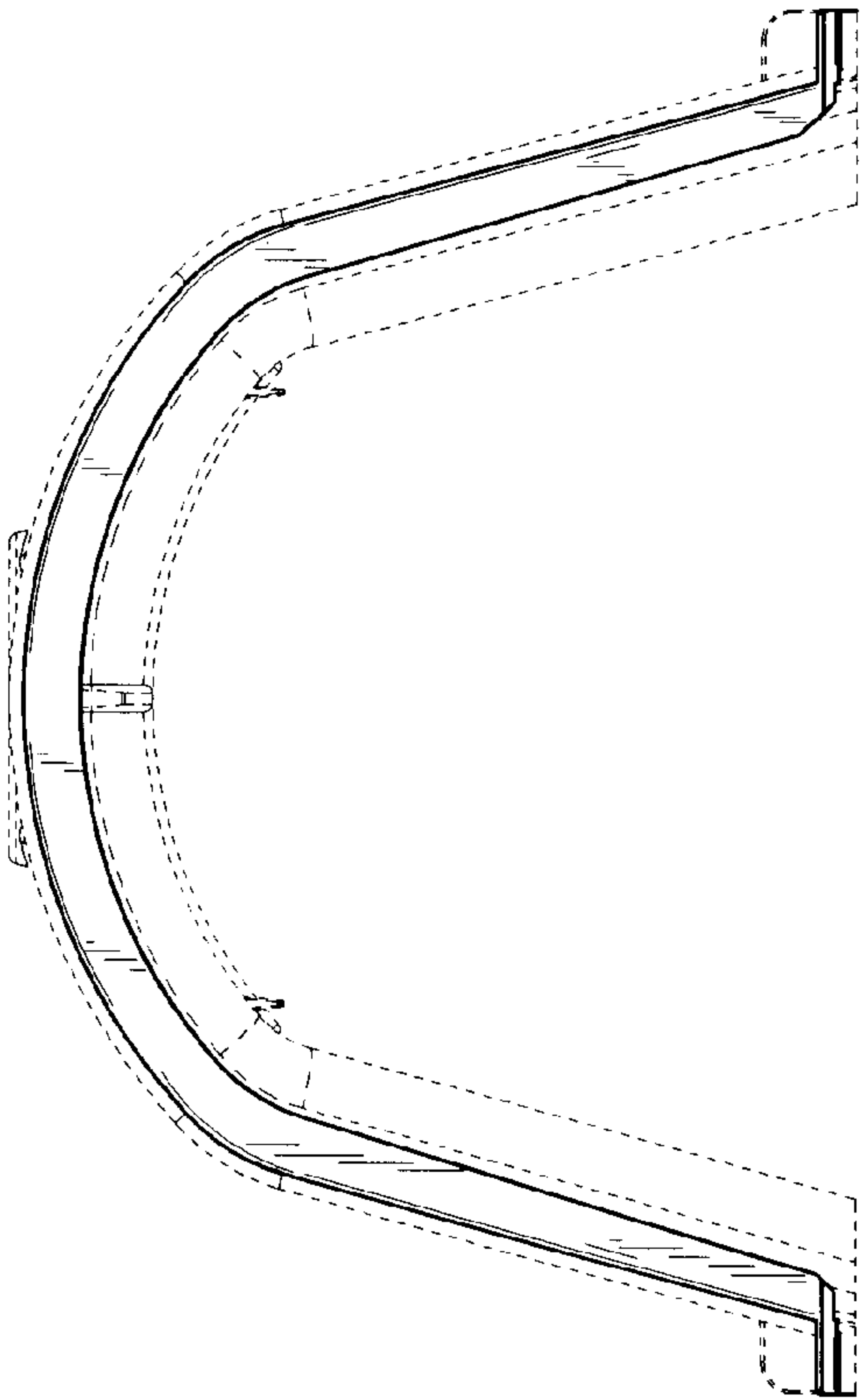

