DESCRIPTION

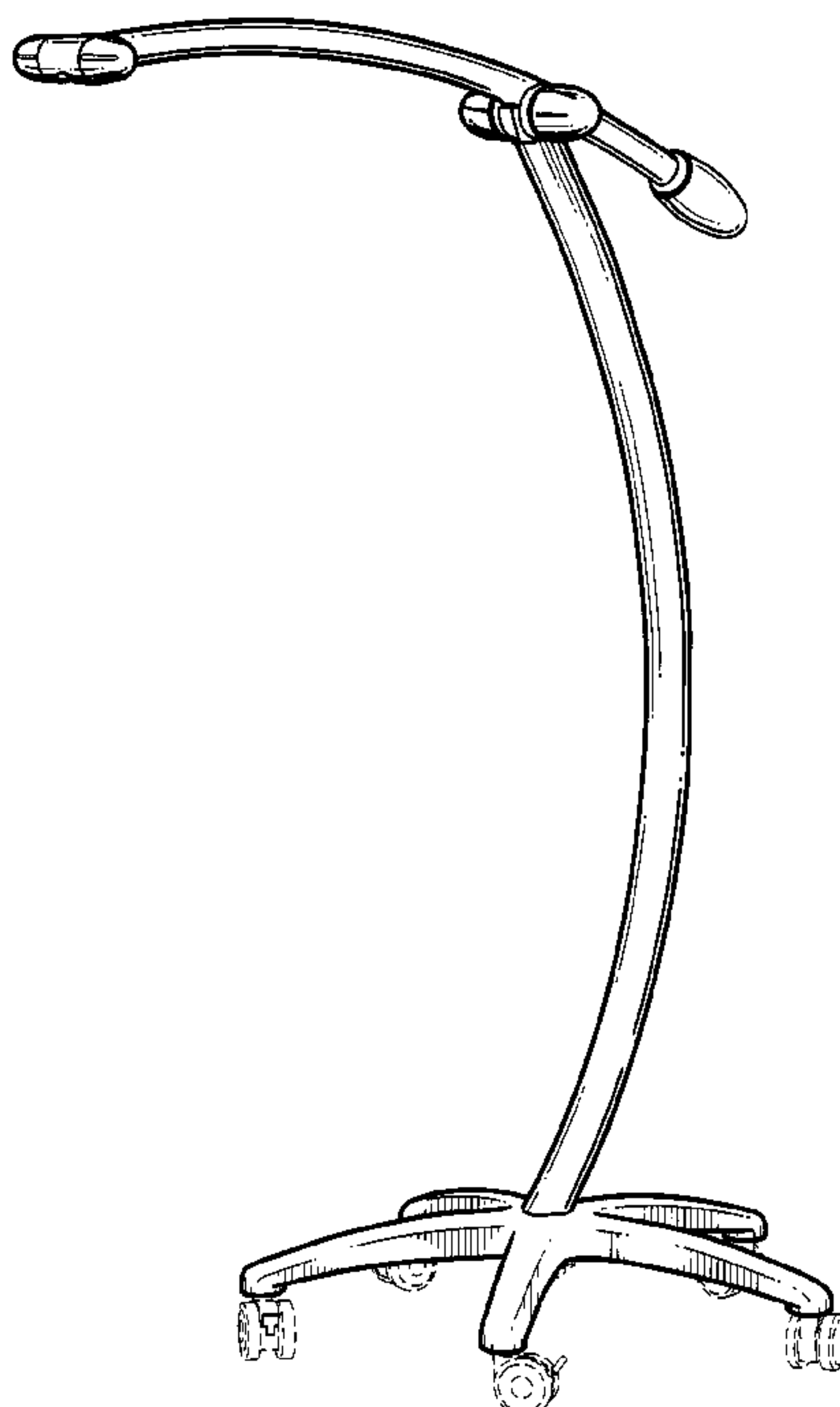

