(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a handle for hand-operated tool,
as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a handle for hand-operated
tool showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the handle for hand-
operated tool of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the handle for hand-
operated tool of FIGS. 1 and 2;

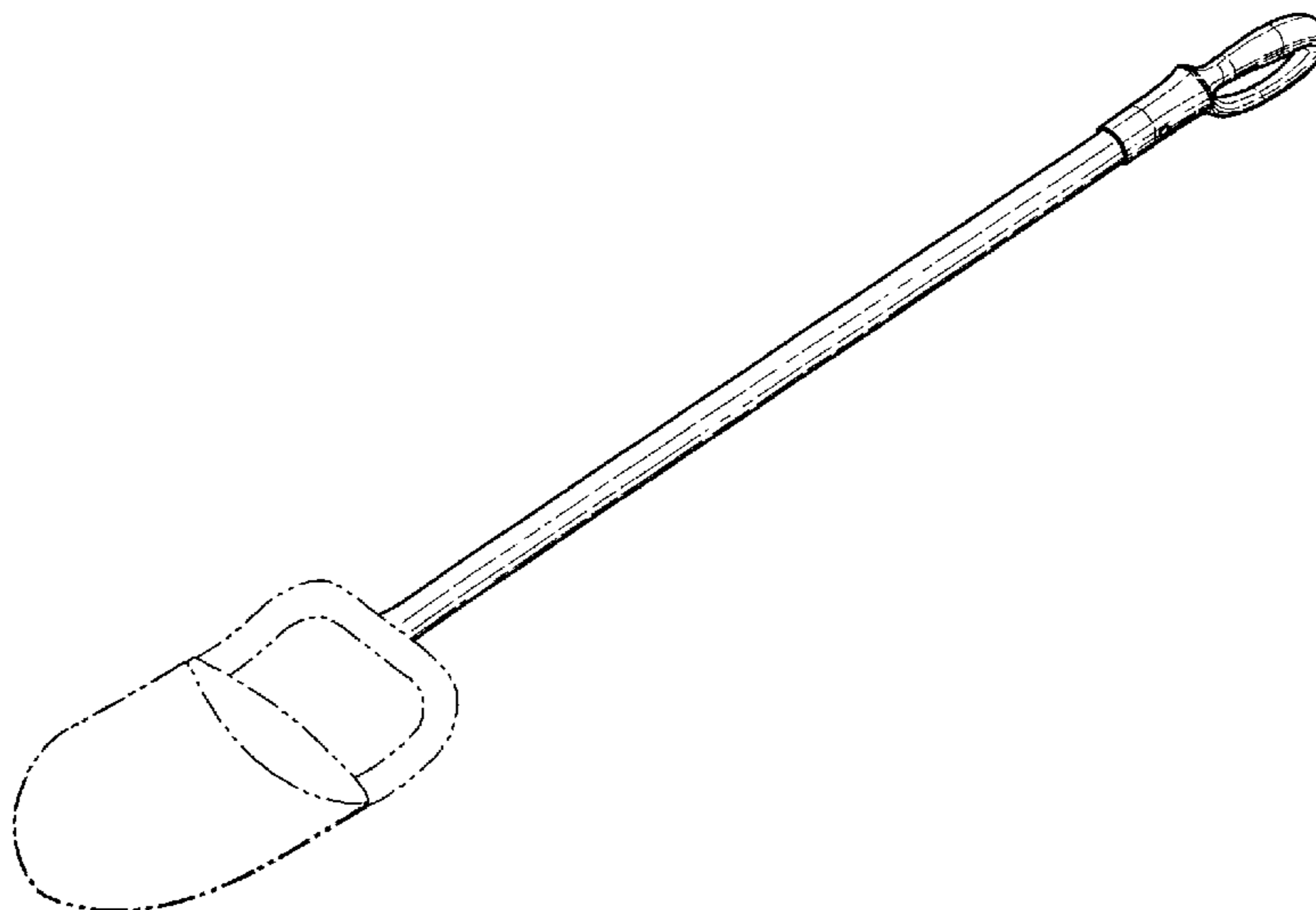
FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view of the handle for
hand-operated tool of FIGS. 1 to 3, the right side elevational
view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the handle for hand-operated
tool of FIGS. 1 to 4; and,

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the handle for hand-operated tool
of FIGS. 1 to 5.