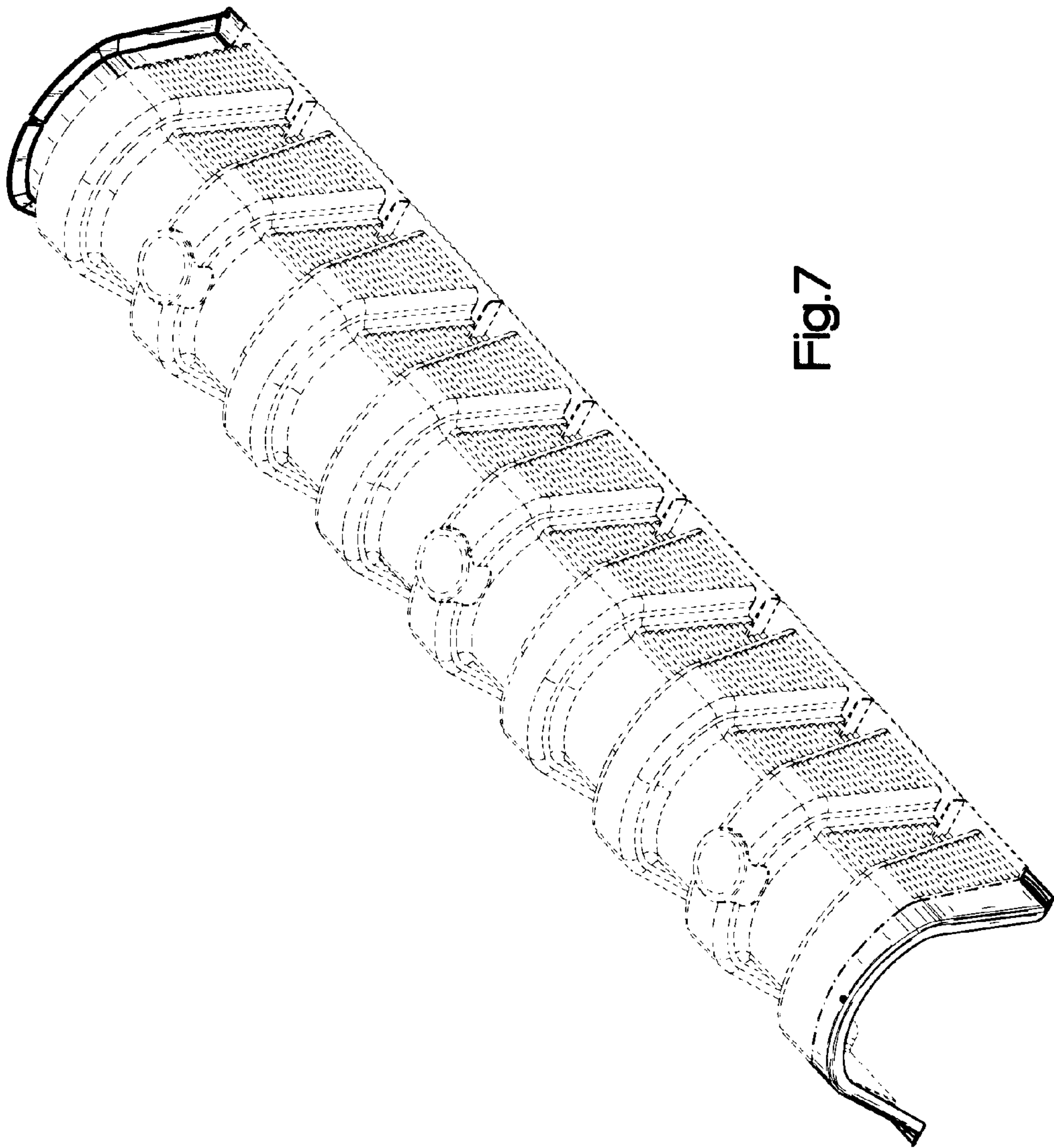