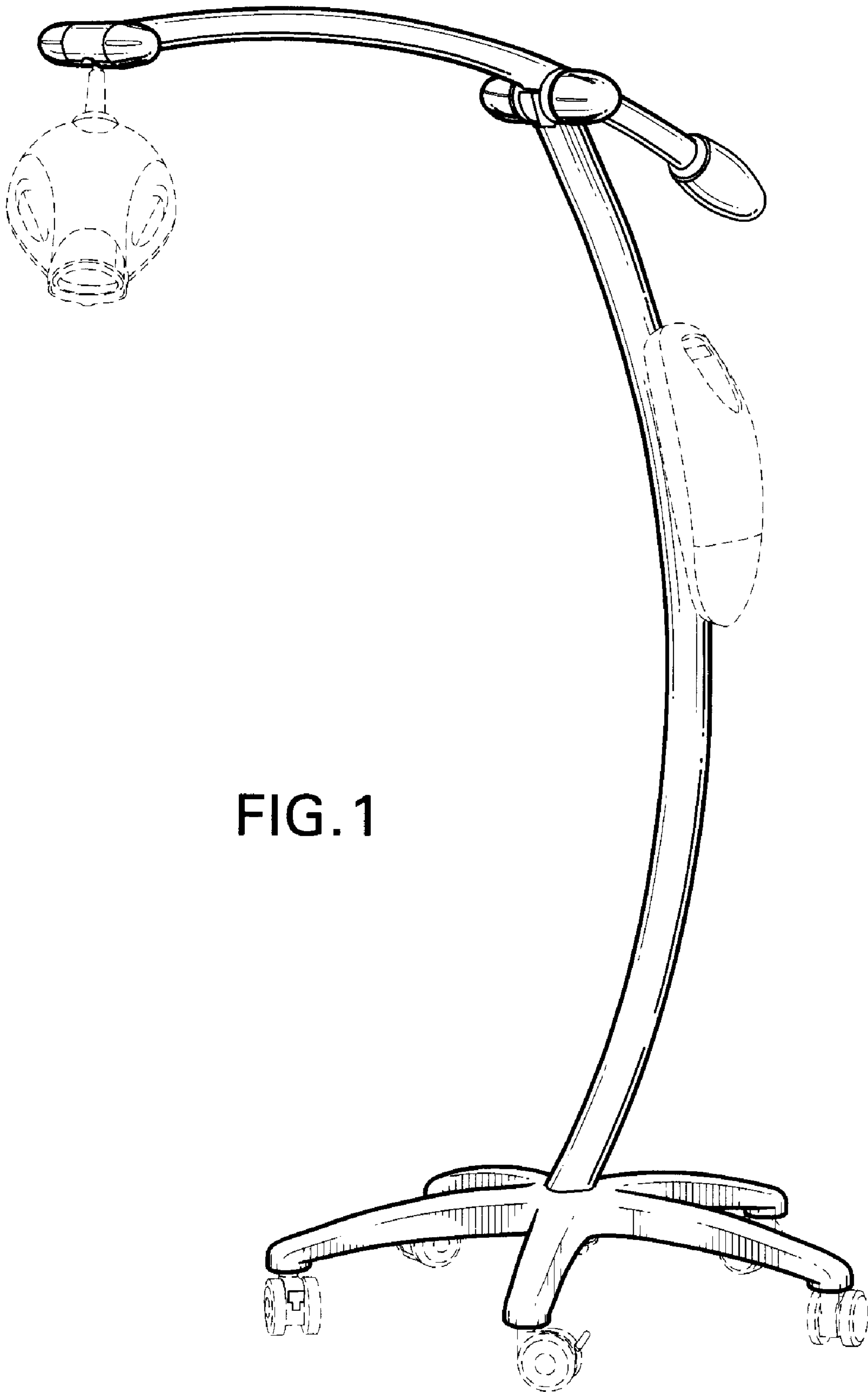

