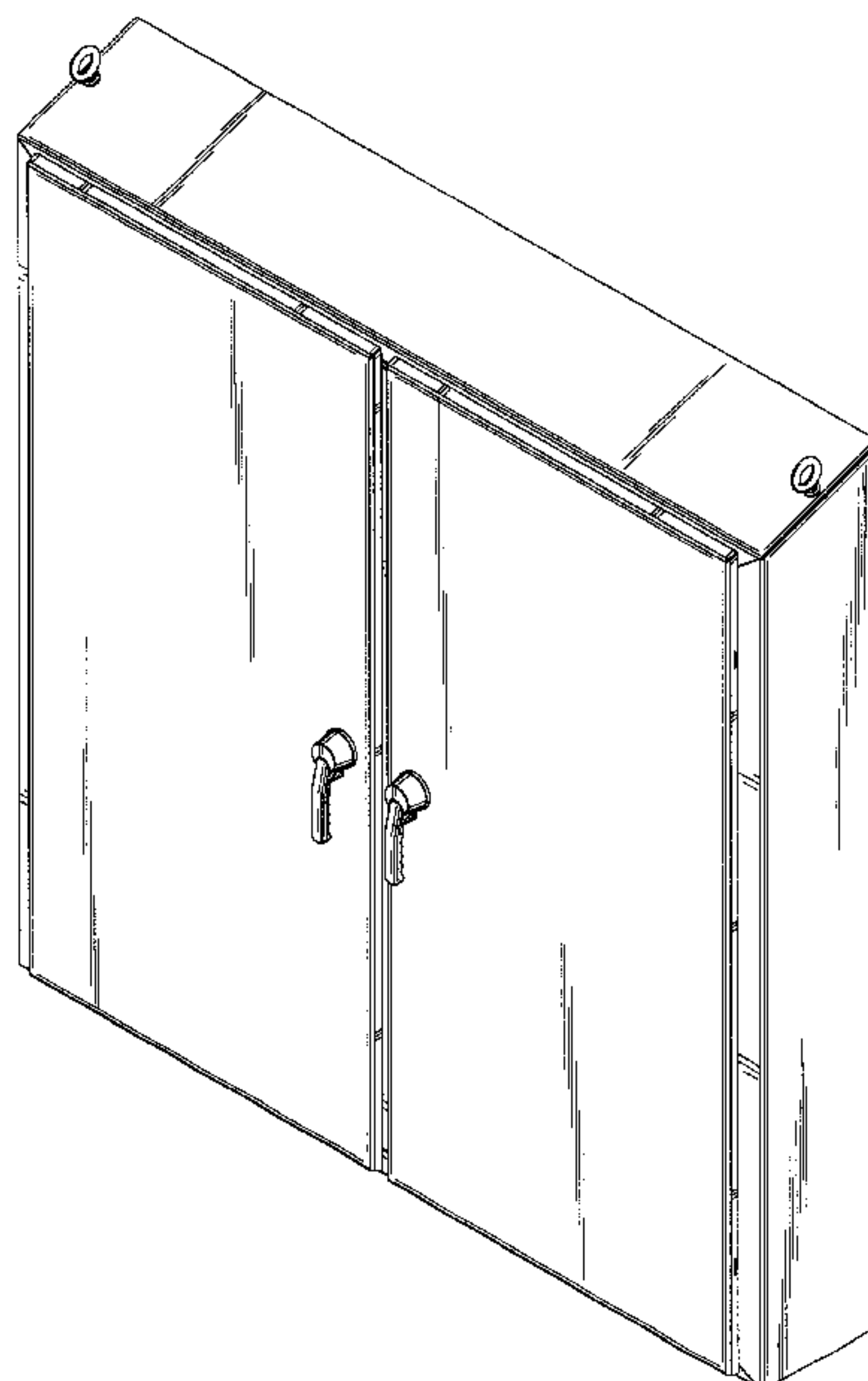
The ornamental design for the sanitary enclosure, as shown.