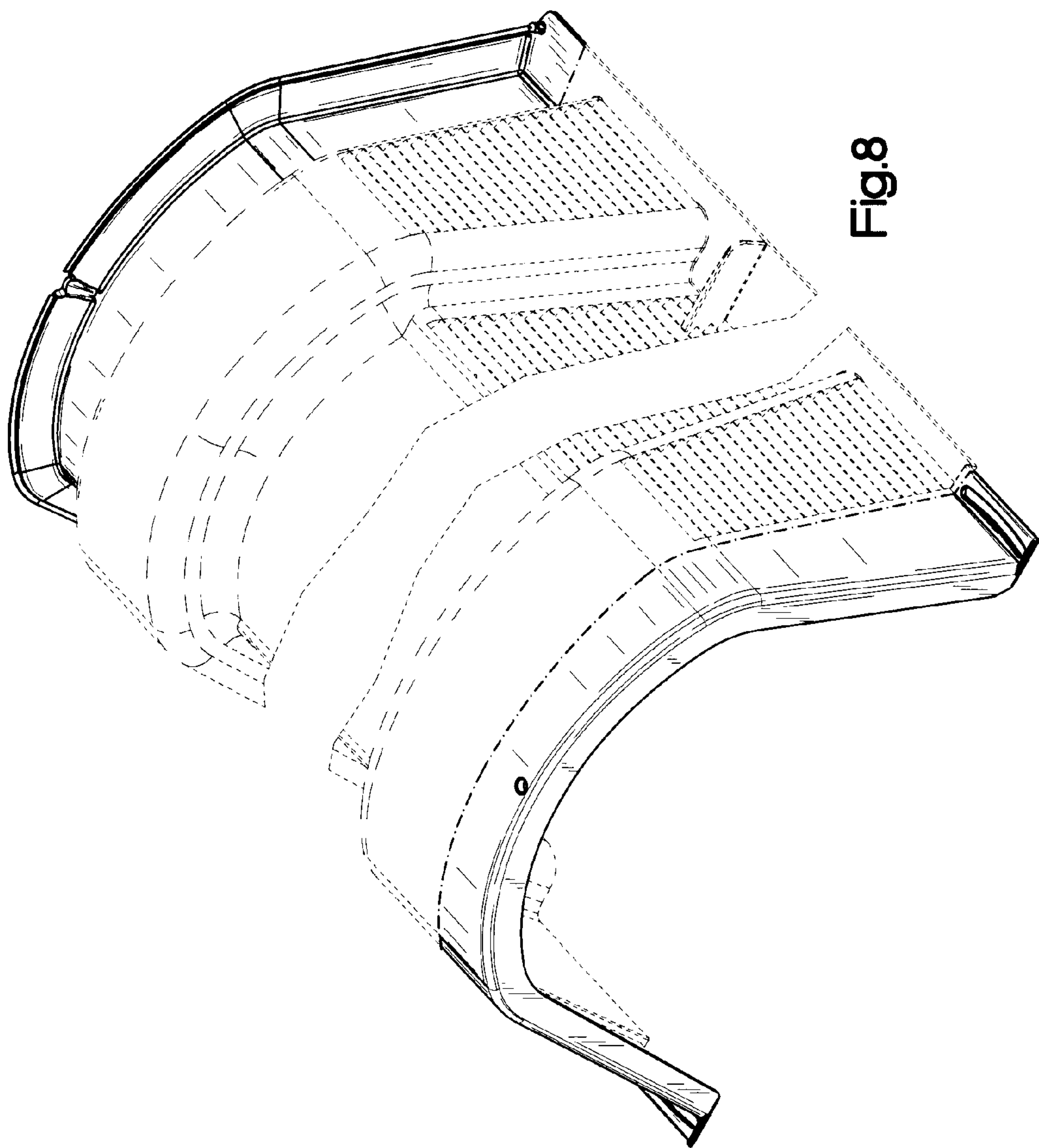