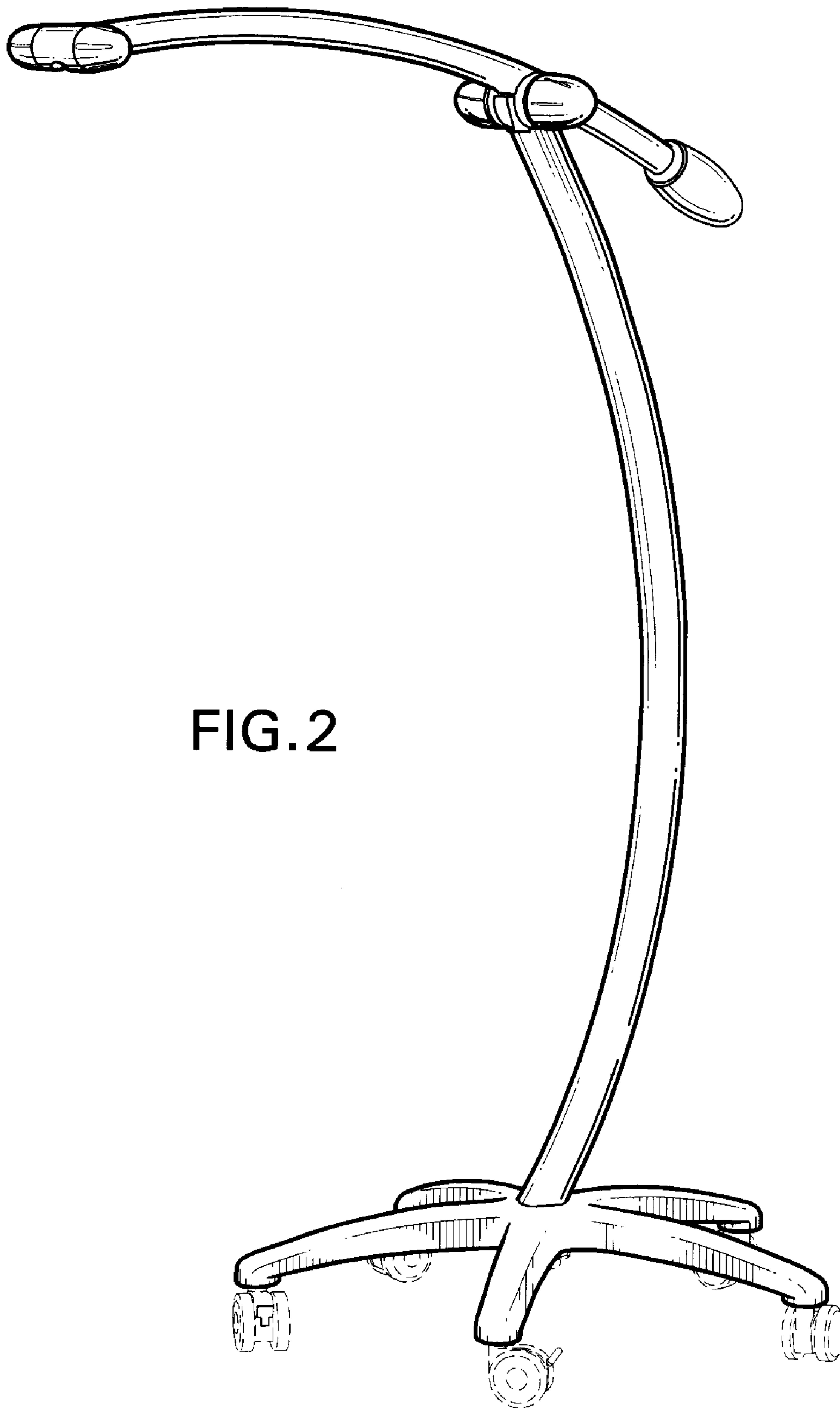