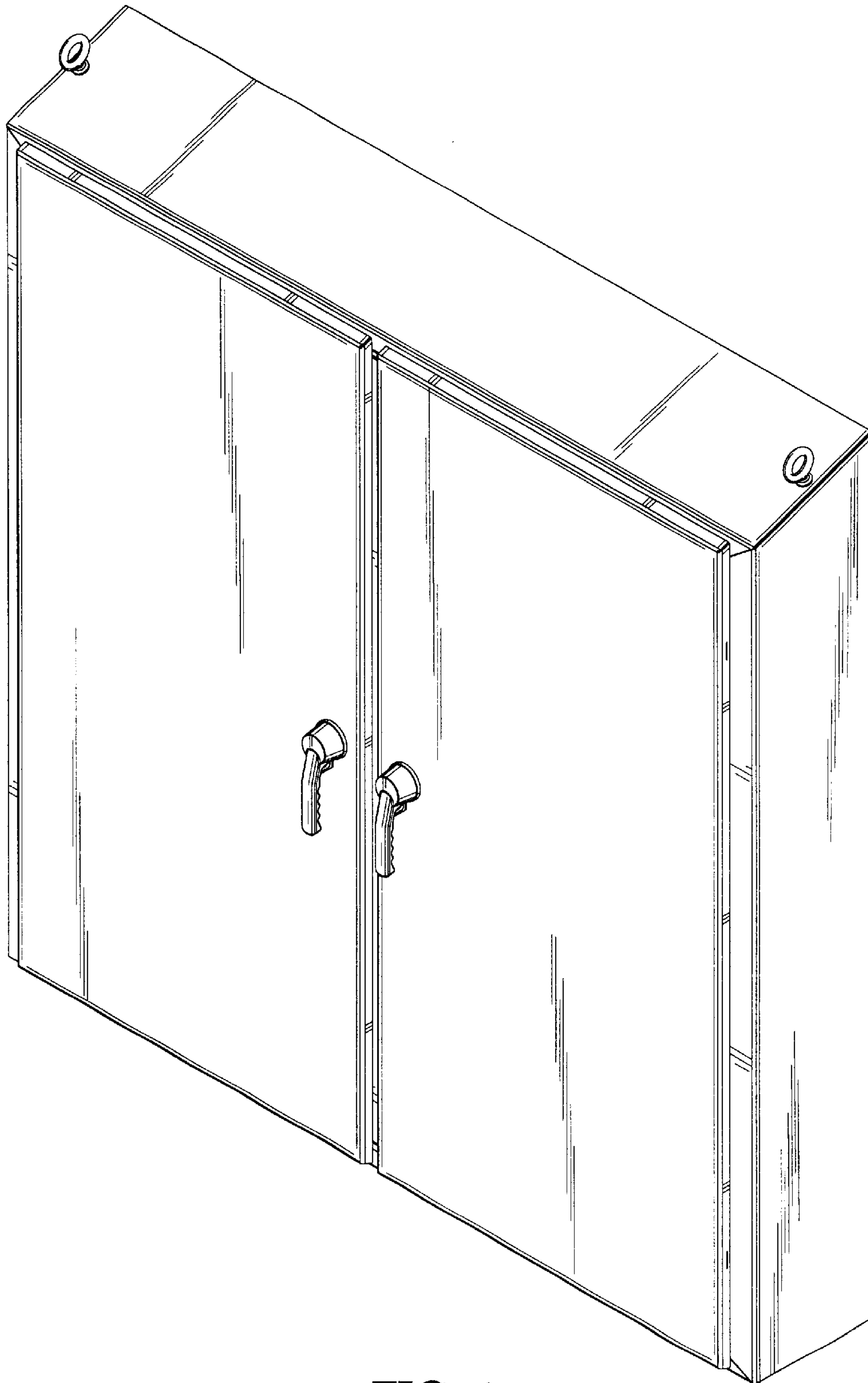

