design.

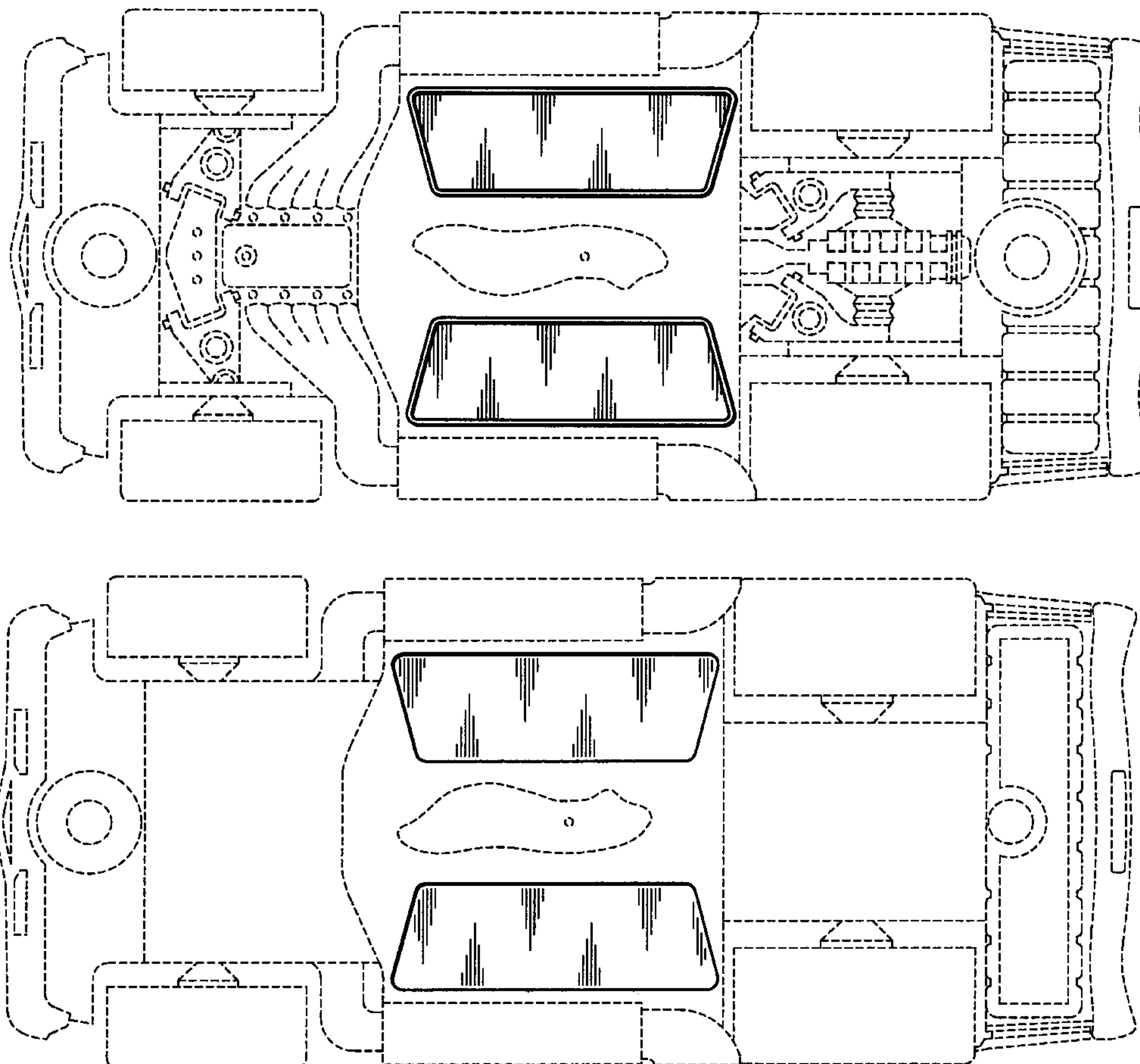
The shading lines shown in the drawing represent the

