(57) **CLAIM**

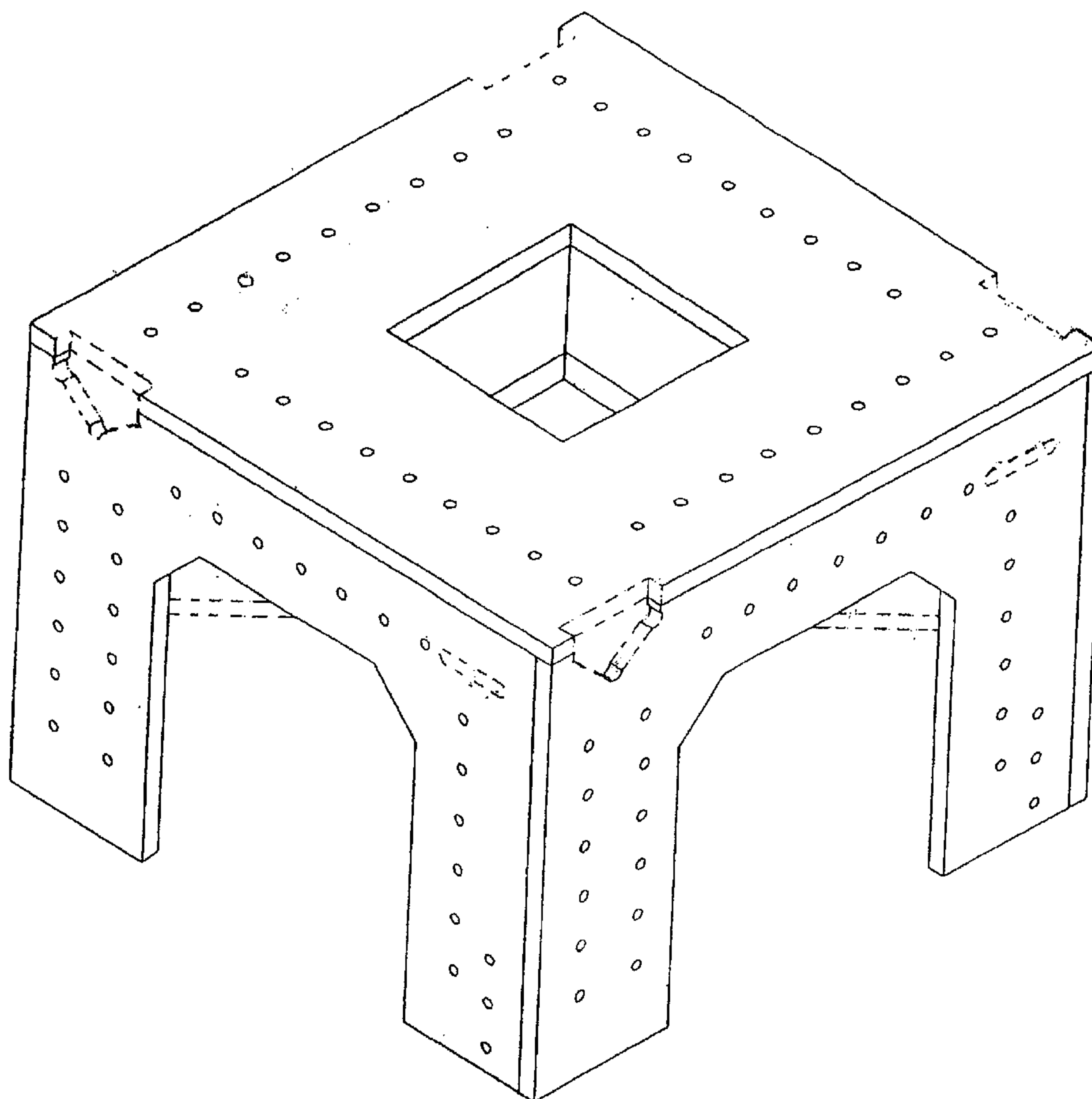
The ornamental design for a bench, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a bench of a first embodiment shown in square formation, the rear perspective view being a mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of the bench shown in square formation and broken away showing an indefinite length, the rear perspective view being a mirror image thereof.