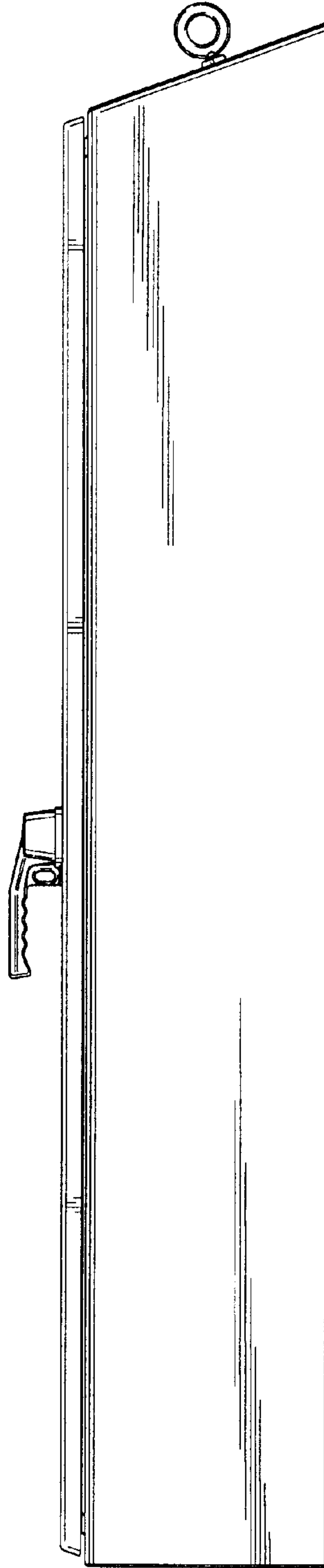

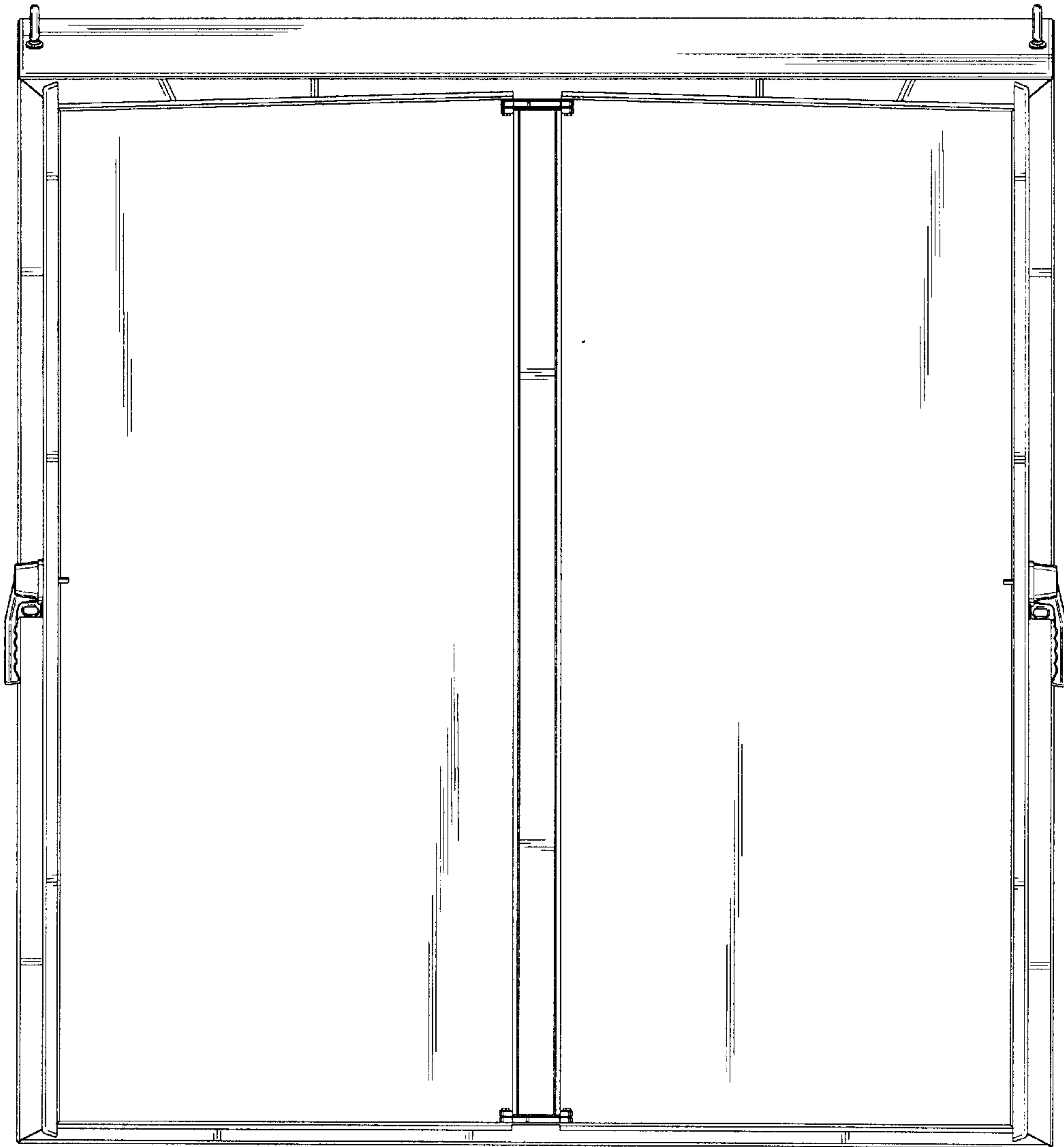