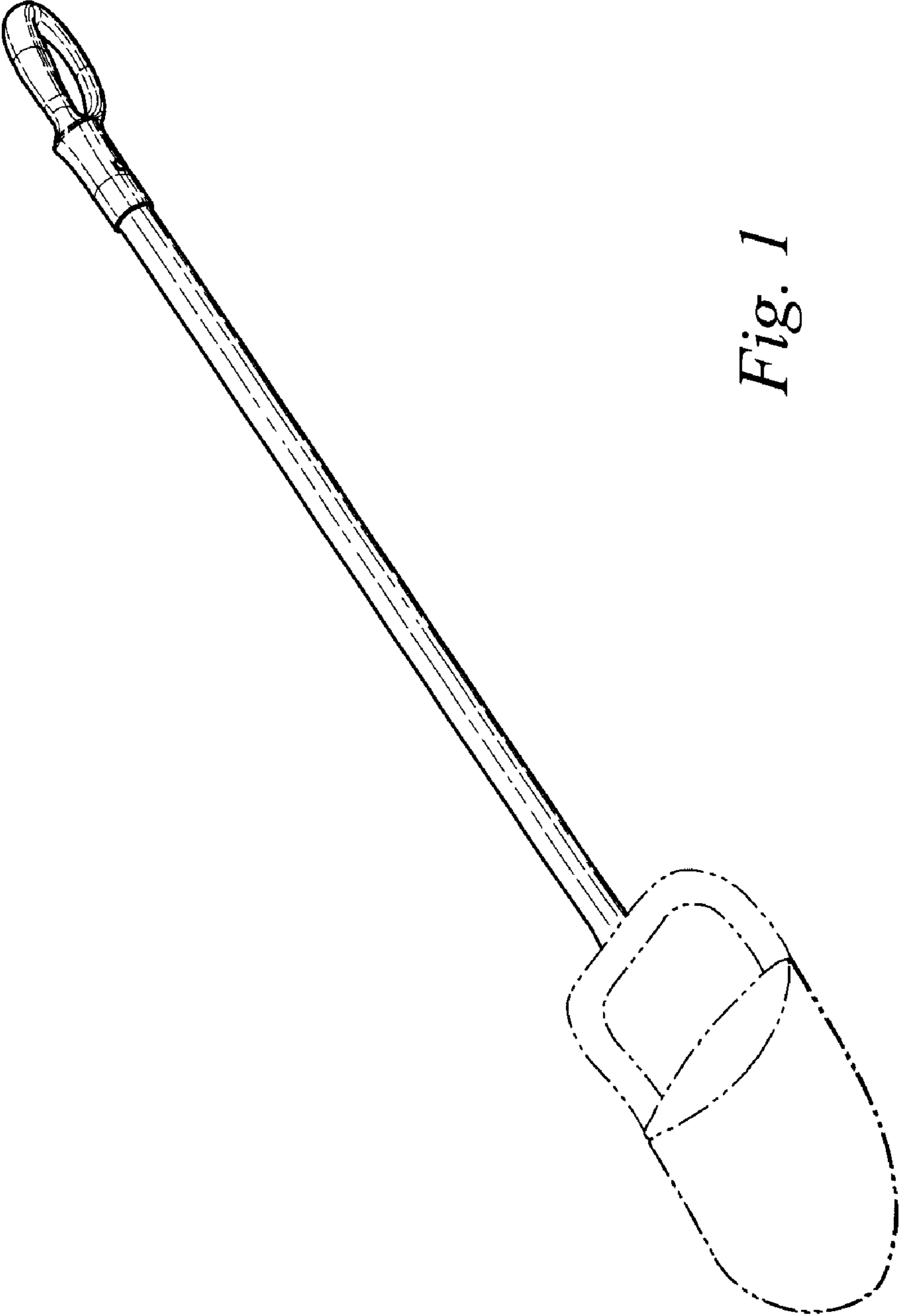