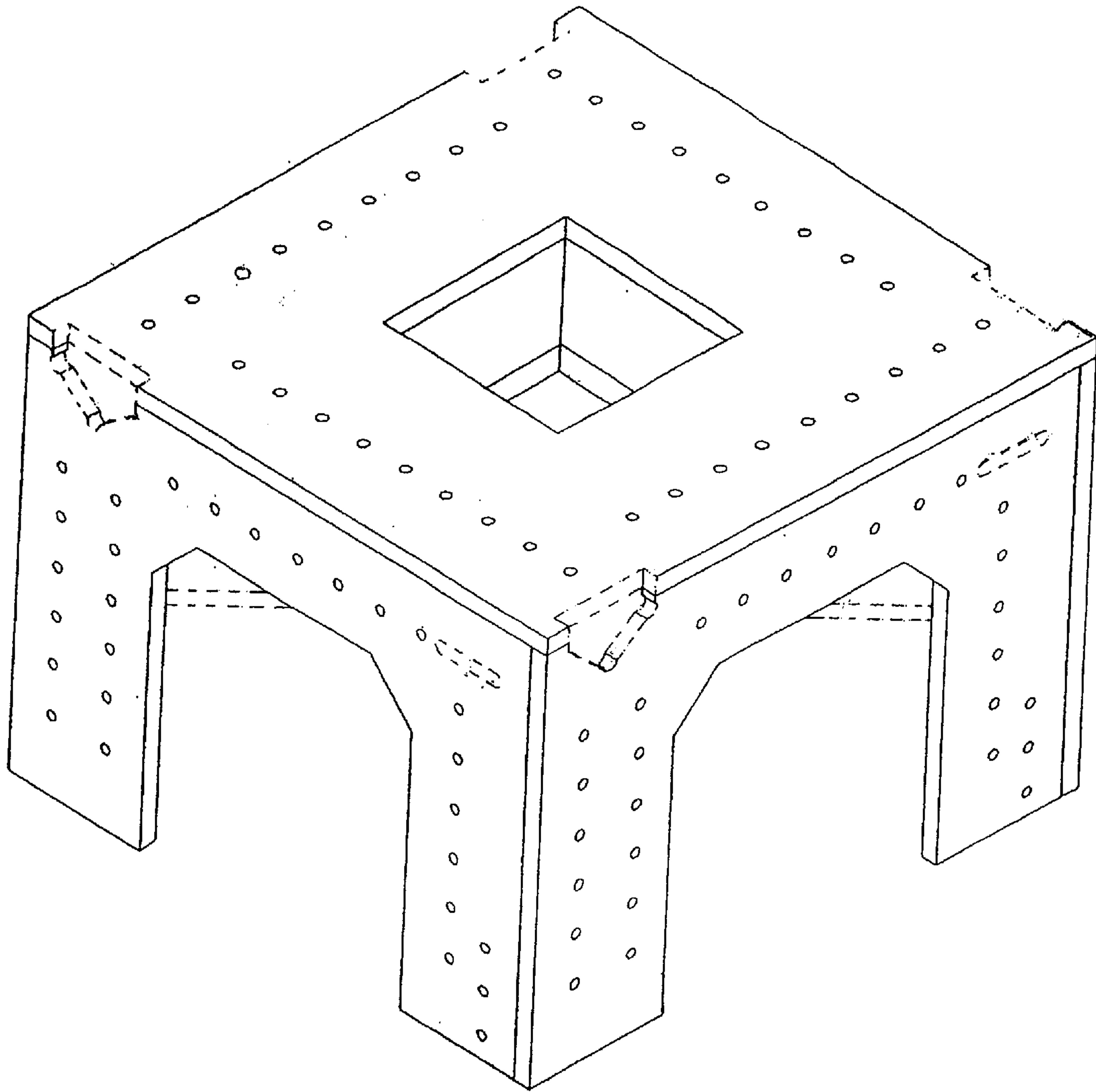

