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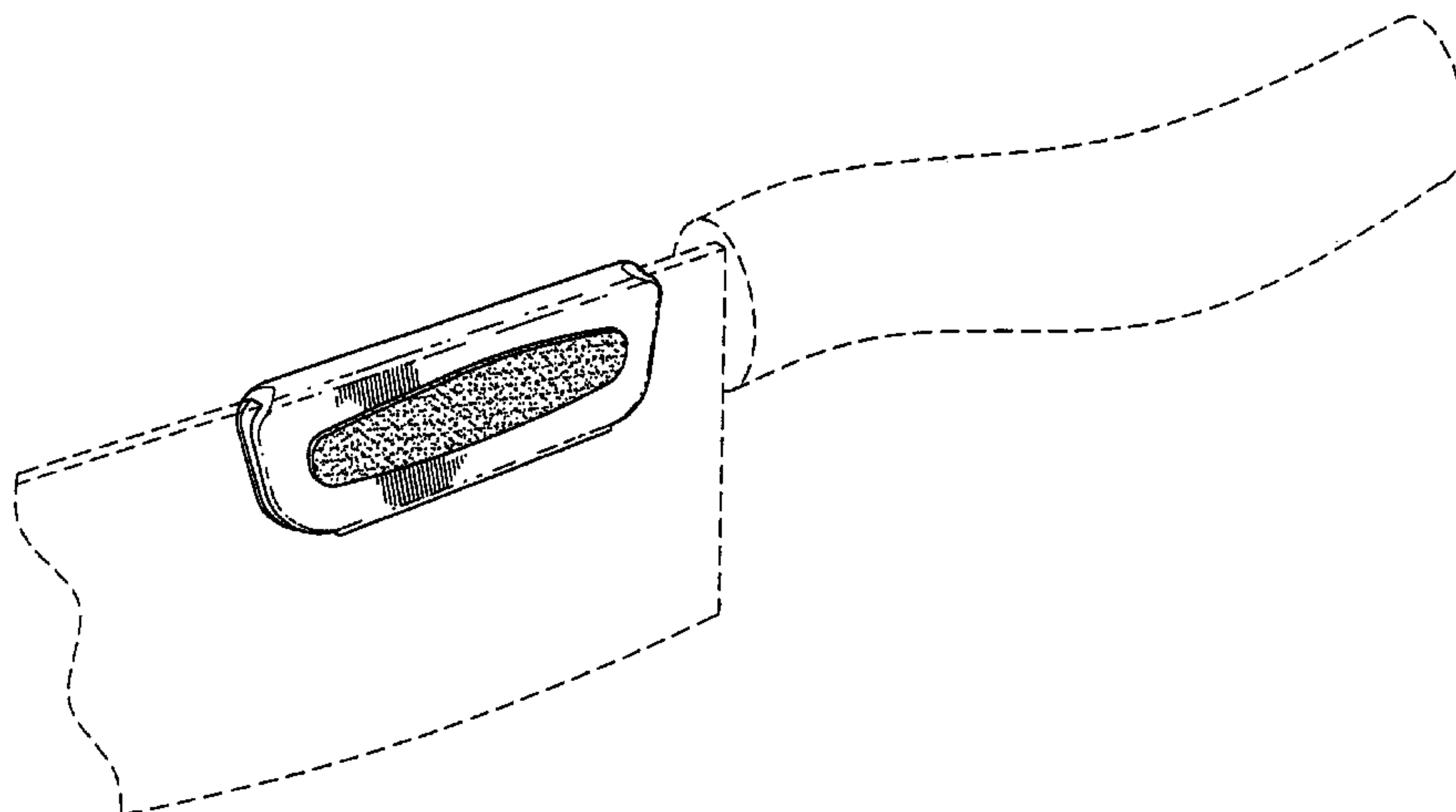
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the