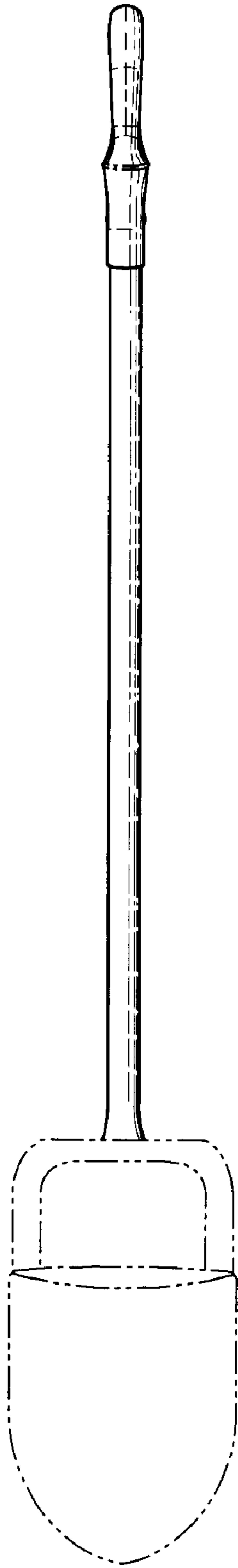

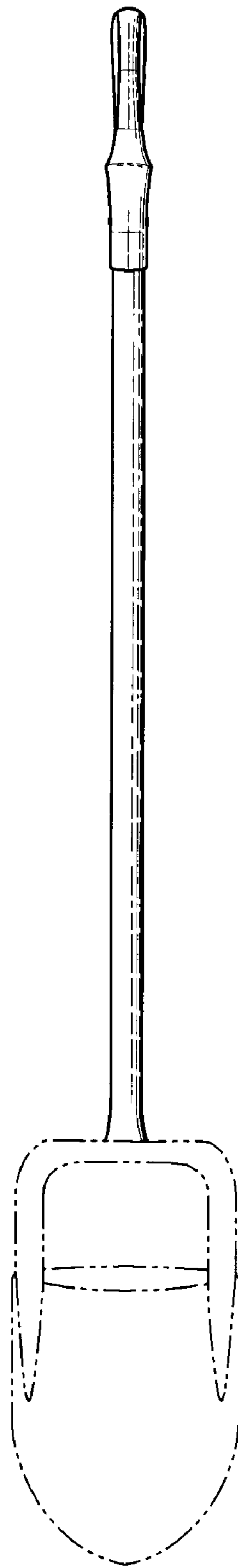