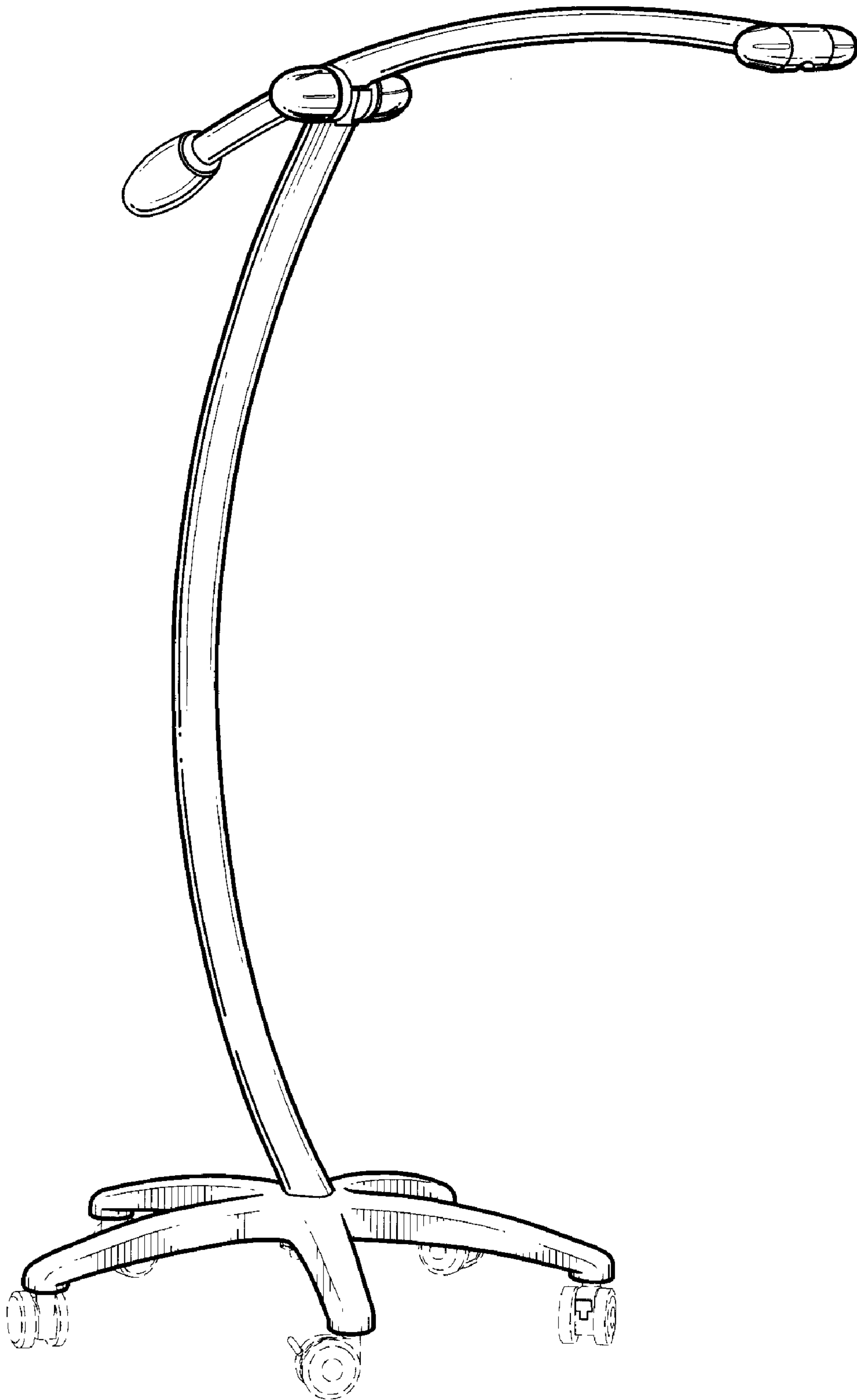

