The ornamental design for a belt buckle, as shown and described.

#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a belt buckle, according to a preferred embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a top view of the belt buckle illustrated in FIG. 1, according to the preferred embodiment;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the belt buckle illustrated in FIG. 1, according to the preferred embodiment;


FIG. 4 is a left side view of the belt buckle illustrated in FIG. 1, according to the preferred embodiment;