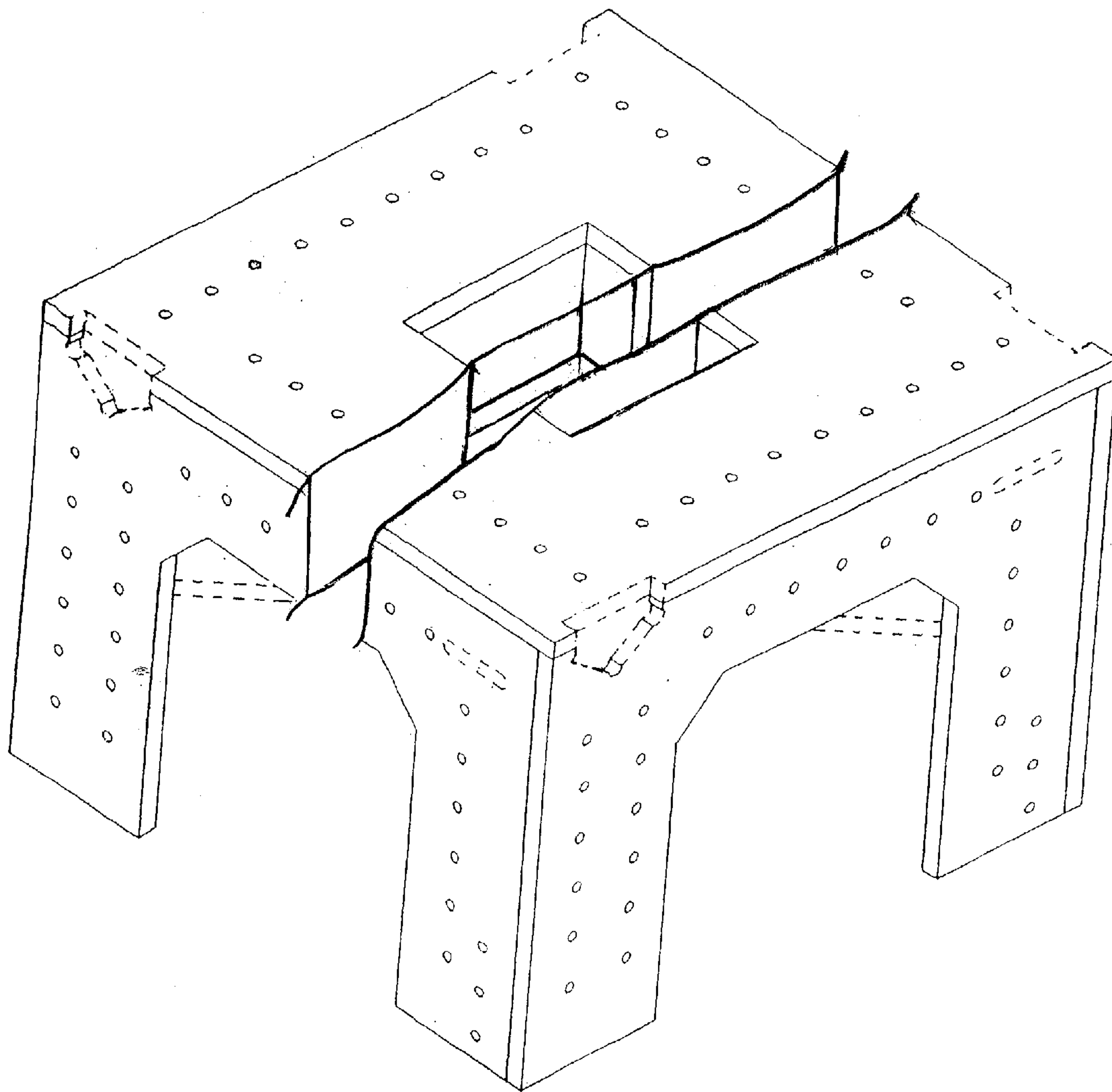