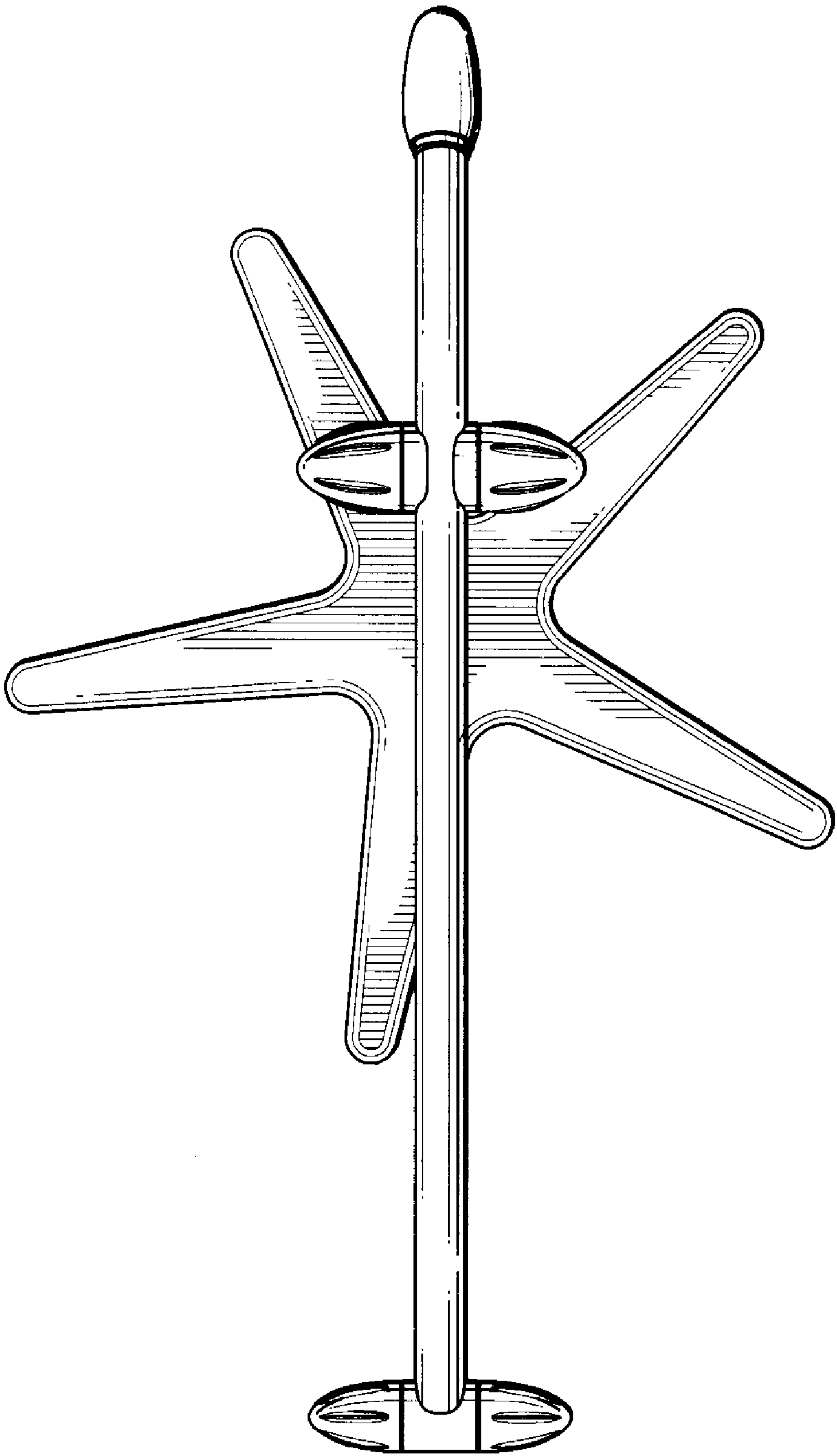