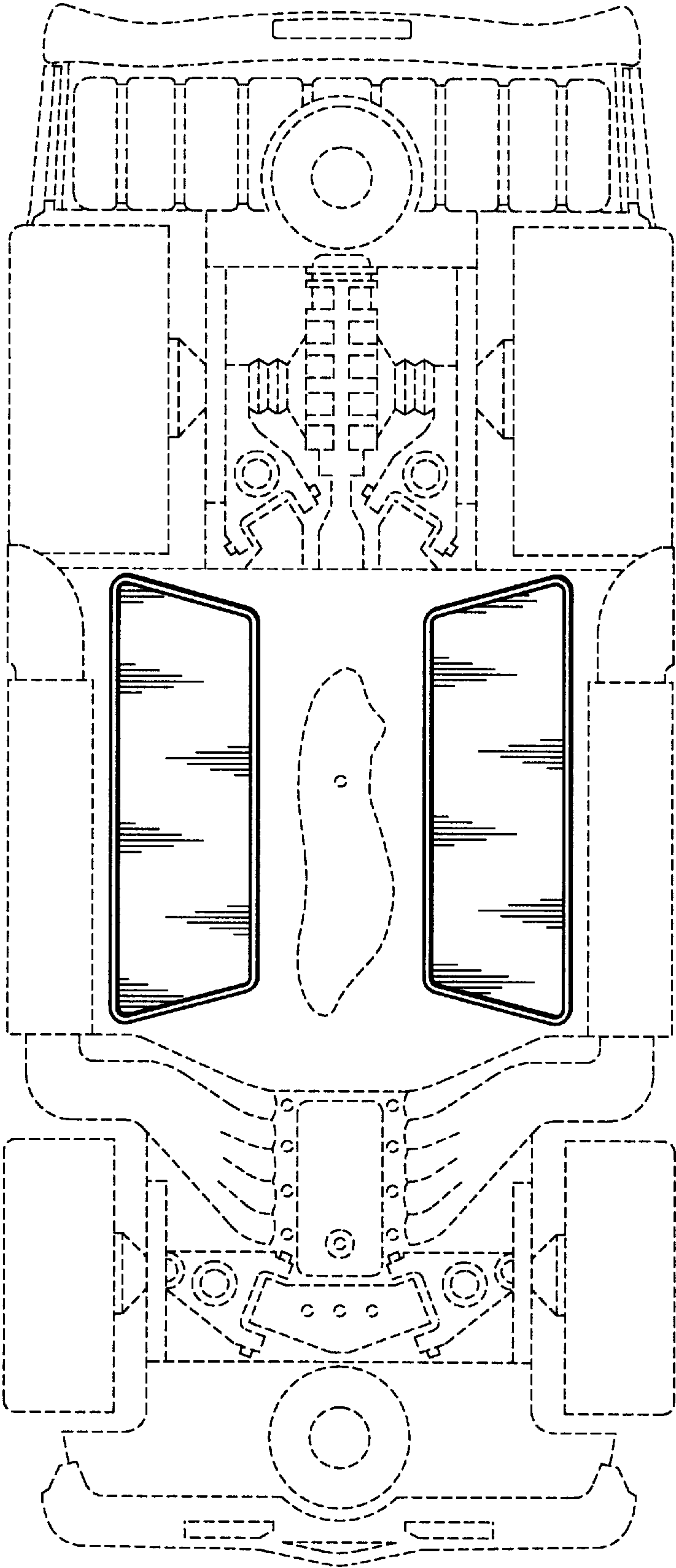

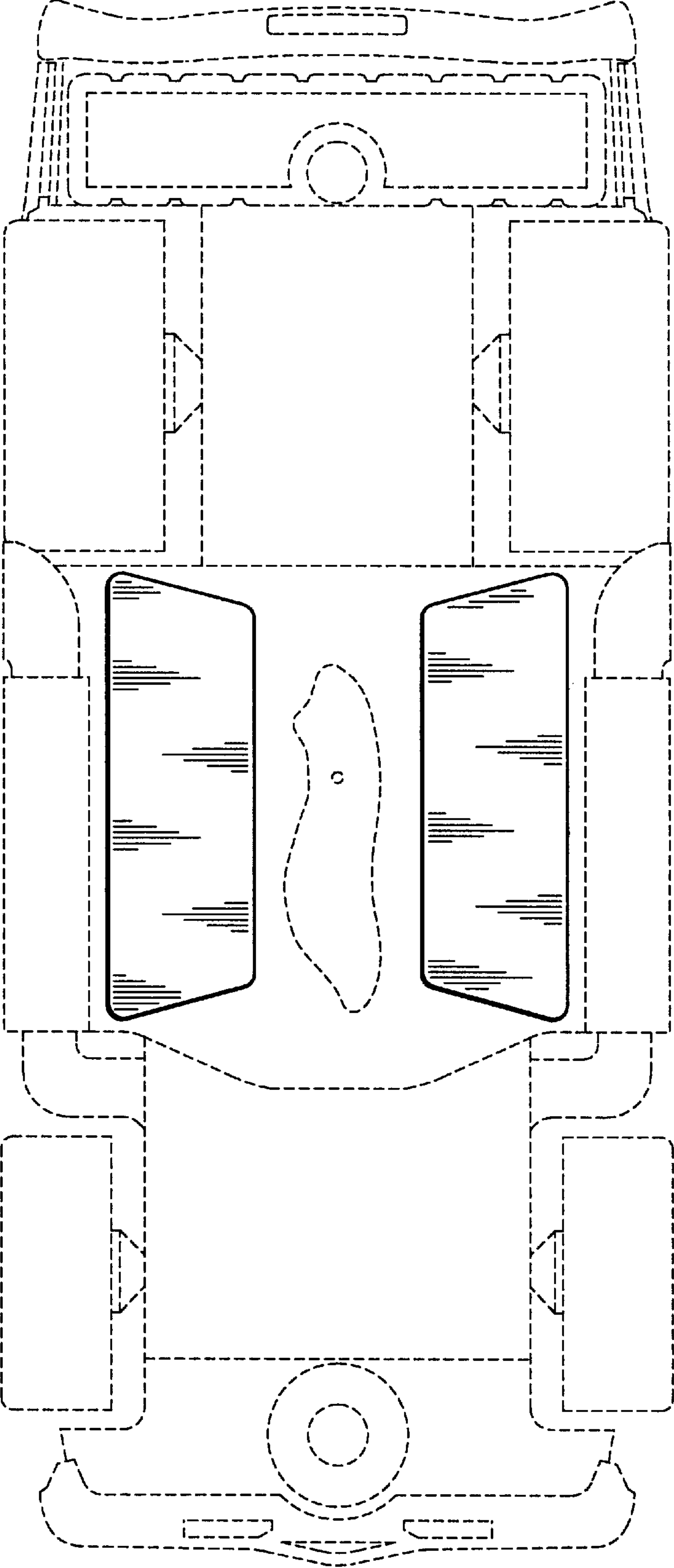