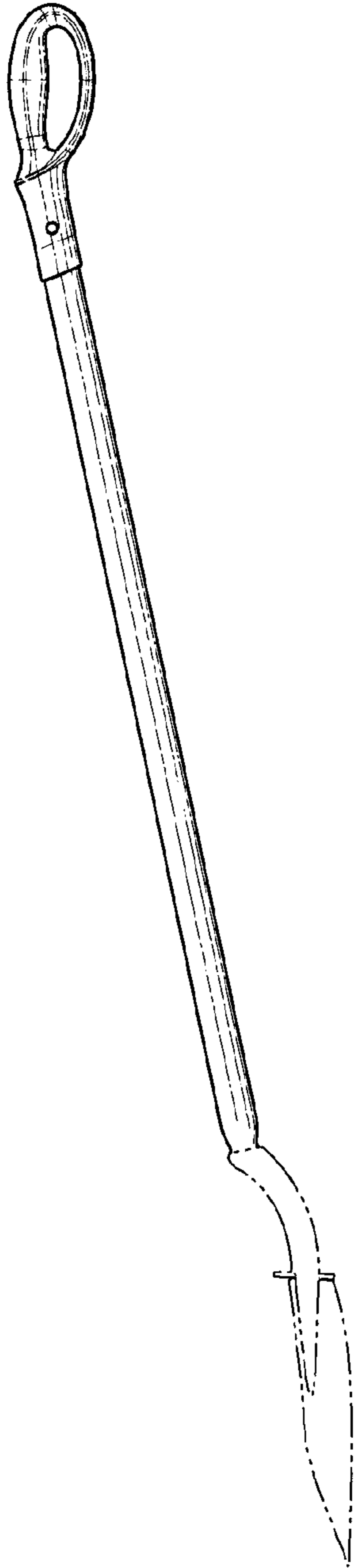