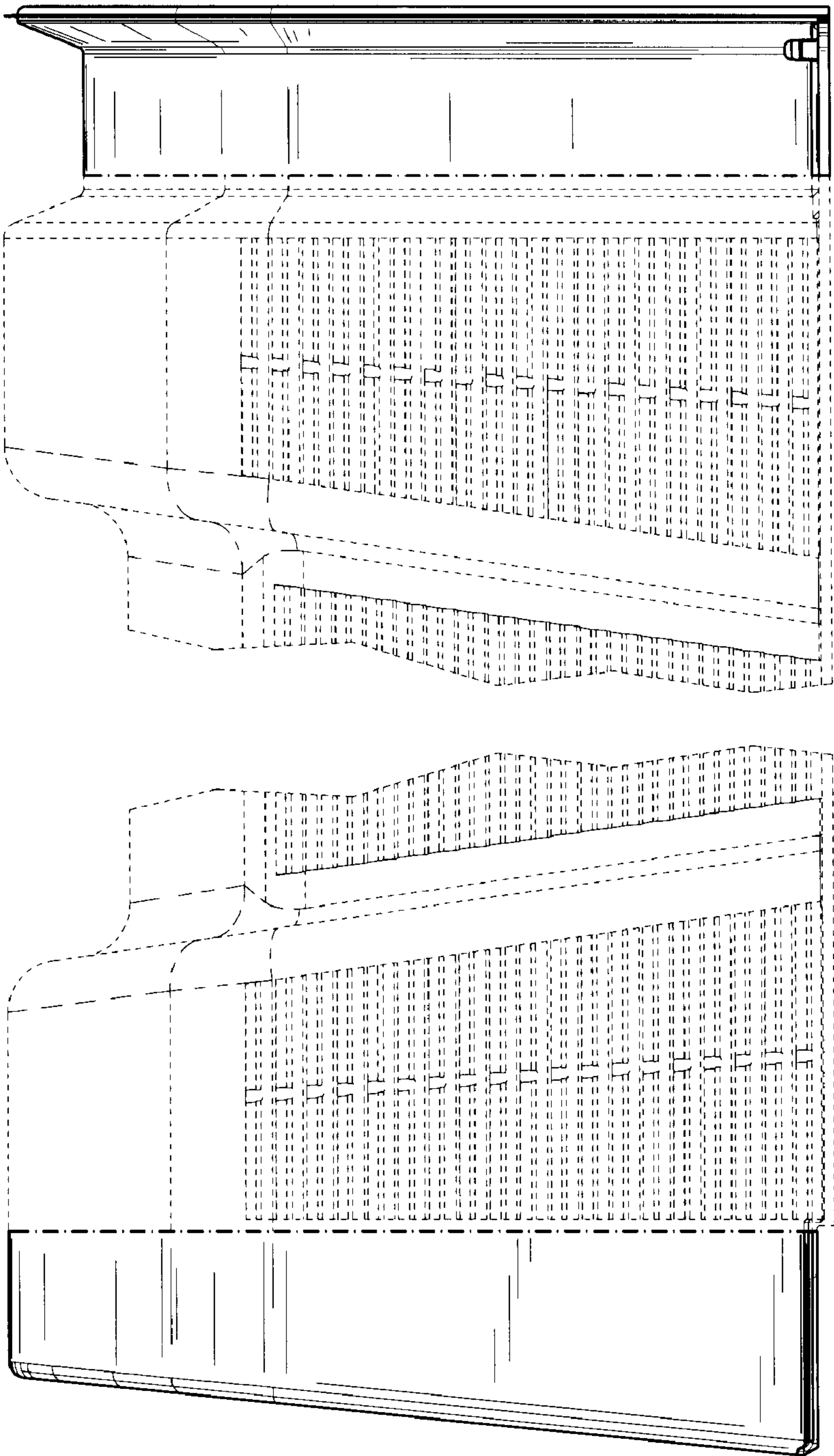