knife blade grip showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view, the rear being a mirror image;
 FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along line 4—4 in FIG. 3;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view; and,

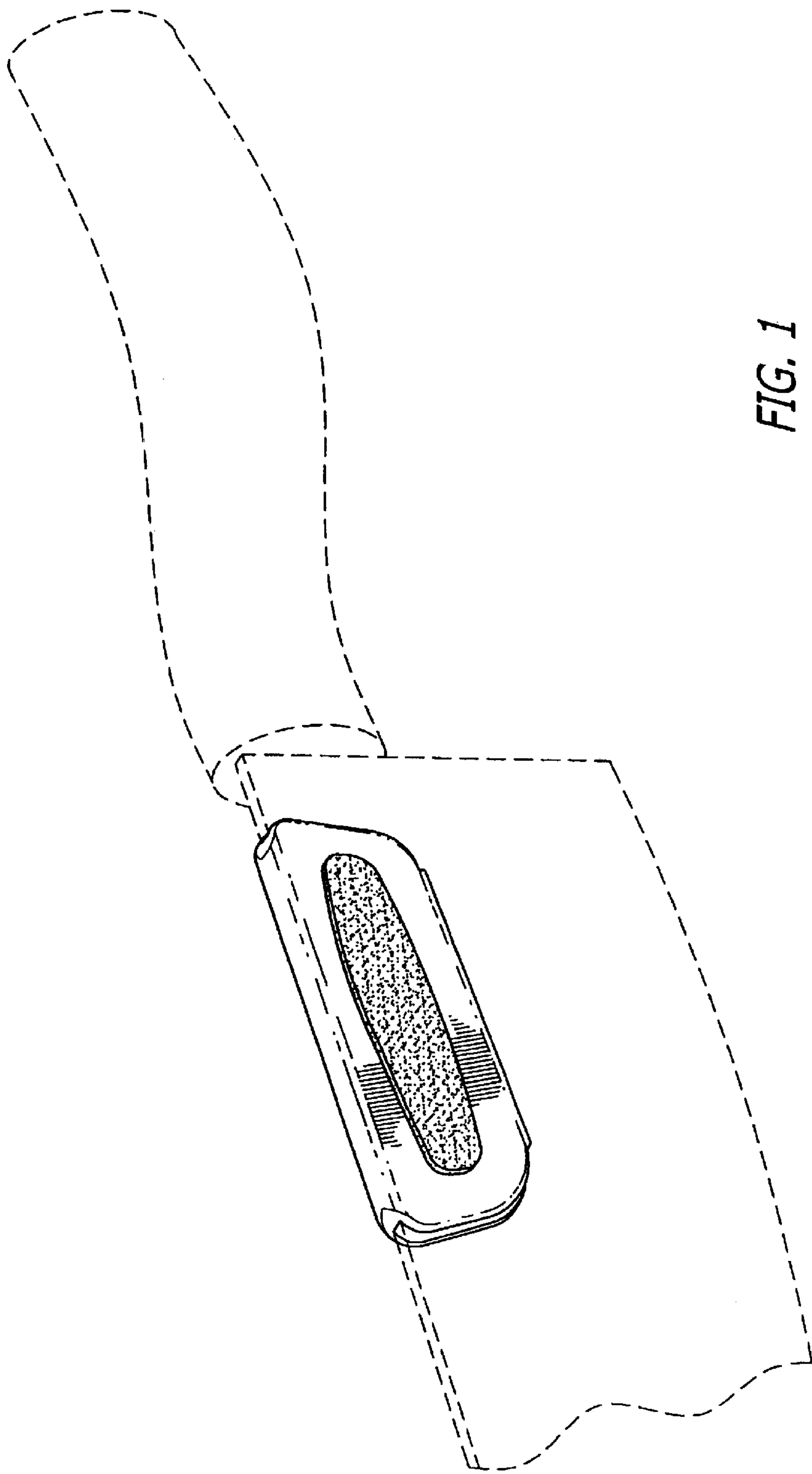