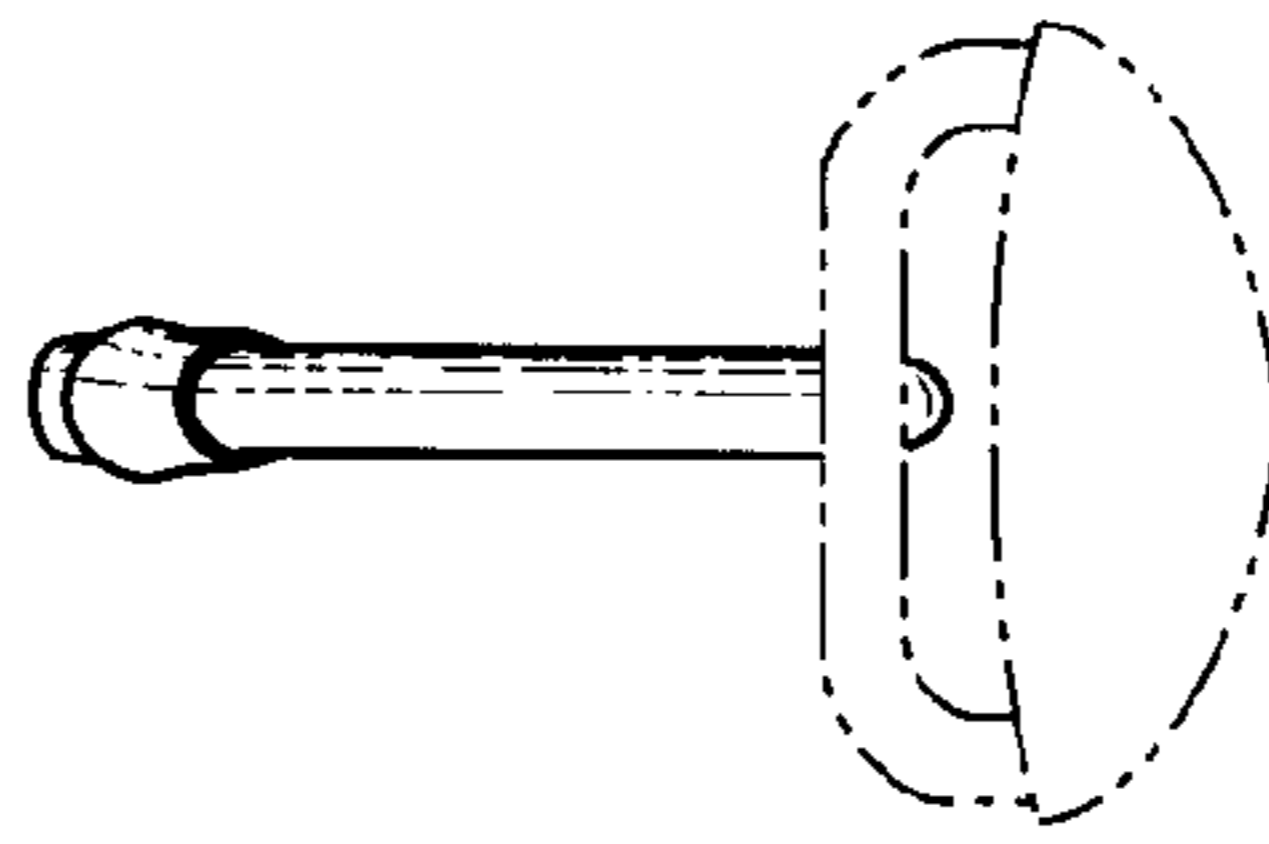

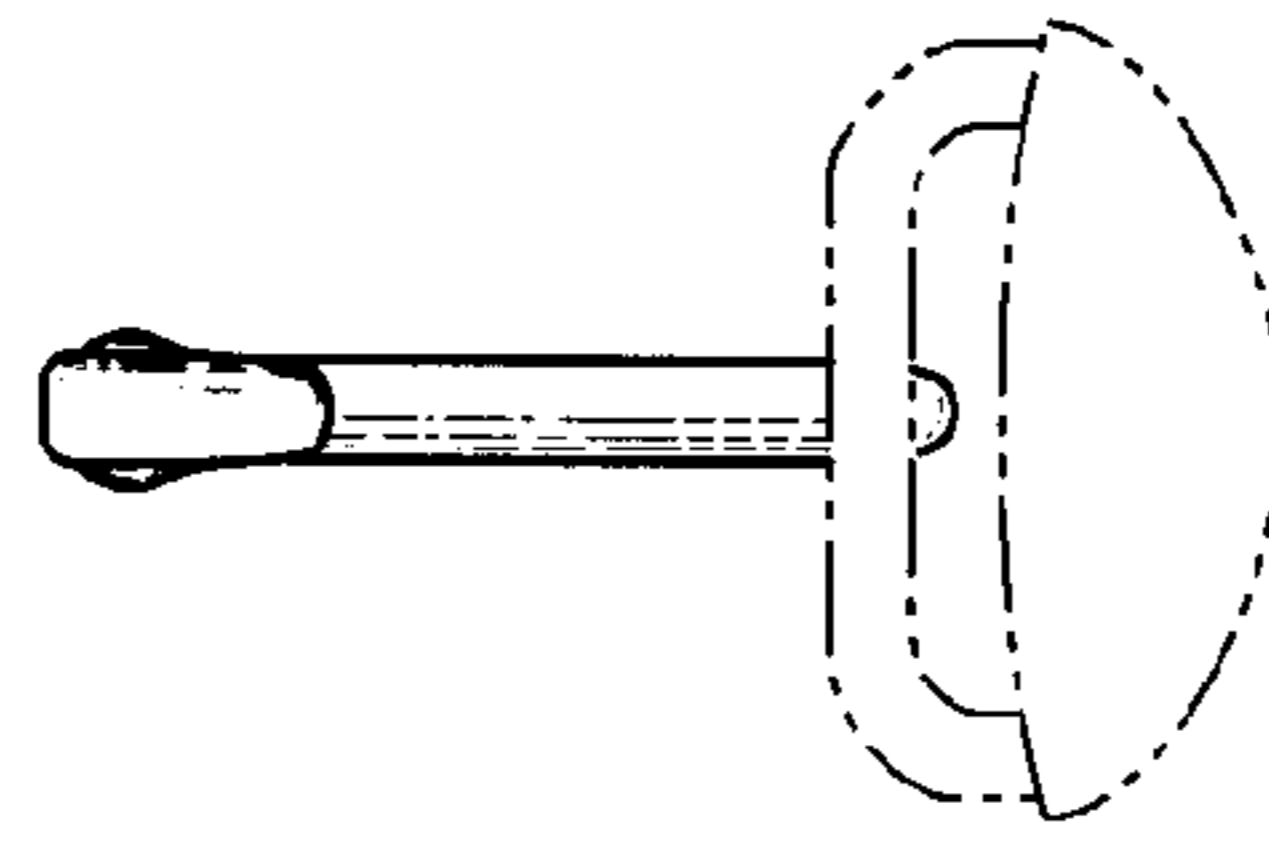