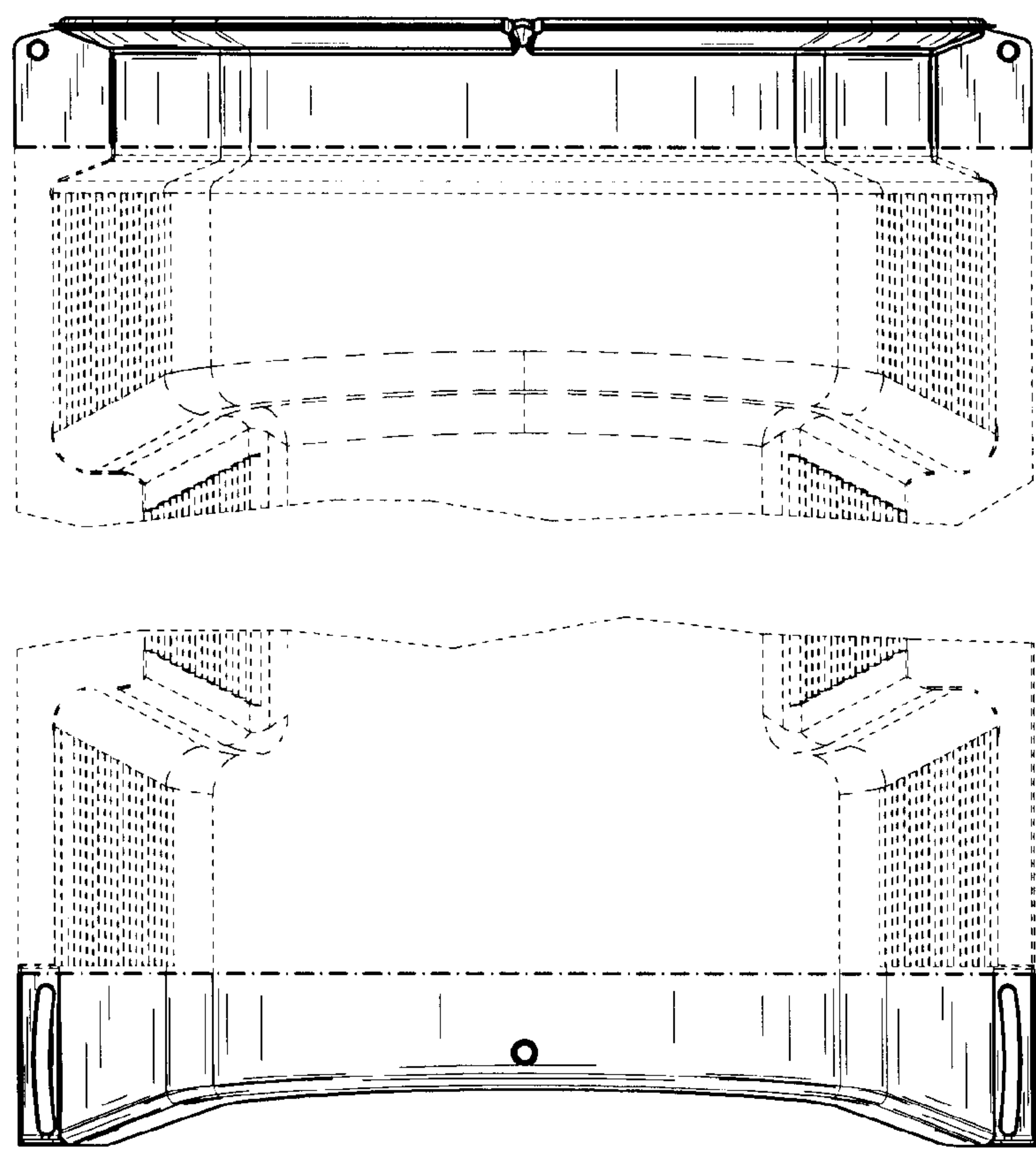