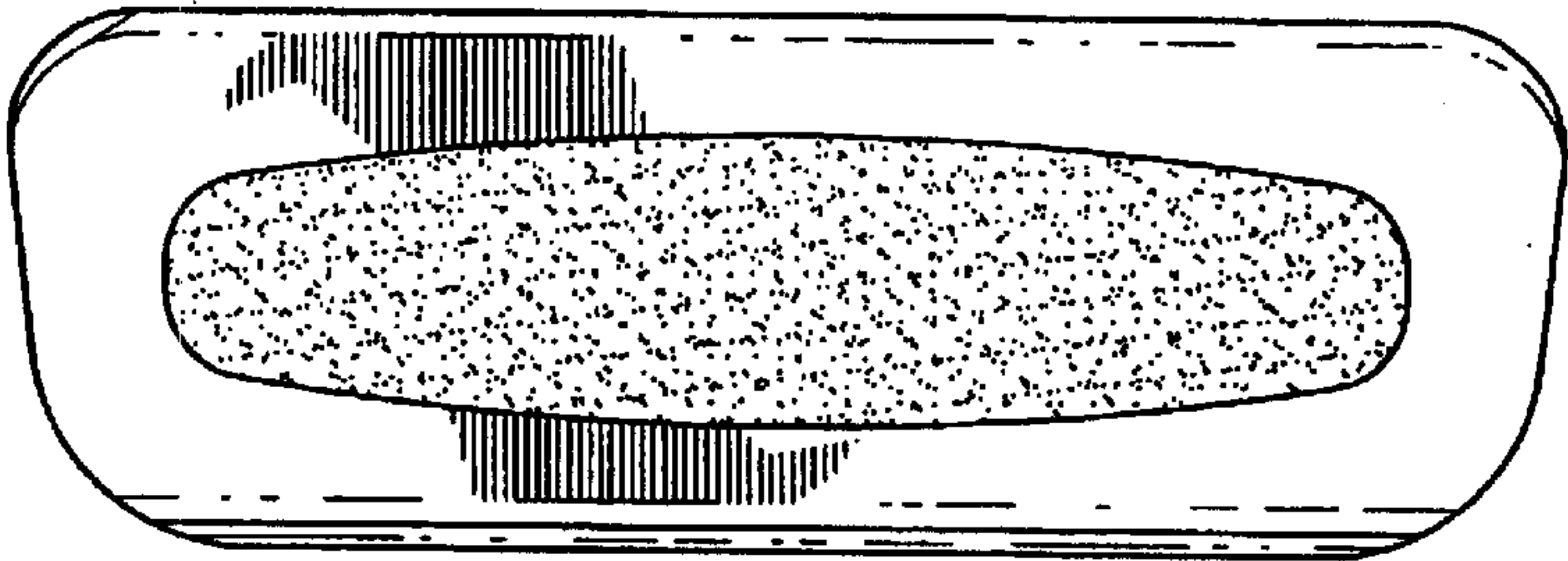

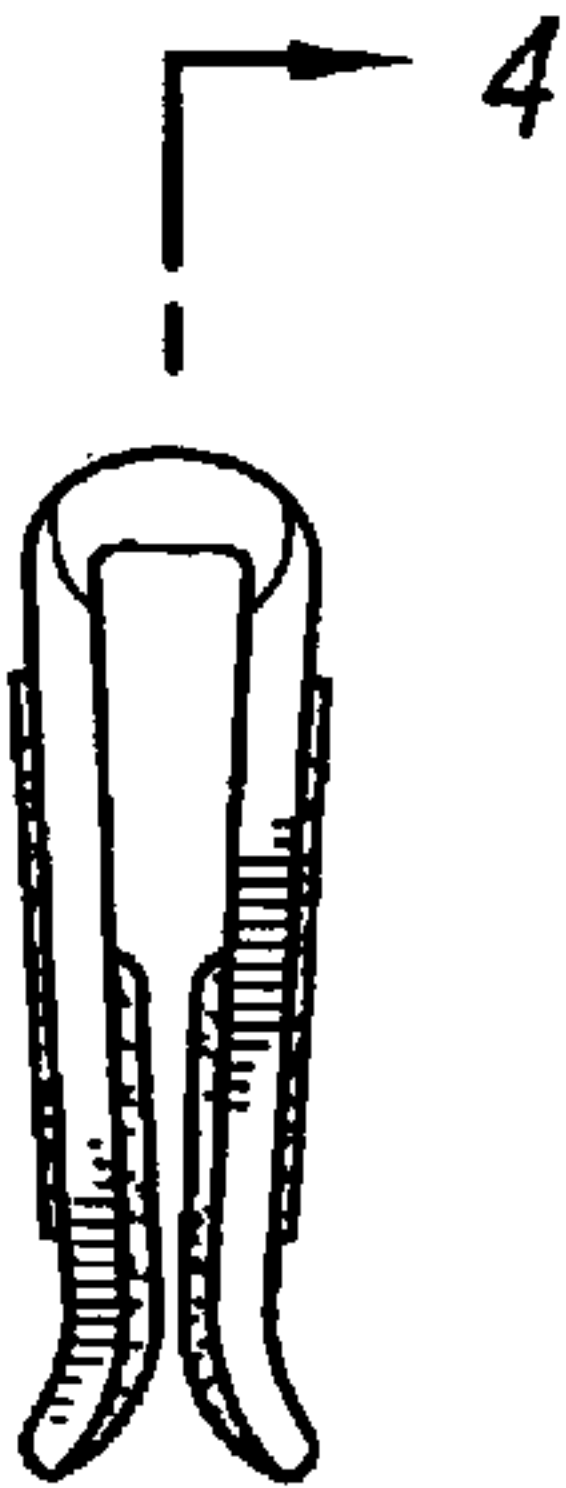

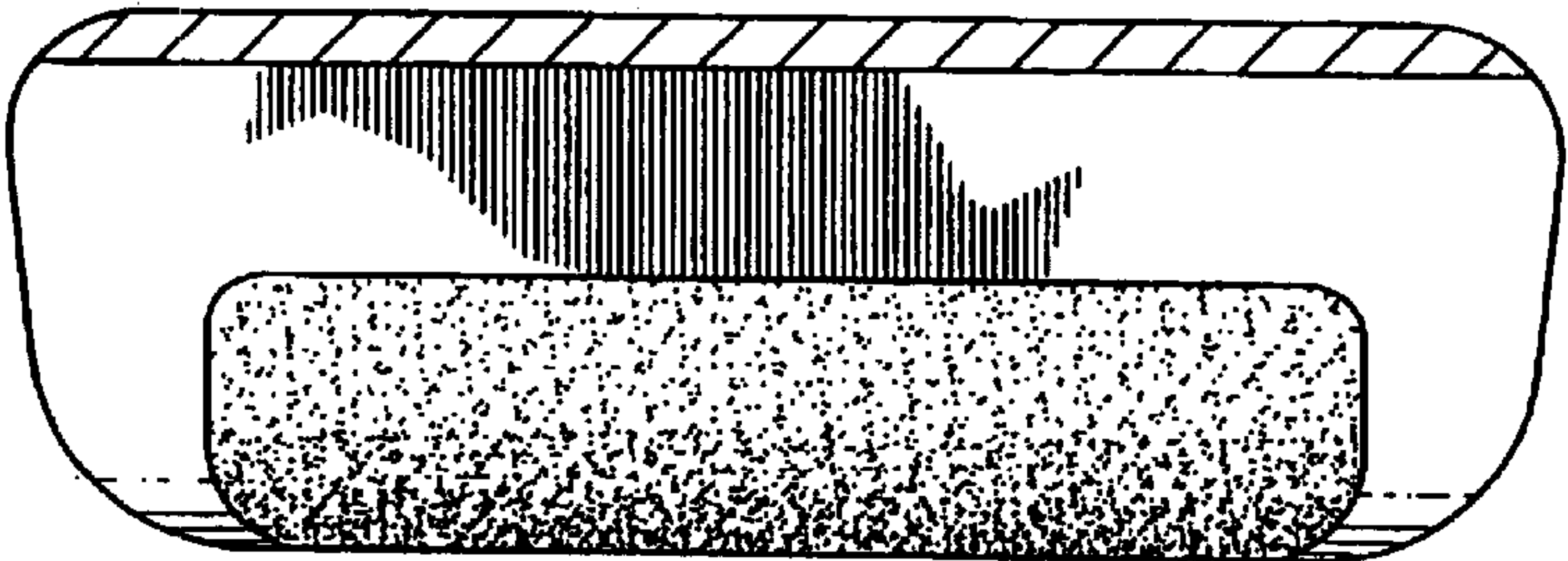

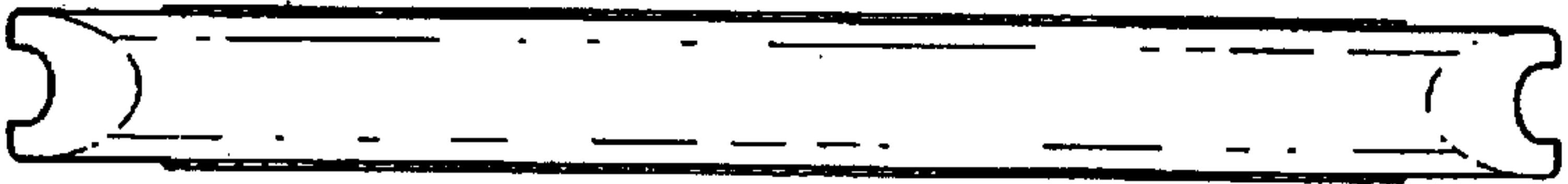