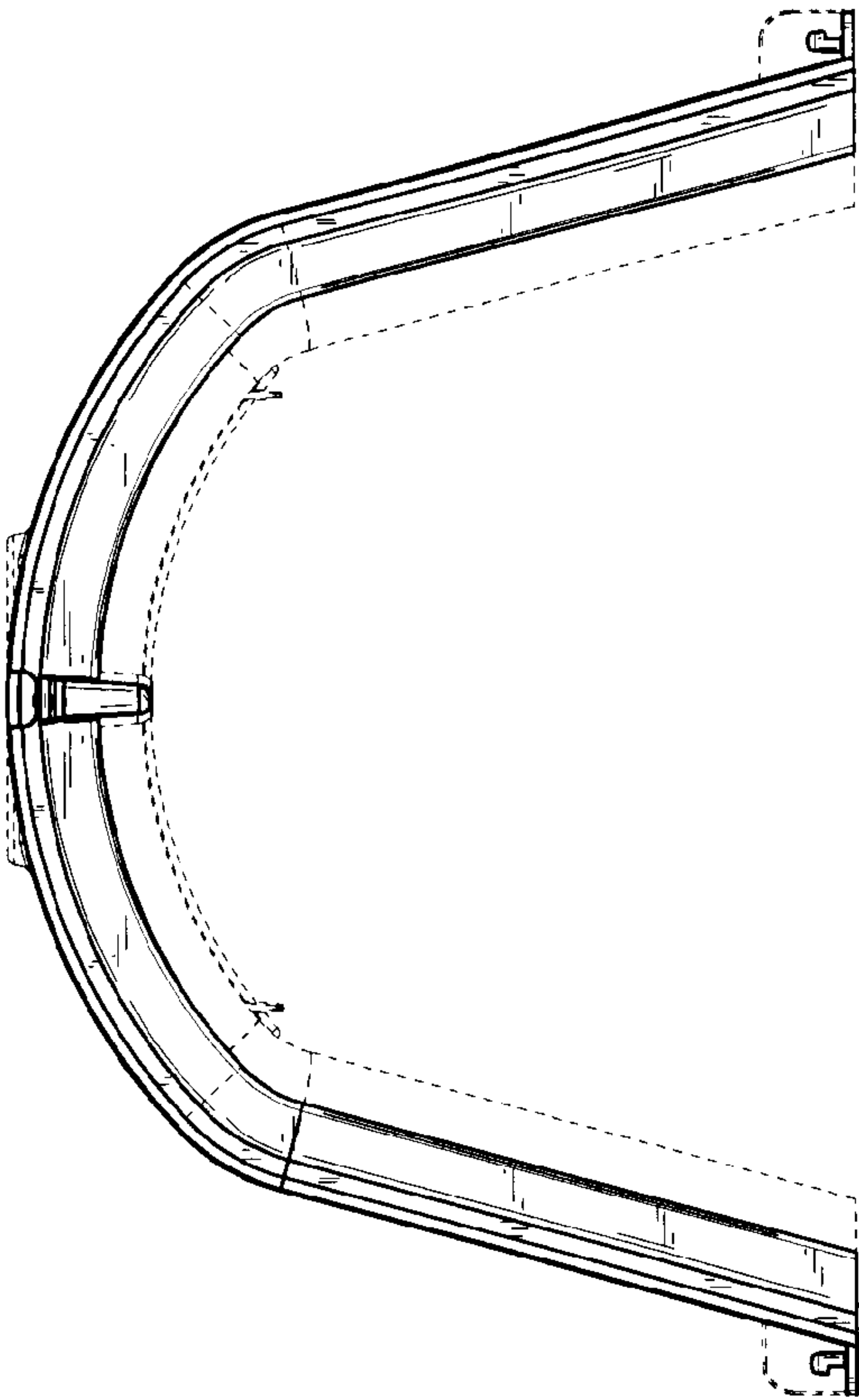

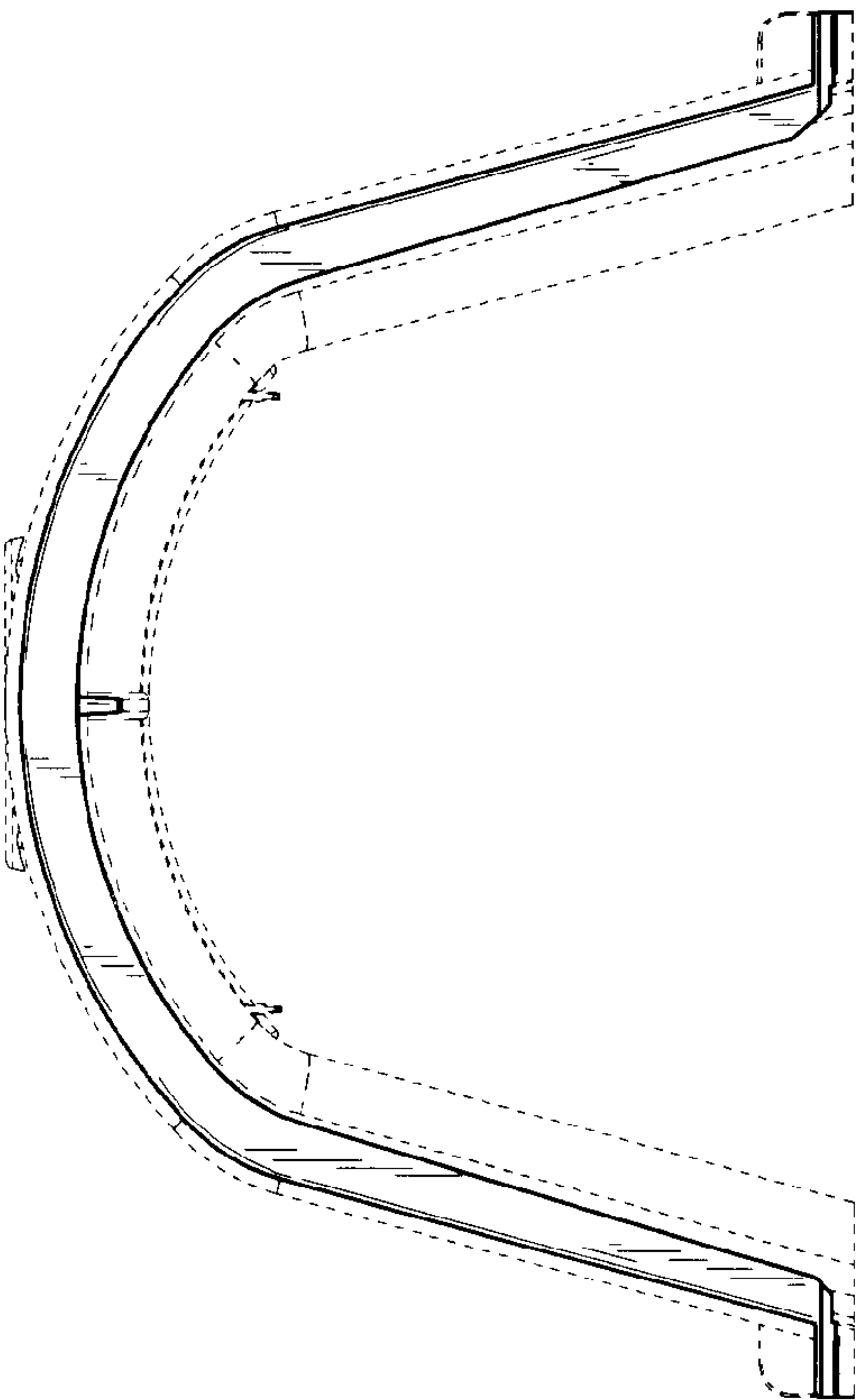
